## PM NARENDRA MODI CALLS ON RICH NATIONS TO BACK INDIA'S EFFORTS

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday called on rich nations comprising of the G7 grouping to support India's efforts towards meeting its climate commitments.

Addressing a G7 session on 'investing in a better future: climate, energy, health', Modi said, "India's dedication to climate commitments evident from its performance."

Modi, who is in Germany on a two-day visit from Sunday for the summit of the G7, said, "There's a misconception that poor countries... cause more damage to environment. But India's history of over 1,000 years completely refutes this view. Ancient India has seen a time of immense prosperity."

"We hope rich countries of G7 will support India's efforts. A huge market for clean energy technologies is emerging in India." "India has world's first fully solar power operated airport; India's huge railway system will become net

We also had deliberations on furthering environmentally friendly growth for our planet," he tweeted after meeting German Chancellor.

The PM also met South African President Cyril Ramaphosa.

## SC RELIEF TO MAHA REBEL MLAS, EXTENDS RESPONSE DEADLINE TO JULY 12

The Supreme Court on Monday queried whether the Maharashtra Assembly Speaker can become a judge in his own cause and decide whether the motion to remove him is invalid.

The top court also extended, till July 12, the time granted by Deputy Speaker to the 16 dissident MLAs to submit their written responses to the disqualification notice, and asked the Maharashtra government to ensure protection of all rebel Shiv Sena MLAs and their family members.

Senior advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi, representing Shiv Sena's Ajay Choudhari and Sunil Prabhu, submitted before a vacation bench of Justices Surya Kant and JB Pardiwala that rebel leader Eknath Shinde's petition can be heard by the Bombay High Court, saying: "This isn't a case to allow leaping."

The bench asked Singhvi a specific query - could the Speaker become a judge in his own cause and decide that the motion to remove him is invalid? "Is the Speaker entitled to decide disqualification petitions when his own removal motion is pending?" it asked.

Senior advocate Rajeev Dhavan, representing Deputy Speaker Narhari Zirwal, submitted that his client has questioned the authenticity of the motion seeking his removal, sent through an anonymous email.

The top court noted that in all fairness, it should have all the records from the office of the Deputy Speaker before it and asked Zirwal to file a detailed affidavit.

As the bench again asked Singhvi to explain whether he could be the Deputy Speaker, whose removal has been sought, himself decide on that notice, Singhvi replied: "Yes, he can."

The top court also asked the Maharashtra government to provide protection to the rebel MLA and their families, after their counsel made submission stating they apprehend threat to their lives. It recorded the Maharashtra government's undertaking that no harm would be caused to life, liberty, and properties. The top court also extended, till July 12, the time granted by the Deputy Speaker to the 16 rebel MLAs to submit their response to the disqualification notices.

Senior advocate Neeraj Kishan Kaul, appearing for the petitioners, submitted before the bench that the Deputy Speaker cannot proceed with the disqualification proceedings when the motion seeking his removal is pending.

After detailed hearing in the matter, the top court issued notice on petitions by Shinde and the rebel MLAs of Shiv Sena challenging the disqualification notices issued by the Deputy Speaker to them and also the appointment of Choudhari as Shiv Sena Legislature Party leader.

Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, NCP chief Sharad Pawar, Samajwadi Party chief Akhilesh Yadav, National Conference chief Farooq Abdullah, CPI-M leader Sitaram Yechury and other opposition leaders were present at the filing of Sinha's nomination.

Sinha also paid tributes to Mahatma Gandhi and Dr B.R. Ambedkar before filing his nomination.

Meanwhile, the TRS announced its support to Sinha. "President of @trspartyonline Sri KCR Garu has decided to extend support to the candidature of Sri @YashwantSinha Ji in the election for President of India. Along with our Members of Parliament, I



will be representing the TRS at the nomination today," working president of TRS and minister Telangana government K.T. Rama Rao tweeted announcing party's support to Sinha's candidature.

The support to Sinha as joint opposition candidate comes days after TRS opted out of the meeting called by West Bengal chief minister Mamata Banerjee to discuss the strategy for Presidential polls.

Now Sinha will also begin his campaign to meet MPs and MLAs. On Friday, Sinha had telephoned Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Defence Minister Rajnath Singh's offices seeking their support for the poll. He also wrote a letter to all the lead-

ers of the opposition parties. In the letter Sinha wrote: "India is going through extremely difficult times. I shall raise my voice for the common people."

Sinha had also said that the leaders of the other ideology are intent on throttling the Constitution and "making a mockery of the people's mandate in elections."

BJP-led NDA candidate Draupadi Murmu filed nomination last week in presence of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, party chief JP Nadda, union ministers Rajnath Singh, Amit Shah, Nitin Gadkari and leaders of alliance partners.

## 2 TERRORISTS KILLED IN GUNFIGHT IN J&K'S KULGAM

Terrorist arrested from Doda in J&K

Two terrorists were killed in an ongoing gunfight with the security forces in the Nowpora-Kherpora area of South Kashmir's Kulgam district, while one Pakistani intruder was neutralised by the BSF at the International Border (IB) in Jammu and a terrorist has been arrested from Doda district of Jammu and Kashmir along with arms and ammunition, officials said on Monday.

Two terrorists were killed in an ongoing gunfight with the security forces in the Nowpora-Kherpora area of South Kashmir's Kulgam district, officials said on Monday.

"One more terrorist killed (Total 02). Operation going on," police said in a tweet.

The gunfight started after a joint team of police and security forces got an input about the presence of terrorists in that area.

The security forces cordoned off the area. Terrorists hiding there started firing drawing retaliation by the



security forces. There have been a series of encounters between the terrorists and security forces across Kashmir over the last few months.

Many terrorists and their commanders have been eliminated.

Most of the operations have been jointly conducted by the police and the army on the basis of specific intelligence inputs. Meanwhile, one Pakistani intruder was neutralised by the BSF at the International Border (IB) in Jammu, officials said on Monday. The Border Security Force (BSF) said alert BSF troops noticed suspicious movement across the fence in the general area of Border Outpost (BOP) Baquarpur.

"Our domination party at night noticed a person coming from the Pak side aggressively towards the fence with an intention to cross the fence. Our party challenged him to stop, but he paid no attention to it and continued his movement towards the fence," BSF said.

"Left with no option, our troops fired three rounds on the intruder due to which he fell down immediately ahead of the fencing."

The BSF said an early morning search party checked the area and found the dead body of a Pak intruder very close to the fence.

