REFRAIN FROM UNNECESSARY REMARKS ON MOVIES': PM MODI TELLS BJP LEADERS AMID PATHAAN ROW

QUIT BOYCOTT GANG

rime Minister Narendra Modi asked Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leaders to refrain from making unnecessary comments on movies as they put the party's development agenda on the back-burner,

The PM made the comment while addressing the party workers on the second and final day of BJP's National Executive Meeting in Delhi on 18 January. PM Modi said that while everyone in the party works hard, some people make some comments on a movie and the entire narrative changes. PM's diktat to the BJP workers came amid growing calls to ban Shah Rukh Khan and Deepika Padukone-starrer 'Pathaan', which faced ire from several BJP leaders including Narottam Mishra and Ram Kadam. BJP leaders opposed Pathaan

BJP MLA Ram Kadam stated that no film insulting Hindutva will be tolerated. He said Hindu organisations, including its saints, and "crores of people" have strongly protested against the film on social media. Ram Kadam further said 'JNU Dharis' are aiming to insult the 'Janeu Dharis' and threatened that they will not allow any anti-Hindu film to release in the State

Madhya Pradesh Home Minister Narottam Mishra had also objected to Padukone's costume in the song of "Pathaan" and also frowned upon the colour of the attire of Padukone and lead actor Shah Rukh Khan, calling for its "rectification". He warned that if the objectionable scenes were not deleted then a ban on the film would be worth considering.

Madhya Pradesh Assembly speaker Girish Gautam had lashed out at Shah Rukh Khan and said that he should watch the film with his daughter. Gautam even challenged the actor to make a similar film




PATHAAN SEES INDIA AS HIS MOTHER: SRK

SC reserves verdict on Delhi-Centre row over control of services

five-judge bench of the Supreme Court on Wednesday allowed the Centre to file additional submissions seeking reference of the Delhi-Centre dispute over control of services to a larger bench.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, representing the Centre, submitted before a five-judge bench headed by Chief Justice D.Y. Chandrachud, "I have filed an application for reference". The Chief Justice replied, "We did not hear arguments on reference. It was never argued, now we are in rejoinder...". Mehta pressed that reference is needed and added that they do not want to be remembered in history for "handling over capital to complete anarchy".

The bench - also comprising justices M.R Shah, Krishna Murari, Hima Kohli, and P.S. Narasimha - reserved the judgment after hearing Mehta and

During the hearing, the top court said that reference to a larger bench has to be argued at the outset and pointed out that hearing in the case is nearing end. Senior advocate Singhvi, representing the Delhi government, opposed Mehta's submissions. Mehta argued that when he filed the application seeking reference to the larger bench Delhi government opposed and the court told him that it can be argued during submissions.

"Reference is essentially on the ground that contours of federalism between Union and Union Territory require relook. It is covered in my arguments", said Mehta.

templated suicide. "Adhyaksh (WFI President) and a few coaches in the national camp have sexually exploited female wrestlers,' she said. "No one takes



responsibility for injuries. They talk of banning wrestlers from nationals. The WFI President called me khota sikka (useless). I want-

ed to commit suicide. "I've openly said it today, I don't know if I will be alive tomorrow. We have requested many times to move the camp away from Lucknow. Why does it happen only there? by investors in railways' assets, the government is bullish on pushing them and in the forthcoming Union Budget, it is likely to set a target, albeit a reasonable one, for monetisation of railways assets, the sources said.

Under asset monetisation, the government transfers revenue rights to private parties for a specified transaction period in return for a revenue share and commitment of investments in the assets.

The assets are monetised through models like Public Private Partnership (PPP) - Operate Maintain Transfer (OMT), Toll Operate Transfer (TOT), and Operations, Maintenance and Development (OMD).

Under monetisation, the government does not sell assets, but leases them for a certain period for redevelopment and operations by a private entity, while continuing to retain their ownership.

'Hitting cops with slipper'

MP BJP LEADERS FIGURING IN **HEADLINES FOR WRONG REASONS**

adhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan took to Twitter to express anguish over the abusive video against him and family at a recent Karni Sena protest in Bhopal, and said he has "no grudge against anyone', but leaders of his BJP, on the other hand, are making headlines for using abusive language and insulting public servants publicly.

The latest incident was reported from Satna district, where a local BJP leader was seen hitting a policeman with slippers, as per a video on on social media. As per the reports, Chitrakoot police (under Satna district) had received information about illegal mining at village, and therefore, a team along with revenue officials reached the spot.

