WRESTLING MESS: IOC CONDEMNS POLICE ACTION AGAINST WRESTLERS, URGES IOA TO PROTECT ATHLETES

Wrestlers got support

The International Olympic Committee (IOC) has condemned the alleged manhandling by Delhi Police of protesting wrestlers over the weekend by calling it "disturbing" and urged the authorities to ensure the "well-being of the athletes" throughout the investigation against Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) sidelined chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh.

Close on the heels of a similar statement by United World Wrestling, the sport's world governing body, the IOC also urged the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) to take all necessary action to protect the protesting wrestlers.

Since April 23, prominent Indian wrestlers led by Olympians Bajrang Punia, Sakshi Malik, and Vinesh Phogat have been staging a protest at the Jantar Mantra demanding the arrest of Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh over sexual harassment of female

athletes, including a minor. The IOC also confirmed its close communication with the United World Wrestling (UWW), the global governing body for the sport, regarding the matter.

Last weekend, the protesting wrestlers were detained by the Delhi Police during their march towards the new Parliament building.

As the protesters tried to breach the security cordon, a fierce tussle broke out -- the wrestlers and cops pushed, shoved and grappled with one another.

Khaps extend full support to wrestlers, mull approaching President

Muzaffarnagar (UP): The Mahapanchayat of Khaps that met in Muzaffarnagar on Thursday has decided to meet President Droupadi Murmu if need be and seek justice for the protesting wrestlers demanding the arrest of Wrestling Federation of India chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh on charges of sexual harassment.

Bharatiya Kisan Union (BKU) spokesman

Rakesh Tikait said the final decision on the issue of wrestlers' protest will be taken at a meeting in Haryana on Friday.

The Mahapanchayat held at Sauram village extended full support to the protesting wrestlers and demanded the arrest of WFI chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh. Meanwhile, farmer leader Mangeram Tyagi alleged that the wrestlers' protest is being

given a casteist colour. BKU chief Naresh Tikait, who had persuaded the wrestlers not to immerse their medals into River Ganga on Tuesday, made it clear that they will leave no stone unturned.

The wrestlers have been on a warpath since January, demanding action against WFI chief Singh, whom they accused of sexually harassing seven athletes.

Security tightened at Delhi borders following SKM's nationwide protest call

New Delhi: Delhi Police have tightened security measures along the city's borders, including Singhu, Tikri and Ghazipur, in the wake of a nationwide demonstration call by the Samyukt Kisan Morcha (SKM) in support of the country's top grapplers protesting against the Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) chief, Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh.

"Additional police personnel have been deployed, and extra checkpoints were set up to prevent any undesirable occurrences," a senior police official said on Thursday. "Security has been heightened, and we have increased the presence of police personnel while setting up additional checkpoints at Delhi's borders. Our objective is to ensure the maintenance of law and order and prevent any untoward incidents," said another officer. The officer also mentioned that vehicles entering Delhi from neighbouring states are being subjected to thorough inspections at the borders. On Tuesday, the SKM had announced demonstrations and effigy burning of the WFI chief at villages and town centres on June 5, the day RSS workers and Mahants have called a rally in support of Brij Bhushan in Ayodhya.

Meanwhile, The state government on Thursday appointed senior IPS officer Rajiv Singh, belonging to the neighbouring Tripura cadre, as Director General of Police (DGP) replacing incumbent state police chief P. Doungel.

As the sporadic incidents of violence continued in Manipur, the government extended the suspension of Internet services till June 5 to prevent the spread of rumours and videos, photos, and messages, which might affect the law and order situation in the ethnic-violence hit northeastern state. Commissioner, Home, H. Gyan Prakash, in a fresh notification extending the suspension of Internet services till June 5, said that the Director General of Police, Manipur, reported that there are still reports of incidents like arson of houses and premises. "There is an apprehension that some anti-social elements might use social media extensively for transmission of images, hate speech and hate video messages inciting the passions of the public, which might have serious repercussions for the law and order situation in the state," the order said.

After the widespread violence broke out on May 3 in 11 of the 16 districts during and after the 'Tribal Solidarity March' called by the All Tribal Students' Union of Manipur to oppose the demand for inclusion of the Meitei community in the Scheduled Tribe category, the Manipur government suspended the Internet to control the situation.

When shortage of various essentials, transport fuel and life-saving drugs, disturbances in banking and ATM facilities shattered the normal life, the Internet suspension for around a month across the mountainous state further added to the problems of the people.

Shah announces separate judicial, CBI probes into Manipur violence

Imphal: Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Thursday announced a judicial probe into the month-long ethnic violence in Manipur by a retired High Court Chief Justice and a CBI investigation into six specific cases. After a four-day visit to the strife-torn Manipur, the Home Minister said that a high-level peace committee headed by Governor Anusuiya Uikey would be formed and people from all sections and communities would be included in the committee. He said that a joint security command headed by Chief Security Advisor to Manipur Kuldip Singh (Retired IPS officer and former CRPF Chief) would be formed and it would impartially conduct all the security related operations. The Home Minister announced that a Joint Secretary and five director level officers would be posted in Manipur by the central government to supervise to deal with all the issues and actions in the Manipur crisis. The Centre would provide an additional 30,000 MT of rice besides taking all out efforts for uninterrupted supply of petrol, diesel, cooking gas, essentials, vegetables and all other required items.

INDIA CARRIES OUT SUCCESSFUL TRAINING LAUNCH OF MEDIUM-RANGE BALLISTIC MISSILE AGNI-1

New Delhi: India carried out successful training launch of medium-range ballistic missile, Agni-1, from APJ Abdul Kalam Island off the coast of Odisha, the defence ministry said on Thursday.



"The missile is capable of striking targets with a very high degree of precision. The training launch successfully validated all operational and technical parameters of the missile," the ministry informed.

Earlier, a successful test of Agni 5 missile was carried out in December last year. The Agni 5 is a nuclear capable ballistic missile. It was a night trial of Agni 5 ballistic missile and the test was successful.

The test of Agni 5 was also carried out from Odisha. The missile is capable of striking targets at ranges up to 5,000 kilometres with very high degree of accuracy. Range of the missile can be further increased based on the results of the testing.

