AFFIDAVIT BEFORE SC CLAIMS THAT SEBI BROUGHT AMENDMENTS TO BENEFIT ADANI

One of the petitioners in Adani-Hindenburg matter has filed an affidavit before the Supreme Court claiming that the Securities Exchange Board of India (SEBI) brought a series of amendments only to benefit the Adani Group and the market regulator has a conflict of interest in investigating the violations of law committed by it.

The affidavit sworn by Anamika Jaiswal alleged that not only has the SEBI suppressed important facts from the Supreme Court and slept over DRI (Directorate of Revenue Intelligence) alerts, but there is also an apparent conflict of interest in SEBI conducting Adani investigation.

"Mr. Cyril Shroff Managing Partner, Cyril Amarchand Mangaldas has been a member of SEBI's Committee on Corporate Governance, which looks at offences like insider trading.....Cyril Shroff's daughter is married to Karan Adani, son of Gautam Adani, showing clear conflict of interest," said the affidavit, adding that 5 out of the 24 SEBI investigation reports on Adani group companies are on insider trading allegations.

The affidavit further claimed that the frequent amendments brought in to the regulations and definitions have "provided a shield and an excuse to the Adani Group, due to which their regulatory contraventions and price manipulations remained



undetected". It said that all 24 investigation reports prepared by the SEBI should be made available to the Expert Committee appointed by the Supreme Court and to all the petitioners, adding that the market regulator has failed to either detect or act against violations in a timely manner and thereby, causing financial losses to unsuspecting small investors which run into crores.

The Adani-Hindenburg matter is likely to be taken up for hearing by a bench headed by CJI D.Y. Chandrachud on September 15, as per the details available on the website of the Supreme Court.

On August 25, the market regulator, in a fresh status report, said that it had examined 24 matters in compliance with orders of the top court, adding that the SEBI will take appropriate action based on the outcome of the investigations in the Adani-Hindenburg matter.

"Out of the said 24 investigations, 22 are final in nature and 2 are interim in nature. As on date, the said 22 final investigation reports and 1 interim investigation report are approved by the Competent Authority in accordance with the SEBI's extant practice and procedures," said the status report filed by the SEBI's Executive Director V.S. Sundaresan.

It said that in respect of one remaining matter, interim findings are approved by the Competent Authority and the SEBI has sought information from external agencies or entities."Upon receipt of such information will evaluate the same vis-a-vis the interim investigation report to determine further course of action, if any, in the said matters," it said.

On August 14, the SEBI had sought an extension of 15 days to conclude the investigation process and file an updated status report in the matter.

Earlier, the SEBI had filed its views before the Supreme Court on various recommendations made by the Court-appointed Expert Committee in connection with the Adani-Hindenburg case.

It had opposed the suggestion of prescribing timelines for initiation of investigation and proceedings and said that "prescribing specific timelines to complete the investigation may compromise the quality of investigation".

The apex court on March 2 had formed an expert committee headed by Justice A.M. Sapre, former judge of the Supreme Court with an objective to review and strengthen the existing financial regulatory mechanisms. It had directed the SEBI to expeditiously conclude the investigation within two months and file a status report.

Later in May, the Supreme Court had granted an extension of time till August 14 to the market regulator to submit its report.

Seat sharing to be discussed at INDIA alliance first coordination committee meet

Seat sharing among the Indian National Developmental Inclusive Alliance (INDIA) alliance will be discussed at its first coordination meeting.

The first coordination meeting will take place on September 13 at Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) Chief Sharad Pawar's residence.

The INDIA alliance had announced a 14 member coordination committee during its third meeting in Mumbai on September 1.

Besides Pawar, the coordination committee has Congress' KC Venugopal, DMK's TR Bala, JMM's Hemant Soren, Shiv Sena's Sanjay Raut, RJD's Tejashwi Yadav, Trinamool Congress Abhishek Banerjee, AAP's Raghav Chaddha, Samajwadi Party's Javed Ali Khan, JD-U's Lallan Singh, CPI's D Raja, National Conference Omar Abdullah,

PDP's Mehbooba Mufti as its members. The CPI-M is yet to give name of their party leader for the committee.

Sources said that during the first meeting of the coordination committee of INDIA the issue of seat sharing will come up for discussion.

They said that during the three meetings previously, the INDIA leaders did not have a single discussion on seat sharing till date.

The source said that the discussion for seat sharing in Bihar, Uttar Pradesh and other states will be on the agenda of the leaders. The source said that a detailed discussion will take place on the number of seats the parties want to contest in these states. The source said that discussion on seat sharing in Maharashtra, West Bengal will also come up for discussion. The Congress-led INDIA alliance will take on BJP-led NDA in 2024 Lok Sabha elections.

BJP CEC meeting likely on Sep 13 to discuss nominees for Raj, MP polls

The Central Election Committee (CEC) of Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) is likely to hold a meeting on September 13 to discuss the candidates for the upcoming Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh Assembly elections. A source said the meeting would be attended by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and BJP president J.P. Nadda, Home Minister Amit Shah, party General Secretary (organisation) B.L. Santhosh, among other party CEC members.

The BJP is expected to hold deliberations on the names of candidates to be included in the second list for the Madhya Pradesh polls, and in the first list for the Rajasthan Assembly elections.

On August 17, the party announced 21 candidates for



the Chhattisgarh polls and 39 nominees for the Madhya Pradesh elections.

Nadda and Shah held a meeting with Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan, state unit BJP chief V.D. Sharma and other leaders ahead of the CEC meeting.

Nadda on Sunday met Rajasthan election in-charge, Union Minister Pralhad Joshi,

party's state unit chief C.P. Joshi, former chief minister Vasundhara Raje, and Rajasthan in-charge & national general secretary Arun Singh.

Also, on Monday, C.P. Joshi and Arun Singh met Nadda along with former Congress MP Jyoti Mirdha, and Sawai Singh Choudhary, who joined the saffron party of September 11.

India vs Bharat: No attempt made to change country's name: Pralhad Joshi

Hubballi (Karnataka):

Union Minister for Coal, Mine and Parliamentary Affairs Pralhad Joshi on Monday said that no attempt has been made to change the name of the country. "We have not stated anywhere that the name of the country would be changed. Only people who are fearful are talking about this. We address the nation as 'Bharat' and you can address it the way you want it," the minister said. However, he said that the declaration has been made dexterously by the Prime Minister. Maha govt forms panel for Maratha quotas, urges activist to end hunger strike

An all-party meeting, presided over by Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, on Monday decided to appoint a committee to decide on the Maratha reservations in education and jobs sector within a month, belying expectations that a final decision would be taken on the issue to end the stalemate.

The all-party meet also unanimously passed a resolution urging the Shivba Sanghatana leader Manoj Jarange-Patil to give time to the committee to submit its report in one month and call off his hunger strike immediately, the CM told media persons after the discussions.

"We all the leaders are extremely concerned about Jarange-Patil's health... We are fully committed to give the Maratha quotas and the committee will decide. It can also have representatives of the Maratha community including Jarange-Patil," he said.

In Jalna, in a brief initial reaction, an adamant Jarange-Patil told media persons that he would take a decision on



ending his 14-day-long hunger-strike after discussing with his team members on Tuesday.

Besides, the government has decided to withdraw all the police cases filed against the protesting Marathas who were subjected to a crackdown in Jalna on September 1, sparking off a huge political furore.

"We have directed the police to forthwith withdraw all the cases filed against the protestors. We have also decided to suspend three senior officers who were responsible for the police baton charge that day in Antaravli-Sarati village," said Shinde, referring to the demands of Jarange-Patil. He mentioned that earlier Deputy CM Devendra Fadnavis, who holds the

home portfolio has already tendered an apology for the police action, and now all the other demands of the community have been accepted, and now the Jarange-Patil should break his fast in the interest of law and order.

