## 'INDO-NEPAL TIES UNSHAKEABLE LIKE HIMALAYAS:' PM MODI

Addressing a Buddhist Conference in Lumbini, Modi said India and Nepal's ever-strengthening friendship and closeness will serve entire humanity

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday said India and Nepal's ever-strengthening friendship and closeness will serve entire humanity "amid the kind of global situation that is emerging today." Modi, who is in the Himalayan nation at the invitation of his Nepalese counterpart Sher Bahadur Deuba on a day-long visit to Lumbini on the occasion of Buddha Purnima, said the relations between the two nations are "unshakeable like the Himalayas."



Addressing a Buddhist Conference in Lumbini, Modi said Buddha is the embodiment of the collective understanding of humanity. "The growing and strengthening friendship

between India and Nepal will work for the benefit of entire humanity amid the kind of global situation that is emerging today. The devotion to Lord Buddha binds us together and makes us mem-

bers of one family," Modi said. Modi also said the energy of the place where Lord Buddha was born, gives a different feeling. "I was happy to see that the Mahabodhi sapling I had gifted in 2014

for this place, is now growing into a tree," he added. Modi, who attended the 2566th Buddha Jayanti Celebration at International Convention Center and Meditation Hall at Lumbini, was accompa-

## SC to hear challenge to survey Gyanvapi mosque

The Supreme Court will on Tuesday hear a plea against the Allahabad High Court order which dismissed a petition challenging a Varanasi court's order to appoint an advocate as a court commissioner to inspect the Gyanvapi mosque complex. A bench comprising Justices D.Y. Chandrachud and P.S. Narasimha will hear the plea filed by Committee of Management Anjuman Intezamia Masjid Varanasi.



On May 13, the apex court had declined to immediately stop the survey of the Gyanvapi mosque in Varanasi, and agreed to list the matter. Senior advocate Huzefa Ahmadi, representing the petitioner, mentioned a plea before the top court filed by the Committee seeking a stay on survey of complex. The plea challenged the validity of Allahabad High Court's April 21 order, which dismissed the plea against the civil court's order for the survey. Ahmadi mentioned the plea before a bench headed by Chief Justice N.V. Ramana. The bench said: "We don't know anything about the matter... We have no details. How can we pass the order?"

Ahmedi said "please grant status quo", and added that the mosque has been covered under Places of Worship Act. The bench said: "Let me look at the papers, let me see..." A Varanasi court on a suit filed jointly by five Hindu women, last month ordered an inspection of the premises

through advocate commissioner Ajai Kumar Mishra. The Allahabad High Court affirmed the civil court order.

The petitioners urged the court for year-long access to pray at a shrine behind the western wall of the mosque complex.

The women petitioners also want permission to pray to other "visible and invisible deities within the old temple complex".

On May 12, a Varanasi court ordered resumption of the video survey of the Gyanvapi mosque complex, including the basement and closed rooms.

The Muslim parties had objected to the survey. The court said the survey report should be submitted on May 17. The Varanasi court also declined to entertain the demand of Muslim parties to remove advocate commissioner Ajai Kumar Mishra, instead appointed two additional commissioners -- lawyers Vishal Singh and Ajay Pratap Singh -- to assist him.

## SCO ANTI-TERROR MEET BEGINS IN DELHI

New Delhi: The meeting of the Regional Anti-Terror Structure (RATS) began here on Monday with an eye on curbing terror activities.

Delegations from the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) countries are participating in the meeting.

The RATS is a permanent anti-terror unit under the ambit of the SCO-based in Uzbekistan. The main aim is to promote cooperation among the member countries against terrorism.

SCO chairmanship is by rotation for a year between the member states. India is currently heading the executive council as the chairman. It is expected that discussion will be on the security situation in Afghanistan as the Taliban has used violence and it is feared that it could become a terror launch pad and drug smuggling hub, sources indicated.

Anti-terror teams from China, Pakistan, Russia and other Asian countries are participating in the meet from May 16 to 19.



## CORBEVAX PRICE SLASHED TO RS 250 PER DOSE

Vaccine maker Biological E. Ltd (BE) on Monday announced that it has reduced the price of its Covid-19 vaccine corbevax, from Rs 840 to Rs 250 a dose inclusive of GST, for private Covid-19 vaccination centres.

For the end user, the price would be Rs 400 a dose, including taxes and administration charges.

The Hyderabad-based company said it has lowered the price of its vaccine with the aim of making it more affordable and help increase the reach to protect the maximum number of children against the virus.

The decision comes within weeks of Biological E. receiving Emergency Use Authorisation (EUA) for children between 5 and 12 years of age. The previous private market price for the vaccine was Rs 990 per dose, including taxes and vaccine administration charges.

Corbrvax is also offered in a single-dose vial, making it more convenient for vaccine administration. It eliminates vaccine wastage, which is a major advantage for private hospitals.

The Corbevax vaccination slot can be booked through the Co-WIN app or the Co-WIN portal for children aged 12 to 17.

So far, 43.9 million doses of Corbevax have been administered to children across the country and Biological E. has supplied close to 100 million doses to the government.

Biological E., in collaboration with Texas Children's Hospital and Baylor College of Medicine, has developed a recombinant protein sub-unit vaccine for the novel coronavirus, Corbevax.

Prior to receiving EUA for vaccination, the company conducted Phase 2 and 3 multicentre clinical trials in 624 children aged 5-12 and 12-18.

## LET TERROR MODULE BUSTED IN J&K'S BANDIPORA, 7 HELD

A terror module of proscribed terror outfit LeT was busted in Jammu and Kashmir's Bandipora with the arrest of seven terrorists/terrorist associates, including a woman, police said on Monday. Incriminating materials, including arms and ammunition, have also been recovered from their possession. Six vehicles including four two-wheelers have also been seized.



"During the course of investigation of cases regarding the recent Bandipora encounters, Bandipora police, along with other security forces, busted a terror module of proscribed terror outfit LeT by arresting an active Pakistan-trained terrorist, two hybrid terrorists and four terrorist associates," a police official said.