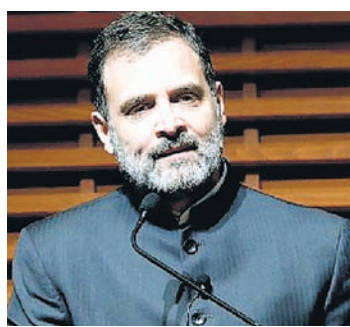
Not seeking any int'l support, our fight is ours: RaGa at Stanford

In his address at the Stanford University, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi clarified he was not seeking any international support and said that "our fight is ours".

While addressing a gathering at the California-based varsity on Wednesday, Rahul, who is on a six-day trip to the US, was asked about his opinion on many opposition parties across the world seeking international support. To this, the former MP said: "I'm not seeking support from anyone or anybody. I am very clear that our fight is our fight."

The Congress leader said that he wanted to speak to a group of young students from India at the Stanford University and build rela-



tions with them.

"I think it is my right to do it and I don't understand why Prime Minister Narendra Modi doesn't come here and do it. The Prime Minister needs to answer some hard questions," Rahul said.

On a number of occasions, the BJP

has attacked Rahul Gandhi for defaming the country on foreign soil.

Breaking his silence on his disqualification from Parliament, former Congress Rahul Gandhi has said that he had never imagined that he would get maximum punishment in a defamation case and would be disqualified as an MP, but asserted that it has given him a lot of opportunity to work. He said on Wednesday that "democracy isn't about opposition, it is about sacred institutions that support the opposition, and those institutions by the capture certainly want to change the role it is supposed to do." He made the remarks while delivering a lecture at the prestigious Stanford University Campus in California on the changing world order and India's crucial role within it.

'Man Mein Ek Aas Hai', Pilot's video triggers speculations

With Assembly polls nearing in Rajasthan, the Congress high-command recently 'resolved' the internal conflict between Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and his former deputy Sachin Pilot after two months of constant exchange of barbs between the two camps.

As the party leadership is now trying to show that everything is fine in Rajasthan Congress, a tweet by Sachin Pilot has triggered speculations in the political circles.

Pilot has posted a video story on his Twitter handle, in which he is seen with the people of the state.

He captioned the video: "There is hope in my mind, there is a belief in the heart, will build a strong Rajasthan, when people are together."



While Pilot is visible in every slide in the video, no other Congress leaders, nor the party's symbol, could be seen in it.

Actually, Pilot and Gehlot have not been in the best of terms ever since the Congress government was formed in 2018. On many occasions, Pilot has expressed his displeasure with the Congress high-command for not resolving his pending issues.

Man kills wife for refusing sex in Hyderabad

Hyderabad: Enraged over his wife refusing sex, a man strangled her to death in Hyderabad.

The shocking incident came to light with the autopsy report revealing the cause of the death. Though the crime was committed on the night of May 20, the police could solve the case 10 days later.

Hailing from Nagarkurnool district of Telangana, the couple had a love marriage in 2021. Tarun told police that on the night of May 20 he expressed his desire. Jhansi told him that she was very tired. The man, however, started forcing her. When she started shouting, he pressed her mouth with his hand. As he kept her mouth and nose blocked with his hand for some time, this apparently cut the air supply. When she became motionless and started foaming at the mouth, Tarun panicked and alerted his relatives. She was rushed to Owaisi Hospital, where doctors declared her brought dead.

The hospital authorities informed the police, which shifted the body to government-run Osmania General Hospital for autopsy.

SC refuses urgent hearing on plea against HC order on exchange of Rs 2K notes

The Supreme Court on Thursday declined urgent hearing on a plea challenging the Delhi High Court's May 29 judgement allowing exchange of Rs 2,000 currency notes without any identification.

A bench comprising Justices Sudhanshu Dhulia and KV. Viswanathan told advocate Ashwini Upadhyay, appearing-in-person, the court is not taking up these kinds of cases during vacation and "you can always make a mention to the chief (Chief Justice of India)".

Upadhyay submitted that all the kidnappers, gangsters, drug smugglers, etc., are exchanging their



money and according to media reports in last one week Rs 50,000

crore have been exchanged and urged the court to grant urgent

hearing in the matter. The bench reiterated that he can mention the matter before the chief and "we are doing nothing...bring to the notice of the RBI..."

Upadhyay pressed that money was being exchanged by mining mafias, kidnappers, neither there is a requirement of requisition slip and also no identity proof is required.

"This is happening for the first time in the world ... I filed a writ in the Delhi High Court and the high court disposed of the matter without issuing notice...this is happening for the first time in the world ... entire black money will become white," said Upadhyay. The bench allowed Upadhyay to mention the matter after the vacation.

Hundreds of bras found scattered on Goa bridge

Panaji: Hundreds of branded bras were found scattered on the Carona-Calvim bridge of Aldona village of North Goa district.

Village resident Sameer Gadekar told reporter that he noticed the weird scene on Wednesday evening and collected the undergarments to throw into a dustbin.

"I was passing by this bridge, where I first noticed three undergarments of ladies and later saw them everywhere scattered on the bridge. I felt it was like disrespect to women as these branded bras were also placed on railings of bridge, which were visible to public," he said.

Gadekar said that he collected all the stuff from the bridge and threw it at the garbage point. "As a responsible citizen, it was my duty to clear the mess from the bridge, so I informed Sarpanch of our village and then cleared it," he said.

He expressed surprise over the incident and said that there should be CCTV cameras on bridge to check such things.



INDIA, NEPAL INK PACTS ON ENHANCING PHYSICAL CONNECTIVITY; POWER, TOURISM COOPERATION

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday said that several agreements have been signed between India and Nepal, focussing on enhancing physical connectivity, as well as cooperation in power and tourism sectors.

Addressing the media during a joint press conference with his visiting Nepalese counterpart Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda' after their bilateral meeting, Modi said: "We have established new rail links to increase physical connectivity. Long term power trade agreement has been established between India and Nepal today. This will give strength to the power sector of our countries."

He further added that the religious and cultural ties between India and Nepal are very old and strong.



"To further strengthen this, we have decided that projects related to Ramayana Circuit should be expedited," Modi added.