The all-party meeting was attended by Shinde, Fadnavis, Deputy CM Ajit Pawar, Ministers, government officials, Leaders of Opposition Vijay Wadetiwar (Assembly) and Ambadas Danve (Council), senior leaders of Congress, both factions of Nationalist Congress Party, the ruling alliance of Shiv Sena-BJP, all other big and small parties, the descendants of the Chhatrapati clan and others, though the Shiv Sena-UBT led by ex-CM Uddhav Thackeray was not invited.

Heavy rain likely over Odisha, MP, T'gana, Chhattisgarh from Wednesday: IMD

The IMD further said that in Central India light to moderate rainfall, thunderstorms, and lightning is expected. "West Madhya Pradesh can expect this weather pattern on Monday and Friday. East Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh are likely to experience these conditions till Friday, while Vidarbha will see them from Wednesday to Friday," the weather department said.

The weatherman went on to say that in West India, light to moderate rainfall, thunderstorms, and lightning is anticipated. "Konkan and Goa, as well as the ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada, are likely to experience these conditions on Friday," said the IMD.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) said that isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall activity is likely over east Uttar Pradesh and coastal Andhra Pradesh on Monday, while Odisha, east Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha region, Telangana and Chhattisgarh will receive downpours from Wednesday.

In Northwest India, the weather forecast indicates the likelihood of light to moderate rainfall and widespread thunderstorms, the weatherman said. "West Uttar Pradesh is expected to experience fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated instances of heavy rainfall on Monday. East Uttar Pradesh is likely to see similar weather conditions till Wednesday. Uttarakhand is also expected to receive rainfall on Monday and then again from Wednesday to Friday," said the IMD in its bulletin. Furthermore, an



isolated extremely heavy rainfall event is anticipated in east Uttar Pradesh on Monday. In East India, the forecast indicates light to moderate rainfall, thunderstorms, and lightning. "Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Bihar are expected to experience this weather pattern on Monday and Tuesday. Odisha will see this weather till Friday, Jharkhand from Wednesday to Friday, and Gangetic West Bengal on Thursday and Friday," the IMD predicted. Moreover, isolated instances of very heavy rainfall are

likely to occur in Odisha Wednesday to Friday.

In South India, the forecast suggests light to moderate rainfall with isolated heavy rainfall events.

"Kerala and Mahe can expect this weather on Monday and Tuesday, Rayalaseema on Monday, coastal Andhra Pradesh on Monday, Tuesday, and Friday, and Telangana on Thursday and Friday. Coastal Andhra Pradesh may also experience isolated very heavy rainfall on Monday," said the IMD.

In northeast India, light to moderate scattered rainfall and thunderstorms are expected.

"Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, and Meghalaya are likely to see this weather on Monday and Tuesday, while Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, and Tripura will experience it till Friday. An isolated instance of very heavy rainfall is predicted for Assam and Meghalaya on Tuesday," said the IMD.

Everyone wants Ukraine war to end but on just and durable terms: US Secy of State

US Secretary of State Anthony Blinken has denied that the joint statement adopted at the recently-concluded G20 leaders summit in New Delhi has not "explicitly" condemned Russia's actions in Ukraine, saying all "stood up very clearly" for Ukraine's sovereignty and territorial integrity.

He also said that Ukrainians would be open to a negotiated settlement to the conflict but on "just and durable terms" in connection with their sovereignty and territorial integrity.

"Well, the leaders here all stood up very clearly, including in the statement, for Ukraine's sovereignty, for its territorial integrity. I think



the statement's a very strong one. And what I heard in the room as well makes very clear that virtually every member of the G20 - perhaps minus one - is intent on making sure that there is a just and durable end to this Russian aggression. And

leader after leader in the room made clear that, for the rest of the world too, the consequences of what Russia has done are having a terrible, terrible impact..." he said in an interview to ABC before leaving New Delhi, as per the US State Department.



DELHI-NCR SEES RISE IN VIRAL FEVER, FLU & DENGUE CASES: DOCTORS

City doctors on Monday said that they are seeing an increase in cases of viral fever, dengue in the national capital region. Recent floods have doubled cases of dengue over the last three weeks and is the highest reported in the last six years, the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) said in its latest statement.



viral prodrome syndrome, the doctor said.

Cases of swine flu and typhoid are also being reported. Speaking to reporter, Ajay Aggarwal, Director of Internal Medicine at Fortis Hospital in Noida, said that there is an increase in the number of acute febrile illness cases. "Viral cases like influenza and dengue have been on the rise. Patients coming in with low platelet counts are seen with an increased frequency since the last month. However, not all cases of low platelet are dengue," Aggarwal said. "Patients generally present with high grade fever with chills along with generalised malaise, weakness, joint pains, cough, vomiting or loose stools -- all of which are included in the

In addition, there is also swine flu (H1N1). Aggarwal said "10-15 cases of H1N1 flu have been detected in our hospital". However, no cases of Covid have been reported yet, he noted. "There has been a 20-25 per cent rise in people coming with flu-like symptoms," Tushar Tayal, Lead Consultant, Department of Internal Medicine, CK Birla Hospital, Gurugram, told reporter. "Some elderly patients have also

required hospital admissions, and consequently developed pneumonia and bronchitis," he added. Tayal said that dengue cases have reduced slightly, compared to the last two weeks. But certain patients are showing overlap in symptoms, who present flu-like symptoms which upon tests are turning positive for dengue, the doctor noted. In addition, there have been multiple cases of hepatitis and typhoid. This was also confirmed by online community platform LocalCircles in

its recent survey which showed that one in two households in Delhi-NCR now has one or more individuals with viral symptoms. Households impacted have more than doubled in the last month. The survey, which included over 9,000 residents from Delhi, Gurugram, Faridabad, Noida and Ghaziabad, revealed a sizable jump in people who are unwell with 50 per cent of households surveyed being affected now than last month. "Blood investigations like CBC are usually done on the third day of fever onset which may reveal low platelet count and neutropenia (low TLC)," Aggarwal said. Also, since dengue causes decreased immunity, it may be complicated by secondary bacterial infections as well, he said. "Treatment of viral febrile illness involves symptomatic management of fever along with adequate hydration. Patients are advised to seek doctor advice in case of very high grade fever, persistent vomiting, bleeding, severe loose motions or respiratory distress," the doctor noted.

Chhattisgarh's Bhupesh Baghel most popular CM among 6 states headed for polls

Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel is the most popular among the CMs facing Assembly elections.



As per the IANS CVoter Anger Index in the poll-bound states, Baghel faces the least amount of anger which also implies he is the most popular Chief Minister among these.

Among every 100 voters angry at state level governance, Baghel has the least number at 25.4.

Voters are most angry at Telangana CM K. Chandrasekhar Rao at 50.2, followed by Rajasthan's Ashok Gehlot at 49.2. Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy has a score of 35.1 while Madhya Pradesh's Shivraj Singh Chouhan has a score of 27. Mizoram CM Zoramthanga has a score of 37.1.

Among the six states going to the polls, people's anger is the most palpable against the governments of Telangana, Madhya Pradesh, and Andhra Pradesh, while the voters are most angry with

the Chief Ministers of Telangana and Rajasthan, as per the IANS CVoter Anger Index.

The sitting MLAs in Telangana faces the least amount of anger from the electorate in the coming Assembly elections.