The Pakistan-trained terrorist has been identified as Arif Ajaz Shehri, son of Ajaz Ahmad alias Anfall, resident of Nadihal, who had gone to Pakistan on a valid visa in 2018 through Wagah Border and infiltrated back to

this side after obtaining illegal arms training and started actively working with proscribed terror outfit LeT in Bandipora.

The two hybrid terrorists have been identified as Ajaz Ahmad Reshi, resident of Rampora, and Shariq Ahmad Lone, resident of Gundpora.

They were tasked with carrying out attacks on police/security forces and other soft targets, particularly in Bandipora dis-

trict. The four terrorist associates, who include a woman, have been identified as Riyaz Ahmad Mir alias Metha Shehri, resident of Plan Bandipora, Gh Mohammad Waza alias Gul Bab, resident of Tawheedabad Bagh, Maqsood Ahmad Malik, resident of Chittibandy Aragam, and Sheema Shafi Waza, resident of Tawheedabad Bagh.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the arrested terrorist associates were involved

in harbouring terrorists, providing logistics/material support including transportation of terrorists in the Bandipora district. The arrested female terrorist associate was also involved in providing wi-fi hotspot, accommodation and ferrying terrorists in Bandipora town," police said.

Arms and ammunition, including two pistols, three pistol magazines, 25 pistol rounds, and three hand grenades, were recovered from their possession. Besides, an Ecco Van bearing registration number JK15A-1528 which was being used in ferrying of terrorists from Bandipora to Nowgam, Pantha Chowk and Srinagar was also seized. Moreover, three two-wheelers, which were being used for doing recce of police, security establishments, monitoring movement of security forces, and ferry terrorists in Bandipora area, were also seized. Similarly, a Maruti-800 Car and a Pulsar bike were also seized.

Cases under the relevant sections of law have been registered and further investigation is going on.

## More 'surgical strikes' in offing in Kashmir University

Continuing its exercise to dismantle the 'intellectual infrastructure' created by the secessionists in Kashmir University, the J&K government is contemplating to ban the Kashmir University Teachers Association (KUTA).

An official revealed that KUTA is one of the half a dozen associations that had played an extremely important role in creating and sustaining the ideological-narrative framework necessary for a militant-secessionist network to thrive and succeed in Kashmir's case as part of a well-thought strategy designed by the hostile Pakistani intelligence agency ISI to eventually defeat the Indian state by turning its own instruments against itself and making the Indian state finance its own meltdown.

The secessionist 'infiltration' into this highest institution of learning in Kashmir has a three-decade long history. Valley's highest seat of learning remained under the de facto control of the secessionists who ensured their control by positioning 'loyalists' at vital positions in academia and administration. The radicalisation of the University was so complete that even admissions to vari-



ous departments were done on recommendation of the secessionist leaders and militant commanders.

Shootouts between those who stood for 'independence' and those for merger with Pakistan were reported from within the campus during the mid 1990s.

Intelligence agencies, both Central and state, had mountain loads of inputs about the radicalisation of the University students.

As a senior intelligence officer put it, "Those were reports, but not all of them had actionable inputs and whenever we got actionable inputs, we acted." In layman terms, 'actionable input' meant the presence of a militant with weapons or presence of some communication network or

any information about a wanted person hiding inside the campus.

Interestingly, even during the official functions where the chancellor (state Governor) and the vice chancellor would be present, no student would stand up in deference to the national anthem. The worst part of that story was that even some of the faculty members would also refuse to stand up when the national anthem was being played. The recent dismissal of professor Altaf Hussain Pandit of the University's chemistry department has proved that the intelligence agencies have been able to find what they call 'actionable evidence.' Pandit's dismissal could be the beginning of an operation clean up, the Lt Governor Manoj Sinha's

government has decided to undertake in the University. Post abrogation of Article 370, two discreet analyses of academic and student activities in Kashmir University have been carried out, said top intelligence sources. These analyses have shown that "Three faculty members have been contaminated to an extent that requires immediate action." 12 faculty members have been found contaminated to a lesser extent that needs a graded response.

"24 members of different faculties are contaminated to an even lesser extent who need counselling and observation," intelligence sources revealed. The intelligence reports have also suggested long term measures to carry out reforms to ensure a free academic atmosphere in the University and also an atmosphere for recruitments that is free from nepotism, corruption and favouritism. Presently, the intelligence agencies are carrying out analyses of the non-teaching staff.

What becomes clear from these intelligence reports is that in not a very distant future, the University would see more heads rolling to restore the academic excellence for which the University was once famous.

## J&K LG meets Rajnath, seeks assistance of BRO for Amarnath Yatra

Jammu and Kashmir Lt Governor Manoj Sinha on Monday met Union Defence Minister Rajnath Singh here, and discussed the road infrastructure for the upcoming Amarnath Yatra.

It was learnt that LG also requested the Defence Minister for setting up make-shift hospitals by the Defence Research Development Organisation (DRDO) in least two places, and oxygen booths in the route to the holy cave.

Sinha will also be participating in the high-level meeting chaired by Union Home Minister Amit Shah on the preparedness of Amarnath Yatra on Tuesday in North Block.



Along with him, officials of the Jammu and Kashmir administration and police chief Dilbag Singh will be participating in the meeting wherein they will make a presentation of a 'blueprint' prepared for this 45-day long Yatra.

This annual pilgrimage is commencing from June 30 after a hiatus of two years and expecting a huge participation of the devotees this year.

The Jammu and Kashmir administration has planned this annual pilgrimage on a grand scale with many new initiatives such as setting up of Tent Township on the line of Kumbh Mela and a huge and fool-proof security apparatus will be created with the help of Jammu and Kashmir Police, Central Armed Police Forces and the Indian Army.

Congress General Secretary Sachin Sawant has dug out old photos and videos of several BJP leaders who had visited the burial site of the late Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb at Khuldabad and raised uncomfortable questions.

"The BJP National Executive member and Spokesperson, and Jammu & Kashmir Waqf Board President Darakshan Andrabi had gone to Aurangzeb's tomb during the Corona period," he said.

Similarly, Khalid Qureshi, the Vice-President of BJP's Minority



Affairs also had gone there and in 2019, when current Leader of Opposition Devendra Fadnis was the BJP CM even AIMIM MP Asasuddin Owaisi went to pay homage there in 2019. "The tomb is under the jurisdiction of

Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). So why can't the Central government control, restrict or even ban entry to Aurangzeb's grave?" Sawant demanded.