Upon reaching the village, the police team spotted a few people performing illegal mining and when they tried to stop them, locals started abusing the police team. After a few minutes, BJP leader Sadhna Patel, who also happens to be the Municipal Council president of Satna



started abusing and she beat up police personnel with slippers. Some of her supporters were also

seen arguing with the police officers, one of whom snapped back, asking, "Do you want us to take you to the police station? We will begin our investigation from there.'

However, Patel was not arrested even then for assaulting a govern-

ment official. On Wednesday. reporter sought a reply on this issue, a senior police official in Satna said: "They had no information about the case against her in Chitrakoot."

However, a revenue official said that a case has been registered against Sadhna Patel and nine other people at a local police station. BJP MLA from Maihar constituen-

Tripathi, around two months back, had claimed that illegal mining has been operating in the area. Tripathi had alleged that illegal mining was happening with involvement of a strong nexus of local politicians and revenue officials. He had also written to Chief Minister Chouhan regarding the same. Now, the district revenue department and the police too have accepted that illegal mining was happening in the district.

Before this slipper incident, Union Minister and senior tribal leader Faggan Singh Kulaste used a highly abusive word, while slamming the erstwhile Kamal Nath-led Congress government's 15 months period in MP. Kulaste made the abusive statement while talking to journalists on camera during a public program in his native Mandla district on Sunday.

Similarly, another senior BJP leader and former minister, Gaurishankar Bisen, who is now the state OBC Welfare Commission head, with a cabinet minister's status, was caught on camera, addressing the local RTO in abusive language at a public hearing in Lalbarra police station of his native Balaghat district.

According to a report published in The Times of India, one of the bike-borne men raped her. The incident took place in the Sukhi Sewania police station area. The accused took the girl to an isolated place and allegedly raped her. The girl's family started searching for her when she did not return home. They found her at the spot where she was allegedly raped. The girl then revealed her ordeal to her family members. They approached the police and lodged a complaint. After receiving the complaint, the police swung into action and arrested the prime accused. He has been identified as 21vear-old Anku Khushwaha, Meanwhile, Khushwaha's aide Tikaram is still absconding. Both the accused are natives of Vidisha district. They had reportedly come to attend



the birthday party at the same house where the girl had gone. As per the police, Khushwaha raped the girl, while his friend acted as a guard. The police have initiated an investigation into the matter. A manhunt operation has been launched to nab the absconding accused.

Meanwhile, in another incident, a six-yearold girl was murdered in Delhi by her neighbour on January 12. The incident took place in the Kapashera area. The body of the girl was reportedly found in a drain the next day in the morning. It is still not clear whether the minor was sexually assaulted. The police

Man booked for duping six on pretext of selling flat

he Jahangirabad police of Bhopal have registered a case of fraud against a man on the pretext of duping six people of Rs 1.25 lakh in total, on the pretext of selling them flats under the Pradhanmantri Aawas Yojana, the police said on Wednesday. The police added that the accused is a listed criminal, who has several cases registered against him at Kotwali police station. Jahangirabad police station in-charge, Shahwaz Khan said that the accused has been identified as Zeeshan Rehman, who is a listed crim-



against him under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC). Complainant Rishabh Sen, told the police that Rehman had approached him in August 2022, claiming that he can provide him and five of his friends an accommodation in the new building under construction at Barkhedi, under the PM Aawas Yojana.

Sen and his friends agreed, after which Rehman demanded a sum of Rs 25 thousand from each of them. After Sen and his friends paid him the amount, he told them to wait for some time.

When Sen and his friends received no update in this regard, they reached the construction site on Tuesday, where they learnt that the building is under the supervision of Bhopal Development Authority (BDA) and carries no provision under PM Aawas Yojana. Realising that they had been duped, all six of them approached the police, who registered a complaint against the accused.

Jabalpur's Bargi on Wednesday morning. Two of the labourers died on the spot while the third is in a critical condition. The accident happened in Manegaon village of Bargi where a retaining wall for crusher was being constructed. In this accident, labourers Narayan Kol and Dashrath Barkade died on the spot while another labourer Girdhari Lal was seriously injured. After getting the news of the accident, the people present around the spot informed the police and an attempt was made to evacuate the labourers buried under the debris.

