## Former Pakistan military ruler Pervez Musharraf passes away in Dubai

Former Pakistan military ruler General (ret'd) Pervez Musharraf, who had been living in Dubai since 2016, breathed his last on Sunday, local media reported.



The 79-year-old former president and chief of army staff was suffering from amyloidosis, a rare disease caused by a build-up of an abnormal protein called amyloid in organs and tissues throughout the body, according to his family. The build-up of amyloid proteins (deposits) can make it difficult for the organs and tissues to work properly, The Express Tribune reported. Musharraf assumed the

post of Chief Executive after imposing martial law in the country in 1999 and served as the president of Pakistan from 2001 to 2008, The Express Tribune reported.

The former president's family moved from New Delhi to Karachi in 1947. He joined the Pakistan Army in 1964 and was a graduate of the Army Staff and Command College, Quetta.

## KERALA POLICE ARREST 2,069 CRIMINALS UNDER 'OPERATION AAG'

Thiruvananthapuram: The Kerala Police in a major operation across the state have arrested 2,069 'anti-social' elements under 'Operation Aag'. The raids started on Saturday evening and are continuing till now.

The raid is being primarily held to arrest those who were placed under the Kerala Anti-Social Activities (Prevention) Act (KAAPA). Some are absconding while others are those who have not appeared even after arrest warrants were served. Those who are arrested under non-bailable charges will be remanded in judicial custody while the others will be placed in preventive custody for more than 24 hours and will be let scot-free after questioning.

The state police had earlier conducted 'Operation Kaaval' for cracking down on anti-social elements which were later discontinued. According to police, most arrests took place in Thiruvananthapuram with the state capital district accounting for 297 arrests.

## Agreement between UP police & Meta saved 2 lives in a week

An agreement signed between Meta (Facebook's parent company) and Uttar Pradesh Police has helped save two people's lives in the state in a span of less than a week.

One of them was a college student in the Ambedkarnagar district of Uttar Pradesh, who late Friday night said she was going to die by suicide in an Instagram post, posting pictures of pills she was going to pop up.

The other occurred in Ghaziabad on January 31, when a man, as he prepared to hang himself from a ceiling fan, beamed a live telecast of the act on Instagram.

In both cases, the tech giant managed to scupper their attempts by alerting in time the local police, who then traced the two people and stopped them from dying suicide. "Under the prevailing agreement between Uttar Pradesh Police and Facebook



from March 2022, if any person posts something related to suicide or self-harm on Facebook or Instagram, then Meta Hqs USA immediately sends an alert to the social media centre of PHQ UP Police through phone and email," Rahul Srivastav, Additional Superintendent of Police ATS/In-charge of Social Media Centre of UP Police, said on Sunday. He added that more than 10 lives have been saved so far.

In Ambedkarnagar incident, Meta sent an alert to the Social Media Centre of UP Police at 11.37 pm with her details, after which police reached the woman's place in 15 minutes, thwarted her pursuit and took her family into confidence, Srivastav said. On

the directions of Additional Director General, Law and Order, Prashant Kumar, Superintendent of Police of Ambedkarnagar Ajit Kumar Sinha has deputed a female officer, Rukmani Verma, to counsel the girl.

In the Ghaziabad incident, after receiving an alert from the Social Media Centre of UP Police, Vijayanagar Police Station Inspector Anita Chauhan reached the spot within 13 minutes and prevented the man from killing himself. The man was depressed after losing 90,000 in a business. The Ghaziabad Police counselled the youth and also spoke to his family.

"UP Police is making diverse use of social media for the cause of public service offering a bouquet of online services. We have a dedicated and well-trained team of more than 500+ police personnel who work round-the-clock to render any kind of assistance," he said.

## Men dance with rifles, fire, while drinking on Ghaziabad elevated road

The elevated road in Uttar Pradesh's Ghaziabad is again in the news after a video of a group of men in luxury cars, carrying guns, and drinking alcohol in the middle of the road went viral. The police have identified the car owner.

The video, shot on the elevated road of Ghaziabad under the Indrapuram police station area, is reportedly from Saturday night. A group of men can be seen brandishing rifles while drinking alcohol, while loud music plays from the car. Another video shows a man loading bullets in the rifle and firing in the air from the vehicle, while driving. The man was allegedly firing the gun while drunk, endangering lives.

The police scanned the car's number plates and identified the driver as Raja Chaudhary, a resident of Chiranjeev Vihar. A case has been registered against him and the police are trying to locate him, they said.

The police had in December last year arrested a person for dancing and blocking the same road. In a viral video, a man and two women were seen dancing after parking the car on the highway, hampering the movement of traf-

## DEARNESS ALLOWANCE LIKELY TO BE HIKED BY 4%: REPORTS



New Delhi: The government is likely to raise the dearness allowance (DA) for employees and pensioners by 4 per cent, according to reports.

The DA hike will be effective from January 1, 2023, however it needs to be cleared by the Union Cabinet first. If hiked, this would take the DA to 42 per cent from the existing 38 per cent.

DA, paid to employees as insulation from inflation, is revised periodically twice a year on a half-yearly basis, and it is calculated as a percentage of the basic salary of employees.

## Centre bans over 200 Chinese apps

Following constant complaints against Chinese loan and betting apps, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) has started the process of banning 138 betting apps and 94 lending apps that had Chinese links, on the instructions of the Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA).

According to the information, the MeitY was recently instructed by the MHA to ban such apps, which operate through a third party link.

Sources said that all these apps were found violating Section 69 of the IT Act and contained material which was deemed as a threat to India's sovereignty and integrity.

As per sources, these apps are used to trap financially strapped people in a debt trap, by increasing their interest on loans up to 3,000 per cent. Many such people who were caught in the debt trap committed suicide when the people working for the apps mentally harassed them.

The issue came to the fore after several cases of suicides by bor-



rowers of these apps were seen in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

On the other hand, the Chinese apps can potentially misuse serv-

er-side security by using them as spying tools as they have access to the important data of many Indians.

Access to such data can be used for espionage on a large scale, due to which all such apps are being considered as a threat to the country.

The MHA had started investigating some Chinese loan giving apps around six months ago. It was revealed that 94 such apps were available on the e-store and operated through third party links.

