ndian space agency on Friday said it had successfully taken the country's moon lander closer to the Moon by reducing its orbit. The Moon lander or the lander is part of the

Indian Space Research Organisation's (ISRO) Chandrayaan-3 spacecraft. The spacecraft comprises a propulsion module

(weighing 2,148 kg), a lander (1,723.89 kg) and a rover (26 kg).

"The Lander Module (LM) health is normal. LM successfully underwent a deboosting operation that reduced its orbit to 113 km x 157 km. The second deboosting operation is scheduled for August 20, 2023, around 0200 Hrs. IST," ISRO

On Thursday, the lander was detached from the propulsion module at an orbit of 153 km x 163 km around the Moon. The main purpose of India's third Moon mission costing about Rs 600 crore is to land the lander softly on the Moon.

The Chandrayaan-2 mission failed as the lan-

der called 'Vikram' crashed on to the Moon. According to the ISRO, the lander is expected to make a soft-landing near the South Pole of the

Moon on August 23 at 5.47 p.m. The lander will descend to the Moon from a height of about 100 km from the Moon's surface.

The soft landing is a tricky issue as it involves a series of complex manoeuvres consisting of rough and fine braking. Imaging of the landing site region prior to

landing will be done for finding safe and hazardfree zones. Subsequent to the soft landing, the sixwheeled rover will roll out and carry out experiments on the lunar surface for a period of one lunar day which is equal to 14 earth days.

The Chandrayaan-3 was put into orbit on July 14 in a copybook style by India's heavy lift rocket

The spacecraft completed orbiting around the earth and headed towards the Moon on August 1.On that day a successful perigee-firing performed at ISTRAC, the ISRO had injected the spacecraft into the translunar orbit.

Hate speech cases of all sides to be dealt with as per law: SC

he Supreme Court said on Friday that it does not need to reiterate that 'hate speech' cases be dealt with as per the law, irrespective of the community or religion of the offender.

A bench comprising Justices Sanjiv Khanna and S.V.N. Bhatti was hearing pleas seeking action against calls for social and economic boycott of Muslims following the communal clashes that broke out in Haryana's Nuh on July 31.

"We are very clear. Whether it be one side or the other side, they have to be treated alike. If anyone indulges in anything which we know as 'hate speech', they will be dealt with as per the law. This is something we have already expressed our opinion on," the bench said in a short hearing after a counsel said that a rally was organised in July by the Indian Union Muslim League in which slogans against Hindus were raised.

The court adjourned hearing the matter to August 25 as the bench said that it will proceed to hear pleas challenging the validity of caste-based survey in Bihar.Last week, the Supreme Court had asked the petitioners to forward hate speech videos to the nodal officers appointed by the state governments pursuant to the judgment of the top court.It had also mooted the formation of a district-level committee by the Director General of Police (DGP)



of all states police to look into the hate speech cases. The top court had stressed that the issue of hate speech "has to be solved" and had asked Additional Solicitor General K.M. Nataraj, appearing for the Centre, to seek instructions by August 18."There has to be harmony and comity between communities. Everyone is responsible. All communities are responsible. This is not acceptable," the bench had said during the hearing. The plea filed before the apex court said that more than 27 rallies have been organised across various states where blatant hate speeches calling for the "killing and social and economic boycott of Muslims" have been openly delivered. In April this year, the top court had stressed that the Constitution envisages India as a secular nation, while directing all states and Union Territories to take strict action in hate speech cases, and register criminal cases irrespective of religion against the culprits without waiting for a complaint to be filed.

NOTICE TO MANIPUR GOVT

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Friday sought response of the Manipur government in another shocking incident where a woman claimed that her clothes were torn by the mob and she was paraded but police did not come to her aid during the time of sectarian violence in the state.

A bench comprising Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud, Justices J.B. Pardiwala and Manoj Misra issued notice to the Manipur government and listed the matter for hearing on October 13 along with the main matter. The petition, filed through advocate Amrita Sarkar, claimed that women, who were also part of the mob, hit the survivor's oneyear-old baby and due to violence, she suffered fractures in her hands and grave injuries on her head."Petitioner No.2's clothes were torn by the mob and she was made to parade till Deputy Commissioner's building in Imphal where the police were standing but nobody came to her aid," stated the plea. The petition also alleged inaction by the state police in another case where two persons, including one woman, were beaten to death by a "mob of Meitei Community."

