Spate of viral infections hit India, dry cough just doesn't go away

A long-lasting dry cough that refuses to go away, repeated flu/viral infections, and low immunity amid disturbing weather patterns, Indians from Delhi-NCR to Mumbai are suffering a lot in the New Year. Health experts on Monday said that poor air quality coupled with increased susceptibility to viral infection have contributed to the current situation. Dry cough is a common complication of upper and lower respiratory viral infection and it may be present for 3 weeks to 3 months after acute phase.

According to health experts, there has been a spate of viral infections which has been doing rounds since December 2022. Most of the infections are related to respiratory tract and are in the form of cold, cough, and fever.

"What has been a concern is the fact that most of the patients are taking about 2 to 3 weeks to get better from the post-viral cough. It is thought that the poor air quality coupled with increased susceptibility to viral infection both have contributed to the protracted convalescence," Dr Anita Mathew, Infectious Disease Specialist, Fortis Hospital, Mulund, told correspondent.

No age group is exempt and the reason is mainly attributed to post viral inflammatory cascade affecting upper or lower airway or both, added Dr Anish Gupta, lead consultant, ENT, C.K. Birla Hospital, Gurugram. "Quality of air may also be responsible for increase in severity and duration of coughing," said the doctor. Changes in temperature can

weaken the immune system, making people more vulnerable to flu or viral infections that can cause a persistent dry cough due to inflammation and irritation of the airways or postnasal drip from congestion and sinus pressure. According to Dr Shovna Veshnavi, Consultant, Department of Internal Medicine, Jaypee Hospital, exposure to indoor or outdoor air pollution can irritate the respiratory system, causing inflammation and making it more vulnerable to infections. "Prolonged exposure can weaken the immune system, increasing the risk of infections and causing respiratory symptoms such as coughing," she told correspondent.

Individuals with a history of respiratory illness, such as asthma or COPD, are at an increased risk of contracting respiratory infections and may experience severe symptoms, including coughing, shortness of breath, and chest tightness.

They may also have weaker immune systems, making it more challenging to fight off infections.

"Flu can lead to acute bronchitis. It can cause inflammation in the bronchial tubes that carry air to the

ADENOVIRUS TAKING ALARMING SHAPE AMONG CHILDREN IN WEST BENGAL

Kolkata: In the current time of season change, Adenovirus appears to be taking an alarming shape among the children in West Bengal. Although the state health department is yet to compile the definite figure of deaths of children being affected by Adenovirus, unofficial estimates indicate that since December last year, more than ten children have died of cold and breathing problems, symptoms which are typical of being affected by the virus. The common symptoms of Adenovirus are flu-like ones, cold, fever, breathing problems, sore throat, pneumonia and acute bronchitis. The children of two-years of age and below are most vulnerable to being affected by the virus. The virus can spread through skin contacts, by air through coughing and sneezing and through an infected person's stool. So far, there have not been any approved medicines or any specific treatment-line to treat the virus.

lungs. This can result in coughing, wheezing, and shortness of breath. Individuals with weakened immune systems or pre-existing respiratory conditions may be more vulnerable," said Dr Veshnavi.

Dr Mathew said that the pollution in Mumbai has been a major contributory factor for the prolonged cough. "Breathing exercises, having home-based remedies also help.

Vaccination for flu preferably in May-June of every year will also reduce the

incidence of catching infection," she told correspondent.

Drinking plenty of fluids can help to thin mucus and soothe a dry cough. Water, herbal tea, and warm broth can all help to keep you hydrated and soothe your throat.

"If the cough persists or is accompanied by other symptoms such as chest pain or difficulty breathing, it is important to seek medical attention to rule out any underlying medical conditions," said Dr Veshnavi.

The Supreme Court on Monday observed that everything which is said could not be equated with hate speech, stressing: "We have a common enemy, that is hate. That is the only thing. Remove hate from your minds and just see the difference."

A bench of Justices K.M. Joseph and B.V. Nagarathna, hearing a batch of petitions seeking directions against hate speech, also considered a plea by Shaheen Abdullah in connection with an event organised by a body known as the Sakal Hindu Samaj in Mumbai earlier this month.

The top court had directed the Maharashtra government to record the event scheduled on February 5, and stressed that the government has to ensure that hate speeches are not made, while seeking a report on it.

Earlier, The Supreme Court on Monday directed the Delhi Police to place on record the charge sheet in a case of hate speeches made at Dharam Sansad in Govindpuri in December 2021. Additional Solicitor General (ASG) K.M. Nataraj, appearing for the Delhi Police, submitted that the probe in the matter is at an advanced stage. Nataraj contended before a bench headed by Chief



Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud that they were expecting a forensic science laboratory (FSL) report on voice samples of the accused. He further added that the police will soon file a charge sheet in the matter. The top court noted that the ASG has submitted that

the investigation is now at an advanced stage and the report of the voice sample is expected soon from the forensic lab.

The bench, in its order, said: "A copy of the charge sheet be placed on records. The matter is in the first week of April."

PLEA FOR UNIFORM MARRIAGE AGE REFUSED

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Monday refused to entertain a plea seeking direction to ensure uniform age of marriage for men and women, saying it can't issue mandamus to the Parliament to legislate.

Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud also pulled up petitioner-advocate Ashwini Upadhyay, saying: "We are not here to please you or any section of the polity. Don't you give me gratuitous comments. This is not a political forum..."

Upadhyay submitted that the matter involves a question connected with gender equality and the court as custodian of law must intervene to remove the anomaly to prescribe minimum age of marriage as 21 years for both men and women.

UPENDRA KUSHWAHA RESIGNS FROM JD-U, ANNOUNCES NEW PARTY

Patna: Upendra Kushwaha, who has been skirmishing with Chief Minister Nitish Kumar for some time now, on Monday announced his resignation from the primary membership of Bihar's Janata Dal-United (JD-U) and the setting up of a new party. Addressing a press conference here, he said that the decision was taken after the two day meeting of his supporters in Sinha Library here. Kushwaha also said that he will soon resign from the state Legislative Council too. Kushwaha also announced the launch of a new political party, the Rashtriya Lok Janata Dal.

Sitharaman refuses to provide NPS funds for old pension scheme

Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Monday refused to give the money kept aside for the New Pension Scheme (NPS) to the state governments for the Old Pension Scheme (OPS).

"If any state takes a decision for some reason that the funds of NPS can be collected from the Centre, then it will not be available," the Finance Minister said. It needs to be mentioned here that Rajasthan recently announced the OPS for its state employees. In fact, the Congress government has also announced OPS in Himachal Pradesh.

This Old Pension Scheme will receive a setback due to the fresh announcement by the Finance Minister.

Sitharaman said that it is the employee's money and that money will come into the hands of the employee at the time of retirement or whenever it is required by



the employee.

"The collected money will not come into the hands of the state government. When the right time comes, only then will this money be given to the employee," said Sitharaman while interacting with the media after the budget discussion at a hotel here on Monday.

On the free schemes run by the Rajasthan government, Sitharaman said: "When the financial condition of the government is good, (you) run such schemes. Make provision for

them in your budget. If the financial condition of your state is not good, you are not making provision in the budget, you are taking a loan for that. It is not right. Who will give this money? That is why the Finance Secretary said that there is no free lunch." The Finance Minister further said: "To bring such schemes, the states should raise funds from their own resources and earn from taxes. For free schemes, the states are putting their burden on someone else... it is wrong."

