# INDIA TOP COUNTRY IN AI SKILL PENETRATION GLOBALLY: NASSCOM

- The current demand-supply gap in data science and AI in the country stands at 51 per cent, significantly lower than major economies such as the US.
- Currently, the top five roles -- ML engineer, data engineer, data scientist, data architect and DevOps engineer -together constitute 73 per cent of all Al job openings in the country.
- At the same time, the two top roles -- ML engineer and data engineer -- constitute 46 per cent of total installed talent.
- With over 1.6 million digital talent pool (as of FY2022E), India has emerged as the prime destination for talent globally, said the report.

ndia currently ranks first in terms of AI skill penetration and AI tal-Lent concentration and fifth in AI scientific publications, a Nasscom report said on Friday.



India's 'AI Skills Penetration Factor' has been reported to be 3.09 -- the highest among all G20 and OECD countries. It shows that India's tech talent is 3X more likely to have or report AI skills than other countries, according to the report by the National Association of Software and Services Companies (Nasscom) in partnership with Salesforce and Draup. India is also expected to witness high growth in the demand for data science and AI professionals with an estimate of more than 1 million professionals by 2024.

"AI-led disruption in India's core sectors alone has a potential impact

of \$500 billion on India's economy in gross value added (GVA) terms by 2026. However, this cannot be achieved alone and would require concentrated efforts from the government, industry and academia to ramp up AI skilling and initiatives at scale,' said Debjani Ghosh, President, Nasscom.

The recent announcement by the government to set up three Centres of Excellence to develop AI for India and to make AI work for India is acean excellent step forward in building the core capabilities in AI and design thinking needed to drive actionable impact," she added.

More than 1,900 AI-focused startups are providing innovative solutions, primarily in the areas of conversational AI, NLP, video analytics, disease detection, fraud prevention and deep fakes detection.

"People with the right domain expertise and business context have the ability to build predictive models, plan simulations and scenarios, and cluster data. These skills are in highdemand and have huge potential to optimise business efficiency and more importantly build trust among customers and employees," explained Deepak Pargaonkar, VP, Solution Engineering, at Salesforce.

## BEWARE WHILE SEARCHING FOR PHONE NUMBERS ON INTERNET

t may seem rather convenient to search for a phone number on search engine but not many realize that this could be a trap set up by miscreants.

Two recent incidents prove this. In the first case, a man was duped of Rs 71,000 when he surfed the Internet to find the number of a hospital. His wife had fallen ill and he called up the number for consultation.

The victim, Bhagwandin, was asked to deposit Rs 10 through Phonepe to get the patient's registration done for consultation with a doctor of Indiranagar.

Since the victim told the miscreant that he cannot make the payment through the app, on which the miscreant asked him to share the bank account number, which he did.

He was asked to download the QuickSupport app and pay Rs 10 through the app. A little later the victim got an OTP on his registered mobile number and the miscreant asked him to share it.

After his wife was admitted, the man went to an ATM to withdraw the money, he came to know that Rs 71,755 had been withdrawn from his bank account.

In another case, a resident of Aminabad was duped of over Rs 64,000 in the name of purchase of sweets from a prominent shop in

Sadar locality under Cantonment.

The victim, Ashok Kumar Bansal, placed an online order for sweets from the shop after he searched the mobile number of the shop on Google. He said that the person who took the call asked him to furnish details of his bank account for the payment.

Superintendent of Police, Cyber cell, Triveni Singh, said that when a user downloads this type of (Quick Support) app, they give all the permissions to the app. While the victim is busy filling his name, number and paying Rs 10 as service charge, miscreants can watch the pin code, which is then used to withdraw the money later.

## **DELHI L-G RECONVENES MCD HOUSE FOR MAYORAL POLL ON FEB 22**

fter the Aam Aadmi Party on Saturday recommended the Mayoral election to be conducted on February 22, Lt Governor V.K. Saxena has approved the proposal.

