Weather office forecasts above average monsoon for 2024

MP govt met all targets assigned by PM Modi: CM Mohan Yadav

India is likely to witness rainfall above the normal level this monsoon, the weather department has said. Sharing the forecast, the India Meteorological Department said the country will receive cumulative rainfall estimated at 106 per cent of long-period average of 87 cm.

India is likely to experience above-normal cumulative rainfall in the 2024 monsoon season with La Nina conditions likely to set in by August-September, the IMD has said on Monday.

However, normal cumulative rainfall does not guarantee uniform temporal and spatial distribution of rain across the country, with climate change further increasing the variability of the rain-bearing system.

Climate scientists say the number of rainy days is declining while heavy rain events (more rain over a short period) are increasing, leading to frequent droughts and floods.

Based on data between 1951-2023, India experienced above-normal rainfall in the monsoon season on nine occasions when La Nina followed an El Nino event, India Meteorological Department chief Mrutyunjay Mohapatra told a press conference here.

India is likely to see above-normal rainfall in the four-month monsoon season (June to September) with cumulative rainfall estimated at 106 per cent of the long-period average



(87 cm), he said. Positive Indian Ocean Dipole conditions are predicted during the mon-

soon season. Also, the snow cover in the Northern Hemisphere is low. These conditions are favourable for the Indian southwest monsoon, he said. Moderate El Nino conditions are prevailing at present. It is predicted to turn neutral by the time monsoon season commences. Thereafter, models suggest, La Nina conditions may set in by August-September, Mohapatra said. Reacting to the southwest monsoon forecast, BoB Economist Jahnavi Prabhakar said the prediction comes in the wake of the extreme heatwave conditions ongoing in the country. "The water reservoir level has also been lower at 33 per cent of their total capacity compared with 39 per cent reservoir levels noted last year (as of April 12, 2024). However, the expectations of normal monsoon bodes well for the agriculture sector and will also keep a check on food prices," she said.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI), while retaining its inflation and growth projections, in its recent monetary policy statement had assumed a normal monsoon which will also be positive for the kharif crops, Prabhakar added. Out of the last 8 years, this is the first time in 2024 that the IMD has forecast above-normal

rainfall (104-110 per cent of LPA) in its first forecast. In 2022, India had above-normal rainfall, against the expectation of normal rainfall. Last year in 2023, in line with expectations, the country actually witnessed normal rainfall at 94 per cent of LPA, Prabhakar added.

CLIMATIC PHENOMENA

Three large-scale climatic phenomena are considered for forecasting monsoon season rainfall. The first is El Nino, the second is the Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD), which occurs due to differential warming of the western and eastern sides of the equatorial Indian Ocean, and the third is the snow cover over the northern Himalayas and the Eurasian landmass, which also has an impact on the Indian monsoon through the differential heating of the landmass. The southwest monsoon delivers about 70 per cent of India's annual rainfall, which is critical for the agriculture sector.

BJP's Idea That India Should Have Only One Leader Is Insulting: Rahul Gandhi

Senior Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Monday accused the ruling BJP at the Centre of imposing the idea of "one leader in the country" and said it was an "insult" to the people of the nation.

India is like a bouquet of flowers and each one has to be respected because it promotes the beauty of entire bouquet, the Wayanad MP said.

"This idea that India should have only one leader is an insult to every single young Indian," he said.

Gandhi was addressing party workers and voters in this high range constituency after a massive road show as part of his election campaign.

He asked why India could not have more leaders and claimed that this line of thought is the main difference between the Congress and the BJP.

The MP said the Congress wants to listen to the people of the country and love and respect their beliefs, language, religion, culture. But, the BJP wants to impose something from the top, he alleged.

"We did not get freedom from the British to be colonised by the ideology of the RSS. We want India to be ruled by all her people," he said.



Gandhi, who is seeking his electoral luck again from Wayanad, came to the constituency for the second time after the date of the Lok Sabha polls were announced. He kicked off the poll campaign in Wayanad early this month by filing his nomination papers and holding a massive road show.

Gandhi won from Wayanad with a record margin of 4,31,770 votes during the 2019 Lok Sabha polls.

Polling in Kerala's 20 Lok Sabha seats will be held on April 26.

AUSTRALIA IN SHOCK AS ANOTHER STABBING INCIDENT REPORTED FROM SYDNEY

Sydney: In yet another shocking incident, a bishop and a few other worshippers were stabbed by a man during a church service that was being broadcast online in Sydney on Monday evening (local time).

In a video that has now gone viral on social media, a man could be seen attacking Bishop Mar Mari Emmanuel at a church in Wakeley before being overpowered by the locals. The New South Wales (NSW) Police said the injured individuals suffered non-life-threatening injuries and were treated by NSW Ambulance paramedics before being shifted to the hospital. "A man was arrested who remains in police custody. A large police response is underway and the public are urged to avoid the area," said a statement released by the NSW Police. Local media reported that hundreds of people gathered outside the crime scene where the situation remains tense. This is the second major stabbing incident reported from the city in as many days.

Everyone Will Regret'": PM Modi On Scrapping Of Electoral Bonds Scheme

The scrapping of the electoral bonds - in a landmark decision by the Supreme Court in February - is a decision "everyone will regret when there is honest reflection" and has "completely pushed the country towards black money", Prime Minister Narendra Modi told news agency on Monday.

The Prime Minister said the electoral bonds scheme launched by his government was meant to fight the use of 'black money', referring to unaccounted cash or funds from criminal activities, in election campaigns, and that he had "never claimed this was an absolute way" to achieve that goal.

Modi also attacked the opposition for spreading "lies" about the bonds and said his government had introduced the scheme to cut down on 'black money' during elections. He countered criticism - that his Bharatiya Janata Party was the largest beneficiary, to the tune of thousands of crores. "There has been a discussion in our country for a long time... that black money allows for dangerous games to be played during elections. That money is spent in elections... no one denies. My party also spends... all parties and all candidates



spend, and this money is taken from the people. I wanted to try something... how can our elections be free from this black money? How can there be transparency for people giving donations? This was a pure thought in my mind," the PM said. "We were looking for a way. We found a small way... never claimed this was absolute," he said, building on comments from earlier this month, when he told a Tamil news channel "no system is perfect... shortcomings can be improved".

Modi's comments on electoral bonds came in a wide-ranging interview aired this evening - four days before the start of the Lok Sabha election - that included detailed remarks on the opposition INDIA bloc, the contentious 'One Nation, One Election' scheme, and allegations his government uses central investigative agencies, like the Enforcement Directorate, to target rivals before polls.

