NESTLE BABY FOOD SUGAR STUDY CAUSES CONCERN IN INDIA, NESTLE INDIA'S SHARES FALL

The baby-food brands sold by global giant Nestle in India contain high levels of added sugar, unlike the same products in the UK, Germany Switzerland, and other developed nations, revealed an investigation by Swiss organisation Public Eye and the International Baby Food Action Network (IBFAN), sparking concern in the country at the violation of health guidelines.

The Indian government is reportedly looking into the issue of sugar being added to baby food.

Meanwhile, the share price of Nestle India Ltd went down in the bourses on Thursday following the study.

At the BSE, on Thursday, Nestle India's shares opened at Rs 2,539 (Wednesday closing price Rs 2,547.15) and went down to close at Rs.2,462.75.

Findings showed that in India, all Cerelac baby products contain an average of nearly 3 grams of sugar per serving. The same product is being sold with no added sugar in Germany and the UK, while in Ethiopia and Thailand, it contains nearly 6 grams, the study said.

The report said that Nestle adds sugar to infant milk and cereal products in several countries which is a



30 per cent over the past five years and it continues to "review" and "reformulate" products to reduce them further. "We believe in the nutritional quality of our products for early childhood and prioritise using high-quality ingredients."

On Wednesday, the leading UK paper The Guardian reported that the Swiss food giant adds sugar and honey to infant milk and cereal products sold in "poorer countries". It cited data from Public Eye and IBFAN that examined Nestle baby food brands sold in these markets. Public Eye examined 115 products sold in Nestle's main markets in Africa, Asia and Latin America across two key brands -- Cerelac and Nodi.

In India, all Cerelac baby cereal products examined by Public Eye contained added sugar -- on average nearly 3 gm per serving.

"Almost all the Cerelac infant cereals examined contain added sugar -- nearly 4 grams per serving on average, equal to roughly a sugar cube -- although they are targeted at babies from six months of age. The highest amount -- 7.3 grams per serving -- was detected in a product sold in the Philippines," the report said.

WHO expert Nigel Rollins was cited in media reports as saying that "this is a double standard that cannot be justified."

NCPCR ASKS FSSAI TO REVIEW SUGAR CONTENT

New Delhi: The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) on Thursday asked the Food Safety and Standards Authority (FSSAI) to take a "comprehensive review" of the sugar content in Nestle's baby food products, after a report showed violation of health guidelines. The report, by Swiss organisation Public Eye and the International Baby Food Action Network (IBFAN), revealed that baby-food brands sold by global giant Nestle in India contain high levels of added sugar, unlike the same products in the UK, Germany, Switzerland, and other developed nations. "In light of these concerns it is requested that FSSAI undertake a comprehensive review of the sugar content in baby food products manufactured and marketed by Nestle and other companies," said NCPCR Chief Priyank Kanoongo, in the letter to the food regulator.

The Commission said it has "taken cognisance" of the report and that the added sugar content could potentially harm the health of infants and young children.

SC reserves verdict on pleas seeking mandatory EVM-VVPAT tally

The Supreme Court on Thursday reserved its verdict on a batch of public interest litigations (PILs) seeking a direction to the Election Commission of India (ECI) to mandatorily cross-verify the votes cast in Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) with Voter-Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) slips.

Observing that official acts are normally presumed to be done validly under the Indian Evidence Act, a bench, headed by Justice Sanjiv Khanna, remarked that everything done by the poll body cannot be suspected. As Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, the second highest law officer of the Centre, slammed the peti-



tioners for periodically filing PILs on the eve of elections saying that the democratic choice of a voter is being turned into a joke, the Bench, also comprising Justice Dipankar Datta, remarked that the petitions were filed long back and could have not been decided due to work pressure. The SG added that the issue has already been

settled by the apex court with the dismissal of the pleas seeking similar relief in the past. During the hearing, senior advocate Maninder Singh, representing the ECI, said that media reports suggesting that EVM erroneously registered votes in favour of the BJP during mock polling in Kerala's Kasargod were found to be completely false.

HAVING A DRIVING SKILL HIGHLY DESIRABLE FOR JOB SEEKERS: REPORT

New Delhi: Having a driving skill is highly desirable for job seekers across different sectors such as manufacturing, e-commerce, construction, tourism, and customer service, among others, a new report revealed on Thursday. According to the global hiring and matching platform Indeed, about 53 per cent of employers have highlighted the importance of driving proficiency as a desired skill. Despite a four per cent drop in job openings requiring driving skills from March 2023 to March 2024, there has been a significant 10 per cent increase in job seeker interest. "The data highlights a paradox where fewer job opportunities coexist with a rising number of job seekers eager to fill these roles," said Sashi Kumar, Head of Sales, Indeed India. "This could indicate a tougher competition among candidates, but also underscores the importance of possessing robust driving skills," he added.



Delhi court defers hearing on framing of charges against ex-WFI chief

Delhi court on Thursday deferred a hearing concerning the framing of charges against BJP MP and former Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) chief, Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, in an alleged sexual harassment case by six women wrestlers. The decision to defer came after Singh submitted an application seeking further examination of evidence concerning his whereabouts on the alleged date of the incident, September 7, 2022. He told the court that he was not in Delhi when one of the complainant wrestlers was allegedly sexually harassed. Presiding over the case, Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Priyanka Rajpoot of



Rouse Avenue Court, deferred the pronouncement of the order and will hear the matter on April 26.

The application argues for a detailed investigation into Singh's claims of being abroad when the incident purportedly took place. The application

also demanded that the Delhi Police produce the Call Detail Record (CDR).

APP Atul Srivastava, representing the Delhi Police, opposed the application, arguing that the timing of the request was strategic and intended to prolong the case.

He stressed the potential legal ramifications of reopening the investigation at this stage. Meanwhile, the legal counsel for the complainants criticised the application as a tactic to delay the proceedings.

They argued that the necessary documents should have been procured earlier under Section 207 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (CrPC), which deals with the communication of evidence to the accused.

INDIGENOUS CRUISE MISSILE SUCCESSFULLY FLIGHT-TESTED BY DRDO

DRDO has conducted a successful flight test of Indigenous Technology Cruise Missile (ITCM). The missile is equipped with advanced avionics and software to ensure better and more reliable performance.

The flight of the missile was also monitored from the Su-30-Mk-I aircraft of the Indian Air Force.

The Ministry of Defence informed on Thursday that the test was conducted from the Integrated Test Range (ITR), Chandipur, off the coast of Odisha on April 18, 2024.

During the test, all subsystems performed as per expectation. The missile performance was monitored by



several Range Sensors like Radar, Electro Optical Tracking System

(EOTS) and Telemetry deployed by ITR at different locations to ensure

complete coverage of the flight path.

The missile followed the desired path using waypoint navigation and demonstrated very low altitude sea-skimming flight. This successful flight test has also established the reliable performance of the indigenous propulsion system developed by Gas Turbine Research Establishment (GTRE), Bengaluru.

The missile is developed by Bengaluru-based DRDO laboratory Aeronautical Development Establishment (ADE) along with contributions from other laboratories and Indian industries. The test was carried out in the presence of many senior scientists from various DRDO laboratories along with representatives from the production partner.