On his part, Prachanda said: "This is my fourth visit to India. The relationship between India and Nepal is age-old. Today we discussed

over steps to strengthen the ties between both nations. We also jointly launched many groundbreaking projects." Modi and Prachanda virtually participated in the groundbreaking and inauguration ceremony of various projects, giving boost to cross-border connectivity

and flow of people, goods and energy. Both leaders jointly unveiled the e-plaque of the Kurtha-Bijalpura section of the railway.

They also jointly flagged off the Indian Railway cargo train from Bathnaha to Nepal Custom yard. They participated in the

handing over of Kurtha-Bijalpura section of railway line and also witnessed the inaugural run of an Indian railway cargo train from Bathnaha (India) to the Nepal Customs Yard.

The two Prime Ministers inaugurated inland container ports (ICPs) at Nepalgunj (Nepal) and Rupaidiha (India). They also participated in the groundbreaking ceremony of ICPs at Bhairahawa (Nepal) and Sonauli (India) and also in the groundbreaking ceremony of phase-II facilities under Motihari-Amlekhgunj petroleum pipeline.

Modi and Prachanda also virtually participated in the groundbreaking ceremony of the Indian portion of Gorakhpur-Bhawal transmission line.

Prachanda arrived in India on Wednesday on a four-day official visit.

Dalit man attacked in Gujarat for wearing 'fashionable' attire

A Dalit man has been attacked in Gujarat's Banaskantha district by some persons of the upper caste for wearing fashionable clothes and sunglasses.

Jigar Shekhalia was attacked as the upper caste persons felt he was "flying too high these days". When his mother tried to intervene, the accused also assaulted her and also tore her clothes.

The assault took place on Tuesday night in Mota village, with the victims now receiving medical treatment at a hospital.

Shekhalia lodged a complaint against seven persons, leading to the filing of a First Information Report (FIR) at Gadh police station.

The accused, who carry the Rajput surname, reportedly expressed displeasure at Shekhalia's stylish dress and eyewear, triggering the inci-



dent.

According to the complaint, on Tuesday morning, one of the accused confronted Shekhalia outside his house, threatening him and saying him that he was "flying too high these days".

Later, six of the alleged perpetrators approached him outside a village temple, wielding sticks and demanding an explanation for his attire. Following a heated conversation, they attacked.

When Shekhalia's mother intervened, attempting to save her son, the assailants

turned their ire towards her, physically assaulting her and ripping her clothes, the police said.

The accused were booked under sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) relating to rioting, unlawful assembly, outraging the modesty of a woman, voluntarily causing hurt, and using abusive language.

They also face charges under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act. No arrests have been made so far.

Foxconn to start manufacturing iPhones at K'taka plant by next April: Minister

Karnataka Minister for Large and Medium Industries, M.B. Patil, said on Thursday that Apple Inc supplier Foxconn has plans to start manufacturing iPhone units at its proposed plant in Devanahalli by April 2024, and the state government will hand over the required land to the company by July 1 to facilitate the process.

Patil said this after the representatives of the company led by George Chu met him as part of a courtesy visit in which Information Technology

Party is supreme, will contest elections unitedly: Jairam on fresh Gehlot-Pilot tussle

Days after truce was hammered out between Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and senior party leader Sachin Pilot, the Congress on Thursday said that party is supreme and it will fight the Rajasthan Assembly polls unitedly to emerge victorious.

The remarks came a day after Pilot refused to budge from his demands for the Gehlot government to act against corruption.

Addressing media at the party headquarters here, Congress General Secretary communications in-charge Jairam Ramesh said, "On May 29, (Congress President Mallikarjuna) Kharge, (former party chief) Rahul Gandhi, Gehlot, Pilot, party General Secretary (Organisation) K.C. Venugopal and state in-charge Sukhjinder Singh

Randhawa were present and they had long meeting where they had a detailed discussion on all issues."

"All issues were discussed during that meeting and we had decided to contest the elections unitedly as the party is supreme," he added.

Pilot on Wednesday during his visit to the assembly seat of Tonk said that action would have to be taken on the issues that he had raised, particularly on corruption in the previous BJP rule.

After the long meeting at Kharge's residence on Monday, Venugopal told media: "In view of upcoming Rajasthan Assembly elections, Kharge and Rahul Gandhi had a detailed discussion with Gehlot and Pilot.

"In this election, we have decided to fight the election unitedly and both of them are in agreement that the Congress has to go together in

Rajasthan. Both have agreed to work together and definitely we will win in Rajasthan. Both the leaders Pilot and Gehlot unitedly and unanimously

agreed to the proposal."

Asked about the details of the proposal, Venugopal said: "Both left it to the high command."

SAD alleges jail inmate appointed market committee chief in Punjab

Chandigarh: The Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) on Thursday condemned Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann for criminalising politics by appointing a jail inmate, who was booked for abetting suicide, as Chairman of the Anandpur Sahib Market Committee. Expressing shock that four Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) functionaries had been appointed Chairmen of Improvement Trusts, which had been dissolved by the government, SAD leader Bikram Singh Majithia said "the AAP government has achieved the dubious distinction of touching new lows day after day." Asking the Chief Minister to explain his conduct, Majithia said "it is not conceivable that the government was not aware of Kamikkar Singh Dhaddi's case, especially considering his close proximity to the Chief Minister. The very fact that he has been appointed Chairman of a market committee despite being arrested after being accused of driving a person to commit suicide by jumping into the Bhakra canal speaks of his closeness to the Chief Minister." "It also sends across a clear message that this anti-people and corrupt government does not care for the law of the land and will do as it wishes regardless of the consequences of its actions on civil society," the SAD leader added.

10 SHOOTERS OF LAWRENCE BISHNOI-GOLDIE BRAR GANG HELD IN GURUGRAM

A total of 10 sharpshooters of the notorious Lawrence Bishnoi-Goldie Brar gang have been nabbed from two different places in Gurugram, the police said on Thursday.

A police officer said that Crime Branch units of the Gurugram Police apprehended the shooters on Wednesday, following inputs, from Bhondsi and another place near Devial Stadium.

A total of four foreign-made pistols, 28 live cartridges, two vehicles (1 Scorpio and 1 Honda City), seven police uniforms, among other things, have been recovered from their possession.

It was learned that the

Honda City vehicle was stolen from Delhi.