RBI eases rules on hedging of gold price risk in overseas markets

Mumbai: The RBI on Monday eased rules to allow resident entities to hedge their exposures to the price risk of gold using the OTC derivatives in the International Financial Services Centre (IFSC) in addition to the derivatives on the exchanges in the IFSC. Resident entities such as banks were permitted to hedge their exposure to the price risk of gold in the IFSC that are recognised by the International Financial Services Centres Authority (IFSCA), and the new directive provides them with further flexibility to hedge their exposures to the price risk of gold.

IIT Madras launches India's 1st mobile medical devices calibration facility

Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras on Monday launched India's first medical devices calibration facility on wheels. Calibration is key for life-saving medical devices as it will help check the accuracy of medical instruments for precise disease diagnosis, which will lead to improved treatments.

Irrespective of geographical locations across the country, the new mobile facility will ensure quality health-care. This will also help test and maintain medical devices that are used in a

wide range of hospitals including those in remote villages.

"Proper diagnosis and treatment are extremely important and for that, the medical devices need to be calibrated accurately and frequently," said Prof. V. Kamakoti, Director, IIT Madras. The initiative boosts the United National Sustainable Development Goal (SDG-3), which calls for health and well-being for all.

The infrastructure in the mobile unit includes state-of-the-art equipment that will test the safety of medical devices as per international standards.

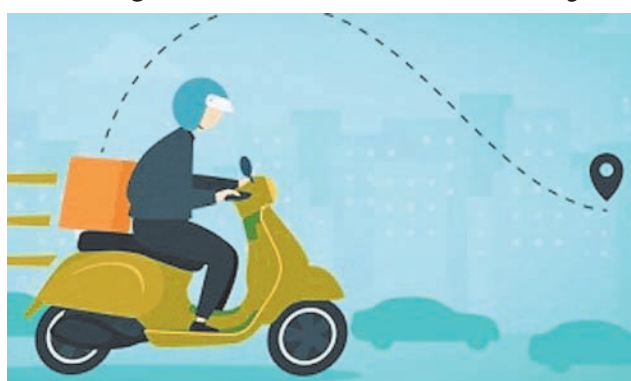
Online food delivery menus missing key nutritional information: Study

As more and more young people increasingly use apps to make food purchases, a new study warned on Sunday that most advertised items are missing nutritional information in online food delivery menus that would otherwise help consumers make healthy choices.

Researchers from the University of Sydney investigated menu items on major online food delivery outlets and apps.

They found that less than 6 per cent of menus of food outlets on online food delivery apps like UberEats, Menulog and Deliveroo had complete nutritional labelling. A total of 482 menus from UberEats, Menulog and Deliveroo were reviewed by the researchers in the study published in the journal Public Health Nutrition. "There are multiple studies



that show menu labelling having real-world impact that consumers who were provided with nutritional information selected meals with significantly lower energy content," said lead study author Sisi Jia.

"Although there is increasing demand for food delivery services, it is unknown how well menu labelling is implemented by online platforms," added Jia

from the Charles Perkins Centre and Susan Wakil School of Nursing and Midwifery at the University of Sydney.

The use of online food delivery services has grown rapidly, including during the pandemic.

Online food delivery is also making it easier for people to buy food of low nutritional quality, according to the researchers.

Firing at Salman Khan's home

Shooters identified; motorcycle used bears Raigad registration number

After the brazen firing at Bollywood megastar Salman Khan's home, the motorcycle used by the two shooters is reported to have origins in adjoining Raigad district, investigations revealed on Monday.

The motorcycle, with a Raigad registration number plate as seen in the CCTV footage, is being tracked to ascertain whether it was sold by someone, missing or stolen. The police have also been attempting to trace out the attackers, at least one of whom is identified as Vishal from Gurugram and the other from Rajasthan, both reported to be members of the Rohit Godara's gang. While Vishal a.k.a. Kalu is a history-sheeter who spent time in Delhi's Tihar Jail for thefts in 2020, the police have also identified the other shooter but have not revealed much details.

It may be recalled that at around 5 a.m. on Sunday morning, Mumbai woke up to a rude shock with at least four bullets fired



at the home of Salman Khan in Galaxy Apartments in Bandra west. Hours later, Anmol Bishnoi -- the brother of notorious gangster Lawrence Bishnoi -- claimed responsibility for the attack in a social media post. He termed the firing incident as the 'first and last warning' for Salman Khan, and ominously decreed that the next time "the bullets won't be fired at walls or an empty home", indicating the actor would be directly targeted for a hit.

The social media post (Facebook) by Anmol Bishnoi, was purportedly on behalf of other 'Bishnoi group' baddies like Goldy Brar, Rohit Godara, and Kala Jathedi. "Salman Khan, this is just to show you a trailer, to make you understand our power and not to test our patience further... this is the first and final warning to you," the post read.



KAMAL NATH'S AIDE BOOKED FOR CONSPIRING TO CIRCULATE OBSCENE VIDEO TO DEFAME BJP'S CHHINDWARA CANDIDATE

Madhya Pradesh Police has registered a case against former Chief Minister Kamal Nath's right-hand man RK Miglani and a journalist associated with a national news channel for allegedly conspiring to circulate a fake obscene video of BJP candidate, Vivek Banti Shahu.

The case has been registered on the basis of a written complaint submitted by a journalist Sudesh Nagvanshi, who claimed that he was asked to circulate an obscene video of Vivek Banti Shahu with a woman, in Chhindwara.

Vivek Banti Shahu will take on sitting Congress MP from Chhindwara and ex-CM Kamal Nath's son Nakul Nath. The complainant told the police that he received a call from another journalist Sachin Gupta telling him to reach Kamal Nath's bungalow in Chhindwara.

"Upon reaching the bungalow, Sachin Gupta took me inside (to an office) where Kamal Nath's PA, RK Miglani was already present. They showed me an obscene video of BJP candidate, Vivek Banti Shahu and asked me to share the video two days before voting in Chhindwara," a copy of the complaint available with reporter stated.

Nagvanshi added that after leaving Kamal Nath's bungalow, he contacted Vivek Banti Shahu and told him about his obscene video with a woman.



Subsequently, a police team knocked on the doors of Kamal Nath's residence in Chhindwara on Monday afternoon and interrogated Miglani.

