AAP-Congress's candidate Kuldeep Kumar declared as Chandigarh Mayoral poll winner

CHEERS FOR SUPREME COURT

Setting aside the election of the BJP candidate as declared by the Returning Officer, the Supreme Court on Tuesday declared AAP councillor Kuldeep Kumar as the Mayor of Chandigarh Municipal Corporation during the hearing on the contentious Chandigarh mayoral election case.

The apex court was dealing with a plea filed by INDIA bloc's mayoral candidate Kuldeep Kumar accusing Returning Officer Anil Masih of allegedly "defacing the ballots" during the Chandigarh mayoral polls held on January 30. Kumar had accused the Returning Officer of resorting to fraud and forgery in the counting process.

"Setting aside the election process itself would not be proper since the issue is only when the Returning Officer made the counting," a bench comprising Chief Justice D.Y. Chandrachud and justices J.B. Pardiwala and Manoj Misra observed.

The court also ordered prosecution of Returning Officer Masih for 'misdemeanour'.

"It is evident that Anil Masih is guilty of serious misdemeanour for deliberately defacing eight ballot papers. He must be held accountable" the CJI said. Contempt proceedings has been initiated against Masih.

On Monday, the top court had said that it would examine the ballot papers of the Chandigarh Mayoral polls along with the entire video recording of the counting day on Tuesday, citing concerns about potential horse-trading.

Expressing the need for transparency and fairness in the electoral process, CJI Chandrachud stressed the importance of scrutinising the invalidated ballots.

On Monday, the court had directed the



Registrar General of the Punjab and Haryana High Court to assign a judicial officer to safely transport the records to Delhi.

CJI Chandrachud had stressed the urgency of the matter and declined a plea to postpone the hearing, citing ongoing horse-trading concerns.

Masih, appearing before the bench, had admitted to marking eight already defaced ballot papers with an 'X' and accused AAP councillors of creating disturbance during the process.

Masih had said that he had to monitor the situation via CCTV due to the disruptions caused by the AAP councillors.

The top court had summoned the official in question to remain present before it on Monday to explain his conduct.

After perusal of the CCTV footage given in the pen drive by senior advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi, representing the AAP councillor, CJI Chandrachud had orally observed: "This is a mockery of democracy. He is murdering democracy. Is this the behaviour of a Returning Officer, who looks at the camera and defaces the ballot? It is obvious that he defaced the ballots. This man has to be prosecuted."

Deferring the February 7 meeting of the Corporation, the Supreme Court had ordered that the entire record pertaining to the election, including ballot papers and videography footage, would be sequestered under the custody of the Registrar General of the Punjab and Haryana High Court.

The AAP and Congress' joint candidate

Kuldeep Kumar had petitioned the top court after the Punjab and Haryana High Court refused to stay the election results for the post of Mayor.

In his petition before the high court, Kuldeep Kumar had alleged complete departure from the practice and rules, saying that the Returning Officer refused to allow the nominees of parties to monitor the counting of votes. He also prayed for fresh elections in a free and fair manner under the supervision of a retired high court judge.

RETURNING OFFICER SERVED NOTICE

New Delhi: The returning officer at the centre of Chandigarh vote-tampering row is guilty of misdemeanour and made a deliberate attempt to deface eight ballot papers so that BJP's candidate is elected the city's mayor, the Supreme Court held today.

The court has now directed contempt of court proceedings against the officer, Anil Masih. A showcause notice has been issued, and he has been asked to file a response in Punjab and Haryana High Court within three weeks. The returning officer was earlier removed as a member of the BJP's minority cell in the wake of a massive row over a video of him tampering with the ballot papers after the January 30 election.

The bench, led by Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud, noted that all the eight ballot papers declared invalid by returning officer Anil Masih were in the favour of AAP candidate and petitioner Kuldeep Kumar. The court has now ordered that Mr Kumar will now take over as Chandigarh mayor.

Maha Assembly unanimously passes 10% Maratha quotas bill

The Maharashtra Legislative Assembly unanimously passed the Maratha Reservation Bill giving 10 per cent quotas to the community in education and government jobs, here on Tuesday.

The Bill was introduced in the assembly at the Special Session of the Legislature this afternoon and Chief Minister Eknath Shinde detailed the government's position on the quotas issue.

Now, the Marathas will be entitled to 10 per cent reservations in educational institutions and in state government jobs, fulfilling a long-pending demand of the community.

Addressing the House, Shinde said that he was a soldier of the late

Balasaheb Thackeray and would stick to his word, and said he felt proud to introduce the reservation for the Maratha community.

"This is the victory of the movement launched by (Shivba Sanghatana leader) Manoj Jarange-Patil, and is a day of fulfilment of the aspirations of the Marathas. This has been done without doing injustice to any other community including the OBCs or disturbing their quotas," said Shinde.

He assured that this reservation will stand legal scrutiny before the courts and everybody had worked very hard to finalise it to ensure justice to the Marathas, as the Bill was passed without any opposition with thumping of desks.

Sonia Gandhi elected as RS MP for first time

Congress leader Sonia Gandhi was elected as Rajya Sabha MP for the first time in Rajasthan and two candidates from the BJP, Chunni Lal Garasiya and Madan Rathore were elected unanimously from the state, confirmed Election Commission officials on Tuesday.

Mahavir Prasad Sharma, Principal Secretary of Rajasthan Legislative Assembly and Returning



Officer of Rajya Sabha, declared that all three candidates from Rajasthan had

been elected unopposed in the Rajya Sabha biennial elections. After the deadline for withdrawal of nominations passed, the election officer announced the victory of all three candidates.

After the announcement, Chunni Lal Garasiya and Madan Rathore received their certificates while Sonia Gandhi's agent received the certificate on her behalf.

As of now, out of 10 Rajya Sabha seats in the state, six seats are with the Congress and four are with the BJP.

'MAKESHIFT TANKS', IRON SHEETS: FARMERS' PLAN TO CROSS HARYANA BORDER

The protesting farmers from Punjab have rejected the Centre's proposal to buy three types of pulses, maize and cotton at the old MSP and their march to Delhi will continue tomorrow. The police and paramilitary forces have geared up to stop the convoy with multi-layer fortifications at the Shambhu border between Punjab and Haryana and other checkpoints that lead to the national capital.

Concrete barriers, barbed wires and large shipping containers are part of the multi-layer blockade by the administration. The cops have cemented nail strips on the highway to stop the movement of tractors and other vehicles by the farmers. Four years ago, farmers in large



numbers had camped at various Delhi borders for months and the cops, anticipating a similar scenario, had taken such measures.

The farmers have created a makeshift "tank" to counter the measures and continue their 'Dilli Chalo' march.

TALKS FAIL, MARCH RESUMES

Protesting farmers rejected the government's proposal of a five-year contract to buy maize, cotton and three types of pulses at the old minimum support price. The announcement by the protesting farmers came hours after the Sanyukt Kisan Morcha, an umbrella organisation of farmer unions, which is not part of the current protests, also criticised the MSP proposal. Laying out the reasons for rejecting the proposal, farmer leader Jagjit Singh Dallewal said in Hindi, "The government proposed (on Sunday night) and we have studied it. It doesn't make sense for the MSP to apply to only two or three crops and for the other farmers to be left to fend for themselves."

