Wuxi, (China) Agencies ndia's top fencer Bhavani Devi on Monday scripted history as she secured a bronze medal in the women's sabre event at the Asian Fencing Championships.

This remarkable achievement marked India's first medal at the continental meet.

Bhavani defeated the reigning world champion and world No.1 Misaki Emura of Japan 15-10 in the quarterfinals of the women's sabre event. It was also the Indian's first win over the Japanese in four meetings.

The 29-year-old settled for bronze after suffering a close 15-14 loss to Uzbekistan's world No.79 Zaynab Dayibekova in the semifinals.

Earlier, the Indian fencer received a firstround bye. She got the better of world No.95 Dospay Karina of Kazakhstan 15-13 in the next round and stunned world No.40 and third seed Seri Ozaki of Japan 15-11 in the pre-quarterfi-

The 29-year-old became the first Indian fencer to represent India at the Olympic Games when she competed at the Tokyo 2020 Olympics.

WORLD BRACES FOR EXTREME WEATHER **Asian Fencing Championships EVENTS AS EL NINO IS OFFICIALLY HERE**

▶ Global temperatures have accelerated to record-setting levels this month, an ominous sign in the climate crisis ahead of a gathering El Nino that could potentially propel 2023 to become the hottest year ever

Extreme hot weather caused by the El Nino phenomenon is predicted to drag up to 8,70,000 hectare of agricultural lands in Indonesia into drought and crop failures.

In India, El Nino Southern Oscillation (ENSO) led to a delay in monsoon, while cyclone Biparjoy also played a crucial role in the delay, according to experts.

s the world, including India, stares at extreme weather and climate events like agonizing heat waves, deadly cyclone and drought risks owing to monsoon deficit, the ocean-warming phenomenon El Nino is officially here and could last until 2024, scientists have warned.

According to the US National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), El Nino could lead to new records for temperatures, particularly in areas that already experience

above-average temperatures during El Nino. El Nino events usually occur every two to seven years and are characterized by warmerthan-average sea surface temperatures around the equator in the central and eastern Pacific Ocean, reports Space.com.

The last El Nino event occurred between February and August 2019 but its impacts were relatively weak.

"Depending on its strength, El Nino can cause a range of impacts, such as increasing the risk of heavy rainfall and droughts in certain locations around the world," Michelle L'Heureux, a physical scientist at NOAA's Climate Prediction Center, said in a statement recently."El Nino could lead to new records for temperatures, particularly in areas that already experience above-average temperatures during El Nino," he added.

Last month, Kelvin waves, a potential precursor of El Nino conditions in the ocean, rolled across the equatorial Pacific toward the coast of South America.

According to NASA, the data showed Kelvin waves -- which are roughly 2 to 4 inches (5 to 10 cm) high at the ocean surface and hundreds of miles wide -- moving from west to east along the equator toward the west coast of South America. The advent of El Nino this year could push global temperatures into uncharted territory and contribute to global warming crossing the 1.5 degree Celsius threshold within the next five years, which



would lead to catastrophic and irreversible

climate breakdown, according to reports. "In April 2023, an El Nino 'watch' was issued, signaling the beginning of the warm phase of the ENSO phenomenon. Since then, all the Nino indices have remained positiveneutral or above the designated threshold. The Nino indices in the western half of the equatorial Pacific Ocean are still on the borderline, while the eastern portion consistently displays sufficient warming," said a Skymet

WHEN WILL SELF-STYLED 'VISHWAGURU' LISTEN TO 'MANIPUR KI BAAT': CONG

New Delhi: The Congress on Monday once silence on violence in Manipur, asking him when will the self-styled 'Vishwaguru' listen to 'Manipur

In a tweet, Congress General Secretary (organisation) K.C. Venugopal said, "Manipur is burning since 49 days. On Day 50, will PM Narendra Modi fly away to foreign lands, without uttering a single word on the ongoing crisis? Hundreds dead, thousands rendered homeless, countless churches and places of worship destroyed, and a state administration that is part of the problem, not the solution. To make matters even worse, the violence is

now spreading to Mizoram as well." He said, since the last many days, Manipuri leaders have been seeking time from the Prime Minister to ensure his intervention. "Every passing day of neglect confirms the belief that PM Modi and the BJP are interested in prolonging the conflict, not finding a solution. When will the selfstyled Vishwaguru listen to Manipur Ki Baat? When will he speak to the country, to make a simple call for peace? When will he demand accountability from the Union Home Minister (Amit Shah) and the Manipur CM (N Biren Singh) for their total failure in bringing peace?" Venugopal asked.