However, the police did not respond to the mediapersons standing outside the former CM's bungalow. Speaking to the media after the police team left the house, Miglani said, "I was not questioned by the police. I was served a notice. I told them I will respond to it after the elections." This incident has taken

place just three days before the first phase of General Elections on April 19 have heated up Madhya Pradesh's political scenario.

Importantly, this entire drama has unfolded a day before Union Home Minister, Amit Shah, is set to visit Chhindwara where he will participate in a mega roadshow and address a public rally for the party candidate.

Piyush Babele, media adviser to Kamal Nath, confirmed that a police team reached the senior Congress leader's residence to conduct a search.

Police team at Kamal Nath's residence in Chhindwara, 3 days ahead of voting

Bhopal: A police team on Monday reached former Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Kamal Nath's residence in Chhindwara in connection with a complaint filed by BJP candidate Vivek 'Bunty' Sahu.

As per the information, Bunty, who is contesting Lok Sabha elections against Kamal Nath's son Nakul Nath from Chhindwara, has alleged that ex-CM's right hand R. K. Miglani has given money to some journalists to create fake videos to defame him. In his complaint, Sahu has alleged that Miglani has given Rs 20 lakh to some independent journalists to make fake videos against him and spread them on social media platforms. Police, however, did not say anything on this matter.

The development came as senior BJP leader and Union Home Minister Amit Shah is set to arrive in Chhindwara on Monday. Chhindwara Lok Sabha constituency is a stronghold of the Congress party. It goes to polls in the first phase on April 19. In the 2019 elections, the BJP swept the state winning 28 out of 29 seats, barring Chhindwara.

Candidates will be able to spend up to Rs 95 lakh in election campaign

All posters, banners, pamphlets, handbills, even if they are printed/published before nomination, but are being used/displayed after nomination, will be added to the election expenses of the

candidate. He informed that all expenses for commercial vehicles hired/rented for organizing the rally will be included in the publicity expenditure account. All expenses incurred on any rally attended by the candidate/display of photo/sharing of stage etc. will also be added to the election campaign expenditure account of the candidate.

RB Prajapati will be the joint candidate of India Alliance from Khajuraho

Congress has decided to support All India Forward Bloc candidate RB Prajapati from Khajuraho parliamentary seat of Madhya Pradesh. In such a situation, RB Prajapati will be the joint candidate of the alliance.

Minor boy sexually assaulted by neighbour in Rajgarh

A neighbouring youth allegedly stripped naked a 10-year-old boy and applied red chilli powder all over his body including genitals, accusing him of injuring his rooster in Madhya Pradesh's Rajgarh. The child cried inconsolably and had to sit in water tub for hours to soothe his irritation. He was rushed to the hospital.

The child's mother reached the police station to register a complaint application into the matter. Ahimsa Welfare Society has also taken cognizance of the matter. According to local media reports, the woman lives with her 10-year-old son in Baradwari locality of Rajgarh. The father of the child died almost 7 years ago. Since then his mother has been running the family by working as house-help. The victim is a class 6 student.

Notably, the child was playing 'Kanche' with his friends in Baradwari locality



on Friday and his mother has gone to work. Meanwhile, his neighbour Golu Mewade (40) came and dragged the child to his home, accusing him of breaking the leg of a chicken. After taking off the child's clothes, he applied red chilli powder all over the child's body. Mewade also applied red chilli on the private parts of the child.

When the child's mother returned from work on Friday evening, she saw the child crying sitting in a tub of water. When asked, the child told the whole story. After that the woman took the child to the hospital for treatment. On Saturday, the woman reached Rajgarh police station with her son and filed a complaint.

Congress will end in one stroke: Jyotiraditya Scindia

Jyotiraditya Scindia, who reached Gwalior on Monday before the Lok Sabha elections, has made a big attack on Congress. Scindia has made this attack on Rahul Gandhi's question for the first time. On Congress terming BJP's resolution manifesto as an apology,

Jyotiraditya Scindia said that the Congress party which made its policy against the promise, the Congress party which made corruption its policy, the Congress party which made its promise to destroy Sanatan Dharma. We have full confidence that the people are going to completely abandon that Congress Party which has made its goal to destroy power.

Scindia will go to file nomination from Guna-Shivpuri parliamentary constituency on Tuesday 16 April. He will reach Shivpuri district headquarters on Tuesday morning and submit nomination papers in the collector's office. The time was fixed from 11 am to 3 pm. Excluding government holidays 13, 14 and 17 April, nomination papers can be filled till 19 April 2024. After this, the nomination papers will be reviewed on April 20. Nominations can be withdrawn till 3 pm on 22 April 2024. The third phase of voting will take place on May 7. After this the election results will be declared on June 4.

Ayodhya gears up to welcome 25L devotees on Ram Navami

With just two days left for Ram Navami, Ayodhya is gearing up for massive crowd control -- bigger than the one seen in the holy city during the pran pratistha ceremony in January. Police officials deployed at Ayodhya for the Ram Navami celebrations, which will begin from midnight on April 16, have been asked to do 24-hour long shifts. Chief Secretary D.S. Mishra said that the government is anticipating the arrival of around 25 lakh devotees in the temple town. He said that the Health Department had been directed to station ambulances at all main areas while all hospitals have been directed to remain in alert mode. Temporary health centres have been set up at 12 spots and they will be equipped with all necessary medicines and facilities, he said. "For crowd control and the convenience of devotees, large LED screens are being set up in the Ayodhya and in holding and parking areas where live streaming from the sanctum sanctorum of the temple will be done. Security personnel will be stationed in the temple premises and the Mela area on 24x7 duty. CCTV coverage of the entire area will be done around the clock. These should be used to monitor the movement of devotees, for traffic control and crowd assessment," the chief secretary said. He further said that 24 automatic number-plate recognition cameras had been installed across Ayodhya and cameras installed at the borders of Ambedkar Nagar, Sultanpur and Barabanki districts would be monitored to get an assessment of visitors entering the city.

Rahul Gandhi's 'Khatakhath' genie won't snap votes

The pressure of staying relevant in the 2024 Lok Sabha polls seems to be forcing Congress to promise the moon and the sun to people. A manifestation of this is the slew of promises made by Rahul Gandhi just ahead of the polls. During his election speech in Rajasthan last week, he had said: "The Congress government will transfer Rs one lakh to the bank account of a woman from every poor family in the country... khatakhath khatakhath aata rahega aur ek jhatke se hum Hindustan se gareebi ko mita denge (it will come instantly and, we will remove poverty from Hindustan)."