By the time the labourers were pulled out, two of them had already died. Locals admitted a seriously injured Girdharilal to Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical College Hospital for treat-

Bargi TI Ritesh Pandey said, "We have



conducted the post-mortem of the dead bodies and have taken the whole matter under investigation. If anyone is found responsible for the incident, strict action will be taken against them."

Notably, this is not the first such case in the Bargi assembly. Earlier as well, many incidents of illegal mining through crushers have been reported in the area

which have also claimed lives of labourers. But, the administration has not paid heed to these accidents

According to the villagers, illegal explosions are carried out in crushers to break stones, due to which cracks have started appearing in the walls of people's houses, which is now causing worries for the locals.

HOW INDOOR AIR POLLUTION IS 5 TIMES WORSE THAN OUTDOORS

s Delhi-NCR reels under massive air pollution after Diwali every year, leaving people with respiratory illnesses gasping for fresh air, experts on Tuesday said that as most people spend winter days inside and even though the indoor air quality may appear to be better than outdoor air quality, it can be up to five times worse. The indoor and outdoor air pollution are often treated as two separate entities but outdoor pollutants, such as vehicle exhaust fumes, pollen and mould spores, can also enter our indoor spaces. The main cause behind indoor air pollution is known to be gases or particles released into the air, substances like building materials, tobacco smoke, wood-burning stoves cause indoor pollution. Once inside, they can react with indoor pollutants, creating a complex cocktail of dirty air. Furniture and carpets can also emit formaldehyde and flame retardants that accumulate in the air, while emissions from cooking appliances, such as ovens and stoves, may contain a range of substances that deteriorate indoor air quality. According to a report in the Indian Journal of Community Medicine, statistics suggest that in developing countries, health impacts of indoor air pollution far outweigh those of outdoor air pollution. Around 4.2 million people die prematurely due to indoor air pollution, according to the World Health Organisation (WHO). Lee said that their purifiers make the invisible visible, helping users to understand the types of pollution they are exposed to on a daily basis and giving peace of mind that these pollutants are being captured and that they are breathing clean air indoors. The HEPA+Carbon filter removes 99.95 per cent of pollutants as small as 0.1 microns such as allergens, bacteria, pollen and mould spores and harmful gases.

Meghalaya, Tripura Assembly polls will be litmus test for Trinamool Congress

his election in two of the three northeastern states - Meghalaya, Tripura and Nagaland will prove to be a litmus test for Trinamool Congress (TMC), headed by West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee.

TMC leader and party's Rajya Sabha member Sushmita Dev said that her party would field candidates in Meghalaya and Tripura and would not contest in Nagaland.

The TMC is the first party in Meghalaya which declared their candidates for 52 of the total of 60 seats.

Twelve MLAs, led by former Chief Minister Mukul Sangma (2010-2018), who had won in the 2018 Assembly election as Congress nominees joined the TMC in November 2021, making the West Bengal-based party the main opposition in the northeastern state

However, weeks before the announcement of Assembly elections, two TMC MLAs switching loyalty quitting the Assembly recently joined the ruling National People's Party (NPP) and another joined the BJP.

With three MLAs leaving the Trinamool, the party's strength in the 60-member Assembly has come down to nine now.

However, the TMC leaders in Meghalaya claimed that thousands of NPP and other party supporters, including some leaders joined their party.

To woo the electorate, the TMC has promised to roll out the Meghalaya Financial Inclusion for Women Empowerment (MFI WE) scheme that would provide assured monthly income support of Rs 1,000 per woman per household in the state, if the party is voted to power in the forthcoming Assembly polls, expected to be held by the end of February.

The MFI WE, also called 'WE Card', was announced by TMC supremo Mamata Banerjee in Shillong on December 13, sparking a controversy in the state.

The BJP has announced to lodge a complaint with the Election Commission against the TMC for its promise to implement an income support scheme.

State Trinamool Vice-President, George B. Lyngdoh said that opposing 'WE Card' exposes BJP's "anti-poor" politics, claiming that two lakh families have already registered for the

BJP's Meghalaya unit Chief Ernest Mawrie said: "The Trinamool did not disclose how it



will raise funds for the scheme. Such a scheme should be seen as a corrupt and unethical practice under the sections of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, as its intent is nothing but to bribe voters."

Claiming that the 'WE Card' scheme failed in West Bengal, the BJP leader accused the Trinamool of making false promises since it does not have any development agenda.