SP's final offer, INDIA unity in up hinges on Congress reply

Signs of fresh trouble for the INDIA Opposition bloc in Uttar Pradesh, seat-sharing talks between the Samajwadi Party and Congress have hit a roadblock. The Akhilesh Yadav-led party, sources said, has made a final offer of 17 seats, but the Congress is yet to accept it. Yadav has so far stayed away from the Rahul Gandhi-led Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra, which is moving through Uttar Pradesh, and said his party will join the yatra once the seat-sharing arrangement for Lok Sabha polls is finalised. The Congress has been trying to

drive a hard bargain in the politically significant state. The Samajwadi Party had first offered 11 seats to the Grand Old Party. But with the Jayant Chaudhary-led Rastriya Lok Dal switching to the NDA camp, the Samajwadi Party agreed to give 15 seats to the Congress. The latter bargained for more and Samajwadi Party offered Saharanpur and Amroha seats too, reportedly on the request of Congress's Priyanka Gandhi Vadra. Then, sources said, Congress asked for Moradabad or Bijnor seat. The Samajwadi Party put its foot down on a final 17-seats offer, and the talks stalled. "We have had several rounds

of discussions, exchanged many lists. When the seat-sharing is done, Samajwadi Party will participate in their Nyay yatra," Yadav said yesterday. The Samajwadi Party leader, sources said, is waiting for a reply from the Congress leadership. Yadav wants the Congress to reply before the first leg of Rahul Gandhi's Yatra ends. If Congress does not seal the deal in the next three days, the alliance is likely to fall apart, the sources said.

Amid the tussle between the allies, Samajwadi Party spokesperson Fakhru Hassan Chand posted on X that the Congress will be responsible if the alliance gets derailed.

Modi launches India's longest transportation tunnel in Jammu and Kashmir

The longest transportation tunnel of the country on the Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla Rail Link (USBRL) was opened by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday as he flagged off the first electrified trains of the Kashmir valley. "Prime Minister Modi was present in Jammu and he virtually flagged off two electrified trains simultaneously -- one from Srinagar to Sangaldan in the down direction and the other from Sangaldan to Srinagar in the up direction," a railway official said. Over 100 school children and



their teachers took the inaugural trip from each side as special guests. The official added that the

prime minister also inaugurated the 48.1-km-long Banihal-Khari-Sumber-Sangaldan section. "This

longest tunnel, which is 12.77 km long and known as T-50, falls between the Khari-Sumber section," the official said.

According to the Northern Railway (NR), trains can now run from Baramulla to Sangaldan via Banihal, which used to be the last or originating station earlier.

T-50 is supposed to be the most challenging of the 11 tunnels in the Banihal-Khari-Sumber-Sangaldan section. According to railway officials associated with the project, the tunnel survey work started around 1996 but the tender was awarded in December 2013 so it took around 10 years to operationalise it.

TEJAS JET FLIES SUCCESSFULLY WITH INDIA-MADE DIGITAL FLIGHT CONTROL SYSTEM

An indigenously developed digital fly-by-wire flight control computer was integrated into the Tejas light combat jet, the defence ministry said on Tuesday, describing it as a "significant development" in the aircraft programme.

The home-grown Tejas is a single-engine multi-role fighter aircraft capable of operating in high-threat air environments. It has been designed to undertake air defence, maritime reconnaissance and strike roles.

"In a significant development towards Tejas Mk1A programme, the digital fly-by-wire flight control computer (DFCC) was integrated into prototype LSP7 and successfully flown on February 19," the defence ministry said. The DFCC has been indigenously developed by the Aeronautical Development Establishment (ADE), Bengaluru, for the Tejas-Mk1A version. All critical parameters and performance of the flight controls were found satisfactory, the ministry said in a state-



ment. The maiden flight was piloted by Wing Commander Siddarth Singh KJM (Retd) of the National Flight Test Centre. The Indian Air Force has already operationalised Tejas LCA Mk1.

The improved version of the aircraft, Tejas Mk1A features an advanced mission computer, high-performance digital flight control computer (DFCC Mk1A), smart multi-function displays (SMFD), advanced electronically scanned array (AESA) radar, advanced self-protection jammer, and electronic warfare suit among others, the ministry said. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh complimented joint teams from the Defence Research and Development Organisation, the IAF, ADA and industries involved in the development and successful flight test of this critical system for Tejas Mk1A. Singh described it as a major step towards 'atmanirbharta' (self-reliance) with a reduced count of special imports.

Tejas aircraft are set to be the mainstay of the IAF. It has already inducted nearly 40 Tejas of initial variants. In February 2021, the defence ministry sealed a Rs 48,000 crore deal with Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd for procurement of 83 Tejas Mk-1A jets for the IAF. In November, the ministry accorded an initial approval to procure an additional batch of 97 Tejas jets for the IAF.



AMIT SHAH SOUNDS POLL BUGLE IN RAJASTHAN, REITERATES 400-SEAT TARGET

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Tuesday sounded the poll bugle for the upcoming Lok Sabha elections from Bikaner in Rajasthan during his day-long tour of the desert state.

Addressing a gathering of party workers that was attended by Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma and other senior leaders from the nearby constituencies, Shah shared the strategies to achieve the party's target of winning 400 seats in the coming Lok Sabha polls.

He also urged the party workers to ensure that the BJP wins all the 25 Lok Sabha seats in Rajasthan.

Those who attended the event included MPs, MLAs, former MLAs, district heads and Mayors, along with members of the management committee, steering committee and core committee of the three Lok Sabha constituencies in the area.

Later, the Home Minister visited Udaipur where he reiterated the party's goal of winning more than 400



seats in the Lok Sabha polls.

"There should be no mistake anywhere. The BJP had won all the seats in Rajasthan in 2014 and 2019 (its ally Rashtriya Loktantrik Party had won one seat in 2019), and the same should be repeated this time too," Shah said.

Shah also accused the Congress of working to divide the country.

"The Congress is bent on dividing the country. Their leaders want that North India and South India should be divided. You have a double-engine government in Rajasthan, where no one has the courage to incite commu-

nal tension anymore," Shah said.

Praising the Narendra Modi government at the Centre, Shah said, "Narendra Modi took our economy from 11th to fifth position in 10 years. Once we get another chance, the economy will jump to the number three spot."

Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma said, "We will win every seat in the state by more than 5 lakh votes in the upcoming Lok Sabha elections."

State BJP chief C.P. Joshi said, "Former minister Mahendra Singh Malviya has joined the BJP because Congress did not allow him to attend the Pran Pratishtha ceremony of the Ram Temple in Ayodhya.

At the Prabuddhajan Sammelan in Udaipur on Monday, former state minister and tribal leader Mahendra Singh Malviya joined the BJP from the Congress, and claimed that he also has influence in Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat.

"I will go there and make the tribal brothers and sisters working in the Congress join the BJP," he had said.

The district administration of Gurugram is going to organise a Mega Marathon event in Gurugram on February 25.

Cricketer Shikhar Dhawan will be the brand ambassador for the event while the Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar will also join the event.

The official said that more than 27,000 people have registered themselves for the Gurugram marathon. "This number is expected to increase to around 40,000," he said.

Deputy Commissioner of Gurugram Nishant Kumar Yadav said that this is going to be the biggest mega marathon event of the entire country. He said that meetings have been held with all the universities located in the district, school associa-



tions, runners community and major RWAs for their positive support.

"Since Gurugram is the hub of MNCs, the district administration has also approached all the major corporates located in the district for their active participation," he said.

The marathon will have four different categories - three for competitive runners and one for fun runners. The competitive cate-

gories are full marathon (42 km), half marathon (21 km) and 10km marathon, boasting prizes ranging from Rs 75,000 to Rs 1.5 lakh.

Additionally, there will be prizes for master runners (above 42 years), oldest runners, youngest runners, persons with disabilities, and LGBTQ categories.

The majority of participants are expected to take part in the non-competitive fun marathon (5 km).

charge of Azamgarh and Kannauj seats, Manoj Chaudhary is in charge of Baghatpat seat, while Mehboob Ali and Ram Avtar Saini are in charge of Amroha seat.