The best jiffy moment has always been Aladdin's magic lamp but Rahul Gandhi's "khatakhath khatakhath" claim could well be the new one. The closest translation of Khatakhath, a Hindi word, could be jiffy or in one stroke or instant. And, instant for most of the present-day generation is always noodles, a Chinese-origin food item.

As all political parties are making promises to woo the electorate, the perpetual youth leader of his party offered the ultimate 'Khatakhath' solution to address poverty in the nick of 2024 Lok Sabha elections. The solution is a sharp contrast to the statement that Rahul Gandhi made 11 years ago in Uttar Pradesh when he said that "poverty is a state of mind."

In August 2013, the Congress leader was participating in a discussion in Uttar Pradesh when he said: "Poverty is just a state of mind. It does not mean the scarcity of food, money or material things. If one possesses self-confidence, then one can overcome poverty." To prove his point, he even cited the example of a poor woman from Amethi, who got hold of her life by taking help from Rajiv Gandhi Mahila Vikas Pariyojana.

If, in 2013, Rahul believed that providing the right atmosphere to earn and sustain can help tackle poverty, then why the U-turn in 2024? A decade of sitting in the opposition has made the Congress scion believe that promising doles is the only way to impress people. And the khatakhath system of transferring money in accounts is the easiest way to the hearts of people. Had it been so easy then Karnataka and Telangana economies would not have been struggling with fulfilling the pre-election promises on guarantees. Various development activities have almost stopped and legislators, even from the Congress, are unhappy as fund flow is slow.

Overlooking the ground realities, Rahul also made another equally startling promise which is to do a wealth survey, very much a Communist idea that actually originates from Karl Marx and Friedrich Engels' Communist Manifesto. Rahul Gandhi said that if voted to power, his government would conduct a caste census to know the exact population and status of backward communities, SCs, STs and minorities. After that, the financial and institutional survey will be done and finally, the "historic assignment to distribute the wealth of India, jobs and other welfare schemes to these sections based on their population" will be done.

History has examples of several countries under the influence of Communism going for this concept, but after suffering the ill effects, decided to change again. China tried the same in the 1960s but failed and finally reworked its policies. Today, China's economy is huge with a rise in wealth, private properties and income



gaps. But, in India, the Congress scion is seeking the 1848 idea for developing the country where youths constitute 66 per cent of the population.

By talking about wealth distribution, he also appears to be taking an about-turn from the liberal economic model of 1991. It was Manmohan Singh, the then Finance Minister in P. V. Narasimha Rao's government, who presented a landmark budget, ushering in a new dawn for the country's economy. Since then, India has not looked back.

Rahul Gandhi, with such withered and weird ideas, is seeking to impress the youth of the country who want to move ahead and not get entangled in caste and religion wars. It is an aspirational India in 2024 which is seeking new opportunities to grow, prosper and lead.

With less than a week to go for the first phase of elections on April 19, what has the Congress shaped itself into? Inner contradictions are galore and its leaders at all levels are just running away

with a majority of them picking the lotus merrily. Those abandoning the grand old party's ship do not hesitate to blame Rahul Gandhi for "suffocating them" and the party for being directionless. While the BJP has built a strong narrative of developmental politics, the Congress has been unable to come up as a challenger. In fact, it is today seen as a party standing with the corrupt and openly giving impetus to caste politics.

As surveys predict, Congress may find it difficult to even retain the 52 seats that it secured in 2019. The blame squarely rests on the top leadership. There is no Khatakhath genie that can help Rahul Gandhi get even near 100 seats. His aunt Maneka Gandhi has the best advice for him. He should take a break, she said, and perhaps this could work for him.

Situation worsening in southern Russian regions hit by spring floods

Conditions are deteriorating in regions of southern Russia hit by spring flooding, authorities in the area reported on Monday. Up to 15,600 homes and 28,000 uninhabited properties were under water, with the situation in the Kurgan region on border with Kazakhstan particularly dangerous. Here, the Tobol River in western Siberia had risen by 1.5 metres to around 6.5 metres within a 24-hour period, the reports said.

The Orenburg region to the west has also seen record levels along the Ural River, which takes spring runoff from the Ural Mountains flow.

Exceptional flooding this spring has washed away roads, bridges and other infrastructure in the region. The authorities



in the cities of Orenburg and Orsk have estimated the damage at more than 40 billion rubels (\$430 million), but the final figure could be higher.

Dozens of bridges have been closed to traffic, and the health authorities have launched a vaccination campaign against Hepatitis A amid concerns about water

quality.

There have been complaints that the authorities reacted too late and that assistance has been inadequate and delayed. According to the authorities, 193 localities and 33 regions have been affected, among them Samara and Omsk.

Preparations are also being made in the Novosibirsk region to the east where flooding along major rivers is expected.

Kurgan Governor Vadim Shumkov has urged residents to pack documents, valuables and clothes and evacuate to safe areas. The situation was extremely difficult and was deteriorating, he posted on the Telegram messaging service.

Police, accompanied by members of sports clubs, were organizing patrols to prevent looting, he said.

High-level Saudi delegation to visit Pakistan

As Pakistan moves ahead towards privatisation of its assets including the Islamabad International Airport and the National Flag carrier airline the Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) along with other major projects; a high-level delegation from Saudi Arabia will land in Islamabad on Monday to materialise the agreements done between Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and Crown Prince Mohammad Bin Salman. Pakistan's Foreign Office confirmed the visit stating that the high-level Saudi delegation would be led by Foreign Minister Prince Faisal bin Farhan bin Abdullah, who



will be accompanied by a team of important and esteemed figures from the business community. Saudi delegation comprises important government dignitaries including Minister of Industry and Mineral Resources Bandar Ibrahim Alkhorayef, Minister of Water and Agriculture Engineer

Abdul Rahman Abdul Mohsen Al-Fadley, Deputy Minister of Investment Badr AlBadr, Head of Saudi Special Committee Mohammad Mazyed Al Towajri and other senior officials from Saudi Fund for General Investments and the Ministry of Energy.

The delegation will be in Islamabad on 15 and 16 April with an objective to take the agreements done between Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and Crown Prince Mohammad Bin Salman during the recent meeting in Makkah. Sources said that the Saudi delegation is scheduled to have important meetings with key figures from various ministries of Pakistan. Meetings are also scheduled with President Asif Ali Zardari, Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif, Foreign Minister Ishaq Dar, Chief of Army Staff (COAS) General Syed Asim Munir and the APEC Committee of the Special Investment Facilitation Council (SIFC).

