71% Indian professionals confident to retain jobs in 2023 despite global layoffs

bout seven in 10 (71 per cent) professionals in India are confident about keeping their jobs in 2023 despite the rough macroeconomic conditions and global layoffs, a report showed on Monday.

There is a stark difference in the confidence levels of freshers and entry-level professionals and the ones with more than six years of experience. While 63 per cent of professionals



with 0-3 years of experience are confident about retaining their job, this number jumps up to 83 per cent for professionals with more that six years of experience, according to the report by edtech company Great Learning.

"With a tighter job market in 2023, skill development will be as critical as ever. The increase in intent to upskill in 2023 among professionals is expected given how rapidly technology and business practices are evolving," said Hari Krishnan Nair, Co-Founder, Great Learning. "In 2023, the primary motivation for Indians to upskill is career growth within their current organisation. This is followed by personal interest and the expectation of new job opportunities as a result of upgraded skills," it added. In general, more male professionals enrolled in upskilling programs in 2022, but the gap in representation becomes more pronounced at higher levels of work experience.

This is even lower than the general industry trend for female representation at senior positions, the report

CENTRE AGREES TO SET UP EXPERT PANEL ON PROTECTING INVESTORS

he Central government on Monday informed the Supreme Court that the existing structure, which includes the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) and others agencies, are fully equipped to handle the situation which occurred after Hindenburg report on Adani group, and it would not oppose the court's suggestion to constitute a committee to strengthen the existing regime.It stressed that the court could permit it to suggest the remit of that committee with possible suggestions of names of the committee.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, representing the Centre, submitted before a bench headed by Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud that: "Our instructions are that existing structure fully equipped not only regime wise but otherwise also, in taking care of the situation.

"However, responding to suggestion which fell from your lordshipsathe government has no objection in constituting a committee." The bench asked the SG to come back with the proposed remit of the committee by Friday and put it down on a note for the bench to examine, so that it could either modify or reflect on it, and then it can pronounce an order.Advocate Vishal Tiwari, one of the petitioners, argued that although organisational structure is there, yet this problem has arisen, there may be some loopholes which could be examined by the expert committee.The bench said it will continue hearing the matter on

SC REGISTERS SUO MOTU CASE ON **UNLICENSED FIREARMS**

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Monday observed that unlike the US where the right to bear arms is a fundamental right, no such right has been conferred on anybody under the Indian Constitution, while registering a suo motu case to curb the large number of unlicensed firearms in the country.

The bench, hearing a bail application of murder noted that an irearm was used and offences under along with 307 of the IPC was registered. It added that it has come across several cases where unlicensed arms were used and termed the trend "very disturbing".

The bench observed that unlike the US constitution where the right to bear arms is a fundamental right and under the wisdom of our founding fathers, no such right has been conferred on anybody under the Constitution.

PETITION DISMISSED AGAINST DELIMITATION IN J&K

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Monday affirmed delimitation of Assembly and parliamentary constituencies in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir.A bench headed by Justice Sanjay Kishan Kaul and comprising Justice A.S. Oka clarified that the decision on delimitation would not affect a separate batch of matters where abrogation of Article 370 is under challenge before a constitution bench of the apex court. The detailed judgment will be uploaded later in the day.

NOMINATED MEMBERS CAN'T GO FOR ELECTION'

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Monday orally observed that the nominated members cannot vote in the election for the mayor of a municipal corporation.

During the hearing, the office of the Delhi Lt Governor told the court that it would postpone the February 16 may-oral election to a date after February 17.

A bench headed by Chief Justice of India D Y Chandrachud orally observed that nominated members cannot go for the election and the constitutional provision is very clear. Senior advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi contended before the bench, that Article 243 R of the Constitution makes it very clear. Additional Solicitor General Saniav Jain, representing the office of Delhi LG, suggested that the election scheduled on February 16 can take place after February 17.

The bench said that they will be permitted in a committee is a different aspect of the matter. Singh said there are three committees which constitute the corporation itself. The top court was hearing a petition filed by AAP leader Shelly Oberoi in connection with the election of mayor of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD). The top court has scheduled the hearing in the matter on February 17.