ARUNACHAL, MIZORAM CELEBRATE STATEHOOD DAY WITH VARIETY OF FUNCTIONS

Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister Pema Khandu said that the 38th Statehood Day was celebrated with usual fervour and enthusiasm on Tuesday.

The Chief Minister said that from day one, Team Arunachal is leaving no stone unturned to make the state witness remarkable infrastructure growth with the construction of new roads, bridges and airports, enhancing connectivity within and beyond its borders in sync with the spirit of last mile development as envisioned by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.



Vice President Dhankhar along with his wife Sudesh Dhankhar, Arunachal Governor Lt Gen K.T. Parnaik (Retd), Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein and many other dignitaries were present in the main Statehood Day in Itanagar. In Mizoram, Governor Hari Babu Kamhampati said that the state was conferred the status of a full state after the signing of a memorandum of settlement, also known

as the 'Mizoram Peace Accord', between the Central government and the Mizo National Front (MNF) on June 30, 1986.

Addressing the Statehood Day function, the Governor congratulated the people of Mizoram for maintaining the reputation of being one of the most peaceful states in India.

The Peace Accord was a culmination of two decades of insurgency while the formalisation

of Mizoram state took place on February 20, 1987, the Governor said adding that it was noteworthy that while the Government of India had granted statehood as a condition of the Peace Accord, Mizoram has also kept its end of the bargain and maintained peace for 37 years.

Mizoram Chief Minister Lalduhoma, as part of the commemoration of Mizoram Statehood Day, laid a wreath and paid tributes to the fallen martyrs at the Assam Rifles War Memorial in Aizawl.

Addressing the function, the Chief Minister underlined how Mizoram, as a state, was already lagging behind other states by 25 years on the day of its creation.

He said that during these 25 years, Mizoram missed out on all the progress and developments that came with the five consecutive five-year plans. Since the state was a very late starter, the Chief Minister stressed that the state needed to walk faster and, most importantly, work harder than others to catch up. He also briefly hinted how his government will take all the necessary steps to promote growth and progress even if it takes some hard decisions.

RAHUL APPEARS IN SULTANPUR COURT, GETS BAIL IN DEFAMATION CASE

A special court in Sultanpur on Tuesday granted bail to Congress leader Rahul Gandhi in a defamation case dating back to 2018.

Advocate Santosh Pandey told reporters, "Rahul Gandhi surrendered in the court today and the court took him into custody for 30-45 minutes. After that, his bail application was submitted and was accepted. The further date has not been given yet."

The court asked Rahul to submit two bail bonds of Rs 25,000 each.

The case, initiated by Vijay Mishra on August 4, 2018, stemmed from remarks Gandhi purportedly made against Union Home Minister Amit Shah during a Press conference in Bengaluru on May 8, 2018 during the Karnataka elections.

The complainant cited Rahul



Gandhi's statement during which he asserted that while the BJP professes a commitment to honest and clean politics it is led by a "party President who is an accused in a murder case."

At the time of Gandhi's comment, Amit Shah was the BJP President. However, approximately four years prior to Gandhi's remark, a special CBI court in Mumbai had cleared Shah of charges in a 2005 fake encounter case. This decision came during Shah's tenure as the Minister of State for Home in Gujarat.

Rahul Gandhi was unable to attend the previous hearing in the special MP-MLA court on January 18 due to his commitments to the Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra.

Talking to reporters, Vijay Mishra, the complainant, said, "The BJP is the biggest party of the country. Calling it then President a murderer is unjustifiable."

TN govt to set up 100 farmers markets: Minister

Tamil Nadu Minister for Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare M.R.K. Panneerselvam on Tuesday said that the government will set up 100 Uzhavur Angadis (farmers markets) across the state.

"An amount of Rs 5 crore has been allocated for this project," the minister said while presenting the Tamil Nadu Agriculture Budget for the year 2024-25.

He said that the farmers markets will be established to facilitate easy access to quality agricultural produce as well as value added products to the urban consumers.

"Agriculture produce with specified quality norms will be directly procured from farmers and then will be graded, packed and branded and sold through Uzhavur Angadis," the minister said.

He said that the government will provide



kits comprising saplings of banana, papaya, moringa and curry leaf will be distributed to encourage the cultivation of nutritious fruit crops in home gardens. "This initiative aims to provide access to pesticide-free, non-toxic fruits and vegetables. An allocation of Rs 4 crore has been earmarked for this scheme," the minister said.

50 HUTS GUTTED IN FIRE IN TELANGANA'S KARIMNAGAR TOWN

Hyderabad: At least 50 huts were gutted in a major fire in Karimnagar town of Telangana on Tuesday.

However, no loss of life was reported.

The incident occurred in the busy area Subhash Nagar in the town.

Police said the dwellings of migrant labourers from Khammam, Warangal and other districts were gutted in the fire.

At least five cooking gas cylinders exploded in the fire. Multiple fire engines rushed to the spot and doused the fire.

There was no loss of life. Almost all the residents had gone to Medaram in Mulugu district for Sammakkha Sarakka jatara.

The cause of the fire is not yet known. Police said they were trying to ascertain how the fire broke out.

According to locals there was a dispute with regard to the land. The workers, who had been living there for over two decades, had refused to vacate the land located in a key commercial area.

RAIN & SNOW IN J&K, SRINAGAR-JAMMU HIGHWAY BLOCKED

Rain/snow occurred in J&K during the last 24 hours as landslides blocked the Srinagar-Jammu national highway on Tuesday.

Traffic department officials said that due to multiple landslides on the Srinagar-Jammu national highway in Ramban district, traffic on the highway has been suspended.

"Before undertaking the journey, intending travellers must contact our control rooms in Srinagar and Jammu to know about the latest status of the highway", traffic officials said.

Rain/snow occurred in J&K during the last 24 hours as the MeT office said weather would improve from Wednesday afternoon.

Srinagar had minus 0.7, Gulmarg minus 1 and Pahalgam minus 0.5 as the minimum temperature today.

Leh town in Ladakh region had



minus 4.5 and Kargil minus 9.2 as the minimum temperature.

Jammu city had 13.4, Katra 9.2, Batote 3.4, Bhaderwah 1.6 and

Banihal 2 as the minimum temperature.

TRACTOR-TRAILERS CAN'T BE USED ON HIGHWAYS, OBSERVES PUNJAB AND HARYANA HIGH COURT

Chandigarh: Ahead of the farmers groups' call for a protest march to the national capital over their demands, the Punjab and Haryana High Court on Tuesday slammed them for camping at Shambhu border with hundreds of tractors, saying tractor-trailers can't be used on highways.

A bench of acting Chief Justice G.S. Sandhawalia and Justice Lapita Banerji questioned the Punjab government for allowing the assembly of farmers in such large numbers. "According to the Motor Vehicle Act, you can't use tractor-trolleys on the highway. You are travelling from Amritsar to Delhi on trolleys," the bench remarked. Justice Sandhawalia orally asked the state government to ensure that protestors are not gathered in large numbers as "they have right to protest but it is subjected to reasonable restrictions". During the hearing, he also objected to farmers travelling in tractors and trolleys for protest. The court was hearing a public



interest litigation, moved by advocate Uday Pratap Singh, who said the road blockade is not only causing inconvenience to residents but also hindrance in the movement of ambulance, school buses and pedestrians since February 13.

SWAMI PRASAD MAURYA RESIGNS FROM SAMJWADI PARTY, ALSO QUITS AS MLC

Senior Samajwadi Party (SP) leader Swami Prasad Maurya, on Tuesday, resigned from the primary membership of the party and also from the membership of the UP Vidhan Parishad.

In a brief letter to SP President Akhilesh Yadav, Maurya said that since there had been no talks following his letter of February 13 in which he had stepped down from the post of party general secretary, he thought it fit to quit the party.