At polarised UNSC meet on Iran attack, only consensus is Middle East tensions shouldn't escalate

After hearing a warning at the polarised Security Council's emergency meeting from Secretary-General Antonio Guterres that the "Middle East was on the brink", the only consensus was that there should be no further escalation of tensions there.

"The message around the Council table was very, very clear that there should be no further escalation. Everybody was of the same opinion on this," Council President Vanessa Frazier told reporters after the meeting on Iran's thwarted massive attack on Israel.

At the meeting convened hastily at Israel's request within 24 hours of Saturday's attack using barrages of missiles and fleets of drones, Israel and Iran traded charges, the US and Britain strongly condemned Iran, and Russia mounted a defence of Tehran.

The Council immobilised by its divisions did not take any action and the meeting was only an occasion for venting.

The opinions, however, coalesced around Guterres' call "to step back from the brink".

"It is vital to avoid any action that could lead to major mili-



tary confrontations on multiple fronts in the Middle East," he said briefing the Council on Iran's attack.

"The people of the region are confronting a real danger of a devastating full-scale conflict. Now is the time to defuse and de-escalate. Now is the time for maximum restraint," he said.

The capture of the Israeli-owned ship, Aries, by Iran, came up during the meeting with several countries calling for the release of the crew, including Indians.

Israel's Permanent Representative Gilad Erdan asked the Council to not only condemn the attack but also to

impose the strongest sanctions on Iran for going ahead with its nuclear programme.

He said that almost all of the missiles and drones were destroyed by Israel and its allies before they could hit their targets, but the failure of the attack should not mean that Tehran is not punished for the attack.

Holding up a video on his tablet, Erdan said it showed Israel neutralising missiles and drones over Jerusalem's Al-Aqsa Mosque, one of the holiest Muslim shrines and said that Tehran was targeting Islam's holy places in its quest for Shia domination.

Iran's Permanent

Representative Amir Saed Iravani said that Tehran was using its right to self-defence under the UN Charter to attack Israel after it had struck its diplomatic mission in Syria and killed its personnel.

His country decided to attack Israel only because the Council did not act against it.

US Deputy Representative Robert Wood said his country "is not seeking escalation", but it "also supports Israel's exercise of its inherent right to defend itself in the face of this attack".

He said that a strong condemnation by the Council of Iran and its proxies is the surest way to prevent an escalation of tensions in the Middle East.

Wood countered Iran's claims of self-defence listing several actions by it across the region and said, "These and other reckless Iranian actions, are not inherently defensive actions".

Russia's Permanent Representative Vassily Nebenzia accused the US and its allies of following a double standard when it came to Iran because they would consider an attack on a diplomatic mission a justification for war under international law.

US not seeking war with Iran: National Security spokesman

The US does not want to go to war with Iran, a White House national security spokesman has said. Appearing on CNN's State of the Union news program one day after Iran launched attacks against Israel, US National Security Council Coordinator for Strategic Communications John Kirby on Sunday was asked by host Jake Tapper if the Biden administration supports an Israeli retaliatory operation directly aimed at targets inside Iran.

"As the President has said many times, we don't seek a wider war in the region. We don't seek a war with Iran. And

I think I'll leave it at that," he said. Kirby seemed to be showing more restraint in his remarks, Xinhua news agency reported.

According to US media reports citing White House officials, President Joe Biden told Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu on the phone on Saturday night that the US would neither participate in nor support any offensive operations by Israel against Iran. Iran and allied armed groups launched coordinated drone and missile strikes on Israel late Saturday night in retaliation for a strike on the Iranian consulate in Syria two weeks ago.

German Chancellor warns China not to support Russia ahead of meeting with Xi

German Chancellor Olaf Scholz says he will warn Chinese President Xi Jinping against providing military support for Russia.

He will point out that Russia is waging a war of conquest against Ukraine, "and insist that no one must help this to succeed," Scholz said in Shanghai on Monday. "That is why we are also calling on everyone not to circumvent sanctions... and that is why we are also calling for no arms deliveries."

This also applies to goods that can be used for both civilian and military purposes, emphasized Scholz. China is considered Russia's most important ally and is suspected of supplying such goods.

Scholz is meeting Xi and Premier Li Qiang in Beijing on Tuesday. The Russian war against Ukraine is not just a European issue, Scholz said. "If this sets a precedent, it is a threat to peace and security everywhere on the planet," he said.



Indira Gandhi tried to 'end' democracy, PM Modi 'protected' Constitution: Devendra Fadnavis

Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Monday criticised the Congress, saying that Late Prime Minister Indira Gandhi tried to "end" democracy in the country while Prime Minister Narendra Modi has "protected" the Constitution in his last 10 years of rule. "For the last 10 years, Prime Minister Narendra Modi has had an absolute majority. But he protected the Constitution. Supreme Court has clearly said that the Parliament cannot change the basic structure of the Constitution. So this is Congress' jumla," Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister said while addressing a press conference in Nagpur.

She kept lakhs of leaders and activists of opposition parties in jail for two years. Even after the suppression Indira Gandhi could not end democracy in India, "the Deputy Chief Minister said.

On Rahul Gandhi's statement that if the Congress comes to power the Agniveer Yojana will be scrapped, he said that Congress has never fulfilled its promises.

"Congress must show its track record. Congress has not fulfilled its promises in any state like Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Himachal, and Karnataka. They know that they will not get elected. Rahul Gandhi can also promise that he will build a Taj Mahal for every citizen of the country," the Deputy Chief Minister said.

Congress to contest in Bhandara-Gondia after 25 years

Following demarcation in 2008, the name of the constituency was changed to Bhandara-Gondia. While the seat has seen intermittent control by the BJP, Congress-NCP has wielded influence over it for a substantial period.

Originally under Congress's control, from 1951 to 1998, the Bhandara-Gondia constituency was primarily represented by the Congress party. Former Union Civil Aviation Minister Praful Patel served as a Congress MP for Bhandara-Gondia in the election years 1991, 1996, and 1998. However, the dynamics shifted when Patel switched allegiance to the Sharad Pawar-led NCP in 1999, diminishing Congress's stronghold in the region. Subsequently, in the Congress-NCP alliance, the constituency remained firmly with the NCP. In 2009, Patel secured victory and was elected as an NCP MP from this seat.

In the 2014 Lok Sabha polls, during the Modi wave that swept the nation, Patel lost to Nana Patole who was in BJP then. However, in 2017, Patole quit the BJP, necessitating a by-election in 2018. NCP candidate Madhukar Kukde emerged victorious, defeating the BJP's Hemant Patle in the by-election, delivering a blow to the BJP. In 2019, the BJP fielded Sunil Mendhe, who defeated the NCP's Nana Panchbudhe to become an MP from the constituency.