He wondered why Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government does-

n't initiate action against the Owaisi and even the BJP leaders who have gone to Aurangzeb's final resting place in Khuldabad.

Sawant slammed the BJP, MNS and the Independent MP Navneet Kaur-Rana and her MLA husband Ravi Rana for blaming the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) government for the May 12 visit to the grave by Telangana MLA Akbaruddin Owaisi.

Some BJP and MNS activists threatened "to bury" Owaisi in a grave right next to Aurangzeb's and the Rana couple challenged Maharashtra Chief Minister to take strong action against Owaisi for his trip there which sparked off a major political row. Shiv Sena MoS Kishore Tiwari and other MVA leaders have dismissed the 'frivolous demands' from who they term as the BJP's Team B, C or D and said they should not divert from more serious issues like runaway inflation, high prices of fuel and gas, rising unemployment, etc and point at the developments in Sri Lanka.

# Sharjeel Imam seeks relief from Delhi HC after SC stays sedition law use

JNU scholar-activist Sharjeel Imam, who is behind the bars in connection with cases against him under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, has approached the Delhi High Court for relief following the historic Supreme Court verdict which put on hold the colonial-era penal provision of sedition.

JNU scholar-activist Sharjeel Imam, who is behind the bars in connection with cases against him under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, has approached the Delhi High Court for relief following the historic Supreme Court verdict which put on hold the colonial-era penal provision of sedition.

In his fresh bail application, he said that since the top court has put sedition (Section 124-A of the Indian Penal Code) in abeyance, his case has improved for the grant of bail.

He was seeking interim bail in the alleged inflammatory speeches

delivered by him at Aligarh Muslim University and in the Jamia area in Delhi during the anti-CAA agitation in 2019 and 2020.

A division bench of Justices Siddharth Mridul and Rajnish Bhatnagar will hear his plea on Tuesday. "The appellant has been incarcerated for nearly 28 months since January 28, 2020 whereas the maximum punishment for the offences -- not including 124-A IPC -- are punishable upto a maximum of 7 years of imprisonment," the plea read. JNU scholars and activists Imam, Umar Khalid are among the nearly a dozen of people involved in the alleged larger conspiracy case

linked with the Delhi riots 2020, as per the Delhi Police. Imam and Khalid are facing charges in connection with the inflammatory speeches which are allegedly fuelled, as per the police, the riots broke out in the national capital in February 2020 as clashes between the anti-CAA (Citizenship Amendment Act) and pro-CAA protesters took a violent turn. The mayhem, which coincided with the then US President Donald Trump's maiden trip to India, saw more than 50 people lose their lives and while over 700 were injured.



# CPI(M-L) wants Left unity in Bengal sans 'Left Front' tag

The Communist Party of India (Marxists-Leninist), which had provided a latent support to Trinamool Congress in the 2021 Assembly elections in West Bengal, now wants a bigger unity of all Left parties in the state but without the 'Left Front' tag.

CPI(M-L) national General Secretary Dipankar Bhattacharya told newsmen here on Monday that many Leftists were previously not part of the Left Front.

"But time has come for a bigger unity of the Left parties in West Bengal to counter the BJP's organisational growth in the state, as well as to resist the misuse of the ruling Trinamool Congress. But that bigger unity of Left parties in the state cannot happen with the 'Left Front' tag. We are ready to discuss what would be the new banner with all the other Left parties, especially



the CPI(M)," Bhattacharya said. He also said that in the 2021 Assembly elections, his party had given a call for 'No vote to BJP'.

"Although the people stopped the BJP from coming to power in West Bengal, the opposition space in the state Assembly has been occupied by the saffron party, while the seat tally of the Left parties was reduced to zero. So now we are calling for a bigger unity of all the Left parties in the state to

stop BJP's growth and resist Trinamool Congress' atrocities at the same time," said Bhattacharya.

Bhattacharya has his own logic as to why the Left Front tag should be shed for achieving this bigger Left unity.

"The people of West Bengal associate the Left Front with the Left Front government that ruled the state for 34 years from 1977 to 2011. In the latter part of its rule, there were growing grievances among the

people against the Left Front government, as a result of which it was voted out of power in 2011. So, we are against that Left Front banner," Bhattacharya said.

When contacted, CPI(M) politburo member and state secretary Md Salim told IANS that it is good that Bhattacharya is showing a positive gesture with regard to bigger unity of Left parties.

"Today only we had a meeting on this count where all the constituents of the Left Front as well as those outside the Left Front, including CPI(M-L), were present. Similarly, at the district level, similar meetings are being conducted which are being attended by parties outside the Left Front.

"Our stand is clear that in West Bengal, we want unity of all forces who are anti-BJP and anti-Trinamool. As regards to what will be the banner, discussions can continue," Salim said.

# NCP SCREAMS OVER INFLATION, SMRITI REVELS IN 2019 AMETHI VICTORY!

In a flash agitation, hundreds of Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) activists staged a massive protest over inflation and fuel prices hike before Union Textiles Minister Smriti Irani here on Monday.

The NCP workers sought to present a box of bangles to Irani as a reminder to her own anti-price hike agitation held during the tenure of then Prime Minister Manmohan Singh. However, later an unruffled Irani, surrounded by her security, spoke nothing on inflation but seemed to gloat over her 2019 victory in Amethi trouncing the then Congress President Rahul Gandhi from his traditional stronghold.

"The Congress - and NCP, which has emerged from it - are still shocked at how an ordinary BJP worker like me gave an unprecedented defeat to a sitting Congress President and he had to run to another constituency," smiled Irani victoriously. Pune City NCP President Prashant Jagtap said that around 2014, when the price of gas cylinders went up by just Rs 5, Irani had sent bangles to Manmohan Singh.



"Today, under the BJP, the gas

cylinder prices have shot up from some Rs 350 to over Rs 1,000 now, but Irani has nothing to say and Prime Minister Narendra Modi is also silent at the sufferings of the masses," Jagtap said. The NCP men and women workers shouted angry slogans and

carried boxes of bangles for Irani with a plea to hand them over to the Prime Minister to draw his attention at the peoples' sufferings, but were stopped by the Pune Police.