After TMC was founded in 1998, it had set up bases in Tripura, Manipur and Assam but they could not maintain the political tempo in these states

There were seven MLAs of other parties that once joined the TMC but eventually, they quit one by one.

Former Tripura Chief Minister late Sudhir Majumder, incumbent Tripura Assembly Speaker and former Congress leader Ratan Chakraborty, Ashish Saha, Subal Bhowmik and others went to TMC in 1998 and most of them returned to Congress in 2001-2002. Majumder contested in the West Lok Sabha Constituency in 1999 with TMC ticket and secured second position.

Present lone Congress MLA in Tripura Sudip Roy Barman, six other MLAs and many leaders quit the Congress in 2016 and joined TMC and next year (2017) they joined the BJP. Roy Barman, also a former Minister, quit BJP early last year and was re-elected to the Assembly in last year's June by-elections as a Congress nominee.

After the TMC started its organisational work in the third phase in Tripura in early 2021, it had been searching for a candidate for the party's president post in the state and finally appointed Subal Bhowmik, a former Congress MLA and BJP leader, in April 2022.

But due to internal feud, the TMC removed Bhowmik from

the post on August 24, 2022, and appointed former Tripura Congress President and veteran lawyer Pijush Kanti Biswas as President of party's Tripura unit on December 11 last year.

Within a week after Ripun Bora, a former Assam state Congress President and former Rajya Sabha member joined the TMC in April 2022, party supremo Mamata Banerjee had appointed him as the President of Assam unit.

Bora along with his wife and former Congress MLA Monika Bora and son and many Congressmen also joined the TMC.

TMC leader and party's Rajya Sabha member Sushmita Dev claimed that her party would form the government in Meghalaya after the Assembly elections in February "mainly because of the allegations against Chief Minister Conrad K. Sangma-led Meghalaya Democratic Alliance (MDA) government and also since the Congress is almost 'inactive' in the state.'

The MDA government has done nothing for the people of Meghalaya, and the Congress, which once ruled the state and was the main Opposition party, is now "non-existent" in the hill state, Dev, a former All India Mahila Congress Chief, told correspodent.

She alleged that except for the atrocities and terror against the Opposition parties' workers, leaders and supporters, the BJP also

did nothing in Tripura "People have also realised that they (BJP) gave false promises before the 2018 Assembly

polls," Dev said, adding that the Congress and Left tie-up did not work in West Bengal and there is factionalism over the alliance. "If the Congress and CPI-M forge an

alliance, there would be further erosion among the Congress rank and file. Grassroots workers of Congress would not accept the Congress-CPI-M alliance as the Left cadres earlier unleashed atrocities on the Congress workers." she said.

Claiming that the people would not vote for the BJP, Dev said: "Trinamool Congress, therefore, is the only alternative that could form the government after the Assembly elections in Tripura."

She refused to make any comments about the party's possible alliance with TIPRA (Tipraha Indigenous Progressive Regional Alliance) headed by former royal scion Pradyot Bikram Manikya Deb Barman.

he three main figures in Ukraine's interior ministry have been killed in a helicopter crash beside a nursery in an eastern suburb of the capital Kiev.

Interior Minister Denys Monastyrsky, 42, died alongside his first deputy minister and state secretary, BBC reported.

Nine people were killed

when the helicopter came down in Brovary and another nine died on the ground, including three children. Monastyrsky is the highest profile Ukrainian casualty since the war began,

BBC reported. The deputy head of Ukraine's presidential office, Kyrylo Tymoshenko, said the minister had been en route to a war "hot spot" when his helicopter went

There is no indication the crash was anything other than an accident, although witnesses said Russia's war

was to blame for the disaster.

"It was very foggy and there was no electricity, and when there's no electricity there are no lights on the buildings, local resident Volodymyr told the BBC. The 42-year-old interior minister was

a prominent member of President Volodymy Zelensky's cabinet. He played a key role in updating the public on casualties caused by Russian missile strikes since Ukraine was invaded.

Ukrainian reports said that those on board the helicopter included six ministry officials and three crew.

7.3-MAGNITUDE **EARTHQUAKE** HITS PHILIPPINES

Manila: An offshore earthquake with a preliminary magnitude of 7.3 jolted the southern Wednesday, authorities said, adding there were no reports of damages or casualties yet.

