



Cyclone Biparjoy to cross Saurashtra and Kutch coasts on June 15 noon

he India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued an orange alert for Gujarat's Saurashtra and Kutch coasts as Cyclone Biparjoy has intensified into an extremely severe cyclonic storm and is expected to impact the state and Pakistan in the coming days."The extremely severe

cyclonic storm 'Biparjoy (pronounced as 'Biporjoy') over east central and adjoining northeast Arabian Sea moved north-northwestwards with a speed of 07 kmph. It is very likely to move nearly northwards till June 14 morning, then move north northeast wards and cross Saurashtra and Kutch and adjoining Pakistan coasts between Mandvi (Gujarat) and Karachi (Pakistan) near

Jakhau Port (Gujarat) by noon of June 15 as a very severe cyclonic storm with maximum sustained wind speed of 125-135 kmph gusting to 150 kmph," IMD

The IMD further predicted that that there will be light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Kutch, Devbhumi Dwarka, Porbandar, Jamnagar,

Rajkot, Junagarh and Morbi districts of Saurashtra and Kutch on Wednesday.

armers in Haryana on Monday once again blocked the National Highway-44 near Pipli in the state's Kurukshetra district, severely hampering the movement of traffic between Chandigarh and Delhi.

The traffic was halted after the "mahapanchayat" called by the Bharatiya Kisan Union-Charuni failed to get any response from the government over procurement of sunflower seeds at the minimum support price (MSP) of Rs 6,400 per quintal.

Also they were demanding the release of their leaders, especially Bharatiya Kisan Union-Charuni chief Gurnam Singh Charuni.

Responding to issue of farmers, Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar told the media that the government has a round of talks on the sunflower issue.Nearly 50,000 farmers from Punjab, Delhi and Uttar Pradesh, besides Haryana and its neighbouring states, gathered in Pipli town and earlier gave an ultimatum to the govern ment that "if it doesn't listen to their demands, a big call could be taken to block the national highway again or block the government Secretariat in Kurukshetra".

The sunflower growers are not happy with the relief announced on June 10 by Chief Minister Khattar, saying it was an attempt to prevent the 'mahapanchayat' called by farmers' associations.

The farmers have been demanding that the state government procure their sunflower crop at an MSP of Rs 6,400 per quintal, as announced for the crop by the Central government

However, traffic on the Chandigarh-Delhi highway was diverted to avoid congestion after farmers gathered in Pipli over their demand.

Days after protesting sunflower growers were baton-charged and National Highway-44 near Kurukshetra, crowds of farmers on Monday started gathering again in support of the demand.

Tikait had already threatened a larger agitation than the year-long protest against the now repealed farm laws if the government did not announce a legal guarantee of the MSP for procurement of crops.

As a preventive measure, the government has imposed Section 144 in Pipli, a ruling that prohibits public gatherings in a given jurisdiction.

Farm leaders have also warned the authorities to release their nine leaders, including Charuni, who were sent to custody for 14 days for blocking the

national highway on June 7, otherwise a massive rally would be held on June 12. Besides charges pertaining to rioting, they are facing cases for unlawful assembly, use of criminal force to deter public servants from discharg-

ing duty and attempt to murder. Amidst the rift between the state overnment and farmers. Chief Minister Khattar has said the government was studying the market for adequately compensating sunflower growers.

While digitally releasing Rs 29.13 crore as an interim 'bharpai' (compensation) to 8.528 sunflower farmers growing the crop on 36,414 acres of land on Saturday, he said that some people are trying to create confusion among the farmers claiming that his government does not care for the

The government has included sunflower in the Bhavantar Bharpai Yojana under which farmers will be paid Rs 1,000 per quintal if produce is selling below the MSP.

Fire breaks out in govt office, health data destroyed

IAF choppers sought to douse fire raging at Bhopal's Satpura Bhawan, Congress apprehends 'cover-up'

he six-storey Satpura Bhawan, where at least half a dozen departments of the Madhya Pradesh government are located, was engulfed in a massive fire on Monday, resulting in damage to official records, computers, furniture and other prop-

The fire, which broke out on the third floor of the building, where the Tribal Welfare Department is located, gradually, spread to cover the entire building and was still raging late in the night. However, no casualty was reported, according to an official statement released late night.

The fire was so massive that efforts by the firefighters for several hours could not control it, and fire services of the Airport Authority of India were also summoned. Later, the state government sought the help of the IAF to douse the fire.

State Home Minister Narottam



Mishra, who was present at the spot at 11.20 p.m., told media persons that Air Force helicopters will reach soon to help douse

The Satpura Bhawan is located in front of the Madhya Pradesh

Secretariat Vallabh Bhawan. All official records, especially pertaining to the Tribal Welfare Department, were reportedly reduced into ashes in the fire.