The activists chanted "Mahengai Ki Rani, Smriti Irani", "Smriti Bhabhi, Jawab do", etc against the Union Minister who had come to attend an event here. "When the people voted for the BJP and Modi, they had great expectations that he would set things right. Now, people are regretting that decision," said a woman activist.

Jagtap said that each and every poor family in the country is reeling under the high inflation and runaway fuel prices, but the BJP and Prime Minister Narendra Modi seem "least concerned" at their plight.

The Pune Police detained several scores of NCP men and women activists and rounded them off to local police stations even as Irani departed after completing her function this evening.

# Not only Saha, ex-Congress leaders getting plum posts in BJP

Manik Saha has become the third chief minister in the northeast after N Biren Singh of Manipur and Himanta Biswa Sarma of Assam who have had a long political innings in the Congress. The party claims that the BJP is now full of former Congress leaders and many have been given plum ministerial berths in the state and union governments. Saha, who had quit the Congress and joined the BJP in 2016, was appointed the BJP's state president in 2020. He had replaced Biplab Kumar Deb who ended the 25-year-old Communist rule in 2018. Similarly, Manipur chief minister N Biren Singh

was in the Congress and a minister in the state government led by the Congress before joining the BJP.

In 2002, Singh was elected to the Manipur assembly as the Democratic Revolutionary People's Party candidate. Later he joined the Congress and was made a minister but quit in 2016.

Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma was one of the high profile ministers in the Tarun Gogoi government but a turf war between Gogoi and Sarma led to the exit of Sarma who later joined the BJP. He is being credited for the BJP's success in the entire northeast. The other high profile leaders in BJP governments are Jyotiraditya Scindia as

Union Minister of Civil Aviation and Jitin Prasada as PWD minister in the UP government. Recently RPN Singh too left the Congress to join the BJP.

The Congress has witnessed an exodus in Madhya Pradesh and Karnataka also where scores of MLAs left to join the BJP which led to the fall of the Congress government in MP and a coalition government in Karnataka. Former Uttarakhnd Chief Minister Vijay Bahuguna, ex-Foreign Minister S M Krishna, Uttarakhnd minister Satpal Maharaj and most recently Amarinder Singh in Punjab and Sunil Jakhar are some other leaders who have deserted the Congress since it lost the polls in 2014.

# KEJRIWAL TO HOLD MEETING OVER ANTI-ENCROACHMENT DRIVE

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal will on Monday to hold a meeting with Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) MLAs regarding the anti-encroachment drive in the national capital.

The meeting, which will begin at around 11 a.m., was initially scheduled for May 14 but it was cancelled due to the massive building fire in Mundka the previous day which claimed the lives of 27 people.

Monday's meeting will take place at Kejriwal's residence in Civil Lines.

"Everyone will share their ideas to counter the BJP. The BJP-controlled MCD (Municipal Corporation of Delhi) has launched the encroachment drive, which we have to stop to save the Delhites. In the name of encroachment they are

# Textbook repeat of Dec 1949 in Babri Masjid: Owaisi on Gyanvapi row

Amid claims by the Hindu side of having discovered a Shivling in Gyanvapi mosque, AIMIM leader and Hyderabad MP Asaduddin Owaisi has slammed a court order that directed to seal the place where the Shivling was discovered in the survey.

"This is a textbook repeat of December 1949 in Babri Masjid. This order itself changes the religious nature of the Masjid. This is a violation of 1991 Act. This was my apprehension and it has come true. Gyanvapi Masjid was, and will remain a Masjid till judgement day, Inshallah," Owaisi tweeted.

It was alleged that in 1949, idols were kept inside the disputed Babri Mosque. However, the court in its judgement has given the land

to the Ram temple, and the construction is in full swing.

On Monday, the Hindu side advocates claimed that a 'Shivling' had been found inside the well. Lawyer Vishnu Jain said he would go to the civil court to seek its protection.

An advocate from the Hindu side, Madan Mohan Yadav, claimed that the 'Shivling' is Nandi faced.

Heavy security was deployed as the court-appointed committee reached the spot to conduct the survey on Monday.

Nearly 65 per cent of the exercise was completed on Sunday.

Another report would be submitted to the court on Tuesday. On Sunday, the survey of the areas of the mosque which, according to lawyers Hari Shankar Jain and Vishnu Jain, used to be a



part of the temple was done. On the western wall of the Gyanvapi complex, the remains of Hindu temple demolition are visi-

ble and the pictures which are the "biggest proof", will be surveyed. For this, the fourth lock was opened on Monday, while the first

three rooms were opened during the survey on Saturday.

Gyanvapi Mosque, adjacent to the Kashi Vishwanath Temple in Varanasi, is currently facing a legal battle.

court in Varanasi has directed the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) to probe the structure of the Gyanvapi Masjid.


The survey is to find out the truth behind the claims of the presence of Hindu symbols of worship in the mosque complex.

## BJP's 'Chintan' for Gujrat polls 2022

As Gujarat heads for Assembly elections later this year, and the Congress is busy preparing plans at the 'Chintan Shivir' in Udaipur and the AAP has launched Parivartan Yatra in the state, the ruling BJP kicked off its state-level 'Chintan Baithak' on the outskirts of Ahmedabad. Party sources said two to three major issues to be discussed thoroughly is the BJP's prospects on all the 182 seats, and what plans and strategies should be implemented to win a record-breaking number of seats in the upcoming elections. The second challenge likely to be discussed is how to counter issues like inflation, unemployment, and the image of the state government, which is badly damaged by paper leaks in competitive exams one after another. Though the BJP is publicly underplaying the Aam Aadmi Party's presence in the state, but takes it seriously in private. According to sources, party senior leaders believe that if the AAP's influence spreads in rural areas, it will not damage BJP, but if its influence increases in urban areas, it will be problematic for the BJP. To weaken the Congress further, the BJP is still going to lure a few more of its MLAs and leaders, and Hardik Patel is on the top of the list, said sources. If the last one works out, BJP leaders believe half the match is already won. The BJP has identified more than 40 seats, which it won in 2017 with a paper thin margin, and some seats which Congress never lost post 2002 riots and even when then Chief Minister Narendra Modi's charisma was at its peak. To win such seats, the party plans to either divide the Congress organisation vertically, or ensure more parties contest from such seats and divide anti-incumbency votes, which can benefit the ruling party.