The Telangana and Rajasthan CM face much higher anger index score

than the sitting MLAs. However, the picture reverses as more voters are angry at the sitting MLAs in Chhattisgarh with a score of 44. Only 27.6 are angry at sitting MLAs in Telangana and only 28.3 in Rajasthan. Voters are very angry with sitting MLAs in Andhra at 44.9, 41.2 in Mizoram, and 40.4 in Madhya Pradesh.

Govt did not send invite to opposition for any G20 event, says Tharoor

Congress leader Shashi Tharoor on Sunday criticised the Modi government for not sending an invitation to the opposition for any of the G20 events, including the dinner hosted by President Droupadi Murmu on Saturday, noting no other democracy would snub its own parliamentary colleagues on a global stage like this. "This diplomatic triumph makes it all the more a pity that the government does not bring the same attitude of conciliation and co-operation to bear in its domestic dealings. The failure to invite the Leader of the Opposition (in Rajya Sabha Mallikarjun Kharge), and indeed any Opposition MP, to any of the G20 events, receptions, dinner etc underscores my point. "No other democracy would snub its own Parliamentary colleagues on a global stage like this. A pity that the spirit of accommodation that prevailed at G20 is absent within Indian politics," Tharoor wrote on X (formerly Twitter) referring to the G20 Summit while resharing his earlier post, complimenting India's G20 Sherpa Amitabh Kant



for achieving consensus on the Delhi Declaration.

Wait for some time, PoK will automatically merge with India: V K Singh

Minister of State of Road Transport and Highways retired general VK Singh on Monday said that Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) will automatically merge with India after some time.

"Wait for some time, the PoK will automatically merge with India," Singh in Dausa, Rajasthan responded after he was asked about the demands of PoK Shia Muslims to open the roads to India.

On the success of the G20, the minister said: "The G-20 event has been successful. Such an organised event has never happened before. Around 200 meetings were organised in 60 cities of the country."

He said that other countries too have praised India for organising such a successful event.



"India has achieved a big victory in the collective manifesto issued in the conference. The world was divided on many issues including Ukraine,

but with the wisdom of Prime Minister Modi, we all together have found a way out that no country had any objection to," the minister said

while addressing a press conference at BJP's Parivartan Sankalp Yatra in Dausa.

He said that the formation of the Biofuel Alliance and the corridor from India to Europe will pave the way for India's economic progress.

"Congress leader Shashi Tharoor has also welcomed the joint declaration of G-20," he said.

On the question about the BJP's chief minister face in the state, he said that wherever elections are held, BJP does not declare the chief minister face but contests elections only on the charisma of the Prime Minister.

"Everyone should assume that the party will give opportunity to such leaders who are good, useful and on whom the public has confidence," he said.

Noida lawyer killed by husband for refusing to sell off bungalow

The 61-year-old woman lawyer, who was found dead in Noida Sector 30 on Sunday, was allegedly killed by her husband as she refused to sell off their bungalow, police said. The accused husband, who was hiding in the store room of the house, was arrested by the police on Monday. According to the police, the husband had taken an advance of Rs 55 lakh for the bungalow and had priced the property at Rs 4.30 crore. The wife, Renu Sinha was not at all ready to sale this property, due to which they used to fight every day.

The husband, Nitin Nath Sinha was posted in Indian Information Services in Delhi and was selected in the 1988 batch. He left the job after 10 years in 1998 by taking VRS.

According to the police, Ajay Kumar, brother of female lawyer Renu Sinha, had on Sunday, informed the police that his sister, was not picking up his phone and the house is locked. After which the police reached the spot and broke open the door.



When the police went inside, they found the woman's dead body lying on the bathroom floor. The police called the forensic and dog squad team who inspected the incident site and took into their custody the hard

disk of the CCTV installed in the house.

When the police enquired the locals and the woman's brother, they came to know that Renu and her husband Nitin Nath Singh were not on

good terms and used to fight often. They also have a son who lives in America and comes to meet his parents once a year.

When the police tracked the last location from her husband's phone, they came to know that it was from the same house. Thereafter, the police searched for the accused husband and arrested him after he was found hiding inside the store room on the first floor of the house at 3:00 a.m.

During interrogation, Nitin told the police that on Sunday, he had a fight with his wife following which he strangled her to death around 8 a.m. Later he showed the house to a broker who came during the day and then hid himself in the store room along with his passport. Whoever called him, he told them that he was on Lodhi Road in Delhi and would meet him when he comes home.

He also told the police that if he had not been caught, he would have flown to foreign and could appear in the court later through his lawyer.

Man involved in biggest gold loot in Bihar, gunned down

A man, who was released from jail five months ago and was involved in Bihar's biggest gold loot, was gunned down by four bike-borne assailants in Vaishali, said officials on Monday.

The deceased, identified as Raj Hani, and a native of Bag Dulhan locality, was intercepted by the bike-borne assailants near R.N. college and shot from close range.

Raj Hani sustained four to five gunshot injuries on his back and died on the spot. "Raj Hani was involved in 55 kg gold loot from Muthoot Finance gold loan outlet located in Hajipur Vaishali on November 23, 2019. He was booked under the IPC sections 397, 412, 201 and 120B in the town police station. The accused was arrested by Vaishali police soon after and lodged in jail. He came out of



jail on bail some five months ago," said Om Prakash, SDPO (sub divisional police officer) of Sadar Vaishali.

"We have found the CCTV of the crime scene which shows four bike-borne assailants arriving there at 9.45 p.m. on Sunday and firing on Raj Hani. He sustained 4 to 5 gunshot injuries and died on the spot. We are making efforts to identify the accused," Om Prakash said.

In another incident in Vaishali, a gold trader was shot at by three unidentified

men behind a temple on Sunday around 10 p.m. The victim was identified as Ram Ishwar Shah who had closed his shop and was returning home. The accused came on one bike and fired at him.

The trader sustained one gunshot injury on his thigh. He is admitted in the Sadar hospital Hajipur and is out of danger.

"We have obtained the CCTV footage of that incident. The accused will be put behind the bars soon," Om Prakash said.

Modi holds talks with Saudi Crown Prince, reviews wide range of bilateral issues

Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the visiting Crown Prince of Saudi Arabia Mohammed bin Salman held the first leaders' meeting of the India-Saudi Arabia Strategic Partnership Council on Monday.

The agenda included a broad range of areas of bilateral cooperation including energy security, trade and investment, defence and security, healthcare, food security, culture and community welfare issues among others, the External Affairs Ministry said.

The Crown Prince is currently on a state-visit to India. He had arrived on September 9 to attend the G20 Summit and will be departing for Riyadh on Monday. During the meeting, both the leaders reviewed the



progress made under the two Ministerial Committees of the Strategic Partnership Council -- the Committee on Political, Security, Social and Cultural Cooperation and the Committee on Economy and Investments Cooperation.

India and Saudi Arabia have historically close and friendly relations with exten-

sive people-to-people contacts. The trade between both countries reached all time high of \$52.75 billion in 2022-23. India is Saudi Arabia's second largest trading partner whereas Saudi Arabia is India's fourth largest trading partner. Both countries also have a strong partnership in the area of energy.

Delhi govt bans firecracker licenses, manufacturing ahead of Diwali

Delhi Environment Minister Gopal Rai on Monday said that Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal has issued a directive to the city police against granting licenses for the sale, manufacture or storage of firecrackers ahead of Diwali which will fall on November 12 this year.

The action is aimed at reducing pollution levels during Diwali as well as the winter season.