28 houses on the verge of collapse in Karnaprayag

Karnaprayag: After Joshimath, cracks have developed in several houses in Karnaprayag in Uttarakhand's Chamoli district, which are increasing rapidly now. As many as 28 houses in the area are on the verge of collapse.

Chamoli District Magistrate Himanshu Khurana, Karnaprayag SDM Himanshu Kafaltia, MLA Anil Nautiyal and disaster management officer N.K. Joshi inspected the affected areas in Bahuguna nagar, Subhash Nagar and Upper Bazar on Sunday.

The DM was stunned after witnessing the wide cracks on the walls of houses in Bahuguna Nagar. The residents requested the officials to make proper arrangements to guarantee their safety. Khurana instructed the officials to shift the affected people to safer places and install crackmeters in the affected structures to monitor the cracks. Land subsidence started in this area of the town last year during the rainy season. The residents had demanded the administration to take security measures in the disaster-prone areas, which was ignored. Khurana said that the buildings which have developed extensive cracks will be evacuated and the people living there will be shifted to safer places. The residents who choose to live in rented accommodations will be provided the rent amount for six months, said the official. Khurana also directed the SDM to get a detailed survey of the structures done.

Gujarat's Thakor community bans girls from using mobile phones

The Thakor Community here has prohibited the community's teenage girls from using mobile phones. The community, while unanimously passing resolutions to bring reforms in the community traditions, however, decided to stop the girls from using mobile phones.

Without referring to love affairs, friendship between girls and boys, or inter-caste marriages, the community was of the view that "because of the use of cell phones among teenage girls, a lot of wrong things are happening, and so they should be banned from using cell phones."

The resolution was passed in presence of Congress MLA Vav Geniben Thakor. The event took place on Sunday at Lunsela village in Bhabhar Taluka in Banaskantha district.

The reform step they took was to limit the number of guests allowed at engagement and marriage ceremonies. According to the resolution, only 11 people should attend an engagement or marriage ceremony, each village where the Thakor community has a good number of members should arrange mass marriages, and expenses on marriage and engagement should be controlled. No DJ sound system should be hired for marriage.

Don't fall prey to fake websites, mobile apps offering passport services: Govt

People looking for passport related services should not fall prey to the fake websites or mobile applications targeting people online, the government warned on Monday.

It has come to the notice of the authorities that many fraudulent websites and mobile applications are collecting data from applicants and also levying additional hefty charges, a government alert said.

"It has come to the notice of the Ministry that many fraudulent websites and mobile applications are collecting data from applicants and also levying additional hefty charges for filling up the online application form and scheduling appointments for passport and related services. Some of these fake website are registered in the domain name *.org, *.in, *.com such as www.indiapassport.org, www.online-passportindia.com, www.passportindiaportal.in, www.passport-india.in, www.passport-seva.in, www.applypass-



port.org and many other similar looking websites," said the alert on fake websites related to passport services.

"It is therefore advised to all citizens applying for Indian passport and related services that they should not visit the above mentioned fraudulent websites or make payment related to passport serv-

ices. The official website of the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India, for Passport services is www.passportindia.gov.in," said the alert.

Alternatively, applicants may also use the official mobile app mPassport Seva which can be downloaded from Android and iOS application store, said the alert.

MP FROM WAYANAD, RAHUL GANDHI BECOMES AICC MEMBER FROM UP

Former Congress President Rahul Gandhi has been elected as an AICC member from Uttar Pradesh despite being an MP from Wayanad in Kerala.

Only AICC's elected members can cast vote in the Congress working committee elections. Congress sources said that the people of Amethi in Uttar Pradesh, mainly the Congress supporters, want Rahul Gandhi to again contest from Amethi, which used to be a Congress stronghold before Smriti Irani defeated the former Congress chief from there in the 2019 general elections.

Deepak Singh, a former MLC from Amethi considered close to the Gandhi family, said, "People of Amethi are waiting to make Rahul Gandhi the Prime Minister of the country."

Many party leaders said that while there is no indication from Rahul Gandhi yet, Amethi will remain a Gandhi bastion as the constituency shares decades long relationship with



the family. In 2019, Rahul Gandhi had lost from Amethi but won from Wayanad.



IndiGo flight makes emergency landing in Lucknow after bomb threat

Lucknow: Yet another aviation incident involving IndiGo airlines took place on Monday when a flight from Delhi had to make an emergency landing in Lucknow after receiving a bomb-threat call.

"Flight 6E 6191 operating from Delhi to Deogarh was diverted to Lucknow following a specific bomb threat. All necessary security protocols were followed and the aircraft was cleared for take-off later. IndiGo is following the rules of the security agencies in the probe," the airline said in a statement.



MAHA POLICE SWOOP IN HYDERABAD, NAB 2 MAOISTS ON THE RUN FOR 17 YEARS

In a swoop in Hyderabad, the Maharashtra Police has arrested two dreaded Maoists - a husband-wife couple - who were absconding from the law for the past 17 years, an official said here on Monday. They are Madhukar Chinanna Kodape, alias Thuge, 42, and his wife Jamani Mangalu Punam, alias Shamala, 35, said Gadchiroli Superintendent of Police Neelotpal. Hailing from Aheri here, Thuge had joined the Sironcha dalam in 2002, and later was the commander in Jimalgata and Sironcha Local Organisation Squads (LOS). With 25 serious cases like 9 murders, 8 encounters, 4 arsons, 2 dacoities, attempt to murder and others, Thuge went absconding around 2006 and Maharashtra government had announced a reward of Rs 8 lakh for his capture.

Belonging to Bijapur district of Chhattisgarh, Shamala worked for the Aheri LOS as a member and had 9 serious offences of 1 murder, 5 encounters, arson, dacoity, etc. and carried a prize of Rs 2 lakh on her



head. As per the Maharashtra Police investigations, the fugitive Thuge-Shamala couple had reportedly quit the Maoist movement and had been moving from place to place in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh to avoid detection. The Gadchiroli police

was tracking them for over a year and finally found Thuge working as a watchman and Shamala serving in a car showroom's housekeeping, under fake identities. Zeroing on their location in Hyderabad, a Gadchiroli police team swooped on them early this morning

and arrested them. With this latest success, the Gadchiroli police said it has succeeded in arresting 64 hardcore Maoists from different parts in the past 13 months since January 2022, even as SP Neelotpal appealed to the rebels to give up arms and return to the social mainstream.

Fake currency with face value of Rs 27 lakh seized in Hyderabad, 2 held

Hyderabad police have arrested two persons, including a woman, involved in printing and circulation of fake Indian currency notes in Telangana and other states and seized counterfeit money with face value of Rs 27 lakh.

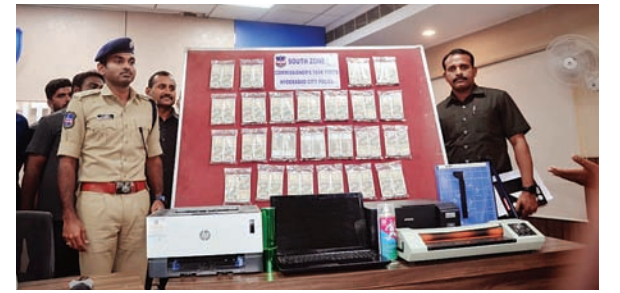
The arrests were made in a joint operation by Commissioner's Task Force, South Zone Team and Chandrayangutta police.