The exact reason of the fire

was yet to ascertained so far,

however, preliminary information indicates that a blast in an air conditioner may have caused it, Additional Chief Secretary, Administration, Vinod Kumar said. Mishra also said that a high level committee has been formed

to investigate the fire incident in Satpura Bhawan. The five-member committee, chaired by Additional Chief Secretary, Home, Rajesh Rajora will conduct a detailed inquiry in the matter and submit the report to Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan.

Meanwhile, the Congress has raised apprehension on fire incident, alleging that the incident could be a planed conspiracy to destroy files and other docu-

State media in-charge K.K. Mishra said: "Today, (Čongress General Secretary) Priyanka Gandhi started the election campaign in MP. A fire broke out at Satpura Bhawan. Claims of data breach mischievous, CoWIN portal completely safe: Health Ministry

he Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) on Monday dubbed the alleged data breach of Covid-19 vaccine beneficiaries as "mischievous in nature", saying that the CoWIN portal is completely safe with adequate safeguards for

data privacy. The Health Ministry also said that it has requested the Indian Computer Emergency Response Team (CERT-In) to look into this issue and submit a report, besides initiating an internal exercise to review the existing security meas-

ures of CoWIN. The Health Ministry's remarks came after some media reports and social media posts claimed breach of data of vaccine beneficiaries.

These reports also alleged breach of data from the CoWIN portal of the Health Ministry, which is the repository of all the data of beneficiaries who have been vaccinated against Covid-19.

The Health Ministry said in a statement, "Certain posts on the social media platform Twitter have claimed using a 'Telegram (online messenger application) BOT', the

It also said that security measures are in place on the CoWIN portal, with Web Application Firewall, Anti-DDoS, SSL/TLS, regular vulnerability assessment, **Identity and Access Management**

It also said that CoWIN was developed and owned and managed by the MoHFW.

CONG SLAMS RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR FOR 'DATA BREACH' OF 1.4BN PEOPLE

he Congress on Monday criticised the government over the alleged data breach of the Covid vaccine beneficiaries, dubbing it as a very grave matter with serious implications for privacy, making everyone vulnerable to financial fraud.

The Congress also slammed Union Minister of State for Electronics and IT Rajeev Chandrasekhar, saying instead of issuing casual "WhatsApp forward-style tweets, he should clarify at the very least".

In a tweet, Congress General Secretary Jairam Ramesh said: "The personal data breach is a very grave matter with serious implications for privacy, security and makes us all vulnerable to financial frauds. The techsavvy Minister instead of issuing casual WhatsApp forward-style tweets should hold a Press Conference at the earliest and clarify at the very least."

Firing questions at the government, the Rajya Sabha MP said: "What does he mean by 'previously stolen data stolen in the past' - stolen from which database, when, and what action was taken? If the CoWIN database hasn't been 'directly breached', is the Minister then accepting that it is an indirect breach? What other databases are linked to the CoWIN database that has led to this vulnerability?"



Ramesh also asked what immediate steps the Narendra Modi government is taking to secure the personal data of crores of Indians who trusted the government to keep their details

Even earlier, Congress general secretary (organisation) KC Venugopal on Monday hit back at Chandrasekhar, saying that he was appalled at the minister's casual response regarding the breach of privacy of 1.4 billion Indians.

Venugopal engaged with Chandrasekhar after Trinamool Congress spokesperson Saket Gokhale alleged that the data of several citizens, including politicians and journalists, who took Covid vaccine, has been leaked and asked why the Centre was not aware of the incident. In a response to Chandrasekhar's

AMID RUMOURS OF RIFT, JJP TO CONTEST ON ALL 10 LOK SABHA SEATS IN HARYANA

s the rift in Haryana's ruling alliance of the BJP and the JJP seemed to be widening, the latter on Monday asserted that it would contest all 10 parliamentary constituencies in the state on its own.

However, the JJP remained silent that whether it would continue with the alliance in the remaining term of one and a half years of the state government or not.

At the crucial party's meeting here, Jannayak Janta Party (JJP) chief Ajay Singh Chautala and Deputy Chief Minister Dushyant Chautala told its legislatures and senior leaders to start preparing for next year's Lok Sabha and Assembly polls.

An official statement quoting Ajay Chautala said the JJP has started working on its "Mission 2024" and as part of it senior leaders are attending programmes across the state.

The JJP is part of the BJP-led ruling coalition in Haryana. In the coming days, party veteran leaders, ministers and legislators will speed up public

meetings up to grassroots to strengthen the party, said the statement. After discussing in detail with all MLAs,

Ajay Chautala has outlined the programs of the party under which it was decided to intensify public relations campaign in the next three months. Later, Development and Panchayat

Minister Devender Singh Babli told the media here that the JJP has done more than 50 successful public outreach programs in the past two months. During this period, the programmes have been done in about 20 cities and equal number of rural circles.