Assistant Commissioner of Police (ACP) Varun Dahiya told reporters that acting on a tip-off, seven persons -- Kumar a.k.a. Anil (24), Harjot Singh (23), Ajay Isharwalia a.k.a. Punjabi (20), Prince a.k.a. Golu (18), Joginder a.k.a. Joga (31), Sandeep a.k.a. Deep (23) and Sinderpal a.k.a. Bittu (33), were nabbed from Bhondsi area in Gurugram. After questioning the arrested individuals, their three other accomplices -- Dharmender a.k.a. Dharma (27), Deepak a.k.a. Dilawar (26) and Bharat (24), were also nabbed along with illegal weapons from a place near Devial Stadium in Gurugram.

"It was learnt that all of them are active shooters of notorious gangsters Lawrence Bishnoi and Goldie Brar gang, and had come to Gurugram to execute a major incident of robbery and kidnapping. As part of their plan, Joginder had to disguise as a police inspector while other members would wear police uniforms and carry out the crime in police uniform.

"They were planning to kidnap a person and extort crores of rupees as ransom. However, before they could do anything, they were nabbed. Seven of the accused were wearing police uniforms at the time of arrest," ACP Dahiya said. They were in constant contact with Goldie Brar and others.

GUJ WOMAN STRIPPED & BEATEN IN PUBLIC, 4 ARRESTED

Dahod (Gujarat): A tribal woman was publicly abused, stripped, and beaten by a group, including her estranged husband, in Gujarat's Dahod district, police said, adding that four accused have been arrested.

The incident took place on May 28, but a video of the shocking incident went viral on the social media on Wednesday, following which the arrests were made after widespread public outcry.

According to an official report, the woman's estranged husband, upset with her for living separately from him and their four children for the past 19 months, collaborated with two others to abduct her from Rampura village.

The victim was subsequently taken to Margala village, where the public assault took place, an official from Sukhsar police station said.

Officials revealed that the woman, belonging to a tribal community, had been living with another man in Chanasma in the Mehsana district, where they both earned a living as daily wage labourers.

The man's mother had invited them to a wedding in Rampura village and also extended an invitation to the woman's estranged husband.

Upon arrival, the estranged husband, accompanied by a group of men in a four-wheeler, abducted the woman and her companion, and transported them to Margala village.

The matter is still under investigation.

Everyone has the right to visit Bihar, BJP scared of opposition unity: Tejashwi

Bihar Deputy Chief Minister Tejashwi Yadav on Thursday made light of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's expected visit to address a string of rallies, saying that everyone has a right to come to Bihar and who is stopping him.

"Since we have come together in Bihar and formed the government, they (BJP) are in a deep scare. They are frightened about what will happen in the 2024 Lok Sabha election and this fear is not leaving their hearts. I don't know if their fear would go or not but one thing is sure that they would be thrown out from power through people's mandate," he said.

There is a buzz in Bihar that PM Modi will address four rallies in Bihar soon. The dates of the rallies are not finalised yet but the decision has been taken to counter the meeting of opposition leaders from 18 parties in Patna scheduled on June 12.

The BJP has also decided to protest on June 11 and 12 against the meeting of opposition parties.

Sources in BJP are saying that Home Minister Amit Shah came to Bihar several times and held rallies in Purnea, Nawada and some other



places but the things are not going in the favour of BJP. Hence, the BJP wants to launch its trump card - the PM - to turn the tables in its favour. So

far, the performance of the BJP's Bihar unit and rallies of Amit Shah are failing to sway voters similar to the situation before 2019 Lok Sabha polls.

9 IAF trainer aircraft crashes in K'taka, pilots eject safely

Lightweight Kiran trainer aircraft crashed into an open field at Bhogapura in Karnataka's Chamarajanagar district on Thursday.

The pilots managed to eject from the aircraft and landed safely using parachutes.

According to authorities, the trainer aircraft had taken off from the HAL airport of Bengaluru in the morning. The aircraft developed a technical snag and crashed. The aircraft was completely damaged and gutted in the fire. The parts of the aircraft were strewn all around the place.

No casualties were reported in the incident. One female pilot and one male pilot were in the aircraft and they safely ejected.



A court of inquiry has been ordered to ascertain the cause of the incident.

This is the second such incident in the state this week. A major tragedy was averted as a training aircraft developed technical snag and made an emergency landing at a farm in Marihal police station limits of Belagavi district on Tuesday (May 30).

The training aircraft VT-RBF belonged to Redbird Institute and took off from the Samba Airport in Belagavi and was on routine sortie. Two persons, including the pilot, were on board. There were no casualties.

BOYS INDULGE IN 'PDA' ON SCOOTY IN UP DISTRICT

Responding to the video clip, the Rampur police tweeted that they are looking into the matter.

Cong to move HC over 'scam' in 'Mahakal Lok' corridor

The Congress on Wednesday said it will approach Madhya Pradesh High Court to seek its intervention over alleged financial irregularities in 'Mahakal Lok' corridor of Ujjain. The opposition also raised question on Ujjain district collector Kumar Purusottam, saying the officer has acted like "puppet of Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan." Congress MLA Sajjan Singh Verma and Shobha Oza, who were among the seven opposition leaders who visited Mahakal Lok corridor on Tuesday, levelled serious allegations on the ruling BJP. The Congress leaders claimed China's local material was used for building the statues of 'Saptarshi'. He further claimed damaged statues were kept in a hidden place and were being redeveloped. When asked why the Congress is demanding judicial inquiry into the matter when Ujjain district collector Kumar Purusottam has said that 'statues collapsed due to gusty wind and there is no need of any investigation. However, Urban Development Minister Bhupendra Singh ruled out the Congress' allegations and accused the opposition of doing politics on religious issue. The Minister further said that over 100 Fibre Reinforced Plastic (FRP) statues were made at a cost of Rs 7.5 crore and artwork carried out on them "was only possible on such statues" and cited the examples of Kingdom of Dreams in Gurugram, Haryana, the Akshardham temple in Delhi and other other projects where FRP statues were used. Notably, six out of the seven idols of 'Saptarishis' installed at the Mahakal Lok corridor, developed on the Mahakaleshwar temple premises collapsed and suffered damages due to gusty winds. Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the first phase of the Mahakal Lok corridor project on October 11 last year.

