Nehru's 'Tryst with Destiny' speech will inspire future generations of lawmakers: Modi

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday, while delivering his last speech in the old Parliament House, said that the echo of nation's first prime minister Jawaharlal Nehru's iconic 'Tryst with Destiny' speech will always resound and continue to inspire the generations of future people's representatives. Recounting the 75 years of Parliament, the Modi said that during this period, around 7,500 MPs including 600 women MPs have represented the country during this period. Nehru, during his address to the nation on August 15, 1947, had said that, "At the stroke of the midnight hour, when the world sleeps, India will awake to life and freedom.'

"Today is an occasion to recollect and reminisce the Parliamentary journey of 75 years of India. We might be shifting to the new building but this building will keep on inspiring the coming generation as it is a golden chapter of the journey of Indian democracy," Modi said. "India will always feel pride for the inclusion of the African Union in G20 during its presidency," he added, while referring to the recently concluded Delhi G20 summit.

He informed the House that in the current 17th Lok Sabha, there is the oldest MP in Samajwadi Party's Shafiqur Rehman Barq, who is 93 years old, while in Chandramani Murmu of the Biju Janata Dal, the House has the youngest MP at 30 years. Nehru never mocked or deflected Opposition: Adhir Ranjan

New Delhi: After Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday hailed first Prime Minister Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru for his 'stroke of midnight' speech that made India, Congress MP Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury said that he was "tireless" in listening to the voice of the Opposition and "never mocked or deflected" when answering questions. Chowdhury also hailed Nehru's vision saying that in 1946 Atomic Research Committee was formed and from there, "we moved forward and developed ISRO in 1964". Speaking in the Lower House, Chowdhury said, "It is really an emotional moment for all of us to move out from this (old) Parliament building today. We are all present here to bid adieu to our old building."

Chowdhury, NDA's leader of the Rajya Sabha Piyush Goyal and leader of opposition in the Upper House Mallikarjun Kharge will speak, sources said.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, who is the leader of the Lok Sabha, will be present at the function but it is not clear if he will address the gather-

Meanwhile, the Lok Sabha was adjourned for the day on Monday after the culmination of the discussions on 75 years of Parliament.

Delhi HC allows DU to offer admissions to law courses based on CLAT result for current academic year

he Delhi High Court, in an interim order, on Monday allowed the Delhi University (DU) to offer admissions in its newly-introduced five-year integrated law courses based on Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) 2023 result only for the current academic year instead of implementing Common University Entrance Test (CUET) scores for admission.

A division bench of Chief Justice Satish Chandra Sharma and Justice Sanjeev Narula, which was dealing with a plea filed by law student Prince Singh from the DU's Law Faculty against DU's decision, passed the interim order keeping in mind that classes have already begun for the current academic year in all other universities.

The issue has now got the court into considering a broader question whether CUET should be mandatory for admissions in all Central Universities or if they should have the freedom to make decisions in the matter of admissions.

The court has appointed senior advocate Arun Bhardwaj as amicus curiae in the mat-

On September 12, the University Grants Commission (UGC) had told the high court that the five-year law course is a professional degree programme which may require differ ent criteria to grant admission to students. It had filed a counter affidavit in the matter wherein it has sought dismissal of the peti-

The UGC had said that the DU, with the approval of its Academic Council and Executive Council, has resolved to admit students through CLAT.

Even the Centre opposed the plea, saying the admission standards for professional courses like engineering, medicine, law etc are shaped by their specialised nature and specific skill and so are needed to be guided by the distinct prerequisites of each course.

While there are overarching policy guidelines, universities retain the flexibility through their competent bodies i.e. Academic Councils and Executive Councils to tailor these guidelines to suit the unique

demands of such professional courses," the

Centre said in its reply.