Remaining 16 Indian crew members free to return home: Iranian Envoy

The 16 remaining Indian crew members on board a cargo ship seized by Iran have not been detained and are allowed to leave the country easily, Iran's Ambassador to India, Iraj Elahi, said on Thursday. "The 16 Indian crew members on board the cargo ship have not been detained and are free to leave the country easily," Elahi told NDTV over the phone on Thursday. The Iranian Ambassador's comment came a few hours after deck cadet Ann Tessa



Joseph, one of the 17 Indian crew members on board vessel MSC Aries, landed safely at the Cochin International Airport. Joseph, who is from Kerala's Thrissur, was received by the Regional Passport Officer at the air-

port. Commenting on the development, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar, who had spoken to his Iranian counterpart Amir Abdollahian on the matter earlier this week, said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi's guarantee works not just within the country, but outside as well.

Why excess sugar, oil are as dangerous for liver as alcohol

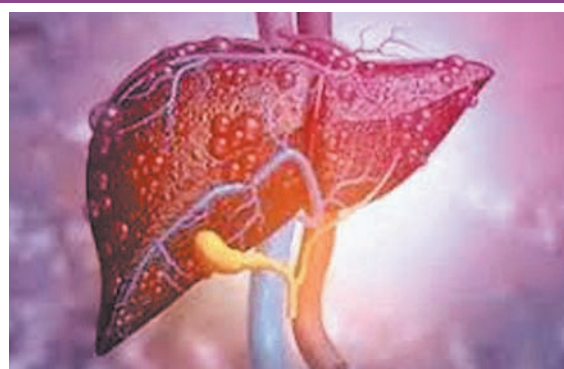

While alcohol is known to be bad for liver health, consuming foods rich in sugar and oil may be equally dangerous for the organ as well as for overall health, said doctors on Thursday, ahead of World Liver Day.

World Liver Day is observed on April 19 every year to highlight the importance of a healthy liver for the normal functioning of the body. The theme this year is 'Be vigilant, get regular liver check-ups, and prevent fatty liver diseases'.

The liver acts as the body's warehouse, processing everything one consumes. Eating more calories can accumulate in the liver, leading to fatty liver disease, which can trigger diabetes and other metabolic disorders.

"While the dangers of alcohol-related liver disease are well-known, there is a rising concern over non-alcoholic liver disease caused by high-calorie foods, such as sugars



and fats. This condition can lead to the same severe complications as alcoholic liver disease, including liver cirrhosis, which might eventually require a liver transplant," Dr

Shreevidya, Medical Director, Apollo ProHealth, told correspondent. "Excess sugar and oil intake, like alcohol, give rise to fat droplets scattered through the liver tissue leading to a cascade of liver injury due to inflammation leading to liver failure," explained Dr Pavan Dhole, Junior Consultant - Gastroenterology, P. D. Hinduja Hospital & MRC, Mahim.

Excess sugar and oil intake fuels obesity leading to adverse liver health, including non-alcoholic fatty liver diseases (NAFLD). Data shows nearly one out of every four Indian adults are either overweight or obese (at risk of fatty liver disease) and alcohol use is also on the rise.

A study conducted by AIIMS, analysing reports on NAFLD in India, revealed a startling reality: over one-third (38 per cent) of Indians have fatty liver or NAFLD. This phenomenon extends to affect nearly 35 per cent of children as well, as per the Journal of Clinical and Experimental Hepatology and calls for attention to addressing lifestyle-related health issues from an early age.



CM KEJRIWAL EATING MANGOES TO RAISE SUGAR LEVEL TO SEEK BAIL: ED ALLEGES IN DELHI COURT

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) alleged in a Delhi court on Thursday that Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal is deliberately eating mangoes and other high-carb food in Tihar Jail to raise his blood sugar level to build a case for bail.

Arguing the matter before Special Judge Rakesh Syal of the Rouse Avenue Court, special counsel Zohab Hossain appearing for the ED said on the one hand CM Kejriwal is claiming high sugar levels, and at the same time he is eating mangoes, sweets, etc. in jail.

The Delhi Chief Minister is in judicial custody till April 23 for his alleged involvement in the excise policy case.

The ED has alleged that CM Kejriwal is consciously consuming items like tea with sugar, banana, sweets (1/2 pieces), poori, aloo sabji, etc. on a regular basis, despite being a Type 2 diabetes patient, "knowing very well that consumption of such items results in an increase in sugar levels".

The agency also said that this is being done to create a medical emergency "to obtain sympathetic treatment from the court on medical grounds".

"Further, the jail authorities on Wednesday asked AIIMS to prescribe a diet chart for the Chief Minister after considering his sugar records and the fact that he is a Type 2 diabetes patient with chronic constipation and cough (chronic bronchitis), who is under regular treatment," the ED counsel said.



However, advocate Vivek Jain, appearing for CM Kejriwal, opposed the federal agency's submission saying the ED counsel is playing by the gallery and making statements for the media. After a brief hearing, the court sought a medical report from Tihar Jail authorities on the CM's diet and listed the matter for hearing on Friday. While the ED's allegations were made in court on Thursday, the issue has been doing the rounds on social media since Wednesday. According to a post on X, one of the netizen's sources in the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) revealed that CM Kejriwal is taking high-sugar food deliberately to increase his sugar level so that he

can use it as a reason to get bail. "He is not only forcing the jail authorities to give him sugar-laden high glycemic index drinks and food early in the morning, but his family is also sending him sugar and carb-laden food so that his blood sugar rises," the post read.

CM Kejriwal's lawyers had gone at length detailing his health conditions earlier, saying he was diabetic when he was sent to judicial custody.

Kejriwal's counsel had informed the court that his blood sugar level dropped to 46 and argued that in such circumstances, he should be allowed to consult his doctor three times a week via video conferencing.

However, special public prosecutor (ED) Simon Benjamin had contended that jail facilities are equipped to conduct medical examinations, suggesting that CM Kejriwal could be examined there, expressing his intent to file a reply on the application. Meanwhile, another user posted: "Every day Kejrui asks for high sugar food like juice, banana etc. and he gets high carb food! The plan is to show high sugar and get out of jail. This has been told by your top sources. Whether this is true will be known in a few days!"

Last week, alleged conman Sukesh Chandrashekar claimed in a press statement that Kejriwal is fooling the people with news of losing weight and falling sick.

Sharad Pawar made many attempts to finish Shiv Sena, claims Maha minister

As the campaigning for the Lok Sabha elections is gathering momentum, the MahaYuti partners have stepped up their attack on NCP SP chief Sharad Pawar saying that he is responsible for the present political situation in Maharashtra.

Shiv Sena leader and school education minister Deepak Kesarkar at the MahaYuti's joint press conference here on Thursday claimed that Pawar senior made several attempts to finish the Shiv Sena.

"Senior leader Sharad Pawar consistently made many attempts to finish the Shiv Sena. On the contrary, Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the BJP tried to maintain the alliance with the Shiv Sena. However, since Uddhav Thackeray has fallen into Pawar's trap, he is making false allegations



against PM Modi in a bid to gain sympathy," alleged Kesarkar who was accompanied by NCP minister Anil Patil and BJP legislator Prasad Lad.