Notably, both the JJP and the BJP have been non-committal on whether they would contest the 2024 Lok Sabha and Assembly polls together.

Amid talks of a possible rift, Chief Minister



Manohar Lal Khattar asserted on June 19 said the alliance was reached for public welfare, and it will continue in the future as well.

"No change has been made," he categorically told the media here, setting aside rumours of fissures between his party and alliance partner JJP.

he Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Monday questioned two officials of Bahanaga railway station in Odisha's Balasore district in connection to the triple-train tragedy, which left 288 persons dead and over 1,000 injured.

According to reports, the CBI officials have picked up Bahanaga Bazar Station Master and signalling officer and interrogated them in an undisclosed location in Balasore. The central agency officials are trying to find out the persons responsible for the massive tragedy. They may get some information from the two officials of the station, sources said.

A CBI team has been investigating the case since last Tuesday. The CBI officials



have examined the accident site, tracks, the signaling room, control room, etc.

It has also sealed the equipment and

for investigation. So, no train stops at the station now.On the other hand, the Commissioner of Railway Safety (CRS) visited the accident site on Monday where he went to the control room, signal room and signal point at Bahanaga Bazar railway station. Meanwhile, AIIMS Bhubaneswar officials have decided to preserve the unidentified 81 dead bodies till the identification process is not completed.

At least 207 of the 288 bodies have been identified and returned to their families, but remaining 81 unclaimed and unidentified bodies have been kept in containers adopting scientific procedure.

The claimants are waiting for DNA test reports. After DNA matching, the bodies will be handed over to the genuine family members, officials said.

Tourist killed, 4 staffers injured in Pahalgam hotel fire

Srinagar: A tourist was killed and four staffers injured in a hotel fire in J&K's Pahalgam hill station on Monday, officials said.

Officials said that the tourist was identified as Bhupinder Gill, 75, from Dehra Dun.

"Three injured staffers have been discharged from the hospital while the 4th one is undergoing treatment. All the injured staffers are locals. The cause of fire is being ascertained," an official said.

"Inquest proceedings have been started in the death of tourist," the official said.

Kejriwal accuses BJP, Congress of Wife ties husband to tree for taking solfic sots him afire in Dibarvillage neglecting education for 37 years

elhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Monday accused the BJP and the Congress party of neglecting education for 37 years while inaugurating the new building of a Girls' Senior Secondary School in Uttam Nagar.

He said that this school was opened in 1985 but was operating in temporary tin sheds.

Kejriwal said that despite the BJP and Congress governments being in power for 37 years, no one took steps to improve the school.

He emphasized that his government had rebuilt the school, which was previously functioning in substandard conditions. The infrastructure of the new school is now better



than that of any private school.

As per Kejriwal, when his government approved the construction of a new building in January 2021, the school was operating in 48 tin sheds.

However, within a record time of 28 months, the new building was completed which consists of 41 classrooms, where 1,600 girls study.

Additionally, the school has 12 labs, 2 libraries, offices and staff rooms, activity rooms, including those for children with special needs. Each floor also has a toilet block, and a lift is installed in the main school building.

Moreover, the school boasts a multi-purpose auditorium with a seating capacity of 250 people.

selfie, sets him afire in Bihar village

woman in Bihar's Muzaffarpur district tied her husband to a tree, poured kerosene oil and set him on fire, an official said on Monday.

RETAIL INFLATION FALLS TO 25-MONTH LOW IN MAY AS FOOD PRICES SLIDE

ndia's retail inflation, which is measured by consumer price index (CPI), fell to a 25month-low in May, to 4.25 per cent, as food prices came down. In April, it was 4.70 per cent. Food inflation too slid to 2.91 per cent in May from 3.84 per cent in April.

According to data released by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, retail inflation was at a high of 7.04 per cent in May 2022, while food inflation was 7.97 per cent during the period.

This is the third consecutive month when CPI-based inflation has remained below the Reserve Bank of India's tolerance level, which is between 2 per cent to 6 per cent.

Prices of cereals, oil and fats, fruits, beverages as well as clothings and footwear came down in May compared to April.