The Bhandara-Gondia Lok Sabha constituency comprises six Assembly constituencies, evenly distributed between Bhandara and Gondia districts. In the Bhandara district, Tumsar, Bhandara, and Sakoli constitute the assembly segments, while Arjuni Morgaon, Tirora, and Gondia represent the assembly segments in the Gondia district.

Elections in this constituency are often shaped by caste dynamics, with the Kunbi community exerting considerable influence, followed by the Teli and



Powar communities. Historically, candidates from the Kunbi community have enjoyed success in electoral contests here.

In the current elections, both the BJP and Congress have fielded candidates from the Kunbi community. Meanwhile, the Bahujan Samajwadi Party has nominated Sanjay Kumbhalkar from the Teli community. Notably, many members of the Teli community are rallying behind Praful Patel, who has endorsed the BJP. The final outcome may hinge on the support of the Powar community, which holds significant sway across the two districts.

MVA slams Goyal for aversion to 'fishy odour' in coastal hamlets, slums of Mumbai

The Congress and Nationalist Congress Party (SP) took a swipe at Bharatiya Janata Party's Mumbai North Lok Sabha candidate and Union minister Piyush Goyal for displaying his abhorrence to the strong smell of fish while going around a Mumbai slum, here on Monday.



Congress General Secretary Sachin Sawant said that Goyal "couldn't stand the smell of fish" when he passed through the fishing village and was seen walking around with a handkerchief to his nose.

NCP (SP) Chief Spokesperson Mahesh Tapase said that an MP is supposed to represent all sections of society, particularly the poor who form the backbone of Indian democracy and must be seen in public as a sensitive and sympathetic person.

On a campaigning spree, the usually dapper Goyal had gone around some humble slums of Borivali west suburb -- which has some fishers living and working -- and the vicinity emitted the stench of fish, a familiar atmosphere in many part of Mumbai North, and other coastal areas of

the country's commercial capital.

Unable to take a lungful, Goyal -- fighting his maiden LS election -- tied a handkerchief around his face, covered his nose and then tried walking around in the poor neighbourhood of Kolis, whose chief vocation is fishing in the Arabian Sea, as per his schedule.

"The Koli brothers-sisters are the original inhabitants of Mumbai. Goyal walked around with a handkerchief on his nose and cannot be representative of the poor people. Maybe now he wants to evict them to some other place," said Sawant sharply.

Tapase felt that peoples' representatives must ideally not display such 'airs' in

public, particularly when they are seeking the votes of the very same ordinary masses who can make or break a candidate's prospects.

Sawant added that Kolis and sea-food are a part and parcel of Mumbai culture, but after witnessing Goyal's behaviour the people of Mumbai North, especially shanty slum dwellers and fisher people will teach him a lesson 'for displaying an insulting attitude towards the poor voters'.

Locals contended that many of the fishing folks and slum dwellers found Goyal's actions offensive and even bordering on rude, which could serve to alienate them from the BJP nominee at the height of the electioneering.

Man kills 3 children by throwing them into well

A man allegedly killed his two daughters and 12-year-old son by throwing them into a well in a village in Maharashtra's Jalna district, police said on Monday.

The accused, Santosh Dhondiram Takwale, was arrested on Sunday after he called up the police to inform them about the deaths, an official said. Santosh Takwale allegedly threw his son Soham and daughters Shivani (8) and Dipali (7) into a well in Domegaon village in Ambad tehsil on Saturday, he said. The victims were Santosh Takwale's children from his first wife, who died, and he had remarried, inspector Raghunath Nachan of Ambad police station said.



A case has been registered, and a probe is on to ascertain the motive behind the crime, he said. According to sources, the accused, a resident of Kachner village in Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar, worked in a hotel and arrived in Domegaon with the children over the weekend. The accused himself called up the police to inform them about the murders and later switched off the phone, they said.

CM Shinde relieved as Independent MLA opts out of race in Hatkanangale LS seat

Chief Minister and Shiv Sena chief leader Eknath Shinde heaved a sigh of relief after Independent MLA Prakash Awade on Monday declared that he would not contest from Hatkanangale seat in Kolhapur district.

Awade, who was elected as an Independent in the 2019 assembly elections from the Ichalkaranji seat, is supporting the MahaYuti government in Maharashtra.

Shinde's timely intervention has paid off as Awade, who had decided to enter the poll fray on Saturday to seek votes on making Narendra Modi the Prime Minister for the third time, has announced to work for Shiv Sena nominee Dhairyashel Mane.

Awade accompanied Shinde and other Shiv Sena leaders for the filing of nomination by Mane at Kolhapur district collector's office. Shiv Sena was worried



after Awade unilaterally declared to contest the elections from Hatkanangale. Shinde had held a marathon meeting with Awade on Saturday but despite that, the latter remained firm on his decision.

The party was of the view that had he remained in the fray, it would adversely impact Mane's poll

prospects. With Awade's decision not to contest the elections, Mane faces a fight from Shiv Sena (UBT) nominee Satyajeet Patil, Swabhimani Shetkari Sanghatana founder Raju Shetti, Shetkari Sanghatana leader Raghunath Patil and Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi nominee DC Patil.

Salman Khan's security team gets more personnel after gunshots near home

Additional personnel have been added to Bollywood actor Salman Khan's security a day after gunshots were heard outside his home in Mumbai. He earlier had two personal security officers (PSO), two commandoes, two escort vehicles and 11 cops under Y+ category security, now three more cops and one PSO have been added to his team. His security level has not been upgraded, only more personnel have been added.

Salman Khan has also been asked to inform the Mumbai Police before moving out of his house. He has been advised to stay at home unless something important comes up.

Two people fired four rounds outside Bandra's Galaxy Apartments, around 5 am and fled from the spot. Later, CCTV footage released by the police showed the men on a motorcycle. The man riding pillion was also seen firing shots.

The motorbike, which was abandoned near Mount Mary Church, a little over a kilometre from the actor's house, was registered in the name of a man living in the Panvel area of Navi Mumbai, officials said.

A probe revealed that the abandoned two-wheeler was registered in the name of a person residing in Panvel, and a team from the crime branch went



there and brought the vehicle owner and two others for questioning, the official said.

The police are questioning the owner of the motorcycle. The man had recently sold the two-wheeler, assistant commissioner of police Panvel Ashok Rajput said.

