

XBB.1.16 VARIANT DRIVES GLOBAL SURGE IN COVID CASES, DEATHS

According to the World Health Organization (WHO) so far, 3,648 sequences of the Omicron XBB.1.16 variant have been reported from 33 countries, including India, on open research platform GISAID, the global health body said. Meanwhile, India on Monday reported 7,178 new Covid cases in the last 24 hours, according to the data shared by the Union health ministry.

- Although there has been a "slight increase" in XBB.1.16-related hospitalisation in India and Indonesia, the levels are "much lower than seen in previous variant waves", as per the WHO.
- Further, "available information does not suggest that XBB.1.16 has additional public health risk relative to XBB.1.5 and the other currently circulating Omicron descendent lineages".
- "However, XBB.1.16 may become dominant in some countries and cause a rise in case incidence due to its growth advantage and immune escape characteristics," the WHO added.

he Omicron subvariant XBB.1.16, present in 33 countries, is making a fresh surge in Covid infections as well as deaths in Italy, the US, the UK, Vietnam, and other nations, including India.

According to the Italian Ministry of Health, the country recorded 27,982 new positive cases during April 14 and 20, compared to the previous week (21,779).

The number of deaths also increased by 48.1 per cent, totalling

191, compared to the previous week (129).Latest estimates from the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention states that the subvariant XBB.1.16 accounts for 9.6 per cent of new infections this week - up from nearly 6 per cent of cases the week before and about 3 per cent two

weeks prior. The UK Health and Security Agency (UKHSA) in the latest technical briefing said there were at least 135 cases of Omicron XBB.1.16, in the UK. It also claimed five lives in England. Media reports state that Ho Chi Minh City in Vietnam logged 56

fresh coronavirus cases with 42 hospitalisations during the past 24 hours, on April 23. Currently, 180 patients are receiving treatment in medical facilities and 57 cases require mechanical ventilation. In addition, Singapore and Australia also are seeing over 100 Covid cases.The current Covid surge in India is showing signs of slowing. In the last seven days, cases across the country rose by 20 per cent, a significantly lower rate than the 80 per cent to 110 per cent spikes seen in the previous five weeks, as the seven-day case count fell in four states where infections had earlier been surging.

Kerala, which has been reporting the highest number of new cases, logged a 13 per cent drop in the current week. Cases also fell in Gujarat, Himachal, Goa, Jammu and Kashmir, while showing no rise in Maharashtra. The global health body, last week, also upgraded XBB.1.16 as a Covid-19 "variant of interest" (VOI) due to its "sustained increase" and "growth advantage" reported from

several countries. Maria Van Kerkhove, technical lead for Covid-19 response at WHO said in a tweet that XBB.1.16 has shown "growth advantage and immune

'Better to wind up CBI'

SC sets aside Telangana HC order asking CBI to give questionnaire to YSRCP MP

he Supreme Court on Monday set aside the Telangana High Court, which directed the CBI, investigating the murder of former Andhra Pradesh Minister Y.S. Vivekananda Reddy, to provide a written questionnaire in advance to MP Y.S. Avinash Reddy, who is also under the agency's scan-

The top court said it is really perturbed by the high court order.

During the hearing, a bench headed by Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud and comprising Justice P.S. Narasimha orally observed that if this is the standard for investigation, then it is better to wind up the CBI and added that imagine other accused citing this as a precedent.

"First, anticipatory bail. Second, questionnaire by CBI. This is like rewriting criminal law jurisprudence... at the end of it, the CBI may or may not arrest you... the choice is of the investigating agency," the Chief Justice told senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi, representing Avinash Reddy. The Chief Justice said if this is the yardstick, then the same written questionnaire will have to apply in all CBI and ED cases. "Look what the high court said, the petitioner shall attend the CBI office, the question and answer shall be in printed written form. Questionnaire may be handed over to the petitioner,



why do we need the CBI?"

The top court observed that the high court has misapplied itself and passed an extraordinary order and such orders prejudice the investigation, especially when the CBI is ascertaining the role of several accused. It termed the high court order unwarranted, while quashing the direction the high court had issued to the CBI. However, the top court said the high court can proceed with the hearing of the anticipatory bail plea of Avinash Reddy on merits.

NO HEAT WAVE IN MOST PARTS OF INDIA FOR A WEEK: IMD

New Delhi: There will be no heatwave for the next seven days in most parts of the country, the weather office said today, in a big relief after days of scorching heat. A fresh w expected in the northwest region from Friday, it

Earlier this month, it had predicted abovenormal maximum temperatures in most parts of the country except northwest and peninsular India, during April-June.