Deputy Commissioner of Police, Crime P. Shabarish told media persons that fake Indian currency notes with face value of Rs 27 lakh and other materials were seized at the instance of accused.

Hassan Bin Hamood, an autorickshaw driver and resident of Falaknuma, Hyderabad and Rameshwari, resident of Kosgi in Narayanpet district have been arrested.

Main accused Kasturi Ramesh Babu of Narayanpet district is absconding.

According to police, Ramesh Babu, 35, working as a car mechanic, faced finan-



cial problems due to lockdown and he hatched a plan to earn easy money through illegal means. Gaining knowledge in printing and circulation of fake Indian currency, he procured all materials and printed Indian fake currency and kept in market for circulation. He was arrested by Gopalapuram Police Station in September 2022 and was sent to jail. While he was in jail, Ramesh Babu met Hamood who was in jail in a murder case and they became close friends. They hatched a plan to circulate fake currency on commission basis. After release from jail, Ramesh Babu and his family shifted to Tandur. Later, he procured raw material for further preparation of fake cur-

rency notes along with his sister Rameshwari.

The police officer said Ramesh Babu started printing fake currency denomination of Rs 500 notes and circulated the same in Gujarat. Last month, he was arrested by Gujarat Police in fake Indian currency circulation case and sent to judicial custody. Later, Rameshwari contacted Hamood and shifted all the materials including FICN to Chandrayangutta, Hyderabad for further circulation.

Basing on credible information, the Commissioner's Task Force, South Zone Team, Hyderabad along with Chandrayangutta police apprehended the accused persons and seized fake Indian currency notes.

CBI's fresh summon asks Sisodia to join probe on Feb 26

Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia has been summoned again to join the probe in Delhi excise policy scam on February 26.

Sisodia was earlier asked to appear before the CBI on February 19, but he expressed inability to join the probe and sought one week time. He told the CBI that he was busy in giving final touch to Delhi's budget which would be sent to Centre for approval.

The CBI allowed his request and now has issued him a second notice. Sisodia has alleged that it



is BJP who is behind the scene. He alleged that he was busy in giving the final touch to Delhi budget when he was called to join the investigation. "I am a finance minister too. I have to prepare Delhi Budget. It will be sent to Centre for the approval. BJP is using CBI to stop us in doing development. I have sought time," Sisodia had said while requesting for more time.

20 VEHICLES COLLIDE ON LUCKNOW-DELHI HIGHWAY DUE TO FOG

Lucknow: About 20 vehicles collided in an accident on the Delhi-Lucknow highway due to dense fog on Monday.

According to reports, the visibility was poor and many car drivers jumped onto the wrong side and ended up colliding with other vehicles.

The injured have been admitted to the hospital.

It may be recalled that on Sunday, about 15 vehicles collided on the Delhi-Meerut Expressway in Masuri area of Ghaziabad due to dense fog and poor visibility. Five people received minor injuries and one truck driver was seriously injured.

K'taka woman officers spat turns ugly as IPS officer questions IAS officer over 'nude pics'

In spite of the warnings of the Karnataka Chief Minister and Home Minister, a senior woman IAS officer and a senior woman IPS officer continued their public spat.

Retaliating to IAS officer Rohini Sindhuri and her husband's comments that she is "mentally ill", IPS officer D. Roopa Moudgil, sharing a screenshot allegedly from Sindhuri's number, asked the IAS officer if she will talk about "her nude pictures".

Sindhuri, the Commissioner, State Hindu Religious and Endowments Department, asked Moudgil to "get well soon". Her remarks came right after husband Sudheer Reddy branding the IPS officer as "mentally ill".

IGP Moudgil, currently the MD, Karnataka Handicrafts Development Corporation and recipient of the President's Gold Medal, said: "Rohini Sindhuri has told me to get well soon through the media. Will she talk about her deleted nude pic-



tures? This number is hers, right? Can an IAS officer send her nude pictures?"

The screen shot shows 10 deleted messages, while the reply says, "So madly, madly beautiful."

The development has taken the incident of social media war between two senior civil servants to a

new level. Sindhuri has stated that she had lodged a three-page complaint against Moudgil for making personal allegations with Chief Secretary Vandita Sharma and sought action. In turn, Moudgil, who also lodged a complaint with the Chief Secretary maintained that she is lodging complaints of corruption against Sindhuri. The IPS officer contended that nothing is personal about her allegations. "I had brought the matter to the notice of the government 25 days ago," she said.

Regarding posting of photos she said it is not a personal matter. Law Minister J.C. Madhuswamy has stated that the government will initiate action against the sparring officers. He maintained that they were quiet so far, thinking that the matter was personal. But, both officers engaging in conflict of words in the public and the government can't tolerate this, he added. Earlier, Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai and Home Minister Araga Jnenendra had given warning to both officers and directed issue of notice to both officers.

Godhra train burning case: Gujarat govt seeks death penalty for 11 in SC

The Gujarat government on Monday told the Supreme Court that it will press for the death penalty to 11 convicts in the 2002 Godhra train burning case, as it was a "rarest of the rare and grave offence." The death penalty of these 11 convicts was commuted to life imprisonment by the Gujarat High Court.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, representing the Gujarat government, submitted before a bench headed by Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud that state is seriously pressing for death penalty for the convicts, which the Gujarat High Court commuted to life imprison-



ment. Mehta said, "This is the rarest of rare cases where 59 people, including women and children, were burnt alive," and added that it is consistent everywhere that the bogey was locked from outside and 59 died.

In February 2002, 59 people were killed when a coach of the train was burnt at Gujarat's Godhra, triggering riots in the state.

The top court asked counsel for both sides to submit a consolidated chart giving details such as actual sentences awarded to the convicts and the period spent in jail till now.

After hearing arguments, the bench fixed the bail pleas of several accused in the case for hearing after three weeks.

Carrying passengers on 2-wheelers to attract fine upto 10,000 in Delhi

Carrying passengers on two-wheeler bike taxis bearing Private registration number has been made a punishable offence and may attract fine upto Rs 10,000 here.

A circular issued by Transport department of Delhi government reads, "It has been brought to the notice that two-wheelers having Non-Transport (Private) registration mark/number are being used to carry passengers on hire or reward which is purely commercial operation and in violation of Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and rules made thereunder".

It further reads, "The



above said violation is a contravention of the registration condition of the vehicle which is punishable under Section 192 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 having punishment for the first offence up to Rs 5000/-, and for a second or subsequent offence with imprisonment which may extend to one year with fine up to Rs

10,000/- beside impounding of the vehicle".

In addition to the above punishment, the driving license of the driver will also be suspended for a minimum period of three months under the direction of the Supreme Court committee.

Some digital platforms are facilitating such operations by offering booking through an app thereby engaging themselves as an aggregator in contravention of the provision of Section 93, and shall be punishable with a fine up to one lakh rupees.

The transport department through the notice has directed the digital platform to immediately stop such kind of activities to avoid prosecution and penalty.