BJP MP DEMANDS SEPARATE STATE OF BUNDELKHAND IN LOK SABHA



New Delhi: The demand for the creation of Bundelkhand state by separating its districts from Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh is decades old. BJP MP from Uttar Pradesh's Hamirpur Lok Sabha constituency, Kunwar Pushpendra Singh Chandel again demanded the forma-Bundelkhand state in the Lok Sabha on Monday.

During Zero Hour in the Lok Sabha, Chandel demanded the formation of a new Bundelkhand state by separating its parts from Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh, saying that Bundelkhand is a special region, which has its own distinct culture.

He added that as per the intentions of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, Bundelkhand should be made a separate state for its development and to ensure that organic farming, employment, tourism, culture and religious sectors are promoted in the area.

Liquor has been banned in Bihar since April 2016 but is still available illicitly and a large number of people have lost their lives by drinking spurious or poisonous liquor. One such incident recently occurred in Chapra district when more than 100 persons died in January this year.

Too early to gauge spillovers of central bank digital currency: Sitharaman

New Delhi: Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Monday told the Parliament that it is still too early to gauge the spillovers of the central bank digital currency (CBDC), while assailing concerns on whether it would impinge on an individual's autonomy.

Replying to a question on the CBDC during Question Hour in Lok Sabha, she said that digital currency is something which the RBI issues. "Reserve Bank of India has come up with a pilot project in terms of retail and wholesale use of digital currencies for which there are several sandboxes created, so that user cases can be tested. It is only during this process and immediately after that can there be any kind of understanding on how the retail or the wholesale use of digital currencies will have any spill overs for which any action has to be planned.

'LTTE CHIEF PRABHAKARAN **ALIVE', CLAIMS TAMIL LEADER**

amil nationalist leader and President of World Tamil Confederation, Pazha Nedumaran on Monday claimed that LTTE leader, Velupillai Prabhakaran is alive and lives with his wife and daughter.

While addressing the media at Thanjavur, Nedumaran said Prabhakaran's location will be disclosed at an appropriate time. He said that the Sri Lankan government had portrayed Prabhakaran as anti-India. Since the present global situation is optimistic and the Rajapakse rule has ended, he was disclosing this now. Nedumaran added. The Tamil nationalist leader also said that the information that Prabhakaran was alive will instil a lot of confidence among the Tamils in Sri



Lanka and that he has made the announcement with Prabhakaran's permission.

Sivaji Lingam, a former Member of Parliament from Sri Lanka said that the Sri Lankan government had not confirmed the body of Prabhakaran. He added that the announcement made by Nedumaran that Prabhakaran was alive has brought a lot of happiness to the Tamil people across

the world. Notably, in May 2009, after the final battle between LTTE and Sri Lankan Army, it was announced that Prabhakaran was killed and some photographs released.

LCA Tejas at the centre stage of 'India Pavilion' at Aero India 2023

LCA Tejas is a single engine, light weight, highly agile, multi-role supersonic fighter aircraft. It has quadruplex digital fly-by-wire Flight Control System (FCS) with associated advanced flight control

Tejas is equipped with state-of-the-art features like glass cockpit, zero-zero ejection seat, inflight refueling probe, jam-proof AESA radar, UEWS with SPJ, CMDS, HMDS DashV, BVR missile capability and many more which make the aircraft more lethal. The LCA has come a long way in terms of development and is presently available in Air Force fighter and twin-seater and LCA Navy fighter



and twin-seater variants. Other variants like LCA LIFT (Lead in fighter trainer) and MK-2 are being developed for LCA Tejas.The 14th edition of Aero India will have a separate 'India Pavilion', which is based on the 'fixed wing platform' theme to showcase India's growth in the area, including the future prospects for the same. The India Pavilion will also showcase the growth of India in developing an eco-system for fixed wing platform which includes the demonstration of various structural modules, simulators, systems (LRUs) etc. of LCA Tejas aircraft being produced by private partners. There will also be a section for

ith the arrest of three persons, the Delhi Police's Crime Branch said it has busted a racket involved in forging documents including Aadhaar cards, PAN card, and driving license for obtaining SIM cards, opening bank accounts and taking