It said that petitioners, who are from the Kuki community, were brutally tortured, and their family members killed before their eyes.

SCINDIA LOYALIST DENIED TICKET FROM GOHAD

Bhopal: Union Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia loyalist and former MLA Ranveer Jatav has been denied ticket by the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) from the Gohad assembly seat in Madhya Pradesh. Jatav was one of the Congress MLAs who switched to the BJP to support Scindia in March 2020. Jatav had later contested a by poll on BJP ticket. However, he lost the elections to the Congress' Mevaram

Jatav in November 2021. This time, the BJP has picked Lal Singh Arya as its nominee from Gohad assembly seat. Jatav, who was in Congress in 2018, had defeated BJP's Lal Singh Arya from Gohad assembly seat.

Three-time former MLA Lal Singh Arya has been in Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan's cabinet in the previous tenure. Meanwhile, sources told that several other Scindia loyalists could be denied tickets by the BJP. If sources are to be believed, out of 11 Scindia loyalist ministers in Shivraj Singh Chouhan's cabinet, merely four-to five of them are likely to get ticket this time.

LADAKH: 2 KILLED, **10 INJURED**

Srinagar: Two people were killed and 10 others injured on Friday in a blast in Kargil's Drass town.

Official sources said that a blast occurred at the scrap site in Kabadi Nallah area of Drass town on Friday evening in which two people were killed and 10 others were injured. "The injured have been shifted to sub-district hospital in Drass town for treatment. A case has been registered in the incident and investigation has been started to ascertain the actual cause of the explosion", sources said.

Sources said that the blast mostly likely occurred when some scrap collectors/dealers fiddled with the scrap that could have resulted in some unexploded old shell going off.

Centre refutes claims about dead availing treatment under Ayushman Bharat Scheme

edia reports claiming that Ayushman Bharat PM-JAY beneficiaries who are already dead are still on the system getting treatment are misleading, the health ministry said on Thursday. The ministry also said that mobile numbers have no

role in deciding beneficiary eligibility. The ministry's remarks came in response to media reports that claimed that the Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) has flagged that treatments have been booked for AB PM-JAY beneficiaries who

have been declared dead on the system. The reports also claim that the same beneficiary had been found to avail treatment at two hospitals at the same time. "These media reports are completely misleading and ill-informed," the ministry said.

The CAG report which contains results of the Performance Audit on Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri - Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY) covering the period September 2018-March 2021 was placed in parliament in the Monsoon Session of 2023, the ministry said in a statement." It is clarified that under AB PM-JAY, hospitals are allowed to initiate requests for pre-



authorization up to three days post the date of admission in the hospital. This feature is enabled to avoid denial of treatment in case of limited connectivity, emergency situations, etc," the statement said. In some cases, the patients were admitted and

before their pre-authorisation was raised, they died. "In such cases, the date of death is the same as the admission date or earlier. Moreover, death has also been reported by the same hospital which raised the

pre-authorization request. Thus, had the hospital intended to defraud the system, it would not have shown any interest in declaring the patient dead on the IT system," the statement said.

It is pertinent to note that more than 50 per cent of cases highlighted in the report have been booked by public hospitals, which have no incentive in committing fraud, as the money is reimbursed in the hospital account, it said. Further, in case of death during treatment, the hospital has to mandatorily submit a mortality report, it said. There are also many instances where the patients were admitted in the hospital as private patients (self-paid) but when they discovered the scheme, they requested the hospital to register them under the scheme for free treatment, the statement said. The feature that allows back-dated pre-authorisation helps save people out-of-pocket expenditure.

On the patient getting treatment in two hospitals at the same time, the statement said that under AB PM-JAY, children up to 5 years of age avail treatment on the Ayushman Card of their parents.

Accordingly, Ayushman Cards can simultaneously be used for children and either of parents at two different hospitals, it said.

MORE ECONOMISTS EXTEND SOLIDARITY TO SABYASACHI DAS

s many as 288 economists at over 81 institutions across the country have so far extended their support to assistant professor Sabyasachi Das after the Haryanabased Ashoka University accepted his resignation, urging the varsity to immediately reinstate him.