NIA RELEASES CCTV FOOTAGE OF ATTACK ON INDIAN HIGH COMMISSION IN LONDON, SEEKS PUBLIC HELP TO IDENTIFY CULPRITS

The FIR was registered under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code, the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, and the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, and an investigation has been initiat-

The British Deputy High Commissioner was also summoned by the Indian government, demanding an explanation for the complete absence of security during the protest.



hief Minister Eknath Shinde has urged the administration of Union Territory of Jammu ■ Kashmir to provide a plot of land to construct a 'Maharashtra Bhavan' to boost ties between the people, an official said here. Shinde, on a tour of Kashmir last weekend, called on the Lt. Governor Manoj Sinha to convey his request vide a letter on Sunday. A prominent NGO, Sarhad, Founder Sanjay Nahar said that his organisation had made a similar proposal at least 10 years ago, but it was kept in cold storage as it could kick up similar demands from other states in the country. "We are ready for the project even today... Our only condition is that the Maharashtra Bhavan in Srinagar shall be run and managed by Kashmiri Muslim youth... They want to repay a debt to this state which has always hosted them and helped them in dire times," Nahar told reporter. In his letter, the visiting CM told the Lt. Governor that in view of the growing tourism and cultural

exchanges, plus enhancing economic and social ties, such an institution will be beneficial to people on both sides. He said the Maharashtra Bhavan in Srinagar will not only provide accommodation facilities to tourists from this state, but provide a glimpse of the state, its rich arts, culture and cuisine for the people of Jammu & Kashmir. The institution could also be used as a major hub for students, entrepreneurs, senior officials to strengthen ties between the state and the UT. Shinde assured that if a suitable piece of land is provided, the state government will construct a Maharashtra Bhavan keeping in mind the culture and environment of J&K. The ruling ally Bharatiya Janata Party leaders have welcomed the CM's proposal for setting up a Maharashtra Bhavan in J&K and said it would further cement ties with the UT.

Further investigation is underway, he added.

Thane court grants transit remand to Ghaziabad 'conversion' accused

day after his arrest, Shahnawaz Khan, alias Baddo -- prime accused in the alleged conversion case through gaming app' -was granted a transit remand and ordered to be produced before the Ghaziabad court in Uttar Pradesh within three days, officials said here on Monday. Shortly after the court orders, the Mumbra Police (Thane), which had tracked and nabbed Khan, 23, from a resort in Alibaug (Raigad), handed him over to the Ghaziabad Police four-man team camping here for the past six days. Following complaints of this and other alleged 'conversions through App scam', the Kavinagar Police Station of Ghaziabad lodged an FIR on



May 30 against Khan, a youth said to be a resident of Devripada in Thane and engaged in a cosmetics business. The complaint contended that Khan had sold computer gadgets to a minor Jain boy in Ghaziabad, then befriended him through regular chats, later made the juvenile

recite Quranic verses and allegedly brainwashed him with videos of the fugitive evangelist, Zakir Naik of Mumbai. The minor boy soon started visiting a local mosque in Ghaziabad to offer 'namaz' five times daily, shocking his family members and others, sparking a huge furore. Following the complaint, the Ghaziabad Police swung into action, nabbed Abdul Rehman, a cleric linked to the alleged 'conversion' racket and were on the lookout for Khan who was said to be hiding

in Mumbai and then moved to Raigad. A techie studying in a junior college, Khan evaded the police teams but using tech-intel, the investigators finally zeroed in on him to a resort in Alibaug where he was holed up with his brother and arrested him on Sunday (June 11).

Mumbai Airport's 2nd runway gets a new 'carpet' for safety, efficiency

he Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport here has completed the six-month long 're-carpeting' project of its secondary runway 14/32, enhancing the operational efficiency and maintaining higher safety standards for air travel, an official said here on Monday. The CSMIA operates one of the busiest single-crossover runways in the world -- secondary runway 14/32 and the main runway 09/27 -- handling an average of 950 flights daily and it is imperative for the runways to be kept in optimal conditions for continuous and safe landing/take-off of aircraft.



Accordingly, the re-carpeting project was taken up on December 9, 2022, and completed as per scheduled on June 10, just as the monsoon sets in, giving a meticulously structured approach to ensure smooth and efficient operations for the secondary runway. Around 200 personnel comprising engineers and workers toiled daily for the

project and the runway was closed for up to 12 hours daily, following a comprehensive schedule to complete the recarpeting within the deadline, said the official. The work involved a runway length of 2,210 metres excluding the intersection portion, and a breadth of 75 metres, and the upgradation of all the stressed portions by laying some 72,500 tonnes of asphalt. The Adani Group-owned CSMIA adopted the widely-acclaimed 'Mill & Fill' technique for Runway 14/32 comprising carefully orchestrated steps that include precise removal of existing Airfield Ground Lighting fittings by core cutting, core filling with quick-set concrete, etc.