The accused, who were operating from a cyber cafe in Jahangirpuri area, also used to sell the bank account details to other fraudsters, the official

Police have also recovered 27 Aadhaar cards, 34 PANS cards, four election identity cards, 15 blank chip cards for driving license, 20 cheque books, 48 SIM cards, 15 mobile phones, a stamp of Adarsh Nagar MLA Pawan Sharma etc from the possession of the

The accused have been identified as Rohit alias Aakash, a resident of Mukandpur, Pintu, a resident of village Wazirabad. and Anurag, a resident of Baprola.

etc through fraudulent means. "Police sent a decoy to the cyber cafe where the proprietors of the cyber cafe agreed to prepare PAN card and Aadhaar card through fraudulent means and also provided a SIM card for using the documents in bank," Special Commissioner of Police, Crime, Ravindra Singh Yadav, said.

"After confirmation, the cyber cafe was raided and three persons were apprehended. Several forged docuseized," he added.

Many of the PAN cards issued in different names were found in NSDL envelopes mentioning the address of the holder as Jahangirpuri which happens to be the same address where the cyber cafe was being run.

On interrogation of the accused, police found that they used ordinary persons who don't have any ID documents for preparing these documents and further misusing them. "It also came out that in some cases

instead of fingerprints, they used the toe prints. They have opened a large number of bank accounts in different names. Many cheque books as detailed below have also been recovered," said the Special CP. Rohit was looking after the work at Aaynaa Cyber Cafe with the owner Kareem. "He along with Kareem are involved in preparing the documents and also printing fake licenses on chip based blank cards," said the official. Pintu used to provide the SIM cards to Kareem and Rohit by using aadhar cards prepared by the gang. "To activate and get the activation SMS, different mobile phones were being used,"

The Congress had on Sunday criticised the appointment of Justice Nazeer as the Governor. Party spokesperson Abhishek Singhvi alleged that this is being made a tradition which is



wrong.Singhvi recalled statement of late BJP leader Arun Jaitley that the desire of a post-retirement job influences pre-retirement judgements, and the former Union Minister had termed this as a threat to the independence of judiciary. Justice Nazeer, who hails from Karnataka, was on the Constitution bench of the Supreme Court that delivered verdict in

Ayodhya case. He was also on the full bench that delivered the verdict on the triple talaq controversy. Welcoming Justice Nazeer, Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy said on

Sunday that he is looking forward to working with him in unravelling Andhra Pradesh's full potential.

Justice Nazeer succeeded Biswa Bhusan Harichandan, who was moved to Chhattisgarh Raj Bhavan.

Harichandan, a senior BJP leader from Odisha, had assumed office as Governor in July 2019, a couple of months after YSRCP came to power. Meanwhile, Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy along with his wife Y.S. Bharathi Reddy, called on Harichandan and his wife Suprava Harichandan at Raj Bhavan on Monday.



Munshi Chowk area in Khandwa, around 360 km from Bhopal. The situation was under control, police said on Monday. However, a heavy police force was deployed in the area and Section 144 imposed in

At least four police personnel, including a Chief Superintendent of



Police and SHO, were reported injured in stone pelting.

Five alleged perpetrators of the incident have been detained so far, and identification of more was under way, police said on Monday.

"On Sunday, around 8.30 p.m, a

group of people barged into the house, installed Hanuman's idol and chanted mantras. This led to people from both communities gathering outside the house. Both sides pelted stones at each other, but police

crowd," a senior police official said on

As per the police, the house where the incident took place belonged to one Ganesh Jadhay, which was recently sold to a Muslim, Shaikh Asagar. The agitated people even attacked the police who arrived to control the situation, prompting them to use tear gas to disperse the crowd.