"Nothing recovered from him. Body being handed over to Police for

further disposal," BSF said. In the meanwhile a terrorist has been arrested from Doda district of Jammu and Kashmir along with arms and ammunition, officials said on Monday. Doda Police along with security forces have arrested one terrorist Fareed Ahmed, resident of Koti Doda, and recovered one Chinese pistol, two magazines, 14 live cartridges and one mobile phone from his possession, they added. "As an increased security measure before the Amarnath yatra, a police party of Police Station Doda laid a naka on the outskirts of the town and intercepted a young man carrying arms and ammunition," police said.

"The accused was taken into custody, and a special team started investigation into the matter. It has come to fore that Fareed Ahmad received arms and ammunition from one suspect during month of March and he was tasked to attack police personnel in Doda."

Police said due to timely and swift action this nefarious plot was foiled.

A case has been registered by the local police and investigation has been taken up. "Initial investigation revealed that subject is highly radicalised and used to receive calls from terror commanders based across the border, and was motivated to work for terror outfits in Kashmir valley and Doda region," police said.

### ED MAY SUMMON MORE SHIV SENA LEADERS

A number of Shiv Sena and NCP leaders are currently on the radar of the Enforcement Directorate (ED) and may receive summons from the financial probe agency in the coming days, escalating the ongoing political crisis in Maharashtra.

New Delhi: A number of Shiv Sena and NCP leaders are currently on the radar of the Enforcement Directorate (ED) and may receive summons from the financial probe agency in the coming days, escalating the ongoing political crisis in Maharashtra. Shiv Sena chief spokesperson and MP Sanjay Raut has been issued a notice to join the investigation on Tuesday. Apart from him, there are other leaders who are on the radar of the ED like Eknath Khadse, Anil Parab, Bhavana Gawali, Nawab Malik and others. Maharashtra Transport Minister Anil Parab was recently grilled by ED officials for over six hours over three days in connection with a prevention of money laundering case. The ED filed the case over allegations that Parab constructed a resort at Dapoli in Ratnagiri district of Maharashtra in 2017 after flouting environment protection laws. Bhavana Gawali, a five-time Member of Parliament, was earlier summoned by the ED. NCP leader Eknath Khadse was recently asked to vacate a few properties which were attached by the ED. Nawab Malik, the NCP leader, is already behind the bars. Maharashtra's former home minister Anil Deshmukh was also arrested by the ED in connection with a Rs 100 crore extortion case involving former Mumbai police commissioner Parambir Singh.

The government has itself admitted to a shocking 1,25,000 non-commissioned vacancies in armed forces."

The Monday Satyagraha against the scheme by the Indian National Congress follows a memorandum to the President requesting him to with-



draw the controversial scheme.

"We urge the Prime Minister Narendra Modi to shun his arrogance and accede to the youth's demand," Prakash said.

The Congress said it stands with the lakhs of Ex-Servicemen who are concerned about the scheme's impact on the ethos, unit cohesion and combat effectiveness of the Armed Forces.

"We are concerned that such gimmicks are being experimented with at a time of deteriorating global security and rising threats to our borders. ## INDIA REGISTERS OVER 45% RISE IN NEW COVID CASES

India has reported over 45 per cent single-day rise in new Covid cases after 17,073 infections were reported in a span of 24 hours, the Union Ministry of Health and Family Affairs said on Monday. On Sunday, a total of 11,739 Covid cases were reported. The country has also reported 21 new Covid deaths, taking the nationwide toll to 5,25,020. With increasing cases, the active caseload has surged to 94,420 cases, accounting for 0.22 per cent of the country's total positive cases. The recovery of 15,208 patients in the last 24 hours took the cumulative tally to

4,27,87,606. Consequently, India's recovery rate stands at 98.57 per cent. India's daily positivity rate has jumped to 5.62 per cent, while the weekly positivity rate in the country currently stands at 3.39 per cent.

Also in the same period, a total of 3,03,604 tests were conducted across the country, increasing the overall tally to over 86.10 crore. As of Monday morning, India's Covid-19 vaccination coverage exceeded 197.11 crore, achieved via 2,56,08,118 sessions. Over 3.63 crore adolescents have been administered with a first dose of Covid-19 jab since the beginning of vaccination drive for this age bracket.

## SATYENDAR JAIN'S JUDICIAL CUSTODY EXTENDED BY TWO WEEKS

A special CBI court on Monday extended the judicial custody of Delhi Minister Satyendar Jain arrested in connection with an alleged money laundering case, by 14 days.

Earlier on Monday, the court had refused the extension of Jain's judicial custody as neither the minister nor his lawyers were present in the court.

Jain, who is under the custody of the Enforcement Directorate (ED) since May 31, was admitted to the Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Hospital after he complained of reduced oxygen levels last week.

As the probe agency apprised the circumstances at the CBI court at Rouse Avenue and argued for the extension of Jain's custody citing the probe is ongoing, the court directed the ED to present him before the court through video conferencing.

After the submissions, the vacation judge Neelofar Abida Parveen extended the custody of the accused by two weeks and directed the probe agency to present him before the court on July 11. Prior to his hospitalisation, the court had on June 18 rejected Jain's bail application. On June 9, he was also rushed to a hospital after he complained of uneasiness while leaving the Rouse Avenue Court, just after the court



hearing. On June 18, while dismissing the bail plea of Jain, a special court observed that no medical documents have been produced to show his medical history and only on the ground that the accused suffers from sleep apnea, he cannot

be enlarged on bail.

His lawyer submitted that he was suffering from sleep apnea, a medical condition that was quite grave and could even cause the sudden death of a patient if the continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) machine was cut off in the absence of an attendant. In case, the patient removed the machine or there was a power failure and it needed power back-up which was not there in the jail, he argued saying Jain had suffered severe pneumonia during Covid and had just managed to survive.

Even at the time of remand, on request made in that regard, directions were given to make arrangements for the said condition of the accused to provide a CPAP machine, the counsel pointed out.

The CBI has accused Jain, his wife and others of commission of offences under the Prevention of Corruption Act. On March 31, the ED provisionally attached immovable properties worth Rs 4.81 crore belonging to companies beneficially owned and controlled by the minister.

The ED had on June 6 conducted raids at multiple locations belonging to Jain, his wife and his accomplices, who had either directly or indirectly assisted him or participated in the processes of money laundering. The recovery of cash worth Rs 2.85 crore and 133 gold coins weighing 1.80 kg was made during the raid.

There has been speculation since Sunday evening that Sunil Raut was planning to jump the ship and throw his lot with the rebel camp currently camping in Guwahati. "All this is not true... He is very much with me," asserted Sanjay Raut on Monday, and Sunil Raut confirmed that he was present in Mumbai and not gone to Assam. The rebels group has now claimed the support of around 39 Sena MLAs and another dozen independents/smaller parties' legislators with a legal battle now started in the Supreme Court.