Das resigned from the university after his paper suggesting voter manipulation in 2019 elections sparked a controversy. Later, Professor Pulapre Balakrishnan resigned in protest over acceptance of resignation

"We, economists working in India, strongly believe that academic freedom is the cornerstone of a vibrant educational and research community, and that everyone must have the right to pursue knowledge, share their findings, and engage in open dialogue without the fear of censorship or retribution," the economists said in a joint statement.

"We stand in solidarity with Prof Sabyasachi Das and extend our sup-



ics department at Ashoka University. We urge the Governing Body of Ashoka University to immediately reinstate Prof Das unconditionally."

Among the economists includes AJC Bose from Shri Ram College of Commerce, Delhi University, Abhiroop Mukhopadhyay from Indian Statistical Institute (Delhi), Archana Prasad from Jawaharlal University, Arpita Chatterjee from

(Bangalore) and Debalina Chakravarty

from St. Xavier's University (Kolkata). Meanwhile, the Media Studies Department of the varsity while extending their support to Das and Balakrishnan in a statement said: "We stand with all our colleagues in the unanimous ask for professors Sabyasachi Das and Pulapre Balakrishnan to remain as Ashoka Faculty, without delay. Recent events have once again brought up the need

to create and ensure a functioning firewall between Ashoka University's Faculty and its founders/governing body, on the protection of academic freedom and expression. This must now be a priority.'

"Concrete suggestions on how to go about creating a secure space that allows free expression to flourish in academia have been made by several of our colleagues. We fully endorse the efforts to create institutional safeguards to protect academic freedoms to read, write, say and publish to rigorous standards, without fear of extreme institutional backlash." It added: "Our department, as a collective of diverse practitioners in the media space, is well aware of both the realities and perceptions of pressure on free expression in our digitally mediated, social media driven information landscape. We are firmly of the view that a consultative approach involving the faculty in dealing with such pressures, is the only way forward.

MOODY'S REITER-ATES INDIA'S BAA3 **RATING BUT WARNS** OF POLITICAL ISSUES

New Delhi: Moody's Investors Service on Friday maintained its stable outlook on India, while affirming its Baa3 rating.

Nitish orders high-level inquiry into journalist's murder

ihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar on Friday ordered a high-level inquiry into the murder of a Hindi daily journalist in Araria district earlier in the day.

"It was an extremely unfortunate and painful incident. I have asked the officers to look after this matter and take action against the accused," the Chief Minister said.

Unidentified assailants gunned down Vimal Kumar in front of his house in the Prem Nagar area at around 5 a.m. on Friday morning. According to the police, the bike-borne assailants called the victim to come out of his house. As soon as he stepped out, one of the attackers shot him on the right side of the chest, killing him on the spot.

Following the incident, there was widespread outrage against the state government.

Bihar BJP president Samrat Chaudhary slammed Nitish Kumar government over the deteriorating law and order situation in the

"Murders are taking place every day in Bihar but Nitish Kumar is unable to see it. He needs a special spectacle to see the crime cases in Bihar. We are going to borrow a special spectacle for him. He is visiting Delhi and Mumbai and unable to see murders taking



Also slamming the state government, LJPR president Chirag Paswan said that if police officers and journalists were not safe, how could the common people feel secure.

"Nitish Kumar, who is also the home minister of Bihar, is staying silent on these issues which is demoralising the police. He did not go to meet the kin of the victims. Why would police officers put their lives to fight with criminals?" he further queried.

he parents and brother of a 22-year-old woman have been arrested for allegedly strangling her to death and performing her last rites at their native village, police said on Friday.

According to police, the victim Anjali (22), a B.sc student, who was a native of Surehti village in Jhajjar, was allegedly killed over her love marriage with one Sandeep Kumar from the same village.

While Anjali belonged to the Jat community, Sandeep hailed from the Brahmin community.

After their marriage in December 2022, the woman used to reside with her husband, brother Kunal, and sister-in-law in a rented flat in Aarav Society Sector-102 in Gurugram.

Police preliminary invention revealed that the woman had married the man despite opposition



from her family. "The family was against the marriage and was hatching a plan to execute the crime for eight months.

On Thursday, when Anjali was alone with her brother Kunal, he informed his parents Kuldeep and Rinki who reached Gurugram. As

per the plan Kunal tied her legs while the mother Rinki tie her hands and Kuldeep, the father strangled her to death," Varun Dahiya, ACP (crime) said.

Thereafter, Kuldeep took her body and put it inside a borrowed vehicle and the trio performed her last rites in their native village to destroy the evidence, he said.