The National Education Policy (2020) also envisions governance of Higher Education Institutions by highly qualified independent Boards having academic and administrative autonomy...the relief as sought by the petitioner to quash the admission notice of University of Delhi may not be granted," it

On August 28, the Centre had informed the high court that for Central universities, the CUET is not compulsory, and they enjoy autonomy in the matter of admission. However, the UGC had taken a different stand and submitted that it is mandatory for all the Central Universities to adhere to the CUET score for admission to UG or PG courses. The court had then granted a weeks' time to the UGC as well as the Centre to file a detailed counter-affidavit in the matter.

It had also asked the DU to file a supplementary counter-affidavit in case it wants to, making it clear that if none is filed by the next date of hearing, the matter will be heard finally on interim relief.

The PIL argues that the DU decision creates a separate category of students eligible for admission. Additionally, CUET's inclusivity in terms of languages is highlighted, as opposed to CLAT's English-only format. The plea states that the CLAT exam has been conducted in English medium since its inception. However, the CUET (UG) exam is being conducted in 13 languages -- English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu.

" $I\bar{t}$ is worth noting here that the CUET is more inclusive, more diverse and in tune with the mandate of the National Educational Policy. It is not out of the place to mention here that the Respondent No. 1 uses two languages, i.e., English and Hindi in its teachings and semester exams," the plea says. The introduction of these law courses at DU had been in demand for a long, with the Bar Council of India (BCI) granting approval for 60 seats each in the BA.LL.B. (Hons) and BBA.LL.B. (Hons.) programmes. The university has said that sessions for both courses are scheduled at the Faculty of Law, Kanad Bhawan, in the North Campus.

RPF rescues 23 minors during 10-day drives against human trafficking

Guwahati: The Railway Protection Force (RPF) of Northeast Frontier Railway (NFR), which operates in



the northeastern states and in seven districts of West Bengal and five districts of north Bihar, rescued 23 minors during the drives against human trafficking in the past ten days, officials

said on Monday. NFR's Chief Public Relations Officer Sabyasachi De said that the 23 minors were rescued and apprehended one person involved in human trafficking from different trains and railway stations over the NF Railway jurisdiction. The drives were conducted at different locations in New Bongaigaon, New Jalpaiguri, Jalpaiguri Road, Samsi, Badarpur, Barsoi, Rangiya, Katihar and Dimapur railway stations.All the rescued persons were later handed over to the respective child lines as per norms for safe custody and family members after proper verification.

During the month of August, the RPF of NFR rescued 70 minor boys and girls and three women while one person involved in human trafficking was also arrested.

The RPF remains vigilant for suspected persons involved in human trafficking as well as the movement of children in a suspicious manner, travelling alone, without proper guardians.

Triathletes from 30 countries to participate in IRONMAN 70.3 India this October

riathletes and endurance sports enthusiasts from 30 countries will participate in the latest edition of the prestigious IRONMAN 70.3 India triathlon -- the country's biggest and truly international triathlon -- scheduled to be held in Goa next month.

This internationally acclaimed endurance race spread over three sports disciplines -- swimming, cycling and running -- is regarded as a global benchmark for the ultimate test of endurance, grit and an athlete's mental and physical strength.

The gruelling IRONMAN 70.3 India triathlon will begin with a 1.9 km swim off Miramar beach in Goa, followed by a 90 km bicycle ride, before concluding with a 21.1 km run; the latter two legs will start from the Miramar circle in

Panaji, the state capital. The race has a cut-off time of 8 hours and 30 minutes and each leg -- swimming, biking and the run also has its indi-

The triathlon is not just about competition, but also about the spirit of camaraderie and personal growth," he said.

Sena row: SC criticises Maharashtra Assembly Speaker for delay in ruling on disqualification petitions

he Supreme Court on Monday criticised the Maharashtra Assembly Speaker Rahul Narwekar on a plea filed by the Shiv Sena's Uddhay Thackeray faction against the delay by him in deciding the disqualification petitions filed against Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and his

A bench of Chief Justice D.Y. Chandrachud, JB Pardiwala. and Manoj Misra came down heavily on the issue of delays in ruling on disqualification of lawmakers who quit the Thackeray faction and aligned with the Shinde group.