The maximum temperatures were between 36-39 degrees Celsius in the northwest, central, and east India on Sunday, while it was 30-35 degrees in the rest of the country. The

Himalayan region saw it between 15-25 degrees. "No heat wave conditions are likely in the country during the next seven days," the India Meteorological Department said in its latest bul-

It said that the western Himalayan region is likely to receive rainfall from Wednesday and the northwestern plains from Friday.

Thunderstorms have been predicted in central Maharashtra, Telangana, and southern Madhya Pradesh between Tuesday-Thursday. Southern states like Tamil and Kerala are likely to receive rain for the next three-four days.

In Maharashtra, all schools affiliated with the state board have been shut till June 15 while the summer vacation extends till June 30 in Vidarbha region.

Wrestlers move SC for FIR against WFI President Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh

Trestler Vinesh Phogat and other wrestlers have moved the Supreme Court seeking a direction for registration of an FIR against Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh.

As senior advocate Narendra Hooda mentioned the plea before a bench headed by Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud on Monday, the Chief Justice asked Hooda to mention the matter again on Tuesday as his petition was not on the list of mentioning

According to the plea, Phogat and other wrestlers have cited an inordinate delay in registration of an FIR by Delhi Police against the WFI chief and urged the apex court to issue a direction to police to lodge a case against him. Counsel familiar with the development said the matter will be mentioned again for early hearing in the Supreme Court

A previous study, published in Melanoma Research earlier this year, showed that people who took vitamin D regularly were less likely to have had melanoma in the past or currently. They were also deemed by dermatologists to be less likely to develop melanoma in the future.



ED seizes 91.6 cr in action against app/payment gateways dealing into crypto

he Enforcement Directorate (ED) recently conducted searches against the offices of an app which dealt into cryptocurrencies and seized 91.6 crore lying in various Payment Gateways/accounts.

The seach was carried out on April 21 at three bank/payment gatways premises in respect of the accounts held by the entities controlled by Bhupesh Arora and his associates in connection with an investigation relating to the misuse of App-based token named "HPZ" and other similar applications by several entities.

The ED lodged the case on the basis of an FIR registered by Cyber Crime Police Station, Kohima, Nagaland, under various sections of IPC against HPZ token and others.

"The HPZ Token was an App-Based Token which promised users of



large gains against investment by investing in mining machines for Bitcoin and other crypto currencies.

Investigation unearthed larger conspiracy and involvement of various entities in money laundering," said

ED Investigation revealed that Lillian Technocab Pvt. Ltd and Shigoo Technology Private Limited were involved in the operating and collecting money from investors in the name of HPZ token. Bhupesh Arora and his associates had control over Shigoo Technology Private limited and he was indulged in operating unregistered gaming Apps/website in this company and various other entities and was collecting money fraud-

garb of these Apps/website. "During the searches, the total amount of Rs. 91.6 Crore was found lying-in various Bank accounts/Merchant Accounts maintained with Banks/Payment Gateways of the entities involved in money laundering and the same was freezed. Total freezing in this case is now Rs. 178 Crore," said the official.

SHARMILA ARRESTED FOR ASSAULTING POLICE PERSO

7SR Telangana Party (YSRTP) leader Y.S. Sharmila was on Monday arrested by the Hyderabad police for assaulting police personnel on duty.

Sharmila's two drivers were also booked under various sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC).

On a complaint by a sub-inspector of police, a case was filed against the sister of Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy at Banjara Hills police station.

Sharmila will be produced before a magistrate later in the day.

On the complaint by the subinspector, police registered a case against Sharmila and her drivers under IPC's Sections 353 (Assault or criminal force to deter public servant from discharge of his duty), 332 (Voluntarily causing hurt to deter public servant from his duty), 509 (Word, gesture or act intended to insult the modesty of a woman), and 427 (mischief causing damage)

Another case was booked under IPC section 337 (Causing hurt to any person by doing any act so rashly or negligently as to endanger human life, or the personal safety of others).



Earlier, Deputy Commissioner of Police Joel Davis said police had gone to Sharmila's house following information that she was going to the office of the Special Investigation Team (SIT) probing the Telangana State Public Service Commission (TSPSC) question paper leak. Since there was no permission for Sharmila's visit to the SIT office, the police personnel were trying to explain the same to her but she

assaulted police personnel.

A driver of Sharmila's car also did not stop the car on the order of police and hit them, injuring constable Giribabu. Sharmila allegedly manhandled two sub-inspectors and a woman constable. One of the SI's went to hospital for treatment.