"As recommended by Hon'ble Chief Minister, GNCTD. I approve the proposal to convene the adjourned first meeting of Municipal Corporation of Delhi on Wednesday, the 22nd February, 2023 at 11:00 a.m. at 4th Floor, A-Block, Dr. S.P. Mukherjee Civic Centre for election of Mayor, Dy Mayor and six members to the Standing Committee," said the notification from L-G Saxena.

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Saturday sent a proposal to Delhi's L-G V.K. Saxena regarding the election to be held on February 22. The capital city



is yet to elect the Mayor and Dy Mayor as three previous meetings held on January 6 and 24 and February 6 were adjourned without holding the exercise following a ruckus between BJP and AAP councillors over the 'voting rights of nominated councillors'. However, the Supreme Court in a ruling on Friday said that the nominated members cannot vote in Delhi Mayor elections. The last meeting of MCD councillors held on February 6 was adjourned until the next date amid sloganeering and ruckus over the issues of aldermen voting rights.

# 'Housewife a nation builder\_', says Kerala HC while ordering adequate compensation to woman

The Kerala High Court slammed the Kerala State Road Transport Corporation (KSRTC) for denying compensation to an accident victim on the ground that she is a housewife and does not earn any income.

The High Court not only called the role of the housewife to that of a nation builder, but also ordered for a good compensation to be paid to her.

Justice Devan Ramachandran said that such a stand by the transport body was 'outrageous' and urged that accident compensation should be same for a housewife and a working woman as the former also invests her time for the family and ensures that the next generation is fostered with the highest levels of excellence.

He also went on to point out that the life of human beings can never be tested on the scales of their monetary worth but by their contribution and selflessness.

Specifically on the role of a house-



wife, the judge said that her contributions as a mother and wife is invalu-

"At the outset, I must say that the contentions of the KSRTC, that a housewife earns no income and therefore, not eligible for compensa-

tion for disability and loss of amenities, is outrageous and beyond comprehension. The role of a mother and wife at home is beyond compare, and she is a true nation builder. She invests her time for the family and ensures that the next generation is

fostered with the highest levels of excellence; and her efforts can never be taken trivially or brushed aside, as being without monetary value. The lives of human beings are never tested on the scales of their monetary worth, but by their contribution and selflessness," the court said.

The court made this directive while hearing an appeal moved by a housewife challenging the order of the Motor Vehicle Accidents Claims Tribunal (MACT) that awarded her only Rs 40,214 as compensation for the grievous injuries she sustained on account of a rash application of brake by a KSRTC bus driver.

The woman instead sought Rs 2 lakh as she had to undergo extensive treatment and trauma for a long period of time after the incident.

This prompted her to approach the High Court with an appeal and the judge termed it as outrageous stand taken by the KSRTC, granting the petitioner a compensation of Rs 1,64,654, instead of Rs 40,214 award

# Nikki Yadav, Sahil Gehlot got married in 2020, photos surface

The Crime Branch of Delhi Police has revealed that deceased Nikki Yadav and Sahil Gehlot got married in October 2020. Their wedding photos have also come to the fore

Nikki (23) was strangled to death by Sahil with a charging cable, who then stuffed her body in a fridge on February 10.

As per the Crime Branch, the couple got married at the Arya Samaj Mandir in Greater Noida on October 1, 2020.

Delhi police interrogated the temple's priest on Friday after the accused revealed details of his marriage during interrogation.

According to sources, Sahil and Nikki were in a relationship since a long time and the had vowed to marry each other, which was known to their family members



While the victim's family had agreed to the arrangement, Sahil's family were not in favour of their relationship, said sources.

According to a Crime Branch official, on the night of February 9, the accused, a resident of Mitraon village, went to meet Nikki at her Uttam Nagar residence where she lived with her younger sister.

"Sahil stayed there for two-three hours and later both of them went to Nizammudin railway station. But as they could not get tickets to Goa, they decided to go to Himachal Pradesh instead and reached the ISBT in Kashmere Gate," said the official.