"It was a planned murder. Kuldeep carried the victim's body on his shoulder and came out of the society where the victim was residing. The act has been recorded in a CCTV camera installed in the society. The police havealso recovered the bones of the victim from the cremation ground and sent them for an autopsy, the ACP said.

A case of murder and other relevant sections of the IPC has been registered against the suspects at Rajendra Park police station for further probe, police said.

RBI directs banks to clearly inform borrowers about rise in EMIs, loan duration due to floating interest rates


mid rising complaints by several borrowers that their loan duration and EMI amounts rise due to floating rate of loans owing to rising interest rates, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Friday directed banks to clearly communicate such possibilities clearly to them at the time of issuing loans.

The central bank in a circular, has issued a set of instructions regarding floating interest rates of loans and their impact on EMIs.

It has directed banks to ensure that these instructions are conveyed to borrowers by December 31, 2023.

The directions were issued by the RBI as it had received several grievances from borrowers that owing to floating interest rates, banks hiked their loan tenure and even the EMI amount, without communicating them about the changes and also without their consent.

The RBI has said that in order to address these



concerns, banks are advised to put in place an appropriate policy framework, wherein at the time of sanction, banks shall clearly communicate to the borrowers about the possible impact of change in benchmark interest rate on the loan leading to changes in EMI and the tenure or both.

Subsequently, any increase in the EMI or tenure or both on account of the above shall be

communicated to the borrower immediately through appropriate channels, the RBI said. At the time of reset of interest rates, banks shall provide the option to the borrowers to switch over to a fixed rate as per their board approved policy. The policy may also specify the number of

times a borrower will be allowed to switch during

the tenor of the loan.

The borrowers will also be given the choice to opt for enhancement in EMI or elongation of tenure or for a combination of both options, and to prepay, either in part or in full, at any point during the tenure of the loan. Levy of loan foreclosure charges or pre-payment penalty shall be subject to extant instructions, the RBI said.All applicable charges for switching of loans from floating to fixed rate and any other service charges or administrative costs incidental to the exercise of the above options shall be transparently disclosed in the sanction letter and also at the time of revision of such charges or costs by banks from time

The man suddenly went to his house and brought a gun and fired. In this incident, 2 people died while six are undergoing treatment. The person who fired the shot has been arrested and further investigation is on," ADCP Amarendra Singh said.

27 billionaires among 225 Rajya Sabha MPs

ut of the 225 sitting Rajya Sabha MPs analysed, 27 are billionaires with six from the BJP, a report revealed on Friday, which also said that the average assets of the Rajya Sabha MPs were Rs 80.93 crore. In a report, the Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch (NEW) said that it has analyzed and updated the criminal background details of 225 out of 233 Rajya Sabha MPs. It further said that in the current Rajya Sabha, one seat is vacant while three MPs have not been analysed as their affidavits were unavailable and four seats of Jammu and Kashmir are undefined The report said: Out of the 225 sitting Rajya Sabha MPs analysed, 27 (12 per cent) are billionaires. The report also said that the BJP has the maximum number of billionaries with assets worth more than Rs 100 crore followed by Congress and YSRCP. The report said that BJP has six (7 per cent) out of 85 Rajya Sabha MPs; four (13 per cent) out of 30 Congress Rajya Sabha MPs; four (44 per cent) out of nine RS MPs from YSRCP; three (30 per cent) out of 10 RS MPs from AAP; three (43 per cent) out of seven Rajya Sabha MPs from TRS; and two (33 per cent) out of six Rajya Sabha MPs from RJD; who have declared assets valued more than Rs 100 crore. The report also highlighted that the average assets of Rajya Sabha sitting MPs is Rs 80.93 crore.

Change Needed in Thinking on Living in the Mountains

irst the calamities of Uttarakhand, and now in Himachal Pradesh have raised many questions on the hill life, whether the hill life will become impossible, or we will have to adopt new ways to live safely on the fragile mountains. The destruction of life and property due to heavy rains and landslides in these mountains is highly disturbing. This is, however, not the first time when such devastation has taken place in the mountains. Even before this, many other such devastation have been taking place in the mountainous states of the country, when not only a large number of people have lost their lives, but private and government properties are also getting damaged. In such situations, the question arises: what lessons have we learned to minimize the devastation caused by frequent natural disasters?