STUDIOS CLAIM OWNERSHIP OF RIGHTS

It was since foreign companies entered the Indian film market that filmmakers in the country, especially in the Hindi film industry, took huge strides. Films with budgets in lakhs suddenly started costing crores. With projects being underwritten by big-time backers, the films with stars started costing over Rs 100 crore. This was just the beginning of the whole filmmaking industry going haywire! Creativity went for a toss and greed took over. The budgets went high but content suffered. Films depended solely on the kind of draw a star commanded! Actors wanted to be paid in crores and so did the director. Soon, the stars started asking for Rs 100 crore or more and the ones with just a single success wanted Rs 10-15 crore. Female artistes started demanding in crores, even thought their films, at best, collected Rs 5 crore or less in lifetime business. Somewhere along the line, the filmmaking happened with no sense of the economics. The prices the stars demanded were artificial, much against their draw or potential to recoup. This continued for a long time because the companies which backed these films opened their purse strings generously. The producer had nothing to lose and stood only to gain. Nobody cared for what a star charged or a director did. Ridiculous budgets were presented and sanctioned by the new corporate entrants who were under the impression that they were producing films when, in fact, they were actually outsourcing the film production activities. They had neither the knowledge of filmmaking the way it happened in India, nor any control. Besides the budgets of the films, the manipulations extended to the media and on social media. Amitabh Bachchan, at his peak, commanded the price of Rs 15 lakh, it is said. That price was meant to be the equivalent to one major circuit (Mumbai circuit was one), there being about six. Yet, the maker stood to earn an amount worth one circuit. It was all worked out to everybody's satisfaction and interest. Bachchan's films drew massive footfalls and his price was recovered within a day if you added up all-India box-office collections. In those days, only net collections were made public after deducting the entertainment tax as well as the cinema rentals. That was unlike the practice now, which is aimed at deceiving the people with gross figures, or the recovery from ticket sales, being put out, which is unfair. If Bachchan recovered his price within a day, the films of stars today don't recover their own price, let alone the cost of the film in the lifetime business. A star is someone who assures an initial draw to his every new release. But when the star's prices became



unviable, filmmakers resorted to giving out inflated collection figures. There was no way a film costing Rs 100 crore could recover the investment; the film was now limited to multiplexes with an average ticket price (ATP) of Rs 270. The masses, who accounted for a film's success and flocked to the single screens, were driven out. Even at today's prices with inflation and all things considered, one can buy a few things of necessity for that kind of money! Just about everybody was making money, except for those who backed these films. As the things worked in the film industry in India, the negative belonged to the producer of the film, albeit considering there was no lien on the film. That all the financiers' claims had been settled as often there were multiple people from whom the producer borrowed in the process of making his film. The various financiers' claims were guaranteed by the film processing laboratory with whom vested the film's entire negative footage shot for the film. Unless, there was another kind of arrange-

ment in place. It was called World Rights Controller, which involved a single financier. He would let the film release even if his monies were not recovered, but the rights to the negatives vested with him till the time the money was recouped. In those days, the normal practice was to release a film in various circuits through local distributors with an understanding that they paid a price described as MG, and after recovery, shared, what was called the overflow equally with the producer. In the World Rights arrangement, that overflow went to the world rights controller. Now, of course, the recoveries are not only from the overflow of a film, but there exist various other avenues, such as OTT, satellite and other rights. These rights are given out for a stipulated period and recur again. Some of the studios backing Hindi films withdrew from the trade and some were left to wonder what came to them in this whole exercise? It was their money so, rightfully, the rights

in the content should belong to them. After all, the producer on record was being paid what is called the Runner Fees to produce a film for the studio, like the director was paid his, so was the star as well as the other crew. As things work now, projects are sanctioned and financed by the principal, say a television channel or an OTT streaming platform, and they own the content. Even during the good old days of Doordarshan, if your serial was sanctioned and televised, the rights and the content finally belonged to DD. The studios that financed film production recently took up this issue with the filmmakers whose films they had bankrolled. The studios staked their claim to the films they had financed because it was their product by all logic. After all, even the producer was paid for his work. In other words, some of our top-rung filmmakers, who were hogging the glory and the limelight when a film was a success, were no more than mere production controllers or, at best, executive producers, and they were making the film on behalf of a studio. So, some of the big-time filmmakers, for that is the kind these studios preferred to deal with, were asked to cede the film rights, rock stock and barrel, to the principal studio, it must have come as a bolt from the blue! The fact that the studios were correct in their demand must have played on their mind. It resulted in the few top names who stood to lose it all, to get into talks. The settlement reached, according to reports, is that the one who produced the film will share the gains from the film on a 50:50 basis. The arrangement will last for ten years from the date of the film's release. Thereafter, all rights in the film in subject will revert back to the studio in toto. Can you imagine that the films that will feed many of your generations to come, won't be yours eventually! Many filmmakers of the yesteryear, such as Raj Kapoor, Shakti Samanta, G.P. Sippy, N.N. Sippy, N.C. Sippy, Pramod Chakravorty, Manmohan Desai, Prakash Mehra, Devendra Goel and many others who made a number of films (though some of them may have sold their film negatives for various reasons), have left them behind and their value in the era of satellite, OTT and other rights are worth crores. Unlike them, the present-day producers may have made a lot of money while they made their films, but nothing will remain with them for the future. Among all these, the one production house that has emerged with no claims on its films is Yash Raj Studios. It has never been reported to seek finance from the corporate studio houses.