The CJI said that the Speaker has to abide by the dignity of the Supreme Court, and that four months have passed since their judgement. "... and we are only at the stage of notice," he said.

The court asked what action had been taken following its May 11 judgement, wherein he was told to rule on the petitions within a "reasonable time"

The court remarked that the

Speaker could not continue to drag his feet and directed that he shall hear the concerned matter no later than a period of one

On July 14, the apex court had issued notice and called for responses of Narwekar and Shinde within a period of two

The plea filed by Shiv Sena-UBT leader Sunil Prabhu has alleged that the Speaker is delaying in deciding the disqualification pleas to permit "the illegal continuance of Eknath Shinde as Chief Minister, against whom the disqualification petitions are pending".

The Thackeray faction had moved the apex court on July 4 against the delay by the Speaker in deciding the disqualification petitions pending against Shinde and his camp. On May 11, a constitution bench of the Supreme Court had directed that the Maharashtra Speaker "must decide disqualification petitions in a reasonable time" against 16 Shiv Sena MLAs, including Shinde, who were accused of anti-party activities.

BJP chalks out 'ABCD' formula based on winnability in poll-bound Rajasthan

ith Assembly elections nearing in Rajasthan, the BJP is working on different strategies to return to power in the desert state.

Party leaders have confirmed that the 200 Assembly constituencies in the state will be divided into four categories -- A, B, C and D -- depending on the party's winnability in the respective seats.

While the seats with highest winnability factor have been included in 'A' secion, the lesser popular seats have been put under 'B' category. The seats weaker than 'B' section have been clubbed in 'C' category, while the weakest seats have been bracketed in 'D' category. The party will give top priority to the seats in A, B and C categories, party workers said.

The party workers also confirmed that the BJP's first list of candidates for the Assembly elections in



Rajasthan will be released after Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to

Jaipur on September 25. Earlier, there were speculation that middle of the 'Parivartan Yatra'. However, party workers have denied this possibility now.

In the first list, BJP can announce candidates for the A and D category seats, the strongest and the weakest. There are around 29 seats in A and 19 seats in D category, sources said.

The 'strong' BJP seats include Bundi, Kota South, Ladpura, Ramganjmandi, Jhalrapatan, Khanpur, Asind, Bhilwara, Udaipur, Rajsamand, Bikaner East, Ratangarh, Phulera, Vidyadhar Nagar, Malviya Nagar, Alwar City, Ajmer North, Ajmer South, Beawar, Nagaur, Sojat, Pali, Bali, Sursagar, Sanganer, Siwana, Bhinmal and two others.

He also recalled the contributions of first Prime Minister Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru and recalled how it was here that Pandit Nehru, gave his 'Tryst With Destiny' speech which "will continue to inspire us".



Even Leader of Opposition in Rajya Sabha and Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge during the day also took a pot shot at Modi and said that former Prime Ministers Atal Bihari Vajpayee gave statements 21 times, and Manmohan Singh gave statements 30 times during their tenure while apart from a few "customary comments", Prime Minister Modi made a statement only twice.

Delhi court to hear Gehlot's application against defamation case on Oct 14

A Delhi court has posted Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot's application against a defamation case filed against him by Jal Shakti Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat for hearing on October 14.

The case pertains to alleged "misleading statements" made by Gehlot in connection with the Sanjivani Credit Cooperative Society scam in Rajasthan.

On the joint request of both the parties' advocates, special MP-MLA court judge M.K. Nagpal of the Rouse Avenue Court posted the matter for arguments on October 14.

On September 14, a magisterial court had posted the next hearing of Shekhawat's case against Gehlot for September 19.