## SC agrees to examine plea against attacks on Christian institutions, priests

▶ THE SUPREME COURT ON A MONDAY AGREED TO EXAMINE A PLEA ALLEGING INCREASE IN ATTACKS ON CHRISTIAN INSTITUTIONS AND PRIESTS ACROSS THE COUNTRY.

The Supreme Court on a Monday agreed to examine a plea alleging increase in attacks on Christian institutions and priests across the country. The petitioners are the Archbishop of the

Bangalore Diocese, along with the National Solidarity Forum, and the Evangelical Fellowship of India.

Senior advocate Colin Gonsalves mentioned the matter before a vacation bench of Justices Surya Kant and J.B. Pardiwala and sought urgent listing of the matter.

He submitted that on an average, between 40 to 50 violent attacks occurred against Christian institutions and priests every month across the country, as he pressed on implementation of guidelines which were issued by the top court in a 2018 judgment to curb hate crimes.

Gonsalves emphasised that in month of May, more than 50 cases of violent attacks took place as

he sought the implementation of the guidelines issued in the Tehseen Poonawala judgment (2018).

He cited that in the judgment, direction was passed for the appointment of nodal officers to take note of hate crimes and register FIRs across the nation. In the 2018 judgment, the top court had said hate crimes, cow vigilantism and lynching incidents should be nipped in the bud.

The top court told Gonsalves that if it is happening, then it is very unfortunate. As he pressed for urgent listing of the matter, the bench replied: "What we can ensure is that your matter is listed on the re-opening day itself." After a brief hearing

in the matter, the bench directed the registry to list the matter on the re-opening of the court after summer vacation. The matter is likely to come up for hearing on July 11.

The top court, in 2018, passed a slew of guidelines for the Central government and state governments, which included disciplinary action against lax law enforcing officials, fast tracking of trials etc,

It had said state governments should designate a senior police officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police as nodal officer in each district, and one DSP rank officer will assist these officers to form a task force to develop methods to prevent mob violence and lynching.

## Monsoon misses date with Delhi, IMD to declare date on Tuesday

▶ WITH THE SOUTHWEST MONSOON PROCEEDING SLOWER THAN NORMAL, IT HAS MISSED ITS DATE WITH THE NATIONAL CAPITAL ON MONDAY EVEN AS THE INDIA METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT (IMD) SAID IT WILL DECLARE THE MONSOON ARRIVAL OVER DELHI ON TUESDAY.

With the Southwest Monsoon proceeding slower than normal, it has missed its date with the national capital on Monday even as the India Meteorological Department (IMD) said it will declare the monsoon arrival over Delhi on Tuesday.

The normal date of arrival of monsoon over Delhi is June 27, shifted from June 29 two years ago based on correction provided by long term data. As on Monday, the



IMD said the northern limit of monsoon passes through Deesa, Ratlam, Shivpuri, Rewa, and Churk, pushing only a little ahead after a hiatus of four days.

"Northwest India gets monsoon rains due to strong easterlies and this time, we had weak easterlies. These easterlies become stronger

only when the Bay of Bengal branch of monsoon is active," said senior scientist K.S. Hosalkar at IMD's Climate Research & Services (CR&S), Pune. This is not the first time that the monsoon has missed its date with Delhi. Last year, the monsoon reached Delhi on July 10, making it the most delayed in 19

years. In 2020, it was two days before time, on June 25. The saving grace for IMD has been that it has made no predictions for the monsoon arrival over Delhi.

"There is no consensus in the multiple models that we use for forecasting. Therefore, we had not announced any date as there was uncertainty. We have decided to wait for one more day and will declare the date only tomorrow (Tuesday)," said R.K. Jenamani, a senior scientist with the IMD, Delhi.

For the last four days, the monsoon system had not moved as expected. However, the IMD bulletin on Monday said: "Conditions are favourable for further advance of monsoon into remaining parts of Arabian Sea and Gujarat, some parts of Rajasthan, remaining parts of Madhya Pradesh and Bihar, some parts of Uttar Pradesh and some parts of Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir during next 3-4 days."

The most delayed monsoon arrival over Delhi - that crossed over to July - include July 19 in 2002 and July 9 in 2006 but it was in 1987 that Delhi had witnessed the most late monsoon arrival on July 26.

## K'taka textbook row: BJP bows down to criticism, orders rectification

The BJP government in Karnataka has bowed down to criticism from various quarters regarding the revision of textbooks by the committee headed by the Kananda Development Authority President, Rohit Chakratirtha.

The education department has ordered the rectification of textbooks as per the demands of progressive thinkers and opposition parties.

Former Prime Minister H.D. Deve Gowda had written to Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai to drop the revised syllabus.

The religious seers of three prominent castes of the state -- Lingayat, Vokkaliga and Kuruba -- have objected to the revised education syllabus highlighting the ill-treatment meted out to social

reformers Basavanna and Kanakadasa.

Vokkaliga seers have objected to belittling of Rashtrakavi (National poet) Kuvempu, who is hailed with pride by the community, and the architect of Bengaluru, Nadaprabhu Kempegowda.

Progressive thinkers and litterateurs have raised objections to the dropping of lessons on social reformer Narayan Guru and freedom fighter Bhagat Singh. The authors have written to the state government withdrawing their permission to publish their work.

The ruling BJP, fearing a backlash as nearly all the communities have turned hostile, finally ordered the rectifications in the school textbooks.

The Karnataka government has directed to add the deleted line in the les-

son on "Namma Samvidhana" (Our Constitution) that considers the contributions concerning drafting of the Indian constitution. B.R. Ambedkar is called an "architect of the constitution".

The state government has also noted that the lessons on social reformers Kanakadasa and Purandaradasa, have been trimmed in the seventh standard social science textbooks and it has directed the publication of full chapters on them.

The state government has also ordered rectification of the content on Basavanna and publication of photographs of Rashtrakavi Kuvempu.

It has directed to drop the line in the lesson on Kuvempu that he became a great writer with the help of many people, which was strongly objected to.

In April, the ED had attached Raut's property in connection with the land scam.

A property worth Rs 9 crore of Raut's associate Pravin Raut and assets worth Rs 2 crore belonging to Varsha Raut, the wife of Sanjay Raut, were attached by the ED.

Pravin had eight parcels of land in Alibaug and a flat registered in the name of Varsha Raut which were attached. The ED had arrested Pravin in connection with the matter.

