# Global Recession Ahead

The global economic slowdown is beginning to dampen demand for the region's exports of commodities and manufactured goods, a report noted.

Now we have to weather what looks like an oncoming recession. I think a global recession. That's what I think we are edging into. But at the same time, we have to start thinking of the recovery. We have to restore growth. "A key factor slowing global growth is the generalised tightening of monetary policy, driven by the greater-than-expected overshoot of inflation targets," the OECD added on Monday in its latest Economic

Annual gross domestic product (GDP) growth is projected to slow sharply to 0.5 per cent in the US in 2023, and to 0.25 per cent in the eurozone, with risks of output declines in several European economies during the winter

#### **ECB EXPECTS ECONOMIC ACTIVITY TO SLOW, INTEREST RATES TO INCREASE FURTHER**

Brussels: The European Central Bank (ECB) expects economic activity in Europe to slow down substantially in the coming months, due to skyrocketing prices, decreased spending power and overall uncertainty, ECB President Christine Lagarde said. The euro area economy grew by 0.8 per cent in the second quarter of 2022, Lagarde explained, mainly owing to strong consumer spending on services as the economy reopened, Xinhua news agency reported. However, growth is expected to slow substantially. This is mainly due to high inflation, slower demand for services, a weakening global demand and worsening terms of trade. Falling household and business confidence due to a high level of uncertainty are also contributing factors. #### **BANK OF ENGLAND 'WILL NOT HESITATE'** TO RAISE RATES AS POUND FALLS

**London:** The Bank of England (BoE) said that it "will not hesitate to change interest rates as necessary" after the British pound plunged to its lowest level against the US dollar since decimalisation in 1971.

It will make a full assessment at its next scheduled meeting of the impact on demand and inflation from the government's announcements, and the fall in sterling, and act accordingly, the central bank said in a statement on Monday while dampening the prospects of an emergency rate rise to shore up the pound. On Monday, the pound tumbled more than 4 per cent to trade as low as \$1.035 in early Asia trading, taking it closer to parity with the dollar, though the British currency later rose above \$1.08, reports Xinhua news agency. In the wake of the BoE statement, the pound slid again below \$1.07.

Both the former employees, who are husband and wife, fled the resort to save their lives after being tortured like Ankita.

The couple, presently living in Meerut, used to do the same work till June. In just two months, they got so upset that they had to escape from the resort overnight to save their lives. Both the husband and wife revealed the wrongdoings of Pulkit Arya and Ankit alias Ankit Gupta.

These two former employees had done hotel management courses. After that they were looking for jobs. Meanwhile, they got information about the staff requirement at the resort of Pulkit Arya. They then came here and contacted Pulkit Arya and got the

Ishita, a former employee of Vanantra Resort, told the probe team that Pulkit Arva was harassing her so much that many a times she tried to escape from here, but every time she failed. Pulkit Arya used to keep the staff here trapped in his clutches, due to which it was very difficult to get out.

Ishita said that Pulkit Arya had accused

her of theft as well. After being accused of theft, she apologized in writing even though she had not committed any theft. Both the husband and wife finally managed to come out from the resort.

They said the Patwari often used to come here. Pulkit Arya had good relations with the Patwari and the people associated with him. Here, many times employees were beaten and Patwari was informed, but no action was ever taken. On the contrary, Patwari always used to threaten the employees. Patwari was always given special treatment in the resort.

#### SC Constitution bench to hear petitions against demonetisation

five-judge Constitution bench will on Wednesday hear petitions challenging Centre's decision to demonetise currency notes of Rs 500 and Rs 1,000 in November 2016.

A bench of Justices S.

Abdul Nazeer, B.R. Gavai, A.S. Bopanna, V. Ramasubramanian, and B.V. Nagarathna, will hear the petitions against demonetisation. This is the fourth Constitution bench which has been constituted in the apex court.In November 2016, Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced demonetisation of all Rs 500 and Rs 1,000 notes, as a



measure to curb the circulation of black money in the economy.The bench will also hear a matter in connection with issues relating to freedom of speech of public/state functionaries.It will hear another matter raising an issue, whether the immunity to legislative Assembly

members, under Article 194(2), in connection with any vote given by them in the legislature includes immunity against prosecution for bribery. The top court will also hear a matter in connection with questions under the Prevention of Corruption Act.

Abu Salem a.k.a Abdul Qayoom Ansari, along with his associates Parvez Alam and Sameera Jumani, had applied for a passport in the name of Aqeel Ahmed Azmi at the Lucknow passport office in 1993. Salem affixed forged documents of fake name and address with the application and obtained passport, which he later used.