Both Gehlot and Shekhawat had appeared before the court of Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (ACMM) Harjeet Singh

During arguments, the counsels for both Shekhawat and Gehlot had placed on record various judgements made by the apex court, as the court took on record the fresh 'Vakalatnama' filed on behalf of the

complainant. Earlier, the court had directed the

complaint. Jaspal had said that the investiga-

tion should be such that the three main questions -- whether complainant Shekhawat was addressed as an accused" in the Sanjivani scam by the accused Gehlot, whether Gehlot stated that the allegations against Shekhawat stand proved in the

Sanjivani scam, and whether Shekhawat or his family members have been arrayed as "accused" in the investigation of the scam -- are

Shekhawat had filed the defamation case against Gehlot in March this year, stating that an investigation was initiated into the Sanjivani case but his name was not mentioned anywhere, and demanded the prosecution of Gehlot for criminal defamation under the relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC).

He also demanded appropriate financial compensation for the loss of his reputation.

Gehlot had said after a budget review meeting at the state secretariat on February 21 that the entire Shekhawat family, including his parents and wife, were involved in the Sanjeevani scam.

Gehloit had also welcomed the filing of the defamation case, saying: "At least the case will move forward on

DELHI L-G MAKES IT MANDATORY TO GEO-TAG EVERY PROJECT ON ONLINE PORTAL

n a move aimed at curbing corruption, cost escalation and delays in execution of civil works in various Delhi government departments, Lieutenant Governor (L-G) V.K. Saxena has made it mandatory to geo-tag each and every project on an online portal developed by the IT Department of the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (GNCTD).

The L-G office said that from now on, it will also be mandatory to upload before and after colour photographs of all such projects for evaluation and any payment to the contractors will only be made after their verification by the authorities.

This initiative would not only bring transparency, but will also be effective in checking misuse of funds, corruption, and ensure quality and timely completion of the projects/ works. Regular uploads in the form of photographs on the portal will also



help in regular and timely monitoring of the projects by the concerned authorities," the L-G office said.

While approving the proposal of Directorate of Vigilance to this effect, the L-G noted that the IT Department of the GNCTD has developed a portal

for monitoring of the projects, but most of the departments are not using it for monitoring of their projects/works.

The L-G further directed that all head of the departments of the GNCTD shall ensure geo-tagging of all projects and works along with uploading of progress report with colour photographs, mandatorily on online portal developed by the IT Department in this regard (https://delhiemonitoring.calibrewebsol.com/), before release of any payment for any project/work.

This, he noted, apart from serving the requirements of vigilance, will also enable the use of IT in monitoring of progress of works and related expenditure, which will help keep a strict vigil on the spending of government money.

It may be noted that at present, geo-tagging and uploading of project status online has been made mandatory by several state governments for their respective schemes.

Arunachal Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh and Kerala, as well as Union ministries/departments for their schemes like Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, MGNREGA, Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram etc. have been using the technology of geo-tagging.

'Organisational structures' not necessary to take process forward: CPI-M on INDIA committees



Sena row: SC criticises Maharashtra Assembly Speaker for delay in ruling on disqualification petitions

he Supreme Court on Monday criticised the Maharashtra Assembly Speaker Rahul Narwekar on a plea filed by the Shiv Sena's Uddhav Thackeray faction against the delay by him in deciding the disqualification petitions filed against Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and his camp.

A bench of Chief Justice D.Y. Chandrachud, JB Pardiwala. and Manoj Misra came down heavily on the issue of delays in ruling on disqualification of lawmakers who quit the Thackeray faction and aligned with the Shinde group.

The CJI said that the Speaker has to abide by the dignity of the Supreme Court, and that four months have passed since their judgement.

... and we are only at the stage of notice," he said.

The court asked what action had been taken following its May 11 judgement, wherein he was told to rule on the petitions within a "reason-

The court remarked that the Speaker could not continue to drag his feet and directed that he shall hear the concerned matter no later than a period of one week.

On July 14, the apex court had issued notice and called for responses of Narwekar and Shinde within a period of two weeks.

The plea filed by Shiv Sena-UBT leader Sunil Prabhu has alleged that the Speaker is delaying in deciding the disqualification pleas to permit "the illegal continuance of Eknath




Shinde as Chief Minister, against whom the disqualification petitions are pending".