Around that time, security agencies had asked the Ministry to impose a ban on such betting and loan lending apps. Significantly, the Centre had banned 54 Chinese apps that posed as a threat to the country's security in 2022.

## PM Modi to inaugurate India Energy Week Today

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the India Energy Week (IEW) 2023 on Monday in Bengaluru. During the programme, the Prime Minister will participate in a roundtable interaction with global oil and gas CEOs. He will also launch multiple initiatives in the field of green energy.

The IEW, which is a G20 event, will be held between February 6 to 8, in Bengaluru. It is aimed at showcasing India's rising prowess as an energy transition powerhouse. The event will see the presence of more than 30 ministers from across the world.

Over 30,000 delegates, 1,000 exhibitors and 500 speakers will gather to discuss the challenges and opportunities of India's energy future. Meanwhile Modi will launch the E20 fuel at 84 retail outlets of oil marketing com-



panies in 12 states. E20 is a blend of 20 per cent ethanol with petrol. The government aims to achieve 20 per cent blending of ethanol by 2025.

Oil marketing companies are setting up ethanol plants to facilitate this process. The Prime Minister will also flag off a green mobility rally for creating awareness about clean fuels. He will also dedicate a twin-cook top model of Indian Oil's indoor solar cooking system -- a revolutionary indoor solar cooking solution that works on both solar and auxiliary energy sources simultaneously.



# POWER MINISTER URGES G20 MEMBERS TO COUNTER CLIMATE CHANGE CHALLENGES UNITEDLY

 Power Minister R.K. Singh on Sunday called upon G20 member countries to join together in countering the challenges posed by global warming and climate change.

Delivering the keynote address at the first Energy Transitions Working Group (ETWG) meeting in Bengaluru, he said that India now stands committed to reduce emissions intensity of GDP by 45 per cent by 2030 from 2005 level.

He said that the country also aims to achieve close to 50 per cent cumulative electric power installed capacity from non-fossil fuel-based energy resources by 2030.

Noting that India has been ranked amongst the top five performing countries in the Climate Change Performance Index, the Power Minister said that the country's per capita greenhouse gas emissions are far below the world average of 6.3 tCO<sub>2</sub>e in 2020.



Various energy saving schemes of the government have led to 267.9 million tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> reduction per year, resulting in an estimated cost savings of \$18.5 billion, he added.

# ADGP Kashmir reviews security, law & order situation

 Additional Director General Police (ADGP) Kashmir Zone Vijay Kumar visited Police district Awantipora in South Kashmir and chaired a review meeting regarding security scenario, anti-terrorism operations, law and order and anti-drug drive, police said on Sunday.

During the meeting, the ADGP appreciated the efforts of the police personnel to maintain law and order in the Police district.

"During the meeting, he took stock of the overall security situation and counter-insurgency operations. He emphasised upon the officers to adopt a professional approach while dealing with counter-insurgency operations. He also urged officers to strengthen the general security grid and ensure great synergy and coordina-

# AIMPLB opposes UCC, says it is against spirit of constitution

 The All India Muslim Personal Law Board (AIMPLB) met here on Sunday and discussed various issues including the Gyanvapi dispute, uniform civil code and other issues related to Muslims.

The Board discussed the issue of uniform civil code and said that the fundamental rights provide freedom of religion to all citizens and bringing the uniform civil code would deprive citizens of the privileges given to them by the constitution.

"Such a code is neither relevant nor beneficial for a multi-religious, multi-cultural and multi-lingual country like India," the Board said in a release.

The AIMPLB also appealed to all to preserve religious freedom and personal laws. The Board said that the



Places of Worship Act 1992 should be adhered to in word and spirit in national interest. It also urged the courts to take note of atrocities on minorities and weaker sections since the judiciary is the last hope of all citizens. The Board further objected to the practice of putting down houses and implicating the accused even before law is allowed to take its course. The protection of Waqf and how it can be used for education of the poor and Muslims, bettering the lives of women and increasing their participation in social life was also discussed. The meeting was attended by All India Majlis-E-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) chief Asaduddin Owaisi. AIMPLB member Maulana Khalid Rasheed Farangi Mahali said issues faced by the community including conversion, and the Gyanvapi case were also discussed. The AIMPLB has 51 executive members including AIMIM chief Asaduddin Owaisi.

# PRADHAN SLAMS ODISHA CM OVER LAW & ORDER SITUATION

 Senior BJP leader and Union Minister for Education, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Dharmendra Pradhan, on Sunday slammed Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik over the deteriorating law and order situation in the state.

Speaking to the media here, Pradhan said: "Naba Das, an influential Cabinet Minister, was murdered on January 29. However, no one has any clue about why a police officer killed him."

"The Chief Minister, who also holds the Home portfolio, has remained silent on this incident while the DGP is trying to shrug off his responsibility. This tells a lot about the law and order situation in the state," Pradhan said.

Raising questions about a Crime Branch probe under the monitoring of a retired judge of Orissa High Court, he said: "The judge was not appointed under the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952. There is no clarity about the responsibility and power of the retired judge."

"In between, some people (Biju Janata Dal leaders) are saying that a Crime Branch investigation is going on. But the Crime Branch investigation is totally unacceptable. The case should be investigated by a third party," said the Union Minister.

Murder of the Minister is not just a single case, many other law and order cases have happened in



the state, he said, referring to Mahanga double murder case and Anand Tappo murder case and the alleged sexual harassment case against a BJD MLA, where FIRs were registered only after the intervention of Orissa High Court. "Only two days ago, a Balasore sub-collector and his driver were attacked by the sand mafia, when the officer was going to stop illegal sand mining. All these incidents show 'lawlessness' in Odisha," said the Union Minister. "What is going on in Odisha? Who is holding the

power? Who is ruling the state?" he said. Meanwhile, senior Congress MLA Narasingha Mishra demanded a Court-monitored SIT probe into the murder case.

"We do not have any faith in the Odisha police. Though several capable officers are there in the state, the government is not allowing them to work independently," Mishra said.

Raising questions on the ongoing Crime Branch investigation, the Congress leader said: "When the bullet had pierced into the heart and lungs, the Minister might have died on the spot. Why was a drama created by air-lifting him to Bhubaneswar?"

The Chief Minister should step down and appoint a capable person as Home minister, he added.