Immediately after, he also resigned from the membership of the UP Vidhan Parishad.

"Since I had been elected to the Vidhan Parishad as SP member and I have now resigned from the SP, it is morally correct for me to resign from the membership of the Parishad too," he wrote in his resignation letter. Talking to reporters later, Maurya said that Akhilesh Yadav had not even telephoned him after he resigned from the party post.

"I have resigned due to ideological differences and not any personal issues. Akhilesh had strayed from the path that was pursued by his father, late Mulayam Singh Yadav. Whenever he gets back on the right track, I will welcome him," he said.

Asked about his future plans, he said that he would continue his fight for the weaker sections.

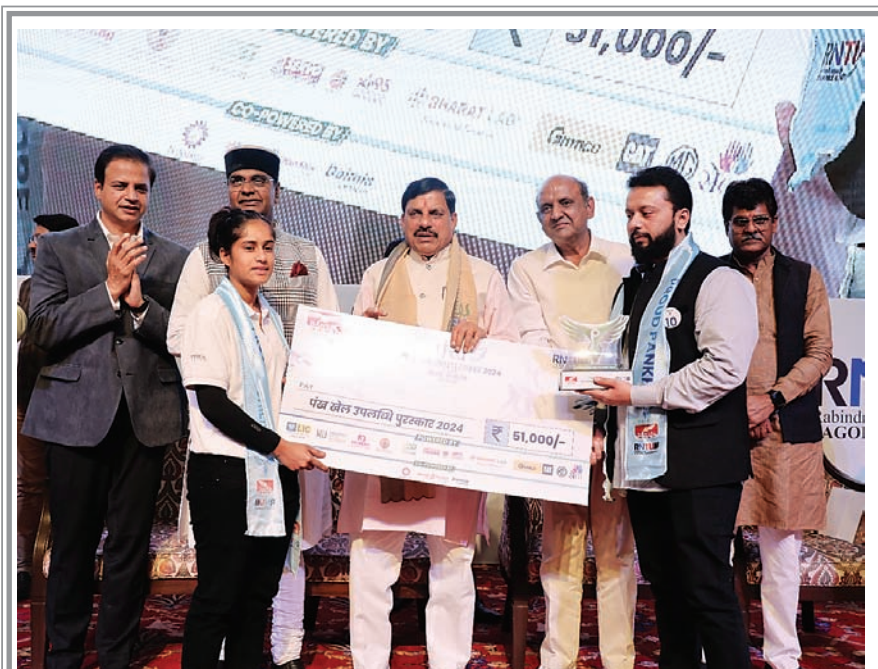

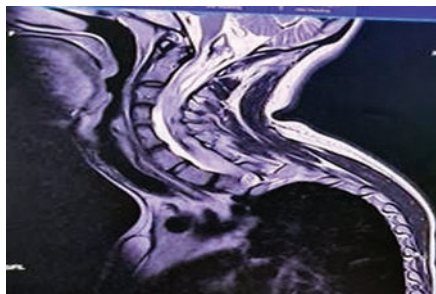
World's longest spinal tumour operated at AIIMS Bhopal

Surgery of Longest intramedullary spinal tumour was done at AIIMS Bhopal in the Department of Neurosurgery in a 22 years female, who is a resident of Distt. Rajgarh (M.P.).

A 22 years old female presented in Neurosurgery OPD with weakness of all the 4 limbs and was admitted for complete evaluation. M.R.I of whole spine was done in the Radiology Department and discussion was done with Dr. Radha Gupta and Dr. Harsha. M.R.I showed an intramedullary tumour extending from cervicomedullary junction to D11 vertebra. It was more challenging as the patient had scoliosis.

Intradepartmental meeting was held with Prof. Amit Agrawal and all the faculties of the department and it was decided to operate as early as possible as delaying could be life threatening. The case was operated by Dr. Sumit Raj and was assisted by Dr. Jitendra and



Dr. Abhishek. A laminotomy was done from cervical to D12 vertebra. Total excision of the tumour was done and the case was finished in exhausting 15 hours. The tumour was around 40 cms in length. After tumour removal the spine laminotomy was fixed with mini plates and screws. The support from Neuro Ot staff was exemplary especially from Neenu, Bhagwati, Nandram and others.

Anesthesia team played an important role for carrying out the procedure which comprised of Dr. Shikha and Dr. Rhea. Post-opera-

tive patient was managed by Critical care unit under Dr. Saurabh Seghal. Patient is now planned for discharge. Such cases are done only in specialized centers like AIIMS Bhopal. As the patient was an Ayushman beneficiary, they did not have to pay for the procedure.

WHAT IS INTRAMEDULLARY TUMOURS?

There are commonly three types of spinal tumours: extradural, intradural extramedullary and intramedullary. Out of these intramedullary tumours are the most challenging. These tumours are inside the spinal cord and hence to reach these tumours, have to open the spinal cord. The management of Intramedullary tumour is challenging. Success depends on the coordination between Neurosurgeons, Neuro-anesthesiologist, Neurophysiologist and a cooperative patient.

7 CULPRITS SENTENCED TO 7 YEARS EACH IN POLICE CONSTABLE RECRUITMENT EXAMINATION-2013

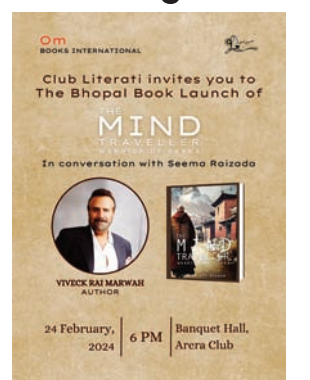

RS polls: Fear of cross voting looms large over BJP, SP in UP

The fear of cross voting is now looming large over the BJP and Samajwadi Party in the upcoming Rajya Sabha biennial elections. Resentment is brewing in the Nishad Party -- an ally of the BJP -- over the selection of candidates for the Rajya Sabha biennial elections. At least, two Nishad Party legislators have voiced their reservations over the candidature of Sanjay Seth, who is BJP's eighth candidate. The BJP has 252 MLAs and its NDA allies account for 34 MLAs -- 13 from the Apna Dal, nine from the Rashtriya Lok Dal (RLD), six each from the NISHAD Party and the Suheldev Bhartiya Samaj Party (S BSP). The Jansatta Dal Loktantrik, which has two MLAs and is headed by strongman politician Raja Bhaiya, is also expected to vote in favour of the BJP. The BJP has also nominated former Union minister R P N Singh, ex-MP Chaudhary Tejveer Singh, state party general secretary Amarपाल Maurya, former state minister Sangeeta Balwant, party spokesperson Sudhanshu Trivedi, former MLA Sadhna Singh and former Agra mayor Naveen Jain for the Rajya Sabha. Meanwhile, the SP's Rajya Sabha list includes senior leader and actor Jaya Bachchan, Dalit leader Ramji Lal Suman and former state chief secretary Alok Ranjan. If the two Congress MLAs vote for the SP candidates, taking the SP's tally to 110, the latter will still fall short by one vote to reach the required 111 votes (37 multiplied by 3) to get its three candidates elected. SP MLA Pallavi Patel has already announced that she would not vote for "candidates like Bachchan and Ranjan" because they do not fit into the PDA (Pichhda, Dalit Alpasankhyak) formula. Sources said that some other legislators could cross vote because of prevailing crisis in the SP.

FARMERS PROTEST: WHOSE POPULARITY GRAPH IS AT STAKE?

Hundreds of Punjab farmers who have been trying to swarm the national capital for the past week have failed to recreate the 2020-2021 sensation. Their agitation this time is increasingly proving to be an activism for a political case, the target of which seems to be Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the BJP.