Rai also mentioned that Chief Minister Kejriwal has instructed the Delhi Pollution Control Board (DPCB) to impose a complete ban on the manufacturing, storage, online sale, and bursting of firecrackers. "We all celebrate Diwali with great enthusiasm. Besides lighting lamps, we also burst crackers, which results in a thick cloud of smoke which engulfs the entire Delhi the day after Diwali. When the pollution from stubble burning is added to this, the AQI level reaches severe levels," the Environment Minister said.

Rai explained that this is why they have designed a Winter Action Plan to combat pollution.

"We are aware that pollution increases in Delhi with the arrival of winter. Delhi's AQI remained low between January and August, recording 45 AQI in



Delhi yesterday (Sunday). However, in October, as winter advances, particulate matter (PM) begins to accumulate, making the environment toxic due to both local and external pollution sources."

The Minister also informed that they are holding a meeting with environmental experts on Tuesday, and another one with all department officials is scheduled for September 14.

Rai further mentioned that on October 23, 2018, the apex court issued an order allowing only green crackers in the capital.

However, it was observed that various types of crackers were sold and burst under the guise of green crackers, leading to severe pollution levels.

On January 12, 2020, the NGT passed an order to ban crackers entirely in the entire NCR where pollution levels reach the severe category.

DPCC imposed a complete ban on the manufacturing and storage of crackers on September 28, 2021.

"In 2022, there was also a complete ban on crackers. In 2014, PM levels used to be 324, which have now reduced to 188. PM 10 has also decreased by 46 per cent. PM 10 has witnessed a 42 percent decline between 2014 and 2023. The Delhi Chief Minister has decided and directed the DPCC to ban the manufacturing, storage, online sale, bursting, etc.," Rai said. Rai stated that Delhi Police issues licenses for selling crackers each year, so they are issuing directions to the Delhi Police not to grant any licenses for the storage, sale, or manufacturing of crackers to help reduce pollution. "We have noticed that people in Delhi secretly bring crackers from other states. We appeal to neighboring states to adhere to the NGT order, and we will also write letters to them," he added.



AFTER LAST WEEK'S TEMPLE VISIT, SHIVRAJ SINGH CHOUHAN RETURNS TO THANK FOR RAINFALL

Ujjain: Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan on Monday visited Mahakaleshwar temple in Ujjain and expressed gratitude for good rain in the state.

"I have come to pay obeisance to Mahakal Maharaj. When we came here last Monday, there was a famine situation in the state. Due to lack of water the crops had started drying up and at many places there were cracks in the fields. The faces of the farmers were dull and they were in great trouble," he told reporters.

Last week, Chouhan had offered prayers at the temple over a drought-like situation in the state.

Guest scholars to get up to Rs 50 thousand per month: CM Chouhan

No guest scholar and lecturer will be excluded. 25 percent posts reserved in PSC for guest scholar lecturers. Announcements guest scholars and guest lecturers

Bhopal : The guest scholars employed in government colleges will be given monthly salary instead of working days and it will be up to Rs 50 thousand. Guest scholars from technical education will be included. Guest scholars will get the leave facilities like government servants. The honourarium of guest lecturers will also be Rs 20 thousand. The guest scholars will also be given the facility of transfer to nearby colleges at their wish, instead of their own college during an academic session. The Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan made these

announcements while addressing the Panchayat of guest scholars and guest lecturers here today. He said that the state government has taken these important decisions to end uncertainty in the lives of guest scholars and guest lecturers.

Chouhan said that a system will be put in place to ensure that there is situation of fallen out. Instructions will be given to start the process of reserving 25 percent posts by revising the PSC examination for guest scholar lecturers. Currently, guest scholars are given 4 and maximum 20 additional marks every year. This should be increased to a maximum of 10 percent marks.

Chouhan said that now any guest scholar or lecturer who is continuously teaching

will not be excluded. Guest teachers and lecturers from ITI, Polytechnic and Engineering Colleges will also be eligible. Any guest scholar and lecturer who is regularly teaching will continue teaching.

Various provisions have been made for the welfare of different classes and different categories of officers and employees. Guest scholars and guest lecturers are also eligible to get benefits. They have been given responsibility of building the future of the students.

The Chief Minister said that guest scholars and guest lecturers are integral parts of educational governance. The state government is committed to ensuring facilities to guest scholars and guest lecturers.

Putting hand on girl's shoulder, pulling clothes, proof of ill intention in POCSO case: HC

Madhya Pradesh High Court has upheld the conviction of appellant Nageshwar in a case related to the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act. The High Court said that a man pulling a girl's clothes and placing his hand on her shoulder shows his sexual intent.

A single judge bench of Justice Prem Narayan Singh said that as per law, any offense under the POCSO Act requires a guilty mental state on the part of the accused and the same would be considered by the special court in such offences.

According to the Bar & Bench report, the court said that as far as delay in sexual intent is concerned, the appellant was a 22-year-old man at the time of the incident. He pulled the victim's clothes and placed his hand on her shoulder. This conduct clearly reflects the sexual nature of the Appellant.

Therefore, the High Court confirms the conviction of the appellant-accused under Section 354 (outraging modesty) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and Section 7/8 of the POCSO Act. The court has imposed a fine of Rs 4,000 on the convict and also upheld the

sentence of 3 years' imprisonment.

The prosecution alleged that when the victim, studying in class 9, was returning from her relative's house, the accused held her hand with malicious intent and pulled her clothes. When she raised an alarm, her uncle Manish came there and the accused threatened her and ran away from the spot.

Based on the charge sheet filed by the police, the trial court found the accused guilty after lengthy legal cross-examination of both the parties. The court sentenced him to 3 years rigorous imprisonment under the POCSO Act and also imposed a fine of Rs 4000 on him. The appellant had approached the High Court challenging the decision of the lower court.

With regard to the question whether the victim fell within the definition of 'child' below 18 years of age, the High Court clarified that at the time of the incident, she was below 15 years of age. Furthermore, while acknowledging minor contradictions in the testimony of the prosecutor and other witnesses, the High Court emphasized that such discrepancies would not impair the credibility of their statements.

Congress silent on the quota for women issue

If there is one issue that blared out from loudspeakers during the 2022 assembly polls in Uttar Pradesh and has now gone completely silent, it is the one related to reservation for women. When Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra launched her 'Ladki hoon, Lad sakti hoon' campaign and announced 40 per cent tickets for women, she did manage to unnerve the other political parties. Parties like the Samajwadi Party, maintained a studied silence but keenly watched the situation to see if quota for women does yield the desired results. The issue flopped badly and the Congress put up its worst ever performance with only one woman as winner - Aradhana Mishra Mona, who is a veteran politician. 40 civilians killed in airstrike on Khartoum market; Sudanese army denies involvement

At least 40 civilians were killed and dozens injured in an airstrike "carried out by the Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF)" on a market in southern Khartoum, a volunteer group has said. However, the SAF has denied responsibility for the attack. The resistance committee of South Khartoum said in a statement on Sunday that "40 civilians were killed in an air strike by the SAF warplanes on a market in Mayo area, south of Khartoum", Xinhua news agency reported. The committee also published photos showing large numbers of injured and



corpses covered with cloths. On the same day, the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF) also accused the SAF of shelling civilian neighbourhoods in the Mayo area. "The SAF carried out aerial bombardments this morning

on residents in Mayo neighbourhood," the RSF said in a statement, adding dozens of injuries were transferred to the nearby hospital. The SAF, however, rejected the rebel militia's claims as misleading and false, saying it had never targeted any civilian gatherings, according to a statement by its spokesman's office. "The armed forces confirm that they only launch their strikes against rebel gatherings, crowds, sites and bases as legitimate military targets, while fully adhering to international humanitarian law and the rules of engagement as a professional army, far from innocent citizens," said the statement. Sudan has been witnessing deadly clashes between the SAF and the RSF in Khartoum and other areas since April 15, which have left at least 3,000 deaths and more than 6,000 injuries, according to the Sudanese Health Ministry.