Commenting on Pradhan's statement, BJD spokesperson Sammit Patra said: "In the BJP-ruled states, there have been very sensational cases, whether it is liquor tragedy or bridge collapse leading to the deaths of many people and also crimes against women. People demanded judicial enquiry but in most cases it was never done."

"The only intention of Pradhan is to politicise every criminal case and create a political narrative," he said.

"The state is transparent and has given this case to be monitored by a High Court judge nominated by the Orissa High Court. What's there to hide for us?" Patra questioned.

# NIA arrests 2 in connection with Phulwari Sharif terror module case

 The National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Sunday arrested two persons from Bihar in connection with a case related to the busting of a suspected terror module in the Phulwari Sharif area of Patna, an official said.

According to an official, the NIA conducted search operations at eight locations, following which two persons, identified as -- Tanveer Raza a.k.a. Barkati and Mohammed Abid a.k.a. Aryan, were arrested.

Earlier, several persons were arrested and incriminating articles and documents related to the banned organisation Popular Front of India (PFI) were seized.

"The raids were conducted in Bihar's East Champaran district on Saturday while the two persons



were arrested on Sunday. We have learnt that they had hatched a conspiracy to carry out targeted killings. The arrested individuals had arranged weapons and ammunition to carry out the killings. A

rece was also conducted," an NIA official said, adding multiple digital devices were also seized during the raids.

"The arms and ammunition had been handed over to a PFI trainer, Yakoob, who had been conducting training sessions for PFI cadres. A few days ago, Yakoob had posted a derogatory and inflammatory Facebook video, which was aimed at disturbing peace and communal harmony. Yakoob is currently on the run," the official said.

The case pertains to involvement of PFI and its members in "unlawful activities". The PFI members were suspected to have assembled to discuss their plans in the Phulwari Sharif area of Patna.

The case was initially registered at Bihar's Phulwari Sharif police station on July 12, 2022, and later on, the probe into the matter was taken over by the NIA.

# Chennai Police to install 200 more ANPR cameras to curb traffic violations

 The Greater Chennai Police is to finalise the tender for installing 200 more Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) cameras to curb traffic violations. The tender for the same would be finalised on Monday.

According to a senior traffic police officer, these cameras would be installed at 50 different locations under Chennai Police limits. The ANPR cameras can automatically detect those jumping traffic signals and using mobile phones while driving in the process of expanding coverage under the Traffic Regulation Observation Zone (TROZ).

ANPR cameras are now linked to the VAHAN portal and this will help generate e-challans automatically in the name of traffic violators. A call centre will be dedicated



for pulling up those who do not pay the fine in the stipulated period. An Intelligent Video Management System (IVMS) is linked to the ANPR cameras and this will monitor, detect and record any attempts of vehicle theft on the roads. Police said that if the IVMS detects vehicle theft, automatic alerts will be generated as voice calls and SMS and WhatsApp messages to the nearby police station. Officers in the rank of inspectors and above will also be alerted through SMS and WhatsApp messages and calls.

# Digital way to track pregnant women, children for vaccination in Himachal

 As a pilot project in Himachal Pradesh's Solan and Sirmour districts, the government has launched U-WIN portal, a digital way to facilitate tracking every pregnant woman and children for vaccination.

Under the Centre-sponsored project, these districts have been included among the selected ones in the country.

The aim of the project is to increase the immunity of children and prevent them from various diseases. Complete information about maternal and child vaccinations will be available on the portal.

Himachal Pradesh has an estimated target of vaccinating over one lakh newborn babies and about 1.27 lakh pregnant women annually.

The portal has been developed on the lines of CoWIN portal. The data of all vaccination beneficiaries will be available on the portal from time to



time after the birth of the child. All government and private hospitals are also being linked with the U-WIN portal. All the beneficiaries will get the information regarding their vaccination through SMS. The prominent feature of the portal is that after the completion of the vaccination process, the

beneficiary will also get the vaccination certificate. To get the beneficiary registered on the U-WIN portal, an Aadhaar card and mobile number will have to be provided at the vaccination centre. The state government, through the Health Department, vaccinates children against diseases that mainly include rotavirus, tuberculosis, measles, whooping cough, tetanus, hepatitis-B, etc. For the vaccination, there are 390 cold chains in the state. As a pilot project, 42 cold chains in Solan and Sirmour districts will be covered under the U-WIN portal. Currently, an estimated 43,000 beneficiaries will get benefits annually through the U-WIN portal. An estimated 11,000 children in the age group of 0-1 year and 13,000 pregnant women in Solan district, while 9,100 children and 10,000 pregnant women in Sirmour district will get benefit of the portal.

# Jolt for BJP in Bengal as another party MLA joins Trinamool

 Ahead of the forthcoming panchayat polls in West Bengal, the BJP on Sunday received a major jolt as another party MLA shifted to the ruling Trinamool Congress.

On Sunday afternoon, BJP legislator from Alipurduar constituency in Alipurduar district Suman Kanjilal reached the office of Trinamool's national General Secretary Abhishek Banerjee in south Kolkata and joined the ruling party.

Banerjee himself handed over the party flag to Kanjilal - the sixth BJP legislator and the third from north Bengal to join Trinamool after the 2021 assembly elections. With this, the total number of BJP MLAs in the Assembly has come down to 68.

The Trinamool, in a statement, said that Kanjilal had joined them rejecting the anti-people policies of BJP



as well as to be a part of the development activities under the leadership of Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee. Although Kanjilal himself had not made any comment on his action, his close associates said that his differences with BJP Lok Sabha member John Barla were the reasons for his decision to quit the party and join Trinamool. State General Secretary and spokesman Kunal Ghosh told media persons that Kanjilal was the beginning and more elected BJP representatives are keen to join the state's ruling party. "We have asked them to wait for some time," Ghosh said.



# VIKAS YATRA CAMPAIGN WILL CHANGE THE LIVES OF PEOPLE: CM CHOUHAN

# Cop thrashes man for recording his video

A Madhya Pradesh Police officer was caught on camera assaulting a man in front of his family during a routine traffic check in Shahdol on Sunday. The video of the incident has gone viral on social media.

