On this day in 2019, 40 CRPF personnel lost their lives in the Pulwama terror attack four years ago. The jawans lost their lives after a suicide bomber drove a car laden with explosives into the security force convoy.

The attack was carried out by the Pakistani terror group Jaish-e-Mohammed, which is led by Masood Azhar based in Bahawalpur.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi also paid homage to the soldiers. He wrote in a tweet, "Remembering our valorous heroes who we lost on this day in Pulwama. We will never forget their supreme sacrifice. Their courage motivates us to build a strong and developed India."

Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan today participated in Samadhan Online through video conferencing from Samatva Bhawan, Chief Minister's residence. CM Chouhan got pending problems of the applicants of various districts resolved online. The Chief Minister congratulated the best performing officers who resolved 100 percent complaints lodged in departments, districts and CM Helpline.



Chief Minister Chouhan has issued instructions to stop the increment of a development block medical officer guilty of delay in various cases, suspension of a Patwari, departmental inquiry in one case, stop one increment each of two Tehsildars and give show cause notice to a principal.

Chief Minister Chouhan ensured the payment of an amount of Rs 51,000 made to an applicant Neetu Patel of Sidhi district on the com-

plaint of non-receipt of assistance amount in the Mukhya Mantri Kanya Vivah/Nikah Yojana. Janpad Office Sidhi was directed to provide immediate assistance in such cases in future. In a similar case, necessary action was taken and payment of

amount made on the application of Purushottam Singh of Umaria district. Action was also taken on the complaint of the applicant Brijesh of Singrauli district. In this case, there was a delay due to the change of mobile number by the officer who

resolved the case registered in the CM Helpline. Chief Minister Chouhan said that it should be ensured that the facility of changing the mobile number should not be misused by the officials who are responsible for disposal of applications.

Chief Minister Chouhan also took serious note of the inaction on the application of Shyamlal Prajapat of Ujjain district to feed his land details online. He has given instructions to stop one increment each of two Tehsildars found guilty and to suspend one Patwari. Chief Minister Chouhan had been given an application for non-receipt of compensation amount by Mehraj Gond of Jabalpur, who was injured in an attack by wild animals. In this case, the applicant was immediately paid the compensation amount of Rs. 50 thousand. In two cases of Chhindwara district also, Chief Minister Chouhan got the problems of the applicants resolved.

STIPEND LESS THAN LABORER'S WAGE, VET STUDENTS ON DAY-2 OF 'DHARNA'



Jabalpur: As many as 350 veterinary students of Jabalpur's Nanaji Deshmukh Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwa Vidyalyaya complained that their stipend is less than that of a labourer's wage, as they continued 'dharna' for the second straight day on Tuesday. The students are demanding a raise in the internship stipend, along with an increase in the number of posts for veterinary surgeons.

Veterinary students allege that in the name of internship stipend, they were given Rs 4600, amount less than a MGNREGA worker, which makes it difficult for students to survive. Also, students mentioned that the existing posts of veterinary surgeons are 1671, whereas according to government rules, there should be one veterinarian for 5000 animals.

12 South African cheetahs to land in India on Saturday

After months of delay, 12 cheetahs from South Africa will finally arrive on February 18 in Kuno National Park (KNP), where eight such spotted cats were brought from Namibia last year, a wildlife expert associated with India's cheetah revival project has said. These big cats - seven males and five females - will embark on journey to their new home thousands of miles away aboard an Indian Air Force (IAF) transport aircraft from the OR Tambo International Airport, Gauteng, South Africa on Friday evening, the project participant and expert said. He said the South African cheetahs will first arrive at the Gwalior Air Force base in MP on Saturday morning and 30 minutes later they will be transported some 165km away to KNP in Sheopur district by IAF helicopters.



cheetahs. In two of these facilities, two pairs of cheetah brothers would be kept. "We have completed our preparations to receive the big cats on Saturday," he added.

Experts said a delegation from South Africa visited KNP in early September last year to see arrangements at the wildlife sanctuary for housing the world's fastest land animals. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between India and South Africa last month for the translocation of the mammals. South Africa has donated these big cats to India. But India has to pay USD 3,000 for the

capture of every cheetah to the African nation before they are translocated, said the wildlife expert.

India had planned to airlift these South African cheetahs in August last year but couldn't do so due to delay in signing a formal translocation agreement between the two countries. Due to the delay in the MoU signing for the inter-continental translocation of these big cats, some experts had in December expressed concern over the health of the South African cheetahs as these animals have been quarantined in their home country since July 15 in anticipation of their transfer to India.