Hawaii's Kilauea volcano erupts, alert level elevated to warning
Honolulu: After a lengthy period of elevated seismic activity, Hawaii's Kilauea volcano has started erupting again at the summit crater, prompting the US Geological Survey (USGS) to elevate the alert level to warning. The eruption started at 3.15 p.m. on Sunday, the Hawaiian Volcano Observatory (HVO) said, adding that there was no immediate danger from the eruption to downslope communities, reports the Hawaii News Now. Lava was remaining along a dropped down block of the caldera and the edge of Halemaumau crater, but authorities stressed that hazards were being assessed and the eruption was "dynamic". "HVO will continue to monitor this activity closely and report any significant changes in future notices," Hawaii News Now quoted officials as saying. They added that all activity was confined to Hawaiian Volcanoes National Park. Webcam images showed fountains of lava shooting into the air. Kilauea is the most active of the five volcanoes that together form the island of Hawaii.

INDIAN-AMERICAN CONGRESSWOMAN INTRODUCES RESOLUTION FOR 9/11 RACISM VICTIMS

A group of lawmakers, including Indian-American Pramila Jayapal, has introduced a Congressional resolution condemning hatred, xenophobia, and racism against South Asian, Sikh, Arab, Muslim and Mid-Eastern communities in the aftermath of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks. Introduced on September 9 ahead of the 22nd anniversary of one of the deadliest terrorist attacks in the history of the US, the resolution recognised the tragedy and put forward a series of recommendations to support those affected by the hateful profiling after the attack. "This day irrevocably changed our country and its impact is still felt. Muslim, Middle Eastern, South Asian, and Sikh communities in the aftermath," Congresswoman Jayapal said. "The murders of Balbir Singh Sodhi, Waqar Hassan, and Adel Karas in the days following the attack were shocking displays of hatred. Xenophobia and racism have no place in this country, and today we recognise the shared trauma that these communities faced as they experienced stigma, discrimination, and losses of liberty," she added. The resolution called for the creation of an interagency task force to work with community-based organisations to review government policies, investigate and document their impact, and dismantle those policies that continue to profile and unfairly target these communities. It also called for hearings by congressional and civil rights bodies to explore the findings and recommendations of this interagency task force in consultation with and centering community-based organisations. The resolution supported allocating resources to community-based organisations outside and independent of law enforcement that center the experiences and demands of these communities to both support hate crime prevention and the needs of victims of hate and state violence.

Death toll from Morocco earthquake rises to 2,122

At least 2,122 people have been killed and 2,421 injured since a massive earthquake struck central Morocco on Friday night, according to the latest update from the Moroccan Interior Ministry. The deaths include 1,351 people reported in the Al Haouz Province, 492 in Taroudant Province, 201 in Chichaoua, and 17 in Marrakesh, added the ministry in a press release on Sunday. Moroccan troops and emergency services were reportedly struggling to reach the most affected areas in the Atlas Mountains region, as roads leading up there were blocked by fallen boulders, Xinhua news agency reported, citing local media. Earlier in the day, Marrakesh's residents told reporters that aftershocks could still be felt. According to the World Health Organization estimates, the disaster has affected more than 300,000 people in the ancient old city and its outskirts. The number of casualties is expected to rise. The Moroccan Red Crescent (MRC) has said the situation on the ground posed a vast challenge to search and rescue efforts, and "getting heavy machinery into those remote



areas of the Atlas Mountains to help with that is a priority". As more people were being pulled out of the rubble, the MRC and other first responders were working around the clock to identify and prioritize the most severe cases, the MRC said in a statement. The earthquake hit Morocco Friday at 11:11 p.m. local time at a depth of 18.5 km, according to the US Geological Survey.

Sunak confirms raising British Sikh's detention with Modi: Report

UK Prime Minister Rishi Sunak has confirmed that he raised the case of a Scottish Sikh detained in India since 2017 during his talks with counterpart Narendra Modi on the sidelines of the G20 Summit in New Delhi, a BBC report said. While the UK Foreign Office ruled out intervening in the Jagtar Singh Johal's case on September 8, Sunak, under pressure to highlight the issue, said he raised it along with other consular issues. He did not provide details, but said: "The Foreign Office is continuing to provide support to Mr Johal's family and will continue to do so." In response to the development, campaigners for Johal said the UK government should declare Modi's response to Sunak on the issue, and that it is "meaningless" if the Prime Minister didn't call for "immediate



release", the BBC reported on Sunday. "What did Rishi Sunak say to Narendra Modi about the case and how did he respond? Without answers to these questions, the prime minister's talk is meaningless," Maya Foa, Director of human rights group Reprieve, told the BBC. The UK Sikh Federation said Sunak had appeared "very reluctant" to press Johal's case since entering No 10, and "has demonstrated his weakness and lack of leadership by shamefully fail-

ing to stand up for the rights of a British citizen". Rishi Sunak and his Foreign Office ministers are now talking utter nonsense in terms of Jagtar's best interests and justice. They appear scared and clueless on how best to apply diplomatic pressure on India and are leaving it to the corrupt Indian judicial system," Dabinderjit Singh, the principal adviser to the Sikh Federation, told the BBC. Sunak's action came after a group of more than 70 MPs called on him last week to urge Prime Minister Modi to secure the 36-year-old Sikh campaigner's "immediate release". En route New Delhi for the G20 Summit on September 9-10, Sunak, on being asked whether he would be raising the case, said that he would be "raising a range of things with Prime Minister Modi -- this (Johal's case) is something that, just so people are reassured, has already been raised on multiple levels on multiple occasions". Johal's brother Gurpreet Singh Johal, a lawyer and Labour councillor, said he is "pleased" that Sunak has raised the case with Modi but it is "not enough". "Raising (the case) is not enough unless he has called for Jagtar's release in line with the UN Working Group on Arbitrary Detention's findings. I fear that this is just more talk from the UK government and no action," Gurpreet told the BBC. Jagtar Singh Johal from Dumbarton was in Punjab for his wedding when he was arrested from Jalandhar on November 4, 2017, over his alleged role in killings by the Khalistan Liberation Force (KLF), a banned terrorist organisation. His family claims that he was tortured, including through electric shocks, before being made to sign a blank confession document - allegations that have been denied by the Indian authorities.



PARLIAMENT SPECIAL SESSION INTENDED TO BREAK MUMBAI FROM MAHARASHTRA: CONGRESS

The Maharashtra unit of Congress on Monday claimed that the upcoming special session of Parliament has been called with the agenda to "divide the country and separate Mumbai from Maharashtra".

State Congress president Nana Patole said that no agenda has been announced for the September 18-22 session so far. "The government of Prime Minister Narendra Modi has called this session without asking anybody, including the Opposition and the Parliamentary Affairs Committee. No such special sessions were called during the Covid-19 crises, demonetisation, the Manipur violence, then why now?" he asked.

Patole also alleged that session is intended "to divide the country and push through the Modi government's plans to separate Mumbai from Maharashtra, and declared it a Union Territory". He pointed that Mumbai is a city of global importance, the country's financial nerve-centre, the pride of the state and the nation, and the BJP has been eyeing it for the past nine years by systematically downgrading its importance.