#### NIA conducts pan-India raids against PFI, several detained

Both the flight tests have completely met the mission objectives, the Defence Ministry

statement said. VSHORADS is a manportable air defence system (MANPAD) designed



and developed indigenously by the Defence Research and Development Organisation's Research Centre Imarat (RCI), Hyderabad in collabora-

tion with other DRDO

laboratories and Indian industry partners. The missile incorporates many novel technologies including miniaturised reaction control system (RCS) and integrated avionics, which have been

successfully proven during the tests

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh complimented and appreciated the efforts of the DRDO and industry partners, saving that this new missile equipped with modern technologies will give further technological boost to the armed forces.

The missile, meant for neutralising low-altitude aerial threats at short ranges, is propelled by a dual-thrust solid motor. The design of the missile and its launcher has been highly optimised to ensure easy portability.

#### **Terrorist killed in encounter** in J&K's Kulgam

Srinagar: One terrorist was killed in an ongoing encounter - the second in two days - between terrorists and security forces in Jammu and Kashmir's Kulgam district on Tuesday, police said.

'One terrorist killed. Operation in progress," police said. Earlier Jammu and Kashmir Police in a tweet, quoting Additional Director General Police Kashmir zone, Vijay Kumar, said that two local ter rorists of proscribed terror outfit JeM were trapped in the ongoing encounter in Ahwatoo area of Kulgam. Both the trapped terrorists are involved in several terror crime cases

A Pakistani terrorist belonging to terrorist outfit Jaish-e-Muhammed was killed in an encounter between terrorists and security forces at Batpora

### **Maken recommends disciplinary** action against Dhariwal, two others

ongress' Rajasthan in-charge Ajay Maken has recommended disciplinary action against three MLAs including Shanti Dhariwal, Mahesh Joshi and Dharmendra Rathore whom he blamed for holding a parallel meet.

Maken, in his report to the party president Sonia Gandhi, has reported "grave indiscipline" on part of the three MLAs. The party on Tuesday also issued show cause notices to all the three legislators.

Dhariwal, the Urban Development and Housing Development and Parliamentary Affairs Minister, had called a meeting of MLAs from the Ashok Gehlot camp at his residence and reportedly strategised ways to ensure that Gehlot stays the Chief Minister.

The official meeting of the Congress Legislature Party was to be held at 7 p.m. on Sunday at the Chief Minister's residence in Jaipur, but before that Gehlot's loyalists gathered at Dhariwal's residence. From where, they went to Speaker C.P. Joshi's residence and collectively submitted their resignation to him.The show cause notice addressed to Dhariwal reads: "...you have committed grave



indiscipline by hosting a parallel MLAs meeting at your residence pressuring them not to attend the official meeting. As Parliamentary Affairs Minister, hosting the unofficial meeting confused the Congress MLAs as to which one was convened officially."

The notice that has sought response within 10 days also noted that Dhariwal's action came even when senior party leader Mallikarjun Kharge and Maken repeatedly clarify that they have come to speak to each MLA individually and impartially report to the Congress President.

### Sitharaman directs banks to enhance coverage of SCs in all schemes

inance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Wednesday called upon public sector banks to enhance coverage of Scheduled Castes (SCs) in all schemes and advised them to also look into their needs for capacity building and entrepreneurship development, as the community constitutes about 18 per cent of the total workforce of in banks and financial institutions.

Sitharaman gave these directions during a review meeting of various Central financial schemes being implemented by state-owned banks and their coverage towards the SCs.

During the meeting, which was attended by chiefs of all public sector banks and officials of the department of financial services as well as chairperson of the National Commission for SCs, the Finance Minister directed them to make proper digital records for jobs being outsourced, especially for posts like safai karamcharis, from October 1,

She emphasised on redressal of all pending grievances pertaining to the SC community and asked them to



take these up on priority through special drives from October 2 onwards.

The minister also asked banks to fill up all backlog vacancies at the earliest and in a time-bound man-

Banks were also directed to ensure forward and backward linkages through convergence of various schemes of different government departments for SCs while giving them financial assistance. The Finance Minister said that the

objective of the meeting was to bring all stakeholders on a common platform to work together in the fulfilment of the rights enshrined in the Constitution for the upliftment and betterment of the people belonging to Scheduled Castes.