"Three cases under different IPC Sections pertaining to house-trespassing, attempt to murder and rioting lodged and as many as five persons have been detained so far. The prime accused in the entire incident is a self-styled Hindu leader Ravi Awhad," police officials said.

Notably, last year (on April 10, 2022), a communal clash had broken out in Khandwa's bordering district -

group of unidentified people torched and defiled a church in Madhya Pradesh's Narmadapuram district, police said on Monday. Locals found burnt furniture inside, walls blackened with smoke from the fire, and 'Ram' written on the wall inside the Christian prayer hall in Chauki Pura village in tribal dominated Sukhtawa block of the district. A case was filed under Indian Penal Code Section 295 (Injuring or defiling place of worship with intent to insult the religion of any class) against unidentified accused.

According to initial investigation, the vandals entered the place of worship, built around five years ago and located 40 km from the district headquarters, by removing a window net and burnt it from inside, Gurukaran Singh, Superintendent of Police, Narmadapuram, said. Some religious texts and other items including furniture were also destroyed in the fire, an official said, quoting a complaint filed in connection with the incident. The church, located in Sukhtawa village of Kesala block,



was connected to the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, locals said.

Another communal face-off over the forcible installing of a Hanuman idol in a Muslim man's house in the state's Khandwa city was reported today. The police used force to disperse both sides, which was met with stone pelting, injuring four police personnel. He used to demand lakhs of rupees from her. When she began receiving calls, she informed Shahpura police, who began probe and identified the accused as Mridul.

After this, Mridul also blackmailed Dr Arvind Bedkar who runs a clinic at Talaiyya, after which the police swung into action and arrested him.

The state government suspended the officer and attached him to the PHQ till further orders.

FLOOD-RESISTANT RICE

he Agriculture institute in Karaikal, Puducherry has developed a new rice variety that can tolerate floods. The rice variety was developed with the *support of the Department of* Biotechnology, Central government. The rice variety, KKL(R)2 was developed by a team of researchers led by Dr. S. Thirumeni, Head of the Department of Plant Breeding and Genetics, at the Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru College of Agriculture and Research Institute. During samba/thalady season, the paddy crop is affected in rain and shortterm submergence leads to the destruction of these crops. The institute has been working on the development of water submergence-tolerant rice varieties. Dr S. Thirumeni said, "The new variety KKL(R)2 was developed by crossing ADT 46 and Swarna Sub 1 through the 'Marker Assisted Backcross Method' three times." He also said that the new rice variety matures in 135 days and is suitable for the Samba season. The scientist said that this rice variety is tolerant to flash floods and submergence for a period of 14 days during the tillering stage. Dr Thirumeni and his team told IANS that the average grain yield of KKL(R) 2 is 6,850 kg per hectare under normal circumstances but under submerged conditions, it can give a yield of 3,600 kg per hectare. KKL(R) 2 is the first rice Puducherry rice variety that is recommended for release by Central Variety Release Committee (CVRC). Scientists also said that this rice variety is moderately resistant to pets including brown plant hopper, white-backed brown hopper, and blast and brown spot.

As I sit down to write this piece, both PoJK and PoGB are suffering from severe shortages of both wheat and electricity. Hundreds of families are starving and thousands have

become unemployed as a result of the closing down of small businesses and workshops. Protests against economic deprivation have been a daily

occurrence for almost a year now. People have braved minus 20 degree celsius temperatures

to observe daily sit-ins Pensioners have not been paid for months in both territo-

ries as the treasury has gone dry. Government employees in PoJK have not been paid their salaries for three months. An attempt to garner support for Pakistan in PoJK-GB by

observing February 5 as Kashmir Solidarity Day has also back-On the day, protests were held in several cities in which, one after the other, speakers rejected Pakistan's claim that India

was mistreating Kashmiris in the union territory. A comparison of prices of flour, onion, tomatoes and other daily essentials between the Kashmir Valley and PoJK is the

talk of every town and village in PoJK-GB. The International Monetary Fund (IMF) team has arrived in

Pakistan and are dictating Islamabad to make deep cuts into the privileges and perks of military and bureaucracy. The IMF has asked for an increase in fuel and electricity

prices and to raise \$6 billion in the next five months and a total of \$16 billion in foreign exchange before it presents the next fiscal budget in June this year.