"This has been going on for long... The Global Financial Centre has been taken to Gujarat, the diamond industry has been shifted there, the Air India headquarters was also moved out. Now, it is said there are plans to relocate the Bombay Stock Exchange and National Stock Exchange as part of the larger conspiracy to 'secede Mumbai' from



Maharashtra." Patole also contended that all this was not possible during the rule of Maha Vikas Aghadi government of Shiv Sena (UBT)-Congress-Nationalist Congress Party, led by former Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray, which was the reason it was toppled with the help of the Centre and the then state Governor. "However, ever since the government of Chief Minister Eknath Shinde took office, many big-ticket projects of Mumbai and Maharashtra have been 'hijacked' to Gujarat. Neither Shinde nor the Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis have dared to oppose all this," he said. He said that if Shinde-Fadnis-Ajit Pawar have the courage, they should question the Prime Minister for taking away all major projects, institutions and offices out of Mumbai to the detriment of the people of the city and the state.

Mumbai's 'fugitive scam couple': Police freeze more bank accounts, properties

Moving ahead in the investigations, the Mumbai Police's Economic Offences Wing (EOW) has frozen another 11 banks accounts and five prime properties purportedly owned by absconding scamster couple Ashesh Mehta and his wife Shivangi Lad-Mehta, officials said on Monday. The five residential properties, worth an estimated Rs 16 crore, are in Kandivali, Goregaon, and Santacruz, while 11 bank accounts of the Mehta couple and their companies have also been frozen. "The Mumbai Police EOW has taken prompt cognisance of my complaints and so far they have frozen around Rs 175 crores siphoned off by the Mehta couple by cheating over 4,000 investors all over India and then disappearing," ruling Shiv Sena spokesperson Krishna Hegde said. Official sources said that the EOW has also started questioning the relatives, friends, business associates and others in the entire scam and attempt to trace out the missing couple, now off radar for nearly four months.

Hegde urged the Mumbai Police to now expedite the necessary legal formalities to liquidate the properties and release the monies lying in these frozen bank accounts that can be disbursed among the needy investors who were gyped of their hard-earned cash. Last month, the Mumbai Police cracked the whip on the Mehtas after Hegde demanded a probe into a staggering withdrawal-transfers of



some Rs 180 crore to various associates or entities of the scamster couple. IANS highlighted the matter in June-July after it came to the fore when the Madhya Pradesh Police were probing a drug case which was linked to the Mehta couple. Besides a NDPS case in MP, the couple is accused of money-laundering, running illegal ponzi schemes, cheating gullible investors and other frauds totally estimated at over Rs 1,000 crore, before decamping. The MP and Maharashtra Police have probed the homes and offices of the Mehtas in Mumbai in the past few months, but they have not been able to trace the couple. After getting many grievances from the people, Hegde moved Chief Minister Eknath Shinde in July who directed the issue of a Look Out Circular for the couple and the Mumbai Special Police Commissioner Deven Bharti and Joint Commissioner Nishith Mishra to intensify the probe.



DELHI TOP CITY FOR IPHONE ENTHUSIASTS, BEATS MUMBAI BY BIG MARGIN: REPORT

New Delhi: Delhi has emerged as the top city for iPhone enthusiasts as it beats the second in the chart, Mumbai, with a mammoth "182 per cent" more iPhone purchases this year so far, reveals a new report.

The research, "iPhone unboxed" conducted by consumer electronics store chain Croma, found "47 per cent growth" in iPhone sales in Delhi from 2020 to 2021 and rose to "106 per cent" from 2021 to 2022 in the city.

Interestingly, Mumbai, while second in iPhone purchases, also experienced a significant iPhone wave, with over a "tenfold increase" in 2022, according to the report. The list was followed by

Pune, Bengaluru, and Hyderabad, with growth percentages of 198 per cent, 221 per cent, and 132 per cent, respectively, from 2021 to 2022.

"The findings by Croma are based on the purchase patterns of Croma consumers throughout the year and close observations of post-purchase usage trends. The iPhone unboxed not only gives the highlights of the past few years but also sets the tone ahead of Apple's forthcoming event on September 12th," read the report.

It also revealed iPhone 13, 128GB, starlight white as the bestselling model; followed by the iPhone 13, 128GB midnight black edition, and the iPhone 13, 128GB blue.

Apple will be announcing its latest iPhone 15 series on Tuesday.

Shiv Sena-UBT dropped from Maha all-party meet on Maratha quotas: LoP Ambadas Danve

Maharashtra's Leader of Opposition in Council Ambadas Danve on Monday accused the state government of not inviting his Shiv Sena-UBT for the all-party meeting this evening to discuss the vexed issue of Maratha quotas. Slamming the government of Chief Minister Eknath Shinde for being "mean-minded" and "playing politics", Danve said that he has been invited in his capacity as the Leader of Opposition in the Council, but his party's name does not figure in the invite list. "Many big and small parties have been invited for this meeting. But the government has not officially invited the Shiv Sena-UBT. I have been invited as the Leader of Opposition," said a peeved Danve. He also pointed out that Bharatiya Janata Party leader Chandrakant Patil, who is heading a panel for Maratha reservations, has been invited as a Minister for the meeting and wondered "what is the government trying to achieve by this".

However, Danve said several other ministers have also been called for the meeting and asked how they are concerned in the matter. Danve said that when the erstwhile Maha Vikas Aghadi CM Uddhav Thackeray had convened a similar meeting, he had also invited some five dozen organisations, but today not a single organisation figures in the list of invitees. He also questioned whether the government had appointed an official representative to meet or hold talks with the Shivba Sanghatana leader Manoj



Jarange-Patil who is on an indefinite hunger strike for the past 14 days for Maratha quotas. On September 2, NCP President Sharad Pawar and ex-CM Thackeray were among the first to reach Jalna's Antarvali-Sarati village which witnessed a major police clampdown on Maratha protestors a day earlier, and later protests spread across the state. Meanwhile, as many as 32 representatives of the ruling coalition of Shiv Sena-BJP-Nationalist Congress Party-AP, Congress' Leader of Opposition in Assembly Vijay Wadettiwar, the Congress, NCP-Sharad Pawar, other big and small parties and officials have been invited to join the 'all-party' meet to be addressed by the CM later this evening.

Uddhav Thackeray's "Godhra" warning over Ram temple event, BJP reacts

Former Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray has warned of a "conspiracy (yielding a) Godhra-like incident... in the name of the Ram temple" after its inauguration in Uttar Pradesh's Ayodhya. The temple is to be inaugurated in January, months before the Lok Sabha election, and is likely to be attended by tens of thousands of Hindus from across the country.

Thackeray's claim against the Bharatiya Janata Party, in power at the centre, has been sharply criticised by senior BJP leader Ravi Shankar Prasad, who reminded his former ally that Balasaheb Thackeray (the late Shiv Sena founder) had "blessed" the Ram temple movement, and declared he would "pray to Lord Ram for wisdom (to the opposition leader)".

Thackeray's remark was also slammed by Union Minister Anurag Thakur and Goa Chief Minister Pramod Sawant. At an event in Jalgaon, Uddhav Thackeray referred to a "possibility that many Hindus will be called from all over the country in buses and trains... and, while returning from there, a Godhra incident can be carried out somewhere on the way".