"We had filed a chargesheet in the matter against Pravin, Sarang Wadhawan and Rakesh Wadhawan of HDIL and Guru Ashish Construction and others were named as an accused in the chargesheet," said an ED official. The ED came to know during the probe that Pravin allegedly paid Rs 55 lakh to Varsha. This was paid from the bank account of Pravin's wife.

The money was termed as proceeds of crime by the ED.


It was also alleged that the travel expenses of Sanjay Raut were borne by Pravin which included his hotel stay and air tickets.

The decision was taken in public interest to ensure a smooth functioning of all departments and not hinder the decision-making process in view of the absence of the five cabinet ministers and four ministers of state, according to Thackeray. The work of the departments belonging to the

concerned rebel Ministers and Ministers of State has been handed over to the existing Ministers and Ministers of State, till further orders, said the CMO.

The rebel group's leader and Minister Eknath Shinde's Urban Development, Public Works (Public Enterprises) have been allocated to Minister Subhash Desai, Minister Gulabrao Raghunath Patil's Water Supply and Sanitation Department goes to Anil Dattatraya Parab, Minister Dadaji Dagdu Bhuse's Agriculture and Ex-Servicemen Welfare Department and Minister Sandipan Asaram Bhumare's Employment Guarantee Scheme & Horticulture have

been given to Minister Shankar Yashwantrao Gadakh, Minister Uday Samant's Higher & Technical Education Department goes to Minister Aditya Thackeray.

Similar changes have been affected for the Ministers of State -- who are currently not attending to duties since a week -- and their departments have been passed onto existing MoS till further orders. An official said that the Chief Minister may direct any other Minister to carry out all or any of the duties in the absence of any minister when it is not possible to carry out his duties due to illness or any other reason as per the Government of Maharashtra rules.

## Maha crisis: Rebels rejoice, hectic politicking in BJP

There was jubilation in the rebel Shiv Sena legislators' camp after the Supreme Court proceedings on Monday while hectic politicking started in the Bharatiya Janata Party and the mood turned sombre in the ruling Maha Vikas Aghadi.

Rebel leader Minister Eknath Shinde tweeted: "This is the victory of Hindu Friday Samrat Balasaheb Thackeray's Hindutva and the ideology of Dharmveer Anand Dighe."

The faction - currently in a Guwahati hotel - erupted into joy and celebrations

after the apex court ruling and also expressed gratitude to the Centre for providing security to the rebel MLAs and their families. Shinde is reported to have initiated the process to finalise and send a letter to the Maharashtra Governor that they have withdrawn support to the MVA government of Shiv Sena-Nationalist Congress Party-Congress. On the Opposition side, the BJP's core committee meeting got underway with top leaders present to finalise their strategy to form the next government in the state, possibly with the help of the rebel group. Shinde has claimed the support of 39 Sena MLAs,

and 11 independents or other parties, totalling to 48, and the group is likely to extend its sojourn in Assam by a few more days.

Several leaders joining the meeting were seen beaming in anticipation and some flashed the 'V' sign, indicating an upbeat mood.

Hitting out again, MVA Minister Aditya Thackeray alleged that many of the MLAs were misled or abducted to join the rebel group and the party is ready to take them back. "If the rebels had courage, they would have first resigned and faced the electorate instead of all this," said Thackeray Jr.

# MAMATA SLAMS CENTRE OVER ED NOTICE TO SANJAY RAUT

West Bengal Chief minister Mamata Banerjee on Monday hit out at the Centre

over the Enforcement Directorate (ED)'s summons to Shiv Sena leader, Sanjay Raut over questioning on an alleged money laundering case.

"I heard that a Shiv Sena leader in Maharashtra has received summons from ED today. I heard that there is an attempt to attach his property as well. This is the BJP's tactics.

Whenever they want to harass any opposition leader or topple a state government, they just let loose the central agencies.

"It is being done everywhere. The CBI and the ED will haunt you if you speak the truth. The country or life cannot move on like this. Why all are threatened like this?" she said, in her address at a government function at Burdwan.

On the other hand, Leader of Opposition in the Assembly, Suwendu Adhikari, at a rally in Cooch Behar district drew the reference of Maharashtra, in threatening to topple

the West Bengal government by 2024.

"It has started with Maharashtra. Now after travelling through Rajasthan and Jharkhand, we will reach West Bengal and bring an end to the state government here by 2024," he said. All four states are currently ruled by opposition parties.

Meanwhile, the Chief Minister also lambasted the Union government on the Agnipath scheme of defence recruitment.

"After going through a training period for six months, one will be appointed for only four years. What will these youths do after that? How can one maintain the expenses for his own life from the earnings of just four years? This is nothing but another eyewash before the Lok Sabha elections. I demand the service period should be at least till 60 years and if possible, 65 years," the Chief Minister said.

She also said that she might go to

New Delhi soon to settle the issue of non-payment of central dues on account of different schemes like Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) and Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), among others. She also demanded that the state governments should be allowed to operate schemes like PMGSY, which is a housing scheme, in their own names.

Banerjee also slammed the local administration over complaints from a section of farmers that they are facing difficulties while selling their products at the local Kisan Mandis.

"I will not tolerate this. If anyone faces this problem, just go to the BDO office and file your complaints. The BDO should file an FIR and I am instructing the police to take action and even arrest those who are harassing the farmers," she said.

# 'MLAs lives under threat, can't pursue cases in Mumbai', Shiv Sena rebels to SC

▶ THE SUPREME COURT ON MONDAY ASKED THE EKNATH SHINDE'S FACTION, 'WHY THEY DID NOT MOVE THE BOMBAY HIGH COURT' TO WHICH THEY RESPONDED THAT 'THEIR LIVES WERE UNDER THREAT AND ATMOSPHERE WAS NOT CONDUCTIVE TO PURSUE LEGAL REMEDIES IN MUMBAI.'

The Supreme Court on Monday asked the Eknath Shinde's faction, 'why they did not move the Bombay High Court' to which they responded that 'their lives

were under threat and atmosphere was not conducive to pursue legal remedies in Mumbai.

A vacation comprising Justices Surya Kant and JB Pardiwala asked senior advocate Neeraj Kishan Kaul, representing the rebel MLAs, why they did not move the Bombay High Court.

Kaul cited threats to the lives of the rebel Shiv Sena MLAs and their families, which made the atmosphere non-conducive to pursue cases in Mumbai.

Kaul said the petitioners said that the Deputy Speaker cannot proceed with the disqualification proceedings against them, when a resolution seeking his removal was pending. He cited the decision of the apex court in the "Nabam Rebia" case (2016).

Kaul added that a minority of the legislative party was subverting the state machinery, and their houses were being attacked. Kaul said they said, "bodies will arrive and we will be slaughtered like bulls..."