According to the police, the man and his family, from Chhattisgarh, were on their way to attend the funeral of a relative in Shahdol. They were signalled to stop near a checkpoint by police officials. Due to its high speed, the vehicle skidded to a stop a little bit ahead of the checkpoint. Following this, police officials checked the vehicle's papers and found out that the pollution certificate was missing. As the cops began the procedure of issuing a challan, the man driving the vehicle brought out his mobile phone and started recording everything. Agitated by the act, an inspector, identified as Abhinav Rai, rained down punches on the man. The man's family mem-



bers and others present at the scene had to intervene to put a stop to the beating.

According to senior Shahdol police officer Mukesh Dixit, the matter reached the police station and both parties mutually agreed to settle the dispute.

# UPSET OVER EX'S MARRIAGE, INDORE NURSE INJECTS SELF WITH ANESTHESIA, DIES

Indore: A 27-year-old nurse allegedly died by suicide after injecting herself an overdose of anaesthesia due to a failed love affair in Madhya Pradesh's Indore city, police said on Sunday.

Pooja Ganjan allegedly injected herself with an overdose of anaesthesia at her house two days ago, inspector Sanjay Shukla of Aerodrome police station said.

The victim's body was handed over to her family after a post-mortem on Saturday, he said.

The woman left behind a two-page note, in which she said that she was in a relationship with a colleague in the hospital. But he took up a job in another medical facility and married another woman, Shukla said quoting the letter. In a statement to the police, the victim's former boyfriend claimed that while he did have an affair with the woman, he had made it clear to her that they would not tie the knot, as his family had fixed his marriage elsewhere, the official added.

# 3 MEMBERS OF BANNED GROUP PFI ARRESTED: COPS

The Madhya Pradesh Police have arrested three members of the banned outfit Popular Front of India (PFI) on charges of conspiring against the government and indulging in unlawful activities, an official said on Sunday.

With this, the police have taken into custody four members of the banned outfit in the last couple of days. In the latest action, two PFI members were arrested in Madhya Pradesh capital Bhopal on Saturday while the third one was arrested after being brought on production warrant from Aurangabad (in Maharashtra) in connection with a case registered by the MP Police's Special Task Force last year, the official said.

The three accused have been identified as Gulam Rasool Shah, a resident of Dhar district, Sajid Khan aka Gulam Nabi, a resident of Indore, and Parvez Khan, from Aurangabad, he said.

They were charged under



Indian Penal Code Sections 121A (conspiracy to wage war against government), 153B (assertions prejudicial to national integration) and 120B (criminal conspiracy), besides provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act," the official said.

Parvez Khan was in a jail in Aurangabad and was brought to Bhopal on Saturday on a production warrant, he said.

Gulam Rasool was an active member of the PFI and used to inspire people to work for the organisation by visiting various areas of the state, he said. Gulam Nabi was looking after the PFI's financial management Madhya Pradesh, the official said. The three accused were produced before a local court which sent them in police remand till February 8.

# Minor boy raped 58-year-old woman & killed her with a sickle: cops

A 16-year-old boy allegedly raped a 58-year-old woman and murdered her by gagging and hitting her brutally in Madhya Pradesh's Rewa district, a crime suspected to be the fallout of a mobile phone theft two years ago, police said on Sunday. The incident took place on the night of January 30 in Kailashpuri village under Hanumana police station limits.

The boy allegedly stuffed a plastic bag and a cloth into her mouth, dragged her to an under-construction part of the building where she resided, hit on her head and other body parts with a sickle and also caused injuries to her private parts with a stick, an official said.

Additional Superintendent of Police (ASP) Vivek Lal said an information was received on February 1 that the body of a 58-year-old woman was lying at an under-construction building.

The police and forensic team reached the spot and it was found the woman



was brutally murdered by an unidentified person, he said. On the basis of tip-off from informers and the investigation, the police zeroed-in on the boy living in her neighbourhood.

The woman's family members also expressed suspicion on the boy, who used to come to their house to watch television two years back, the official said. The woman's family had accused the boy of stealing a mobile phone two years

ago and the boy wanted to take revenge for it, he said.

The boy wanted to take revenge because of the embarrassment he faced in the village following the theft charge, the official said. On January 30, when the victim's son and husband were out of station, the boy entered her house. He allegedly overpowered the woman sleeping on a cot and when she tried to scream, he stuffed a polythene bag and a cloth into her mouth, the police official said.

After tying her to a door, the boy allegedly hit the woman repeatedly and raped her when she became motionless after being suffocated, the official said. He also hit on the victim's head, hands, throat and chest with a sickle and caused injuries to her private parts with a stick, Lal said.

The boy later fled after taking away Rs 1,000 cash and jewellery kept in the woman's house, he said. "After being detained, the boy admitted to the crime during interrogation," the official said.

# Case registered against woman who branded 3-month-old girl by hot iron rod in Shahdol

## Several block level officers transferred

A case under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act (JJ Act) has been registered against the woman healer who performed branding on a 3 month old girl in Shahdol, on Sunday. The victim girl died after alleged 'daagna' (branded with hot iron rod) took place in village Kathautiya under Singhpur police station of Shahdol district on Saturday night.

The victim was allegedly branded 24 times in the name of treatment and was taken out of her grave on Friday for conducting post-mortem.

The district administration swung in action after the incident came to light and termi-



nated the services of ASHA worker and ASHA assistant. The administration also transferred the sector medical officer, block education and extension officer, lady health visitors (LHV), BPM, block community mobiliser, two community health officers and two RBSK medical

officers of Sohagpur block. Additionally, a show cause notice has been served to the block medical officer, YK Paswan. "As soon as the incident was reported, I got in touch with the doctors. They said that the reason for her death was acute pneumonia. Such malpractices have been

reported in Shahdol for a long time. The administration has been making every possible effort to put an end to such malpractices. However, despite such efforts, some incidents do take place. We will ensure that such incidents are not repeated," Shahdol Collector Vandana Vaidya said.

The collector further added that another similar incident has been identified in which the parents of a child of Santapur village had shifted their ailing child to a private hospital. Before shifting the child to a private hospital, the parents had taken her to a healer and branded her. Earlier, the kid was admitted to a government hospital.