The IMF is demanding these reforms to be made and targets to be achieved in order for it to release a mere \$1.3 billion loan, which the IMF has held back since November last year.

As Pakistan's economy is in a freefall, its military has just earned a whopping Rs 40 billion profit from a record sale of fertilizer worth Rs 109 billion by Fauji Fertilizer Company Limited, which is a military business enterprise. Not to mention that its former Army chief, General Qamar Javed Bajwa, had accumulated Rs 12 billion before he retired in November

Millions of dollars' worth of lithium and other precious minerals from PoJK-GB are being looted and smuggled into Pakistan on a daily basis and are unaccounted for.

Just to give you a perspective of the value of the loot, I must tell you that one truck load of 25 tons of lithium is worth Rs 53 crore. Pakistan is not poor and neither is PoJK-GB.

However, the Military-Mullah-Feudal troika has collectively usurped the land and the minds of its people.

Baloch, Sindhi, Pashtun and the people of PoJK-GB are liv-

ing under the barrel of the military gun. No real political or economic rights are allowed to be freely exercised by them. However, in order to achieve liberation from Pakistan, all stakeholders, including the oppressed people of PoJK-GB, Balochistan, Sindh, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa have to be bang on the beat and that can only become possible if they form a collective warring alliance.

BEIJING DENIES THREE 'OBJECTS' DOWNED BY US CAME FROM CHINA

eijing has denied any knowledge of the three "airborne objects" that the US military shot down in North American airspace over the weekend as China prepares to take down an unidentified flying object near one of its main naval bases, media reports said.

Chinese Foreign Ministry's spokesperson Wang Wenbin told reporters in Beijing on Monday that any suggestion that they came from China is just a "smear", RFA reported.

The US North American Aerospace Defense Command (NORAD) announced that "an F-16 fired an AIM9x to successfully shoot down an airborne object flying at approximately 20,000 feet altitude in the US airspace over Lake Huron in the state of Michigan" at 2:42 p.m. on Sunday.

This object was first spotted on Saturday over Montana, when it flew near sensitive military sites, U.S. officials told the media, RFA reported.

However, NORAD said it was not assessed "to be a kinetic military threat to anything on the ground," but a safety flight



hazard and "a threat due to its potential surveillance capabilities."Before this, a "high-altitude object" was shot down on Saturday over the Yukon territory in Canada and another "flying object" on Friday off the Northern coast of Alaska, both by US F-22 fighters.

Authorities have yet to determine

whether the flying objects are linked to reported.Meanwhiloe, China's Foreign Ministry said the US has flown balloons into its airspace more than 10 times in the past year, BBC reported.Questioned on Monday, Beijing said the US had made many airspace breaches.

"It's not uncommon as well for the US to illegally enter the airspace of other countries," said Foreign Ministry spokesman Wang Wenbin at a regular press briefing.

'Since last year alone, US balloons have illegally flown above China more than 10 times without any approval from Chinese authorities

'The first thing the US side should do is start with a clean slate, undergo some selfreflection, instead of smearing and accus-

ing China," he added. He said Beijing had responded to the

incursions in a "responsible and professional" manner.

"If you want to know more about US high-altitude balloons illegally entering China's airspace, I suggest you refer to the US side," he said, BBC reported.

4,300 DEATHS REPORTED IN NW **SYRIA FOLLOWING EARTHQUAKE: UN**

Damascus: A total of 4,300 deaths ed in northwestern Syria as a result of the massive earthquake that hit the country a week ago, a UN relief agency said on Monday.

The tally reported by the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs does not include the condition in government-controlled areas, Xinhua news agency reported.

The district with the highest death toll and injuries as of Sunday is Harim, followed by Afrin and Jebel Saman in northwestern Syria, said the agency.

The Syrian health ministry said in an update on Sunday night that 1,414 people in the country had been killed and 2,349 wounded.