Kesarkar said that the Shiv Sainiks, who are loyal to Balasaheb Thackeray's thoughts, should not fall prey to Pawar's delusions.

He stated that Sharad Pawar and Uddhav Thackeray have made many baseless allegations against Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the Bharatiya Janata Party during the Lok Sabha election campaign.

"Shiv Sainiks, who are loyal to Balasaheb

Thackeray's thoughts, must know the facts. It is well known that Sharad Pawar split the Shiv Sena when Balasaheb Thackeray was still alive. After 2014, Pawar tried to see how a militant organization like Shiv Sena could be finished," he noted.

Seeing that no party got a majority on its own in the 2014 assembly elections, Pawar unilaterally announced his support to the Bharatiya Janata Party in a bid to reduce the Shiv Sena's bargaining power. It was also due to his desire that the BJP and Shiv Sena should not come together again, said Kesarkar.

BJP will hardly win 12-15 LS seats in south India: Telangana CM Revanth Reddy

Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy on Thursday claimed that the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) will hardly win 12-15 Parliamentary seats in the southern states in the Lok Sabha polls.

Speaking with NDTV's Marya Shakil at a rally while campaigning for Congress leader Adoor Prakash in Kerala's Attingal, Revanth Reddy said that the grand old party will win all 20 LS seats in Kerala, while it will bag at least 14 out of 17 LS seats in Telangana. On the BJP expressing confidence of crossing 400 seats, Revanth Reddy said even BRS president and former Telangana chief minister K. Chandrashekar Rao while campaigning for last year's Assembly polls had claimed that he would win 100 seats but could bag only 39 seats.

Revanth Reddy said that "similarly, the BJP is trying to



confuse people, but people are intelligent and they are going to teach a lesson to the party". KCR has recently said that the Congress government in Telangana will not last more than a year "as nobody knows who will join the BJP and when".

"We don't know, the Chief Minister (Revanth Reddy) himself may jump to the BJP,"

he said.

KCR said while they want the Congress government to complete its five-year term, considering the recent developments, he doubts if it will last more than a year.

He also said that all surveys showed that the Congress would not get more than two Lok Sabha seats in Telangana.

'K'TAKA SHOCKER: MAN LACES DRINKING WATER WITH PESTICIDE; WIFE, TWO CHILDREN DIE

Mandya: A man laced drinking water with pesticide and gave it to his family, resulting in the death of his wife and two children. The incident was reported from Nagamangala town in Mandya district of Karnataka on Thursday.

The deceased have been identified as 23-year-old Keerthana and her children, four-year-old Jayasimha and one-year-old Rishika. According to the police, Narasimha, mixed the pesticide with the drinking water and gave it to his family.

Subsequently, Narasimha himself consumed the poisonous water and was shifted to the taluq hospital in Nagamangala town. He had married Keerthana five years ago.

The couple had frequent disputes and quarrels. Narasimha had reportedly decided to kill his wife and children and commit suicide.

The Nagamangala police have registered a case and are investigating the matter.

Narasimha worked as a barber and owned a salon.

'Yamraj' files nomination as Independent for Maharashtra's Madha LS seat

A man attired as 'Yamraj', the Hindu God of Death, and riding the deity's preferred mount, a buffalo, reached the Collectorate on Thursday to submit his nomination as an Independent candidate for Maharashtra's Madha Lok Sabha constituency.

Ram Gaikwad, garbed in a gold-and-black robe and dhoti, a gleaming golden headdress with two protruding curved white horns and toting a shining mace, announced that he would contest the LS polls from Madha to enter the Parliament with the aim of saving the country from the menace of corruption, poverty, unemployment and other ills.

He claimed that he was donning the role of 'Yamraj' to "finish" off corruption in the country, ensure Maratha quotas, prevent the misuse of central investigation agencies by the government against political rivals, the politics of hacking and breaking political parties, self-centred politics, etc. Gathering plenty of interesting glances from passers-by, who stopped



to see the unusual spectacle, the handle-bar moustache sporting candidate's arrival was heralded from quite a distance as over a hundred of his supporters lustily cheered and raised slogans in his support.

As his buffalo, guided and controlled by a couple of aides, reached the Collectorate office, Gaikwad alighted with alplomb, cast a menacing glance around and then stomped inside to submit his nomination papers.

In case his nomination is accepted,

then 'Yamraj' Gaikwad will lock horns-cum-mace with two powerful contenders - Bharatiya Janata Party's sitting MP Ranjitsinh Naik-Nimbalkar and Nationalist Congress Party-SP's Dhairyasheel Mohite-Patil, who quit the BJP last week to join Sharad Pawar's party.

Though it was labelled as a 'publicity gimmick', Gaikwad's arrival as 'Yamraj' not only made waves but managed to garner much attention though most decided to keep a safe distance from the God of Death.

Mehbooba Mufti files nomination for Anantnag-Rajouri LS seat

Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) President and former J&K Chief Minister Mehbooba Mufti on Thursday filed her nomination papers for the Anantnag-Rajouri Lok Sabha constituency.

Accompanied by senior PDP leaders and a large number of supporters, she filed her papers before the District Development Commissioner, Anantnag, who is the returning officer of the constituency.

Earlier on Thursday, senior NC leader Mian Altaf Ahmad filed papers for this constituency, while Democratic Progressive Azad Party (DPAP) President Ghulam Nabi Azad, who hinted at joining the fray, has now announced he would not contest the Lok Sabha election.

J&K Apni Party, headed by



Syed Altaf Bukhari, has decided to field Zafar Iqbal Manhas from the constituency. The BJP has not, so far, announced its candidates for any of the 3 Lok Sabha constituencies of the Kashmir Valley.

The Congress is supporting the NC candidates in the Valley, and the NC is reciprocating the support in the 2 Lok Sabha seats in the Jammu division.

Anantnag-Rajouri is the only Lok Sabha constituency in J&K that has voting segments in both the Kashmir Valley and the Jammu division, as it comprises the districts of Anantnag and Kulgam in the Valley and Poonch and Rajouri in the Jammu division.

Friday is the last date for filing nomination papers for the constituency that goes to polls on May 7.

UP's glass skywalk to open after Lok Sabha polls in Chitrakoot

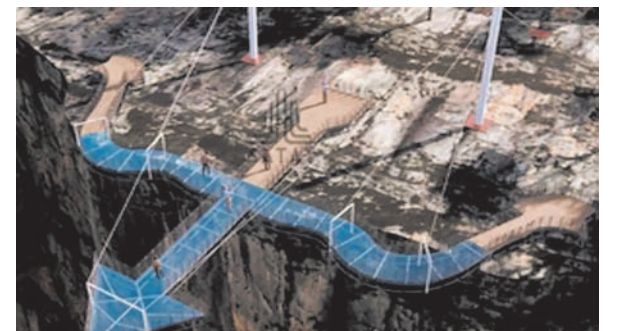

Union Minister for Parliamentary Affairs, Coal, and Mines, Pralhad Joshi, asserted on Thursday that Rahul Gandhi's act of holding the flag of Muslim League in Wayanad is inciting anti-Hindu sentiments.

Addressing reporters, Joshi stated that during his nomination paper submission in Wayanad, Rahul Gandhi held the flag of the Muslim League instead of the Congress party's flag.

