INDIAN-AMERICAN WINS OKAWA PRIZE FOR INNOVATIVE IMAGING TECHNIQUES

n Indian-origin Columbia University professor has been awarded Japan's prestigious Okawa Prize for his seminal work on computer vision and computational imaging. K. Nayar, the T.C. Chang Professor of Computer Science at Columbia Engineering, is being recognized for "the invention of innovative imaging techniques and their widespread use in digital photography and computer vision". "I am grateful to the Okawa Foundation for this honor," said Nayar, who directs Columbia's Computational Imaging and Vision Laboratory.

"Over the last three decades, I have had many close and productive collaborations with Japanese researchers and companies. These have enabled my laboratory to translate our results into imaging technologies that are currently being used in consumer devices and factory automation systems, Nayar said in a statement. Hailing from

Thiruvananthapuram, Nayar heads the Columbia Vision Laboratory (CAVE), which develops advanced computer vision systems. His work is motivated by applications in the fields of digital imaging, computer vision, computer graphics, robotics, and human-computer interfaces. Nayar's work has changed the way visual information is captured and used by both machines and humans.

WITH 600 VARIETIES OF ORCHIDS

Northeast's first ex-situ orchid conservatory ready in Arunachal

Appreciating the scientists at the centre for their efforts to turn the almost barren complex into a vibrant and green centre, Arunachal CM Pema Khandu said with the new Orchidarium, the centre is working towards conservation and propagation of highly-valued orchid species besides developing orchid-based entrepreneurship.

Tortheast Indias first ex-situ orchid conservatory has been established at Kimin in Arunachal Pradeshs Papum Pare district with financial support from the Department of Biotechnology (DBT) under the Union Ministry of Science and Technology.

The 600 sq mt orchid conservatory houses about 600 varieties of orchids. Ex-situ conservation involves maintenance and breeding of endangered plants and animals under partially or wholly controlled conditions in specific areas. It means conservation of selected plants and animals in selected areas outside their natural habitat.

AAP leader Raghav Chadha said that the BJP must fight the mayoral election themselves, what is the point of hiding behind an independent candidate like a coward?

"The BJP had announced that it will not contest the mayoral election, but is now fielding an independent candidate, who will be supported by all BJP councillors. It does not suit BJP to contest elections from the backdoor...," said Chadha addressing

Rajya Sabha MP Chadha said that the BJP should come forward and contest the election, the people of Delhi will decide who will be the mayor of MCD.

The public threw BJP out of Delhi's

NIA conducts raids in terror case related to banned Khalistani outfits

he National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Saturday conducted searches at 14 different locations in Punjab, Jammu and Kashmir and Delhi in connection with a terror related

The case relates to terror activities of chiefs of proscribed terrorist organisations, such as the Khalistan Liberation Force, Babbar Khalsa International and International Sikh Youth Federation, among others.

"Such activities include smuggling of arms, ammunition, explosives and IEDs across international borders for use by operatives of terror outfits and organised criminal gangs operating in various parts of the country for carrying out terrorist acts like explosions, targeted killings etc.," an NIA official



This case was registered suo-moto by the NIA on August 20 this year. During the searches coninating materials, including digital devices and documents, were seized by the NIA.

Arrested ISI spy in Bengal trapped by Pakistani agency through porn site: Police

uddu Kumar, a suspected ISI-spy, who was arrested by the Special Task Force (STF) from New Jalpaiguri in north Bengal on December 21, has informed the interrogating sleuths that he was trapped by the Pakistani intelligence agency through a pornographic website.

Kumar, an original resident of Champaran in Bihar, is currently under the custody of STF, whose sleuths are interrogating him to get additional information about his nexus.

State police sources said that during interrogation, Kumar had admitted to the police that during his days in Bihar, despite being married, he was keenly addicted to pornographic websites especially those having explicit Indian contents.