# ELDERLY WOMAN'S HANDS TIED, THRASHED, RECORDED ON CAMERA

Bhopal: An elderly woman was tied with a rope and thrashed by a group of people while hurling casteist remarks at her at a village in Madhya Pradesh's Khargone district. A video of the incident has been shared widely on social media.

A man and two women have been named in a first information report, or FIR, filed under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, which severely punishes ill-treatment to tribes. In the police complaint, the woman said some people in her neighbourhood picked a fight with her for no reason and also abused her verbally with casteist comments. She lives alone in her house at village Hirapur. Her son is a labourer in Indore. The woman said her neighbour, Ganesh, came to her house after drinking and started hurling casteist abuse on Friday. When she stopped him, his wife and mother also reached there and dragged her out, according to the police complaint. "All three dragged me out and tied my hands behind my back. Then they thrashed me. A video of the incident shows the elderly woman being given water from a metal cup while her hands were still tied behind her back. Police officer Manish Khatri said they have filed a case and are investigating the incident.

## CAN ADRIYAN KARMAKAR, GO ONE BETTER THAN HIS ILLUSTRIOUS FATHER





BJP, Cong to woo women voters in 2023 MP polls

The upcoming Assembly elections in Madhya Pradesh are extremely crucial for both the Opposition Congress and the ruling BJP which are busy formulating poll strategies.

Both the parties are specially targeting the female voters, which form half of the population in the state, through their respective election campaigns. The total population in the state is 5,39,87,876, of which male voters are 2,79,62,711 while the number of female voters is 2,60,23,733. Therefore, of the total number of people polling in the state, the BJP and Congress are going all-out to influence the women voters towards them respectively.

On the one hand, the BJP-ruled Madhya Pradesh government has increased the participation of women in urban and rural civic body elections; while on the other hand, a provision has been made for including reservation in government jobs. Apart from this, efforts are underway to make women self-help groups financially 'self-reliant' or 'Aatmanirbhar' under the Madhya Pradesh Livelihood Mission. Now state CM Chouhan has announced the 'Ladli Behna Yojana' for poor and middle-class women. Under this scheme, Rs 1,000 per month will be deposited in the bank accounts of every woman in the state.

On the one hand the BJP and the Madhya Pradesh government are trying to woo women, on the other hand the Congress has announced a separate election manifesto for women before the upcoming state Assembly elections. This poll manifesto will be titled 'Priyadarshini' named after former Prime Minister Indira Gandhi. There will be special provisions for women in this poll manifesto, including issues like women safety, socio-economic strengthening of women, etc. Political analysts believe that both parties are trying to influence women voters, but the real question is whether both the parties will field women legislators in the upcoming state Assembly elections on the basis of their total population in the state.

# ANTIQUATED LOOMS PUSH WEAVERS' VILLAGE PATWA TOLI INTO STRUGGLE FOR SURVIVAL

Patwa Toli of Manpur block in Gaya district, called the 'Manchester' of Bihar, was once identified as a village of weavers. "The situation has drastically changed," said 55-year-old Jumman Ansari, who is a worker in a powerloom here.

The small weavers and the powerloom owners have been facing a tough time as they are unable to compete with the technologically advanced machines of today's era. The demand for readymade garments of Punjab and Ludhiana has increased in the village's markets.

Manpur, which is also known as 'Mini Kanpur,' is situated on the banks of Falgu river in the district. Powerlooms and handlooms are run in almost every house of the village, through which a wide array of fabrics, from gamcha (a traditional cotton towel) to quilt, mattresses and pillow covers are made.

Jumman Ansari said that earlier the elders would want their children to join the business, which was also preferred by the children. He added that the situation had changed as these days they do not want the future generations to indulge in the business.

Getting nostalgic of the past, Ansari said that the thread which is now imported from other states, was easily available in the village earlier. He added that the technique of weaving clothes in the village remained the same whereas other states had progressive technology of the same.

President of Bihar Pradesh Weavers Welfare Association, Gopal Prasad Patwa said that earlier threads were made in many areas, including Gaya, Bhagalpur and Mokama of the state. He said that these factories were gradually closed.

Patwa added that it had been rightly said that the business is a cottage industry, in which the whole family gets involved. He said that the Mini Textile Park Screening Yarn Mill at Gaya would prove to be beneficial for the domestic micro cottage textile industry.

He added that adopting modern technology would lead to a decrease in cost and an increase in quality of production. Apart from 12,000 powerloom machines, 1,000 textile production units of a large number of handloom machines run today in the village. A total of 20,000 workers are provided



employment directly or indirectly in operating these machines, running the calendaring machine along with dyeing and washing the yarn. An elderly artisan said that handlooms have been running in Manpur since three to four generations. He said that the majority of handlooms that existed earlier had been replaced by powerlooms, the trend of which increased after 1957.

Powerlooms run at a higher speed as compared to handlooms which increases the production, due to which the people started preferring powerlooms over handlooms. Ravindra Singh, Bihar state president of Laghu Udyog Bharati, said that 70-75 per cent of the produced goods are sent to West Bengal.

Apart from West Bengal, goods are supplied to Assam, Odisha and Jharkhand but there is minimal demand in these states. Singh said that the traders, who used to buy goods from them earlier, have stopped as the quality of goods is low due to not using modern technology.

He said that people of the Patwa Toli are unable to change their machines due to the difficulties faced in availing bank loans. Apart from this, Singh added that recently, discharging the chemicals used to dye yarn in the drains was banned citing pollution, which added to the villagers' problems.

Prakash Patwa, who is associated with the business, said

that the powerlooms that run in other parts of India including Rajasthan, Gujarat and Uttar Pradesh are equipped with state-of-the-art techniques, due to which they are flourishing. He added that such modernisation was still a long way to go in Patwa Toli.

Patwa said that the red coloured gamcha made in the village is popular amongst the tribals of Bengal, Odisha and Assam and has high demands. Powerloom owners claim that such gamchas are not manufactured anywhere else. Significantly, Patwa Toli is also known as the village of IITians.

## China denounces US move to shoot down unmanned 'airship'

Beijing | Agencies

China expressed strong dissatisfaction and opposition towards the US use of force to attack China's civilian unmanned airship, Chinese Foreign Ministry said on Sunday in a statement.