His remarks came a day after the RSS appealed for peace in violence-hit Manipur, which has been witnessing clashes since May 3.

British Columbia province. He was the president of Guru Nanak Sikh Gurdwara.

Nijjar, a resident of a village in Jalandhar, was associated with the separatist organisation, Sikhs for Justice (SFJ), which is banned in India. He had played a key role in organising the Khalistan referendum in Brampton city.The National Investigation Agency (NIA) last year filed a charge sheet against four persons, including Nijjar, in connection with a conspiracy to kill Hindu priest Kamaldeep Sharma in

Jalandhar on January 31, 2021. The three others charge-sheeted in the case are Kamaljeet Sharma and Ram Singh, who attacked the priest on the directions of Nijjar and his associate Arshdeep Singh alias Prabh.

Sarva Brahmin Mahasabha on 'Adipurush': 'Changing dialogues won't stop us'

he national President of Sarva Brahmin Mahasabha, Suresh Mishra, has demanded a ban on the film 'Adipurush' starring Prabhas, Kriti Sanon and Saif Ali Khan with immediate effect.

Claiming that a conspiracy has been hatched to insult 'Hanuman ji' and other deities through 'Adipurush', Mishra slammed the poor usage of computer graphics for the main characters of the film. Mishra also said that all the dia-

logues in the film are baseless. On the recent statement of writer Manoj Muntashir about changing dialogues of the film, Mishra said, "Changing the dialogues will not

stop our protest. The film should be banned with immediate effect. Misrepresentation of Ramayana is



beyond tolerance."

The film is sending a very contradictory message to the society. Movies impact people's mind. That's why special care should be taken so that films don't tamper

with religion and culture. The looks of the mythological characters and their dialogues in the film are subpar. The film wrongly depicts the characters of Lord Rama. Hanuman, Sita and Ravan. The film is an insult to Ramayana. It is like playing with the faith of crores of Hindus," Mishra said.

"Gods and goddesses have been shown in a fictional manner in the film, which is absolutely wrong. We will not tolerate this. The Sarva Brahmin Mahasabha

had sent a notice to the film's director, Om Raut, through advocate Kamlesh Sharma a year ago. At that time, Raut had said that

nothing wrong will be shown in the film. But we now see that all the characters of Ramayana have been made fun of in the film," he added.

Mishra demanded Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot to ban the film with immediate effect, and appealed to the general public to boycott the film. An appeal to this effect has also been filed in the court, Mishra said.

Foodies have a chance to win money with 'Bahubali samosa'

f you are a foodie, here is your chance to win some money too. A Meerutbased sweet shop is making 'Bahubali samosas' each weighing around 12 kg.

The eatery has also thrown a challenge, inviting customers to try and eat the entire samosa in 30 minutes, and take home a cash prize of Rs 71,000.

Ujjawal Kaushal, 30, the third-generation owner of Kaushal Sweets in Lalkurti, said: "As many as four cooks prepare one 12 kg samosa in six hours. The samosa is stuffed with 7 kg of traditional filling such as potatoes, peas, spices, paneer, and dry fruits and it takes around 90 minutes to get it fried."

He added that he is now



getting orders from several people who prefer to cut a 12 kg samosa on their birthdays, instead of a cake.

Kaushal, whose family has been in the sweets business for over 60 years, came up with the idea to make a giant samosa that weighs 4 kg in July last year.

"Seeing the response we

got, we started making samosas in 8 kg and 12 kg as well. One 12 kg samosa costs Rs 1,500 and we take orders in advance only," he said. Families, he claims, are

ordering the Bahubali Samosa for special occasions and some even use the leftover filling to make parathas the following day.

KEJRIWAL DIRECTS DJB TO RESOLVE WATER CONTAMINATION ISSUES

elhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Monday directed the Delhi Jal Board (DJB) to develop a comprehensive plan to eradicate water contamination issues across the city.

Kejriwal chaired a high-level review meeting with DJB officials to assess the progress made and discuss future strategies for the timely implementation of a permanent solution.