The bench said there were two things --

first the alleged threats to the lives of the MLAs, which the court has no means to verify, and the second issue the lack of time given to the MLAs to respond to the disqualification notice.

The bench noted that the important overarching issue was that the Speaker or Deputy Speaker could not continue till his continuance was under doubt.

Kaul reiterated how a Deputy Speaker could proceed with the issue when his removal was in question.

The bench queried: Is the Deputy Speaker not competent to proceed when the MLAs moved for his removal, and asked Kaul, "Why can't you raise this question before the Deputy Speaker?" Kaul replied that the Deputy Speaker cannot entertain disqualification petitions at all.

The hearing was in progress in the matter.

The top court was hearing petitions by Eknath Shinde and the rebel MLAs of Shiv Sena challenging the disqualification

notices issued by the Maharashtra Deputy Speaker to them and also the appointment of Ajay Choudhari as the Shiv Sena Legislature Party leader.

The plea said the petitioner was aggrieved by the notice/summon dated June 25, which was grossly illegal, unconstitutional and in utter disregard of the judgment of this court in the matter of Nabam Rebia & Bamang Felix Vs Deputy Speaker, Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly in (2016). "That the seat of Speaker is vacant since Nana Patole resigned from office in February 2021.

Thus, there is no authority who can adjudicate upon the disqualification petition under which the impugned notice has been issued to the petitioner," it added. The rebel leaders urged the apex court to prohibit Deputy Speaker from taking any action under the Anti-Defection Law (10th Schedule of the Constitution) and issue direction against taking any action until the resolution for the removal of Deputy Speaker is decided.

# Maharashtra Deputy CM Ajit Pawar tests Covid-19 positive

With this, three top functionaries in the state -- Governor Bhagat Singh Koshyari, Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray and now Deputy CM Ajit Pawar -- have been infected by Covid-19 in the past one week.

# PIL in Bombay HC seeks 'return to work' by rebel Ministers, MLAs

▶ A GROUP OF ACTIVISTS AND CIVIL SOCIETY MEMBERS HAVE MOVED THE BOMBAY HIGH COURT SEEKING DIRECTIONS TO THE SHIV SENA REBEL GROUP OF MINISTERS AND MLAS TO "RETURN TO THE STATE (MAHARASHTRA) AND ASSUME THEIR DUTIES", HERE ON MONDAY.

A group of activists and civil society members have moved the Bombay High Court seeking directions to the Shiv Sena rebel group of Ministers and MLAs to "return to the state (Maharashtra)

and assume their duties", here on Monday.

The petition has been filed by crusader-lawyer Asim Sarode on behalf of the activists group, comprising prominent personalities from different fields.

Among other things, he has urged the court to direct the rebel group leader Eknath Shinde "who is on unofficial leave" along with other ministers to return to the state and take charge of their duties

The PIL also has demanded "appropriate action" against Shinde, the other Ministers "for omission of duties and moral wrongs committed" leading to disrespect towards public rights and good governance.

The PIL was mentioned before a bench headed by Chief Justice Dipankar Datta and is likely to come up for hearing soon, Sarode told IANS.

The petitioners have also asked for directions to the Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray and other officials to "submit a detailed plan of assurance" mentioning the process of governance in the absence of so many Ministers.

The group of petitioners are: Utpal B Chandawar, Abhijit V Ghule-Patil, Neelima Medha K Kulkarni, S Vartak, Hemant M Karnik, Manali M Gupte and Madhavi Kulkarni.

The respondents are: Shinde, the group of rebels comprising Ministers and MLAs, the State of Maharashtra, and the state Presidents of Shiv Sena-Nationalist Congress Party-Congress of the ruling Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) alliance.

The petition points out how the people in the state are feeling neglected and voiceless, who at many times meek viewers of the (ongoing) political drama, because "they cannot do anything to change the situation of what happens between two elections."

It highlighted the duty of all elected/appointed representatives to the legislative Assembly or Parliament not to disturb or create nuisance in 'Constitutional Governance' for their personal gain or ego' and not upset the basic expectations related to governance due to 'power politics.'

The 'power struggle' in the state has reached its heights, events are unfolding fast and it's difficult to predict how it will end.

"Forming the government is one positive action while creating situations to topple the government by hook or by crook is a definite public nuisance issue for the common citizens. Why should the citizens be compelled to tolerate the nonsense under the name of politics," the petition said.

It also questioned the manner in which the rebel group travelled from Mumbai to Surat (Gujarat) and then to Guwahati (Assam), travelling by chartered flights, living in lavish five-star hotels and asked how the elected representatives are spending such huge amounts and whether they are using 'public funds.'

Amid all this, the PIL says how the acts of these Ministers is affecting their duties and responsibilities towards the people like roads, education, health, infrastructure, etc., and "such conduct interferes with the rights of the public and affects an entire community."

# "I'm In Opposition For 2-3 Days:" Union Minister's Remark In Maharashtra

# BJP leader Raosaheb Danve represents Maharashtra's Jalna constituency in Lok Sabha

Among the tussle between the Shiv Sena leadership and a rebel faction of MLAs that threatens to topple Maharashtra's Uddhav Thackeray government, a Union Minister's remark has become the talking point.

BJP leader Raosaheb Danve, who represents Maharashtra's Jalna constituency in Lok Sabha, has made a remark at an event in his constituency that has sparked a buzz regarding the BJP's plans in the state.

"I am a minister at the centre and Bhaiyya Saheb [a reference to Maharashtra cabinet minister Rajesh Tope] is a minister in the state. I have been a Union minister for two-and-a-half years. But you (Tope) have

been a minister for 14 years, so wrap up your work, time is running out," Danve said.

He then added, "If you want an opportunity in the future, you may think about this. Tope, I am in the Opposition for two-three more days."

Tope is from Sharad Pawar's Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) and holds the portfolios of Public Health and Family Welfare, and Skill Development and Entrepreneurship in the Maha Vikas Aghadi government of Sena, NCP and the Congress. The "two-three more days" remark by Danve, Minister of State for Railways and a former state BJP chief, has triggered speculation on the BJP's next move in the state.

The Opposition party has so far maintained that the

developments in the state are an internal tussle of the Sena, and they have no role in it. However, the rebels' meetings with BJP leaders at the Guwahati hotel where they are stationed clearly suggest that the Eknath Shinde-led faction has the support of the party.

The Sena's tussle has reached the Supreme Court now, with the rebel MLAs filing two petitions -- one opposing the Sena's move to disqualify 16 rebel legislators and another challenging the rejection of the no trust motion against Deputy Speaker Narahari Zirwal.