Joshi alleged that the Muslim League had called for a 'direct action day' against Hindus, advocating violence such as killing Hindus and raping Hindu women. By aligning himself with the Muslim League, which supports subversive activities, and contesting elections, Rahul Gandhi is directly contributing to the escalation of anti-Hindu incidents, Joshi stated.

"Rahul Gandhi bears direct responsibility for the anti-Hindu acts occurring in Karnataka. Incidents such as attacks on Hindus for chanting 'Jai Shri Ram' are facilitated by the Congress party," he alleged.



Joshi slammed Congress for appeasement of Muslims, which he claims has led to incidents like the chanting of pro-Pakistan slogans in Vidhana Soudha, attacks on individuals for reciting Hanuman Chalisa and raising Jai Shri Ram slogans. He asserted that these incidents demonstrate the Congress party's anti-Hindu stance.

Joshi further claimed that states governed by Congress are supportive of terrorist activities. He further urged the public to remain vigilant and awake to this reality.

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, on Thursday, blamed the Election Commission (EC) for the stray incidence of clashes during Ram Navami processions at Murshidabad on Wednesday evening in which some persons were reportedly injured.

"The commission replaced the deputy inspector general of Murshidabad Range just before the Ram Navami festival. What was the reason for doing so. He was well acquainted with the entire district. There was no justification for replacing him. These are very sensitive states. We have to toil hard to keep things under control here," the Chief Minister said while addressing an election rally at Raiganj in North Dinajpur district.



Recently, DIG (Murshidabad Range) Mukesh Kumar was replaced by Syed Waqar Raza, a 2008-batch

Indian Police Service officer. Mukesh was removed reportedly after opposition parties accused him of not play-

ing an unbiased role since the model code of conduct for the Lok Sabha polls had been in place.

Speaking at the election rally, the Chief Minister further said that in the clashes on Wednesday evening, even some officials of the district police were injured. Targeting the BJP, she claimed that they would first create problems in an area and then complain against Trinamool Congress holding it responsible.

Incidentally, the Leader of the Opposition in the West Bengal assembly Suwendu Adhikari informed on Tuesday, that he had written a letter to West Bengal Governor C.V. Ananda Bose and requested him to take up the matter with the Commission so that the latter can take action against the Chief Minister for provoking the tension on Ram Navami procession through her speeches during the last few days.

In the first phase of Lok Sabha Elections-2024, voting will be held in 6 Lok Sabha parliamentary constituencies of the state on Friday, April 19. Voting will be held from 7 am to 6 pm in Lok Sabha parliamentary constituencies No. 11 Sidhi, No. 12 Shahdol (ST), No. 13 Jabalpur, No. 14 Mandla (ST), No. 15 Balaghat and No. 16 Chhindwara. Voting will be held from 7 am to 4 pm in only three assembly constituencies of Balaghat Lok Sabha parliamentary constituency - No. 108 Baihar (ST), No. 109 Lanji and No. 110 Parswara. All the polling parties have left for their respective polling centers to conduct the voting.

In the first phase of Lok Sabha elections in Madhya Pradesh, more than 1 crore 13 lakh voters will exercise their franchise in six parliamentary constituencies. During this period, complete security arrangements have been made. At the same time, air ambulance will also be available to provide emergency health facilities. State Chief Electoral Officer Anupam Rajan said that voting is going to be held on Friday in six parliamentary constituencies of the state, Sidhi, Shahdol, Jabalpur,



Mandla, Balaghat and Chhindwara. Of these, two areas Shahdol and Mandla are reserved for Scheduled Caste and Tribe category. Polling teams are reaching their respective polling centers with materials.

The six parliamentary constituencies where voting is to be held include 46 assembly constituencies and are spread across 13 districts. A total of 88 candidates are in the electoral fray, of which 81 are men and seven are women. Maximum 19 can-

didates are in Jabalpur and least 10 candidates are in Shahdol. Voting time will be from 7 am to 6 pm. Voting will be held from 7 am to 4 pm in the three assembly constituencies of Balaghat parliamentary constituency, Baihar, Lanji and Parswara, which are areas of Naxalite influence.

Giving information in view of the election preparations, Rajan said that one more ambulance is available in Jabalpur a day before the vot-

ing, which will remain till the end of the voting. Along with this, a helicopter is being kept in Balaghat till the completion of voting on 18th and 19th April. Till the first phase of voting, cash and material worth more than Rs 120 crore has been seized.

Holiday declared on voting day
For the convenience of voters, there will be a public and general holiday on polling day (April 19) in the above mentioned 6 parliamentary constituencies. The state government has declared public holiday and general holiday in the respective areas on the day of polling using the powers conferred in Section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

Citizens to get information about voting percentage from Voter Turn-out App and CEO MP website

On the day of voting, information about voting percentage will be available on the Voter Turnout App of the Election Commission of India and the website of Chief Electoral Officer, Madhya Pradesh <https://ceomadhya Pradesh.nic.in>. Through this, citizens will be able to get information about the voting percentage recorded every two hours. Citizens will have to download the Voter-Turnout App by visiting Google Play Store.

In view of the frequent accidents happening in open tube well bores, Electronics Development Corporation has issued a new guideline for tube well boring. Under which a mobile app has been devel-

oped. Only with its help can a new bore be made. With this, private and government boring agencies will have to register in this app. The person doing the boring will also have to upload complete information regarding the bore. On the basis of which government agencies will get information related to the bore.

Information about the new bore will have to be uploaded in the mobile app, in which information including photos regarding the success and failure of the bore will be uploaded. If the bore has failed, it must be safely shut down. The department has also started the trial of the new mobile app from Wednesday.

The department has kept the



option of all types of information related to boring on this portal. In which information about all private and government open and closed tube wells in urban and rural areas will be uploaded. This will enable us

to know where there are bores that need to be protected. - Cemented platform will have to be made. If water does not come out during boring, then it will have to be filled with soil, ballast and other materials. Along with this, a cement block will have to be made and secured. Whose information will be put on the mobile app along with the photo.

Chief Engineer KK Songaria says that the department has also launched a mobile app along with the portal. In which along with the new bore, the boring agencies will also have to register themselves. Information about open bores will also be updated on the portal, so that accidents can be prevented.

11 from J&K qualify UPSC Exam 2023

Eleven candidates from Jammu and Kashmir have qualified for this year's Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) Civil Service exams, the results of which were declared by the Commission on Tuesday. The notification issued by the UPSC said that 1,016 candidates have passed this year's Civil Service exam in which Aditya Srivastava from Uttar Pradesh has topped the selection list. Twenty-four-year-old Anmol Rathore from Doda district has secured seventh All India Rank (AIR) in the examination. She had also topped the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Examination (JKCSE) 2022 and is currently undergoing training at the Revenue Training Institute in Jammu. Anmol said she completed her studies from her house except for some mock tests and the UPSC Mains test series which she attended in Delhi. "Otherwise, I have prepared on my own using the material available online. I would say the youth of this region have huge potential provided their energy is channelled in the right direction," she added. Another candidate, Arjun Gupta of Kathua district has achieved 32nd rank in the select list. Manan Bhat of Srinagar district has secured 88th rank this year. He had earlier also qualified for the civil services exam securing 231 AIR. At present, Bhat is an IPS officer in the Telangana cadre. Harnit Singh Sudan of Jammu has secured an AIR of 177, Mohammad Haris Mir an AIR of 345, Mohammad Farhan Seh AIR 369, Aparajita Aryan AIR 381, Ghulam Maya Din AIR 388, Suwan Sharma AIR 412, Seerat Baji AIR 516 and Dinesh Kumar AIR 1,003.