The Thackeray faction had moved the apex court on July 4 against the delay by the Speaker in deciding the disqualification petitions pending against Shinde and his camp. On May 11, a constitution bench of the Supreme Court had directed that the Maharashtra Speaker "must decide disqualification petitions in a reasonable time" against 16 Shiv Sena MLAs, including Shinde, who were accused of anti-party activities.

In its judgement, the top court had refused to reinstate Uddhav Thackery as the Chief Minister as he had tendered his resignation voluntarily before facing the floor test in the House. The five judges unanimously had held that then Governor Bhagat Singh Koshyari was not justified in calling upon Thackeray to prove his majority, but said that it was justified to invite Shinde to form the government after the post of the Chief Minister fell vacant as Thackeray tendered resignation on June 29.

Declaring the decision taken by the Speaker to recognise Bharat Gogawale (from Shinde faction) as the Chief Whip of Shiv Sena in place of Prabhu as "contrary to law", the CJI Chandrachud-led constitution bench had held that the political party and not the legislature party appoints the Whip and the Leader of the party in

Inaugurated on September 8, the Anandache Shidha comprises 1-kg each cooking oil, rava, chana-dal and sugar, costing Rs 100/per family which holds two types of ration-cards. Around 1.57crore Anandache Shidha kits will be distributed to benefit around 7.50 crore people, said Food & Civil Supplies Minister Chhagan Bhujbal at the inauguration. However, in Solapur and other places, the beneficiaries have objected to the oil packet ostensibly manufac-



tured and supplied by Kirti Agrotech Ltd. Solapur, whose manufacturing licence has been cancelled.

"The oil packets have expired and many people threw them away in the drains as it could be dangerous to consume such oil," alleged a Shiv Sena (UBT) Consumer Protection Cell activist from Solapur, Mallinath Mali.

When contacted, the governmentauthorised Tandulwadi ration shop owner, Vishwajeet J. Meru denied that the oil packets had expired but admitted that the status of the company's manufacturing licence is now under a cloud.

"Some of the oil packets which I have in stock mention the expiry date after six

months (February 2024). However, we have learnt now that the company's license was cancelled some months ago. Yet, we were supplied the cooking oil from them which we have distributed in the Anandache Shidha kits as per the government norms," Meru told reporter.

Despite repeated attempts by reporter, the company owners comprising the Bhutada brothers -- Ashok, Kirti and Bharat -- were not available for their comments in the matter. The Sena (UBT) carried out an agitation in Solapur and Mumbai on this issue and accused the government of cheating the gullible customers in the name of a festival discount kit. Monday morning the Tandulwadi Deputy Sarpanch Lingaraj C. Patil and others rushed to the ration shop and stopped the sale/distribution of the ration kits. Mali claimed that the Kirti Agrotech Ltd., has many complaints with the Centre, the FDA in Mumbai, the district Collector and even the state government, and its licence had been suspended many months ago.

🕆 iddhi Vinayak Lord Ganesha was born on Bhadrapada Shukla Chaturthi. Ganesha was born as the son of Shiva-Parvati. On his birth, all the gods from Heaven came to bless Him. Lord Vishnu blessed Him with knowledge, Brahma blessed him with fame and worship, Dharmadev blessed him with religiosity and mercy. Lord Shiva blessed Him with generosity, intelligence, strength and self-control. Goddess Lakshmi said, "Wherever Ganesha lives, I will live there.' Saraswati provided Him with speech, memory and oratory power. Savitri gave wisdom. The Trinity gave Ganesha the boon of being the most revered, the first god and the provider of Riddhi-Siddhi. That is why He is a god with universal, eternal and worldwide popularity. They are embedded in cultures ranging from India including Sindh and Tibet to Japan and Sri