The YSRTP leader was taken to Jubilee Hills police station. Later, when her mother Y.S. Vijayamma went to the police station to meet her. When she was stopped by the police, she had an argument with them. A video shows Vijayamma slapping a woman police constable.

Police forcibly sent Vijayamma back to her house. She alleged that police acted in a high-handed manner. She wanted to know how long Sharmila would be placed under house arrest. Sharmila's husband Anil Kumar later went to Jubilee Hills police station and met her.

Earlier, BJP's metropolitan in-charge Amit Valmiki, metropolitan president Sanjeev Sharma and many MLAs and all senior officials had gathered at the mayor's office. In the meantime, some workers started reaching there to complain as they were denied tickets.

Workers from the side of MP General V.K. Singh and Sahibabad MLA Sunil Sharma also came. These were the people who were



denied tickets of councillor from BJP, and other candidates were finalised

"A candidate who lives in Delhi has been given ticket from Raj Nagar Extension area. In such a situation, how can we accept an external candidate," a worker alleged.

Another worker alleged that pockets have been filled in distributing tickets in the name of BJP state president. The workers who created ruckus at the office of MLA Ajit Pal Tyagi said that ever since Reena Bhati has been given the ticket for the Khoda chairman seat, the names of eligible candidates are being deleted. "So far three names have been struck off and six have been put on hold. All this is happening at the behest of MLA Ajit Pal Tyagi," they alleged.

16,000 posts vacant in Education Department alone: Himachal minister

7ith 16,000 posts vacant in the Education Department alone, a meeting of the Cabinet Sub Committee on employment opportunities, Harshwardhan Chauhan, was held here on Monday to discuss filling of vacant posts in various government departments.

Around 70,000 posts of different categories are lying vacant in various departments, said the Industries Minister.

In the past five years, 2,375 posts were filled through the HP Public Service Commission and 15,706 posts through HP Staff Selection Commission.

He said the Cabinet Sub Committee expressed its concern over the slow recruitment process and it would also examine the mechanism to speed up the process.

The minister said in tribal areas, various posts were lying vacant in different departments, especially in the Education Department. He said the government would prioritise filling the vacant posts so that studies of students are not hampered for want of



He said that about 16,000 posts are vacant in the Education Department and the government is looking to fill these posts at the earli-

Chauhan said the Congress has promised one lakh jobs in its election manifesto. This was the second meeting of the Cabinet Sub Committee in this regard. He said another meeting of this Sub-Committee has been scheduled for April 25.

"On this information, staff reached the spot. Divers from Disaster Management were called on spot and the missing female was searched. After sincere efforts, her dead body was retrieved from the drain about 25 meters from Dharamshila Hospital," said the official. The woman was identified by her father and husband. "No injury mark was found on her body. Crime team was also called to inspect the spot. Body was removed to LBS Hospital," the official added. On initial enquiry, it was revealed that her marriage was solemnised on May 31, 2020 with Surjeet. Her husband Surjeet has a private job. Her father is a driver at a company in Noida," said the official. The official said that Swati had some mental problems since 2017 and was undergoing treatment at IHBAS Hospital.

"She was being treated for depression. Prima facie it seems to be a suicide case. Further enquiry is being conducted," the official

292 and urinated on him. After the plane landed at the Indira Gandhi





MPs, MLAs with more than 2 children should be made...: Aiit Pawar

enior Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) leader Ajit Pawar has said that people who go on to have more than two children should not be given any concessions, and even legislators in such cases should be made ineligible to contest elections.

India has surpassed China in terms of population growth, Mr Pawar said while speaking at an event in Baramati on Sunday.

"My grandfather used to tell me that when we got independence, our population was 35 crore and now it has reached 142 crore, and for that, we are all responsible," the Leader of Opposition in the state legislative Assembly

Ajit Pawar said that in an interview two days ago, he had asserted that all political parties should take this issue seriously.

"Everyone should stop after having one or two children for the betterment of our country, state, district, and region," he said.

he much-anticipated but hugely-delayed Mumbai-Ahmedabad Bullet Train has yet to pick up speed, as the last fiscal ended.

The mega-venture, which will be the country's first Bullet Train -- in the making since over five years now -- has achieved just 30.15 per cent overall physical progress till March 31, as per official figures.

On the Gujarat side, the progress is a little over one-third -- 35.23 percent done; and on the Maharashtra side it's a dismal 19.65 per cent overall completed.

Around 56.34 of the civil works on the project has been achieved and pile work has been carried out on 272.89 km so far.