The authorities said the quake, which occurred at 2.06 p.m., hit at a depth of 64 km, about 352 km southeast of Sarangani town in Davao Occidental province, reports Xinhua news agency

The tectonic quake will trigger aftershocks and cause damage and temblor was also felt in many areas in Mindanao, the Philippines' second largest island.

The Philippines has frequent seismic activities due to its location along the Pacific "Ring of Fire".

ussia has expanded its entry ban list of EU citresponse to the EU's ninth package of sanctions against Moscow, the Russian Foreign Ministry said.

"In response to the hostile actions of the EU, Russia expanded the list of representatives from European institutions and EU member states who are prohibited from entering Russian territory," the Ministry added in a statement on Tuesday.

According to the statement, officials from EU law enforcement agencies involved in providing military assistance to Ukraine's armed forces, European government and commercial structures that supply military equipment to Ukraine, and EU citizens engaged in promoting anti-Russian sen-



timent, as well as individual members of the European Parliament, have been included in the expanded list, Xinhua news agency reported. "The EU is continuing to pressure Russia through its unilateral restrictive measures," the statement said, calling the latest

mate". The EU adopted the ninth package of sanctions against Russia on December 16. It said the sanctions were meant to further increase collective pressure on Russia to end its military operation and withdraw its troops from Ukraine.

4 generations of a family killed in 'cartel like execution' in California

Islamabad | Agencies

San Francisco: Four generations of a family were killed in what authorities have described as a "cartel like execution" at a private residence in California which was raided by police last week for drug-related activity, the media reported.The victims have been identified as Rosa Parraz (72), Eladio Parraz Jr (52), Jennifer Analla (50), Marcos Parraz (19), Elyssa Parraz (16) and Nycholas Parraz (10 months), reports the BBC.

The house is located in Goshen, Tulare County. Addressing the media on Tuesday,

Tulare County Sheriff Mike Boudreaux did not provide the names of the suspects, saying that it was due to the possibility that the killers were watching in order to avoid capture, but revealed that much was already known to authorities about the tragedy. Police had searched the residence just

last week and found stashes of marijuana and methamphetamines, he said. "None of this was by accident. It was




deliberate, intentional and horrific," the BBC quoted the Sheriff as saying. The FBI's San Francisco office is

assisting in the investigation, and a \$10,000 reward is being offered for information leading to an arrest.

Police are monitoring the Mexico and Canada border for the suspects, the Sheriff said, adding that the "very insecure border" has allowed Mexican drug cartel activity to grow in the central California area in recent years.

He said that the killings appear "similar to high-ranking gang executions, and the style of execution they commit", because the victims were "shot in places where a shooter knew that quick death would occur".

Dharavi revamp figures in Davos, CM Police bans use of drones, says it's 'eco-friendly development'

aharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde raised the issue of the proposed makeover of Dharavi considered among the world's worst evesore slums before a dazzling global audience of influencers in the cool climes of Davos, terming it as an 'environment-friendly' development

Addressing the Congress Centre at the ongoing World Economic Forum (WEF)-2023 on Tuesday evening in Switzerland, Shinde said that although Mumbai has the biggest natural forest, it is also home to the world's largest slum, the Dharavi, literally meaning 'quicksand', in the south-central part.

"In order to make Mumbai slumfree, we are implementing the largest public-private-partnership (PPP) real estate program of slum redevelopment. We are providing free homes of 300 sq. feet to each slum-dweller," informed Shinde.

He termed it as the biggest pro-



gram to rehabilitate around 56,000 families which will help reduce pollution and other environmental sideeffects.Through slum redevelopment, Shinde claimed that the government has succeeded in saving more than 800 hectares of mangroves dotting the country's commercial capital.

Speaking on the viability of the mega-project, the Chief Minister said nectivity and clean cities' to lessen the impact on the changing global weather. "We are trying to reduce carbon

emissions by increasing the forest cover, solid waste management, promoting agreen' wind and solar energy, and providing climate education at the school levels. If sustainable development is desired, PPP is necessary and Maharashtra is already leading in it," Shinde asserted.

It further said "no drone, para-gliders, and remote control microlight aircraft flying activities to be allowed in the jurisdiction of BKC police station, Andheri police station, Meghwadi police station and Jogeshwari police station."