Shiv Sena (UBT) to Maha CM, DyCM: Apologise for 'caning' Varkaris

he Shiv Sena (UBT) on Monday demanded that Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and Deputy CM Devendra Fadnavis tender an apology to the people of Maharashtra for the unprovoked police caning on the pilgrims taking part in the annual pilgrimage of Saint Dnyanesh Maharaj from Alandi to Pandharpur. Sena (UBT) MP and Chief Spokesperson Sanjay Raut said that both Shinde-Fadnavis must apologise to the people and the Varkaris (as the pilgrims are known) for the caning incident at Alandi. "The CM performs the annual pooja at the Pandharpur Temple... This kind of treatment is an insult to the people and the Varkaris who were going on their annual pilgrimage from Alandia Unless the CM apologises, he has no right to perform the special pooja," said Raut sternly. However, Fadnavis and the police have flatly denied that there was any 'lathi-charge' and claimed it was a



minor scuffle with some Varkaris who were allegedly attempting to barge inside the temple on Sunday afternoon, sparking a huge political row. Congress state President Nana Patole, Chief Spokesperson Atul Londhe, NCP Working President Supriya Sule, state NCP President Jayant Patil, Leader of Opposition Ajit Pawar, Chief Spokesperson Mahesh Tapase, Sene (UBT)'s Raut, Sushma Andhare and other leaders have slammed the state government for the caning of the Varkaris. Social media posts and TV clips show police personnel and some Varkaris in a tussle, with the cops resorting to a mild caning to deter the restless crowd, as over 8,00,000 devotees had gathered there for the annual

event. Some eyewitness reports said around 300-plus members of the Warkari Prashikshan Sanstha attempted to enter the sanctum sanctorum of the temple but were prevented by the police, leading to heated exchanges. The pilgrimage involves a palanquin o Sant Dnyaneshwar Maharaj being taken in a long religious procession from Alandi (Pune) to Pandharpur (Solapur). Pimpri-Chinchwad Police Commissioner Vinay Choubey and DCP Vivek Patil and other government officials contended that there was "no caning" of any devotes and the police had merely requested the Varkaris to avoid entering the temple without permission as the space in the sanctum sanctorum is very small. As a precaution to avoid a near-stampede situation experienced last year, this year the authorities have restricted up to 75 member-devotees only per 'dindi' (palanquin procession), and passes have also been issued accordingly by the organisers.

Two 167-year-old British-era cannons, that once protected Mumbai, 'deployed' again (Anchor)

wo mid 19th-century British East India Company-era cannons, installed to protect Mumbai, have now been refurbished and now adorn two parks, officials said on Monday. The sturdy steel cannons, both over long with the inscription 1856, denoting the year they were cast, were part of many installed by the British rulers to protect the then Bombay, from any seaward aggression via the Arabian Sea. These two were unearthed in the Lions Children's Park of Ghatkopar, an eastern suburb a few years ago, among others that had been found in different parts of the country's commercial capital. Following instructions of BMC Commissioner I.S. Chahal and Additional Municipal Commissioner Ashwini Bhide, the two guns were given a meticulous make-over by the BMC's Heritage Conservation Cell. The fully restored magnificent cannons have been installed on befitting pedestals at the Dr K.B. Hedgewar Garden in



Ghatkopar west and the Lions Children's Park in Ghatkopar east, said Parks Superintendent Jitendra Pardeshi. Chief Engineer Vijay Nighot said that after the guns were found several years ago, a special proposal was sent to Heritage Conservation Cell to afford the cannons a makeover for the modern generation. Both cannons are of the British times, with each being 3.10 metres long, and having a 0.64 metre diameter while circumference of their wheels is 1.17 metres. They bear the

words 'NCPC' engraved on them with the year of manufacture, said Nighot. After conducting proper research into their antecedents, the majestic guns were given a facelift and mounted on platforms resembling bastions of forts, to give the people a glimpse of their glorious history. Now, the two historical artefacts have proved to be extremely popular among young and old alike visiting the two parks daily with many posing for selfies or clicking pictures and videos, said Pardeshi.

Mumbai murder victim's sister breaks down on seeing pics of her long hair

ne of the sisters of 32-year-old Saraswati Vaidya, who was allegedly killed and chopped into pieces by her 56-year-old live-in partner Manoj Sane, got emotional after seeing a photograph of Vaidya's long hair that the accused had cut and kept on the kitchen platform in their flat. According to Mira-Bhayandar, Vasai-Virar Police, she broke down while recording her statement. During their investigation into Ms Vaidya's death, police found out that she has four sisters and three of them recorded their statements. Vaidya's sisters confronted accused Manoj Sane for the first time after the murder and police said they were all furious and urged the police to make such a strong case that he gets the strictest punishment. One of the sisters, after seeing a photograph of Vaidya's long hair, broke down and recalled she used to love her long hair, police said. During the course of the investigation as police scanned Sane's mobile, they found that the accused used to watch porn on a regular basis and had jotted down some porn sites names on a paper which was also recovered by the




police. Police said that they will soon interrogate Manoj Sane by him making him sit in front of Vaidya's sisters and a cross-examination of his answers will be done. Police officials said that the accused was being questioned for several hours daily, but he kept changing his statements. Police said that after allegedly murdering Vaidya, he had taken pictures of the body and also did many Google searches to find out how to dispose of the body. The accused has made Google searches to gather information about what should be done to avoid the foul smell coming from a dead body and bought five bottles of Nilgiri oil from a shop in his area. On June