"As confessed by him, through one such websites, he got acquainted with a woman, who included him in a WhatsApp group reportedly meant for sharing pornographic content and videos. There he got slowly trapped and he shared the details of his identity documents like AADHAR card, Pan card and EPIC Card among others. Subsequently, he was blackmailed and forced into the task of gathering information about the different units of Indian Army in north Bengal and as per the



instructions of the ISI handlers, he came to north Bengal from Champaran," a state police official associated with the investigation process in the matter said. He has also confessed that these ISI handlers opened an online payment portal account through which he was made the payment. His task was mainly to collect information, pictures and videos of the important bases of the Indian Army in north Bengal like Sukna, Jalapaharr, Sevak and Bagdogra. He has also admitted that he used to send the information, pictures and video through WhatsApp and net calling was the medium of his interaction with the ISI handlers. On December 21, the STF arrested Kumar based on inputs sent to the state police by a central intelligence agency. To hoodwink the local people of New Jalpaiguri and Siliguri, he worked as the driver of a battery-operated Toto. He also rented a one-room apartment at a busy locality in Siliguri.

GREATER NOIDA SHO'S WIFE **BREAST-FEEDS INFANT FOUND IN** BUSHES

Noida: The wife of a Station House Officer in Greater Noida breast-fed a baby found inside bushes in the Knowledge Park area. The infant, wrapped in a cloth, was left in the cold by her parents in bushes near Sharda hospital on December

According to a senior police official, after receiving information about the baby, a police team rushed to the spot. "She was taken to the police station where the SHO's wife, Jyoti Singh, volunteered to breast-feed her. The baby was hungry and cold and we knew that the baby could not be fed anything other than breast milk," said the official.Police said that the baby girl is in stable condition now. Police teams are also scanning CCTV cameras in the area to identify the person who had aban-

Mathura court orders survey of Shahi Idgah from Jan 2

Mathura Agencies

Mathura district court on Saturday, ordered the survey of the Shahi Idgah mosque, which is said to be built on the birthplace of Lord Krishna, by the Archaeological Survey of India from January 2.

The court passed the order on a lawsuit filed by Vishnu Gupta of the Hindu Sena.

The report will be submitted on January 20.

The lawsuit is one of the many by Hindu outfits demanding the removal of the 17th century Shahi Idgah Masjid from the Katra Keshav Dev temple, claiming that the mosque has been built on the birthplace of Lord Krishna.

The Shahi Idgah mosque was reportedly built on Krishna Janmabhoomi on the orders of Mughal emperor Aurangzeb in 1669-70.

The civil court in Mathura had earlier dismissed the case saying it cannot be admitted under the Places of Worship



Act of 1991, which maintains the religious status of any place of worship as it was on August 15, 1947.

The only exception to the law was the Ayodhya temple-mosque case involving the 16th century Babri mosque, razed in 1992 by Hindu activists who believed it was built on the ruins of an ancient temple. The Supreme Court in 2019

handed over the mosque site to Hindus for a grand Ram temple and ordered alternative land for a mosque.

The petitioners argued in their suit that as devotees of Lord Krishna, they have a right to approach the court. They say they have the right to worship at the actual birthplace of Krishna.

The Akhil Bharat Hindu Mahasabha had earlier this month given a call for reciting Hanuman Chalisa inside the Shahi Masjid Idgah to mark the anniversary of the Babri Mosque demolition. One of the outfit's leaders was arrested and seven or eight were detained.

On February 19, 2021, a civil suit titled "Bhagwan Sri Krishna Virajman and Others Vs UP Sunni Central Waqf Board and Others" was filed before the court of the civil judge (senior division), Mathura, for removal of encroachment and structure illegally raised by the 'committee of management' of the Trust Masjid Idgah with the consent of the Sunni Central Board of Waqf.

ALL GOVT OFFICES IN KASHMIR TO HOIST NATIONAL FLAG ON R-DAY

Srinagar: All the government offices and institutions in the Valley have been directed to hoist the national flag on Republic Day by the Divisional Commissioner of Kashmir, Pandurang K. FAKE CALL CENTRE BUSTED IN DELHI, 6 HELD

T A **7**ith the nabbing of six persons, Delhi Police on Saturday claimed to have busted a fake call centre indulged in duping people on pretext of 20 per cent cashback return on online shopping from credit card in the national capital

Police said that Kundan Kumar and Babloo Kumar, both residents of Shakurpur area were arrested and four women callers were apprehended. According to Harendra K. Singh,

Deputy Commissioner of Police (Outer), on December 16, a case was registered after a complaint from Ekjot Kaur, a resident of Paschim Vihar East, was received at Cyber police station. Outer district.