While pier work is done on 170.56 km, 45.40 km of girders have been launched so far, the Ministry of Railways (MoR) said recently. India's maiden Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail project

(MAHSR) or Bullet Train, estimated to cost around Rs 108,000-crore, has been targeted for a trial run between Surat-Bilimora (63 km) by August

The entire 508 km-long Mumbai-

Ahmedabad corridor -- comprising 156 km in Maharashtra and 352 km in Gujarat -- is likely to commence full operations only by 2027.

As per the National High Speed Rail Corporation Ltd. (NHSRCL), the

Bullet Train would zoom at a maximum speed of 320 kmph, and the entire distance between Mumbai-Ahmedabad can be covered in just

The MAHSR comprises 92 per cent high-speed elevated railway tracks through viaducts (total 460 km) and bridges (9.22 km), tunnels (25.87 km), embankments/cutting (12.9 km).

A major highlight will be the rail corridor passing through the eco-sensitive Thane Creek between Mumbai-Thane on the northern side, a significant part comprising Thane Creek Flamingo Sanctuary (TCFS) which was designated as a Ramsar Site in August 2022.

To avoid disturbing the flamingos at the TCFS location and other wildlife in the adjoining rich mangroves, the MAHSR corridor will pass through an undersea tunnel at this sector. It will be India's first undersea tunnel and the country's longest rail transport thoroughfare with a single tube of 13.2 metres diameters, as per

Pune Customs foils attempt to illegally export livestock to Dubai

he Pune Customs on Monday foiled an attempt to export 3,500 live goats and sheep to Dubai and seized a vessel.

"Based on specific intelligence, the officers of Pune Customs, with the assistance of Indian Coast Guard (ICG), seized a vessel attempting to export about 3,500 live goats and sheep to Dubai from the Vijaydurg Port in Sindhudurg district, Maharashtra, under the guise of coastal cargo by an Indian vessel for supply to Gujarat," an official said.

The official added that the Pune Customs Commissionerate had received an unconfirmed intelligence regarding possible smuggling of goats/sheep out of India from the Konkan coast in Maharashtra.

Discreet surveillance was carried



out on one of the vessels which had submitted documents intimating coastal (domestic) supply of livestock

to Gujarat via sea route from the Vijaydurg port to Okha Port in Gujarat's Devbhumi Dwarka.

n it was noticed that the vessel Nagpur Agend had changed course and was headed towards Dubai, a Coast Guard vessel was deployed to intercept and bring it to the Angre Port in Maharashtra where suitable facilities were available. The Indian Coast Guard intercepted the vessel in the early hours of April 21, at about 90 NM into the open sea. The vessel with livestock was escorted to the Jaigad anchorage where a team of Customs officers conducted a thorough search that resulted in the seizure of several incriminating documents, indicating conspiracy to illegally export livestock

The vessel, along with its crew and cargo, has been detained for investigation, "All local authorities, DG Shipping and animal boards have been alerted, and a relief action is also underway," the official said.

Three killed, 3 hurt in Nagpur MIDC factory fire

t least three workers were killed in a major fire that broke out in a factory in the Hingna MIDC in Sonegaon-Nipani area of the district, officials said here on Monday.

Plumes of dark smoke were seen billowing out of the factory complex that was visible from long distances,

The leaders including MPs, legislators and party officials like Arvind Sawant, Anil Parab, Ravindra Waikar, Dr Manisha Kayande, and Sachin Ahir, said that the "insensitive" government erred in not taking into account the high temperatures in Khargar (the venue



grounds) in Navi Mumbai, while holding the megaevent in the open.

"It was a state function and they should have made arrangements for a marquee, fans, sufficient drinking water and other amenities for the people. It is shocking that the government and organisers did not take these

factors into account and it resulted into such a huge tragedy," the memorandum

They pointed out that the avoidable man-made disaster has served to spoil the image of Maharashtra and now measures must be taken to ensure that such can be avoided in the future.

After Centre's protocols applied, Maha reports zero pesticide-related deaths

fter the Centre's protocols for spraying insecticides in farmlands were implemented in 2018, Maharashtra has reported zero pesticide-related deaths of farm workers, a leading activist said here on Monday.

Shiv Sena (UBT)'s farmer-face Kishore Tiwari said that in 2016-2017, more than 40 farm workers in the state lost their lives while spraying insecticides in their fields, especially cotton farms, besides more deaths elsewhere in the country.

"Following our strong pressures, the Centre had implemented a set of protocols from 2018 which have been rigorously implemented in the farmlands. The results are impressive with zero pesticide-related deaths in Maharashtra," Tiwari pointed out.