'Season is changing', Cong 'warns' ED on raids in Chhattisgarh

After the raids on Congress leaders in Chhattisgarh on Monday, the party reacted sharply and warned the ED that the "decency of Congress should not be considered as weakness".

Addressing a press conference Monday along with Jai Ram Ramesh, Congress Media department chairman Pawan Kherra said, "We also have governments in some states, some of the governments are going to be formed in states and the season is changing... 2024 is also approaching." "I want to give one suggestion to the Enforcement Directorate (ED) officers, who have become tools in the hands of the government, that time changes fast."

Warning the officials and

the BJP, Kherra said, "We have governments in states... we can also do something, but our decency should be considered as ornaments not weakness."

Congress General Secretary Jai Ram Ramesh said that the party will not be cowed down by these tactics and the plan will go on as per schedule.

Three days ahead of the Congress plenary session in Raipur, the ED on Monday was conducting raids at multiple locations across Chhattisgarh in connection with the coal mining case.

A source said that all the locations belong to the various Congress leaders.

"Premises belonging to state party treasurers Ram Gopal Aggarwal, state PRO R.P. Singh, labour committee President Sushil Sunny Aggarwal are being raided," the source said.

MMRDA erects MTHL's steel girder span linking Eastern Freeway

In a milestone, the MMRDA installed the first 40-metre-long composite steel girder span to connect the Mumbai Trans Harbour Link (MTHL) with the Eastern Freeway at two levels, officials said here on Monday.

The girder, weighing 130 tonnes, was erected on the Sewri Interchange side, and is a segmental box girder, cast in situ concrete decks of around 40 metre length spans in all the zones, barring a steel composite span across the Eastern Freeway.

The 10.38 kms of the MTHL Package 1 is divided into 3 zones - Marine around 5.75 km, Intertidal around 4.13 km, and Land or the Sewri Interchange.

There are 8 ramps on the Land zone linking the MTHL main bridge with the Eastern Freeway (4 ramps), the Sewri-Worli Elevated Bridge, and Mumbai Port Trust road underneath with 2 ramps each.

The MTHL is a 6-lane road



bridge plus 2 emergency lanes, spanning the harbour between Sewri on the Mumbai side and Chirle in Navi Mumbai on the mainland, and would be longest sea bridge in India after completion, said Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority Metropolitan Commissioner S.V.R. Srinivas.

Expected to be ready by

December 2023, the MTHL will be 22-km-long comprising 5.5 km viaducts on land on both sides and the 16.5 km bridge running over the sea, with 70,000 vehicles likely to zoom across it daily in both directions.

Estimated to cost around Rs 18,000 crore, the project is being implemented on a Design-Build basis with a loan

from the Japan International Cooperation Agency. "The MMRDA is working towards changing the face of the city and surroundings by integrating its existing road-based transport network with other infra projects. The MTHL will be the engineering marvel that will decongest Mumbai and connect it to the mainland," Srinivas said.

Assam woman kills husband & mother-in-law, stores body parts in freezer

A woman in Guwahati allegedly killed her husband and mother-in-law, stored their body parts in a freezer for a few days and later disposed it in a river, police sources said.

The incident took place in the city's Noonmati area seven months ago but came to light only on Monday after the accused reportedly confessed to the crime.

According to a senior police officer, the accused Bandana Kalita confessed that she killed her husband Amarjyoti Dey and mother-in-law Shankari Dey with the help of two of her friends on August 17, 2022.

Following the murders,

Kalita stored the victims' body parts in a refrigerator and left the house. She returned four days later, on August 21, and disposed of the body pieces into Meghalaya's Dawki River, which is at a distance of at least 200 km from Guwahati," the officer added.

As per the police sources, Kalita's neighbours confirmed that they saw her burning furniture on the terrace of her house.

Kalita's two friends, Arup Deka and Dhanjit Deka, have been arrested for allegedly being involved in the murder.

The police are interrogating them. The police are yet to issue an official statement on the incident.



PROJECTS WORTH RS 2,478 CR INAUGURATED IN 15 DAYS OF BJP'S 'VIKAS YATRA' IN MP

MAN IN PAKISTAN JAIL SINCE 2019 RETURNS TO INDIA

Khandwa: A 44-year-old man who went missing from Khandwa in Madhya Pradesh five years ago and was later jailed in Pakistan after inadvertently crossing into that country has returned to India, an official said on Monday.

Raju Pindare, a resident of Indhawadi, has been handed back to Indian authorities and a four-member team comprising policemen and a medical professional has been sent to Amritsar to bring him here, additional collector Shankar Lal Singhade said.

"Information about Pindare being handed over to India was received by us through Amritsar's Red Cross Society. He will be handed over to his family after legal formalities are completed," Singhade added. Subhash Sharma, Project Manager, Red Cross Society of Amritsar, said Pindare was released by Pakistan authorities on February 14 at the international border at Wagah and handed over to Khandwa police on Monday. Khandwa's Superintendent of Police (SP) Vivek Singh said he has been in constant touch with the police headquarters regarding the man's return.

Meanwhile, Pindare's mother Basanta said he was mentally unwell and she had got information about his arrest in Pakistan through some local officials in 2019, six months after he went missing. Her son used to wander here and there but it is still not known how he managed to get to Pakistan, Basanta said.

MP INTRODUCES NEW EXCISE POLICY

The Madhya Pradesh government has introduced a new excise policy under which consumption of alcohol at 'ahatas' will be prohibited.

Ahata is an area attached to alcohol outlets where people can sit and consume liquor.

The decision to introduce the new policy was taken during a cabinet meeting late Sunday.

Following the approval of the new excise policy, 2,580 ahatas and 31 shop bars will get closed across the state.

"It has been decided by the cabinet that henceforth all liquor vendors will only sell liquor. All ahatas and shop bars (allowing consumption of liquor within shops premises) will be closed," the state government's official spokesperson and home minister Narottam Mishra said, while briefing about the cabinet meeting's decision.

"Further, it has been decided that the distance between liquor



shops and places of worship and educational institutions, particularly girl schools, colleges and hostels, will be increased from the present 50 metres to 100 metres," Mishra added.

He further informed that the state cabinet has also approved a proposal for making stricter provisions for the suspension of driving licenses of those who get caught for drunk driving.

"Our government is committed to discouraging consumption of liquor in the state, owing to which no new liquor shop has been allowed to be opened in the state since 2010. On the contrary,

many shops have been shut down. During our Chief Minister's Narmada Seva Yatra in 2016-17, as many as 64 liquor shops were closed," Mishra added. The move comes amid senior BJP leader Uma Bharti's sustained pressure on the Shivraj Singh Chouhan-led Madhya Pradesh government to have a controlled liquor policy.

Recently, she tied cows and fed them with fodder outside a liquor shop in Orchha town as part of her campaign titled 'Madhushala mein Gaushala', urging people to drink milk instead of alcohol.

Roads of urban bodies will be maintained in rejuvenation campaign: Chief Minister

Chief Minister Shri Chouhan gave approval for road upgradation works worth Rs 750 crore, released the first installment amounting to Rs 350 crore with a single click.