'The complainant reported that she had received a call from a mobile number regarding the credit



card cashback scheme. The caller lured her stating a scheme of cashback of 20 per cent of amount spent for shopping on her credit card and told her that she would need to pay Rs 7.444 yearly or Rs 620 monthly for cashback condition," said the offi-

Later on, after inducing Kaur for credit card cashback benefits, a link she lost Rs 7,444 from her Axis Bank customer care, the complainant found that she has been cheated as no cashback facility is available on her card," stated the official.

"During investigation, the call detail records of the alleged numbers were obtained and analysed. The location of the mobile number was found near Sri Nagar in Delhi. A raid was conducted in the area and a fake call centre was found operating in the name of Aron Enterprises," said the official adding that Kundan and Babloo were arrested while four women callers

have been nabbed. Further, after a search on National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP), police also found seven more complaints related to cheating and connected to the same mobile


he Ghaziabad police have arrested a man for allegedly killing his live-in partner while they were on their way to Kullu in Himachal Pradesh seven

A police officer privy to investigation said that Raman had strangulated the woman while going towards Kullu and then threw her



body in a nearby forest area. The body of the deceased has been found from the the forest area, and further the probe is underway.

The case follows the shocking Mehrauli murder

case, wherein Aaftab Poonawalla killed his live-in partner Shraddha Walkar in May and then chopped her body into 35 pieces and dumped the body parts in a nearby forest area.

name figures in list of tampered OMR sheets Kolkata | Agencies

fresh political slugfest erupted in West Bengal on Saturday after the name of a Trinamool Congress councillor appeared in the list of 952 optical mark recognition (OMR) sheets published by the West Bengal School Service Commission (WBSSC), which were allegedly tampered with to accommodate ineligible candidates as teachers in state-

run schools. After the WBSSC published the full list as per the direction of the Calcutta High Court, it was found that one of the names in the list is that Kuheli Ghosh, the Trinamool councillor from Ward No. 18 of Rajpur-Sonarpur municipality in South 24 Parganas district. Ghosh is also a secondary teacher of history in Sonarpur Chowhati High School, which comes under the ward where she is the councillor. Her name is in the 474th position in the list of 952 tampered OMR sheets published by the WBSSC.

After her name was identified in the list, the opposition parties in the



state launched a scathing attack against the state government and the ruling Trinamool Congress.

Ghosh herself was reluctant to make any comment in the matter,

saying that since the matter is in court, it would be unwise for her to make any comment on it at this point of time CPI(M) central committee mem-

ber Sujan Chakraborty said the fresh revelation proves what massive irregularity had taken place in the recruitment process of teachers in the state under the current regime.

"This is not possible without endorsement from the highest political-administrative level of the state,' he said.

State BJP spokesman Samik Bhattacharya said that the current government has turned the recruitment process into a total farse and a medium for minting money for the ruling party leaders.

"More scandals will be tumble out of the closet in the days to come," he said. As per the records of the WBSSC, Ghosh joined Sonarpur Chowhati High School as a history teacher in January 2019 after clearing the recruitment examination and interview. Prior to that, she was a primary teacher at a state-run primary school.

Therefore, you are requested to direct all the concerned departments to ensure availability functional Life Support Equipments such as Ventilators, BipAp and SpO2 systems along with their consumables is there, said the let-

The Centre has also asked that Oxygen control rooms should be reinvigorated at States/UTs level for prompt resolutions of oxygen related issues and challenges.

On-boarding of all healthcare facilities utilizing oxygen to oDAS platform for daily oxygen demand and consumption be monitored for implementation, said Dr Agnani in the letter.

2017, are those individuals residing in the states of Assam, Jammu and Kashmir and Meghalaya; a non-resident as per the Income-tax Act, 1961; of the age of 80 years or more at any time during the previous year and a person not a citizen of India.A circular issued by the Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) on March 30 said once a PAN becomes inoperative, an individual shall

be liable to all the conse-

quences under the I-T Act and will have to suffer a number of implications.

The person shall not be able to file I-T return using the inoperative PAN; pending returns will not be processed; pending refunds cannot be issued to inoperative PANs; pending proceedings as in the case of defective returns cannot be completed once the PAN is inoperative and tax will be required to be deducted at a higher rate.

In Sikh faith, men wear turban and they do not shave off their beards or cut hair.