Meanwhile, the latest statistics from the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights showed that the quake has killed about 5,329 people in government and rebel-held areas.

Iranian Prez to visit China on February 14

announced on Sunday that the president of Iran will travel to China at the official invitation of his Chinese counterpart, Tasnim News Agency reported. "At the invitation of President Xi

Jinping, President of the Islamic Republic of Iran Ebrahim Raisi will pay a state visit to China from February 14 to 16," she said.



In a congratulatory message to Xi Jinping on securing a third term as the Communist Party's leader in October 2022, Raisi described the goals of strategic cooperation between Tehran and Beijing as a model of broad relations on the basis of mutual respect.

The Iranian president also noted that cooperation between Iran and China within the framework of multilateral organisations and institutions would serve the interests of the two nations and help protect international peace and stability.

Ahluwalia in December 2022 to ensure the exiled professor and his wife's return to Fiji.

"I will apologise on behalf of the people of Fiji for the way they were treated," Rabuka had said, adding that the prohibition order against Ahluwalia was "unreasonable and inhumane". Ahluwalia has been working out of the USP's Samoa Campus in Alafua since December 2021.

n uncertain economic conditions, consumers in Karachi continue to receive severe price shocks following an unchecked hike in the prices of daily use items.

Loose milk, which has been increased to Pak Rs 210 from Pak Rs 190 per litre by some shopkeepers and live broiler chicken which has seen an increase of Rs 30-40 per kg in the last two days, taking the cost to Rs 480-500 per kilogram, Dawn reported. Earlier this month, the live bird was available at Rs 390-440 per kg while it was being sold between Rs 380-420kg in the last week of January, 2023. The chicken meat is now being sold at Rs 700-780 a kg which was Rs 620-650 per kg a few days ago, Dawn reported.

Boneless meat price hit a new peak of Rs 1,000-1,100 per kg, showing a jump of Rs 150-200 per kg in



the same period.Boneless poultry meat rate has crossed the price of boneless veal which is currently being sold at Rs900-1,000 per kg,

while meat with bones is selling at Rs 800-850 per kg.


On loose milk, Karachi Milk Retailers Association media coordi-

nator Waheed Gaddi claimed that "over 1,000 shopkeepers are selling milk at an inflated rate. These are actually shops of wholesalers/dairy farmers and not our members."

He said: "Our 4,000 retail members have kept the price unchanged at Rs 190 per litre.'

In case the price hike announced by dairy farmers and wholesalers is not reverted, retailers will be bound to charge Rs 220 per litre instead of Rs 210 from the consumers as per new rate calculation after Rs 27 per litre jump in procurement price, he added, Dawn reported.

On Dec 16, 2022, retailers got an increase of Rs 10 per litre from the commissioner of Karachi to sell milk at Rs 180 per litre, but majority of retailers continued to sell milk at Rs 190 per litre, rejecting the official rate. At that time, the official wholesale rate was also increased from Rs 160 per litre to Rs 170.

Protests erupt after tower wagon kills 4 railmen in Nashik

t least four railway trackmen were crushed to death after a train tower wagon rolled down from the wrong side near Lasalgaon in Maharashtra's Nashik, triggering protests by local rail workers, officials said here on Monday.

The tragedy occurred around 5.45 a.m. when the workers were working on the tracks and tower wagon suddenly came from the wrong direction, killing them instantly.

Tower wagons are used for maintaining overhead equipment and electrical fittings in electrified sections of the railway networks, generally during low traffic hours.

On learning of the gruesome tragedy, Lasalgaon police and local Central Railway officials rushed to the spot and the tower wagon driver was detained.

The victims have been identified as Dinesh S. Darade, 35, Santosh B. Kedar, Sukhdev Shirshat, both 38, and Krishna A. Ahire, 40.

Shocked by the calamity hitting their four colleagues, several railway employees staged



protests at Lasalgaon railway station, accusing the railway officials of negligence and not reaching the spot for several hours.

They also blocked the Mumbai-bound Manmad-LTT Godavari Express for a few minutes before police removed them from the tracks, though CR services were marginally delayed owing to the accident.