The Sena leadership has accused the BJP of engineering the mutiny in its ranks, alleging that each legislator was paid nearly Rs 40 crore to move to the rebel side and daring them to return to Maharashtra.

End of the Vajpayee-Advani era

The BJP of today is not the BJP of yesterday. The party is now ideologically sharper, more focussed and more aggressive. The BJP nurtured by the trio of former Prime Minister late Atal Bihari Vajpayee, L.K. Advani and Murlī Manohar Joshi was soft, approachable, amiable and also accepting and forgiving. Even its hardest critics agree that the 'old' BJP was people-friendly and sensitive. The neo-Hindutva being practiced by the new BJP, particularly in Uttar Pradesh which has been its nursery, is not even a shadow of the Hindutva of Vajpayee era that was mild and malleable. The harsh neo-Hindutva that is now being pursued by the BJP has made its cadres, particularly the youth, unruly, aggressive and even violent at times. Whether it is the Ikhlāq incident where the man was killed because 'fringe elements' suspected he had stored beef in his house, or the Bulandshahr incident where a police officer was killed while trying to control a mob that went berserk on rumours of beef being transported -- it was the saffron cadres who happily indulged in violence. Young leaders in the BJP now use a language that was unheard of two decades ago. "Hum lad ke lenge, chheen ke lenge" is now the most commonly used phrase when it comes to disputes like the Gyanvapi mosque or the Shahi Idgah row. The bulldozer scare is now so magnified that no political leader -- whether from the BJP or the opposition -- is ready to rub the leadership the wrong way. Even BJP leaders are wary of giving interviews. The new generation leaders, however, justify the aggressive BJP of the present. The new BJP has also ensured that Christians remain as alienated as Muslims in its new scheme of things.

EKNATH SHINDE'S REBELLION A WAKE-UP CALL TO ALL DYNASTS

The happenings in Maharashtra have thrown up several questions. Is it really a rebellion against a dynasty or a political tussle to get power?

Eknath Shinde has made it a fight for "setting the party on the right path", which clearly means a return to its late supremo Bal Thackeray's core Hindutva ideology, giving up on the Maha Vikas Agadhi (MVA) alliance and going back to the "old friend", the BJP. Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray's dwindling camp and his MVA partners have accused the BJP of engineering the plot. As the political tussle rages, the country is watching the unravelling saga, which may have a bearing upon the system of dynasts in vogue in a number of political parties. Whatever the result, it may set a new course in the political setup of the country.

But the big question is: Can India shake off dynasty politics?

Some of India's most powerful political families include the Gandhis, Tamil Nadu's Karunanidhi family, Uttar Pradesh's Yadav family, Bihar's Lalu Prasad dynasty, Kashmir's Muftis and Abdullahs, Punjab's Badals, Haryana's Chautalas, Hoodas, Jindals and Bishnois, Jharkhand's Sorens and Jogis, Scindias in Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan, the Thackerays and Pawars in Maharashtra, Sangmas in Meghalaya, Karnataka's Deve Gowda and Yediyurappa families, the NTR and YSR families of Andhra ... The list is very long.

Can these political parties exist without the families that have been controlling them? Can we imagine the Congress without the Gandhis, National Conference without the Abdullahs, RJD minus Lalu or the Samajwadi Party without Mulayam-Akhilesh, TRS without the Raos, etc, etc? In fact, it may be a difficult proposition, perhaps in most of

these parties the family without the party seems to be an unacceptable concept. The party without the family nameplate, or the owner family sans the party, both seem like impossible ideas.

Except for the Congress, which briefly had two non-Gandhis at the helm, the rest have not deviated from the family ownership pattern. These parties have seen family feuds, some breaking away and joining rivals or forming new parties, but the family's hold has not been diluted. Non-family leaders keep trudging along, bowing to the dynasty and fading away in the course of time.

Challenge to the dynasty

The sudden implosion in Maharashtra's Shiv Sena has stunned political observers. Can an entrenched dynasty be challenged this way? Perhaps Eknath Shinde has shown the way. A 'courageous' move that has all the BJP's backing. Uddhav Thackeray's Man Friday is now the rebel.

Fifty-six years after the party was formed, the Thackerays are on the brink of losing their Sena.

It was on June 19, 1966, when Bal Thackeray formed the party that later made Hindutva its core ideology. Ironically, it is in its founding month that the party is wracked by a coup that is based on the allegations that Bal Thackeray's son Uddhav and grandson Aaditya deviated from the core ideology and went with those whom the founding father had all along opposed.

With support for him growing from within the party, Shinde wants to name his faction as Shiv Sena Bal Thackeray. The tussle within the party is heading towards a legal finish, the result may be whatever, but Shinde has shown that dynasties can be challenged.



Wake-up call for all dynasts

Maharashtra is a wake-up call for all those who believe that political inheritance and dynastic rule can fetch dividends for all time to come. Rebellions can happen and Shinde has shown the way.

The Congress has seen the G-23 rise, even though it has failed to produce results. On the other hand, the dissenting leaders are slowly ebbing away. Kapil Sibal quit the Congress after he was denied a Rajya Sabha ticket, veterans Gulam Nabi Azad, Anand Sharma, etc. find no major role in the party now.

The Congress continues to depend on Sonia Gandhi, Rahul Gandhi and Priyanka Vadra Gandhi, even as questions are being repeatedly raised on their ability to lead the party to election victories. Those who felt 'suffocated' left the party and some of them are doing very well in their new political addresses, notably Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma and the Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia. But they chose

to move out rather than rebel within the party. Dynastic politics is not the hallmark of just the Gandhi family; it is now an integral part of politics in the country. Almost all the states have their own share of parties led by dynasties.

In most of the regional dynasty-led parties, voices are raised from time to time, but the rebels just move away to join other parties. The iron grip of the regional satraps on their parties does not allow anyone outside the family to rise.

The BJP has been raking up the 'vices' of dynasty politics and Prime Minister Narendra Modi has been consistently attacking the Gandhis and the regional dynasties. "Democracy in the country will be strengthened only when all political parties shun dynasty politics and allow the youth of the country to reach the top," Modi said, terming dynastic politics as a challenge to democracy.

Watershed moment

Will the Shinde rebellion help rewrite Shiv Sena history? The party

saw its first rebellion when Chhagan Bhujujal left the Shiv Sena in 1991, upset that the leadership did not appreciate his work for the party. Bal Thackeray was leading the Sena when Bhujujal broke away with 18 MLAs to support the Congress, which was then in power in Maharashtra. But 12 of the 18 rebels returned to Thackeray's fold on the same day.