#### ONE HELD IN AHMEDABAD FOR HELPING ISI **OPERATIVES**

Ahmedabad: The Ahmedabad Crime Branch has arrested a person for providing access to new Indian cellular numbers to Pakistan's Inter-Services Intelligence (ISI), which the Pakistani spy agency was using to fetch sensitive defence information from retired personnel. Joint Commissioner of Police (Crime Branch) Prem Vir Singh told media persons on Tuesday that Abdul Wahab Pathan of Ahmedabad is arrested for

conspiring against the nation. Pathan used to get local sim cards activated in his or his relatives' names and share the cellular numbers with Shafqat Jatoi, a former officer of Pakistani High Commission to India.

Jatoi was using these numbers to make fake profiles on Whatsapp and sharing them with ISI operartives.

Singh further said that ISI operatives using the fake Whatsapp profile reach out to retired defence officers and jawans and seek information from them illegally.

During primary investigation, police have found that ISI operatives have created fake websites in the name of www.ksboard.in, www.desw.in and www.kavach-apps.in, which was used to mislead retired officers and jawans to seek information from them.

Police have registered case against Pathan and others under various sections of Information and Technology act.

#### Delhi Liquor Scam: CBI makes first arrest, nabs businessman Vijay Nair

n a latest development in the alleged excise policy scam in Delhi, the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) made its first arrest on Tuesday by nabbing businessman Vijay Nair.

Sources told that Nair was arrested from Delhi and now the CBI will seek his custodial remand.

Nair, the former CEO of Only Much Louder, an entertainment and event management firm, and one of the prime suspects in the liquor scam, had gone to London. He returned to join the probe and was placed under arrest.

The CBI has alleged that Nair was actively involved in the irregularities in framing and implementing the excise policy for the year 2021-22.

Nair was reportedly a volunteer of the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) and allegedly helped party leaders by organising events and also managed their social media handles.



On behalf of Nair, Sameer Mahendru, Director of Indospirits, allegedly paid around Rs 2-4 crore to Arjun Pandey, an associate of Deputy Chief Minister Manish

Arun Ramchandra Pillai, a resident of Kokapet in Hyderabad, used to collect undue pecuniary advantages from Mahendru for onward transmission of money to accused public servants through Nair.

#### Sexual harassment allegations surface against K'taka varsity Vice-Chancellor

nexual harassment charges surfaced against the Vice-Chancellor of the Karnataka State Open University (KSOU) on Tuesday with a former syndicate member of Mysuru University, K Mahadevu releasing an audio clip.

Mahadevu has alleged that KSOU Vice-Chancellor Vidyashankar S has misused his position to exploit a woman employee of the varsity. "After the release of this audio clip, if Vidyashankar continues in the position, we must think that there is not an iota of respect. The Chief Minister, the Higher Education Minister and the Governor should initiate action against the VC immediately," he urged.

The audio clip allegedly contains a conversation between the husband of the victim and Vidyashankar. The husband rebukes the VC for asking his wife to send selfies, asking her to come to Bengaluru to collect a diamond set. The husband also questions why the VC transferred Rs 15,000 to his wife.

As Vidyashankar sounds apologetic, the husband says that if his wife had approached him, it was his duty to pull her up, instead he had taken advantage of his position to exploit her.

There was high drama in the Mysuru Press Club as Vidyashankar's followers including the regional director barged into the club and prevented Mahadevu and others from holding a press conference there. Later, Vidyashankar's supporters



Mahadevu has lodged a police complaint about the incident with the KR police station.

Sudhakar Hosalli, the regional director who attempted to stop the press conference, stated that private matters are being dragged into the open for vested interests. Mahadevu is angry that his people were not recruited at the KSOU. The victims in this case have not come forward, he added.

Meanwhile, sources said that the allegation surfaced after the search committee shortlisted three vice-chancellor candidates including KSOU VC Vidyashankar on September 24 for the prestigious Visvesvaraya Technological University.

### NGT slaps Rs 100 cr fine on Hry govt over improper legacy waste management

he National Green Tribunal (NGT) has imposed a fine of Rs 100 crore on Haryana government with regard to unremediated legacy waste, which is damaging the environment and public health.

The principal bench of NGT chairperson Justice Adarsh Kumar Goel, in a recent order, noted that a meeting held by the Chief Minister on December 7, 2020 and the appointment of a senior IAS officer to coordinate the work have not produced tangible result, as it took one year to handover 10 acres of land to set up the Waste To Energy Plant.