Water Minister Saurabh Bhardwaj, Delhi Jal Board Vice Chairman Somnath Bharti, and senior DJB officials were present at the review meet-

During the meeting, Kejriwal emphasized the need to identify the root causes of water contamination and develop an effective strategy to address the issue. Kejriwal instructed the immediate installation of Reverse Osmosis (RO) plants in 20 identified JJ colonies. These plants will provide clean water to the residents while raising awareness about the importance of utilizing this resource for their daily needs. Furthermore, he stressed the significance of ensuring water quality before initiating any tubewell project. Thorough examination of water quali-



ty should be conducted before obtaining the necessary No Objection Certificates (NOCs) for tubewell

installation, Kejriwal emphasized. "If there is a problem of contaminated water anywhere, it should be

completely eliminated. The identification of areas receiving contaminated water must be ensured, followed by the preparation of a detailed plan for a permanent solution and immediate implementation," said Kejriwal.

He gave strict instructions to DJB officials to promptly replace any pipes causing contaminated water issues, ensuring that no contaminated water is supplied anywhere.

Kejriwal also stated that clean water obtained from all sewage treatment plants should be made usable. 'This water should be used to fill artificial lakes, and picnic spots should be developed around these lakes to provide people with a pleasant experience. Later, when the groundwater level around these lakes rises, the water can be extracted using tubewells," Kejriwal said.

He has also given instructions to fix all non-functioning flow meters and make them operational again.

In the meeting, the DJB presented a report on the identified land for tubewell installation. According to the report, DJB has identified 1,075 locations where approximately 1,428 tubewells will be installed. Currently, there are already 4,200 tubewells in



The three majestic chariots are almost ready and will be brought to the Singha Dwar and parked facing East towards Gundicha temple. The chariots will be pulled by lakhs of

devotees on Tuesday. A large number of devotees visited the temple on Monday on the occasion of Nabajouban darshan after the deities recovered from 14-day long illness.

The Parimanika darshan of the



Lords was started early at 7:20 a.m. due to early completion of rituals and this was followed by the Sahana Mela darshan from 8:05 a.m. in which the devotees witnessed the Nabajoubana Besha (attire) of the Lords from the Bhitara Katha inside the Jagmohan, said Odisha Chief Secretary P.K. Jena, who was in Puri on Monday.

Praying for a chill weather tomorrow, Jena said all arrangements have

SENIOR CONGRESS LEADER GOVABHAI RABARI TO JOIN RULING BJP IN GUJARAT

enior Congress leader and former legislator Govabhai Rabari from Deesa in North Gujarat's Banaskantha district is set to join the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) following his resignation from the Congress.

Sources indicate that the deteriorating state of Congress in Gujarat, characterised by a lack of leadership and internal conflicts among party members, is a major catalyst for this political shift.

The Congress's weakening hold in Gujarat is evident, as it no longer holds the status of the opposition in the State Vidhan Sabha. To address the situation, Congress leader Shaktisinh Gohil has been appointed as the Gujarat Congress unit chief, but only time will tell how effective his leadership will be in revitalising the party's prospects.

Due to this situation, two influential BJP leaders, Tharad MLA and president Shankar Chaudhary, and Siddhpur MLA Balvantsinh Rajput, played instrumental roles in facilitating Govabhai Rabari's transition, successfully bringing both the father and



son into the BIP fold.

Couple slain, bodies thrown into crocodile-infested Chambal rive

n what could be a case of "honour killing", a girl and her boyfriend were allegedly killed by her family and the bodies of the couple thrown into the Chambal river in Morena district of Madhya Pradesh, police

The victims were allegedly killed by the girl's family around a fortnight ago. Her family members, along with other relatives, allegedly kidnapped the couple, shot them dead, and threw their bodies into the crocodileinfested waters of the river.

The matter came to light after the girl's father Rajpal Singh Tomar, during an interrogation, confessed the crime. As per the police, Tomar claimed he, along with other family members, killed his daughter Shivani Tomar and her boyfriend Radheshyaam Tomar on 3, and then disposed of their bodies into the river.

As per reports, Shivani Tomar, 18, was in a relationship with Radheshyam Tomar, 21. However, this was objected to by the girl's family as both were sharing

the same surname. Despite strong disapproval of their relationship, the young couple continued to meet each other, which made the family furious.

As per the police, on June 3, Shivani's family, along with some relatives, allegedly shot dead the young couple. Following the confession of the crime by Shivani's father, the local police swung into action to

Morena SP Shailendra Singh Chouhan said on Sunday that a team of State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) and divers were carrying out search for the bodies in the river, however, it was unsuccessful so far.

"We have not found anything yet. Searches are on, Chouhan said.

"Nothing can be said unless bodies are found. Our investigations are still underway," he added.

NCP's Leader of Opposition Ajit Pawar, declining any comments, merely said that Bawankule is the head of the state BJP and he has a right to say anything he wants.