In the Jain sect, He is present as the Ganadhyaksha who compiles the knowledge, while the Vajrayana branch of Buddhism believes that mantra accomplishment cannot be achieved without praising Ganesha. Nepalese and Tibetan Vajrayani Buddhists place Ganesha next to the idol of their revered Tathagata. Actually, Ganesha is the presiding deity of happiness-prosperity, wealth, joy, knowledge and auspiciousness. In this world, favourable happens with unfavourable, good happens with inauspicious, knowledge happens with ignorance, happiness happens with sorrow. Ganesha is the saviour for man troubled by adversity, inauspiciousness, ignorance and sorrow. He is a Satvik deity and a remover of all obstacles. They are not only prevalent in every part of Indian culture and lifestyle, but are also present in homes, cars, offices and product centers in foreign countries. Ganesha is present everywhere. Lord Ganesha is worshiped and revered first for man's success in his daily work, for happiness and prosperity, for development of intelligence and knowledge and for the smooth completion of any auspicious work. Apart from being the first god, his personality is multi-dimensional. He is the character of a folk hero.

Lord Ganesha is an integral part of Indian culture. From ancient times, Hindu society has been starting any work with the worship of Lord Ganesha to finish it smoothly. Indian culture has flourished with the vast imagination of one God and the worship of many gods and goddesses. There is a rule to worship Ganapati before worshiping all other gods. Actually, Ganesha is the presiding deity of happiness, prosperity, splendor and joy. All types of worldly tasks, big and ordinary, are started by remembering His divine form. Traders start the new-year by writing 'Shri Ganeshaya Namah' on their ledgers. Every work is started with Ganpati worship and Ganesh vandana. Be it the auspicious occasion of marriage or the laying of the foundation stone of a new house, the celebration of the consecration of an idol in a temple or the occasion of Shodas Sanskar in life, Ganpati is remembered first. According to the Skanda Purana, one who worships Ganesha with devotion never faces any obstacles. Ganpati, Ganesh or Vinayak-all mean the lord or leader of the gods. There are descriptions of different forms of Ganesha at different places, but everywhere the power of Ganesha to remove obstacles has been unanimously accepted.

The shape of Ganesha is strange, but if we try to understand the mystery of the spiritual symbols of this shape, we



can get eternal benefits. Because Ganesha i.e. son of Shiva or Shivatva has to be achieved, otherwise the wish for welfare and profit will not be successful. If we explain Gajanan Ganesh, we will know that 'Gaj' is made up of two consonants. 'J' is the symbol of birth or origin, and 'G' is the symbol of movement and destination. That is, the word 'Gaj' indicates origin and end - you will go back to where you came from. What is birth is also death. Gajanan Ganesh is the one who creates the reality of Brahma and the world. Lord Shiva's comprehensive thinking is behind the entire physical structure of Ganesha. All the qualities of an efficient, just and powerful ruler and god are included in Him. Ganeshji's yard is the head, that is, he is the God of Intelligence. His memory power is very sharp. The Elephant's Myth: The origin of his instinctive inspiration lies in a serious, calm and steady consciousness. Elephant's eyes are relatively small and it is very difficult to understand the expressions in those eyes. Actually Ganesha is the ideal form of a philosopher. The leader of the group should have gravity and seriousness. That gravity is inherent in his physical body. His huge body also inspires to be alert and always ready to face all situations and difficulties. His Lambodar (large tummy) teaches one to absorb the secrets, evils and weaknesses of others, and keeps all kinds of condemnation and criticism in one's stomach, and inspires one to remain firm on the path of duty. His small face indicates being small, logical and soft-spoken.

Ganesha's personality is mysterious, which is not possible for everyone to read and understand. Only that ruler is successful whose feelings cannot be read and understood. In this way, a good ruler is the one who can read the minds of others well, however no one can understand his mind. In fact, he is

also a symbol of bravery, courage and leadership. In his Heramb form one can see his love for war, in his Vinayak form he is seen as fierce as the Yakshas and in his Vighneshwar form he is seen as a people-oriented and charitable person. Gana means group. Ganesh is the lord of the group, that is why he is called by names like Ganadhyaksha, Loknayak,

The ears on the Gaj mouth also symbolize that the ruler should always keep his ears open to listen to the public. If the ruler closes his ears to the public, he will never be successful. The ruler should be as powerful and self-respecting as an elephant. The ruler should neither depend on anyone, nor know his sources of income for the maintenance of himself and his family. An elephant can lift everything with the help of its trunk and nourish Himself without bending. The ruler should not bow before others under any circumstances

By making it his vehicle, Ganapati has enhanced his dignity and given the message that Gananayak should have affection towards even the most insignificant person. The four arms of Lord Ganesha give knowledge of four types of devotees, four types of creation and four efforts.