The original plea in the issue contended that the Bandhwari landfill site in Gurugram is being dumped by about 33 lakh metric tonnes of solid waste since years.

As per the plea, the waste is being

### Telangana Police officers paid over Rs 28 lakh in traffic fines

elangana Police officials have paid a penalty of over Rs 28 lakh for violation of various traffic rules since 2018, a senior official said on Tuesday. The police officers have cleared 11,601 pending challans and paid a fine amount of Rs 28,85,640 to the traffic police, said Joint Commissioner of Police, Traffic, Hyderabad, A. V. Ranganath.

He revealed the information while responding to a post on Twitter which went viral on Tuesday. A Twitter user wrote that DGP Telangana's police vehicle (No TS09PA 1234) is having challans of Rs 7,000 pending for the last two years. He also posted that while traffic police are levying challans against citizens and collecting fines, the challans on DGP's vehicle remained pending. At this, the Joint Commissioner clarified

that all the vehicles in Telangana Police are registered in the name of the DGP. On the vehicle mentioned in the tweet, he

said it had seven pending challans the fine amount of Rs 6,945 and it has already been



paid by the police officer concerned. He pointed out that even the TSRTC is being regularly fined and they had cleared off all the pending challans in April 2022 by paying Rs 15 lakh.

"Hyderabad Traffic Police is enforcing traffic rules/fines without any exception by strictly following the rule of law. The fact that we are imposing Challans on police and other government vehicles clearly demonstrates that we are fining/enforcing against all categories of vehicles," said the official.

#### **CALCUTTA HC CAUTIONS BENGAL** HOME SECY OF CONTEMPT IN FORENSIC LAB RECRUITMENT

Kolkata| The Calcutta High Court on Tuesday cautioned West Bengal's Additional Chief Secretary, Home, B.P. Gopalika of contempt of court proceedings in case the process of recruitment for 10 posts in the state forensic science laboratory is not started before the forthcoming festive season of Durga Puja starting from October 1.

Gopalika on Tuesday morning informed the division bench of Justice Joymalya Bagchi and Justice and Justice Ajoy Kumar Mukherjee that a few months back, the state government had directed the state public service commission to arrange for the recruitment. Accordingly, the official told that the state public service commission has assured the process of appointment to start before the festive season. After that, the division bench directed the state government to initiate the recruitment process by September 30, failing which the contempt of court proceedings will be initiated. It directed Gopalika to submit a report on how the recruitment process has been initiated by that date.

### BJP rally to Nabanna: HC asks Bengal govt to refrain from unnecessary arrests

division bench of Calcutta High Court on Tuesday directed the West Bengal government to refrain from further unnecessary arrests and harassments of any individual in connection with the BJP's march to the state secretariat of Nabanna against corruption issues on September 13.

In a petition filed against the state government accusing it of continuing harassment of the BJP workers in the matter at the division bench of Calcutta High



Court's Chief Justice Rajasekhar Mantha and Justice Rajarshi Bharadwaj, BJP's counsel Subir Sanyal alleged that that the police

have continued arresting people even days after that day of the agitation. Till now a total of 550 persons have been arrested in this connection,

Sanyal informed the division

Countering his argument, state's Advocate General (AG), S.N. Mukhopadhyay informed the bench that most of the people detained in the matter have been released at a later stage. "None has been arrested without any reason. Let the petitioner provide the names of those arrested and the state government will examine when and under what circumstances they were arrested," the AG argued. He also said that arrests were made on the basis of specific complaints and the law had

taken its own course in those

However, the BJP counsel informed the bench that the police have harassed a number of BJP supporters in the Bowbazar and Burrabazar areas in central Kolkata.

"They were not arrested on grounds of disturbing the law & order. Being a part of any protest rally is the constitutional right of the citizens of the country. At least the harassment should stop on the occasion of the forthcoming Durga Puja festival," the

BJP counsel argued. After hearing both sides, the division bench directed the state government to ensure that there are no further unnecessary arrests or harassments in the matter. The same bench will hear the matter again on October 31.