Is it appropriate to make developmental plans, roads, undertake heavy constructions, tunnels, industrial undertakings, and allow tourism etc. in the mountains just like in the plains. It is necessary to investigate the reasons behind increasing incidents of landslides. Hydro- power projects on the mountains are the major reason for frequent landslides. During the hydro-power project, blasting is done to make the tunnel. The use of heavy machinery causes strong vibrations on the mountains. The ecosystem of Himachal Pradesh is still very sensitive. Due to the continuous cutting of trees in these states and the age of existing mountains also decreases, thereby the numbers of landslides increases. Apart from this, climate change can also be considered as one of the major reasons for the increasing cases of landslides.

In February last year, NASA released a report saying, climate change can increase landslides in Himalayan glacier lake areas from June to September. Also, it may have to face the disaster of flood. But why didn't our governments learn from such predictions? Today the Himalaya mountain has become the Himalaya of worries. Over the

decades, there has been indiscriminate exploitation of natural resources in the name of development, especially in the states of the Himalayan region. Not only this, such a construction is being erected against the scientific rules, which have brought in the destruction with cloud-bursts, floods and landslides. This question also persists: what should be the correct scale of development in hill states? If construction activities are necessary somewhere in the name of development, it should be capable of withstanding disasters along with the planning. It is generally seen that in the name of promoting tourism in these states, such huge buildings were erected which not only proved incapable of withstanding sudden floods and landslides, but were also harmful to the ecology and environment. In such a construction, the expectation of vigilance at the government level was ignored. We have handed over the moun-

tains to marketism, the kind of infrastructure from the past area to the residential area, hotels etc. have been constructed indiscriminately and have dug the mountains on one side, and on the other side by making concrete construction work on them. The burden has increased, due to which the appearance of these beautiful places created by nature is changing. Recently, we had seen the condition of Joshimath, the base town of Badrinath pilgrimage, how this city has started to crack. Earlier, I had also seen the destruction by sudden flash-flood in Shri Kedarnath Dham in June 2013. All this is the result of increasing the burden on the mountains and the result of cutting and digging the mountains in an unaccountable way. If landslides happen at ten places on Kalka-Shimla highway till Solan, then we have to think where the mistake has happened. If houses start collapsing on the hills of Shimla city itself, then we have to think what are the rules for con-

places? The incidents in Shimla have caused even more concern. Due to being the capital and more active, populous and tourist city, the scenes seen in Shimla were more

August 15 last, several houses collapsed due to a landslide in Krishna Nagar area of Shimla. Neighbors could not stop their screams after seeing the houses of the people living near them collapsing for decades, after the landslide, the whole country has witnessed an outcry. But when the ground subsides and everything is destroyed before your eyes, that helplessness questions criminality in government schemes, developmental neglect and callous thinking. Landslide occurred after the cloud-burst in Summer Hill area of Shimla itself. The Shiva temple of the area also came under the grip, where the crowd was bigger due to the day being a Monday of Sawan month. The ground sank so fast that no one could get a chance to do anything. A total of 25 bodies have been pulled out from the debris of the temple, so far. On August 14 itself, another landslide occurred at Fagli in Shimla, in which five persons died. There is news of the death of seven persons in Solan district also.

The manner in which the heavy rains have wrought destruction, question marks are being put on the various developmental activities being done for the hilly areas, and geologists are also giving warnings that the scale of development for the hilly areas should not be on par with the plains areas. According to

Sukhu, a gigantic loss of 10 thousand crore rupees and huge loss of life and property has been caused by the natural calamity. These painful and tragic incidents are the result of ignoring the fury of nature. This is the reason why the people of both the hill states have to be prepared to avoid the rush of indiscriminate development in future. Nature is giving us this signal and message with disasters that a lot needs to be done at different levels. It is the responsibility of the government and the people to maintain the dignity, restraint, simplicity and purity of the delicate hilly life. Everyone wants to achieve happiness and prosperity in life, but there is a need to control indiscriminate construction activities. There should be balanced development without disturbing the nature of the mountains.