When the duo reached ISBT, an argument broke out between them. Sahil then strangled Nikki with his mobile phone data cable inside the car, probably at around 8 a.m. on February 10, drove to his dhaba and hid her body in the fridge before proceeding to marry another woman.

n a first-of-its-kind case, Haryana Police by establishing enhanced coordination with CBI and Interpol officials has identified a body abroad by matching DNA of a blood relative with that of the body.

A police spokesperson said in the case related to Kurukshetra district the police did not resort to lengthy procedures like MLAT (mutual legal assistance treaty) or LR (letter rogatory) in the DNA investigation.

This is the first time that such a case of DNA matching has been done using Interpol's standardised digital format. Initially, Haryana Police

was received from Paramjeet Kaur, a resident of Kurukshetra district, in which she said her son Parminder wanted to go to Italy. After completing required formalities, she came to know that his son has reached Serbia and later he will be sent to Italy by air. # HC asks DDA, DUSIB to file affidavits in Mehrauli demolition drive case

The Delhi High Court on Friday directed the Delhi Development Authority (DDA) and Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board (DUSIB) to file affidavits by February 21 in a plea filed by the Goshiya Colony Sewa Samiti and others residing in Mehrauli.

Justice Manmeet Pritam Singh Arora dealing with a plea filed through advocate Anupradha Singh also directed the petitioner to file its rejoinder within three days after DDA and DUSIB file their affidavits.



The court listed the matter for next hearing on February 28

The plea challenges the December 12, 2022 demolition notice, wherein DDA purports to carry out a demolition drive in the entire

Goshiya Colony, which is in existence for more than five decades and consists of over 600 houses, with approxi-

mately 4,000 population.
The plea stated, citing the
'Ajay Maken and others vs
Union of India' case that a

demolition drive cannot be carried out without following the protocol for removal of jhuggis as per the order of Delhi High Court.

The plea stated that before beginning any demolition drive, the land-owning agency must send a request to DUSIB, which will determine if the jhuggis qualifies for rehabilitation in accordance with the cut-off.

The petition claimed that the land-owning agency cannot begin the demolition process until DUSIB determines that the jhuggis are not eligible for rehabilita-

## CAR DRIVER DECAMPS WITH RS 7 CR JEWELLERY IN HYDERABAD

yderabad police have launched a massive hunt for a driver who decamped with gold and diamond jewellery worth Rs 7 crore.

Srinivas, who was working as a driver for a woman running jewellery business, escaped with a car containing the gold and diamond ornaments from Madhuranagar under SR Nagar police station limits on Friday. Police registered a case on a complaint by Radhika, who was running the business from her apart-

ment at Madhapur.
According to police, on the direction of Radhika, salesman Akshay had gone to a customer's house in

Madhuranagar along with Srinivas (28) to deliver an order at a house. Akshay went into the house to deliver the jewellery worth Rs 50 lakh while Srinivas was waiting outside in the car. When the salesman came out, he found Srinivas missing along with the car. He had switched off his mobile phone.

Akshay aleted Radhika, who then lodged a complaint with the police. According to her, the gold and diamond ornaments were supposed to be returned to Sirigiri Raj Gems and Jewellers at Banjara Hills.

The police registered a case and launched a hunt for the accused.A Police were scanning CCTV footage to trace the vehicle and track down the accused.

## NORTH INDIA'S FIRST NUCLEAR PLANT TO COME UP IN HARYANA

**New Delhi:** North India's first nuclear plant is coming up at Gorakhpur in Haryana's Fatehabad district, which is about 150 km north of the national capital.

Disclosing this on Saturday, Union Minister of State for Science and Technology, Jitendra Singh, said that during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's regime, one of the major achievements would be the installation of nuclear or atomic energy plants in other parts of the country, which were earlier confined mostly to the southern states like Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh or in the west in Maharashtra.

The Gorakhpur Haryana Anu Vidyut Pariyojana's (GHAVP) two units of 700 MW capacity each are under implementation near the Gorakhpur village. Till date, an amount of Rs 4,906 crore has been spent out of the total allocated funds of Rs 20,594 crore for the project.