"This can happen... attack can happen. In some colony they will burn buses, throw stones... massacres will take place. The country will be on fire again... and they will bake their political bread on these flames," the Shiv Sena UBT leader declared. At least 58 people were killed, and an entire nation traumatised, in February 2002 after some coaches of the Sabaramati Express were set on fire at Gujarat's Godhra Railway Station. The killings triggered protests and riots, for

which a local court convicted just 31 people (63 were released) nine years later. Appeals against the conviction - upheld by the Gujarat High Court - are now pending before the Supreme Court. The inauguration of the temple - being built on land claimed by both Hindus and Muslims but awarded to the former by the Supreme Court in 2019, in a landmark verdict - will take place months before the 2024 general election, at which the BJP, which has championed the building of the temple, will bid for an unprecedented third term in power. Former Law Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad said Balasaheb Thackeray - Mr Thackeray's late father - may feel "... what happened to my child?" "With whose blessings he became a big leader... will he speak like this? The Ram Janmabhoomi movement which Balasaheb blessed? This alliance against PM Modi can go to any limits for votes," he declared. "I would like to pray to Lord Ram to give them (the INDIA opposition alliance) some wisdom." Thakur, asked to respond, slammed the Maharashtra politician for being "greedy" and swung the question around to the ongoing row over Tamil Nadu minister Udhayanidhi Stalin's remark on 'Sanatan Dharm'.

2 YOUTHS KILLED AS CAR RAMS DIVIDER, CATCHES FIRE IN MUMBAI

In a tragic accident, two youths were killed and three others injured when their car rammed into a road divider and burst into flames near Sion area in Mumbai early on Monday morning, police and the BMC Disaster Control said.

The incident took place around 4.30 a.m. when the Hyundai i20 gas-powered vehicle was speeding along Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Road from Sion to Dadar. Near the Ganga Vihar Hotel, the car dashed into a road divider, overturned and burst into flames, trapping the five occupants inside the burning vehicle.

The locals summoned the fire brigade and also managed to extricate the passengers from the car, and rushed them to Sion Hospital for treatment. The fire teams which reached there later managed to extinguish the vehicle flames within minutes and later it was towed away for police investigations.

Prem Vaghela, 18, and his brother Ajay Vaghela, 20, were killed in the accident while their friends Harsh Kadam, 20, Ritesh Bhoir, 25 and Kunal Attar, 33, have been admitted in a critical condition. The cause of the crash is not known and will be probed from all angles including whether the person at the wheel was dozing or inebriated, said an official.



Woman goes into labour on Mumbai-Goa highway, bus diverts to health centre

A pregnant woman went into labour onboard a bus of the Maharashtra State Transport Corporation (MSRTC) on the Mumbai-Goa Highway and was safely shifted to a primary health centre by the crew, an official said on Monday.

The incident took place near Kolad village in Raigad district on Saturday, the official said.

Susheela Ravi Pawar, a resident of Rudroli village, boarded a Panvel-Mahad bus from Wadkhali in the afternoon and started experiencing labour pains during the

journey, he said. Bus driver Devidas Jadhav and conductor Bhagvan Parab immediately diverted the bus to Ambewadi primary health centre at Kolad and admitted her there, the official said. The woman received medical attention and her delivery was smooth because of the bus crew's timely action, he said. The repair work is underway on the pothole-ridden Mumbai-Goa Highway, and the traffic police have banned the movement of heavy vehicles on this road till the culmination of the upcoming Ganesh festival.

FLYER ACCUSED OF SEX HARASSMENT ONBOARD INDIGO'S MUMBAI-GUWAHATI FLIGHT

A passenger travelling on budget carrier IndiGo's flight to Guwahati from Mumbai was handed over to the Guwahati police on arrival for allegedly sexually harassing a passenger onboard, the airline said on Monday. The complainant has filed an FIR with the local police and the airline will provide assistance in investigation when required, IndiGo said in a statement. The airline, however, did not

share any specific details about the incident. "A passenger travelling on (IndiGo flight) 6E- 5319 between Mumbai-Guwahati was handed over to the Guwahati police on arrival, after receiving a complaint from another passenger for alleged sexual harassment," the airline said. An FIR has been filed by the complainant with the local police and "we will provide assistance in their investigation, where required," IndiGo added in the statement.

NCLT to hear RCAP Resolution Plan matter on Sep 12, unlikely to take any decision

A hearing for an approval of the resolution plan of the Reliance Capital is scheduled for September 12 (Tuesday) in NCLT Mumbai but the tribunal is unlikely to take a final call on the Hinduja Group company IIHL's Resolution Plan in Tuesday's hearing. According to sources, the main reason for NCLT not taking a final decision on the resolution Plan is due to the impending order on Torrent Investment's plea that had challenged the Committee of Creditors (COC) decision to approve the IIHL's Resolution Plan.

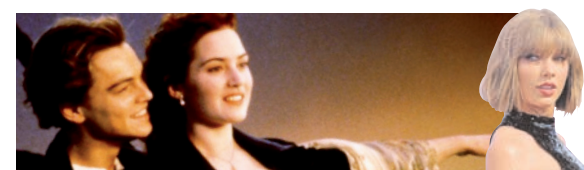
The NCLT has reserved its order on Torrent's plea, and it is unlikely to approve the resolution plan without delivering its final verdict on Torrent's



application. The second reason for NCLT likely to defer a decision is that the lenders

have not yet received an approval from RBI and CCI on IIHL's resolution plan, which is a prerequisite for

NCLT approval. In addition, the Supreme Court in August had adjourned the hearing on Torrent's application, which challenged the second round of auction, to October. Hence, NCLT may not like to take a final decision on the resolution plan approval till there is an absolute clarity on the matter from the apex court. Under the circumstances, the matter is most likely to be adjourned by the NCLT Mumbai. The IIHL's Rs 10,000 crore resolution plan for Reliance Capital was approved by the COC with 99.6 per cent voting on June 29. Post that, the plan was filed before NCLT for its final approval, but due to the litigation by Torrent Investment, the final approval will take some more time.

KOHLI, RAHUL TONS, KULDEEP'S 5-25 SETS UP INDIA'S MASSIVE 228-RUN WIN OVER PAKISTAN

Colombo | Agencies
Fantastic unbeaten centuries by Virat Kohli and K.L. Rahul, followed by a terrific five-wicket haul from Kuldeep Yadav helped India thrash archrivals Pakistan by 228 runs in a totally one-sided Super-Four match in the Asia Cup 2023 at the R. Premadasa Stadium here on Monday.

Resuming their assault on Pakistan on the reserve day starting at 4:40 pm after a rain delay, India reached a mammoth 356/2, their highest score against Pakistan in ODIs.

It was down to Rahul making a stunning comeback to international cricket with a classy 111 not out off 106 balls while Kohli combined astute running between the wickets with dazzling strokeplay to hit his fourth ODI century in as many innings at the venue through an unbeaten 122 off just 94 balls.

If Sunday saw Shubman Gill and Rohit Sharma pulverize the Pakistan bowling by hitting quick fifties in a



121-run opening stand, then Monday belonged to Rahul and Kohli sharing a huge 233-run stand for the third wicket, also the highest partnership

by any Indian pair in its participation history in the Asia Cup.

In reply, Pakistan were nowhere in the chase as only three of their batters managed to go past 20. India's fast bowlers were impeccable in their line and length while putting out a surreal exhibition of seam and swing bowling.

Kuldeep then came to bamboozle the batters and pick 5/25, his second fiver in ODIs, as Pakistan were restricted to just 128, with 228 runs being the highest margin of win for India against Pakistan in terms of runs.

Kohli smashes Tendulkar's record

Fastest 13,000 ODI runs

During his outstanding knock of 122 not out off just 94 balls against Pakistan in the Super Four stage of the Asia Cup at the R. Premadasa Stadium, talismanic India batter Virat Kohli completed 13,000 ODI runs, becoming the fifth player to reach the landmark in men's ODIs.

Sachin Tendulkar, Ricky Ponting, Sanath Jayasuriya and Mahela Jayawardene are the others before Kohli to reach the milestone. While Tendulkar took 321 innings to get to the mark, Kohli has reached the same in 267 innings, becoming the quickest to the milestone and breaking the legendary batter's record.