Among the set of rules prescribed by the government are the use of full body kit while spraying the deadly insecticides, ban on daytime spraying as it created toxicity, using drones to spray in the fields, monitoring water quality, among others. After studying the outcome for five years, Tiwari has written a letter to Dr. J.P. Singh, Plant Protection Advisor in the Union Ministry of



Agriculture, of the protocol's impact in Maharashtra cotton farms.

"Farmers are now fully in support of these positive protocols on insecticides use. They are not only protecting the farmers and farm workers from the related health hazards, but also proving to be cost-effective and helping boost farm incomes," Tiwari pointed out.

Besides, he informed Dr. Singh that the domestically manufactured insecticides are effective and affordable compared to the very expensive imported varieties which led to sharpAincrease in the input costs for the farmers.

Tiwari, the former Chairman of Vasantrao Naik Sheti Swavalamban Mission (VNSSM), said cotton is a highly 'input-intensive crop' owing to its longer duration in the field, making it susceptible to attacks by pests like Pink BollWorms, White Fly, Thrips, Jassids, etc.

Smaller farmers with less than one hectares land could not afford the required six-seven different insecticide sprays as the new products cost more than Rs 10,000/litre, adding hugely to other costs like expensive labour, fertilisers, diesel, mechanisation,. : Most agriculturists, particularly the small farmers have been using the traditional insecticides like the Monocrotophos family that is safe for humans, effective against cotton insects, and doubled the cotton growers' yield. Hence, the cultivators have hailed the Centre's move to continue the use of 24 insecticides based on the scientific data of experts," Tiwari said.

The move followed a major pilot project in 2017 through multiple agencies like Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Agriculture University, Akola, Department of Agriculture, medicos, and other experts carried out on the issue among the cotton farmers

26 regional parties got donations over Rs 189cr in 21-22

wenty-six regional parties have received 5,100 donations worth Rs 189.801 crore -- both above and below Rs 20,000 -- during the 2021-22 financial year (FY), reveals a report by the Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR). No donations have been declared by AIADMK, BJD, NDPP, SDF, AIFB, PMK and JKNC for FY 2021-22. The report focuses on donations declared by Regional Political Parties, during the Financial Year 2021-22, as submitted by the parties to the Election Commission of India (ECI). With regard to the total amount of donations, TRS leads with Rs 40.90 crore from 14 donations followed by AAP which has declared receiving Rs 38.243 crore from 2619 donations. JDU received Rs 33.257 crore that is the third highest amongst all regional parties. SP and YSR Congress have declared total donations Rs 29.795 crore and Rs 20.01 crore, respectively. Nearly 85.46 per cent or Rs 162.21 crore of the total donations received by regional parties, have been received solely by top five regional parties. ADR analysed 33 out of 54 regional parties and only 19 had submitted their donations reports to the ECI in the stipulated time period. Fourteen other regional parties have delayed their submission by a minimum of two days to 109 days. Maximum donations in cash were declared by IUML, which collected a total of Rs 5.55 lakhs, followed by KC-M with Rs 1 lakh, PDF with Rs 80,000, PPA with Rs 5,000 and AAP with Rs 120. Among all the states, donors from Tamil Nadu made the highest donations of Rs 5.55 lakhs in cash followed by donors from Arunachal Pradesh who donated a total of Rs 5,000 in cash. Nearly 4.78 per cent or Rs 1.828 crore of the total donations above Rs 20,000 made to AAP was received from abroad, the ADR report said.

ALL EYES ON BIHAR CASTE CENSUS: CAN IT BE THE NATIONAL TEMPLATE?

With the second phase of the caste based census underway in Bihar, the people of the starting to analyse its positives and negatives.

The 'intellectual community' believes that it has some loopholes like the sub-castes in the Extremely Backward Class (EBC), Other Backward Castes (OBC), Dalit and Muslim communities will be counted but there is no provision to count sub-castes in upper castes.

It has created suspicions in the minds of the people about the intentions of the state government, or this loophole being used for political purposes.

Ashok Kumar, a Patna based private teacher, told IANS: "The state government is well aware that MLAs, MLCs and MPs of upper castes cannot advocate for their castes in Bihar. They believe that if they talk in the interest of upper caste people, their vote banks of lower castes may slip away from them and they might lose the election."