Statements of some farmer leaders, videos of the protesters resorting to violence and raising anti-country slogans have exposed the intention.

"Modi's popularity graph has risen due to the Mandir... we must find a way to lower his graph. He will not do anything till his graph is high..." farmer leader Jagjit Singh Dallewal said in a video on February 14 which went viral.

Dallewal's public submission, perhaps, has given away the plot and the BJP was quick enough to accuse the farmers of having a political agenda. The farmer leader later tried to offer clarification, but there are others who are brazenly revealing the agenda.

Many of those at the protesting sites are not shying away from even making violent statements, like "will attack Modi, will punch him hard".

Some protesters have been seen flaunting Bhindranwale T-shirts, and raising slogans like -- "Bhindranwale Zindabad", "Deep Sidhu Zindabaad", "Amritpal Zindabad".

In a viral video a group of elderly protesters are heard talking about the need to "break away". Some even can be heard saying, "set Punjab free... we can have an accord with Pakistan".

Raising a red flag for the agencies, gangster-turned-pro-Khalistan activist Lakha Sidhana was reportedly seen at a farmers' protest site encouraging protesters to resort to



violence. The video also went viral. Sidhana was involved with the 2020-21 farmers protest during which a mob stormed the Red Fort on Republic Day and erected a religious flag.

Also jumping into the ring is the US-based Sikh terrorist Gurpatwant Singh Pannun, who has also released a video urging "pro-Khalistani elements to infiltrate the ongoing farmers protest" and "raise Khalistani flags".

While the farmer leaders are claiming that their agenda is to raise concerns about the MSP, etc., their supporters on the roads are following an entirely different course.

The protesters at some spots have been attacking the police and trying to remove the barricades. Armed with modified trucks and carrying various tools and weapons too, these protesters this time seem

more violent and ready to take on the security personnel unlike the 2020-2021 protest.

The Haryana Police even shared a video on February 16 showing a group of farmers pelting stones and trying to provoke the security personnel. The police posted on X in Hindi, "Violence cannot be allowed to spread under the guise of farmers' movement, protesters should not disrupt law and order and demonstrate peacefully."

The question is: If the protest is about the rights of the farmers, then why say the graph of PM Modi has to be lowered? And, also why slogans of Bhindranwale or Amritpal, why pelt stones or threaten to swarm Delhi at all?

As the timing and the colour of the latest protest is coming under scrutiny, common people in Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and

National Capital Region (NCR) are once again reeling under the impact, including blockade of roads and rail traffic, impact on local economy and overall feeling of uncertainty. The common man is not liking this at all.

There is also the question, why are the farmers from Punjab always involved in this? They may as well protest against their own state government and force their chosen leaders to change their policies.

Agriculture is a state subject as it forms a part of the state list of the Constitution. This means that states should address all the issues related to the state subject. Then why is not the Punjab government doing its own bit. Perhaps, politics here is heavily lopsided.

The Aam Aadmi Party

after winning a huge mandate in the state has failed to address the genuine problems of its farmers, and has pushed all the burden to the central government.

With the Lok Sabha elections near, the unrest on the Delhi borders and the image of an unhappy farmer can affect the BJP's image and performance, that is what the opposition may be believing. But, far from the toolkit theory, this time the plot is too obvious and stark.

This time the list of demands by the farmers is long -- enactment of a law guaranteeing a minimum support price (MSP) for crops, repeal of the Electricity Act 2020, compensation for farmers killed in Lakhimpur Kheri, and the withdrawal of cases against those involved in the farmers' movement, pension of Rs 10,000 a month, or Rs 1.2 lakh a year, to all farmers and farm labour aged 60 or older, etc.

The demands are too many and some of these are difficult for any government. The strikers know this. And, perhaps, this is what the farmers are aiming at. By making a long and difficult list, they want to impact the graph of Modi-led Centre as said by Dallewal.

In 2021, the Modi government retracted the three farm laws against which various farmer unions held a year-long agitation. Obviously, emboldened by the Centre's climb down, the unions this time are believing that they can repeat a similar situation again.

But this time the government is playing cautious. Three ministers are involved in talks right from the day one of the protest 2.0, and the government is willing to stretch. The onus is on the unions to shun their rigidity. It is their graph which is now increasingly appearing to be declining.

China makes biggest-ever cut to mortgage rate to boost housing market

China's central bank has cut its key mortgage reference rate by a record amount, as it ramps up efforts to stem a prolonged property crisis, a media report said.

The People's Bank of China (PBoC) announced on Tuesday that it would cut its five-year loan prime rate (LPR) from 4.2 per cent to 3.95 per cent, while keeping the one-year LPR unchanged at 3.45 per cent, CNN reported.

The 25 basis point cut to the five-year LPR is the biggest reduction the central bank has made since it revamped its LPR system in 2019.

LPR is the rate at which



commercial banks lend to their best customers. The five-year rate usually serves as a reference for mortgages.

"Today's 25 (basis point) cut to the five-year LPR is clearly aimed at supporting

the housing market," analysts from Capital Economics said in a note on Tuesday, CNN reported.

"On its own, it will not revive new home sales. But coupled with efforts to pro-

vide increased credit support to the developers, today's cut should help to reduce pressure on the property sector somewhat," they said, as per the report.

China's economy has been hobbled by a real-estate downturn since 2021, when a government crackdown on developers' borrowing triggered a liquidity crisis in the sector.

The property market has since entered a prolonged slump, marked by an ongoing decline in both investment and sales of property. Dozens of major developers have defaulted on their debt, with Evergrande, once the country's second largest homebuilder, ordered to liquidate last month, CNN reported.

Australia to double naval warships, largest since World War II

Canberra: Australian Deputy Prime Minister and Defence Minister Richard Marles and Defence Industry Minister Pat Conroy on Tuesday announced the major overhaul in Navy and said the government is committed to more than doubling the size of the nation's naval warships. With the announcement, Australia's fleet of combat-ready warships will be expanded from the current 11 to 26, Xinhua news agency reported. The government will spend an additional \$7.2 billion over the next decade to accelerate the delivery of the future fleet, which Marles and Conroy said will be Australia's largest since the end of World War II. The plan in total will boost the country's defence spend in the early 2030s to 2.4 per cent of GDP, compared to the 2.1 per cent it was planned to be when the government came to office, said reports.

ISRAEL HITS TARGETS IN LEBANON'S SOUTHERN TOWN OF GHAZIEH, CAUSING CASUALTIES

A massive explosion was heard after Israeli warplanes hit with air-to-surface missiles multiple targets in the southern town of Ghazieh, around 45 km from Lebanon's capital Beirut, causing several casualties, Lebanese military sources told the media. Civil defence vehicles and the Lebanese Red Cross teams arrived at the targeted areas with several bulldozers and cranes to carry out the rescue work, Xinhua news agency reported. Meanwhile, casualties were transferred to a hospital in the nearby city of Sidon, said the civil defence, without specifying the details of the casualties. The Lebanese army has isolated the area, with all roads



leading to it being blocked. Israel's military announced on Monday that its warplanes carried out airstrikes near the city of Sidon in Lebanon, stating that the attack targeted the Hezbollah armed group's weapons storage facilities. Two weapons storage facilities were struck in the attack, which, according to a statement released by the military, was carried out following an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle launched by Hezbollah toward the Lower Galilee region in northern Israel earlier on

Monday. "An examination of the incident suggests that the UAV was most likely launched from Lebanon by the Hezbollah," said the military, adding that the incident was under review.

The Lebanon-Israel border has been witnessing increased tension since October 8, 2023, after Hezbollah fired dozens of rockets toward Israel in support of the Hamas attack on Israel on October 7, prompting Israel to respond by firing heavy artillery toward southeastern Lebanon.