Ponting (341) and Sangakkara (363) took over 300 innings to while Jayasuriya reached the mark in 416 innings. Kohli, who also completed 1000 runs in international cricket this year, is also the only one among the five to average over 50. With 47 ODI hundreds, Kohli is also just two away from equalling Tendulkar's record tally of ODI tons.

Kohli, the No.3 batter, resumed from his score of seven overnight on the reserve day and survived an early review for caught behind off Naseem Shah's over. He looked in pristine touch thereafter, combining with a proactive K.L. Rahul to build over India's good start on Sunday.

Kohli took 55 balls to get to his half-century



but took only 29 more balls to get to his 47th ODI hundred. Rahul too, meanwhile, completed his ton on his return to international cricket to give India a strong total in Colombo. The Rahul-Kohli stand of 233 runs for the third wicket is also the highest partnership by any Indian pair in the history of the team's participation in the Asia Cup, as the side posted 356/2, also its highest score against Pakistan in ODIs.

US Open: Djokovic beats Medvedev to take historic 24th Grand Slam, reclaims top spot

Novak Djokovic won his fourth US Open and a record-tying 24th Grand Slam singles title after eliminating Daniil Medvedev in straight sets in the final here.

The battle between the second and the third seed saw Djokovic cruise past Medvedev 6-3, 7-6(5), 6-3. With the victory, the 36-year-old Serbian became the oldest US Open men's singles champion in the Open Era, reports Xinhua.

Having also won the Australian Open and the French Open this year, Djokovic became the first man to win three Grand Slams singles titles in a season four times.

"I never imagined that I would be here standing with you talking about 24 Slams. I



never thought that would be the reality," Djokovic said afterwards. "But the last couple of years, I felt I have a chance, I have a shot for his-

tory, and why not grab it if it's presented?"

The win also marked a revenge to Medvedev, who in 2021 in straight sets halted Djokovic's pace to become the first man to clinch all four Grand Slams in the same year since Rod Laver in 1969.

Following his victory, Djokovic reclaimed the world No.1 in men's singles ATP rankings on Monday, dethroning Spain's Carlos Alcaraz from the top with 11,975 points, 3260 points ahead of the Spaniard.

The 36-year-old made history again in New York, where he captured a record-equalling 24th Grand Slam title, matching Margaret Court's mark. The Serbian, who has now won the US Open four times, dropped just two sets en route to his fifth trophy of the season.

INDIA GEAR UP FOR DO-OR-DIE BATTLE AGAINST UAE

U23 Asian Cup Qualifiers

After the heartbreaking defeat against hosts China by a slender margin, India U23 are determined to turn things around in their last match in Group G against UAE in the AFC U23 Asian Cup Qualifiers here on Tuesday.

A win for UAE will take them to the top of the group since they drew 1-1 in their first game against China, while India will have to win by a big margin at the Dalian Sports Centre Stadium to keep alive their hopes of qualifying as one of the top four second-placed teams in the competition.

"I'm very pleased with the way my players have reacted after the game against China. Their attitude is fantastic and their dedication and professionalism are unwavering," said India U23 Head Coach Clifford Miranda.

"These are the things that matter the most, especially in the first train-



ing session after a defeat. The boys are hurt because of the loss and the manner in which we lost, but their attitude is extremely positive, and they are raring to go again with the same spirit in the next game against UAE," he told the official website of the All-India Football Federation (AIFF). Sharing his thoughts on the upcoming match against UAE, Miranda said: "UAE is both technical and physical, but I think we are capa-

ble enough to handle any kind of physicality. We are also very strong, even though we may be inferior in terms of height. There is no deterrent or excuse for matching up against the UAE."

When asked if there will be an attack-heavy approach to the last game, specifically because India will need to win big to give themselves a chance to qualify for the final round of the competition, the former India player said he believed it's a bit more complex than that.

"It's an international game and we can't just be thinking about scoring and leave openings that our opponents can capitalise on. The most important thing is to have a positive approach to go out and win the game but win the game with caution. We will assess the match-up and be careful in our approach. Of course, we need to play to win, but we need to win by being practical," Miranda was quoted as saying by aiff.com.

Germany wins FIBA World Cup for first time, Schroder awarded MVP

Germany defeated Serbia 83-77 to clinch its first FIBA Basketball World Cup title here. Dennis Schroder was named the Most Valuable Player (MVP) of the tournament.

Schroder, boasting an average of 17.6 points, 6.1 assists, and 2 rebounds throughout the World Cup, delivered a game-high 28 points in the final. Franz Wagner contributed 19 points and seven rebounds, while Johannes Voigtmann added 12 points and eight rebounds, reports Xinhua.

For Serbia, Aleksa Avramovic led the scoring with 21 points, and Bogdan Bogdanovic chipped in with 17 points and five assists. Nikola Milutinovic, however, struggled, missing all four of his attempts and ending the game with just two points and four assists.

The Mall of Asia Arena felt like a



home game for Serbia, thanks to their passionate fans. However, concerns arose early on when Ognjen Dobric sustained an injury and had to leave the court just three minutes into the game. Historically, in each of the previous five finals in the 21st century,

the team leading at half-time emerged victorious. But Sunday's final saw both teams tied at 47 points at halftime.

A pivotal moment occurred in the third quarter when a contentious foul was called on Aleksa Avramovic as he

attempted to block Schroder's shot from behind the arc. Capitalizing on it, Germany went on a 9-0 run after Schroder converted two of his three free throws. Serbia faced offensive challenges, scoring only 10 points in the quarter and lagging by 12 points into the final quarter.

Avramovic, however, ignited in the fourth quarter. The 28-year-old guard netted 16 points, helping Serbia reduce the deficit to just three points with 1:21 remaining.

Schroder, demonstrating resilience under pressure, executed a layup and sank two free throws to secure the victory for Germany.

Germany remained undefeated by winning all eight games, and became the fourth European country and seventh overall to win the world crown. It also marked the first time a nation clinched the FIBA World Cup title in its debut in the final since Spain faced Greece in 2006.

Golf: Diksha Dagar's run of Top-10 finishes ends with tied 21st spot in Big Green Egg Open

Diksha Dagar had another decent finish with a 2-under 70 card on the final day of the Big Green Egg Open in the Netherlands on the Ladies European Tour.

The 22-year-old left-hander, Diksha had rounds of 71-70-70 in a steady display, but not quite to maintain her run of Top-10 finishes.

Diksha, who had a late bogey, finished 5-under 211 and was Tied-21st. She had two birdies and one bogey on either side of the Hilversumsche Golf Club.

Despite a modest T-21 finish, Diksha stayed in third place in the Race to Costa Del Sol, the Order of Merit for the LET. It has been a great season so far for Diksha who has had one win and six Top-10 finishes with a consistent display on all fronts. She also notched up a career-best finish in a Major at T-21 in the AIG Women's Open.

As for the other Indians, Vani Kapoor (70) was T-39 at 1-under 215, while the other girls, Amandeep Drall, Tvesa Malik, Ridhima Dilawari and amateur Avani Prashanth had missed the cut. A thrilling final day saw Thai rookie Trichat Cheenglab landing her maiden LET title as she fired a 67 (-5) to win by one



shot. With seven players tied at the top before the final round, it was a close affair. In the 2023 Race to Costa del Sol, the top three players remained the same with Celine Boutier leading followed by Ana Pelaez Trivino in second and Diksha Dagar in third. Cheenglab moved into fourth on 1,317.72 points and extended her lead at the top of the Rookie of the Year standings.