The Mankurad Mango

Goa's Mankurad mango, awaiting for Geographical Indication (GI) tag, has arrived in the main markets of the coastal state and it is costing Rs 6,000 per dozen. The Mankurad is one of the most sought-after mango varieties in Goa during summer and having a Mankurad tree in the yard is regarded as a matter of pride for the homeowner. For many mango farmers, Mankurad is the source of income during this season. A mango wholesaler from Margao in South Goa, said that as the harvest is less, the prices have gone up. "The rate is considered as per size of the mango. Presently the big size Mankurad is costing around Rs 6,000 per dozen and the smaller size goes for Rs 4800." He said that vendors from across the state visit the Margao market to purchase at wholesale rate and then sell in their areas. According to him, this market opens at 3 a.m. in the morning and closes soon after the vendor leaves the place. "Presently the harvesting of Mankurad mango is less, but by April we may get in large quantities," he said, adding that mango farmers from many areas of state come to sell their produce in Margao. Last year, Chief Minister Pramod Sawant had taken a dig at the summer pride of Maharashtra, the Alphonso mango, by insisting that the Mankurad mango, a native Goan variety, tastes better than its counterpart. "We all say that the Alphonso mango is popular, but I can say for sure that the Mankurad mango is tastier. I can say it with a lot of pride," Sawant said. For the past two years, Goa has been awaiting the GI tag for Mankurad mango after the proposal was submitted in 2020.

EXPLOITING TECHNOLOGY TO UNDERMINE DEMOCRACY

A recent disconcerting report based on an investigation carried by 30 global media outlets, including the Guardian and DeSpiegel, claims to have exposed a team of freelance units based in Israel, which disrupt elections and manipulate public opinion using disinformation campaigns. Undercover reporters recorded a group of covert cyber influence specialists as they pitched their services for seeking fresh business, which involve using disinformation campaigns, false intelligence, hacks and blackmail to promote their clients' interests. The group, which calls itself 'Team Jorge', claims to have worked on dozens of presidential elections around the world and charges multimillion-dollar fees.

Undercover journalists who carried out the investigation included Gur Meggido (The Marker), Frederic Metzereau (Radio France), and Omer Benjakob (Haaretz).

The journalists were part of a collaborative investigation called 'Story Killers', which was coordinated by 'Forbidden Stories' -- an international consortium of investigative journalists that pursue the work of journalists who have been killed or work under threat.

As reported, the covert units or contractors, used the pseudonym 'Team Jorge' headed by Tal Hanan, who previously worked as an Israeli special forces operative, and was apparently caught in an undercover sting operation by the journalists posing as potential clients.

However, Tal Hanan denies any wrongdoing. But he allegedly told the reporters that his unit's services were available to intelligence agencies, political campaigns, and private companies, and that many European, African, Americans well



as Central and South American clients had already used them around the globe.

Their modus operandi is said to involve creating thousands of fake social media profiles on Twitter, LinkedIn, Facebook, Telegram, Gmail, Instagram, and YouTube. These fake accounts, which allegedly used profile pictures from real social media accounts, were also linked to credit cards and could be used to create thousands of bots that sent mass messages.

In one secretly filmed meeting quoted by the Guardian, Hanan is seen boasting that at present his team is now involved in one election in Africa, besides two other teams in Greece and the UAE. Boasting further, he said that his team has so far delivered 33 presidential-level campaigns globally, 27 of which were successful.

Hanan also reportedly boasted to the undercover reporters that he could hack the email and messenger services of election campaigners, and send messages to their contacts designed to damage their campaign.

The investigators found that Team Jorge's tech toolbox included "a platform of influence" called Advanced Impact Media Solutions

platforms checks, AIMS relied on residential proxies to reroute internet traffic from bots through people's homes so it appeared authentic, in order to avoid detection and shut-downs by social media platforms like Twitter and Facebook. This made it difficult for social media platforms to identify a coordinated disinformation campaign.

Verification and analysis of the recorded conversations by reporting partners Le Monde and the Guardian identified clusters of avatars, including those seen in Hanan's pitch presentations, that appeared to have been used for coordinated Twitter campaigns.

Reporters found over 1,700 Twitter accounts connected to 21 AIMS-related campaigns, whose networks had produced tens of thousands of tweets.

In December last, during an in-person meeting with undercover reporters, Team Jorge showed off a new capability of AIMS: Artificial intelligence tools to generate fake news using specified key words, tone and topic.

The identities of Team Jorge members were shrouded in secrecy but reporters managed to piece together some background information on some members of the clandestine group. Some of it lines up with claims Team Jorge made about team members in calls with journalists.

One team member described his other colleagues as former senior information officers, former senior financial information and warfare experts, and psychological warfare specialists, all with intelligence services background.

Hanan indicated that he had orchestrated lobbying operations in the US despite not registering as a "foreign agent", as required by law. He

said he worked via consultants and companies that are already registered, and told reporters he had recently set up a public relations firm called Axiomatics to promote Team Jorge with "existing lobby groups".

During calls with undercover reporters, Team Jorge went into specifics about the technology they say the group uses to swing elections. They added that they have six offices and employ at least 100 people, emphasising that they draw on the backgrounds of colleagues with experience in the intelligence services. This pushes Team Jorge's activities far beyond the realm of public relations strategies that are commonly deployed in elections.

As far as the financial pickings are concerned, Team Jorge told the reporters they would accept payments in a variety of currencies, including crypto currencies such as Bitcoin, or cash. He said he would charge between 6 million euros and 15 million euros for interference in elections.

The information gleaned by the investigative reporters points to one rather disconcerting fact, that there are people out there and they would be there in future too, who would always be ready to interfere in other country's internal affairs and ready to subvert the democratic institutions.

But the bigger question is shall we just ignore them calling it scaling another frontier in the technology advancement or shall we start a campaign to ban such illegal and undesirable activities which may one day be able to destabilise the whole global democratic system?

As Biden visits Ukraine, China's top diplomat heads to Russia

As US President Joe Biden touched down in Ukraine to meet with his counterpart Volodymyr Zelensky on Monday, China's top diplomat was travelling in the opposite direction, on his way to Russia, according to a media report.

Wang Yi - who was promoted as Chinese leader Xi Jinping's top foreign policy advisor last month - is due to arrive in Moscow this week as part of his eight-day Europe tour, a trip that brings into focus China's attempted diplomatic balancing act since Russian tanks rolled into Ukraine a year ago, CNN reported.

The optics of the two trips - taking place just days before the one-year anniversary of the brutal war on Friday - underscores the sharpening of geopolitical fault lines between the world's two superpowers, CNN reported.



While relations between the US and China continue to plummet - most recently due to the fallout from a suspected Chinese spy balloon that entered US airspace - China and Russia are as close as ever since their leaders declared a 'no limits friendship' a year ago - partly driven by their shared animosity towards the United States.

And as the US and its allies reaffirm their support for Ukraine and step up military aid, Beijing's deepening partnership with Moscow has raised alarms in Western capitals - despite China's public charm offensive in Europe to present itself as a negotiator of peace, CNN reported.

At the Munich Security Conference on Saturday, Wang had addressed a room of European officials as "dear friends" and touted China's commitment to peace, while apparently attempting to drive a wedge between Europe and the US.

N.Korea fires 2 short-range ballistic missiles

North Korea fired two short-range ballistic missiles (SRBMs) toward the East Sea on Monday, a day after South Korea and the US staged joint air drills, involving B-1B bombers.