The Chinese side has, after verification, repeatedly informed the US side of the civilian nature of the airship and conveyed that its entry into the US due to force majeure was totally unexpected, the statement said, noting the Chinese side has clearly asked the US side to properly handle the matter in a calm, professional and restrained manner, Xinhua News Agency reported.

A Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson said on Friday when answering a relevant query that the civilian airship is used for research, mainly meteorological purposes. Affected by the Westerlies and with limited self-steering capability, the airship deviated far from its planned course.



According to the statement, the spokesperson of the US Department of Defense also noted the balloon does not present a military or physical threat to people on the ground.

Under such circumstances, the US use of force is a clear overreaction and a serious violation of international practice. China will resolutely safeguard the legitimate rights and interests of the company concerned, and reserve the right to make further responses if necessary, said the statement.

## Forgotten man in Pakistan politics, Musharraf passes away in Dubai

Former dictator, President and military ruler of Pakistan General (Retd) Pervez Musharraf breathed his last in Dubai after being critically ill for about two years.

Musharraf, 79, was in Dubai since 2006. He was suffering with amyloidosis, a rare disease caused by an abnormal development of protein called amyloid in organs and tissues of the whole body. The increasing development of amyloid tissues made it difficult for the organs and tissues to work properly, which became the reason for Musharraf's extended illness and death.

Musharraf's illness was revealed in 2018 when his political party All Pakistan Muslim League (APML) said that he was suffering from the rare disease.

Musharraf's death is being condoled by political and military quarters as despite his departure from Pakistan and re-settlement in Dubai, he enjoyed close support from the military leadership of Pakistan. "May Allah bless the departed soul and give strength to bereaved family," said a statement issued by the Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR) on behalf of Chairman Joint Chiefs of Staff



Committee (CJCS) and Services Chiefs in their heartfelt condolences. Musharraf's time in power as military chief, a military dictator and later a politician is filled with major incidents, which are criticised by many as the worst possible blunders, brunt of which is still being suffered by the country at large. Musharraf's time of dictatorship is criticised for not only attracting political embarrassment for Pakistan due to the Kargil operation; but also the Lal Mosque operation which became the trigger point for a reactionary offensive by terrorists on Pakistan after Musharraf made the country an ally to the US-led war on terror.

Musharraf had several cases against him being heard in the Pakistani courts including that of treason, after he imposed a martial law by ousting the then sitting premier Nawaz Sharif in 1999. This happened after Nawaz Sharif tried to dismiss Musharraf as the army chief, having appointed him above more senior officers just the year before.

Musharraf was declared as an absconder as he refused to appear before the Pakistani courts in various cases against him. Musharraf was also someone who used to showcase the Kargil operation as a feather in his cap whenever he would be addressing the India-Pakistan relations.

Musharraf was also among those who had given a four-point solution to the India-Pakistan dispute on Kashmir, which analysts say was on the verge of being finalised. But because Musharraf's government ended, that major understanding did not materialise. Musharraf had always remained on the target hit list of terrorists as he narrowly escaped at least three assassination attempts on his life by terrorists. His tenure from 2001 to 2008 was ruled under the backdrop of 9/11 terror attacks on the US, which led to the initiation of military operation by the US against terrorists in Afghanistan.

## Locals burn two robbers to death after torture in Karachi

Two alleged street criminals were burnt to death by residents of North Karachi's Sector L1 while fleeing after snatching valuables from a local.

The locals tortured the two men before burning them alive, rescue sources said. The two men died on the spot and their bodies were shifted to a nearby hospital, they added, The News reported.

The police reached the location as soon as they got the news of the incident, SSP Central Maroof Usman said.

The two alleged street criminals have been identified as Muhammad Imran and Nadir Hussain.

According to the police, Imran and Nadir had criminal record. Imran was named in a case in District West while Nadir Hussain was booked in multiple cases in district Korangi, Malir and Central, the police said.



The two criminals were trying to flee after snatching valuables from a local named Jibran, police told the media, The News reported.

According to the police, Jibran shouted as the robbers tried to flee the scene. Shopkeepers near a rickshaw stand caught the men.

The robbers tried to use their firearm but the bullet got stuck. The citizens burnt the accused to death after torture and brought their bodies to the main road. Weapons, mobile phones and a motorcycle were recovered from them, the police said.

## Part of road in Canada to be named Komagata Maru Way

Toronto | Agencies

A portion of a road in Abbotsford, British Columbia, will be named Komagata Maru Way in the memory of 376 Indians who sailed to Canada from India in 1914, but were turned away by the country.

Abbotsford City Council voted unanimously last week to rename a portion of South Fraser Way - which extends from Ware Street to Fairlane Street - to Komagata Maru Way, the Surrey-Now Leader reported.

The decision comes after descendants of those trapped aboard the Komagata Maru ship in Vancouver, asked the council to commemorate the humanitarian role played by Abbotsford's South Asian community at the time.

The project will cost \$4,000 for the renaming. The council has also voted to fund a plaque at the Abbotsford Sikh temple at a cost of \$10,000, and educational kits to inform future generations about the Komagata Maru incident.

"The gesture shows a commitment to promoting and understanding inclusive-



ness, and belonging to all residents regardless of their cultural background. It sends a strong message to our future generations that we must look ... to make sure we have a just society for everybody," Councillor Dave Sidhu told Surrey-Now Leader.

The Sikh residents of Abbotsford rallied together to assist passengers aboard the Komagata Maru... They provided

food, housing, information, and community connection," a committee that was created in 2021 to study the incident, said in its findings.

"This Abbotsford connection to the plight of the Komagata Maru passengers is not well-known locally, and should be recognised as an important point of community pride," the report, which was submitted before the council, said.

The 376 Indians, including Sikhs, Muslims and Hindus, who sailed to Canada from India in 1914, were mostly from Punjab. They were kept from docking for several months in dire conditions, and eventually forced to return to India. They reached Budge Budge near Kolkata on September 23, 1914.

"There (Vancouver) the majority of the passengers were imprisoned, and 20 were killed by gunfire when the ship was fired upon," the report told the council.

The development comes as the historic Komagata Maru Memorial in Vancouver was vandalised earlier this month for the third time in a row between 2021 and 2023.

## Thousands of Israelis protest against govt judicial reform plan

Tens of thousands of Israelis demonstrated in several cities to protest the government's plan to reform the judicial system.