Construction of the main plant buildings/structures viz. fire water pump house (FWPH), safety related pump house (SRPH), fuel oil storage area, ventilation stack, overhead tank, switchyard control building, retaining walls and garland drain is progressing well.

Ground improvement in Turbine Building 1 and 2, 220 kV Switchyard and IDCT-1A is completed. Ground improvement in other areas are in progress. The contractors for the IDCT package and turbine island package have mobilised the site. Purchase orders for major long manufacturing cycle equipment and components like primary coolant pumps, calandria, reactor headers, refuelling machines heads, moderator and other D20 heat exchangers etc. are already in place.

Construction of water duct from Tohana to GHAVP for meeting operational cooling water requirements has been taken up through the Haryana Irrigation & Water Resources Department (HI&WRD) as deposit work and is progressing well.

# Real estates, film production among others avenues to divert coal scam proceeds: ED

The Enforcement
Directorate (ED), which
has given a renewed push
to the ongoing probe in the
multi-crore cattle smuggling
scam in West Bengal by recovering unaccounted cash of Rs 1.40
crore from a businessman's
office on February 8, has
brought under scanner a number of real estate development
agencies, film production houses and one Non-Governmental
Organization (NGO) in the mat-

According to the probe sources, the officials probing the coal smuggling scam have questioned two city-based businessmen and thoroughly examined their books of accounts through which their business transactions with these new entities have surfaced

have surfaced.

Although the ED is not revealing the names of these connected real estate and film production units as well as the NGO, the central agency sleuths have decided to summon their associates one after another and grill them. The production firm behind a recently released Bengali movie is also under the

scanner of the ED sleuths.
One of the two Kolkata-based businessmen who was ques-



tioned by ED was Bikram Sikaria, the owner of Gajraj Group, from whose office at Earl Street in South Kolkata the Rs 1.40 crore of unaccounted cash was recovered by the central agency sleuths on February 8.

On the very next day, the central agency had issued an official release claiming that the seized cash was unaccounted and part of the total cash payment of approximately Rs 9 crore for a property called Salasar Guest House, at an undervalued price.

The ED also questioned another businessman named Manjit Singh Grewal aka Jitti Bhai, who actually purchased that property of Salasar House at the undervalued price.

In the statement issued on February 9, the probe agency claimed that the recovered Rs 1.40 crore cash was part of the coal scam proceeds. "The market value of this property is more than Rs 12 crore, however the deed value of the same is shown at around Rs 3 crore.

This money was part of the agreed differential amount to be paid in cash from the proceeds generated from coal smuggling," the statement read.

In the statement, ED also made a serious revelation that one highly influential political person was making an attempt to launder the proceeds of crime originating from coal smuggling through his close confidant Manjit Singh Grewal, who was also involved in handling illegal cash of a minister.

## SC SEEKS CENTRE'S RESPONSE ON FAILURE TO ASSESS BEARING CAPACITY OF FRAGILE HIMALAYAN REGION

gainst the backdrop of the recent land cracking and sinking issues in Joshimath, a plea has been filed in the Supreme Court raising the failure of Centre and state governments in assessing the "carrying capacity or bearing capacity" of the ecological fragile Indian Himalayan

The plea claimed this region, which is spread across 13 states/Union Territories (UTs), is facing issues of unsustainable and hydrologically disastrous constructions - home stays, hotels, and commercial accommodations -- hydropower projects and unregulated tourism, which has allegedly collapsed the drainage and waste management system.

The plea filed by Ashok Kumar Raghav, which was argued by advocate Akash Vashishtha before a bench headed by Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud, said the governments in the Indian Himalayan Region, spread across 13 states/UTs -- have failed in preparing and implementing the master plans/tourism plans/layout/area development/zonal plans, and also failed to the "carrying capacity or bearing capacity of ecologically fragile areas," which is home to nearly 50 million people.