South Korea's Joint Chiefs of Staff (JCS) said it detected the launch from the Sukchon area in South Pyongan Province between 7 a.m. and 7:11 a.m., and that the missiles flew some 390 km and 340 km, respectively, reports Yonhap News Agency. Hours after the launch, Pyongyang's official Korean Central News Agency (KCNA) reported that the artillery unit of the Korean People's Army fired two shots from the 600-mm multiple rocket launcher during firing drills, and that they flew 395 km and 337 km, respectively.

The weapon system is a "tactical nuclear attack means boasting of the great might powerful enough to assign only one multiple rocket launcher with four shells so as to destroy an enemy operational airfield", the KCNA said.

In a ceremony to "present" the 600-mm rocket launcher at a key party meeting in late December, the country's leader Kim Jong-un called it an "offensive weapon" capable of carrying tactical nuclear warheads that could put all of South Korea within its range. Some observers here noted that given their flight distance, the rockets fired Monday can reach a South Korean air base in Cheongju known to be home to the South's F-35A stealth fighters. Cheongju is located 112 km south of Seoul.

Taliban shuts down main border point with Pakistan

The Taliban-led government in Afghanistan has ordered the shut down of one of the country's main trading and border crossing points with Pakistan, accusing Islamabad of reneging on its commitments.

The Afghan Taliban commissioner for Torkham said the border point had been closed down for travel and transit trade, reports Dawn news.

"Pakistan has not abided by its commitments and so the gateway has been shut down on the directions of (our) leadership," Taliban commissioner at Torkham Maulavi Mohammad Siddique tweeted. He advised the people of Afghanistan to avoid travelling to the border crossing in eastern Nangarhar province.

However, the Taliban official did not specify the commitment Islamabad allegedly breached.

Some unconfirmed media reports suggested the Taliban were irked by an unannounced ban on travel of Afghan patients



seeking treatment in Pakistan, Dawn reported.

There was no immediate official word from Foreign Office in Islamabad.

The Afghan Taliban appear unlikely to shift their strategic calculus on providing support to the Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan (TTP) terror group, an analysis by the US Institute for Peace (USIP) said last week.

It furthered that much of the TTP's political leadership and capability was based in Afghanistan and the outlawed faction was able to fundraise through extortion inside Pakistan as well as in Afghanistan, The Express Tribune reported.

It reiterated that the Afghan Taliban remain "very supportive" of the TTP and are providing the group with a permissive safe haven.

China-linked online superstore surpasses Amazon & Walmart, becomes most downloaded app in US

A new online shopping platform linked to one of China's top retailers has quickly become the most downloaded app in the US, surpassing Amazon and Walmart, CNN reported.

Temu, a Boston-based online retailer that shares the same owner as Chinese social commerce giant Pinduoduo, made its Super Bowl debut on Sunday.

Temu, which runs an online superstore for virtually everything -- from home goods to apparel to electronics -- unveiled a commercial during the game that encouraged consumers to "shop like a billionaire".

The pitch? You don't have to be one, CNN reported.

The surprisingly low prices -- by Western standards, at least -- have drawn comparisons to Shein, the Chinese fast fashion upstart that also offers a wide selection of inexpensive



clothing and home goods, and has made significant inroads into markets including the United States.

Shein is considered one of Temu's competitors, along with US-based discount retailer Wish and Alibaba's AliExpress, according to Coresight Research, CNN reported.

Temu, pronounced "tee-moo", was launched last year by PDD, its US-listed parent company formerly known as Pinduoduo. The company officially changed its name just this month.

PDD's subsidiary Pinduoduo is one of China's most popular e-commerce platforms with approximately 900 million users. It made its name with a group-buying business model, allowing people to save money by enlisting friends to buy the same item in bulk, CNN reported.

Since its rollout in September, the application has been downloaded 24 million times, racking up more than 11 million monthly active users, according to Sensor Tower.

In the fourth quarter of last year, US app installations for Temu exceeded those for Amazon, Walmart and Target, according to Abe Yousef, a senior insights analyst at the analytics firm Sensor Tower, CNN reported.

19 KILLED IN BRAZIL FLOODS, LANDSLIDES

Brasilia | Agencies

At least 19 people were killed due to floods and landslides caused by heavy rain along the coast of Brazil's Sao Paulo state, authorities have confirmed.

Among the victims were a seven-year-old girl who died when a rock fell on top of her family's house and a woman who was killed by a falling tree, local television channel GloboNews reported.

Carnival celebrations were suspended in several coastal cities in Sao Paulo, Brazil's most populous state currently bustling with tourists due to the celebrations this week, reports Xinhua news agency.

"We are summoning the Armed Forces to help rescuers reach places where



there may be victims," said Sao Paulo Governor Tarcisio de Freitas, who visited the disaster zone on Sunday.

The storm mainly affected the municipalities of Sao Sebastiao, Ubatuba, Bertioga, Guarujá, Ilhabela and Santos.

Sao Sebastiao's local government declared a state of calamity as landslides and road damage closed highways and prevented rescue from reaching affected parts of the city.

"There were many landslides that washed away houses, therefore there are many people under the rubble. The situation is chaotic

because it is not possible for rescuers to access those places," Sao Sebastiao Mayor Felipe Augusto told the daily Folha de S.Paulo.

The federal government dispatched lifeguards from the national civil defence agency and Minister of Integration and Regional Development Waldez Góes is expected to visit the area on Monday, according to an official statement.

Góes said the Defence Ministry will help in the rescue operations.

More heavy rain is expected in the area, threatening to make conditions even worse for emergency teams.

Last year, torrential rain in Brazil's south-eastern city of Petropolis killed more than 230 people.



ARMED WITH NAME-SYMBOL, CM SHINDE GROUP TAKES CONTROL OF PARTY OFFICE IN LEGISLATURE

Four days after being declared as the real Shiv Sena and given its 'Bow-and-Arrow' symbol, Chief Minister Eknath Shinde-led entity's leaders moved into the party office in the Maharashtra Legislature. Led by the Chief Whip Bharat Gogawale, the MLAs entered the Shiv Sena office premises for a special meeting ahead of the upcoming Budget Session starting here next week.



The Shinde group MLAs had met Speaker Rahul Narwekar and exchanged communication in the matter, seeking the allotment of the office. The party is also eyeing the party office in Nagpur Vidhan Bhavan, the party head office Shivayaya in Mumbai, over 200-plus 'Shakhas' (branches) in Mumbai and rest of the state, the Shiv Sena offices in various civic bodies and other assets set up by the party in the past 56 years. However, as per current indi-

cations, the Shinde group may not covet the iconic Shiv Sena Bhavan in Dadar, which continues to remain in the control of former CM Uddhav Thackeray. Several of the legislators hailed the Election Commission of India (ECI) for its verdict of Friday February 17 recognising it as the 'real' Shiv Sena against the claims of the Shiv Sena (UBT) led by Thackeray. The Thackeray group has Monday challenged the ECI ruling in the Supreme Court and sought a stay on its implementation till the pending case of MLAs disqualification is decided by the apex court, and the matter is likely to be heard on Tuesday.

Thackeray faction moves SC challenging EC decision on Shiv Sena name, symbol

The Uddhav Thackeray faction has moved the Supreme Court against the Election Commission of India (ECI) decision recognising the Eknath Shinde faction as the official Shiv Sena.