Ganeshji is considered to be the first scribe. He transcribed the epic of Mahabharata written by Rishi Ved Vyasji on the request of the gods. There is a tradition of worshiping Ganesha in Jain and Buddhist religions also. Ganesha is also considered as Adidev in Hindu culture. From time immemorial, Ganesha has been worshiped in many names as the remover of sorrow, fear, worry, etc. and has been removing the troubles of humans. Siddhi gave birth to two beautiful sons named 'Kshem' and Riddhi gave birth to 'Labh'. While Lord Ganesha is the remover of obstacles, his wives are the ones who make people successful, prosperous and prestigious. At the same time, auspicious benefits along with giving every happiness and good fortune keep it permanent and safe. ers in 2015 and as they meet on Monday halfway to 2030, they will find most are need reinvigorated commitments, espe-

cially from the industrialised nations. Symbolically, this meeting starts a day before the traditional General Assembly meeting which will begin by tradition on Tuesday, with the first address by Brazil's President Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva, to be followed by President Joe Biden.

Biden will be the only top leader of a permanent member of the Security Council this week at the UN.

Presidents Xi Jinping of China, Vladimir Putin of Russia and Emmanuel Macron of France, and Prime Minister Rishi Sunak of Britain are skipping the summits, as is Prime Minister Narendra Modi of India.

They were killed at 3 p.m. local time when a Turkish drone attacked their vehicle on a road in the Chalmir area of Sinjar mountain, nearly 120 km west of Nineveh's provincial capi tal Mosul, the statement said on Sunday.

The Turkish forces frequently carry out ground operations, airstrikes, and artillery bombardments in northern Iraq against the PKK, especially in the Qandil mountains, the main base of the group, Xinhua news agency reported.

BRAZIL: 14 DEAD IN AMAZON PLANE CRASH

Sao Paulo: At least 14 people were killed when a small plane crashed in Barcelos, an inland city of Amazonas state in northern Brazil, local authorities have said.

"They were all tourists who were going on a fishing trip," Amazonas governor Wilson Lima told a press conference on Saturday, adding that initial information showed all the tourists were Brazilian, Xinhua news agency reported. It was reported that the pilot had trouble finding the run-

way for landing in Barcelos, a sport fishing destination. The Manaus Aerotaxi airline, owner of the crashed Embraer EMB 110 Bandeirante, a Brazilian twin-turboprop light transport aircraft, confirmed the accident in a social media statement. According to Barcelos mayor Edson Mendes, Civil Defense teams found 14 bodies, which included 12 passengers, the pilot, and the co-pilot.

Iran won't relinquish share in disputed offshore gas field: Oil minister

In March 2022, Saudi Arabia and Kuwait signed an agreement to jointly develop the field, but Iran has



denounced the agreement as illegal and said it violated previous negotia-

In July, Kuwait said it would commence drilling and gas production at the gas field without waiting for it to be officially demarcated with Iran.

China flies 103 military planes towards Taiwan in a new high of activity

Taipei | Agencies

n 24-hour period, China's military sent 103 warplanes towards Taiwan, which the island's defense ministry claimed on Monday was a new daily record in recent times. The planes were noticed between 6 a.m. on Sunday and 6 a.m. on Monday, the ministry said. As is customary, they turned back before reaching Taiwan. China, which asserts Taiwan as part of its territory, has conducted increasingly large military drills in the air and waters around Taiwan as tensions have grown between the two and with the United States. The US, which is Taiwan's main supplier of arms, opposes any attempt to change Taiwan's status through force. Taiwan's Defense Ministry said that 40 of the planes crossed the symbolic halfway point between mainland China and the island. It also reported nine naval vessels in the last 24 hours.