South Korea: More than 6,400 trainee doctors submit resignations

More than 6,400 trainee doctors have submitted their resignations to protest the South Korean government's plan of boosting the number of medical students, leading to delays in surgeries and medical treatment, officials said on Tuesday.

Talking to reporters, Second Vice Health Minister Park Min-said that the ministry has ordered 831 trainee doctors to return to work, Yonhap news agency reported.

Tensions brewed between doctors and the government over the latter's plan to add 2,000 to the country's medical school enrollment quota next year.

Till Monday, 6,415 trainee doctors at 100 hospitals submitted their resignations, with about 1,600 of them walking off the job, Park said.

Park said the government will



extend operating hours at 97 public hospitals and emergency rooms at 12 military hospitals will be opened to the public to cope with a potential disruption of medical services.

The admission quota needs to be enhanced to address a shortage of doctors, particularly in rural areas and essential medical fields, such as high-risk surgeries, pediatrics, obstetrics and emergency medicine.

As per the health authorities, the number of doctors in South Korea relative to the size of the population is among the lowest in the developed world.

UK university slammed for confusing Sikhs with Muslims in social media post

London | Agencies

Members of the Sikh community in the UK have slammed the University of Birmingham for confusing them with Muslims in a social media post, saying that "these mistakes should not happen in 2024".

The University deleted and apologised for the post incorrectly claiming that a recent 'langar (community meal)' event hosted by its Sikh students was part of an Islamic awareness week, The Birmingham Mail newspaper reported on Monday.

Students within the university's Sikh Society hosted the event earlier this month, serving free vegetarian meals on the campus.

But they were left disappointed when a staff member tagged their event in a post with the text 'Discover Islam Week', which is an annual awareness campaign run by the university's Islamic Society.

"It is disappointing... There is clearly an issue with the training



and education given to the staff,"

Jasveer Singh, a member of Sikh Press Association, told the newspaper.

Singh said that aspects of Sikhism are taught at the University, which has lecturers from the community and regularly hosts Sikh events.

Social media users described the mistake as "embarrassing" that left them "utterly gobsmacked".

"The university sincerely apologises for any offence or upset this has been caused. We recognise this post was incorrect. It was identified shortly after being posted and immediately deleted," a University of Birmingham spokesperson said.

"The university respects and celebrates the diversity of our community and continually works to provide a welcoming and inclusive environment. We have made contact with relevant individuals and groups to apologise directly and listen to their views."

Singh said that the University owes a wider apology to two groups for the mistake.

Heavy rain hits California with millions under flood alerts

Los Angeles: New rounds of heavy rain soaked large portions of Southern California, and up to 37 million people are under flood alerts.

A low-pressure system in the Pacific is directing moisture onshore in California, resulting in widespread heavy rain and mountain snow, according to the US National Weather Service (NWS) as quoted by Xinhua news agency report.

Flash flood warnings were issued Monday morning for Southern California counties, including Santa Barbara and Ventura, where 2 to 5 inches of rain had already fallen, according to NWS.

Several roads across the state were closed because of flooding and rockslides, California's transportation agency reported.

Severe thunderstorms packing damaging wind gusts, hail and even a couple of brief tornadoes may develop Monday afternoon and evening, according to NWS.

Areas of rainfall and isolated thunderstorms continue to migrate northward across portions of northern and central California.



Mumbai region's 2nd Ro-Ro service starts, links Bhayander-Vasai towns

The Maharashtra Maritime Board (MMB) on Tuesday launched a new RoRo (Roll-on-Rolloff) boat service connecting the busy towns of Bhayander (Thane) with Vasai (Palghar), officials said.

The maiden service was inaugurated by Shiv Sena-UBT MP from Thane, Rajan Vichare amidst claps and cheers as the first of the passengers and vehicles sailed from Bhayander to Vasai.

Presently, besides the Western Railway (WR) suburban services, the two towns can be accessed via the Mumbai-Ahmedabad National Highway and the journey can take around 100-125 minutes one way.

With the new RoRo ferry, the time will be slashed to barely 15 minutes enabling huge savings in time, fuel, and pollution, said Vichare at the inaugural.

MMB officials said that the RoRo ferry has been started on an experimental basis for three months, and



after checking out all the problems and difficulties, it would be expanded.

During the trial period, the MMB will carefully monitor aspects like safe and easy navigation of the boats, ease of boarding and disembarking both for passengers and the vehicles, the

time taken for the total voyage, including the time taken for vehicles to roll on and roll off.

To begin with, there will be eight round trips in 12 hours, starting at 6.45 a.m. from Vasai end, and from 7.30 a.m. from the Bhayander side. Each RoRo vessel has a capacity of

100 passengers and at least 33 vehicles per trip, and can ferry two, three, four wheelers, or even heavy vehicles.

The minimum fare for children (3-12 years) is Rs 15, for adult passengers Rs 30 and for a two-wheeler Rs 60, and will increase depending on the type of vehicles and the number of occupants.

The RoRo, being operated by Suvarnadurg Shipping & Marine Services Pvt Ltd., will help decongest highway traffic as well as within the two towns.

This has become the second RoRo service in the Mumbai Metropolitan Region with a similar service operational from the Ferry Wharf (Mumbai) to the Mandwa jetty (Raigad) on the mainland which has proved immensely popular.

In the next few months, under the larger Sagar Mala initiative, the state government plans to start four more RoRo services this year at: Dighi, Kashid, Mora, and Rewas - all in the MMR vicinity, as per an official announcement made by Chief Minister Eknath Shinde last year.

GOVT TO HOLD ROADSHOW IN MUMBAI TO PUSH RS 8,500 CR COAL GASIFICATION SCHEME

The Ministry of Coal is planning to hold an interaction with industry leaders in Mumbai on Wednesday as part of a roadshow for the promotion of coal/lignite gasification projects nationwide.

This event aims to nurture the growth and widespread adoption of coal/lignite gasification projects throughout the country. It signifies a notable stride towards leveraging the abundant coal and lignite resources to propel sustainable energy initiatives in India, the Coal Ministry said on Tuesday. including policymakers, licensors, EPC agencies, PMC consultants, industry frontrunners, and investors, to discuss the opportunities and hurdles associated with coal/lignite gasification projects. Participants will engage in insightful conversations, exchange best practices, and explore avenues for collaboration to propel the growth of gasification initiatives in India, the Coal Ministry said in a statement.

The Ministry of Coal has given an open invitation to all interested stakeholders to join the event for drawing up coal gasification plans.

Previous govts involved in some of the biggest scams: Union Minister

Previous governments inadequately regulated critical sectors such as telecom, amid massive scams, but our approach in creating a framework of regulation has been open and transparent, Union Minister of State for Electronics and IT Rajeev Chandrasekhar has said.

During a discussion at the 'Mumbai Tech Week', Chandrasekhar emphasised the transformative approach of the Narendra Modi government. "The telecom sector had some of the biggest scams. So, there is also a healthy dose of cynicism and skepticism when the government talks about regulation because there is a feeling that regulation is either pushing for a particular agenda or pushing forward the need for the government or a politician to control," the minister told the gathering.

"But our approach to creating a framework of regulation has been open, transparent, and consultative. And it is not so much about government regulation as it is about all of the stakeholders coming together and creating the guardrails that are important for the orderly growth of any segment of our economy," Chandrasekhar stressed.

"If it were just about innovation, if it were just about entrepreneurs doing their thing and we did not have some rules, laws, and guardrails, you would have chaos," he added.

The White Paper on Indian Economy, tabled in the Lok Sabha by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman earlier this month, enumerated about 15 cases of corruption and scams that happened during the 10-year rule of the Congress-led UPA government.

As per the document, the UPA's decade of governance was marked by a series of scams in multiple sectors, ranging from coal to telecom to aviation.