As a result of long quarantine, these animals might have lost their fitness, they had said. Prolonged quarantine could be taking a toll on the health of these felines, who are slated to join the eight cheetahs imported from Namibia and released into KNP in mid-September, the experts had said. In fact, the 12 South African cheetahs earmarked for India have not hunted for themselves after being kept in bomas, wildlife experts in the know of India's cheetah reintroduction plan had said.

First G20 culture track meet to be held in Khajuraho

The first G20 meeting under the culture track is slated to be held in the last week of February in Madhya Pradesh's Khajuraho, home to exquisite temples that are part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The meeting will be held from February 22-25, a senior official said.

The G20, or Group of 20, is an intergovernmental forum of the world's major developed and developing economies.

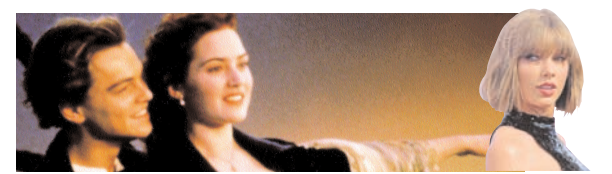
The bloc comprises Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, the Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Türkiye, the UK, the US and the European Union (EU). India assumed the presidency of the G20 on December 1.



Over 200 meetings at 55 locations across the country will be held during this period, culminating with a summit in September in Delhi.

The first G20 Tourism Working Group meeting was held at the pristine Rann of Kutch in Gujarat from February 7-9. The Culture Ministry has also shared digital posters on its Twitter handle about the upcoming event.

The venue for the G20 Culture Working Group meeting is Maharaja Chhatrasal Convention Centre in Khajuraho. In another post on Twitter, the ministry shared a message from Union Culture Minister G Kishan Reddy.

When the "Batgirl" unit completed its seven-month production schedule in Scotland, Leslie Grace received a gift from Brendan Fraser, who played her nemesis, Firefly, in the DC movie -- a gold necklace that included two charms, a little bell and a pair of dice, reports 'Variety'. "What I find most lamentable is that now a whole generation of little girls are going to have to wait longer to see a Batgirl and say, 'Hey, she looks like me,'" he says, according to 'Variety'. "That makes me sad. I know how good she was. And I know what this would mean to so many people."

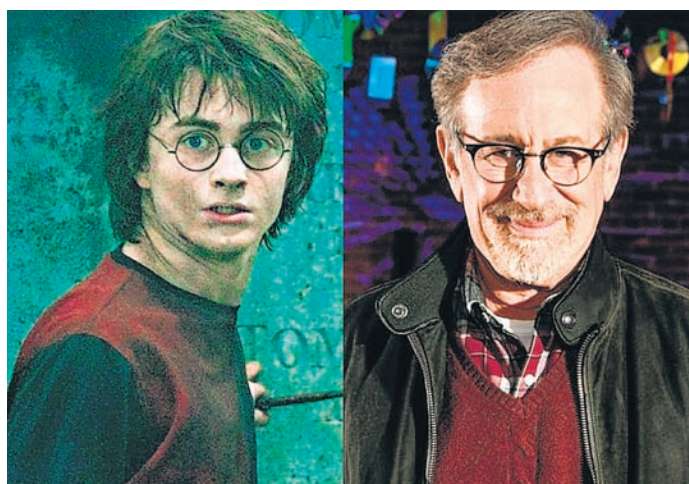

Why Spielberg was happy to refuse directing 'Harry Potter'

Award-winning filmmaker Steven Spielberg doesn't regret turning down 'Harry Potter'. The 76-year-old director was asked to direct 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone', the first movie in the wizardry franchise based on J.K. Rowling's novels, but explained that he snubbed the movie as he wanted to spend time with his family rather than on a film set.

"The personal meaning about (how the conflict between) art and family will tear you in half happened to me later, after I had already established myself as a filmmaker, as a working director," Spielberg, who shares seven children with ex-wife Amy Irving and his current spouse Kate Capshaw, told fellow filmmaker S.S. Rajamouli, reports showbiz.com.

"Kate and I started raising a family and we started having children. The choice I had to make in taking a job that would move me to another country for four of five months where I wouldn't see my family every day."

Spielberg explained that 'Harry Potter' was just one of several projects that he turned down for family reasons.

The 'Indiana Jones' filmmaker said: "There were several films I chose not to make. I chose to turn down the first 'Harry Potter' to basically spend the next year and a half with my family, my young kids growing up. So I'd sacrificed a great franchise, which today looking back I'm very happy to have done, to be with my family."