Police are also trying to gather information if the two accused or the bike dealer or owner are linked to the trespassing case at Salman Khan's Panvel farmhouse.

They are also trying to analyse why the accused would go to Panvel to purchase a bike, when the filing was to take place in Bandra, hence suspicion of links with the Panvel farmhouse case.

It is also being examined whether there was a plan to target his farmhouse again. Two people were arrested in January this year for trying to enter Salman Khan's farmhouse. Cops said that both people were from other states and had come to Mumbai to see film stars. They had tried to enter the farmhouse climbing a tree adjacent to the boundary fence.

Both men are part of the Lawrence Bishnoi gang that is behind several high-profile criminal cases, according to police sources. Gangster Bishnoi is currently in jail for his involvement in several police cases including that of famous Punjabi singer Sidhu Moose Wala and Rajput leader and Karni Sena chief Sukhdev Singh Gogamedi.

The plan of the crime was allegedly hatched in the United States, where Anmol Bishnoi, Lawrence Bishnoi's brother, entrusted the task of selecting shooters to Rohit Godara, another gangster also based in the US. Anmol Bishnoi later claimed responsibility for the attack on a Facebook post.

The police have registered a first information report (FIR) against an "unidentified person" under section 307 (attempt to murder) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and the Arms Act.

Four booked for duping Thane man of Rs 10.8 cr in business deal

The police in Maharashtra's Thane city have registered a case against four persons for allegedly cheating a government contractor of more than Rs 10.8 crore by fabricating documents for a business deal, an official said on Monday, reported news agency.

A first information report has been registered under sections 406 (criminal breach of trust), 420 (cheating) and other relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code against a couple who were directors of two companies and two others, an official from Shrinagar police station



said. The Thane man has alleged that the accused couple wished to sell their elec-

trical goods manufacturing units in Andheri MIDC and Palghar and showed all rele-

vant documents to him. He also visited the manufacturing units, he said.

The Thane man paid Rs 5.82 crore to purchase the two plants, and he examined the document a few days later and found that they were fake, the official said.

The accused allegedly did not present the original documents and refused to transfer the shares to the complainant's name, the official said, adding that the accused couple also allegedly shut their office in Thane.

The complainant was duped of Rs 10.8 crore, which included the amount he paid to buy the factories and earnings from his investments in the units, he said.

Prakash Ambedkar, the head of the Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi (VBA), has criticised both the ruling and opposition parties in Maharashtra for failing to include any Muslim candidates in the fray for Lok Sabha Elections 2024. He emphasised that neither the ruling MahaYuti nor the opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi have nominated any Muslim candidates thus far.

In the forthcoming Lok Sabha Elections 2024, neither alliance has fielded any Muslim candidates, however, VBA has nominated a few nominees. In previous elections, the Congress ran one Muslim candidate in Akola but was unsuccessful.

Ambedkar, per the report, said, "If the MVA has to exclude Muslims - like the BJP - then what is the difference between the two...? On Bhim Jayanti



Day, I am raising this point on inclusion and exclusion." He also raised concerns about why the media had not addressed the issue either.

There is considerable pressure among Congress, NCP (SP), and smaller parties to nominate at least one Muslim candidate to ensure minority representation, especially in districts with a large Muslim population, such as Mumbai North-Central, the report stated.

Per the news agency, amid deliberation for a candidate who will contest from the Mumbai North Central seat,

rumour mills are abuzz that Congress is considering naming former state minister and Congress Working President M Arif Naseem Khan for the seat.

Despite senior party leaders, per the agency report, declining to comment officially on the issue, they highlighted that the grand-old party had been nominating leaders from all minority communities including Muslims to both houses of the Parliament regularly since Independence.

Although Maharashtra has an average Muslim population of 18 per cent, particular constituencies have larger Muslim populations, which influences the political landscape.

Subsequently, Ambedkar tore into both -- the BJP and Congress for circulating false information and propaganda about him and Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi and claimed that they were afraid of the VBA's growing power.

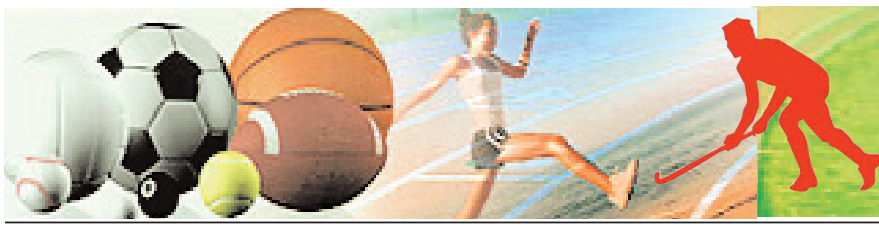

Drake's song, apparently titled 'Push Ups', sees the rapper firing shots in all directions. He, of course, goes at Lamar straight out of the gate with a few jabs. He also poked fun at Lamar's guest appearances on mainstream pop songs and suggested that Lamar's former label, Top Dawg Entertainment, demanded half of his earnings.



IPL 2024: KARTHIK 83 IN VAIN AS CUMMINS' THREE-FER HELPS SRH SEAL 25-RUN WIN AGAINST RCB

for the slog sweep but was beaten by the turn and the slowness of the ball. RCB were 80 for 1 after 6.2 overs, with Kohli gone for 42 off 20 deliveries.

British boxer Willie Limond dies aged 45

Former British and Commonwealth super-lightweight champion Willie Limond has died at the age of 45, a week after suffering a suspected seizure while driving near Glasgow. Limond last faced fellow countryman Ricky Burns in September and was scheduled to have his return fight in Glasgow on May 3 against Joe Laws. From 1999 to 2023, the Glaswegian won 42 of his 48 professional fights, including 13 by knockout; however, just three of those fights occurred after 2016.

Four of Limond's six defeats were against fighters who won world titles -- Amir Khan, Anthony Crolla, Erik Morales, and Ricky Burns. During his boxing career, he won the Commonwealth light-welterweight, WBU lightweight, IBO Inter-Continental lightweight, and British super-featherweight, lightweight, and super-lightweight titles.

'Absolutely ordinary', says Gavaskar on Hardik's captaincy against CSK

Legendary India cricketer Sunil Gavaskar criticised Mumbai Indians (MI) skipper Hardik Pandya for "absolutely ordinary bowling and captaincy" after he conceded 26 runs in the final over of Chennai Super Kings innings in Sunday's match, which eventually proved to be decisive in the visitors' 20-run win.