The largest protest is being held in the coastal city of Tel Aviv, which was attended by thousands of people, Xinhua news agency reported.

Demonstrators have rallied for five weeks in a row to voice their discontent with the judicial reforms proposed by Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's government. They say the reforms will weaken the courts and give the ruling coalition more power.

"These people (protestors) came to save our country," said former Prime Minister Yair Lapid at the demonstration in Haifa, northern Israel. "We will fight this in the par-




liament and the courts ... and we will save our country."

Netanyahu and his partners say the changes are necessary in order to limit the judicial system's power, which has become too powerful in recent decades. They also say the Supreme Court often intervenes in political issues that should be determined by the parliament.

Netanyahu has vowed to push forward with the reforms despite the protests.

Netanyahu himself is facing a trial on corruption charges. While he denies any wrongdoing, his opponents say the reforms are personally motivated.

## FATHER-SON DUO BOOKED FOR ABETTING RELATIVE'S SUICIDE OVER LAND DISPUTE

Nashik: An offence has been registered against a 60-year-old man and his son from Maharashtra's Nashik district for allegedly abetting the suicide of a relative, police said on Sunday. Based on a complaint lodged on Friday, the Kalyan Railway police registered a case under section 306 (abetment of suicide) of the Indian Penal Code against the duo, who hail from Sinnar in Nashik district, an official said. As per the complaint, the accused were harassing Jalandar Kashinath Kanchar, 72, over an ancestral land and threatened him, he said. The septuagenarian allegedly committed suicide by jumping in front of a train in October, 2022, the official said.

# "Yet to be matured": Deepak Kesarkar on Aaditya Thackeray's election dare

Maharashtra Minister Deepak Kesarkar on Sunday attacked Shiv Sena leader (UBT) Aaditya Thackeray for challenging CM Eknath Shinde to contest election against him from Mumbai's Worli, and said that he (Aaditya) is yet to be matured. "His (Aaditya's) statement shows that he is young and yet to be matured," Deepak Kesarkar said while reacting to Thackeray's challenge. If he believes that he is so popular and so strong, he should come and take my challenge," Thackeray said. Meanwhile, Balasahebachi Shiv Sena MLA Mangesh Kudalkar also condemned Thackeray's aforesaid remarks and "requested" him to work with them. He dared Thackeray with a similar challenge and said, "I want to tell Aaditya Thackeray that giving challenges is not okay. The Eknath Shinde government is working progressively. I request him to work with us. I will resign in Kurla, he must also resign and prove by winning the elections against me."

# KCR'S PARTY HOLDS FIRST RALLY OUTSIDE TELANGANA IN NANDED

Team Absolute | Nanded | Hyderabad

Telangana Chief Minister K Chandrababoo Naidu, who has renamed his party for his national ambitions, started the journey today with a rally across the border in Maharashtra's Nanded and an appeal to farmers. While no election is due in the area, Nanded has a chunk of Telugu-speaking population. Earlier, some villages in the area had demanded that they be allowed to merge with Telangana in view of the schemes in the neighbouring state. The relaunched Bharat Rashtira Samithi, to be considered a national entity, must be recognised as a state party in at least four states or win six per cent of the votes in any four states and four Lok Sabha seats. Else it has to win two per cent Lok Sabha seats (11 seats) in at least three states.



"That's why BRS slogan is 'Abki baar, kisan sarkar' (This time around, a government for the farmers)," he told the gathering. "If we unite, it is not impossible. In our country, farmers constitute more than 42 per cent and

if the number of farm labourers is also added to that it will be more than 50 per cent which is sufficient to form government," Rao said. "Today, the time has come. 75 years is a long period. Farmers should also be able to write and

make rules," he said. Rao, who had started out with a vision of a non-Congress-non-BJP front, has modified it somewhat with a plan to take his party national. He is now looking at pan-India groups like farmers' bodies, trade unions and civil society groups, where his party may have more traction and present an alternative welfare, development and political agenda. While Telangana is known for farmer-friendly schemes that include Rythu Bandhu life insurance, Rythu Bandhu investment support, subsidy for seed distribution and scheme for farm mechanisation. Maharashtra is the state that has seen the highest number of farmer suicides. Also, both BJP and the Congress are playing key roles in the state - one as part of the ruling alliance and the other is in the opposition. For KCR, the big question will be the expansion in Karnataka, where they are friendly with the opposition Janata Dal Secular of HD Kumaraswamy.

# Delhi Police arrests member of fake coins syndicate from Mumbai

Team Absolute | New Delhi

The Special Cell of the Delhi Police has arrested a Mumbai-based member of an inter-state syndicate of Counterfeit Indian Currency Coin (FICC). Ingit Pratap Singh, the DCP of the Special Cell, said that fake Indian coins in the denomination of Rs 10 having face value of Rs 9,46,000 were recovered from the accused, identified as Jignesh Gala. "Gala was part of the previous module busted in April 2022, wherein FICC to the face value of Rs 10,48,540 was recovered and the manufacturing unit was busted," Singh added. The mastermind of the racket namely Naresh Kumar was arrested in April 2022, and fake currency coins were recovered from him. Later on, at his instance a manufacturing unit cum godown was unearthed at Charkhi Dadri, Haryana and four of his associates were arrested. "During the investigation of accused persons and other evidences collected on record, it was revealed that bulk of FICCs was manufactured by this syndicate and was supplied to different destinations all over country including Mumbai. To unearth the whole nexus and members of the syndicate, backtrail investigation was carried out," the official said. The police got a tip off about Gala and he was found to be in Mumbai. A



team was sent there and he was held from Malad area of Mumbai. "During interrogation Gala has disclosed that he has been involved in the procuring and supplying of fake currency coins for last eight years. Initially, he used to collect currency coins from banks in Surat, local businessman, traders of old currency," the official said. Further investigation is in progress to verify the other sources and receivers of the syndicate.