accused had bought an electric wood cutter (tree cutter) from a local hardware shop, which he used to chop down the body parts. The chain of this saw had come off during use, and after that, he took it to for repair to the same shop from where he had bought it. As Sane had cleaned the cutter completely, no one got any clue of what work he was

using the machine. Police said it will send the DNA samples of Vaidya and her close relatives to the Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) today. As the accused has accepted that he married Ms Vaidya in a temple in Borivali, police are trying to verify the location of the temple and the priest who got them married. Along with this, the police will be looking for any other witnesses of their marriage. It has come to light that the couple had hidden their marriage from their acquaintances due to their age difference. Manoj Sane had been staying with Vaidya in the rental flat in the Akashganga building in Mira Road area over the past three years.

'DEFAMATORY' REMARKS FOR PM: MUMBAI COURT EXTENDS INTERIM RELIEF FOR RAHUL GANDHI

¬he Bombay High Court on Monday extended till August 2 the interim relief granted to Congress leader Rahul Gandhi from appearance before a court here in a defamation complaint on his alleged remarks against Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2018. The complainant, who claims to be a BJP worker, had alleged that Gandhi's "commander-in-thief" remark in the context of the Rafale fighter jet deal amounted to defamation. A single bench of Justice SV Kotwal adjourned the hearing on the plea filed by Rahul Gandhi challenging the summons issued to him by the local court in 2021 after the complainant's lawyer sought time. "The interim relief granted earlier to continue till August 2," Justice Kotwal said. Earlier, Rahul Gandhi was directed by the local court to appear before it in November 2021 in a defamation complaint filed by Mahesh Shrishrimal. Gandhi then approached the High Court, challenging the summons issued to him. The high court in November 2021 directed the magistrate to



defer hearing on the defamation complaint, which meant the Congress leader would not be required to appear before the magistrate. Since then, hearing on Gandhi's plea has been adjourned from time to time and the interim relief granted to him was also extended. The magistrate initiated criminal proceedings against Gandhi in August 2019. However, the Congress leader in his petition before the high court claimed that he learned about the same only in July 2021. The complainant alleged that Gandhi made defamatory

statements against PM Modi at a rally held in Rajasthan in September 2018. As per the complaint, four days later (after the rally), Rahul Gandhi purportedly commented on a video and posted on his personal Twitter account: "The sad truth about India's commander in thief." The complainant alleged that Gandhi was making "defamatory statements against Modi and by calling him 'Commander in Thief' made a direct allegation of theft against all members of BJP and Indian citizens connected to PM Modi".

Cong takes indirect jibe at PM over BJP leaders praising Godse

he Congress on Saturday slammed
BJP leaders for praising Mahatma Gandhi's assassin Nathuram Godse and indirectly referred to Prime Minister Narendra Modi, saying "he turned Bapu's spectacles into a logo for Swachh Bharat, but takes no action to pull up his colleagues". Congress General Secretary Jairam Ramesh tweeted, "First it is a former CM of Uttarakhand, Trivendra Singh Rawat, who calls Nathuram Godse a patriot. Now Union Minister Giriraj Singh praises him. But the man who turned the Mahatma's spectacles into a logo for Swachh Bharat -- a rebrand of the earlier Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan -- says nothing and takes no action to pull up his colleagues." His remarks came after Giriraj Singh said on Friday, "If Godse is Gandhi's killer, he is also the nation's son. He was born in India, and he was not an invader like Aurangzeb or Babar. Whosoever feels happy to be called the son of Babar, that person can't be the son of Bharat Mata." Singh made the remarks while talking to reporters at Dantewada in Chhattisgarh. Earlier, former Uttarakhand Chief Minister and BJP leader Trivendra Singh Rawat had triggered a controversy after he dubbed Godse as a patriot during his visit to Ballia in Uttar Pradesh. Speaking to reporters on Wednesday, Rawat had said, "Gandhi ji was killed. That is a different issue. But as far as I have understood and read Godse, he too was a patriot. We do not agree with the killing of Gandhi ji." Rawat had also termed Godse a patriot while mocking Congress leader Rahul Gandhi for "merely" sharing the surname with the father of the nation.

NEW HIGHS WAIT SEEMS GETTING LONGER

arkets in the week gone by made a valiant attempt to make new lifetime highs but failed. The top five-six heavyweight stocks in the benchmark indices need to fire on all cylinders at the same time for something like that to happen. That is the missing piece. However, the midcap and Smallcap indices are firing away and continue to make new

Markets saw the benchmark indices rise on two of the five trading sessions. They lost on two, and the fifth was a flattish day. At the end of it, BSESENSEX inched up 78.52 points or 0.13 per cent to close at 62,625.63 points while NIFTY gained 29.30 points or 0.16 per cent to close at 18,563.40 points. The broader markets saw BSE100, BSE200 and BSE500 gain 0.17 per cent, 0.29 per cent and 0.40 per cent respectively BSEMIDCAP gained 0.82 per cent while BSESMALLCAP was up 1.64 per cent.