# INDIA-NEPAL EXTENDING HORIZONS TOWARDS A STRENGTHENED PARTNERSHIP

On the invitation of his Nepalese counterpart Sher Bahadur Deuba, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited to Lumbini, the birthplace of Gautam Buddha, on Monday to mark the occasion of Buddha Purnima. This is the second summit-level interaction between the leaders in less than two months.

While in Lumbini, Modi and Deuba will lay the foundation stone for a Buddhist Vihar, being built with Indian assistance. We should note that Nepal is important for India in the context of its overall strategic interests in the region, and the leaders of the two countries have often noted the age-old "Roti Beti" relationship.

Modi's visit to Lumbini would follow a re-energisation of ties after Deuba's trip to India in April, when four agreements and a number of infrastructure projects were launched.

The four agreements are Nepal officially joining the International Solar Alliance; Indian technical assistance to Nepal's railway sector; cooperation in the field of petroleum sector; and exchange of expertise between Nepal Oil Corporation and Indian Oil Corporation.

During Deuba's visit, the two Prime Ministers discussed the unprecedented opportunities for mutually beneficial cooperation in the energy sector. In this regard, a Joint Vision Statement on Power Sector cooperation that spells out the shared commitment as well as opportunities for win-win collaboration in power generation, transmission and trade was concluded.

They had also jointly inaugurated the 90-km-long 132 KVDC Solu Corridor Transmission line and sub-station built under the Line of Credit extended by India. Both sides agreed to expedite progress in the implementation of the Pancheshwar Multipurpose Project, beginning with early finalisation of the Detailed Project Report (DPR).

Nepal may also hold talks with India for the development of the



West Seti Hydropower Project. Earlier, China was to develop this project. There is an increasing realisation among India and Nepal to expedite the process of energy and border connectivity cooperation. Also, in India's "Act East Policy" and "First neighbourhood policy", energy is a core component.

Nepal appreciated the fresh approvals granted to Nepal Electricity Authority for the export of substantial amount of power to India. Nepal further invited greater participation of Indian companies in its hydropower development projects. The progress made in 900 MW Arun-III hydro-electric project in Nepal was also noted.

India welcomed Nepal's decision to join the International Solar Alliance and became the 105th country to be a signatory to the Framework Agreement of the ISA.

Modi and Deuba had also inaugurated passenger rail services between Jaynagar in India and Kurtha in Nepal. The Hindu pilgrimage centre of Janakpur Dham, considered to be the birthplace of Ramayan's Sita, will be one of the main attractions of the Jaynagar-Kurtha section rail link between the two special neighbours. This link will be the first broad gauge passenger rail service in Nepal. The beginning of the Jaynagar-Kurtha rail line is a

part of priority to trade and cross-border connectivity initiatives for a smooth, hassle-free exchange of people between the two countries. The link bis part of an overall strategy for improved border management, planned and integrated development of border areas and infrastructure in a selective and phased manner.

The Prime Ministers reviewed the progress in implementation of Indian projects in Nepal, including the cross-border rail-link projects connecting (a) Jaynagar-Kurtha-Bijapur-Bardibas (b) Joghani-Biratnagar (c) Raxaul-Kathmandu. India and Nepal are mulling at least five different cross-border railway lines. Nepal assured its full support in resolving bottlenecks and facilitating the time-bound completion of all India-assisted projects, including the National Police Academy at Kavrepalanchowk, the Integrated Check Posts at Nepalgunj and Bhairahawa and the projects under the Ramayana circuit.

The countries welcomed the recent conclusion of the G-to-G Agreement to facilitate the long term supply of fertilizers from India to Nepal and the renewal of the Five-Year General Supply Agreement for supply of petroleum products from India to Nepal.

Energy trade is mutually benefi-

cial to both countries. The trade enables Nepal to sell the surplus energy it produces and opens up an opportunity for it to reduce the burgeoning trade deficit with India. It also ends Nepal's asymmetric dependence on India for energy. Nepal imports all fossil fuel energy from India. In the first six months of the current fiscal year 2021-22, Nepal imported around \$1 billion worth of diesel, petrol, and liquefied petroleum gas. It is also important to highlight that in a historical cross-border supply, first transnational fuel pipeline connecting Motihari (India) to Amlekhgunj (later to be extended to Chitwan-Kathmandu) with \$3.2 billion support extended by India is operationalised. It is estimated that Nepal can save over Rs 1 billion annually in transport cost. This is expected to generate additional revenue for the government, reduce technical loss, oil theft and road deterioration, would make oil supplies cleaner and cheaper. This pipeline is also expected to reduce the long queues of trucks carrying petroleum products at the Birgunj border. Nearly 1,500 trucks transporting petroleum products to Nepal daily.

India and Nepal also launched Indian RuPay card in Nepal which would open new vistas for cooperation in digital financial connectivity, and is expected to facilitate bilateral tourist flows as well as further strengthen people-to-people linkages between the two countries.

Further, Nepal requested India to provide three additional air connectivity from Mahendranagar, Nepalgunj and Janakpur, and also requested an agreement on near-border operation for the Chinese-constructed Gautam Buddha International Airport, Bhairahawa.

Nepal became an energy surplus country (during monsoon) from July 2021. As a result, it started selling 39 MW of electricity to India via the Indian Energy Exchange. However, there is an "unprecedented opportunity

ty" to expand mutually beneficial bilateral cooperation in the power sector. Nepal and India signed a Joint Vision Statement on Power Sector Cooperation in this context. The agreement highlights development of cross-border transmission infrastructure, and bi-directional power trade based on market demand. Based on this, India has allowed Nepal to export an additional 325 MW of electricity from July 2022.

The Joint Vision Statement on Power Sector Cooperation, which was issued during Deuba's visit could also form a key stepping stone to sub-regional energy trade between Bangladesh, Bhutan, India and Nepal (BBIN).