The region includes: Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, West Bengal, Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Mizoram, Sikkim, Nagaland, Tripura and

Arunachal Pradesh. The plea said, "Carrying or bearing capacity of the ecologically fragile areas, hill stations, and highly visited areas in hills is necessary as the same would inter alia determine how much can a given place bear the load of human population or human intervention and the extent of infrastructure projects could be permitted, given its geological/tectonic/seismic posihabitat, air quality and other resources.

It further added that due to nonexistent carrying/bearing capacity studies, grave geological hazards in the form of landslides, land subsidence, land cracking and sinking issues such as that in Joshimath and previously as flash floods/glacial bursts in Kedarnath (2013) and Chamoli (2021), are being witnessed and serious ecological and environmental depredation is taking place in the hills.

The plea added, "That the Uttarakhand Tourism Policy 2018, of

Uttarakhand, had itself recognised identification of the permissible carrying capacities as a major challenge of the Uttarakhand Tourism. The objectives of the said policy are, inter alia, to resolve the carrying capacity issues of the prominent tourism destinations in the state.

On Friday, the Supreme Court asked the petitioner to approach the National Green Tribunal. However, Vashishtha insisted that there is a bar under Section 14 of the NGT Act as there has to be a specific case of environmental violation. After Vashishtha pressed that this is an important issue, the Supreme Court issued notice to the Centre, Ministry of Jal Shakti, and

The plea added that 56,37,102 tourists visited Himachal Pradesh in 2021, which was 75.43 per cent over that recorded in 2020. The places which witnessed the most number of visitors include but not limited to Shimla, Manali, Lahaul & Spiti, Sirmour, Bilaspur and Chamba.

### Entire Rs 16,982 cr GST compensation cess to states to be cleared: FM

inance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said on Saturday that the entire GST compensation cess for June 2022 totalling Rs 16,982 crore will be cleared.

She said this while addressing a press conference soon after the 49th meeting of the GST Council ended.

She also informed that Rs 16,524 crore to six states which have submitted the accountant general's (AG) certificate will also be released.

Delhi, Tamil Nadu and Telangana are among the six states which have submitted AG certificates.

Though submission of AG certificate is a requirement for the states to seek GST compensation, Sitharaman said that it wasn't a strict pre-requisite, as 90 per cent of funds are anyway released to the states, while the remaining amount is given after the AG certificate is submitted.

The GST Council meeting, which was held at Vigyan Bhavan here, discussed matters pertaining to setting up of appellate tribunals and curbing tax evasion in pan masala and gutkha businesses.

The groupf of ministers' (GoM) report on taxation for pan masala was accepted by the council. At the meeting, the GST Council decided to reduce GST on pencil sharpeners and certain tracking devices. Exemption on coal rejects supplied by and to the washeries was also approved by the Council. Also, GST on a type of liquid jaggery has been reduced to nil from 18 per cent if sold loose. If its prepackaged and labelled, the tax rate on it



would be 5 per cent.The GST Council also recommended rationalisation of late fee for delayed filing of annual returns.

However, no decision could be arrived at by the fitment committee for SUVs and Sitharaman said that the GST Council

decided to tax services supplied by courts and tribunals under the reverse charge

She also informed that the decision on the GST Appellate Tribunal has been accepted with change in language and the modification in draft will be circulated within a week

### Pak Defence Minister acknowledges country has already gone bankrupt




erals, said an official on Saturday. The accused have been identified as Mohd. Sameer (19), a resident of Delhi's Shaheen Bagh and a juvenile.



n a massive show of strength, Shiv Sena (UBT) President Uddhav Thackeray targeted the Election Commission of India, terming it as a 'slave' of the Centre and vowed to finish off the 'thieves' who have been given the original 'Shiv Sena' name and 'Bow-and-Arrow' symbol, here on Saturday. "These thieves have stolen the name and symbol of Balasaheb Thackeray's party... It was done on the eve of Maha Shivratri today and Shivaji Jayanti tomorrow. But my 'Sainiks' (soldiers) are with me. We shall not rest till we bury these robbers in the elections," roared Thackeray amidst loud rounds of applause.