According to environmental experts, mountains are being cut from above to widen the roads in Himachal Pradesh. Due to this, the incidents of landslides are continuously increasing. Human and tourism activities are continuously increasing in hilly areas. Because of this, the balance of the mountains is continuously deteriorating. In the rainy season or after the

when it rains, big stones start falling from the mountain. This is also the reason for the accidents happening in Shimla. Man's greed and insensitivity has increased to the extent of tragedy in the mountains, which has become a major cause of imbalance and destruction of mountain life with its wildlife, birds, nature and environment. India will have to prepare a development policy for its mountains. Only geologists can have a major role in this work. The Chief Minister of Himachal Mr. Sukhu is himself admitting that he himself

CANADIAN WOMAN JAILED FOR 22 YRS FOR SENDING POISON-LACED LETTERS TO TRUMP

US court has sentenced a Canadian woman to 22 years in jail for sending letters laced with ricin poison to former President Donald Trump when he was in office.

On Thursday, District Judge Dabney Friedrich sentenced 56year-old Pascale Ferrier to 262 months in prison, the BBC reported.

She will be deported from the US after serving her sentence and faces supervision for life if she ever returns.

Judge Friedrich told Ferrier her actions were "potentially deadly" and "harmful to you, harmful to society, harmful to the potential victims".

Ferrier, a dual citizen of France and Canada, told the court that she regretted that her plan had failed and that she "couldn't stop

that she saw herself as an activist not a terrorist."I want to find peaceful means to achieve my goals," Ferrier added.

He said this progress has been made possible through cooperation with international and local organisations, referring to a comprehensive agreement signed with international groups on the renovation and maintenance of 347

Earlier this month, the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies cautioned that six months on, the path back to a "normal life" remains elusive for the communities affected by the quakes.



It said survivors, particularly those who face steep economic challenges in Syria, are in dire need of necessary resources to rebuild their lives. On February 6, two back-to-back earthquakes measuring 7.8 and?7.7 on the Richter scale struck Turkey and Syria.

The confirmed death toll stood at 59,259 --50,783 in Turkey and 8,476 in Syria.

It was the deadliest earthquakes in both the neighbouring nations in recent history.

urricane Hilary is rapidly intensifying in the Pacific Ocean southwest of Mexico and is on track to deliver potentially significant rain and flooding to parts of the US Southwest starting this weekend, according to the National Hurricane Center (NHC).

In its latest update, the NHC said that as of Thursday night, Hilary had strengthened into a major Category 3 hurricane with sustained winds of 120 mph and even stronger gusts, CNN reported.

The storm will likely reach Category 4 hurricane strength on Friday with winds of at least 130 mph, the Center warned.

The hurricane was about 445 miles south of Cabo San Lucas, Mexico, as of Thursday evening. Hilary's rainfall could arrive as early as Saturday in parts of the Southwest, with the worst of its impacts set to arrive in California on August 21.

Shifts in the forecast track will also affect



which areas of northwestern Mexico will face the worst of Hilary's winds, which will be strong enough to snap trees, down power lines and cause significant damage to property.

According to the NHC, Hilary is expected to

weaken significantly before it reaches Southern California and parts of the Southwest, but there was still an increasing chance of significant impacts to these areas in the form of heavy rain and flooding, CNN reported.

Southern California could receive some of Hilary's heaviest rainfall.

Widespread rainfall amounts of 2 to 4 inches may fall there and in southern Nevada from Saturday through August 21.

The heaviest rainfall is expected mainly August 20-21.


Rainfall is also likely in parts of Arizona, Central California and northern Nevada.

If the storm makes landfall in California as a tropical storm, it would be the first in nearly 84 years, and only the third tropical storm or stronger to do so on record, according to data from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

The most recent was an unnamed tropical storm in 1939, NOAA records show.

Before that, the San Diego Hurricane made landfall in October 1858 -- California's only hurricane landfall on record.

Nora in 1997 was the last and only other tropical storm to maintain its status after crossing into California

Brownie was then rushed to Thank You Earth, an NGO founded by Bhattacharya, which specialises in the rescue and treatment of animals in need.

Bhattacharya revealed that they promptly reported the incident to the police as requested, along with a doctor's certificate detailing Brownie's injuries.

"It is shocking that someone who feeds cats would attack another animal," Bhattacharya stated. The CCTV footage captured the moment when Ansari allegedly threw acid on Brownie, causing the dog to

The Maharashtra Food and Drugs Administration (FDA) has issued a notice to temporarily close Papa Pancho Da Dhaba after it conducted an inspection at the eatery, following the customer's complaint over the horrifying discovery.

Several irregularities were found and the restaurant has been ordered to shut its doors till all the necessary guidelines have been complied with, the FDA said.