NHRC seeks report from DGCA on death of 80-yr old man at Mumbai Airport

The National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) has sought a report from the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) on the death of an 80-year-old Air India (AI) passenger who was not provided a wheelchair after landing at Mumbai Airport from New York, on February 12.

Taking suo motu cognizance of the incident, the NHRC said that if the media reports of the incident were true, they "raise a serious issue of violation of human rights" of the deceased passenger.

The passenger, along with his elderly wife, had made a prior request for wheelchairs with Air India, but only one was provided to the couple. While he walked around 1.5 kms inside the terminal to the immigration counters, his wife was in the sole wheelchair provided. Midway, the US-passport holder



collapsed and was rushed to Nanavati Hospital in Vile Parle west, where he was declared dead.

Subsequently, the AI had said that there was a heavy demand for wheelchairs that day and they had requested the passenger to wait till they

could arrange a wheelchair for him. "But he opted to walk along with his spouse. As advised by the airport doctor, the passenger was immediately rushed to the hospital where he was declared to have passed away," said the AI statement later.

The NHRC has issued a notice to DGCA seeking its detailed report in the matter within four weeks, including the status of compensation, if any, was provided to the next of kin of the deceased passenger, and the steps/measures taken/proposed to ensure that such incidents do not recur.

The NHRC observed that there has been a significant increase in the number of air passengers and also the airfares, "but the standard of facilities doesn't seem to have improved proportionately, resulting in several complaints reported," in the media and social media.

On that particular AI flight on February 12, there were 32 wheelchair requests, but only 15 were available with the ground staff at the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport, forcing the man to walk alongside his wife in the wheelchair, that led to the tragedy.

Pune Police orders Bars and permit rooms to shut by 1:30 am

Pune police has issued an order asking bars and permit rooms to shut their establishments by the stipulated time limit of 1.30 am to avoid any law and order issues. The order was issued on Monday under section 144 of CrPC in the wake of certain incidents having implications on public peace reported in and around bars, permit rooms and restaurants.

"It has come to my notice that some guests/customers are indulging in disorderly behaviour and such ruckus is causing a sense of insecurity amongst fellow guests including women. To curb such incidents, the establishments have been instructed to follow rules and regulations," as per the order issued by Police Commissioner Amitesh Kumar.

Some owners of these establishments are either not exercising due diligence to prevent such incidents, or are wilfully doing certain



acts leading to such incidents, the official said.

The order said all the bars and permit rooms shall strictly adhere to the outer time limit of 1.30 am and shut the establishments by 1.30 am sharp.

"Indoor music performances will not be allowed after 1.30 am and orders for food and liquor cannot be taken after 1 am," it said.

Maratha quota bill will not pass legal test: Congress; dubs it 'pre-poll farce'

The Congress on Tuesday said that the Maratha quota bill passed by the Maharashtra legislature will not stand the legal scrutiny and accused the government of deceiving Marathas and OBCs.

According to the news agency, senior Congress leader Vijay Wadettiwar dubbed the exercise a "farce" with an eye on elections. The Maharashtra State Socially and Educationally Backward Bill 2024 providing 10 per cent reservation for the Maratha community in education and government jobs was passed unanimously by the state legislature in the special session.

"The law on the Maratha reservation was passed earlier also, but it was rejected by the Supreme Court. This (the passage of the bill) was done conveniently before polls. The



legislation will not stand the test of law," Leader of Opposition in the state legislative assembly, Vijay Wadettiwar, told reporters.

"This is a farce to win elections. The government has deceived the Maratha community and OBCs," he alleged.

Vijay Wadettiwar said the government will showcase the passage of the bill to derive political mileage ahead of the elections.

PUNE POLICE SEIZE STAGGERING 600 KG MEPHEDRONE WORTH RS 1100 CRORE; THREE ARRESTED

Pune Police has seized a staggering 600 kilograms of illicit drugs, estimated to be worth approximately Rs. 1100 crores and arrested three persons.

"Unprecedented Action by Pune Police. In the biggest ever haul yet, 600 kg drugs worth approximately Rs. 1100 crores seized," Commissioner of Police Pune City posted on X.

"Like we said, #DrugFreePune is our top priority & we will do what it takes to ensure an end to manufacture, possession, use or distribution of illicit drugs in #Pune," CP Police's post on X added.

The three persons arrested in connection with the



biggest-ever drug seizure in Pune district were booked under relevant sections of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (NDPS Act), police said.

"On Sunday, three persons were arrested and around 1.75 kg of mephedrone (also known as MD) worth Rs 3.85 crore was recovered from

them. During investigation, we traced two godowns where another 55 kg of MD was found.

"Following interrogation of the trio and based on inputs received from them, another operation was carried out in the Kurkumbh MIDC area and approximately 550kg of MD was recovered from a

unit there," said Pune police commissioner Amitesh Kumar.

He said as of now, the police have recovered more than 600 kg of mephedrone which is approximately worth Rs 1,100 crore.

"Investigations are going on a war footing. Upward and downward linkages are being probed and our teams are working in close coordination with other agencies," the IPS officer said.

Asked about antecedents of the arrested accused, Kumar said they were primarily acting as "courier boys" and had some offences registered against them.

The police commissioner declined to divulge further details, saying probe was still at the preliminary stage.

ASHOK CHAVAN, 5 CANDIDATES ELECTED UNOPPOSED TO RAJYA SABHA

Mumbai: All six candidates from Maharashtra in the fray for Rajya Sabha elections, including Congress turncoat Ashok Chavan, were on Tuesday declared elected unopposed.

Among the six, the BJP had fielded three nominees including Chavan, and the Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena and NCP one each. The opposition Congress had fielded one nominee. The BJP nominees declared elected unopposed include Chavan, former MLA Medha Kulkarni, and RSS worker Ajit Gopchade.

The nominees of Shiv Sena and Ajit Pawar-led Nationalist Congress Party are ex-Congress MP Milind Deora and Praful Patel, respectively.

The Congress had nominated Dalit leader Chandrakant Handore, the lone candidate from the opposition.

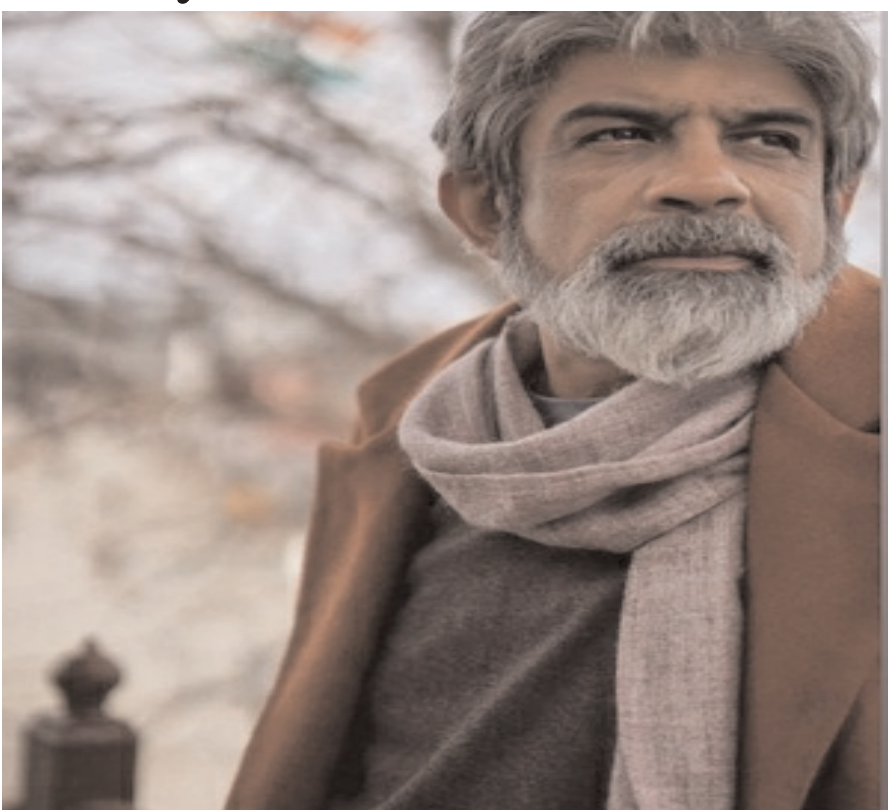

The two have been in a romantic relationship since 2010. They have also features in web series 'Bose: Dead/Alive'.