12-YEAR-OLD BOY **KILLED AS FIRE BREAKS OUT IN SLUM IN MALAD**

Mumbai: A 12-year-old boy was killed after a major fire broke out in several hutments in Kurar village of Malad area in Mumbai on Monday, a fire official said. The blaze erupted at around 11.15 am and was "confined to 50 to 100 hutments," the official said. It was a level-two' (major) fire, he said.

After the incident, a boy was rushed to Shatabdi hospital where he was declared brought dead, the official said. Eight fire engines, four jumbo tankers, ambulance and other assistance were rushed to the spot, he said.

Two hose lines were also in operation and the blaze was brought under control, the official said, adding that cooling operation was on. The cause of the fire was not yet known.

Woman cheated of Rs 3.68 lakh over Valentine's Day gift

51-year-old woman from A Mumbai allegedly lost Rs 3.68 lakh after being lured by a man on a social media platform under the pretext of sending her a gift for the Valentine's Day, a police official said on Monday.

The woman, who is married, came in contact with the man, who introduced himself as Alex Lorenzo, on Instagram last Wednesday, the official from Khar police station said.

The man later told her that he had sent her a Valentine's Day gift for which she will have to pay a fee of Euros 750 after receiving the parcel, he said quoting the complainant.

Later, she received a message from a courier company that as the parcel was heavier than the permissible limit, she would have to pay an addi-



tional charge of Rs 72,000, which she paid, the official said.

The courier company representatives contacted the woman again saying they had found European curren cy notes in the parcel and to avoid

being charged for money laundering,

she would have to shell out Rs 2,65,000. She then paid the sum, he

However, when the woman was asked again to pay another Rs 98,000 to get the parcel that the man had sent her, she got suspicious. When she stopped paying the amount, Lorenzo started threatening her saying he would post her pictures on social media and also share them with her family members, the official said.

The woman subsequently lodged a complaint with the Khar police. Based on the complaint, the police on Sunday registered an FIR against two unidentified persons under various Indian Penal Code sections including 420 (cheating) and provisions of the Information Technology Act, the official said.

An investigation has been launched into the case, he added.

Missing NRI traced to Mumbai suburb, reunited with family after 12 days

69-year-old Non-Resident Indian, who went missing from Mumbai international airport, has been traced to a suburb and reunited with his daughter after 12 days with the help of two alert citizens, police said on Monday.

The NRI, Dharmalingam Pillai, who has been suffering from memory loss and lives in South Africa, went missing on January 30 a few hours before he and his daughter were scheduled to take a flight from the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport here to Durban, they said.

Pillai, who is a retired clerk, and his daughter, working on a senior position in the field of logistics, had come to India to visit their roots on the occasion of his birthday. His grandfather had gone to South Africa and since then the family was settled in Durban, an official said.

A missing person's report was registered at Sahar police station on January 31 following which around 7,000 handbills and posters carrying Pillai's picture and other information were printed and circulated in the city with the help of his daughter and



the office of the South African Consulate General in Mumbai, he said. The city police also shared information about Pillai on social media platforms, he

A number of police teams were formed for a probe into the case and they examined the CCTV footage of various locations to search for Pillai, the official said.

Two citizens, who were aware about the missing NRI through social media and news articles, on Sunday spotted Pillai wandering on 14th Road in suburban Khar. They enquired with him and then informed the police control room, he said. A team was rushed there and the information was also shared with Pillai's daughter.

Pillai was then brought to the Sahar police station and reunited with his daughter on Sunday evening, the official said. "It was an emotional moment for everyone," he said.

"The awareness among Mumbaikars helped in tracing Pillai and this is an example of police and citizens working together," the official said, adding it was a challenging task to search for a person, who has memory loss issue, amid the huge city population. Teams comprising senior police inspector Sanjay Gowilkar and sub-inspectors Sushant Bavachkar and Sunil Vagre were involved in tracing

Day after Dalit student's suicide, students' group points fingers at IIT-B

day after the alleged suicide of 18-year-old Dalit student Darshan Solanki of IIT-Bombay, the Ambedkar Periyar Phule Study Circle (APPSC-IITB) on Monday pointed fingers at the institution for various lapses vis-a-vis pupils hailing from non-urban areas and belonging to SC/ST categories.