First phase of LS polls Will Modi-Yogi popularity override caste equations in UP?

The wave of Prime Minister Modi's popularity, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath's stern dealing with the law & order situation and the euphoria over the Ram temple has started overriding the caste equations in Uttar Pradesh. The state has always witnessed the caste factor come into play whenever elections are to be held, but now it is the popularity of PM Modi and CM Yogi Adityanath that is overtaking all other issues. In the first phase of elections in western UP, where normally the voting pattern of Muslims and Dalits decides the fate of candidates, this time there is a palpable difference because all that seems to be working is the Modi and Yogi factor. The performance of Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) candidates in this phase will also decide the party's future. The BSP has tweaked its strategy when it fielded candidates from castes who, otherwise, are believed to be the core voters of the BJP but apparently, candidates are unable to wean away these votes from the BJP's bag. For example, in 2014, Muzaffarnagar was won by BJP's Sanjeev Baliyan by a low margin of 6,400 votes, and Meerut was won by BJP's Rajendra Agrawal by a margin of around 4,700 votes. In Muzaffarnagar, where the Muslims form around 30 per cent of the electorate, the BSP has fielded Dara Singh Prajapati, an OBC hoping to corner the votes of his community as well as the party's traditional Dalit community. However, the BJP has gained ground in both these constituencies and caste factors have receded into the background. Prime Minister Narendra Modi's rally in Meerut and Yogi Adityanath's rally in Muzaffarnagar has turned the tide completely in BJP's favour. In Meerut, the BSP has Deovrat Tyagi, a Brahmin against BJP's Arun Govil, who played Lord Rama in the serial 'Ramayana'. The BSP nominee is eyeing the support of around 50,000 'Tyagi' voters in Meerut, apart from Dalit and Muslim votes, but sources claim that upper castes and Dalits are preparing to vote for BJP this time. In an interesting development, this time, the Muslim mood towards the BJP has also softened to an extent and even Dalits are veering towards BJP after being disillusioned by Mayawati's indecision.



Observers believe that, unlike Assembly elections, the Muslim voters will be more tactful this time. They will not blindly choose between the BSP and the SP-Congress alliance but will weigh the benefits they have received from the BJP governments at the centre and state. Haji Ikhlq, a trader in Meerut, says, "The BJP is no longer untouchable for us. We have received the benefits of their welfare schemes and there is no reason why we will not vote for them. Muslims are breaking the earlier mindset and the change will be visible in these elections." In the 2014 Lok Sabha polls and 2017 Assembly elections, the minority voters supported candidates of both SP and BSP leading to the division of votes. The BJP got the maximum number of 71 Lok Sabha in 2014 and 312 Assembly seats in 2022. In 2022, the minority vote consolidated towards the Samajwadi Party, but it could not cross the 112-seat mark. It is only the Jatavs among Dalits in the west UP region who are likely to remain loyal to

Mayawati. In Saharanpur, BJP's Raghav Lakhani Pal, a Brahmin is pitted against Congress-SP alliance candidate Imran Masood and BSP's Majid Ali, one of the richest candidates in the fray. Imran Masood is facing a tough challenge from BSP, which could make it easier for BJP to sail through to victory. In Meerut, SP candidate and former mayor Sunita Verma, a Jatav, is likely to draw support from the voters of her caste which will dent BSP's base. In Nagina (SC), Azad Samaj Party chief Chandra Shekhar Azad is likely to make some dent in BSP's vote bank. "If Chandra Shekhar dents BSP, the victory run for BJP will be much easier," said a local leader. BJP's Kunwar Sarvesh Singh, in Moradabad, could find it easier to reach the victory post as BSP's Israr Saifi is locked in a crucial battle of Muslims and Dalit votes with SP's Ruchi Veera. However, in Pilibhit, BSP is not

a major factor. In Pilibhit, Lodh Rajputs or Lodhs would be the deciding factor. It is the vote from this community which will decide who will have the last laugh - BJP's Jitin Prasad or SP's Bhagwat Saran Gangwar. Jitin Prasad, meanwhile, is riding high on the Modi wave and the rallies by the Prime Minister and Yogi Adityanath have strengthened his position in the past week. In Rampur, a lot will depend on how enthusiastic the voters are on the day of voting. There is a clear division of Muslim votes after SP leader Mohd Azam Khan refused to accept the party's official candidate Muhibullah Nadiwi. His supporters are throwing their weight behind Zeeshan Khan of BSP. The BJP candidate Ghanshyam Lodhi stands safe in his position.

Kargil War was an 'ill-conceived blunder', admit former Pakistani military officers

One of the many adventures in the Pakistan-India series of conflicts 'Operation Koh Paima', also known as the Kargil operation -- that was hailed as a success story by its architect and Pakistani military dictator Late General (ret'd) Pervez Musharraf -- is now being labelled as a "strategic blunder" and a "political disaster" by a majority of experts, including former military officers who were serving during the 1999 operation. "The plan was a blunder and a massive failure. It not only turned out to be a disaster, it also violated the Lahore Summit agreement between India and Pakistan. Also, because the Pakistan Army denied its involvement, even refused to accept the dead bodies of its own soldiers who were later buried by the Indian Armed forces, turned out to be more embarrassing and attracted more dishonour to the institution," says Colonel (ret'd) Ashfaq Hussain. The Kargil conflict happened during May and July 1999. It was a decision, undertaken by some top military heads, who initiated the operation without even taking their own Prime Minister at the time, Nawaz Sharif in confidence. The main target of the operation was to cut off the link between Kashmir and Ladakh, block the National Highway-1 and force the Indian forces to compromise their positions from the Siachen glacier. The military minds were of the view that the operation would force India to retreat and come to table talks for resolving the Kashmir dispute on Islamabad's terms. "On one side, Pakistan was faced with international pressure and

on the other side, the plan failed miserably as China did not act as per Islamabad's assumptions. Our then Foreign Minister Sartaj Aziz got a cold shoulder from China along with all others because Islamabad's version that it was not its Army but the Kashmir freedom fighters at Kargil, was a story not bought by anyone," Hussain added. At the time, General Musharraf was leading the operation while his team included Chief of General Staff Lieutenant General Aziz Khan, Commander 10 Corps Lt. General Mahmood Ahmed, and Forces Commander Northern Areas Major General Javed Hassan. While the plan to execute the Kargil operation was the brainchild of a few military heads, the overall plan was bound to fail as it was based on wrong assumptions which were kept in hiding even from the Pakistani Prime Minister along with the country's Chiefs of Air Force and Navy. Keeping in view that the normal practice of both Indian and Pakistani forces was to leave their posts at high altitude during the extreme weather conditions of winter snow and reoccupy them at spring, Pakistani forces and their proxies reoccupied the forward positions before the Indians and took control of the strategic heights of Kargil, Drass and Batalik. The Indian forces then launched 'Operation Vijay' to retake their strategic posts. As the battle between the two sides gained heat, the Pakistani side took advantage of the higher peaks and responded to Indian artillery fire. "We had the advantage of the higher peak position. We could spot them from the height and counter fire on