When contacted, a senior Mumbai Police official confirmed about the order being issued.The order said, "The order shall remain in force with effect from 00 01 hours of January 19 till 24.00 hours of January 19. Any person

"A probe report ordered by me as the chief minister in

"Once we construct concrete roads, they will remain for 40 years," Fadnavis added. The purported fraudulent documents came to light during a scrutiny of the papers submitted by Faraz and his wife Hamleen - who is reportedly a French national - conducted by the Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRO), which informed the Kurla police station.

Based on this, the police late on Tuesday lodged an FIR against Faraz Malik



and his second wife Hamleen Malik under various sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and the Foreigners Act, pertaining to cheating, forgery, etc. No arrests have been made so far and a detailed probe is currently underway into the matter, officials said.

ikas Walkar, father of Shraddha Walkar who was murdered allegedly by her live-in partner Aaftab Poonawala, met Mira Bhayandar-Vasai Virar police chief Madhukar Pandey and demanded action against the policemen who apparently did not act swiftly on two complaints.

Pandey has assured action against the erring officials, Walkar told reporters outside the MBVV police commissioner's office at Vasai in Maharashtra's Palghar district on Tuesday. This was the second meeting between the two. According to Walkar, Shraddha had filed a com-



plaint with the Tulinj police in 2020 accusing Poonawala of abusing and assaulting her, while he himself had approached the Manikpur police after his daughter went

missing last year. Both police stations, which come under the jurisdiction of the MBVV, did not act on the complaints quickly, he had alleged earlier. Poonawala allegedly stran-

gled Shraddha and cut her body into 35 pieces which he kept in a fridge at his residence in Mehrauli in south Delhi in May last year, before dumping them across the city over several days. He was arrested in Delhi in November. A deputy commissioner of police from Vasai is carrying out a probe into the allegations of dereliction of duties, said Walkar on Tuesday. He was also apprised of the formation of a special investigation team (SIT) in the case.

WOMAN JAILED FOR FORCING WOMEN INTO PROSTITUTION

Thane: A court in Maharashtra's Thane district has sentenced a 39-year-old woman to three years rigorous imprisonment for forcing women into flesh trade. In the order passed yesterday, Special Judge V V Virkar pronounced the accused guilty under provisions of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act and imposed a fine of Rs 2,000 on her.

The woman was residing in Turbhe area of Navi Mumbai Township in Thane district.

Special Public Prosecutor Rekha Hiwrale told the court that the accused used her residence in Turbhe for prostitution and pushed women and minor girls into it.On May 30, 2018, a team of the Navi Mumbai police's anti-human trafficking cell raided the premises and found a woman being forced into flesh trade. The woman was rescued and the accused was arrested. Twelve prosecution witnesses were examined to prove the charges against the accused, Hiwrale said. The judge in her order said the prosecution has successfully proved the charges against the accused, who needs to be convicted. Another woman accused in the case was given the benefit of doubt and the court acquitted her of all the charges.

Maha is facing shortage of 1crore eggs per day: official

aharashtra is facing a shortage of one crore eggs per day and the animal husbandry department have chalked out a scheme to increase its production in the state, a senior official has said.

More than 2.25 crore eggs are consumed in Maharashtra per

The state has a capacity to produce 1 to 1.25 crore eggs per day and the department has been chalking out a plan to meet the need, animal husbandry department's additional commissioner Dr Dhananjay Parkale said on Tuesday.

Currently, eggs are procured from Karnataka, Telangana and Tamil Nadu to overcome the shortage, he said.

"The animal husbandry department plans to give 50 White Leghorn chickens at a subsidised



rate of Rs 21,000 along with 1,000 cages to each district in an attempt to increase the production," the official said. The department has sent the proposal to the state government for further sanctions, he added. In Aurangabad, the price of eggs has increased in the last two months.

"As on date, the price of 100 eggs in Aurangabad is Rs 575. The prices have been above Rs 500 (100 eggs) since more than two months," wholesaler Abdul Wahid Shah said.

Metro Line 2A completion was delayed, exposed by RTI; contractors fined

ith so much delay in completion of metro Line 2A, a new RTI has revealed that a penalty of only Rs 36 lakh has been levied on various contractors under metro 2A for

A Right to Information query has revealed that the MMRDA has levied a fine of Rs 36 lakh on various contractors for delay of work by 36 months. The much-awaited Metro 2A from Dahisar East to Andheri West will be inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on

RTI activist Anil Galgali, who had sought information from the MMRDA about the current status of the metro work and the penal action imposed on the contractors, has been informed by Delhi Metro Railway Corporation that the deadline has been extended by 36 months and only 36 lakhs penalty has been imposed on the contractors for



Galgali said that the Metro 2A service from Dahisar East to Andheri West was scheduled to start on December 31, 2019, but the first phase from Dahisar East to Dahanukar Wadi was started on April 2, 2022. The second phase was completed in January 2023.