MIKE PENCE TO ANNOUNCE 2024 BID NEXT WEEK: REPORT

Former US Vice President Mike Pence will announce his bid for the 2024 US presidential election next week -- the latest to join an increasingly crowded field for the Republican Party's White House nomination, a media report said. Citing informed sources, the BBC report said that the 63-year-old will launch his campaign on June 7 in Iowa. Launching his campaign will put Pence face-to-face with former President Donald Trump. Relations between the two soured after Trump turned on Pence for lacking "courage" after the latter refused to help overturn the 2020 election results, the BBC report said. They have largely kept their distance since January 6, 2021, when pro-Trump rioters stormed the US Capitol and were heard chanting "Hang Mike Pence!". Calm and soft-spoken,



Pence began his career in conservative politics as a talk radio host. He was elected to the House in 2000 and served until 2013. When Pence was the Governor of Indiana from 2013-17, he passed the largest tax cut in the state's history and signed bills to restrict abortion and protect religious freedom. Besides Pence, former

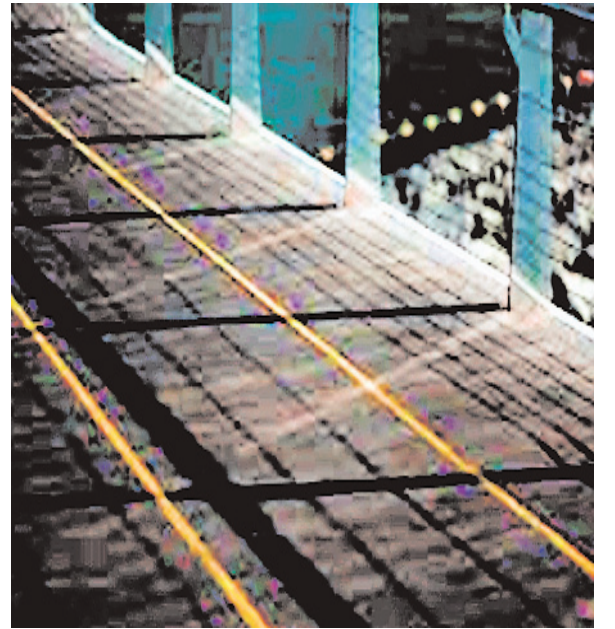
New Jersey Governor Chris Christie is planning to announce his candidacy on June 6 at a town hall event in New Hampshire, where the first Republican primary election will be held, the BBC report said citing multiple sources. After his 2016 presidential bid failed, Christie allied himself with Trump, leading the

incoming president's transition team and preparing him for debates against incumbent President Joe Biden in 2020. But Christie has become a critic of Trump since the Capitol riot, calling the latter "a TV star, nothing more, nothing less". After months of speculation, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis launched his 2024 bid during a live Twitter Spaces event, which was plagued by a technical glitch, delaying his announcement by at least 20 minutes. The other names that have already announced their bids for the Republican Party nomination are former US Ambassador to the UN Nikki Haley, Indian-American entrepreneur Vivek Ramaswamy, South Carolina Senator Tim Scott, former two-term Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson, Virginia Governor Glenn Youngkin, businessman Perry Johnson and conservative radio host Larry Elder.

17 kids, 1 adult injured in Canada walkway collapse

SHOPLIFTING CASES SPIKE IN UK; STEAK, CHEESE, COFFEE MAIN TARGETS

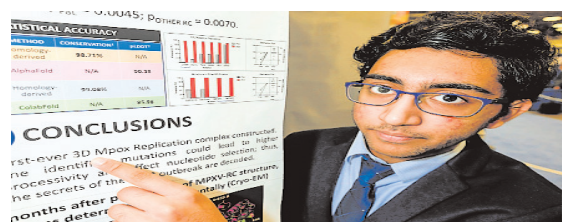


London: Amidst an increase in the number of shoplifting cases in the UK, supermarkets are fitting steak and cheese with security tags and replacing coffee with dummy jars as these are the most targeted items, the media reported. In March, police forces in England, Wales and Northern Ireland recorded nearly 33,000 incidents of shoplifting, according to data analysed by the BBC. This was a significant 30.9 per cent increase compared with March last year. According to the data, shoplifting offences have now returned to pre-pandemic levels as the cost of living is on the rise.

Indian-American teen wins \$50,000 Young Scientist award

A 17-year-old Indian-origin student in Missouri has won the prestigious Regeneron Young Scientist Awards of \$50,000 for his research relating to the mpox virus. Saathvik Kannan of David H. Hickman High School in Columbia was awarded for using biocomputational methods to understand the causes of heightened infectivity in the disease mpox after it re-emerged in 2022. Saathvik's approach, named Bioplex, uses a combination of machine learning and three-dimensional comparative protein modeling to decode structures like those that enable the mpox virus to replicate. This allowed him to identify the mutations in the virus



that likely made it more infectious as well as other mutations that could make it resistant to antibiotics. He credited his mentor, Kamalendra Singh, an assistant professor of veterinary pathobiology at the University of Missouri. "I was overjoyed and incredibly excited!" Saathvik wrote in an email to the Columbia Daily Tribune about the prize. "I felt that it reflected our work with Dr. Singh's mentorship and guidance over the last few years cul-

minating in my project for this year." Saathvik believes scientists will also be able to apply Bioplex to future outbreaks of other viruses. More than 1,600 young scientists and engineers representing 49 states and 64 countries across the world competed at the 2023 Regeneron International Science and Engineering Fair. Saathvik also took first place in the fair's computational biology and bioinformatics division, receiving another \$5,000.

N.KOREA WILL CORRECTLY PLACE SPY SATELLITE INTO ORBIT SOON: KIM JONG-UN'S SISTER

The influential sister of North Korean leader Kim Jong-un has vowed that Pyongyang will "correctly" place a military reconnaissance satellite into orbit soon, state media reported on Thursday, a day after Pyongyang's attempt to launch a spy satellite failed. Kim Yo Jong made the remarks as she slammed the US for its denouncement of North Korea's botched launch on Wednesday of what it claimed to be a "space launch vehicle," according to a statement carried by North Korea's official Korean Central News Agency (KCNA). "If North Korea's satellite launch should be particularly censured, the US and all other countries, which have already launched thousands of satellites, should be denounced," she said. "It is certain that the North Korea's military reconnaissance satellite will be correctly put in space orbit in the near future and start its mission." "We confirmed once again that the enemies are most afraid of North Korea's access to excellent reconnaissance and information means including reconnaissance satellite and,



accordingly, we are aware that we should direct greater efforts to developing reconnaissance mean," she added. Kim, who serves as the vice department director of the Central Committee of the ruling Workers' Party, also called the UN Security Council's resolutions that ban Pyongyang's use of ballistic tech-

nology as "gangster-like" and "wrong" for violating North Korea's right to use space, Yonhap news agency reported. Meanwhile, she reiterated that North Korea is not interested in talks with the US, citing Washington's "hostile policy" toward Pyongyang. "We have no content of dialogue and do not feel the necessity of dialogue with the US and its stooges... we will continue our-style way of counteraction in a more offensive attitude so that they should not but realise that they will have nothing to benefit from the extension of the hostile policy toward North Korea," she said. On Wednesday, North Korea fired the rocket southward, but it fell into the Yellow Sea after an "abnormal" flight, according to Seoul's military. North Korea confirmed the failure, saying its new "Chollima-1" rocket, carrying a military reconnaissance satellite, "Malligyong-1," fell into the sea due to the "abnormal starting of the second-stage engine," adding that it plans to conduct a second launch as soon as possible, the KCNA said. The latest launch drew immediate condemnation from South Korea, the US and Japan.