#### Selja, KC Venugopal front-runners for Cong Prez post after Gehlot snub

ongress sources on Tuesday said that Ashok Gehlot is being ruled out from the Congress' president post and it is likely that Kumari Selja could be considered for the top post while Rahul Gandhi's choice is said to be K.C. Venugopal. However, no final decision has been made yet and Senior Congress leader Kamal Nath who met Sonia Gandhi on Monday said that he doesn't want to become the party president and wants to continue to work for the party in Madhya Pradesh. "I want to remain in MP," Kamal Nath, a former Chief Minister of the state, said. The escalating drama in Rajasthan has made the Congress leadership think about a plan *B* for the top party post, for which Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot was being seen as a contender. Kamal Nath, who was one of the probables, has ruled out himself and now the party has limited options with Mukul Wasnik and Mallikarjun Kharge, but the time is running out as the election process has started and September 30 is the last day of nomination. The party was left red-faced as the Congress Legislature Party in Jaipur on Sunday to decide Gehlot's successor had to be called off after his supporting MLAs came out strongly against Sachin Pilot succeeding him. Congress interim President Sonia Gandhi has sought a detailed report from state in-charge Ajay Maken, following a meeting held at her residence on Monday with Maken, senior leader Mallikarjun Kharge and General Secretary, Organisation, K.C. Venugopal.

# HAS GEHLOT DEFIED GANDHIES OR THE MOVE ORCHESTRATED?



ontrary to the perception that Rajasthan chief minister Ashok Gehlot is working on the commands of the Gandhi family, it turned out to be a complete defiance of Gandhies by the Rajasthan chief minister. The person who has been taking vows in the name of Gandhies is embarrassing them like never before by any leader of the party. The way drama was played out in Rajasthan is unprecedented and would have its bearing in the future as well. However, various theories are doing rounds that Gandhies are still in command and Gehlot is dancing to their tunes which will reflect when dust is settled. But there are some contradictions in it as well.

Proposal to make Gehlot party president came from Sonia Gandhi herself after Rahul Gandhi declined to take up the responsibility and even after long persuasive attempts, he did not relent. The way Gehlot was posturing for Gandhis, he seems to have foxed them just to remain in the saddle in Rajasthan firmly as Rahut wanted Sachin to replace him. He was playing pro-Muslim politics to confuse them. But the moment Gandhies decided to replace him with Sachin Pilot, he somersaulted. However, there are various theories about the development in the Congress.

The first theory that is discussed in the Congress circle and also in media is that the Congress wants to send a perception in the public that despite every attempt made by the top brass of the Congress, no name could have been zeroes in on. So a drama is being enacted in Rajasthan with one of the most trusted lieutenants of Gandhies Ashok Gehlot taking care of every move. With this, the message will be that the only option remains with the Congress that a Gandhi, however unwilling he/she is, must take over reins of the party once again as infighting in the Congress started. And if Rahul Gandhi is unwilling then Priyanka Gandhi should take up the responsi-

Second story that is being discussed is that by bringing Gehlot to Delhi as party president and anointing Sachin Pilot as chief minister of the state, the long pending commitment of Rahul Gandhi with Pilot is fulfilled and Gehlot is also cut to size. But Gehlot is not ready to let



go CM's post at any cost and even by defying the venerable Gandhies, Over 90 MLAs of the Congress threatened to resign in support of Gehlot who refused to meet central observers. They put forth conditions before observers to meet them. This comes under indiscipline but no disciplinary actions were initiated. Because this was not possible without Gehlot asking them to do so, he used to say that his (Gehlot's) resignation letter is always with

Actually Gehlot was ready to become party president but was not ready to relinquish the post of chief minister of Rajasthan and certainly not for Sachin Pilot. But it is interesting to note that moves of Ashok Gehlot made every Hulk in the Congress a pigmy, so the Congress seems to have options of accepting his offers or be ready for further embarrassments. Now, the Congress leadership has started saying that Gehlot is not in the reckoning. Moreover, most of the leaders trying to salvage the situation are either junior to him

except a few or electorally irrelevant anywhere in the country. Gehlot knows the facts very well, so he did not hesitate to challenge their authorities

The other thing that makes Congress leadership and Gandhies vulnerable and Gehlot in the commanding situation is that of Rahul Gandhi's Bharat Jodo Yatra. It needs financial support and cadre support. If the crowd doesn't turn up well, the Gandhies and the Congress will be embarrassed furthermore. So it is very important for the Congress to not only keep Gehlot in good humor but also stop pricking him. This was the reason that Gehlot was dictating terms and the Congress conceded to his wishes.