Senior advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi mentioned the plea challenging the ECI decision before a bench headed by Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud.

Singhvi requested for the listing of the matter along with the ongoing cases before the constitution bench on Tuesday. However, the Chief Justice did not allow Singhvi's mentioning, as the matter was not included in the mentioning list. The Chief Justice asked Singhvi to mention the matter Tuesday.

Last week, the Election Commission allotted the Shiv Sena party name and the bow & arrow symbol to the faction led by Eknath Shinde.

Maharashtra CM and rival faction leader Eknath Shinde had moved the apex court in anticipation, filing a caveat notifying the court that Thackeray faction may challenge



the ECI decision. A constitution bench of the Supreme Court is currently considering the issues relating to the Shiv Sena rift.

On February 17, the Supreme Court declined to make immediate reference to a seven-judge bench the reconsideration of its 2016 Nabam Rebia judgment, which restricted the power of the Speaker to examine disqualification petitions against MLAs as a resolution

for his removal is pending. A five-judge bench headed by Chief Justice of India said the issue of reference will be decided only with the merits of the case and fixed the matter for hearing on merits on February 21. The bench observed that the question of reference to 2016 Nabam Rebia judgement to a larger bench can't be decided in "abstract manner, isolated and divorced from facts of the case".

Disband Election Commission of India, demands Thackeray

Mumbai: In a stunning statement, former Maharashtra Chief Minister and Shiv Sena (UBT) President Uddhav Thackeray said the party name-symbol verdict of Election Commission of India (ECI) was "unacceptable", and demanded that the ECI must be 'disbanded', here on Monday.

Thackeray's shocker came at a media conference when he termed the ECI ruling of last Friday as "incorrect" and said his party has challenged it in the Supreme Court Monday.

"Such undemocratic decisions cannot be made on the basis of money-power... It's an unconstitutional verdict. We demand that the ECI should be dissolved, an impartial EC should be appointed and till then its work should be handled by the Supreme Court," roared Thackeray.

He termed the latest political developments as the Bharatiya Janata Party's strategy to systematically destroy the Shiv Sena for which it had contracted (Chief Minister) Eknath Shinde.

CHAIN SNATCHER HELD IN THANE, 10 CASES SOLVED

Mumbai: Police have arrested a 26-year-old man for allegedly snatching gold chains and claimed to have solved 10 cases including one of theft of a motorbike in Maharashtra's Thane district.

Gold jewellery weighing 135 grams and a motorbike collectively valued at Rs 6.75 lakh were recovered from the accused, Mohammad Karibshah Sayyed, who was nabbed from Kalyan area on Saturday, a police spokesperson said on Monday.

A woman had complained to police that on February 11, when she went out to make some purchases, the accused snatched her 'mangalsutra' (sacred chain worn by married women) worth Rs 75,000.

A police probe team worked on various leads, including the intelligence and technical inputs, and arrested the accused, the spokesperson said.

During the interrogation of the accused, it came to light that he was involved in nine more crimes including the theft of a motorbike from Rabale being used to move while snatching chains, he said.

With this, chain snatching cases in Bhiwandi taluka, Padgha, Shahapur and Rabale police stations have been detected, the official said.

Shah's 'licking soles' remark kicks up fresh political row

A comment by Union Home Minister Amit Shah targeting bete-noire, the Shiv Sena (UBT) President, Uddhav Thackeray has kicked up an unholy fracas, plummeting political discourse to another depth in Maharashtra, on Monday.

Speaking at a function to mark the 393rd birth anniversary of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj in Pune on Sunday, Shah slammed Thackeray for the umpteenth time on the alleged backstabbing after the 2019 Assembly elections.

sion declaring the group led by Chief Minister Eknath Shinde as the 'real' Shiv Sena, Shah said that "now they (Thackeray group) have been shown their true place".

Smarting under Shah's 'sucker-kick' remark, Sena (UBT) Chief Spokesperson and MP Sanjay Raut hit back: "What is Shinde doing now... Who is he sucking up to now...? They are traitors and thieves. Deals worth over Rs 2,000

crore have taken place for grabbing the 'Shiv Sena' name and 'Bow-and-Arrow' symbol..."

As Raut apparently suffered a momentary slip of tongue, a furious Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS) Spokesperson Sandip Deshpande blurted out before the media: "How can he (Raut) speak such foul language... If I was around, I would have given him a tight slap..."

'JAWAB DO' - CPI TO PROTEST ON 8TH ANNIVERSARY OF GOVIND PANSARE'S KILLING

Marking the 8th year of the killing of Communist leader Govind Pansare, the CPI Maharashtra will hold a 'Jawab Do' protest march in Mumbai, Kolhapur and other places, party leaders said here on Monday.

Sarma said that Uddhav Thackeray might have lost the party symbol for bringing God into a political controversy.

Earlier, the Assam government claimed that the Dakini Hill is the site of the sixth Jyotirlinga, which irked the Maharashtra Opposition, including Uddhav Thackeray's Shiv Sena and other parties.

The Opposition said that the pilgrimage fell in Maharashtra's Pune, and they accused the Assam government of 'stealing God'.



While attending a Mahashivratri function, Sarma said on Sunday that the Shiv Puran had mentioned that Bhimshaknar Jyotirlinga was placed in Kamrup's Dakini Hill. The Puran has a full description of it.

He then went on to say, "I have not written the Shiv Puran. Had I written it, you could have attacked me."

"I do not have scientific evidence, but I can say from my sense that when they (Shiv Sena) brought God into political controversy, they had to face backlash by losing the party symbol," he said.

As per Hindu beliefs, the places from where Lord Shiva emerged are known as Jyotirlingas, and there are 12 such Jyotirlingas across the country.

After the Assam government's ad was published in leading newspapers across the country five days ago, Aditya Thackeray and other leaders quickly jumped to criticise Himanta Biswa Sarma.

MAN ON DEATH ROW FOR KILLING MOTHER ALLOWED TO ATTEND DAUGHTER'S WEDDING

The Bombay High Court on Monday permitted a man sentenced to death for killing and eviscerating his mother in an inebriated state with an intention to eat her to attend his daughter's wedding for three days.

A division bench of Justices A S Gadkari and P D Naik directed the authorities at Kolhapur jail, where the man is lodged, to take him to his house from 9 am to 6 pm on three days - February 23 to February 25.

The convict, Sunil Kuchkoravi, pronounced guilty by a Kolhapur sessions court in the 2021 murder case with his death sentence awaiting confirmation, had sought temporary bail for one week from the HC to attend the wedding.

The court said while in capital punishment cases, the convicts are not entitled to temporary bail or other reliefs like parole or furlough, it was inclined to allow the convict in the present matter to be taken to his house for three days as his daughter was getting married.

When the court queried as to why death sentence was imposed in the murder case and if it was a brutal killing, Kuchkoravi's lawyer Yug Chaudhari said the convict had in an inebriated state killed his mother and removed her organs and kept them on a table.

When the court sought to know the motive behind the crime, Chaudhari said it was not clear.

"We don't know the motive. Even his family is shocked. He was a wonderful man they all say. Unblemished record. He used to



have frequent headaches so he used to consume liquor," Chaudhari told the bench.

The prosecution case was that Kuchkoravi killed his mother and then eviscerated her with an intention to eat her organs.