The Marine Corps previously denied all these requests, due to which the trio for years have remained poolees -- an individual who has already signed up to become a Marine but has

not yet left for the recruit training at boot camp.

Further, the Marine Corps argued that allowing Sikhs to wear religious beards would disrupt troop uniformity and appearance among the recruits, ultimately threatening national security

This despite other branches of the US military -- the US Army, Navy, Air Force and Coast Guard -- already accommodating the religious requirements of Sikhism.

MUSIC TEACHER BOOKED FOR SEXUALLY ABUSING 15-YEAR-OLD STUDENT

Indore: Police have registered a case against a 31-year-old music teacher for allegedly sexually abusing his teenage girl student in Indore city of Madhya Pradesh, an official said on Saturday. The incident occurred on Friday, he said. "As per the complaint lodged by

the 15-year-old girl, she went to the music teacher's house in Ayodhyapuri Colony around 3 pm on Friday to attend the class. However, he took her to a room on the ground floor instead of their classroom located on the second floor," Rau police station in-charge NS Raghuvanshi said. There, the accused started touching the girl inappropriately and held her hand, he said. "Scared, the girl rushed out of the room and ran towards her residence. After reaching home, she narrated it to her mother, who took her to the police station and lodged the complaint," he added. A case under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act was registered against the music teacher, he said.

TWO BOYS **DROWN IN RESERVOIR IN CHHATARPUR**

Chhatarpur: Two boys drowned in a reservoir in Madhya Pradesh's Chhatarpur district, police said on Saturday. The incident took place on Friday evening at a stop dam on Urmil river, under Banchhon police post, some 140 km from the district headquarters, police post in-charge Surendra Dwivedi said.

The boys, aged five and seven years, were playing in the vicinity and drowned in the

reservoir, he said. The bodies were fished out by the police and sent for post-mortem, the official said.

'Drunk' cop takes off uniform, throws it at onlookers, suspended

police constable in Madhya Pradesh's Harda district was suspended after a video purportedly showed him taking off his uniform and throwing it towards onlookers on a road, apparently in an inebriated condition, an official said. The video of the incident, which occurred on Friday evening. surfaced on social media.

"The constable, identified as Sushil Mandavi, was suspended after the video of his act emerged," Harda Superintendent of Police (SP) Manish Kumar Agrawal said.

The video shows the allegedly drunk police constable and a shirtless man arguing with each other on a road in Harda town with onlookers around them. During their argument, the constable sits on the road on his knees and starts removing his uniform.



Initially, he removes his shirt and throws it towards the onlookers and later also takes off his pair of pants and then continues to argue with the man.

SP Agrawal said that six months back, Mandavi had met with an accident in a drunken state and was advised to undergo counselling at that time.



MAN TRYING TO MEDIATE BETWEEN COUPLE, BEATEN TO DEATH BY HUSBAND

Jabalpur: A man was killed while trying to mediate between a couple in Madhya Pradesh's Jabalpur on Saturday. The incident pertains to Samad Pipariya village of Bargi police station area. A man named Bablu was having a dispute with his wife. Seeing the dispute escalate, Sunil, who was present there, tried to calm the situation down. However, this only angered Bablu and he started beating Sunil up with a stick. Sunil died on the spot due to severe blows from the stick. The accused Bablu along with his wife is said to be absconding from the village after the murder.

After getting the news of the incident, police reached the spot and sent the dead body to the Medical College Hospital, Jabalpur for postmortem. Police have registered a case and started searching for the accused

Bargi ASI Ramkaran Mishra said, "Injury marks were found on Sunil's head and back. At present, we are searching for the accused."

Bedi Lal, the father of the deceased Sunil Patel, said that his son works at a dairy. "Last night he had gone to the dairy for some work, where Bablu, who was living there, was arguing with his wife after getting drunk. The people of the village were also trying to mediate, seeing the dispute between husband and wife for a long time. The villagers later went to their respective homes, meanwhile Sunil went there and tried to talk to Bablu", Bedi Lal said.

FOUR KILLED AFTER CAR RAMS INTO TRUCK ON HIGHWAY IN BETUL

Betul: Four persons were killed when their car rammed into a truck on a highway in Madhya Pradesh's Betul district, police said on Saturday. The accident occurred on Bhopal-Nagpur Highway in Bhilai village, about 50 km from the district headquarters, around 12 am on Saturday, Multai police station in-charge Sunil Lata

Prima facie, it appears that the truck driver suddenly turned the vehicle to the left causing the car to ram into it, he said.