"Overall, there was a delay of 36 months. Penalties were imposed in case of safety violations in civil works and various safety improvements were taken up on the site. But the information was not given. A fine of 36 lakh has been levied for delay in electrical work. A fine of Rs 4.44 lakh was imposed on one contractor, Rs 1.50 lakh on another, Rs 1.53 lakh on yet another and also a major fine of Rs 28.54 lakh on an international contractor," he said.

"I heard, like, a flagpole sound. I literally heard, 'We're losing the light.' I heard, 'Action.' And I woke up at Bellevue (Hospital)," Chenoweth recalled. BRACEWELL'S TON IN VAIN AS INDIA WIN TO LEAD SERIES BY 1-0

ew Zealand off-spin all-rounder Michael Bracewell produced a stunning counter-attack through a 78-ball 140 but his fightback went in vain as India won by 12 runs in the first ODI to take a 1-0 lead in the three-match series at the Rajiv Gandhi International Stadium, here on Wednesday.

After Shubman Gill produced a magnificent display of batsmanship to make 208 off 149 balls, laced with 19 fours and nine sixes, India made a massive 349/8, New Zealand were in trouble at 131/6.

Bracewell, who hit 12 fours and ten sixes in his 78-ball knock, took charge of the chase and added 162 off just 102 balls for the seventh wicket with Mitchell Santner, who made 57 off 45 balls.

India were put into massive pressure and it needed wickets from local lad Mohammed Siraj, who took 4/46, apart from Hardik Pandya and Shardul Thakur taking out a wicket each at the end to give the hosts' 1-0 lead in three-match series.

Bracewell brought up his century in 58 balls with a six smoked cleanly over long-on off Shami in the 43rd over. Santner crunched three boundaries off fast bowlers to get his fifty. Siraj brought India back in the match by having Santner miscue pull to deep mid-wicket and on the very next ball, got one to nip back in to rattle Henry Shipley's stumps in the 46th over. But Bracewell was standing



tall. Hardik kept hopes of an Indian win high by getting Lockie Ferguson to hole out to longoff in the 49th over, conceding just four runs. With 20 needed off the final over, Bracewell hammered a short ball from Shardul over wide long-on for six before conceding a wide. Shardul finished things for India by trapping Bracewell plumb lbw with a dipping yorker. As DRS confirmed the ball hitting the stumps, India took a sigh of relief. Chasing 350 was always going to be an uphill task for New Zealand. Devon Conway and Finn Allen got going with a couple of boundaries. Siraj, provided the breakthrough by having Conway pull a short ball to fine leg. Shardul took out a dangerous Allen with a short ball pulled

straight to deep mid-wicket.Kuldeep took out Daryl Mitchell with the ball spinning in and trapping the right-hander lbw in his crease.Some tight, disciplined bowling from both ends and asking rate climbing meant New Zealand continued to crumble.

SHUBMAN GILL BECOMES FASTEST INDIAN CRICKETER TO SCORE 1000 ODI RUNS

Hyderabad | Right-handed opener Shubman Gill on Wednesday became the fastest Indian to record 1000 ODI runs during Indias ongoing ODI series opener against New Zealand at the Rajiv Gandhi International Stadium. Gill reached the 1000-run mark when he reached 106 in his 19th ODI innings. Through his stroke-filled knock, he also notched up back-to-back centuries in the format, after hitting 97-ball 116 against Sri Lanka in the third ODI at Greenfield International Stadium in Thiruvananthapuram. The righthander batter overtook Virat Kohli and Shikhar Dhawan, who jointly held the previous record at 24 innings to become the fastest Indian and the joint-second fastest ever to 1000 runs mark in ODIs. He equalled Pakistan opener Iman-ul-Haq for breaching the 1000run mark in 19 innings while missing out on another Pakistan opener Fakhar Zaman's record of fastest to 1000 ODI runs in 18 innings. Gill's third ODI century in 19 innings came off just 87 balls, and among Indian cricketers, only Shikhar Dhawan (17) had reached the third hundred in 50 over cricket in fewer innings than him. He is currently leading India's innings against New Zealand with his sublime knock.