On Sunday night, Anurag Singh and his friend Amin had gone to the restaurant in Bandra for Punjabi food. The two men ordered two dishes, one mutton and one chicken-based curry. The dinner soon turned into a nightmare when Anurag discovered that the meat in the chicken curry, which he said tasted a little strange, was actually a

dead baby rat.
Outraged, the two men confronted

the hotel manager, who "gave vague answers", Anurag later alleged in his complaint to the police.

On the basis of the complaint, the manager and chef of the restaurant were charged, the police had said on Wednesday. A case was registered against the hotel's chef, manager and the chicken supplier, police said.

They have been charged with offences like adulteration of food and endangering the life or personal safety of others, the police said.

One of the men also posted images of the purported meal on X, formerly Twitter, where it has gathered over 200,000 views with most user calling for strict actions against the restaurant.

CBI arrests CGST official in Mumbai for Rs 15 lakh bribe demand

The CBI has arrested a CGST official in Mumbai for allegedly demanding Rs 15 lakh as a bribe for settling tax issues related to a company based in China, officials said Friday

It is alleged that Hemant Kumar, a Central Goods and Services Tax (CGST) superintendent, had demanded Rs 30 lakh from a tax consultant to settle issues related to Wellfull Inter-Trade Pvt Ltd based in Guangzhou, China, they said.

The company had refused to pay the bribe and asked the middleman to report the issue to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) which conducted a verification of the allegation during which the tax consultant was asked to negotiate with Kumar, they said.

A meeting took place at Wadala Railway Station in Mumbai where Kumar allegedly



reduced the demand to Rs 15 lakh, a discussion which was tapped by the consultant, they said. With the allegations verified, the CBI conducted a trap operation where Kumar was arrested with Rs 5 lakh as part of payment, they said.

Meanwhile, an offence has been registered against a man for allegedly threatening a group of porters at gunpoint and preventing them from working at a construction site in Maharashtra's

Thane city, police said on Friday. The incident took place on Wednesday when the accused Yatish Murlidhar Bhoir accompanied by a few locals went to a construction site in Ghodbunder Road and threatened porters engaged in loading and unloading materials, an official said.

Also read: Karnataka Deputy CM Shivakumar announces state government's decision to cancel implementation of National Education Policy 2020. The accused allegedly wielded a revolver and threatened to shoot the porters if they did not stop working, he said. An offence under sections 352 (assault or use of criminal force) and 506 (criminal intimidation) of the Indian Penal Code and Arms Act has been registered against Bhoir, the official from Kapurbawdi police station said. The accused had also similarly threatened porters working at a construction site in May, as he wanted locals to be engaged for the work, he added.



Eight Bangladeshi nationals arrested for illegal stay in Navi Mumbai

The Navi Mumbai police in Maharashtra have arrested eight Bangladeshi nationals, three of them women, for allegedly staying in the country illegally without valid documents, an official said on Friday.

Based on a tip-off, officials of the police's antihuman trafficking cell (AHTC) raided a residential locality in Ulve on Thursday afternoon and nabbed the Bangladeshi nationals.

The eight accused, including three women, had been living in the locality since the last eight months and did not possess any valid documents, he said. An offence under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code, Passport (Entry into India) Rules 1950 and The Foreigners Act of 1946 has been registered against them, the official from Navi Mumbai police said. Meanwhile, on Wednesday, the police arrested two Bangladeshi nationals in Thane for staying in India without valid documents.



According to the police, the arrest was made at Bhiwandi. "While one of the accused worked as a plumber, the other one was a labourer," the police official from Bhiwandi said.

"Acting on a tip-off, the police conducted a raid in Vitthal Nagar locality and caught the two Bangladeshi nationals, and a probe revealed that they have been residing there since 2018 without valid documents," the police official said.

As per the police, an offence under various
Indian Penal Code (IPC) sections, the Passport
(Entry into India) Rules and the Foreigners Act was
registered against the duo.

Earlier, on August 3, Maharashtra Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS) had said that they had arrested nine Bangladeshi nationals who were staying illegally in the country in separate operations across Mumbai and Navi Mumbai, an official told news agency.