them more effectively," said Colonel Ret'd. Ashfaq Hussain, author of the book 'Witness to Blunder' that details his firsthand experience of the time, sitting as an officer in the Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR) in Rawalpindi. The plan on Pakistan's side, limited to the few military minds, was that its occupation of the high peaks at Kargil would force the Indian forces away from Siachen and the international community would intervene during the early stage to normalise the situation, leaving Pakistan with gains along the LoC (Line of Control). Nawaz Sharif, the then Prime Minister who claimed he was completely unaware of the Kargil plan at the start, seemed to act in a way that hinted otherwise. It seemed that he was aware of the plan but had no idea on the serious consequences of the stunt. Sharif may have been of the view that if the Kargil operation goes as planned, then he would own up to it standing tall as the victor of Kashmir. But because of his limited information on the actual plan and lack of assessment on the counter-offensive strategy adopted by India, Sharif preferred to maintain being naive and unknown to the developments. It was by the end of June that Kargil operation was established as a disastrous failure, with the US President Bill Clinton demanding Pakistan to immediately withdraw its forces from the Indian side of the LoC. "Kargil adventure was a blunder. It was a much bigger blunder than the surrender of 1971," says Colonel (ret'd) Ashfaq Hussain.

IDF carries out airstrikes in Rafah, casualties feared

The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) carried out aerial strikes in the Rafah area during the early hours of Thursday. According to Israeli and Arabic media, many were feared dead and several were injured in the attack. Since Iran carried out missile and drone attacks on Israel, the IDF has upped its ante against the Hamas and Hezbollah militants. On Wednesday, the IDF carried out an aerial attack in which seven people were killed. The allies of Israel, including the US, the UK and France had requested Israel not to attack the Rafah region as the population density in the region is high. An estimated 1.3

million people are living in the region and any attack to flush out militants could lead to heavy civilian casualties. While Israel has produced an evacuation plan for the civilians in the region, the US was not satisfied with the plan. Egyptian President Abdel Fattah El-Sisi had expressed his concern about a probable Israel attack on the Rafah region to the US Secretary of State Antony Blinken during his last visit to the Middle East. President Sisi had informed Blinken that any attack on Rafah would lead to an unprecedented exodus of refugees to the Sinai region of Egypt that shares the border with Rafah region.

9 injured after 6.6-magnitude quake hits Japan

At least nine people were injured after an earthquake with a magnitude of 6.6 struck a wide area of western Japan, local authorities said on Thursday. The quake struck at around 11:14 p.m. local time, registering lower 6 on the Japanese seismic intensity scale of 7 in Ehime and Kochi prefectures, both on Shikoku Island, with the epicentre in the Bungo Channel, a strait separating the islands of Kyushu and Shikoku, the Japan Meteorological Agency said as quoted by Xinhua news agency report. According to prefectural governments and local fire departments, six people in Ehime Prefecture and one person in Kochi Prefecture sustained minor injuries, while two were hurt in Oita Prefecture in the Kyushu region, southwestern Japan. A valve defect reduced the power output of the No.3 reactor at the Ikata nuclear complex in Ehime Prefecture by two per cent, though there was no major problem with overall operations, Shikoku Electric Power said. Meanwhile, Japanese researchers warned that earthquakes could continue for another week or so following the powerful tremor, and people in the region should stay alert, Japanese daily Mainichi Shimbun reported. According to Takuya Nishimura, a professor at Kyoto University's Disaster Prevention Research Institute specialising in geodesy, which involves measuring Earth's geometry, said the area near the Bungo Channel has experienced quakes in the past that caused significant damage. "We need to prepare for earthquakes, keeping in mind that they will continue for the next week or so," the researcher warned.

Indonesia issues tsunami warning after more eruption from Mount Ruang

Indonesian authorities have issued a tsunami warning and raised the alert for Mount Ruang to the highest level after the volcano near Sulawesi Island had multiple large eruptions over the past two days. The heightened alert was issued late on Wednesday after the 725-meter-high volcano had two large eruptions earlier in the day, spewing a column of ash 3,000 metres into the sky. The head of Center for Volcanology and Geological Hazard Mitigation (PVMBG), Hendra Gunawan, said that authorities urged people living in the coastal area of neighboring Tagulandang island to remain alert for a potential tidal surge and tsunami which could be triggered by rockfalls from the volcano, which may collapse into the sea. More than 800 people have been evacuated from two villages on Ruang island and



authorities imposed an exclusion zone within a 6-kilometre radius of the crater, which extends to the south-western part of Tagulandang Island. "Mount Ruang's eruption spewed ashfall, rocks and gravels that fell five kilometres away from the coastal areas of Tagulandang Island. Several residents were reported to have been hit by the falling rocks and stones," said Abdul Muhari, spokesman for the National Disaster

Mitigation Agency. Indonesian aviation authorities have issued a NOTAM ordering the closure of Sam Ratulangi airport in Manado, the provincial capital of North Sulawesi about 100 kilometres south of the volcano. The NOTAM has disrupted flights between Kuala Lumpur and major cities in Sabah and Sarawak, the Malaysian states in the neighbouring island of Borneo, which Indonesia shares with Malaysia and Brunei. Mount Ruang last erupted in 2002, spewing out pyroclastic flows that damaged the land and local settlements. The eruptions at Mount Ruang, located in North Sulawesi province, were preceded by volcanic earthquakes in recent days. There are roughly 500 mountains that dot the Indonesian archipelago, of which 127 are active volcanoes and dozens of them have been showing signs of increased activity.



Salman case: Bishnois unhappy with Maha CM, seek apology for 'defaming' community

Days after Bollywood actor Salman Khan's Bandra home was targeted by the Lawrence Bishnoi gang, Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde is now under fire from the enraged Bishnoi community. Members of the community have taken to social media, countering CM Shinde and expressed outrage over his purported remarks to "eliminate" the (Bishnoi) gangsters and vowed to protect the actor and his family from any future hits.

"Anybody who threatens the existence of the Bishnoi community must say sorry to us. Eknath Shinde Tender an Apology," said an X campaign launched yesterday, which got over 16,000 views, likes, forwards and comments.

The Bishnois, who are a Hindu sect and nature-lovers, are sprinkled across northern and north-western parts of India, and have been opposing Salman Khan since the blackbuck poaching incident of 1998.

On Tuesday, Shinde was received by Khans in the lobby of Galaxy Apartments, facing the Arabian Sea, and then escorted to the actor's sprawling first-floor residence where he interacted freely with the entire family.

After spending some time with Khans, the CM emerged and assured the media that contrary to speculation in some quarters, "there is no gang (war) in Mumbai".



Under the MahaYuti government, he said that the mafia has no (place) in Mumbai and said that protecting the family of Salman Khan is the duty of the police and the responsibility of the state government.