At the Wankhede Stadium, Pandya was hit for three sixes by MS Dhoni as he scored 20 runs off just four balls in the last over, which yielded 26 runs for CSK to post an imposing 206. Dhoni's stunning cameo of 20 not out eventually became the exact winning margin for CSK as MI suffered their fourth defeat of the tournament.

Pandya eventually had figures of 2-43 in his four overs with the ball. "One six is fine. But the next one again a length ball when you know that this batter is looking for a length ball to hit. The third ball again, a full toss on the leg side and he's looking for it and hits it for a six. Oh, (that was just) absolutely ordinary bowling, ordinary captaincy. They should have been restricting CSK to 185-190 despite the fact that Rituraj Gaikwad had batted so well along with Shivam Dube," said Gavaskar on Star Sports.

Kevin Pietersen, the former England skipper, thinks the boos and jeers Pandya has received regularly in the tournament from fans in the stadium has started to affect his on-field performances. "I actually think with Hardik



Pandya, everything away from the game is affecting him so much. He's smiling too much when he does the toss. He's trying to act like he's happy. But he's not happy at all! I've been there, as I've been in the firing line and been there proper! I can tell you now that it affects you."

"What's happening with Hardik Pandya is the boos we have been hearing now and how happy they are to see former CSK captain and the Lion (MS Dhoni) smacking him all over the park, it hurts you. He has emotions, as he's an Indian player. He doesn't want to be treated like this. With this happening, it's affecting him and his cricket and some-

thing needs to happen."

Just like Gavaskar, Pietersen was also critical of Pandya's performance with the ball in the last over. "What I saw this evening was not good enough. I saw a captain that had a plan A from a team meeting that was five hours ago and the captain didn't want to go to Plan B when he should have gone for it."

"How on earth have you not bowled a spinner when your seamers are going for 20 runs? Brain Lara was saying on commentary, 'Can we please bowl spinners?' They have spinners that can bowl. You need to change the pace of the game," said Pietersen.

Tsitsipas beats Ruud for third Monte-Carlo title

This is an unbelievable win for me. Capturing that win today was nerve-wracking. I really wanted this trinity. I am extremely happy today," said Tsitsipas.

After taking the first set on his second set point, the 12th seed, Tsitsipas saved one break point in his opening service game of the second set. Ruud struggled to find the court with consistency on his forehand in the first set, frequently overhitting. While he improved in the second set, he was unable to find the required level to hurt the Greek. In a tense 13-minute seventh game, Tsitsipas fended off three break points before holding. He then gained a decisive break himself to seal victory, ATP reports. The Greek, who has won 11 tour-level trophies, including three Masters 1000 titles, will return to the Top 10 for the first time since February on Monday when he climbs to No. 7.

LEVERKUSEN ROMPS PAST BREMEN TO CLINCH FIRST BUNDESLIGA TITLE

Florian Wirtz then took center stage, first extending the lead with a powerful 18-meter shot into the net in the 68th minute, and later completing his hat-trick with goals in the 83rd and 90th minutes, sealing a historic win for his team. With this victory, Leverkusen has now gone 43 games unbeaten in all competitions, a remarkable feat that includes an unprecedented 29-match unbeat-



en streak in the Bundesliga this season, amassing a record 79 points. "I still can't realize what we have achieved today," said Wirtz. "It's incredible and indescribable. I hadn't dreamed it. If you look at it objectively it is also deserved. It feels so great," added Jonas Hofmann. Alonso's men can lift another two titles this season as the UEFA Europe League and Germans Cup are still up for grabs. I liked it when he scored the hundred and didn't raise his bat because that tells me the win means more than the personal hundred."

"He played with real intent right from ball one. He played shots all over the ground. But the power, the finesse came into play. 105 not-out, 63 balls, 11 fours, five sixes. Nargis made her Hindi cinema debut opposite Ranbir Kapoor in 'Rockstar'.

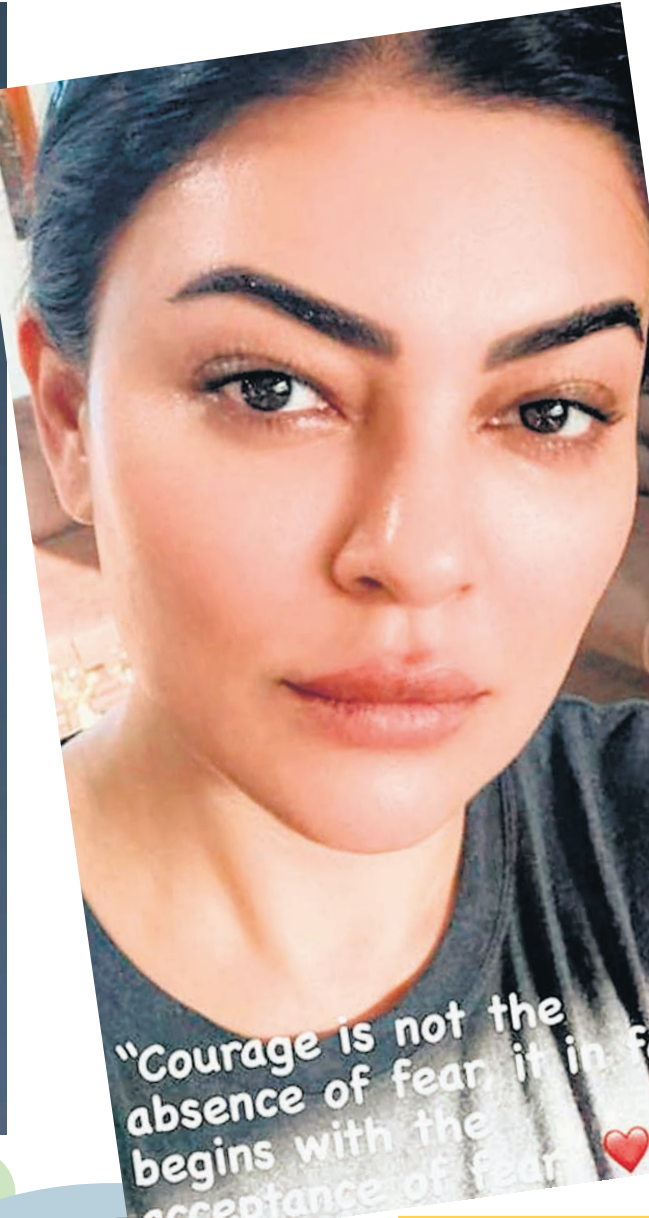