The Indian Rupee lost 16 paisa or 0.19 per cent to close at Rs 82.46 to the US Dollar. The US FED meets between June 13 and 14 for its policy review meeting where there could be a small interest rate hike before a pause begins. This would be because the last job data showed that unemployment rose in the country. How the Dow reacts to the FED statement would influence world markets. Dow Jones gained on the last four sessions continuously and lost on one session. Dow Jones gained 114.02 points or 0.34 per cent to close at 33,876.78

RBI in its bimonthly policy meet kept interest rates unchanged. Repo rate remains at 6.5 per cent. RBI has conveyed its intention to tackle inflation and make best efforts to bring the same down. The differential between the Repo rate in India and the US Fed rate would probably be the lowest ever in over 25-35 years that I have understood such interest rates and what they mean. The rupee needs to show strength and start appreciating slowly so that the forward cover comes down as we go forward. This would be a big help.

The IPO from Ikio Lighting which was open between Tuesday (June 8) and Thursday (June 8) fared very well and beat all expectations. The issue which comprised a fresh issue of Rs 350 crore and an offer for sale of 90 lakh shares was oversubscribed 67.75 times overall. The QIB portion was subscribed 163.06 times, HNI portion was subscribed 65.38 times and Retail portion was subscribed 14.30 times. There were 16.33 lakh applications received. The price band was Rs 270-

The benchmark indices had made their lifetime highs on December 1, 2022 and we are trying to make new highs once again but failed to do so. At the same time action which is concentrated in the midcap and Smallcap space has moved these indices to new levels altogether. BSEMIDCAP on December 1made a high of 26,146 points and then saw a high of 26,440 points on December 15. It hit a low of 23,356 points on March 28 and since then has been moving in an uptrend virtually non-stop. The high made last week was 27847 points. The difference between December 1, 2022 and today is 1,700 points

BSESMALLCAP has had a similar movement as well with the December 1 level being 29,816 points, and then saw a high



of 30,092 points on December 15. The 28th March low was 26,120 and the high during the week was 31,391 points. The difference being 1,576 points or 5.28 per cent. This is a segment where FPIs are active in a handful of stocks only and even domestic mutual funds are selective. Public participation is large and markets are doing well.

Coming to the markets in the week ahead, the outcome of the FED meeting would play an important role. There is expectation of a rate hike this time around. Markets would continue to strive to make new highs and as mentioned earlier the attempt can only be successful if the heavyweights fire. Two of them are getting ready. The first being Reliance with the impending corporate announcement of the demerger of the financial services record date. The second would be the

timeline of the HDFC Twins merger record date. Both these companies have the potential to provide the boost that the markets are looking for.

The strategy for the week would be to look for action in the midcap and Smallcap space. Sharp movement looks unlikely and besides the FED meeting, corporate announcement as mentioned above, the only trigger could be the break of monsoon in large parts of the country. Trade cautiously.

Himachal Pradesh and Karnataka and managed uproot the BJP from both states and formed the government with absolute majority.

In her speech, Priyanka hit out at Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan-led BJP government highlighting issues like atrocities against women and tribals, unemployment, scams broke out in the past 18 years in Madhya Pradesh. Referring to collapse of Saptarishi idols in Ujjain's Mahakal Lok corridor, Priyanka said, "Shivraj government did not spare even the God."

Indore Civic Body workers beat 3 for littering on road, Police case filed

hree men were severely beaten up allegedly by some municipal workers in Indore, the cleanest city in the country, over a dispute after they were told to pay a fine of Rs 10,000 for throwing garbage on the road, police said on Monday.

The video of the incident, which occurred late Sunday night in the central Kotwali area, has gone viral.

Three people injured in the incident alleged that the municipal staff demanded Rs 10,000 in fine from them claiming they littered the road and brutally assaulted

them when they protested," Assistant Commissioner of Police V P Sharma told media on Monday.

A case has been registered against four municipal workers and their associates under sections 323 (Punishment for voluntarily causing hurt.), 341 (Punishment for wrongful restrain), 294 (obscene act) and 506 (criminal intimidation) of the Indian Penal Code and medical examination of the injured men was conducted, Sharma said.

Based on a cross-complaint lodged by municipal staff, a case has also been registered against the injured

trio for assault and other charges, the ACP said, adding the investigation is under-



Djokovic returns to No.1 after 23rd Grand Slam title

ovak Djokovic has returned to No.1 position in the ATP Rankings after triumphing at Roland Garros and has begun a recordextending 388th week at the ranking summit after he clinched a record 23rd major

Djokovic reclaimed the No. 1 spot by defeating Carlos Alcaraz in the Roland Garros semifinals, taking the 420-point lead over the 20-year-old Spaniard, who is placed second with 7,175 points.