"I have assured Salman Khan and his family that we are with them. We will crush this (Lawrence) Bishnoi gang so that no one will dare to repeat such an act in Mumbai. The safety of Salman Khan is our job," asserted CM Shinde.

On April 14, two unknown assailants opened at least five rounds at the home of Salman Khan before speeding off on their motorcycle from there, using multiple getaway modes and escape routes.

The duo - later identified as Vicky Gupta, 24 and Sagar Pal, 23 - fled to Gujarat, in the Pakistan-bordering Kachchh district's Bhuj town.

Using tech intelligence and local field sources, they were nabbed in a joint operation of the Gujarat and Mumbai Police, cracking the case in barely 36 hours.

The shooters were brought to Mumbai on Tuesday and produced before a Magistrate Court which has remanded them to police custody till April 25.

Among other things, the interrogation of the accused has revealed the conspiracy of the shoot-out, the planning from a flat which served as a base camp in Navi Mumbai's Panvel - where the Khans also own a sprawling country house, Arpita Farms.

Gupta and Pal also claimed they junked the guns into some water bodies in south Gujarat. The accused revealed how they were instructed to fire a dozen rounds to virtually terrorise the family of the actor - who has run afoul of the Bishnoi community for over 25 years now.

Simultaneously, Anmol Bishnoi, the brother of the jailed gangster Lawrence Bishnoi, posted a social media note informing Salman Khan to treat it as "the first and final warning", sending shudders down Bollywood which has witnessed many similar incidents in the past.

Meanwhile, security has been beefed up at both Salman Khan's Mumbai home and Panvel (Raigad) farmhouse, but there is no official reaction from the government, ruling Shiv Sena, or the Khan family to the Bishnoi social media campaign so far.

Maha CM says change is certain in Baramati as NCP's Sunetra Pawar files nomination

The MahaYuti partners on Thursday put up a massive show of strength at a rally in Pune at the timing of the filing of nomination by NCP nominee from Baramati Sunetra Pawar. Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar also filed his nomination as the substitute from the Baramati constituency.

NCP sources said it has been done as a precautionary move. After Sunetra Pawar's nomination is accepted, Ajit Pawar's nomination will be rejected during scrutiny. The late date for filing of nomination for Baramati is April 19 while the polling is slated for May 7. The BJP nominee from Pune, Muralidhar Mohol, who was present at the rally, did not file his nomination as the polling for Pune seat is slated for May 13.

Chief Minister Eknath Shinde in his speech claimed it is time for a change in Baramati as people of the constituency have decided that "This battle is historic, it is not personal. It is a battle for development and against dynastic politics. The transformation in Baramati is certain," said CM Shinde at the rally. He announced that "Ab



Ki Baar Sunetra tai Pawar". CM Shinde took a swipe at NCP(SP) chief Sharad Pawar, saying after Prime Minister Narendra Modi left his finger, the latter transformed the country.

"Prime Minister Narendra Modi had said that he learned politics by holding the finger of Sharad Pawar. But after leaving Sharad Pawar's finger, PM Modi transformed the country," he said taking a dig at Sharad Pawar.

CM Shinde further said that Ajit Pawar also left his uncle and his finger. The chief minister also expressed confidence that Sunetra Pawar and Ajit Pawar will not rest until Baramati is transformed.

Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis said that no one will be able to stop

the sister-in-law (Sunetra Pawar is sister-in-law of Supriya Stule) in Baramati. He urged the MahaYuti workers to ramp up outreach to voters.

"Now we just have to go door-to-door in Baramati, reach out to the people and bring them to the polling booths. I believe that the sister-in-law (Sunetra Pawar) will go to Delhi. With your blessings, history will be made and Sunetra Pawar will go to Delhi as an MP," he said.

In his speech, Ajit Pawar asserted that the present election is a fight between PM Modi and Congress leader Rahul Gandhi.

"The party workers should not be complacent but work hard so that PM Modi secures a third term at the Centre," he said.

Bitcoin scam case

ED attaches assets worth over Rs 97 cr of Raj Kundra, Shilpa Shetty

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has attached immovable and movable properties worth Rs 97.79 crore belonging to Ripu Sudan Kundra aka Raj Kundra, businessman, and husband of Bollywood actor Shilpa Shetty, under the provisions of Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), 2002.

The attached properties include a residential flat in Juhu, which is in the name of Shilpa Shetty, another residential bungalow in Pune and equity shares in Raj Kundra's name.

The financial probe agency had initiated an investigation based on multiple FIRs registered by Maharashtra Police and Delhi Police against Variable Tech Pte Ltd, Late Amit Bhardwaj, Ajay Bhardwaj, Vivek Bhardwaj, Simpy Bhardwaj, Mahender Bhardwaj and a number of MLM agents.

It has been alleged that they had collected huge amounts of funds in the form of Bitcoins (worth Rs 6,600 crore in 2017 itself) from the public with false promises of a 10 per cent per month return in the form of Bitcoins.



The collected Bitcoins were supposed to be utilised for Bitcoin mining, and investors were to get huge returns in Crypto assets.

"But the promoters cheated the investors and have been concealing the ill-gotten Bitcoins in obscure online wallets. The probe also revealed that Raj Kundra received 285 Bitcoins from the mastermind and promoter of Gain Bitcoin Ponzi Scam, Amit Bhardwaj, for setting up a Bitcoin mining farm in Ukraine," ED said in a statement issued on Thursday.

The said Bitcoins were sourced out of proceeds of crime collected by Amit Bhardwaj from gullible investors.

"Since the deal didn't materialise, Kundra is still in possession and enjoyment of 285 Bitcoins which are presently valued at more than Rs. 150 Crore," said the ED official.

During the investigation, multiple search operations were carried out in this case and three persons were arrested.

"Simpy Bhardwaj was arrested on December 17, 2023, Nitin Gaur on December 29, 2023, and Nikhil Mahajan on January 16, 2023. All of them are presently in judicial custody as of date," said the official.

However, the main accused Ajay Bhardwaj and Mahendra Bhardwaj are still absconding.

Earlier, ED had attached properties worth Rs 69 crore. The Prosecution Complaint in this was filed on June 11, 2019, and the Supplementary Prosecution Complaint on February 14, 2024.

"The Special PMLA court has taken cognizance of the same. Further investigation is under progress," the official added.

BJP nominates Narayan Rane from Ratnagiri Sindhudurg LS seat

The BJP has nominated Union Minister Narayan Rane from Ratnagiri Sindhudurg Lok Sabha constituency in Maharashtra's Konkarn region, thus ending the suspense.

Rane's nomination was declared a day ahead of the last date of nomination which falls on April 19. The polling is slated for May 7. He is pitted against the Shiv Sena UBT nominee and sitting MP, Vinayak Raut.

Incidentally, CM Eknath Shinde, who is the chief leader of Shiv Sena, had staked the party's claim but could not get it.

Shiv Sena Minister Uday Samant's brother Kiran Samant, who had started a campaign and stepped up outreach with voters in the



last six months, was keen to contest the seat. Rane's term in the Rajya Sabha had ended recently as he was not renominated again though he was tipped off for candidature in the Lok Sabha polls from Ratnagiri Sindhudurg.