Then in 2005, Narayan Rane left the party; in 2006, Uddhav Thackeray's cousin Raj also left and formed his own political outfit, namely, the Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS).

Shinde's rebellion, however, is totally different from the earlier ones. After securing the support of a majority of the MLAs, his sole demand is a "return to Hindutva" and the dissolution of the MVA combine as it is "annihilating" the party.

Will Shinde be able to lead his rebellion to its logical end? That's the million-dollar question today, but his action is a warning to all other dynasts.

SIX MEXICAN POLICE OFFICERS KILLED IN SHOOTOUT

At least six police officers were killed during a shootout with armed individuals travelling in a convoy of about 10 armoured trucks in Nuevo Leon state, authorities said. "Four more policemen were injured and are already receiving medical attention," Xinhua news agency quoted the state's security department as saying. The attack occurred between the towns

of Lampazos and Colombia in the north of the state, where police were outnumbered by the attackers, who carried large-caliber weapons, according to the authorities.

President Andres Manuel Lopez Obrador has said that violence is one of the main challenges of his administration, which began in December 2018.

BRICS MEMBER BLOCKED INVITE TO DEVELOPMENT DIALOGUE IN CHINA: PAK

Islamabad: Without naming the country, Pakistan on Monday claimed that its invitation to a development dialogue held in China on June 24 was blocked by a BRICS member.

In response to media queries about the "High-level Dialogue on Global Development", held virtually on the sidelines of the BRICS meetings, a Foreign Office spokesperson said that Pakistan is fully committed to taking bilateral and multilateral cooperation to new heights, Geo News reported.

According to the spokesperson, a number of developing and emerging economies were invited to the high-level dialogue on global development.

As the host country, China was engaged with Pakistan prior to the BRICS meetings, where decisions are made after consultations with all the members, including invitations to non-members.

"Regrettably, one member blocked Pakistan from participating," Geo News quoted the spokesperson as saying.

According to sources, India blocked Pakistan from participating at the BRICS summit.

"We hope that the organisation's future engagement will be based on principles of inclusivity, with the overall interests of the developing world in mind, and free of narrow geopolitical considerations," the spokesperson said.

He said Pakistan values China's role in advancing the interests of developing countries, adding that Islamabad, along with Beijing, has been a strong advocate for global peace, shared prosperity, and inclusive development.

CANADA SENDS 2 SHIPS TO ENHANCE NATO READINESS IN BALTIC REGION

Two Canadian ships departed for a four-month deployment in the Baltic Sea and North Atlantic region on Operation Reassurance to enhance NATO readiness, the Defence Ministry said. In a statement, the Ministry said HMCS

Kingston and Summerside are deployed to contribute to NATO assurance and deterrence measures in Central and Eastern Europe, adding that the Canadian Armed Forces is maintaining a presence in European waters on a persistent rotational basis since 2014, reports Xinhua news agency. According to the state-

ment, between July and October 2022, HMCS Kingston and Summerside will join Standing NATO Mine Countermeasures Group One. During Operation Reassurance, the ships will participate in NATO's high readiness on sea, which can quickly and effectively respond in support of any military alliance's operations. HMCS Halifax and Montreal, currently on station as part of Operation Reassurance, will return to Canada in July.

This will be the first deployment on Operation Reassurance for both ships.

HMCS Summerside will deploy with an embarked Royal Canadian Navy clearance diving team, supported by mine countermeasure search capabilities using autonomous underwater vehicles aboard HMCS Kingston, the statement added.

UN summit opens with call to tackle ocean emergency

With climate change, biodiversity loss and pollution exacting a devastating toll on the world's ocean -- critical to food security, economic growth and the environment -- the 2022 UN Ocean Conference opened in Lisbon on Monday with a call for a new chapter of ocean action driven by science, technology and innovation. "Sadly, we have taken the ocean for granted, and today we face what I would call an 'Ocean Emergency'," United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres told delegates at the opening of the conference. "We must turn the tide. A healthy and productive ocean is vital to our shared future." The theme of the conference, "Scaling up ocean action based on science and innovation for the implementation of Goal 14:

Stocktaking, partnerships and solutions", in line with the UN Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development, stresses the critical need for scientific knowledge and marine technology to build ocean resilience. Human activities are placing the health of the ocean in peril. According to the World Meteorological Organization's State of the Global Climate in 2021 report, sea level rise, ocean heat, ocean acidification and greenhouse gas concentrations set new records in 2021. Additionally, marine pollution is increasing at an alarming rate, and if current trends continue, more than half of the world's marine species may be all but extinct by 2100.

The Secretary-General also stated there is good news with a legally binding instrument on the conservation and sustainable use of marine biological diversity of areas

beyond national jurisdiction; a new treaty that is being negotiated to address the global plastics crisis that is choking our oceans; and a week ago multilateral action on display with a World Trade Organization agreement on ending harmful fishery subsidies. But he also noted much more needs to be done. "Oceans are central in geopolitical balance of power," said President of Portugal, Marcelo Rebelo de Sousa, in opening remarks. "Healthcare, economic resources, energy, mobility, migrations, scientific and technological development, climate change, all of this is present either in the context or in the outcome of a pandemic, of war and of crisis."

"We must recover too much time (that) we have lost and give hope a chance, once again, before it is too late."

In line with Sustainable

Development Goal 14, human health, strong economic growth and a stable climate depend on a healthy ocean. The ocean is a vital buffer against climate change, absorbing about 25 per cent of all carbon dioxide emissions. More than 3.5 billion people depend on the ocean for their food security, while approximately 120 million people work directly in fisheries and aquaculture-related activities.

The majority of these workers live in developing countries, specifically Small-Island Developing States and Least Developed Countries. More than 20 heads of state and government together with thousands of young people, business leaders, scientists and civil society representatives, will present fresh, bold and innovative solutions to ignite transformational change to effectively address the challenges the ocean is facing.

WAR SHOULD END BEFORE WINTER SETS IN: ZELENKY TELLS G7

In a virtual address to the G7 Summit, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky said on Monday that he wanted the ongoing war waged by Russia against his country to end before winter.

The BBC reported that the Ukrainian President asked the G7 leaders reconstruction aid, anti-aircraft defence systems, help on grain exports and security guarantees. He also asked to "intensify sanctions" on Russia. A day before his address, Zelensky said in his address to the nation that delaying arms deliveries to Ukraine was "an invitation to Russia to strike again and again", reports the BBC. "Partners need to move faster if they are really partners, not observers," he said and called for air defence systems. Over the weekend, Russia fired a barrage of missile strikes on Kiev, the central city of Cherkasy where one person died, and the Kharkiv region, along with Chernihiv in the north and Zhytomyr and Lviv west of the capital. The strike on Starychi district in Lviv was just 30 km from the border with Poland, reports the BBC.