Chaudhari on Monday pointed out that the convict comes from poor financial background and hence can not afford to pay escort charges incurred on police personnel taking him to the wedding venue.

The HC then exempted the convict from paying escort charges, and directed the competent authority of the Maharashtra government to make the necessary payments to policemen who will escort him.

"We are allowing him to be taken out of prison for three days only because it is his daughter's wedding," the court observed.

A sessions judge in Kolhapur in south Maharashtra had convicted and sentenced Kuchkoravi to death for offence of murder in July 2021.

The sessions judge had then remarked the case falls in the category of "rarest of rare" as it shook the conscience of society.

The state government had filed a sentence confirmation plea before the HC in 2021 itself. The confirmation plea was yet to be heard.

"DISAPPEARED LIKE 'MR INDIA": BJP ON UDDHAV THACKERAY'S "MOGAMBO" DIC

A day after Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Uddhav Thackeray dubbed Union Minister Amit Shah as "Mogambo", an iconic villain from the 1980s blockbuster film 'Mr India', the Bharatiya Janata Party on Monday centred its retort around the film's lead character's ability to disappear. 7 WINS TOPPED BY BEST PICTURE:

'All Quiet On The Western Front' creates buzz

The German epic film "All Quiet on the Western Front" dominated the BAFTA Awards in London on with a record-breaking seven wins, including Best Director, Best Film and Best Film Not in the English Language.

The tally means the World War I epic now holds the record for a film not in the English language. The previous record was held by 1988 film "Cinema Paradiso", which won five BAFTAs, reports 'Variety'. Meanwhile, Colin Farrell-starrer "The Banshees Of Inisherin" won the second most awards of the night, including both supporting actor categories with wins for Barry Keoghan and Kerry Condon, who emerged as the correct winner after fellow nominee Carey Mulligan's name was initially called in error. Writer and director Martin McDonagh also won for Original Screenplay and Outstanding British Film.

Other than the unfortunate Best Supporting Actress mix-up, the ceremony ran without a hitch, featuring performances from last year's Best Supporting Actress winner Ariana DeBose and singer-songwriter Dylan.

BAFTA Chair Krishnendu Majumdar opened the ceremony by paying tribute to Elizabeth II, who died last September. Later in the ceremony, Helen Mirren -- who played the monarch in "The Queen" -- also delivered a two-minute tribute. As per 'Variety', Queen Elizabeth II's grandson Prince William and his wife, the Princess of Wales, were in the audience at the Royal Festival Hall on Sunday evening. The prince is President of BAFTA, an honorary role.

Also in the audience were nominees, presenters and guests, including Michelle Yeoh, Eddie Redmayne, Jamie Lee Curtis, Ariana DeBose and Daryl McCormack. Other attendees included Angel Basset, Jessica Henwick, Patrick Stewart, Emma Thompson and fashion designer Vera Wang.

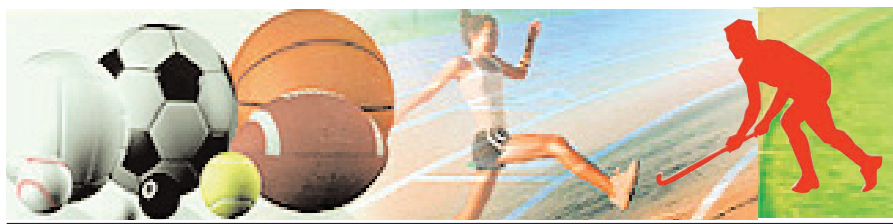

India opted to bat first after winning the toss and got off to a good start with Mandhana playing some crisp strokes. The openers put

Walking in at No.3, skipper Harmanpreet Kaur completed 3000 runs in T20Is, becoming the fourth women's cricketer to the landmark in this format. She forged a strong stand with Mandhana, who completed her half-century with a thumping six over mid-wicket. Harmanpreet fell in the 16th over, with Orla Prendergast taking a stunner

running in from the deep. Laura Delany added another wicket in the same over, sending back Richa Ghosh for a duck to complete a three-wicket haul.

Ireland, meanwhile, haven't quite been able to replicate the performance that saw them triumph against Australia in the warm-up match. They have lost all three matches so far but will hope to test the Indian lineup to notch up their first win at the Women's T20 World Cup. Harmanpreet Kaur and her team could have taken control of Group 2 and put one foot in the semi-finals with a win over England.

India bags two gold medals on Day-2

India's 10m Air Rifle Mixed team of Narmada Nithin Raju and Rudranksh Balasaheb Patil and 10m Air Pistol Mixed team of Rhythm Sangwan and Varun Tomar clinched the gold medals in the ongoing ISSF Rifle and Pistol Shooting World Cup.

Indian rifle team trounced Hungary's Eszter Denes and Istvan Peni 16-6 in the gold medal play-off to bag the top spot on the podium.

Earlier in the 38-team qualifications round in the pistol event, India (635.8) and Hungary (631) bagged the top two spots respectively to make it to the gold medal playoff. While Germany and Switzerland were third and fourth with 629.7 and 628.9 respectively.

In the 10m Air Pistol Mixed team event, the pair of Rhythm and Varun Tomar routed Serbians Zorana Arunovic and Damir Mikec 16-10 to pocket the gold medal. Germany took third place after beating France 16-6 in the bronze medal play-off.



Rhythm and Varun have topped the qualifications with 583-17x followed by Serbia team 582-21x in second place to qualify for the gold medal match.

Another Indian team of Divya Subbaraju and Sarabjot Singh missed out on a medal round after finishing fifth

with a qualification score of 577-14x. The 19-year-old Varun also won bronze in the 10m Air Pistol Men event after beating compatriot Sarabjot in a bronze medal shoot-off. India has so far won three medals in the competition (2 golds and a bronze).

Border Gavaskar Trophy

Cummins flies back home due to family health issues, Hazelwood ruled out of Tests due to injury

Carlos Alcaraz clinches title on season debut

With Sunday's win the Spaniard moved within 590 points of No. 1 in the ATP Live Rankings.

Henry, who missed the first Test at Bay Oval due to the birth of his second child, will be rejoining ahead of the second Test, starting on February 24 here at the Basin Reserve.

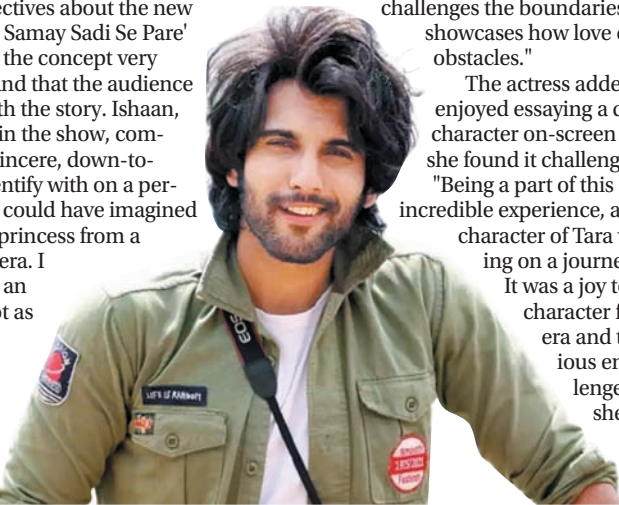