Slamming the Centre, he said that all institutions including the ECI have become the slaves of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, but they can never 'destroy' Balasaheb Thackeray's Shiv Sena, though the name-symbol has been given away to the breakaway group led by Chief Minister Eknath Shinde. "Even the ECI commissioners are behaving like Modi's slaves... probably they may be rewarded with some plum posts after retirement... But the people of Maharashtra know very well who is genuine... I challenge these stealers to come for the electoral battle with the 'Bow-and-Arrow'... We will



confront you with our 'Flaming Torch', and teach you a lesson," Thackeray dared the Shinde group.

## Dalit student's suicide: IIT Bombay forms panel for "parallel" probe

The Indian Institute of
Technology Bombay has
formed a panel to conduct a
"parallel" probe into the death of a
first-year B.Tech student amid allegations of caste bias and has urged
its students to come forward if they
have "relevant" information.

The panel is headed by Professor Nand Kishore and also has SC/ST Students Cell members, including faculty and students, a few student mentor coordinators and the incharge chief medical officer of IIT Bombay hospital, said a statement by institute Director Subhasis Chaudhuri on Saturday.

Darshan Solanki (18), who belonged to a Scheduled Caste community, allegedly died by suicide by jumping off the seventh floor of a hostel building on the Powai campus of the IIT on February 12, but his family suspects something wrong in his death and



said he faced discrimination.

The Powai police are investigating the matter and have also visited Solanki's home in Ahmedabad.

Highlighting that Prof. Nand Kishore was the chief vigilance officer of IIT Bombay till recently and is experienced "in these matters", Chaudhari said that the committee is actively meeting everyone who might have relevant information. "If you have any information that you believe may be relevant, please reach out to the committee by either meeting any of the committee members, or by emailing Prof. Nand Kishore or to the Powai Police," Chaudhari appealed

through the statement.

IIT Bombay and police are
actively investigating the "environment, incidents, and reasons behind Darshan's tragic death", it said. The police have interviewed a large number of people, and also taken Solanki's phone and laptop for forensic analysis, Chaudhari

In the statement, Chaudhari said IIT B is working towards changes in their UG curriculum, starting with the batch of 2022, to make it "more relevant and motivating to students, and to reduce some of the stress".

Calling some media reports about the student's death "premature", Chaudhari said that "as the matter is sub-judice so we cannot comment on the causes until either police report or our inquiry committee report is ready".

According to Chaudhari, IIT
Bombay has an SC/ST students cell,
where students can reach in case of
issues including discrimination.

"We are working actively to create an inclusive campus where all students feel at home," Chaudhari

The ECI ruling has been flayed by the Sena (UBT) and the MVA allies in very strong words, terming it as "hasty, unexpected, injustice, amounts to death of democracy," etc, while a furious Thackeray and other party leaders announced last night that they would move the courts against the decision. The original 'Shiv Sena' with a symbol of 'Bow-and-Arrow' and logo of a tiger, was founded in June 1966 by the cartoonist-turned-politician, the late Balasaheb Thackeray. However, the party split in June 2022, and the faction led by Uddhav Thackeray was given the name of Shiv Sena (UBT) with a new symbol of Flaming Torch, while the group led by Shinde was handed the identity of Balasahebanchi Shiv Sena, till the ECI verdict of February 17 allotting it the original name-symbol.

# New data shows mumbai air pollution rose sharply

Tuch has been made of Mumbai's air pollution in recent months being worse than Delhi's notorious pollution. Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal even tweeted a global ranking, in which Mumbai was placed second, saying that after a long time the national capital was not in the list of the world's most polluted cities.

That was on a day, however, when the Delhi region benefited from strong winds blowing away much of the pollutants in the air. The ranking was by a Swiss firm, IQ Air, and is updated frequently.

While Mumbai's air quality has indeed deteriorated, new data from IQ Air shows different and worrying trends about the real picture.