Two women were among three occupants who died on the spot, while the driver of the car died on the way to a hospital in Nagpur, he said.

Two men killed in the accident were railway employees, the official said, adding that a case has been registered and a manhunt has been launched for the absconding truck driver.

The visitors still require 100 more runs with six wickets in hand on a deteriorating pitch against Bangladesh to win the second Test at the Sher-e-Bangla National Cricket Stadium.

Bangladesh was reeling at 113/6 in their second innings. But Litton Das's counter-attacking 73 helped the hosts' get 118 runs off the last four wickets. He led a spirited fightback with crucial partnerships of 46 with Nurul Hasan, who made 31 and 60

with Taskin Ahmed, who was unbeaten on 31, as Bangladesh made 231 in 70.2 overs.

In defence of 145, Bangladesh's bowlers often attacked the stumps, were accurate with their line and length. The spinners hit the rough patches constantly and reaped rewards with persistent pressure as India's top four batters went on an ultra-defensive approach and lost their wickets in the process.

Bangladesh were given an early breakthrough by captain Shakib Al Hasan, who drew his Indian counterpart KL Rahul for a forward defence, but the thick outer edge was caught by Nurul Hasan behind.

Cheteshwar Pujara danced down the pitch to defend off Mehidy, but he

Warner hungry and eager to play red-ball cricket beyond his 100th Test

oing through his Tlongest sequence of innings without a hundred in the longest format of the game, opener David Warner says the drought is a distraction as he gets ready for

his 100th Test for Australia. The player has been going through difficult times, struggling for form and distracted by the controversy with Cricket Australia over overturning his captaincy ban after pulling out of the process, unhappy with the federation's handling of the process.

Warner's last three Tests have seen him make scores of 5, 48, 21 and 28 against the Windies, before 3 and 0 during the twoday Test at the Gabba against South Africa. That has seen his century drought extend to 29 innings, though he did manage a ton in his most recent ODI innings -- against England at the MCG last month. "Leading into the Perth Test, my mental health probably wasn't where I needed it to be at to be 100 per-

Stokes can replace M.S. Dhoni as captain at CSK: Scott Styris

ormer New Zealand cricketer Scott Styris sees the Chennai Super Kings' decision to buy England Test skipper and allrounder Ben Stokes in the Mini-Auction for the 2023 edition of the Indian Premier League (IPL) as an attempt to find a successor to skipper MS Dhoni.

Dhoni, who had relinquished captaincy in the 2022 edition but was forced to take back the reins as the team fared miserably under Ravindra Jadeja, will probably be leading the CSK for the last time this season as he wants to bid farewell in front

of home fans at Chennai. With the player four-time



IPL-winning skipper set to retire for the final time soon, CSK are desperately looking for someone to take charge of the team and Styris believes Stokes is that man.

In his comments during a post-auction programme on Jio Cinema, Styris suggested that Dhoni would straight away pass on the captaincy to Stokes. "I think so, I think he will be captain. We have seen MS Dhoni try and pass the captaincy on, he has not been playing cricket regularly in between the IPL. It's just an opportunity for MS Dhoni to pass the baton. I think yes, they will do it straight away. Ben Stokes will be captain,"

Match moved from Multan to Karachi due to poor weather conditions

he second and final Test between Pakistan and New Zealand, scheduled to start on January 3 in Multan, has been moved to Karachi -- and to January 2 -- because of poor weather conditions.

The deteriorating weather conditions in Karachi have disrupted flight operations and may also potentially result in the loss of playing hours. Severe fog has been forecast over Multan, resulting in talks between the Pakistan Cricket Board and New Zealand Cricket, before the Test was moved out of the venue.

"The Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) and New Zealand Cricket have mutually agreed to shift the second Test in Multan to Karachi due to deteriorating weather conditions, which have already disrupted flight operations and may also potentially result in the loss of playing hours," PCB said in a state-

There is also a change in dates with the boards agreeing to move the second Test and the three ODIs forward by a day. The second Test will now commence on 2 January instead of 3 January.