Recently, India also announced its next Ambassador to Nepal, to take over after Vinay Kwatra assumed office as India's Foreign Secretary. He is an official with knowledge of regional dynamics, especially China, to head the mission in Nepal. Recently, Nepal has also appointed its new ambassador to India.

"Modi's talks with his Nepal counterpart Deuba in Lumbini, Nepal on May 16 will have a comprehensive agenda to further expand cooperation in multiple areas including hydropower, connectivity, trade and investment, Foreign Secretary Vinay Mohan Kwatra.

"Return visit in so close succession is a reflection of the closeness of our high-level exchanges as well as of the upward trajectory in our mutually beneficial partnership. The entire scope and landscape of the India-Nepal partnership is very wide and extensive."

It is hoped that Modi's visit would be a value addition and an important chapter of India-Nepal partnership as it has reshaped high-level political engagement between the two countries. It has also brought normalcy to Nepal's geostrategic debate by bringing India back into the fold.

## MODI, DEUBA LAY FOUNDATION STONE OF INDIA INT'L CENTRE

Visiting Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his Nepali counterpart Sher Bahadur Deuba on Monday jointly laid the foundation stone of the India International Centre for Buddhist Culture and Heritage in Lumbini.

Modi arrived in Lumbini, the birthplace of Gautam Buddha and a Unesco World Heritage Site, earlier in the day and offered prayers at famous Maya Devi temple to mark the occasion of Buddha Purnima.

Along with Deuba, Modi also participated in the "Shilanyas" ceremony for the construction of the unique centre within the Lumbini Monastic Zone.

The centre is being built at



the initiative of the International Buddhist Confederation, New Delhi.

The construction will be undertaken by the International Buddhist Confederation (IBC), India, under the auspices of the Lumbini Development Trust with the financial support of

the Union Ministry of Culture. The IBC is a Grantee Body under the Ministry. The centre will be the first eNet Zero Emission' building in Nepal. Later, Prime Minister Modi will also deliver an address at a Buddha Jayanti event organised by the Lumbini Development Trust.

## PAK WILL TURN INTO SL IF IMRAN IS ARRESTED: EX-MINISTER

Islamabad: Pakistan's former Interior Minister Sheikh Rasheed Ahmed has warned that former Prime Minister Imran Khan is arrested, the country will turn into Sri Lanka which is currently undergoing its worst economic crisis. Rasheed said that the incumbent coalition government had become directionless and was unable to handle the situation, Geo News reported. "The government should call Nawaz Sharif back now."

Rasheed said that if Khan is arrested, the PTI has already devised a strategy to deal with the situation, adding that the country would plunge into a political crisis and would witness a Sri Lanka-like situation. Taking a jibe at the Pakistan Democratic Movement (PDM), a coalition of parties that successfully toppled the PTI-led government through a motion of no-confidence, Rasheed said that Khan had become the nation's hero despite his ouster, Geo News reported. Later on, while addressing a rally in Faisalabad, Rasheed said that the country is soon going to become a defaulter, therefore, state institutions should intervene.

"Shehbaz Sharif, you should address the nation and declare whether you're going to go to the International Monetary Fund or not," he said, adding that the country has fallen short of \$6 billion within a month.



## Russia to strengthen border with Finland if NATO deploys weapons

Russia will strengthen its border with Finland if NATO's striking weapons are deployed in the neighbouring country amid the latter's intention to join the military alliance, a top official said in Moscow.

"If NATO deploys offensive, striking weapons in Finland, in close proximity to us, we will strengthen our border and increase the presence of Russian troops on the border," Xinhua news agency quoted Viktor Bondarev, chairman of the Defence and Security Committee of the Federation Council, as saying late Sunday. He called Finland's intention to join NATO "disturbing" in a geopolitical sense. Earlier on Sunday, Finnish President Sauli Niinisto and the government's foreign policy



committee took an official decision to start the process of the country's application to become a NATO member.

Addressing a joint press conference with Prime Minister Sanna Marin, President Niinisto described the day as historical as a new era is opening. He said the Finnish security is not "a zero-sum game", not directed against anyone. In a phone call initiated by Helsinki on

Saturday, Niinisto informed Russian President Vladimir Putin of Finland's decision to seek NATO membership in the next few days. In response, Putin "stressed that abandoning the traditional policy of military neutrality would be a mistake, since there are no threats to Finland's security", adding that it may also have a negative impact on Moscow-Helsinki relations.

## 2 KILLED, 3 INJURED IN US HOUSTON FLEA MARKET SHOOTING

Houston: Two people were killed and three others critically injured in a shooting at a flea market in Houston, the largest city of the US state Texas, authorities said. The shooting allegedly took place on Sunday due to a fight among the five male victims, the Harris County Sheriff's Office said. The victims all appear to be in their early-to mid-20s and likely knew each other, officials said, noting they do not believe the shooting was random, Xinhua news agency reported.

No innocent bystanders were hurt although the flea market was very busy at Sunday afternoon when the shooting took place. Harris County Sheriff, Ed Gonzalez said it is estimated that there were "thousands" at the flea market when the gun shots were fired.

Two possible suspects were detained and a third was taken to a hospital, according to an ABC News report.

The Sheriff's office said at least two pistols have been recovered from the crime scene.

## Finland, Sweden made a grave mistake: Russian Minister

Russian Deputy Foreign Minister Sergei Ryabkov said that Finland and Sweden have "made a grave mistake" with their intentions to join the NATO military alliance.

He stressed that Russia would not put up with such a situation and that by doing so, the general level of military tension on the European continent will increase, RT reported.

"They should not have any illusions that we will simply put up with this, just like in Brussels, Washington and other NATO capitals. That is, the general level of military tension will increase, and there will be less predictability in this area. It is a pity that common sense is being sacrificed to some phantom ideas about what should be done in the current situation,"



Ryabkov was quoted as saying. The Deputy Foreign Minister called the decision to expand the military alliance another grave mistake with "far-reaching consequences".

"What should I do? This is the level of those who make political decisions today in the respective countries."

Ryabkov's remarks came after Finnish President Sauli Niinisto

and the government's foreign policy committee on Sunday took an official decision to start the process of the country's application to become a NATO member.

In a phone call initiated by Helsinki the previous day, Niinisto informed Russian President Vladimir Putin of Finland's decision to seek NATO membership in the next few days.