Court acquits man accused of rape, murder of minor girl

court in Maharashtra's Thane district has acquitted a 26-year-old man accused of raping and murdering a 14-year-old girl in 2018, giving him the benefit of doubt.

Special court judge V V Virkar, hearing cases under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, in the order passed on June 6 said the prosecution has failed to prove the charges against the accused.

A copy of the order was made available on Monday. The prosecutor told the court that the girl and the

accused resided in Mankoli area of Bhiwandi town. accused forcibly entered the

On September 23, 2018, the girl's house when no one else was around. He allegedly raped the girl and then

immersed her head in a bucket



full of water and killed her, the prosecution told the court. The defence counsel said the accused was falsely implicated and he had no role in the

The judge in her order said from the police testimony, it is very much clear that the accused was caught and arrested for the crime merely on the basis of suspicion.

In such circumstances, there appears some substance in the submission on behalf of the accused that though the incident of rape and murder of the girl took place, the real culprit

could not be revealed and, therefore, the accused was caught on suspicion and prose cuted, the judge said.

" In view of all the above discussion, it has to be concluded that the evidence brought on record by the prosecution is not sufficient to establish any of the circumstances against the accused," the court said.

The failure to establish the defence by the accused cannot exonerate the prosecution from its responsibility to establish the guilt of the accused and as discussed above, in the present case, the prosecution has not discharged its burden, it

"In view of my findings, since the prosecution failed to establish any of the allegations against the accused, none of the offences charged against the accused can be held to have been proved and the accused is entitled to be acquitted," the judge said.

Thrombocytopenia Syndrome --which implies blood clots in veins). The MoHFW categorically stated that "there is a very miniscule but definitive risk" of Thromboembolic events following Covishield (SII) jabs, but Covaxin (BBL) posed no such potential

In a relief of sorts, the MoHFW added that the 'risk' was just "0.61/million doses" compared

with 4/million in the UK or 10/million in Germany.

The Centre also prepared two separate advisories -- one detailing diagnosis and treatment of TTS post-vaccine doses for health-care institutions and workers, and another for beneficiaries to encourage them to report any such

side-effects and seek treatment. Activists like Pune businessman Prafful Sarda said that when all this was known, "why did the government make the entire country a guinea pig to boost the profits of the vaccine-manufacturers".

He said that hundreds of cases are being filed in different countries as more and more serious adverse effects of the vaccines are coming to the fore and many deaths of perfectly healthy people are now being attributed to the

Nagpur-based Council for Protection of Rights (CPR) chairman, barrister Vinod Tiwari said though the vaccines were permitted for 'emergency use' only, a mass-immunisation program was taken up as people panicked.

Court acquits man accused of rape, murder of minor girl

court in Maharashtra's Thane district has acquitted a 26-year-old man accused of raping and murdering a 14-year-old girl in 2018, giving him the benefit of doubt.

Special court judge V V Virkar, hearing cases under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, in the order passed on June 6 said the prosecution has failed to prove the charges against the accused.

A copy of the order was made available on Monday. The prosecutor told the court that the girl and the

accused resided in Mankoli area of Bhiwandi town. accused forcibly entered the

On September 23, 2018, the girl's house when no one else was around. He allegedly raped the girl and then

immersed her head in a bucket



full of water and killed her, the prosecution told the court. The defence counsel said the accused was falsely implicated and he had no role in the

The judge in her order said from the police testimony, it is very much clear that the accused was caught and arrested for the crime merely on the basis of suspicion.

In such circumstances, there appears some substance in the submission on behalf of the accused that though the incident of rape and murder of the girl took place, the real culprit

could not be revealed and, therefore, the accused was caught on suspicion and prose cuted, the judge said.

" In view of all the above discussion, it has to be concluded that the evidence brought on record by the prosecution is not sufficient to establish any of the circumstances against the accused," the court said.

The failure to establish the defence by the accused cannot exonerate the prosecution from its responsibility to establish the guilt of the accused and as discussed above, in the present case, the prosecution has not discharged its burden, it

"In view of my findings, since the prosecution failed to establish any of the allegations against the accused, none of the offences charged against the accused can be held to have been proved and the accused is entitled to be acquitted," the judge said.

"To me, starting and developing stories that I'm passionate about is an incredible thing," Gadot told Total Film.


"The fact that I don't have to sit still at home and just wait for the next offer is something that makes me feel empowered. I enjoy doing it, it keeps me alive.