BHOPAL CELEBRATES ITS 'GAURAV DIWAS' ON DAY OF MERGER INTO INDIAN UNION

'Gaurav Diwas' was being celebrated in Madhya Pradesh's capital Bhopal on Thursday, to mark its merger into the Indian Union in 1949, with different departments of the state administrations having made elaborate arrangements, sports activities having begun a day before and an extravagant cultural programme to be held. The concept of 'Gaurav Diwas' initiated by Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan in February last year when he had appealed the representatives of each village, town, district of the state to celebrate the occasion on a particular day - for instance Indore's 'pride day' was celebrated to mark the foundation day of state's commercial city last week. Similarly, Bhopal district administration is celebrating capital city's 'Gaurav Diwas' on its merger day with India after Independence.

Bhopal, which remained a princely states even after Independence like many others across the country, was merged with the Union of India on June 1, 1949, hence it the 74th anniversary of the merger.

Chouhan had greeted people of the city on the occasion. "This auspicious time came on June 1, 1949, two years after independence of the country, when Bhopal became an integral part of India. Number of people had made sacrifices for this day. I bow at the feet of determined, brave sons."

There are many stories on how Bhopal's last Nawab, Mohammad Hamidullah Khan, who had acquired a high profile by virtue of being the Chancellor of the Chamber of Princes, harbored aspirations of an independent Bhopal and made his best possible effort to achieve it but was foiled.

One such untold story on merger of Bhopal, written by senior journalist Sandeep Bamzai, who is Editor in-Chief and CEO of



IANS, in his book "Princedom", which explain how the unity of a newborn nation was insured by Jawaharlal Nehru, Sardar Patel and Lord Mountbatten.

As per the book, some courses that some of the Princes, particularly the Nawab of Bhopal, had hoped to present to the politicians in British India were "already in disarray by the time the Congress and the Muslim League had agreed to accept the plan for Indian independence, and the situation deteriorated rapidly thereafter".

"The Nawab of Bhopal was harbouring delusions of grandeur - like several others - was completely spooked. He reckoned that the Congress would swoop down on him (which they did eventually). He resigned as Chancellor of the Chamber and announced that he would consider himself free and

independent the moment the British departed from India, to choose the destiny of his state for himself."

The Nawab, as per the book, had due to his "high profile by virtue of being the Chancellor of the Chamber of Princes", shared an excellent rapport with Mohammad Ali Jinnah and an excellent equation with Lord Mountbatten as well.

"But the Nawab, like Travancore, Hyderabad and Kashmir, harbored aspirations of an independent Bhopal and thought the British crown would bail him out in crunch situations. In fact, with Mountbatten arriving in India, Hamidullah Khan's hopes were high before the new Viceroy crushed the ambition without so much as a by-your-leave." The Nawab thought of a brighter future in Pakistan such as planned to abdi-

cate in favor of Abida Sultan, the heir apparent, and leave for Karachi. The Nawab was even promised the post of Governor General of Pakistan. He was prevented from doing so by a grievous family dispute that he could not resolve, although he tried his best.

In March 1949, V. P. Menon (the then Secretary of the government of India) arrived in Bhopal to finalise the merger agreement. According to this, Hamidullah Khan was to receive a privy purse of Rs 11 lakh annually and the Princely State of Bhopal was relegated to the annals of history. Subsequently, the state of Bhopal was taken over by the Union Government on June 1, 1949. Later, according to the States Reorganisation Act 1956, Bhopal was integrated into the state of Madhya Pradesh and Bhopal was declared as the capital of the state.

"WE TAKE RESPONSIBILITY": ENVIRONMENT MINISTER ON CHEETAH DEATHS

With three cheetahs and as many cubs dying at the Kuno National Park in Madhya Pradesh in three months, Union Environment Minister Bhupender Yadav Thursday said, "We take responsibility for whatever happened", but asserted that the translocation project will be a major success.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi released the first batch of eight spotted felines from Namibia into a quarantine enclosure at Kuno in Madhya Pradesh on September 17 last year. In a second such translocation, 12 cheetahs were flown in from South Africa and released into Kuno on February 18.

Three cheetahs died in March and April. Of the 17 remaining adult cheetahs, seven have already been released into the wild. The death of three adult cheetahs and three of the four cubs born to a female Namibian



cheetah, Sisaya, has prompted questions from several experts on the suitability of the habitat and wildlife management.

"It's an international project and we had anticipated mortality. It's mentioned in our report too (cheetah

introduction action plan). One of the cheetahs was unwell before it even came to India. We have provided the reasons for the deaths of the two other (adult) cheetahs.

"The three cubs died due to extreme heat. The temperature

soared to 47 degrees Celsius... We take responsibility for whatever happened. However, the project will be a major success and the whole country will be proud of it," he said in reply to a question at Times Network's conclave.

Shortly after news emerged about the death of two cheetah cubs last week, the Centre set up an 11-member high-level steering committee to review and monitor the progress of the cheetah reintroduction programme.

The government and experts involved in the project have maintained that the mortalities are within the normal range. The action plan for cheetah reintroduction anticipated up to 50 per cent mortality in the first year of relocation.

The steering committee met for the first time on Wednesday and decided to release seven more cheetahs, including two females, into the wild by the third week of June.

Karni Sena leader found dead in his car in Indore

A 27-year-old local functionary of Karni Sena was found dead in his car with bullet wounds in Indore, the police said on Thursday.

The deceased has been identified as Mohit Patel, who was the district president of Karni Sena. The car was parked on the road side.

The police said that Patel's licensed revolver was also found in the car with two bullets less in the magazine.