In response, Putin "stressed that abandoning the traditional policy of military neutrality would be a mistake, since there are no threats to Finland's security", adding that it may also have a negative impact on Moscow-Helsinki relations.

Finland shares a 1,300 km border with Russia.

Sweden has also indicated its intention to join the military alliance in the wake of Russia's ongoing war against Ukraine, the BBC reported.

## AFGHAN JOURNOS RESTRICTED FROM COVERING SECURITY INCIDENTS

Afghan journalists have claimed that the Taliban-led government has imposed restrictions on them from covering security incidents in the country.

Jawad Etimad, a journalist who works for an online media outlet, said he was arrested while covering a blast in Kabul city and spent two days in custody.

"They (Taliban) prevented me from making footage. They kicked and punched me, and then they arrested me," TOLO News quoted Etimad as saying.

Another journalist, Farogh Faiz said that whenever there is a security incident in an area, they go to cover it.

"But, unfortunately we are not being allowed cover the incidents," he said. Meanwhile, the

Afghanistan National Journalists Union said restrictions on access to information is not acceptable. "The media has the right to make footage. Whenever there are restrictions on access to information, it is a violation of the law of access to information," Masroor Lutfi, head of the media watchdog, was quoted as saying by TOLO News. According to the Reporters Without Borders, at least 50 media workers were arrested since the Taliban took over the country in August last year until February 2022.

In a report earlier this year, Human Rights Watch said that an estimated 80 per cent of women journalists across Afghanistan have lost their jobs or left the profession since August 2021, and hundreds of media outlets have closed.



# SAMBAL YOJANA IS A REMARKABLE SCHEME TO HELP WORKERS IN PROBLEMS: CM

Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has said that the family of all workers will get the benefit of Sambal-2.0 scheme. This scheme is remarkable as it benefits the beneficiaries in critical situations throughout their lives. The scheme is a support of the poor. Whether it is a matter of extending financial support at the time of accident or illness, in case of death of a family member of a beneficiary's family, Sambal Yojana was launched to help workers through obstacles. The implementation of this scheme started in the year 2018. The previous government did not pay attention to the implementation of the scheme and withdrew it. The names of the beneficiaries were struck off from the lists. Many poor were deprived of its benefits. Now we have decided to implement it once again.

Chouhan transferred the amount under Sambal Yojana to families of labourers of all the districts of the state with a single click from his residence office. He also interacted with the families of the labourers. Chief Minister said that according to the philosophy of Pt. Deendayal Upadhyay, Sambal Yojana is being implemented afresh with the aim of reaching the backmost person of the society.

Chouhan transferred Rs 551 crore



16 lakh to 25 thousand 982 labourer families of Sambal Yojana and Rs 22 crore 23 lakh to 1036 construction workers through a single click, thus transferring Rs 573 crore 39 lakh to the accounts of the beneficiaries in total 27 thousand 18 cases.

Chouhan said that the state government has launched a more beneficiary-oriented Sambal Yojana this time. Also, now the process of adding more beneficiaries to the scheme will also be started. Lakhs of tendu leaf pluckers of the state have also been included as unorganized labourers in the new registration process.

Applications can be made through MP Online, Nagrik Suvidha and Lok Seva Kendras. In the Sambal-2.0

scheme, those workers who were declared ineligible earlier will also be able to apply afresh. After receiving the application, beneficiaries will be provided benefits through tracking at each level.

Chouhan said that Sambal 2.0 scheme also has the provision that if the beneficiary's application is canceled, he can make an appeal. An amount of Rs 4 lakh is given to the family in case of death in an accident under the Anugrah Sahayata Scheme to lakhs of labourers of the unorganized sector. Rs 2 lakh is provided in case of natural death. Similarly, Rs 2 lakh is provided in case of permanent disability and Rs one lakh for partial disability. An amount of Rs 5 thou-

sand is given as funeral assistance. All those workers who do not get the benefit of social security like Provident Fund, Employees State Insurance Scheme, Gratuity etc are eligible for the scheme. If the beneficiary family has less than one hectare of agricultural land, beneficiary is not in government service and is not an income tax payer, he is eligible.

Chouhan said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi has taken concrete steps for the welfare of street vendors. With his inspiration, focus is being made on economically weaker sections in Madhya Pradesh. Chouhan said that we see that today those doing small agricultural work are hardly able to make both ends meet. All our small vegetable vendors, labourers, tendu leaf pluckers, tea shop owners and members of organized and unorganized sector selling other items will be included in this scheme. All eligible beneficiaries will be linked to the scheme. The government stands with the labourers at the time of crisis. Madhya Pradesh has prioritized the welfare of labourers of the unorganized sector.

The portal which has been launched today will also give impetus to the scheme. Beneficiaries can now apply from the Lok Seva Kendras. There is no need for them to visit offices frequently, the names of all will be added to the beneficiary list of the scheme.

The commission had held a meeting with collectors of all districts recently in which the election commissioner Basant Pratap Singh said that polling for urban civic bodies will be held through EVMs.



The commission has also reviewed the availability of EVMs in the state and asked the district administrations to do preparations accordingly and get ready for elections. As per the earlier statement, the SEC is likely to issue a notification to conduct elections by May 24. In its order last Tuesday, the apex court had asked SEC to issue notification within two weeks.

Polling for rural civic bodies will be held through paper ballots. The state election commissioner had asked the government to ensure sufficient supply of paper as it would be required in large quantities for Panchayat polls.

the village, they pelted stones at them forcing the police to fire tear gas shells. The administration then deployed a heavy police force in the village to control the situation.



An FIR has been registered in the matter," the police said.



Punjab gave away just ten runs in the last two overs to get momentum in their favour at the innings break, which was inadequate to seal a win.

# AC Milan on brink of Serie A title

**Rome:** AC Milan took a giant step towards the Serie A title, defeating Atalanta 2-0 to need just one point to win the league in their last home game of the season.