This is a really very rare occasion when any Congress leader defies the Gandhies and sustains it as well. Gehlot is well aware that Gandhies failed to deliver in their home turf that is Uttar Pradesh. Vote share of the Congress has come down to 2.5

average 10 per cent in the previous elections despite Priyanka Gandhi leading the campaign in the state. Rahul Gandhi lost his pocket borough Amethi in 2019 Lok Sabha elections. The Congress base is shrinking with Rajasthan and Chhattisgarh being two states where the Congress is in power on its own and destabilizing party in these state is suicidal. The entire Congress of Punjab has joined the BJP and most of its important leaders too have either joined the party or are hobnobbing in Gujarat. After the demise of Ahmed Patel, the Gujarat Congress too is in tatters. No attempt is being made to wrest power in the state and if the infighting in the party continues, the anti-incumbency votes will shift to

The Rajasthan chief minister knows very well that the Congress president will have a bumpy ride ahead not only during Gujarat and Himachal Pradesh Assembly elections but also in Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan elections next year. So he has around a year as CM of Rajasthan where he is solidly in the saddle. Who will buy Ashok Gehlot's answers to the Central leadership that he is not in control of the behaviors of MLAs of Rajasthan who threatened to resign if Gehlot doesn't remain their CM. A wellplayed drama scripted by Gehlot is successful and he is out of Congress President's race.

Now with Gehlot ruled out as party president, the Congress is considering candidates like Mallikarjun Kharge and Digvijaya Singh. Former Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Kamal Nath's name has also come up but he met with Sonia Gandhi and requested her that he would prefer to focus on Madhya Pradesh where Assembly elections are next year. But amid all these developments, if the name of Priyanka Gandhi pops up which means Gandhies prevailed and Gehlot is still their man and move was orchestrated by them else Congress is heading towards hitting

### **UN CHIEF CALLS FOR ALL-OUT EFFORTS** TO ELIMINATE NUCLEAR THREAT

N Secretary-General Antonio Guterres has called for the use of every means to eliminate the nuclear threat.

Guterres made the appeal at a UN General Assembly high-level meeting to commemorate and promote the International Day for the Total Elimination of Nuclear Weapons, which falls on September 26.

We come together on this international day to speak with one voice. To stand in defence of our world -- and our future. And to reject the claim that nuclear disarmament is some impossible utopian dream," he said on Monday.

He noted that the elimination of nuclear weapons would be the greatest gift "we



could bestow on future generations".

In late August, the 10th Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons failed to result in the adoption of an outcome document.

# 15 KILLED IN RUSSIAN SCHOOL

Moscow: At least 15 people were killed, including 11 children, in a shooting at a news agency reported, citing the Russian Investigative Committee.

According to the committee, 22 children and two adults were injured in the attack at the No. 88 school located near the city administration building of Izhevsk, the capital city of western Russia's Udmurt Republic on Monday.

It was reported earlier that 13 people were killed and nearly 20 others wounded in the shooting, Xinhua news agency reported. Investigators identified the shooter as Artem Kazantsev, born in 1988, a native of Izhevsk and a graduate of the school. Kazantsev brought two pistols and a large number of cartridges with him and committed suicide after the attack, the committee said. The school has 982 students and 80 teachers, and they have been evacuated. Russian President Vladimir Putin expressed deep condolences for the tragedy, the Kremlin said in a statement.

The Governor of the Udmurt Republic declared three days of mourning beginning on Monday.

### Russia expels Japanese consul for espionage

A Jananese dinlomat based in Russia's far eastern city of Vladivostok is being expelled after being detained for espionage, the Russian Federal Security Service (FSB) announced.

A consul of the Consulate General of Japan in Vladivostok was "detained red-handed while receiving, for a money reward, information of limited distribution about the current aspects of Russia's cooperation

with one of the Asia-Pacific countries, including the impact of Western sanctions, on the economic situation in (Russia's) Primorsky territory," an FSB statement said on Monday.

The Minister Counselor of the Japanese Embassy in Moscow was summoned to the Russian Foreign Ministry on Monday and was



informed that the consul in question must leave Russia within 48 hours for activities incompatible with the status of a consular officer and detrimental to Russia's security interests, the Ministry said in a statement. The Russian Foreign Ministry has

lodged a strong protest over the incident to the Japanese side, Xinhua news agency reported.

#### **DEATH TOLL FROM B'DESH BOAT CAPSIZE REACHES 61**

**Dhaka:** The number of deaths due to a boat capsize in Bangladesh's Karatoya river increased to 61 on Tuesday, after 10 more bodies were recovered,

a senior police official said.

The official told Xinhua news agency said the bodies were recovered from several parts of the Karatoya river in the Panchagarh district, 468 km away from the capital

The search operation is still underway for the five to six people still missing, he said, adding the vessel has been dragged to the

SM Sirajul Huda, superintendent of Panchagarh District Police, earlier said the jam-packed boat, carrying some 100 passengers, overturned due to overloading and sank on Sunday afternoon.