Among them, two Bangladeshi nationals were wanted in connection with a rape case registered at Navi Mumbai's Nerul police station in 2022, he said. The operations at multiple locations and spread over a week were part of a drive against Bangladeshi nationals staying in the country without valid documents. On July 26, a raid was conducted at Nerul village in Navi Mumbai where ATS officials nabbed a Bangladeshi woman. She was wanted in a case registered by the Mumbai Crime

Branch in 2009, he said.

Priya Malik wins gold in U20 World Indian men, and women's recurve teams win bronze in Paris Championship; 2nd Indian to do so in Amman

he Indian men's and women's recurve teams won bronze medals in their respective sections in the Archery World Cup 2023 Stage 4 at the Olympic Games venue in Paris, France.

The recurve men's team of Dhiraj Bommadevara, Atanu Das, and Tushar Prabhakar Shelke were the first to seal their place on the podium as they came from behind to beat Spanish trio Pablo Acha, Yun Sanchez, and Andres Temino 6-2 on Thursday.

Spain had defeated fourth seeds USA en route to the last four, but the Indian team ultimately proved a step too far in Paris conditions.The recurve women's team of Bhajan Kaur, Ankita Bhakat, and Simranjeet Kaur then repeated the feat with a bronze of its own, as it beat Mexico's Alejandra Valencia, Angela Ruiz, and Aida Roman in a shoot-off after the teams were locked at 4-4.

The Mexico trio had raced into a 4-0 lead but were reeled back in by India who levelled the scores before an X from Bhajan Kaur sealed the victory in the shoot-off.

The bronze medal bagged by the men's team in Paris is India's third medal in Archery World Cup this year, and the archers hailed the influence of coach Sergio Pagni in their postmatch interview with World Archery's official website. "He's the finest coach, I have seen,"



said the seasoned Atanu Das. "[He's teaching us] how the mindset works, how archers should shoot in tournaments and practice, how can we train and get better day by day.""It's a perfect example of a good archer because he was an archer too. Our government is supporting us very well at the grassroots level, until the elite level all the way.""The government support is very important for us, and we have received so many sponsors and opportunities to train abroad," Das added. The Indian women's team fed on the success of the male counterparts to bag bronze."The men's team won one bronze before us, so we were very motivated to see them, and we just followed their footsteps," Simranjeet Kaur was quoted as saying by the official website.

ndia's Priya Malik made history in women's wrestling by emerging as world champion in the 2023 U20 World Championships.

Former World Cadet champion Priya improved on the silver medal she won in the 2022 U20 World Championships, winning the gold medal in the women's 76kg category, becoming only the second Indian women wrestler to win gold at the Junior World championships.

In the women's 76 kg final in Amman, Priya Malik defeated Laura Celine Kuehn of Germany 6-0 on points in another dominant display by the 18-year-old from Nidani village of Jind district of Haryana.

Priya, the two-time U17 world champion, was clearly a better version of her 2022 self with solid defense and diverse attacks. Unlike her final against Ayano Moro of Japan last year, Malik had more attacking options and scored early as Kuehn failed to get to Malik's legs most of the

"I was much better prepared for



this final than last year," Malik said. "I worked on my power and even defense so I can take this world champion belt home," Priya Malik was quoted as saying by United World Wrestling (UWW) on its website.Daughter of an Indian Army veteran, Priya Malik won India's second gold of the tournament, adding to the gold that male wrestler Mohit Kumar

won by defeating Eldar Akhmadudinov of Russia 908 in the final, becoming the first Indian wrestler after Deepak Punia in 2019 to be crowned the U20 World Championship.

Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports, Anurag Thakur congratulated Priya Malik on her success. The 18year-old wrestler had earlier won the

gold medal in the 2021 World Cadet Wrestling Championship in Women's 73 kg and had also won a bronze medal in the Asian wrestling championship held earlier this year in

"Congratulations to #TOPScheme wrestler Priya Malik on being crowned World Champion in the Women's 76kg, scripting history to become only the 2nd Indian Women Wrestler to win GOLD at the Junior Worlds," Thakur said in a tweet on Friday. Without dropping a single point throughout the tournament, brilliantly pinning her ???? counterpart in the semifinal bout and claiming victory in style and confidence, she magnificently converted her SILVER to a GOLD this time."Fantastic effort, Champ! In the semifinals, Priya Malik defeated Alexis Blades Kennedy of the United States 10-0 in a dominant performance. She had also blanked Aliaksandra Kazalova of Russia 11-0 by points in the quarterfinals.