AC Milan went into the San Siro on Sunday night with a two-point advantage over second-placed Inter Milan, while Atalanta were still fighting for a spot in the European places. Milan's last victory against Atalanta on home turf was in 2014, followed by four draws and three defeats. AC Milan sealed the win 20 minutes later in sensational style, when Theo Hernandez started a move from his own half to surge forward and ride tackles before sending the ball to the bottom corner. Elsewhere, Inter Milan kept their



Scudetto hopes alive as Matteo Darmian's opener and Lautaro Martinez's brace saw the Nerazzurri beat Cagliari 3-1.

The title winners will be decided in the final round as AC Milan visit Sassuolo, while Inter Milan host Sampdoria. One point would secure the Rossoneri their first Serie A title since 2011, due to their superior head-to-head record.

Napoli secured third place after crushing Genoa 3-0. Lorenzo Insigne, who is leaving for Toronto FC this summer, waved goodbye to Napoli fans in his last match at the Diego Armando Maradona Stadium, while Genoa follow Venezia to drop into Serie B after 15 years in the top flight. Also on Sunday, Sassuolo sailed away with a 3-1 victory over Bologna.

## ALL THE PLAYERS HAVE GONE CRAZY, SLEPT WITH MEDALS AROUND THEIR NECKS, SAYS HS PRANNOY

**Mumbai:** When they left Indian shores for the Thomas and Uber Cup finals in Bangkok, none of the Indian men's team players had expected that they would win their maiden title.

They had expected to win a medal, probably bronze. But a gold medal was beyond their imagination, and that is the reason why the players went to bed late on Sunday night with medals still around their necks. "We never thought we will win the Thomas Cup; we were thinking that we had a good chance of winning a medal but this is beyond our dreams," said HS Prannoy, who won two tie-deciding third singles matches in the quarterfinals and semifinals to propel the Indian team into the final against Indonesia.

"All the players have gone crazy since the win against Indonesia in the final. We had a huge celebratory dinner, spoke to friends and family and just enjoyed ourselves. Most of us slept Sunday night with medals around our necks. It's such a beautiful medal," said Prannoy during an online interaction with select journalists from Bangkok.

The 29-year-old from Kerala said, though they ran onto the court for wild celebrations after Kidambi Srikanth defeated Jonatan Christie in the second singles to seal India's 3-0 victory against Indonesia, the feeling and importance of the achievement only sunk in early on Monday morning.

## SHIMRON HETMYER INDICATES HE IS BACK IN RAJASTHAN ROYALS CAMP

**Mumbai:** Rajasthan Royals' 25-year-old middle-order batter Shimron Hetmyer has probably returned after the birth of his first child in Guyana, and will likely be available for the franchise's remaining matches in IPL 2022.

Hetmyer had left the IPL bio-bubble for the West Indies on May 8 but the left-hander had indicated that he would return to again be part of the team's campaign. With the Sanju Samson-led Royals now currently second on the points table following their emphatic 24-run win against Lucknow Super Giants at the Brabourne Stadium on Sunday, Hetmyer would be a huge asset ahead of the team's last league game against Chennai Super Kings at Brabourne on May 20, and beyond. On Sunday, the Royals urged Hetmyer to return to the side, tweeting, "Gulaabi baalo wale Hettie, laut aao. Hetti bhai phone uthao Mazak nahin hai ab ye (Please return to the side Hetmyer. Pick up the phone; it's not a joke anymore)."

In response, Hetmyer replied, "Idhar hi hoon (I'm here only)," indicating he is back in the team hotel.

Before leaving for Guyana, Hetmyer had played a key role in the Royals overhauling a competitive 189-run total set by Punjab Kings at the Wankhede, winning the match by six wickets with two balls to spare. The West Indian was the more aggressive in his partnership with Devdutt Padikkal, striking an unbeaten 31 off 16 balls embellished with three boundaries and two sixes.

# PSG star Mbappe wins best player award for 3rd time

The Paris Saint-Germain (PSG) striker Kylian Mbappe won the French league's best player award for the third time in his career at the 30th UNFP awards ceremony here on Sunday.

The world champion has just been voted best player of the league again for the 2021-2022 season.

"I am very happy, I thank the whole club, my teammates, all those who work at the club, the staff, and of course the President. They helped me enormously to contribute to this third consecutive title. It is important to leave a mark, to always try to make history, and winning collective and individual titles is what counts for any football player. I have the chance to do it, so I am happy," Mbappe told official website of PSG.

Currently the league's top passer (17 assists) and top scorer (25 goals), he is just one match away from completing this double for the first time in French football history. He would also finish



as top scorer in the French championship for the fourth consecutive season.

Gigio Donnarumma was voted best goalkeeper by his peers after his first season in the French top flight. Competing with Walter Benitez, Alban Lafont, Pau Lopez and Matz Sels, the young Italian keeper succeeded his team-mate Keylor Navas.

He had already been awarded the Yashin Trophy at the Ballon d'Or ceremony last November, with journalists celebrating him as the best goalkeeper in the world.

"I'm very happy to receive this trophy, and happy to celebrate with the team. I'm happy to be here in Paris, and I hope that next year we will be even better," the European champion told PSGTV.

# Ajinkya Rahane to miss England Test after ruled out of IPL



Rahane sustained the injury while batting for Kolkata against Sunrisers Hyderabad at MCA Stadium in Pune on May 14 and didn't come out to field after making 28 runs off 24 balls when the two-time IPL Champions restricted Hyderabad to 123/8 to win by 54 runs, keeping themselves alive in the race for the playoffs.

"Rahane is set to exit the Kolkata Knight Riders bubble on Monday evening. Sources within the Board of Control for Cricket in India said he will be reporting at the National Cricket Academy in Bangalore where he may need more than four weeks of rehab," said a report by Cricbuzz.

Rahane, who lost his vice-captaincy in the longest format of the game, was last



seen in Test cricket action during India's three-match away series against South Africa in January.

He was then left out of the two-match home series against Sri Lanka in March alongside Cheteshwar Pujara as Hanuma Vihari and Shreyas Iyer were given a go.

In seven matches for

Kolkata in IPL 2022 after being picked for INR 1 crores in the Mega Auction, Rahane could make just 133 runs at an average of 19 and strike-rate of 103.90. It was Rahane's commitment to continue batting despite being injured caught the eye of team mentor David Hussey and lauded the senior batter for his efforts to bat on.