On Saturday, the key eastern city of Severodonetsk

also fell to Russia, which gave Moscow the control of nearly all of Luhansk region and much of neighbouring Donetsk, the two Russian-backed separatist regions that form the industrial Donbas. The war in Ukraine is top of the G7 agenda.

While German Chancellor Olaf Scholz has said that Russian missile strikes showed it was "right to stand together and support Ukrainians", US President Joe Biden claimed that his Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin was counting on NATO and the G7 to "splinter... but we haven't and we're not going to".

Later this week, Zelensky is also expected to address the NATO Summit in Madrid.

## Wangamba Pendong is Exhibit of the Week at IGRMS

Under the Latest and popular online series of Indira Gandhi Rashtriya Manav Sangrahalaya (IGRMS) entitled 'Exhibit of the Week' the "Wangamba Pendong" (A traditional rectangular wooden bag) collected from 2006 is at display. The Community of Konyak Naga, Longwa Village, Mon District, Nagaland. It's Measurement 41cms Length, 12 cms. width and 29 cms. height with top, displayed in the audience as the fourth Exhibit of the month of June, 2022 through official website, Facebook, Instagram and twitter page of the IGRMS.

In this regard Praveen Kumar Mishra, Director, IGRMS said that "Wangamba Pendong", a traditional rectangular wooden bag that belongs to the Konyak Naga tribe of Nagaland. It is made from a single piece of wood covered by a detachable wooden knobbed lid. The front part is decorated with three equal sizes of skull motifs and on the upper part of the skulls, two concave motifs are also shown in high relief form. Oblique

lines are engraved all around the front rectangular border. The upper part of the lid is decorated with geometrical designs. There are three loops, two are on both sides and one is below the middle skull motifs. A cane-woven strap is strung within three loops for carrying and supporting purposes. The cane strap is woven in double style, half of the strap strung within the loops is in twined pattern and the hanging part is in a criss-cross pattern. Though the technology is simple, it is excellently done by the Konyaks who expert artisans and skilled craftsmen are. The carved figures generally have their symbolic meaning. The tools used during the carving are made locally such as chisel, axe, adze, dao etc. The object is used for keeping domestic items and carrying important materials at the time of shopping. In response, a BET spokesperson said that the "summation of events around Lil Nas X's 2021 BET Awards performance is simply untrue."

"Since last year's performance, we have been in touch to work on other projects," the representative added. "We are still excited about his previous performances and continue to wish him well. But today, we are focused on culture's biggest night and delivering history-making moments for fans worldwide."

The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) on Monday confirmed that opener Mayank Agarwal has been added to the Test squad ahead of the rescheduled Edgbaston Test against England as a cover for captain Rohit Sharma, who tested positive for Covid-19.



positive for Covid-19. Mayank has left for the UK and will link up with the squad in Birmingham," said the BCCI in an official statement.

Earlier, on his Instagram story, Agarwal was seen in the flight with "Birmingham" typed above where he was seated, signalling that he had been called up to the Indian Test squad. According to the latest government rules on travel to the United Kingdom, Agarwal won't be subjected to any quarantine period and may be available to play immediately if needed. Agarwal, 31, had initially been left out of India's squad for the Edgbaston Test named in May this year. But a right groin injury to K.L. Rahul, which ruled him out of the

home T20I series against South Africa in June and Sharma's availability in doubt due to testing positive for Covid-19 means that Agarwal is now on his way to Birmingham to join the Test squad.

Agarwal, who made his Test debut against Australia on Boxing Day in 2018, has scored 1,488 runs at an average of 41.33 in 21 matches, including four centuries and six half-centuries. He was in the squad for the five-match Test series against England last year but was ruled out of the first Test at Trent Bridge due to a concussion. But with Rahul rediscovering his touch as a Test opener, Agarwal did not feature in the playing eleven for the whole tour.

Agarwal last played a Test match for India in March, during the two-match home series against Sri Lanka in Mohali and Bengaluru. He could manage to score just 59 runs at an average of 19.66. He then turned out for Punjab Kings in IPL 2022, where he was their captain.

But Agarwal had a season to forget with the bat, scoring just 196 runs in 12 innings at an average of 16.33 and a strike rate of 122.5 as Punjab finished sixth on the points table. He then appeared for Karnataka in the Ranji Trophy quarterfinal against Uttar Pradesh, making 10 and 22 in a five-wicket defeat at Alur.

India are leading the Test series 2-1 against England, before a Covid-19 outbreak in the visitors' camp saw the fifth and final Test in Manchester rescheduled to Edgbaston this year. After this, India will play three ODIs and as many T20Is, scheduled to happen from July 7 to 17.

Asian Games gold medalist Olga Sazonova of Kazakhstan came second in 23.21s while Dutee Chand clocked 23.60s to finish third.

However, Dhanalakshmi will be competing only in the 100m at the Commonwealth Games 2022, which will be held in Birmingham, from July 28 to August 8.

Tokyo Olympian Tajinderpal Singh Toor, who was asked by the Athletics Federation of India (AFI) to prove his fitness and produce good results in competitions before the Commonwealth Games to seal his place in the team, did not start the event. In Tajinderpal's absence, India's Karanveer Singh (19.47m) claimed the top podium in the shot put event. Apart from Tajinderpal Singh, hammer thrower Sarita Singh has also been named provisionally in India's Commonwealth Games squad. She won the gold medal with a throw of 62.48m. Zarina Nosirjonova (57.68m) of Uzbekistan came second while her compatriot Elna Silyamieva (55.39m) came third.

Among Indian athletes who have already booked their berth for Birmingham 2022, women's javelin thrower Annu Rani and women's long jumper Ancy Sojan fine-tuned their preparations for the Commonwealth Games by winning gold medals in their respective events.

Annu Rani (62.29m) led India's clean sweep in the women's javelin throw with Shilpa Rani (56.16m) and Sanjana Choudhary (55.12m) following her on the podium. Ancy Sojan won the long jump gold with a 6.44m leap. However, Eldhose Paul (16.55m) and Karthik Unnikrishnan (16.15m) were beaten by Azerbaijan's Nazim Babayev (16.93m) for the top spot in the men's triple jump, an olympics.com report said.

India concluded the Qosanov Memorial 2022 athletics meet, which is a World Athletics bronze-level event, with 28 medals, including 15 gold medals.

The two tied the knot this year on 14 April at RK house in






### Ram Pothineni likely to get married later this year