Solanki, in the B.Tech. First Year Chemical Engineering course, jumped to death from the 7th floor of the hostel building in the IIT-Bombay's Powai Campus on Sunday afternoon, after completing his first semester exams a day earlier.

In a detailed statement on social media on campus suicides, the APPSC-IIT

Team Absolute Mumbai Bombay termed it as "an working of the SWC, called institutional issue", as students from non-urban, non-English speaking backgrounds, oppressed castes (SC/ST) and low-income families "face immense harassment and discrimination" on the campus from students, faculties and employees. "These institutional and casual ways of casteism cause mental and psychological stress on students, but IITs lack any mechanism to help them. We have been raising the issue of the lack of mental health support for our students a with the IIT administration as well as other forums like National Commission for SC/STs," said the group.

In the wake of Solanki's suicide, the APPSC-IITB has demanded a review of the

upon the IIT-B to address the issue of inclusivity in it, and make the centre more accessible to students coming from all backgrounds.

The students group said that after sustained efforts, the SC/ST cell at IIT-B was set up in 2017, but started its student outreach only from 2022, but still lacks in many aspects like a clear mandate which hinders its appropriate status in the institute, and demanded immediate action in this regard.

"How many more Darshans and Anikets need to die?" the APPSC-IITB asked, urging the IIT-B to shed apathy, probe Solanki's death and resolve all the issues pertaining to students from SC/ST/OBCs it had raised.

MAN STRANGLES PREGNANT WIFE TO DEATH, ARRESTED: COPS

Mumbai: A 24-year-old woman was allegedly strangled to death in Mumbai's Dharavi, the police said on Monday. The woman, identified as Roshni Saroj, was pregnant, added Mumbai police.

Officials said that the incident took place on February 11 morning in Dharavi. The victim's husband Kanhaiyalal Saroj has been arrested in connection to the incident, the Mumbai police said. According to the police, a case has been registered against Roshni's mother-in-law and father-in-law on the complaint of Roshni's father Suresh Saroj. Suresh Saroj alleged that Roshni was first strangled to death and then faked to be hanging. The victim was harassed mentally and physically for dowry. Initial probe shows that the woman was strangled to death, officials said while adding that they were further looking into the incident.

Mumbai Metro 6 is two-third ready, to boost east-west connectivity



Mumbai Metropolitan Region **Development Authority** Commissioner S.V.R. Srinivas said that the civil works on Metro stations on Line 6 is over 50 per cent

Besides, 71 per cent of the viaduct work is completed on the line which will connect Swami Samarth Nagar to Vikhroli on the Eastern Express Highway via Jogeshwari, Western Express Highway and Powai.

The major portion of the line will run through the Jogeshwari Vikhroli Link Road, an elevated corridor that would connect the two national



highways (EEH-WEH), as well as the east-west and north-south regions, said Srinivas

Providing railway access to governmental, commercial and geographically important areas of the

city. Line 6 with 13 stations will be integrated with the existing Mumbai Metro Lines 2A, 3, 4 and 7, and the Jogeshwari and Kanjurmarg suburban railway stations. Expected to slash the travel time between EEH-WEH by upto 45 minutes, the Line 6 is coming up at a cost of over Rs 6,700 crore, with a target to complete in next couple of years. The project comprising a combined 2.58-km long road flyover will be constructed below this line at a common pier in the road media to provide additional transport facilities, ensuring its completion with the construction of the Mumbai Metro depot, said Srinivas.

The extended phases of Line 2A and 7 on the WEH and Link Road opened in January - has proved to be a boon for suburban commuters while decongesting traffic on the roads, entailing savings of time and

Gill had wowed fans in January with a lethal combination of graceful and attacking strokeplay. His stand-out performance came