"We are probing whether it was a suicide or a murder, Additional Commissioner of Police, Jayant Rathore, told mediapersons.

Patel was found in his car in the



Kanadiya police station area late on Wednesday night.

"At first glance, it appeared that two bullets were pumped into his chest from point-blank range," Rathore said.

Since Patel was working as a property dealer, the police are looking into the

rivalry angle.

According to Rathore, Patel left his home alone at around 8:30 p.m. on Wednesday.

Patel had reportedly told his friends that he was going to some place and they should meet him there. But when his friends reached there, they found Patel lying dead in his car with bullet wounds on his chest.

"Patel had rung up some of his friends and called them to a place. According to his friends, when they reached there, they found Patel's blood-soaked body in the car," Rathore said.

The officer said that Patel's friends took him to a hospital where the doctors declared him dead.

Some media persons were also present. Congress state spokesperson Siddharth Singh

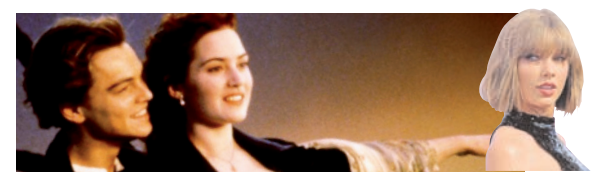
Rajawat told that suddenly this urn fell down. This is also a sample of corruption. An appli-

they were like, yeah, sure, fine."

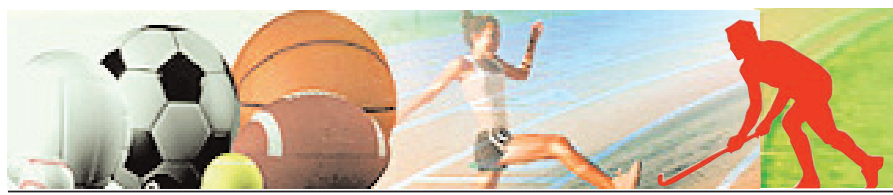

Sevilla overpower Roma in penalties to lift seventh Europa League title

Top Spanish club Sevilla made a remarkable comeback to clinch the Europa League title, with goalkeeper Bono thwarting two attempts to ensure a 4-1 victory in the penalty shootout at the Puskas Arena in Budapest on Thursday.

The opening period proved challenging for both sides, marked by numerous fouls that disrupted the rhythm of the match.

The first genuine scoring opportunity came 12 minutes into the match when Roma's Leonardo Spinazzola tested Sevilla's goalkeeper with a shot from the edge of the penalty area, reports Xinhua.

Despite being Europa League record winners, Sevilla struggled to penetrate Roma's staunch defense.

Roma eventually broke the deadlock when Gianluca Mancini's through ball, following a counterat-



tack, allowed Paulo Dybala to strike past Bono into the far post corner, 35 minutes into the game.

Sevilla rebounded well and nearly levelled the score before the break, but Fernando's header from Ivan Rakitic's corner kick sailed just over the target.

Rakitic, the veteran midfielder, remained a central figure, rattling the woodwork with a 20-meter hammer in the closing stages of the first half.

The momentum shifted after the restart, as Sevilla's Alex Telles squandered another promising attempt from a favourable position.

Sevilla's persistence paid off when Mancini inadvertently deflected a dangerous cross from Jesus Navas Gonzalez into his own goal, equalizing the score 10 minutes into the second half.

Roma nearly reclaimed the lead in the 67th minute, but Bono deftly defused Tammy Abraham's close-range shot.

A potential penalty for Sevilla was revoked by referee Anthony Taylor after a review 10 minutes later.

The final minutes saw both teams trading attacks, as Bono denied Andrea Belotti from close range following a free kick. Conversely, Suso and Fernando couldn't bypass Rui Patricio in quick succession at the other end of the pitch.

After a goalless extra time, the match was decided by penalty kicks. Sevilla converted all attempts, while Mancini and Roger Ibanez were denied by Bono.

Axar Patel confident of India shifting into top gear for WTC final

With IPL fever only just settling down, India now have little time to switch gears for a format change with the ICC World Test Championship Final starting on June 7.

Several members of the India squad have already reached England and kicked off their preparations for the big finale at the Arundel Cricket Club.

While they managed to catch a glimpse of the thrilling IPL 2023 final, all-rounder Axar Patel, who



was among the training group, confirmed that their preparations were

going well for the WTC showdown against Australia.

The switch between formats in a short timeframe comes with its challenges, but Axar revealed that the preparations had begun during the IPL season itself where they practiced with the red ball.

"We knew about this before the start of IPL," Axar told the ICC.

"So even during the IPL, it was discussed that we will bowl with the red ball. We had red balls, so we were using them. You know when and how to play, how much time you have. This mental switch from

white ball to red ball is obviously tough, but we have enough time."

"Those who did not qualify (for IPL Playoffs) got more time. So I don't think there will be many problems because we have had a good time to prepare."

While India play their red-ball games at home with the SG ball, the WTC Final will have the Dukes ball which is used in English conditions. Axar stated that they were practicing with the Dukes ball during the IPL, but maintained that the focus was on hitting the right spot irrespective of the ball used.

Stokes' ability to fully fulfil that all-rounder function is absolutely critical: Michael Atherton

Former captain Michael Atherton said it would be a big blow for England if skipper Ben Stokes' knee problem limits his ability to bowl during the upcoming Ashes, saying the allrounder's role he fulfils in the side is absolutely critical. Stokes suffered a flare-up of a left knee injury during the drawn Test series in New Zealand in February. Since then, he has only bowled just one over in one of his two matches for Chennai Super Kings (CSK), in IPL 2023, where his appearances were limited due to various niggles.

Ahead of the one-off Test against Ireland at 'ord's, Stokes had said the left knee was in a much better position than it was in New Zealand and has given himself the best opportunity to play a role with the ball in England's home summer.

"Stokes' knee is a concern because of the balance of the side. He has asked for good, true pitches against Australia but if England only have four bowlers that puts a lot of work on those bowlers, one or two of whom (in James Anderson and Stuart Broad) are cracking on in years."

"Stokes' ability to fully fulfil that all-rounder function is absolutely critical. I wouldn't expect him to bowl too much in this Ireland game but hopefully, his knee will be okay come the Ashes."