Ferry and boat disasters are common in Bangladesh. Ferries are still a key means of transport in the South Asian country and most of them are often overcrowded.

### TYPHOON NORU KILLS 8 IN PHILIPPINES

uper typhoon Noru slammed Luzon island in the Philippines with heavy rainfall and winds over the weekend, leaving eight people dead and three others missing, a government agency said on Tuesday.

The National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council confirmed the deaths of five rescuers swept by a flash flood in Bulacan, a province north of Manila, a few hours after Noru made landfall on Sunday afternoon, reports Xinhua news agency.

The Council said it received reports of additional three typhoon-related deaths, one in Quezon province and two in Zambales province.

It did not provide details on how the three died.

The Council added that three more people remained missing in the Bicol region, southeast of Manila.

Noru exited the Philippines on Monday night after crossing the central Luzon region.

It is the 11th and the most powerful



cyclone hitting the Philippines this year. It destroyed crops, damaged houses, knocked down power transmission lines, and flooded several areas on cen-

tral Luzon island. The Philippines is one of the most disaster-prone countries globally, mainly due to its location in the Pacific Ring of Fire and Pacific typhoon belt.

On average, the archipelagic country experiences 20 typhoons yearly, some of which are intense and destructive.





#### Poor maintenance, inadequate signages & missing markings on road where Cyrus Mistry's car crashed

Poor maintenance, inadequate signages to mili quate signages to guide drivers, over two dozen median openings and missing road markings -- these are some of the findings of the road safety audit of the 70-km stretch between Mandor in Maharashtra and Achhad in Gujarat of NH-48, where industrialist Cyrus Mistry died in a car

The audit was carried out by a team of the International Road Federation (IRF).

The fatal car accident, which lead to the death of industrialist Cyrus Mistry and another cooccupant, occurred on this stretch on September 4.

The audit by the team, set up by the India chapter of the International Road Federation (IRF), has recommended immediate low-cost counter measures to prevent crashes. These include installation of speed limit signs specifying reduction in speed limit before diversions and bridges, warnings of "reduced carriageway" and against "overtaking", quick maintenance, cloproper markings to guide the



drivers."The audit was carried out barely a week after the fatal crash at Palghar that shook the country. IRF said the audit was conducted after consent from the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI). The report has been submitted to MoRTH and ANHAI for action," said K.K. Kapila, President, Emeritus, International Road Federation (IRF).

"The 70-km long section of NH-48 is a six-lane highway with divided carriageway, with the exception of the Surya River where Mistry's car met with the

"At this location, there is a twolane carriageway on the bridge (on LHS carriageway), and there is a separate carriageway through an existing narrow bridge, which is accessed on the old alignment, which is provided through an "unassuming divergence" from the running three-lane LHS carriageway a short distance of 75-100 metres before the bridge on the LHS carriageway of the new alignment," said Satish Parakh, President, IRF-India chapter.

### MVA GOVT'S STEMI SCHEME SAVES 6,000 RURAL FOLKS FROM HEART ATTACKS, DEATHS

unique artificial-intelligence powered diagnosis and cardiac care initiative of the previous Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) government screened over 2.50 lakh people and detected at least 6,000 heart attacks with a turnaround time of just 6 minutes, compared with the 'golden hour' of 90 minutes, officials said here on Tuesday.

First of its kind in India, the STEMI Maharashtra Programme is endorsed by the Centre's National Health Mission, and implemented in 12 districts since February 2021, in collaboration with Tricog Health Services Pvt. Ltd., Bengaluru.

"In India, the average wait time for patients with ongoing heart attacks is 360 minutes (six hours), a far cry from the golden hour of 90 minutes (one-and-half hour), resulting in high mortality rates. This programme detected

more than 6,000 heart attacks with a turnaround time of barely six minutes, allowing the victims to get timely treatment and saved lives," Tricog CEO Dr. Charit Bhograj told correspondent.

Since implementation, it has screened more than 250,000 people in rural areas, to detect heart ailments and other complications to enable timely medical attention and prevent them from becoming victims of cardiac problems, said Dr Bhograj.

Under the programme, the number of heart cases detected and treated are: Pune (998), Nashik (860), Ratnagiri (683), Thane (663), Nanded (615), Kolhapur (500), Nagpur (404), Aurangabad (373), Wardha (346), Solapur (343), Jalna (219), and Akola (140).