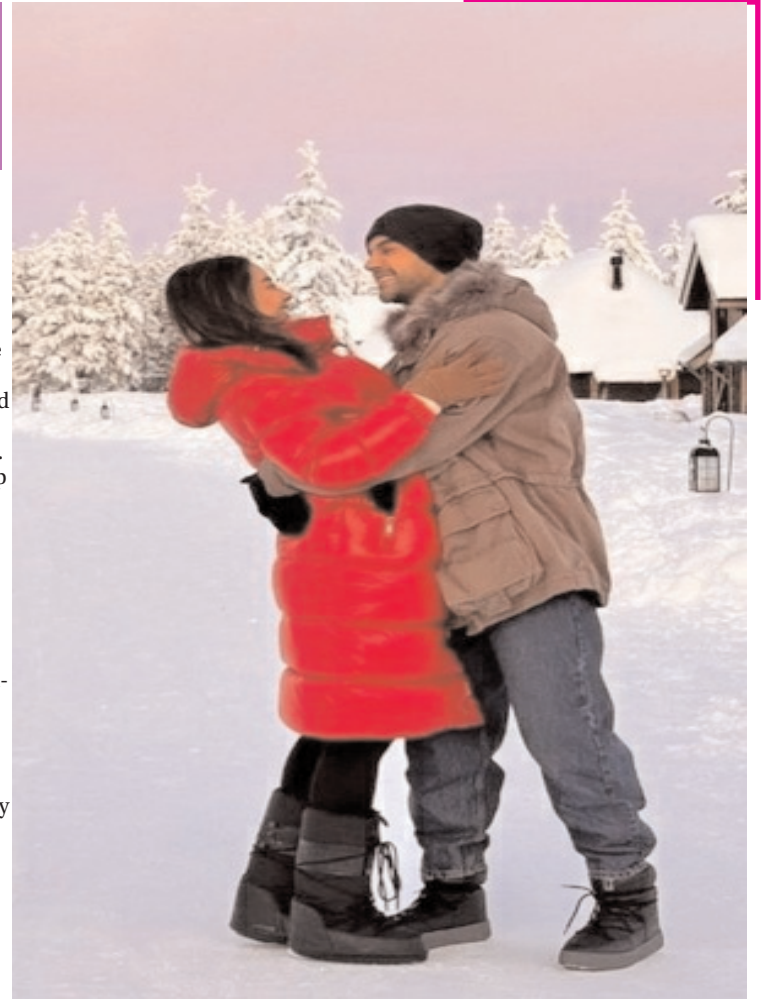

Warner, Head confirm as Aussies' T20I openers; Smith's role less clear ahead of T20 WC

David Warner and Travis Head seem to open the batting for Australia in the T20 World Cup after the duo was confirmed as the opening pair for the three-match series against New Zealand, beginning on Wednesday in Wellington.

Australia all-rounder Mitchell Marsh, captain for the three-match T20I series, also confirmed he will remain in the number three role he has made his own in the 20-over format over recent years.

With Glenn Maxwell excelling at number four and Tim David consistently contributing at six, Australia's top order appears to be well-established leading up to the World Cup in June.

Furthermore, with keeper-batters John Inglis and Matthew Wade (who will miss the start of the NZ series due to the birth of his third child) ready to fit in, along with allrounder Marcus Stoinis also in contention, Smith, who was rested during the West Indies series, faces uncertainty about his position in the team's lineup for the World Cup.

Despite admitting "our top order is pretty set" when asked about his team's planning, Marsh added that few of the 15-member squad in NZ are expected to play all three matches over the coming six days



"You'll have to find out, we'll announce our team at the toss. There will be certain guys that probably bat in different positions than they have done in the past, but ultimately we're here to win the series," Marsh said in response to a query about Maxwell and Smith's batting roles against NZ, as quoted by Cricket.com.au website. "I've batted three for the last 18

months, so I'll be there to start with. And obviously Heady and Davey Warner have been amazing for us over the last period of time, so I dare say that will be the top three.

"I think players like Tim (David) are a rarity, and it (number six) is probably the hardest role within T20 cricket. We're lucky to have him. He's become a phenomenal player in that

role and there's no doubt he's going to play a big part for us," he added.

As Australia prepares for their final bilateral T20I series against New Zealand before the World Cup, the return of star bowlers Pat Cummins and Mitchell Starc adds further strength to the team.

Marsh, who has not been formally appointed Aaron Finch's replacement as Australia T20 captain and continues to lead on a series-by-series basis, joked about anticipating the chance to oust Test and ODI skipper Cummins.

"I can't wait to tell him what to do," Marsh said of the role reversal. "I'm normally filling in for his press conferences when he's had enough, so I'll get him back at some stage."

"But I also feel pretty lucky to have somebody like Pat as another leader within our group to fall back on, and the experienced heads we've got that will help me in certain times throughout this series."

"I just think their experience (Cummins and Starc), certainly at this level and the three of them (with Hazlewood) work together so well.

"We're lucky to have those guys back. Over the international schedule you don't see those guys play a lot of T20 international cricket together so to have them back and building towards a World Cup is great," said Marsh.

'Yashasvi Jaiswal has not learnt from you': Naseer Hussain hits out at Ben Duckett for 'credit' remark

Former England captain Hussain has hit out at Ben Duckett for his remark suggesting that India's young batting sensation Yashasvi Jaiswal's aggressive approach in the Rajkot Test was influenced by England's Bazball strategy.

Jaiswal's scintillating unbeaten double century propelled India to a resounding victory, leaving England to face a crushing 434-run defeat in the third Test of the ongoing series. Speaking at the end of day three of the Rajkot Test Duckett had praised Jaiswal for his century, but also said "when you see players from the opposition playing like that, it almost feels like we [England] should take some credit that they're playing differently than how other people play Test cricket, reacting strongly to Duckett's remark, Hussain said Jaiswal's success stems



from his own upbringing, hard work, and experiences in tournaments like the IPL, rather than any influence from England's tactics.

"The comment on Jaiswal that he has learned from us, I am going to touch on that. He has not learned from you, he has learned from his upbringing and all the hard yards he has put in while

growing up, he has learned from the IPL. If anything, I would look at him and learn from him," Hussain said during a discussion with former England cricketer Michael Atherton on Sky Sports.

Jaiswal's stellar performance in the series has seen him emerge as the leading run-scorer, amassing a total of 545 runs at an exceptional

average of 109 and a strike rate of over 80.

Addressing England's lackluster display in the series, Hussain urged the Ben Stokes-led squad to analyse their mistakes and make necessary adjustments ahead of the fourth Test in Ranchi.

"Whatever they are saying in public and in that dressing room, I hope they are going back into their room with self-introspection. Otherwise, it becomes a cult, doesn't it? At times, Bazball has been described as a cult where you cannot criticise either within or externally. Even in this regime, there is room for learning and improving," Hussain remarked.

With England aiming to bounce back after consecutive losses, the fourth Test is scheduled to kick off on Friday at Ranchi with an opportunity for England to level the series against the hosts India.