# Man held with 108 bottles of banned cough syrup

Police have arrested a man and seized 108 bottles of banned cough syrup from his possession in Maharashtra's Thane district, an official said on Sunday. Acting on a tip-off, the police laid a trap in Mumbra area on February 2 and spotted three persons with bags in their hands. On seeing the police, two of them ran away while one was caught, Mumbra police station's assistant police inspector Krupal Borse said. The police found him to be carrying 108 bottles of the banned cough syrup which he had planned to sell, the official said. A case was registered against the accused, identified as Mumbra resident



Ashraf Abdul Razzak Sheikh (21), under relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code and the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, the official said. Efforts were on to nab the two other persons, he

said. The police were enquiring as to from where the three persons got the cough syrup stock and to whom they planned to sell it, the official said.


## BODY OF MAN FOUND IN CREEK

# FIR against ex-cricketer Vinod Kambli on charge of assaulting wife

Police have registered an FIR against former Indian cricketer Vinod Kambli for allegedly assaulting and abusing his wife in an inebriated state at his home in suburban Bandra, an official said on Sunday. No arrest has been made so far in connection with the alleged incident which took place on Friday, he said. Kambli's wife Andrea in her police complaint alleged that he threw the handle of a cooking pan at her due to which she suffered a head injury, the official from Bandra police station said. The incident took place between 1 pm and 1.30



pm on Friday when Kambli reached his flat allegedly under the influence of alcohol and started abusing his wife, he said.

Their 12-year-old son, who was present at that time, intervened in the fight, but Kambli went into the kitchen, brought the handle of a broken frying pan and allegedly threw it on his wife due to which she got injured, the official said quoting the complaint. Kambli's wife later went to the Bhabha Hospital for a medical examination. Based on her complaint, the Bandra police on Friday registered the FIR against Kambli under Indian Penal Code Sections 324 (voluntarily causing hurt by dangerous weapons) and 504 (intentional insult with intent to provoke breach of peace), the official said.

# Maharashtra to set up four circular economy parks for major industries

Maharashtra will set up four circular economy parks for major industries and an enabling policy for the same will be ready by March and implemented from April, a senior state government official has said. These circular economy parks will primarily focus on recycling scrap and other wastes. The proposed parks will come up in Aurangabad, Ratnagiri, near Pune and Nagpur, the state's Principal Secretary for Steel and Mines Harshadeep Kamble said. Kamble was speaking to reporter over the weekend on the sidelines of an international conference on material recycling organised by the Material Recycling Association of India. He said the government is planning a shipbreaking unit at Ratnagiri on the Konkan coast, an e-waste and auto parts unit near Pune, a steel scrap unit at Jalna near Aurangabad and a multipurpose multi-product unit in Nagpur given its geographical centrality. The Nagpur facility will cater to all



major industries that generate waste and will function like a hub and spoke model for the rest of the country, he added. Each unit will be spread across at least 500 acres and maximum of 1,000 acres. The Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation (MIDC) has land banks in all these areas. Besides, land acquisition will not be a problem even though there are some concerns about pollution issues which will be

resolved before the policy is finalised by next month, he noted. The government is ready to offer lots of incentives to early birds in the form of lower GST rates, lower power and water tariffs along with fully developed land at much cheaper rates. These incentives will be for the first comers who can set up such large units. They will also be offered common scrapyards/breaking units, storage and effluent

treatment facilities, he added. He also said the Material Recycling Association of India (MRAI) will act as the knowledge partner with the government for policy drafting and implementation. Earlier, addressing the event on Friday, union Road Transport and Highways Minister Nitin Gadkari said increased use of recycled steel can lead to cost reduction to the tune of 30 per cent for auto components. Steel Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia had on Saturday said his ministry will ask primary steel makers to increase the use of recycled steel to 50 per cent from the present 15 per cent by 2047 as the country plans to become a net zero economy by 2070. Kamble said the domestic recycling industry is currently worth USD 50 billion while the global industry is over USD 4.5 trillion. The domestic industry should touch USD 200 billion by 2030 and USD 600 billion by 2050, he added. With this, Maharashtra will become the first state to have a special policy for circular economy -- which means full adoption of recycling and reuse of materials.

# Sakal Hindu Samaj to hold 'anti-love jihad' meeting in city SC asks police to videograph event

Sakal Hindu Samaj is set to hold a public meeting in Mumbai on Sunday after the state government assured the Supreme Court that clearance would be given subject to the condition that no hate speech is made. Starting November, when it began its string of public meetings against "religious conversion" and "love jihad", the Sakal Hindu Samaj has covered more than 20 of the state's 36 districts. The rally to be held in Mumbai will be the Samaj's third in the city, demanding "stringent laws to stop love jihad and religious conversion of Hindus". While hearing the mat-



ter, the Supreme Court Friday accepted the demand of senior advocate Kapil Sibal, who appeared for the petitioner, that the meeting is videographed. Directing the police to videograph the meeting, the apex court demanded that the contents of the video be made available to it. A loose conglomeration, the Samaj includes right-wing outfits such as the VHP, Bajrang Dal, Hindu Janjagruti Samiti, Hindu Pratisthan, Durga Vahini, Vishwa Shriram Sena and Sanatan Sanstha. Meanwhile, many groups and organisations had written to Mumbai Police Commissioner Vivek Phansalkar, urging him to not give permission to the Sakal Hindu Samaj's public meeting.

I was eagerly awaiting that when I will get fit and get to play for India," said Jadeja in a video posted by the BCCI on their social media handles.

The rescheduled fifth Test against England at Birmingham in July 2022 was the last time Jadeja played a Test match. He then explained the decision to undergo the surgery on his right knee. "Somewhere I was struggling with the



knee and had to undergo surgery. But I had to take a decision on whether I had to do it before or after the (T20) World Cup."

"The doctor had also advised me to do it before the World Cup because there was very less chance to play the World Cup if I hadn't gone under the knife. I then made up my mind to go for the surgery, but the period after that was

very tough as rehab and training there, you have to do it constantly."

The right knee surgery meant Jadeja missed out on the Men's T20 World Cup, tours of New Zealand and Bangladesh as well as home series against Sri Lanka and New Zealand. For the Bangladesh tour, he was named in the squads, but it was subject to fitness and was subsequently ruled out.

In her first ever 60m race, world 400m hurdles record-holder Sydney McLaughlin-Levrone (UAS) clocked 7.33 to finish fifth in the first heat and miss out on the final by 0.01. World 200m champion Shericka Jackson of Jamaica was also testing her speed in Boston and ran 7.34, finishing fifth in her own heat.


