## BHOPAL WAKES UP TO CLOUDY SKY, THUNDERSTORM LIKELY IN SEVERAL PARTS OF MP

Bhopal woke up to a cloudy morning on Saturday and the weather department has predicted thunderstorm and lightning in parts of Madhya Pradesh later in the day.

According to the regional meteorological department, Bhopal, thunderstorm along with lightning is likely in several other parts of the state including Indore, Jabalpur, Shahdol, Dewas, Narsinghpur, Shajapur and in some more districts.

The maximum temperature during the day time in Bhopal is likely to settle between 22 degrees Celsius and 39 degrees Celsius.

As per the data received from the weather department,



Seoni district recorded 4.8 mm rain in the last 24 hours. While, in the last three days, at least three people were killed due to lightning in Sehore district, adjoining Bhopal.

The weather department has predicted that the temperature in the state would further go up from the next week.

The weather scientists in Bhopal regional office have also predicted thunder and high velocity winds in Morena, Guna, Bhand, Ashok Nagar, Anuppur, Sidhi, Mandla, Tikamgarh, Singrauli, Dindori, Balaghat and Seoni.

## "JYOTIRADITYA SCINDIA ISN'T A TRAITOR, HE'S SELF-RIGHTEOUS": SHIVRAJ CHOUHAN

Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has slammed the Congress party for continuously making remarks against Union Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia and has said that Mr Scindia is not a traitor but a self-righteous leader. Chief Minister Chouhan made the remark while talking to news agency in the state capital Bhopal on Saturday.

"Scindia is not a traitor, he is self-righteous. After all, how much insult he tolerates from the Congress party. The Congress fought the election in the name Scindia but made elderly Kamal Nath the Chief Minister of the state. Even the government was also being run by former Chief Minister Digvijay Singh and Nath was just a face only," Chouhan said.

Time and again Scindia (when he was in Congress party) and his com-



panions were drawing attention of Kamal Nath towards the public problems, but Nath's arrogance was so high that when Scindia said to do

work or else he would protest, then where Nath did not paid attention to it, the Chief Minister said. He added that Nath's ego was such

that he would drop him (Scindia) in another party by car. How could Scindia tolerate it? After all, how much he would get humiliated? he asked "I want to say one more thing that if they (Scindia and his companions) were wrong then how would the public make them win by thousands of votes in by elections. Those who won by 1000 or 2000 votes by staying in Congress, they won by 50 to 60 thousand votes in the by-poll. We are not running the government because of someone's favour, they resigned, contested elections and came back victorious," Chouhan said.

There is a competition of pettiness going on in Congress, the Chief Minister said. "Every congress leader wants to make a statement to belittle the other leader and even Kamal Nath and Digvijay Singh are also involved in it. God knows what will happen to the Congress," the Chief Minister added.

## 2 Maoists with bounty of Rs 14 lakh each killed in Balaghat

State Hawk force and police team killed two women Maoists carrying a reward of Rs 14 lakh each in an encounter in Madhya Pradesh's Balaghat district in the early hours of Saturday.

The Maoists were gunned down in Kandla forest under Garhi police station of the district. The women Maoists were identified as Sunita (Bhoram Dev Area Committee Member) and Sarita (Khatia Mocha Area Committee Member). Both of them were active in Maoist activities for the past many years. The police team also recovered rifles, live cartridges, weapons, edible stuff and other materials from the spot. After the killing of the Maoists during the night, Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan on



Saturday morning congratulated the state police, hawk force and district police force for the same.

"Two dreaded Naxalites were killed, who were carrying a bounty of 14 lakh each on their heads, in an encounter in Balaghat in the night. Weapons and many other things have also been recovered from them. I congratulate the soldiers for the same," Chief Minister Chouhan said.

The Chief Minister further said that it was the fourth encounter in the last one and half years. The bravery and alertness of the police is that they are continuously killing the Maoists. A total of eight dreaded Maoists killed so far in the 1.5 years on whom a reward of about 1.5 crore were announced.

"Our resolution is the rule of law. We will not allow any dacoits to flourish or Naxalites to spread their wings in the state. After Students' Islamic Movement of India (SIMI), we are engaged in eliminating Popular Front of India (PFI) people involved in terror activities from the state. We will not spare the goons and miscreants who disturb the peace and tranquillity of the public. It is the commitment of the MP Government," Chouhan added.

## "Blot On India": BJP slams Digvijaya Singh for dig at Jyotiraditya Scindia

Senior Congress leader Digvijaya Singh's dig at his former party colleague Jyotiraditya Scindia has triggered a war of words, with leaders from the ruling BJP calling the grand old party's Rajya Sabha member a "blot" on the country and wishing that he is born in Pakistan in his next life.