The ministry called the Chinese military action "harassment" and warned that it could escalate the current tense atmosphere. "We urge the Beijing authorities to bear



responsibility and immediately stop such kind of destructive military activities," it said in a statement.'

China last week sent a flotilla of ships including the aircraft carrier Shandong into waters near Taiwan. The drills came shortly after the US and Canada sailed warships through the Taiwan Strait, the waters that separate the island from the mainland.

China also revealed a plan for an integrated development demonstration zone with Taiwan in China's nearby Fujian province, trying to entice Taiwan while also warning it. Experts say it is China's long-running carrot and stick approach. The recent actions by China may be an attempt to sway

Taiwan's presidential election slated to be held in January. The ruling Democratic Progressive Party, which leans towards formal independence for the island, is anathema to the Chinese government. China favours opposition candidates who support working with the mainland

Taiwan and China split in 1949 when the communists took control of China during a civil war. The losing Nationalists fled to Taiwan and set up their own government in the island. The island is self-governing, though only a few foreign nations give it official diplomatic recognition. The US among others has formal ties with China while it maintains a representative office in

IISER BHOPAL TEAM CONDUCTS GENOME SEQUENCING OF INDIAN GOOSEBERRY PLANT

esearchers from the Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER) Bhopal have for the first time unravelled the draft genome of the Indian gooseberry plant, popularly known as Amla.

Understanding the genetic composition of Amla can help us understand their origins, evolution, and how they create the biochemicals that are of medicinal value.

While Amla holds significant pharmaceutical and nutritional importance, its genetic composition has hitherto not been studied in detail. "We analysed the genome and transcriptome of the amla plant using leaves from our campus. We employed advanced sequencing technologies, including 10x Genomics and Oxford Nanopore Technology (ONT) long-read sequencing, along with transcriptomic sequencing," said lead researcher Dr Vineet Sharma, Associate Professor of Biological

Sciences at IISER Bhopal, in a statement. Amla is a well-known plant indigenous to South Asian countries and has been used in traditional Indian and Chinese medicine and home remedies for centuries.

The stone-fruit of the Amla tree is believed to have high itamin C content in addition to being a rich source ous phytochemicals, minerals, and amino acids. Amla has been thought to be effective in treating conditions like unhealthy levels of fat, Type-2 diabetes, chronic gum diseases,

symptomatic knee osteoarthritis, and more. Apart from obtaining the draft genome structure of the Amla for the first time, the researchers also identified genes responsible for vitamin C biosynthesis and compared them with genes in other plants that bear vitamin C-rich fruits.

The team found that Amla's exceptional antioxidant power comes from the adaptive evolution of certain genes involved in the production of antioxidants like vitamin C and flavonoids. Amla's abundant vitamin C content and the remarkable capacity of each tree to yield up to 100 kg of fruits make it superior to other vitamin C-rich fruits such as the West Indian cherry from Mexico and the camu camu fruit found in Brazil, Peru, Colombia, and Venezuela and makes it a perfect choice for switching from the synthetic to a natural source of Vitamin C. According to the research team, the adaptive evolution of this plant could be one of the key reasons for its easy adaptation to various climatic zones and environmental conditions.

The British pair saved another match point on Skupski's serve at 6-5 before converting their second opportunity in the deciding tie-break.

The World No. 27 Evans was competing in his 25th Davis Cup tie, drawing level with third-placed Andy Murray on the most played by a British player.

Two golds and one bronze medal later, As India gear up to play their 57th match at the Asian Games, the first in nine years, Chhetri and Sandesh Jhingan, who were part of

the Incheon 2014 squad, know exact-

Games football is. While six teams participated in the inaugural games in New Delhi, Hangzhou will have 21 participants battling for the podium.