In NDTV exclusive, data shows that the national capital's pollution levels have been consistently twice the level of India's financial capital, Mumbai. This is based on the measurement of PM 2.5 pollutant levels, which is the microscopic and lethal particulate matter (PM) that can beat the human body's defences and embed itself deep in the lungs and thereon into other organs. The new data (table below) shows how Delhi's air pollution level has been higher than Mumbai's every month in 2022, particularly in November-December, which was when Mumbai's air pollution first made headlines for surpassing the national capital's. Delhi's air pollution level has been higher than Mumbai's every month in 2022.

And it's not just recent months. For the past four years, Delhi's annual average of PM 2.5 has been an average of 95 micrograms per cubic metre, whereas



Mumbai's has been 45.

The metropolis on the coast usually benefits from the sea breeze clearing the city of pollution, mainly from vehicles, construction and road dust. However, this winter, doctors have reported a spurt in patients with respiratory infections, especially among children.

The data (table below) shows that PM 2.5 levels in November and December rose by 18 per cent over the previous year. The government's data reportedly shows an even steeper increase of over 60 per cent last November. PM 2.5 levels in November and December rose by 18 per cent over the previous year.

The data, which is presented alongside the World Health Organisation's guideline (table below) for clean air, shows just how far off both cities are from the safe PM 2.5 limit of only 5 micrograms per cubic metre. 

## **1st Test:** Broad's 4-21 sees Black Caps slump to 63/5 after England hammer 374 in 2nd innings

ngland were cruising towards victory in the first Test at Bay Oval here, having reduced New Zealand to 63/5 in their second innings after hammering 374 runs in 74 overs on second calling to set the hosts a target of 394 for victory.

England, who had a small lead of 19 runs on basis of the first innings, scored runs at a frantic pace on the third day of the Day-Night Test.

Joe Root (57), Harry Brook (54), and Ben Foakes (51) struck half-centuries while Ollie Pope blasted 49, skipper



and Ollie Robinson contributed 39 runs as England left the hosts' bowlers shellshocked by their Bazball tactics, continuing to play attacking shots despite losing wickets at regular intervals. Pacer Stuart Broad then claimed four wickets for 21 runs as England reduced the hosts to 63/5, set-

ting themselves up on course

for a big win. On Sunday, they will wrap up their 10th win in 11 Tests under captain Ben Stokes and coach Brendon McCullum, while the Black Caps will have gone seven Tests without a victory.

## City's record-smashing Shield triumph

umbai City FC have secured the ISL League Winners' Shield with two matches yet to be played -- the quickest the league title has ever been sealed. This was the Islanders' first piece of silverware under Des Buckingham -- one that the Englishman and his side have achieved in recordbreaking fashion. The Islanders have dropped just one game this season and have secured 14 wins, 4 draws, and just one loss in the 19 matches they have played so far this league season. Take a look at the stand-out components of this historic title win -- a second for Mumbai City in three years!

Flying high in attack

Under the guidance of head coach Buckingham, the Islanders are a side transformed. The 38-year-



old has brought a new definition to 'attacking' football and his Mumbai City side is a testament to it. The Islanders have scored an astounding 54 goals in 19 games so far this league season. The goals have come from all over the pitch for Mumbai City with 12 different Islanders getting their names on the scoresheet. However, the free-scoring Islanders have four attacking pillars to lean on, contributing to 65

per cent of the league goals scored. The quartet of Jorge Pereyra Diaz (11 goals, 6 assists), Lallianzuala Chhangte (10 goals, 6 assists), Greg Stewart (7 goals, 7 assists) and Bipin Singh (6 goals, 2 assists) have been in scintillating form and have given life to Buckingham's attractive, attacking philosophy. Diving deeper, the goals have been a return on the tremendous attacking output the Islanders have consistently produced game after game. Mumbai City lead the Hero ISL charts for most successful passes (7721), most touches (12,513), most chances created (212), most shots (297) and most shots on target (137). Mumbai City's fluid tactical set-up has also allowed the Islanders to control and dominate possession in nearly all their games in the season so far, averaging nearly 60 per cent possession in the 2022-23 season so far.