Digvijaya Singh on Friday visited Ujjain city in Madhya Pradesh, where the famous Mahakaleshwar temple is located. Responding to a query about what he would seek from the deity, Singh had told reporters, "Hey Mahakal, a second Jyotiraditya Scindia should not be born in the Congress." Scindia, who was once considered to be a close aide of former Congress chief Rahul Gandhi, quit the grand old party in March 2020, ending his nearly two-decade-long



association with the organisation. He then joined the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and was made a union minister. Following Singh's swipe at him, Scindia had on Friday tweeted that Lord Mahakal should ensure an "anti-national" like Mr Singh, who also greatly harmed Madhya Pradesh, is not born in India.

When asked about the Congress veteran's remark against Scindia, BJP leader and Minister for Panchayat Mahendra Singh Sisodia said, "I pray to Lord Mahakal that a person like Digvijaya Singh,

who ruined the entire Congress and Madhya Pradesh, should be born in Pakistan in his next life." Minister for Medical Education Vishvas Sarang, who also belongs to the BJP, reacted sharply to Singh's remarks as he termed him a "Pro-Pakistan" leader and accused him of insulting the country's army and soldiers.

"Leaders like Digvijaya Singh are a blot on this country. Jyotiraditya ji has rightly tweeted. Such people who speak pro-Pakistan language, talk about giving protection to terrorists and dividing this country, such people have no place in India," Sarang said.

The Congress government under Kamal Nath in the state, which came to power in December 2018 after 15 years of BJP rule, collapsed in March 2020 after 22 MLAs loyal to Scindia joined the saffron party following his rebellion in the grand old party.

## 65 new cases were found in Madhya Pradesh

In the last 24 hours, 65 new cases of corona have been found in Madhya Pradesh. Among these, Bhopal has the maximum number of 17 cases, while 13 people were found infected in Gwalior, 9 in Indore and 11 in Sagar. Corona cases have also been reported in Rajgarh, Khandwa, Agar-Malwa, Satna, Sehore and Raisen. 42 patients have recovered, but there are still 369 active cases in the state. Earlier on Friday, 107 new corona

patients were found in the state. Out of these 44 patients were from Bhopal only. On Saturday, the figure of the infected gave some relief and the figure came down. No infected person has died in the last 24 hours. It was a relief.

Corona cases are continuously increasing in the state. Worry has also increased due to this. In such a situation, people also need to take precautions. The mask has to be brought into practice once again. In case of cold or fever, see the doctor immediately.

## 'I turned down Star Wars'

**AL PACINO SAYS HE 'GAVE HARRISON FORD A CAREER' AFTER TURNING DOWN ICONIC ROLE**

Hollywood legend Al Pacino opened up about turning down the role of Han Solo in 'Star Wars' because he "didn't understand the script" and said that he "gave Harrison Ford a career." The actor opened up about being a "new kid on the block" at the time of inception for the now-cultural phenomenon and explained that although they "offered him so much money" he just "didn't understand" the storyline. "Well, I turned down Star Wars," he told David Rubenstein as part of the 92nd Street Y, New York's People Who Inspire Us series, reports mirror.co.uk.

"When I first came up, I was the new kid on the block; you know what happens when you first become famous.

"It's like, 'Give it to Al,' they'd give me Queen Elizabeth to play," Al recalled. "They gave me a script called Star Wars."

"They offered me so much money," he revealed. "But I didn't understand it, I read it. So I said I couldn't do it. I gave Harrison Ford a career." Harrison Ford took on the role as

Han Solo in the original film, which grossed for \$775.8 million at the worldwide box office with just an \$11 million budget. Al looked back on a role he did accept as Michael Corleone in The Godfather and stated that he rewatched the movie after not watching it for 25 years. He added that at the time of filming the cult classic, studio executives were underwhelmed with his performance and were initially planning to replace him. In a meeting with the movie's director Francis Coppola, Al remembers him saying: "You know, I had a lot of faith in you. And you're failing me, I'm standing there thinking 'What the f\*\*k, what did I do?'"

"The Sollozzo scene, where Michael shoots the cop. Coppola pushed that up, because he thought Paramount was about to fire me," Al said. "I do the scene, they liked it, and they kept me in because I shot someone." Al's role in his most "gratifying film," Scarface, came with a few downsides and the actor recalled one of his many injuries from being on set.

## DREW STARKEY TO STAR ALONGSIDE DANIEL CRAIG IN LUCA GUADAGNINO'S 'QUEER'

- has adapted the Burroughs novel for the big screen, continuing his collaboration with the Italian director.

British designer Jonathan Anderson, who has shaken up the fashion world with his creations for Loewe and his subversive signature JW Anderson label, will also continue to collaborate with Guadagnino as costume designer on 'Queer' after handling the costumes on 'Challengers.'

"It is one of my all time favourite books. And the film has everything - Mexico, lots of drugs, and Daniel Craig," Anderson recently told The Guardian.

Written between 1951 and 1953 but not published until 1985, 'Queer' is Burroughs' second novel after 'Junkie.'