"Two to three upper caste MLAs and MPs are in the RJD, BJP, JD-U, Congress, HAM and others but they are not vocal about the interests of their castes. On the other hand, Dalit and minority leaders talk in the interest of their castes. This is the reason why the state government is counting castes and subcastes of EBC, OBC and the minorities but not in the upper castes. The leaders at the panchayat or block level may talk for the interest of their castes but in the rank of MLA, MLC and MP they cannot dare to do that. They are looking at their personal and party interests," Kumar said.

"I am connected to the Bhumihar Ekta Manch Whatsapp group where a number of BJP leaders are also present. The BJP has decided to celebrate Babu Veer Kunwar Singh birth anniversary on April 23 which is okay but I have pointed out to celebrate Parsuram Jayanti as well on 22 but no one reacted to it," Kumar said

No one knows the actual numbers of castes but there is a general perception in Bihar that the numbers of EBC, OBC and minority communities are much higher than upper castes like Bhumihar Brahmins, Rajput and Kayasth. The BJP has traditional voters belonging to the upper castes while Nitish Kumar is an undisputed leader of the Lav-Kush community and Lalu Prasad Yadav is a leader of Muslim-Yadav and other lower castes. Jitan Ram Manjhi is a leader of Mahadalits and Chirag Paswan is a leader of the Dalit community.

However, the caste based census has lots of positives as well. Dr Vijay Kishore, a Patna based economist said: "After the completion of caste based census, we would earmark the backwardness of a particular caste and community. Following that, the state and central governments are running many welfare programmes in the interest of EBC, OBC and minority communities. There is no political interest involved which I also believe will benefit the common people on the social, financial and political fronts."

The first phase of the caste based census was completed in March this year where every house had a unique house code. The second phase kicked off from April 15 and will end in one month.

In the second phase, Bihar government employees will go to every house and ask 17 questions printed on one sheet. The same will also be uploaded digitally as well so that anyone can access it from the inter-



net.

The employees will ask the name of the family head, his/her father's name, age, sex, marital status, religion, caste, sub-caste (In case of EBC, OBC, minority) followed by code, educational qualification, profession, residential status (Staying in own house or rent), temporary migration status, owning computer, laptop, motor vehicles, agriculture land, residential land and income from all sources.

Patna district magistrate and nodal officer of the caste based census in the district Dr Chandrashekher Singh said: "It is taking half an hour to collect the information on one family in physical and digital modes. We are also contacting people who are living abroad. We are asking their profession, tenure, castes, financial status with country code through video calling. Everything is going in a smooth manner."

Bihar chief minister Nitish Kumar said: "The report will be tabled in the Bihar Vidhan Sabha and Vidhan Parishad followed by it being sent to the Centre. The detailed report of the caste

will not only give the caste status of a particular person but also its financial status. It will help to make policies followed by the development of the people and eventually the state."

INDIAN NOT ALLOWED TO BRING PREGNANT SUDANESE WIFE HOME, CRIES FOR HELP

A n Indian national in crisis-torn Sudan has been left in a spot after the Indian mission in Khartoum approved his evacuation request but left behind his pregnant wife who is a Sudanese national.

Boby Sebastian from Kottayam, Kerala, has been working in Khartoum for the past three years, and is married to Sudanese national Hala Muawia Mohamed Abuzaid.

"Due to current unrest in the country and deadly situation we registered evacuation request to (the) Indian Embassy in Khartoum," Sebastian wrote in a message posted by author and migrant rights activist Rejimon Kuttappan on his social media.

"The evacuation request was successful for me but unfortunately, my wife was not listed on the selected names... I feel it is very unsafe and dangerous to leave her here (Sudan), and also she is conceiving," the message read.

Sebastian's Sudanese wife does not have a valid Indian visa or an OCI



card at the moment.

According to Kuttappan, the couple has marriage documents, and the wife has also visited Kerala in the

Sebastian has requested the relevant Indian authorities to intervene,

saying that there isn't "enough time to obtain a valid Indian visa" for his wife. Responding to Kuttappan's tweet,

Tharoor said that he is now in direct
touch with Sebastian, and has con-

tacted External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar's office for an emergency evacuation.

"I am in touch with him directly in Khartoum and have contacted @DrSjaishankar's office to arrange for an emergency evacuation on a temporary permit till her OCI card can be processed," Tharoor wrote in response to the tweet.

"MEA (Ministry of External Affairs) will probably need to coordinate with MHA (Ministry of Home Affairs) to get this done. My sympathies are with him." Tharoor wrote.

There are approximately 4,000 Indian citizens in Sudan, and according to the Indian Embassy in Khartoum, about 1,500 of them are longtime residents.