As per latest data, Maharashtra has witnessed an increase in cardiovascular diseases among men in 30-40 years and women in the 40-60 age group, while the WHO has estimated



that of the 15-30 lakh deaths per year in India, 35 per cent of victims are young adults.

The STEMI Maharashtra Programme was intended to combat this epidemic through an AI-powered advanced diagnosis and care programme which would gradually cover all the 36 districts in the state, to arrest premature deaths and disabilities due to heart problems, said a health department officer, requesting anonymity.

"A total of 145 primary health facilities, including rural Hospitals, sub-District hospitals, district hospitals were upgraded as spokes for STEMI detection and thrombolysis, and are linked with 38 hubs - as the nearest tertiary care facility equipped with a CATH LAB facility for treatment," said Dr Bhograj.

This helps rapid diagnosis of heart disease in all government centres in the state along with timely treatment by teams of cardiologists at the tertiary care facilities and help save valuable lives, he said.

The strategy adopted by Tricog was to spread awareness among patients with heart disease symptoms of chest pains, breathlessness, palpitations, among others, and approach the nearest government facility without delays.

Then followed a rapid detection using a cloud-connected 12 Lead ECG with 24-hour interpretation of the cases within a few minutes by medical experts, supported by AI and a digital platform for care coordination and analytics.The system of STEMI management and protocols created by the state Steering Committee comprising top cardiologists, administrators and experts with other agencies ensured the timely transfer and treatment of

Alec Baldwin could face charges for 'Rust' fatal shooting

ollywood actor Alec Baldwin may well potentially face charges in the fatal shooting that occurred last year on the sets of Spaghetti-western movie 'Rust', according to Santa Fe County District Attorney Mary Carmack-Altwies. During a New Mexico Board of Finance meeting held on September 20, Carmack-Altwies requested emergency funding in excess of \$635,000, reports a local magazine. The request for funding was to continue the investigation into the tragedy that took place on October 21 - when Baldwin, was holding the gun that discharged and killed 42-year-old cinematographer Halyna Hutchins and injured director Joel Souza. Baldwin has maintained that he did not pull the trigger. As per a video recording of their meeting seen by 'People', Carmack-Altwies shared, "We are within weeks, if not days, of receiving the final report from the sheriff's office." Carmack-Altwies further said that, while awaiting the final report, "it's become apparent that we will be potentially charging between one and four people with criminal charges, and each of those charges will probably include some variation of our homicide statute." In a letter to the New Mexico Board of Finance, obtained and published by 'Deadline', the district attorney's office stated, "One of the possible defendants is well-known movie actor Alec Baldwin," adding that the case "could require up to 4 separate jury trials." 'People' further states that on Monday, Baldwin's lawyer, Luke Nikas of Quinn Emanuel, said in a statement: "Some media reports today draw false conclusions based on a letter from the Santa Fe Dist. Attorney." "The DA has made clear that she has not received the sheriff's report or made any decisions about who, if anyone,

might be charged in this case," the statement continued.





# Germany and England draw in six-goal thriller, Italy beat Hungary to win group

Cup in less than two months, but both are still struggling to find their best form.

Germany's home defeat to Hungary on Friday buried their hopes of advancing as they only took one win from the six group matches -- a 5-2 victory over Italy

The four-time World Cup winners looked on course for victory at Wembley Stadium after goals from Ilkay Gundogan and Havertz had put them 2-0 in front after 67 minutes.

Manchester United defender Harry Maguire, who has been criticised for poor performances in recent club matches, has had full support from head coach Gareth Southgate and started for the Three Lions again, but his latest mistake may threaten his place in the team.

The 29-year-old centre-back lost the ball to Jamal Musiala. then brought down the teenager in the box to hand the visitors a

penalty, which was converted by Gundogan.

Maguire then lost his position in midfield 15 minutes later and allowed Chelsea forward Havertz to curl in a superb effort from the edge of the area.

Facing a possible third successive defeat, England showed great resilience, scoring three goals in 12 minutes to turn the game around.

Luke Shaw pulled one back in the 71st minute before substitute Mason Mount hit the equalizer five minutes later. Harry Kane then converted a penalty awarded by VAR in the 83rd minute to finish the incredible comeback.

But it was not the end --Havertz pounced on a fumble by England goalkeeper Nick Pope to equalise in the 87th minute. Bukayo Saka could have killed the match in stoppage time but his close-range attempt was saved by Germany keeper Marc-