If Alcaraz had managed to defeat Djokovic and reach his second major final, he would have been able to retain the No.1 ATP Ranking following the

It will be Djokovic's third stint as World No. 1 this year and the second time in 2023 he has climbed to No. 1 by winning a major. He has won both the Australian Open and Roland Garros and returned to the top of the men's tennis mountain each time.

In February, Djokovic broke Stefanie Graf's record for most weeks at World No.1 by a men's or women's tennis player (then 377 weeks). Only one other man, Roger Federer (310 weeks), has spent more than 300 weeks as World



No.1.

The Serbian is the first man to win all four major events at least three times.

He is also the oldest Roland Garros champion at the age of 36 years and 20

Uruguay beat Italy to lift U-20 World Cup trophy

orward Luciano Rodriguez scored late as Uruguay secured their first Under-20 World Cup title with a 1-0 victory over Italy here.

Rodriguez struck with an 86thminute header as the Celeste ended a run of four consecutive triumphs for European teams in the tournament, reports Xinhua.

"This is a crazy feeling. We are champions of the world. What can I say?" said 19-year-old Rodriguez, who plays his club football for Uruguay's Liverpool Montevideo.

No other top-class Indian cricketer has been treated as bafflingly as Ashwin: Gavaskar

egendary batter Sunil Gavaskar believes no other top cricketer in India has been sub-ected to the baffling treatment which has been meted out to ace off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin, who was excluded from India's playing eleven in their 209-run defeat to Australia in the World Test Championship (WTC) Final at The Oval

The dilemma of Ashwin being in the playing eleven or not had been a huge topic of discussion in the run-up to the WTC final, leading to contrasting opinions. His exclusion from the playing eleven, as India lacked control of the ball, invited severe criticism from former cricketers of both nations.

"No other top-class Indian cricketer in the modern era has been treated as bafflingly as Ashwin has been. Tell me if there was a No. 1 ICC-ranked batter in the team, would he have been left out of the playing XI just because in earlier times he had not got runs on a grassy pitch or if he had not scored runs on a dry spin-friendly pitch? Definitely not."

"This is not being wise after the event, but a pattern that has been seen over the years. But for this 'hard to understand thinking' he would have already played more than 100 Test matches."

"Even if India were to win, it should not blind us to the treatment given to Ashwin and whatever the explanation that is given, the bowling results in the match where India have been asked to chase 444 tells us that dropping him was not the right call to make," wrote Gavaskar in his column for Mid-Day on Monday.

With 474 wickets in 92 matches at a strike-rate of 51.8, including 32 five-wicket per innings hauls, Ashwin, the top-ranked Test bowler, was left out of the marquee clash as India preferred four fast-bowlers, despite the presence of five left-handed batters in Australia's batting order. Ashwin had also been left out of India's matches in England in 2021 and 2022, with conditions being cited as the reason.

eing cited as the reason. "India dropped Ravichandran Ashwin, the



No.1 ranked bowler in the game, according to the ICC rankings. The Australians had five left-handers in the team and while one leftie - Travis Head - scored a quickfire century in the first innings, another southpaw Alex Carey got a 48 in the first innings and an unbeaten 66 in the second." "During that second innings effort, he also put on 93 runs with another left-hander Mitchell Starc at a time when India were looking to dismiss Australia cheaply in the second innings. If Ashwin had been in the team, who knows what could have happened? With the bat too, he could have contributed," added Gavaskar.

He also went on to express his disappoint-

He also went on to express his disappointment over India's shot selection in the match, especially in the second innings.

"For me, though the shot selection of the skipper Rohit Sharma and Cheteshwar Pujara was the disappointing aspect of the Indian innings. Why Pujara attempted a ramp shot is hard to understand for that is not a shot he employs regularly." "To even try it two deliveries after Rohit was out was also questioning the thinking at the time. Pujara is known for his patience and willingness to take blows, but keep occupying the crease so why on earth did he look to play that shot when runs were not the need but preserving wickets was essential."

"Pressure can get a player to do strange things and that's why Test cricket is the highest form of the game and the World Test Championship final, the ultimate Test match," he concluded.

The court acknowledged that the athletes involved have intellectual challenges and that a large contingent of athletes will be participat-

ing and also be requiring assistance. Therefore, the court permitted support staff to accompany the team.

Representing the Centre, senior advocate R.
Balasubramanian said that due to various court orders restricting the release of funds to sports federations, the government was facing difficulties in allocating funds for the athletes' participation in the Games.

The Special Olympics World Games 2023 is scheduled to take place from June 17 to June 25 in Berlin, Germany.