Violent clashes that erupted between the Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF) and paramilitary Rapid Support Forces on April 15, continues unabated. According to Sudan's Health Ministry, the violence has left at least 424 people dead and about 3,730 wounded.



Death due to lightning strikes is common in the densely populated country during this time of the year, as the weather changes from the dry to the rainy summer season. Bangladesh has seen a surge in lightning strike deaths, with hundreds of fatalities recorded annually in the past few years.

SC transfers all FIRs against comedian **Munawar Faruqui to Indore**

he Supreme Court on Monday transferred, to Indore, all FIRs against comedian Munawar Faruqui for allegedly making remarks on Hindu deities during a show and hurting religious sentiments. A bench headed by Justice

B.R. Gavai also extended Faruqui's interim protection for three weeks in connection with a production warrant in Delhi. The bench, also comprising justice Sanjay Karol, made it clear that the court has not gone into the merits of the plea for quashing the case. As Faruqui's counsel contended that FIRs should not be transferred to Indore as there is threat to his client's safety over there, the bench orally observed: "Indore is a safe city. It is also close to Mumbai. What is the issue



with transferring the FIRs to Indore?" The counsel urged the bench to club the FIRs and transfer them either to Mumbai or Delhi and not Indore or Prayagraj. He said there was a huge mob and there were threats to his client's safety in these cities.

After hearing arguments, the bench said: "Taking into

consideration the facts and circumstances, and the previous order of this court, we are inclined to transfer all the complaints to a police station in Indore." The bench said it has not considered the merits of the matter insofar as the prayer for quashing and the petitioner is at liberty to initiate such proceedings as permitted under the law. In February, the top court had released Faruqui on an interim bail by staying the Madhya Pradesh High Court order, declining to grant him bail. The son of a BJP MLA had filed a complaint against Faruqui and others. According to the FIR, the remarks were made at a comedy show held at a cafe in Indore in January 2021. It was alleged that in the show jokes were made regarding Hindu gods and goddesses and Union Home Minister

'Pregnancy test' for eligibility for mass marriage ceremony sparks off controversy

controversy broke out over alleged "pregnancy tests" as part of eligibility for "Mukhyamantri Kanya Vivah" - a mass marriage scheme where the state government provides Rs 51,000 grant to each bride - in Madhya Pradesh's tribal-dominated Dindori district.

As per reports, the test was conducted before the beneficiaries were to take part in the mass marrige ceremony on the occasion of Akshay Tritiya on Saturday, and four women were removed after their positive pregnancy reports. Following the development, the opposition Congress sought to know under what guidelines these women were subjected to the tests. Local MLA Markam Singh said that he has learnt that four women were disqualified from the scheme because of their positive reports. He said that by con-



ducting such tests, the government has not only insulted the poor women, but also have put their life at risk after releasing their reports. "The state government must clarify what are the guidelines or rules for such pregnancy tests. What will be the future of those women whose test reports were made public," Markam Singh told reporter over phone on Sunday. According to Dindori district administration, a total of 219 women from Scheduled Tribes (ST), Schedule Castes (SC) and OBC families were brides in the mass marriage ence of local leaders and officials.

The controversy escalated further after state Congress President Kamal Nath raised questions over the 'pregnancy tests' of women and demanded a high-level inquiry in the matter.

"I want to know from the Chief Minister whether this news is true? If this is true, then on whose orders was such gross insult done to the daughters of Madhya Pradesh? Do the daughters of the poor and tribal communities have no dignity in the eyes of the CM?" he said in a series of tweets. What is surprising is that officials had different stands while responding to the matter.

District Collector Vikas Mishra told the press that directives were issued during the mass marriage event for detection of sickle cell disease of those taking part. He also said that during the medical examination, some brides had complained of periods issues after which the pregnancy test was conducted.

in the future among the students of classes IX to XII.

he death of another cheetah within a month has raised serious questions about the efficiency of officials at Madhya Pradesh's Kuno National Park (KNP). The KNP lost yet another cheetah when the six-year-old male feline Uday died on Sunday. Uday, who was given this name just recently, was among the 12 cheetahs that were translocated from South Africa in a special Indian Air Force plane under 'Project Cheetah' on February 18.

The officials associated with the KNP said that the cheetah died a few hours after the sudden deterioration of health during the treatment and the exact reason for his death would be confirmed only after the postmortem is done. However, sources said that the feline was "highly stressed".

The questions are also being raised because there was no report of ill health of Uday before Sunday.

According to the Madhya Pradesh Forest Department officials, the cheetah was found dull during the inspection in the morning on Sunday, following which the veterinarians alerted senior officials and it was taken out from the large enclosure for treatment.

Correspondent has learnt that ever since the first batch of eight cheetahs was released at KNP on September 17, there was infighting among state Forest Department officials due to one or another reasons. Sources claimed that the appointment of some senior officials at KNP was questioned within the department and the infighting had reached the state Forest Ministry.

Some senior forest officials were reshuffled recently - for instance, P.K. Sharma who was serving as DFO at KNP was transferred to Pench Tiger Reserve (PTR), while Rajneesh



Singh who was DFO at Pench was transferred to the KNP. More importantly, some wildlife activists had raised their concerns over the appointment of Uttam Sharma as Chief Conservator of Forest (CCF).

Madhya Pradesh-based wildlife activist Ajay Dube, seeking the attention of Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan and the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA), had warned that the life of translocated cheetahs "would be in danger".

"The kind of activities (that) are happening, I am raising my concern that the life of cheetahs at KNP would be in danger," Dube had mentioned in a letter written to Chief Minister Chouhan and the NTCA on September 22, just five days after eight Namibian cheetahs were released at

Talking to IANS on Sunday, Dube said: "Wildlife trained full-time director is vital for cheetah project because Uttam Sharma has proven to be inefficient. Transferred DFO Kuno P.K. Sharma should be relieved immediately and a thorough investigation is required on the death of two cheetahs.'

Some other wildlife activists also raised questions on why Uttam Sharma, who is an expert of forest, was given the role of wildlife expertise at three places - at KNP, as CCF of Gwalior and as head of the lion project. "We have to understand that forest and wildlife, both are different. Uttam Sharma is undoubtedly a renowned forest expert as he has been a professor also, but his appointment as a wildlife official has always remained under question. Three radio-collared tigers were killed during his appointment in Panna Tiger Reserve," Dube said.

Earlier, a female Namibian cheetah Sasha died due to a kidney ailment at KNP on March 27.

Ferran Torres scored the only goal of the game two minutes from halftime, with a powerful shot that Atletico keeper Jan Oblak will be disappointed not to have saved. Betis slipped to a 3-2 defeat away to Osasuna, and are in danger of slipping out of the top-six after Athletic Club Bilbao made it three wins and a draw from their

last four games with a comfortable 2-1 win away to struggling Almeria. Athletic's win leaves them just a point behind sixth place Villarreal after the latter became Sevilla's third victim in a week, slipping to a 2-1 defeat in the Sanchez Pizjuan Stadium.

Monchu's 24th-minute goal helped Valladolid make it six points from two games to move them five points clear of the bottom three with a 1-0 win at home to Girona.

aptain Andrew Balbirnie hit a masterful 95 before Lorcan Tucker surpassed him as Ireland's leading Test run-scorer as Ireland reached 319/4 on Day One of the second and final Test match of the series against Sri Lanka on Monday.

Balbirnie registered his career-best Test score in a century stand with Paul Stirling but was dismissed five runs short of a maiden hundred in the evening session. Stirling also reached a career-best total of 74 before retiring hurt, struggling with cramps. The two batting stalwarts led the rebuilding job after Sri Lanka took early wickets, reducing the visitors to 43/2, with PJ Moor and James



McCollum falling cheaply. Harry Tector was given out on an lbw decision on 11, but the review showed the ball bouncing over the wicket. But he was only able to add another seven runs before he charged down the pitch off Prabath Jayasuriya, and hit straight to a stretching midon fielder. That led to Stirling's arrival at the crease, fresh off the plane having joined the squad for this match only. True to style, he made his intentions clear early on, thumping a length ball over the square-leg boundary for a six to get off the mark on his third ball. Stirling

Swiatek maintained her undefeated career record at the Stuttgart GP (8-0 in her two appearances) and now holds a 5-2 win-loss record against Sabalenka in their rivalry. It was also Swiatek's 20th win this year. It was the first clay-court final between the world's top two-ranked players in a decade, with the last one occurring at the 2013 Roland Garros, where No. 1 Serena Williams defeat-

ed No. 2 Maria Sharapova for the title. Reigning Australian Open champion Sabalenka left Stuttgart with 23 match-wins this year. Despite reaching the final in each of the past three years, Sabalenka was denied by Ashleigh Barty in 2021

before her two losses to Swiatek. In the doubles final, No. 2 seeds and last year's champions Desirae Krawczyk of the United States and Demi Schuurs of the Netherlands beat third seeds Nicole Melichar-Martinez of the United States and Giuliana Olmos of Mexico 6-4, 6-1.