Congress cries foul at MahaYuti for 'using' Maha public buses in poll campaign

The Congress on Thursday lodged a complaint against the ruling MahaYuti ally Shiv Sena for allegedly violating the model code of conduct by using some 1,000 Maharashtra state transport buses for a poll campaign, here. Congress Chief Spokesperson Atul Londhe has written to the Maharashtra Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) pointing out the unauthorised use of Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC)'s buses for displaying publicity material of the ruling MahaYuti alliance.

"The banners have a huge picture of Prime Minister Narendra Modi along with the Bow and Arrow symbol of the Shiv Sena and photos of Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, Deputy CMs Devendra Fadnis and Ajit Pawar. As per the Election Commission of India's letter no. 437/6/INST/2015-CCS



dated 29.12.2015, the use of government and PSUs properties is banned for electoral campaigning. Despite this ban, the ST officials have allowed the illegal use of over 1,000 buses for the election campaign of Shiv Sena candidates," said Londhe's letter.

He called upon the CEO to take immediate and decisive action to address these violations, and cancel the candidature of all the LS candi-

dates of Shiv Sena plus initiate appropriate disciplinary measures against the Shinde-led party.

Londhe also demanded action should also be taken against the senior officials of the Planning and Commercial Department of MSRTC for violation of Model Code of Conduct and ECI instructions in this regard to ensure the integrity of the election process.

Maharashtra gears up for Phase 1, voting for 5 constituencies to be held today

The first phase of voting for the Lok Sabha elections 2024 will be held on April 19. More than 95 lakh voters are eligible to exercise their franchise on Friday in the first phase of Lok Sabha elections 2024 in Maharashtra covering five constituencies, including some Naxal-hit areas, where campaigning ended on Wednesday evening.

Polling will be held in the constituencies of Nagpur, Ramtek, Bhandara-Gondia, Chandrapur and Gadchiroli-Chimur, all located in the eastern-most parts of the state.

In Nagpur, a direct fight is on the cards between Union Minister Nitin Gadkari of the BJP and Congress candidate Vikas Thakre. The constituency, which houses the RSS headquarters, has a total of 22,18,259 voters - 11,10,840 males, 11,07,197 females and 222 transgender persons.

In Chandrapur, BJP candidate and Maharashtra minister Sudhir Mungantiwar is facing Congress nominee Pratibha Dhanorkar, wife of late Suresh Dhanorkar who was the lone Congress MP elected to the Lok Sabha from Maharashtra in 2019 from the seat. The Congress MP died last year. Chandrapur has a total of 18,36,314 voters, including 9,45,026 males and 8,91,240 females.

In Bhandara-Gondia, the BJP has fielded sitting MP Sunil Mendhe, who is pitted against Congress candidate Dr Prashant Patole. Bhandara-Gondia



has a total of 18,75,106 voters (9,36,041 males, 9,39,056 females and 12 transgenders).

Two-time MP of BJP, Ashok Nete, is contesting against Congress nominee Dr Namdev Kirsan of Gadchiroli-Chimur. In the 2019 elections, Nete defeated Congress candidate Dr Namdev Usendi. The constituency has 16,12,930 voters (8,11,836 males, 8,01,082 females and 12 transgenders).

In Ramtek, the fight is between Shyamkumar Barve of the Congress and Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena's candidate Raju Parwe. The constituency has a total of 20,45,717 voters (10,43,266 males, 10,02,396 females and 55 transgenders).

A statement by the state electoral office said five assembly segments (spread across two LS seats)

will vote between 7 am and 3 pm, unlike other areas where voters can exercise their franchise until 6 pm.

There are 95,54,667 voters in the five Lok Sabha constituencies where voting will take place on Friday (April 19). Of these, 48,28,142 are male, 47,26,178 female and 347 transgenders, said the statement.

"The assembly segments of Amgaon, Armori, Gadchiroli and Aheri (Gadchiroli-Chimur Lok Sabha constituency) and Arjune Morgaon (Bhandara-Gondia LS seat) will have voting between 7 am and 3 pm. This decision has been taken because most of the voting booths in these segments are located in remote locations, and the region is known for Naxalite activities," a poll official said.

Gadchiroli-Chimur, where some parts are affected by Naxal insurgency, is considered the largest parliamentary constituency in the state, chiefly because its remote villages are separated by vast dense forest regions.

This Lok Sabha constituency consists of the Amgaon assembly segment from Gondia district, Armori, Gadchiroli, and Aheri segments from Gadchiroli district, and Bramhapuri and Chimur segments from Chandrapur district.

Leader of Opposition in Maharashtra Legislative Assembly Vijay Wadetiwar is the Congress MLA from Bramhapuri.

Son of civic sweeper in Maharashtra cracks Civil Services Exam

For 32-year-old Prashant Suresh Bhojane, whose mother works as a civic sweeper in Maharashtra's Thane city, cracking the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) exam was always his dream, and he persevered against all odds to finally fulfil the goal. sweeper with the Thane Municipal Corporation (TMC), while his father is a Class IV employee in the civic body. He completed his engineering degree, but was not interested in doing a job in that field as becoming an IAS officer was always his dream, his family members said.

Talking to PTI, Prashant said that while appearing for the UPSC exam, he started working in Delhi in 2020 at a competitive exam coaching centre, where he was given the job of checking mock exam papers of students.

"That way I could study as well as earn my livelihood," he said.

He said his parents would regularly ask him to stop giving the exams and return home, but he was confident and determined that he would achieve his goal one day.

Bombay HC allows victim of child marriage to get her pregnancy terminated

The Bombay High Court has permitted a teenager, a victim of child marriage, to undergo medical termination of her 28-week pregnancy on the grounds of foetal abnormalities. A division bench of Justices P D Naik and N R Borkar in its order of April 12 also noted that the girl was 'HIV seropositive'. A copy of the order was made available on Thursday. The 17-year-old girl had filed a petition in HC seeking permission to get her pregnancy terminated saying scans had shown that the foetus had skeletal anomalies with the possibility of genetic abnormalities.

Under the Medical Termination of Pregnancy



Act, a court nod is required to terminate a pregnancy beyond 24 weeks of gestation. The high court relied on a report submitted by the medical board of the state-run Sassoon General Hospital in Pune that recommended termination of the pregnancy as the girl is a

minor and a victim of child marriage with 'HIV seropositive status'. The board in its report said the foetus also has multiple defects. The high court said it was allowing termination of pregnancy taking into account the mental and medical situation of the girl.



Kanye West Accused of Punching Man

Kanye "Ye" West is reportedly under investigation by the Los Angeles Police Department for allegedly punching a man, whom the rapper, 46, accused of sexually assaulting his wife, Bianca Censori. The incident took place on Tuesday, April 16, at the Chateau Marmont Hotel on Sunset Boulevard in L.A., according to multiple outlets.

TMZ was the first to report the news on Wednesday, April 17. Per the outlet, Censori, 29, and West "took off" right after West allegedly punched the man in question. The unidentified person did not require medical attention. A rep for the "Jesus Walks" rapper also provided a statement to the outlet, claiming that Censori was not simply "grabbed" by the individual but was "sexually assaulted" by him.

"He put his hands under her dress, directly on her body, he grabbed her waist, he spun her around, and then he blew her kisses," the spokesperson said. "She was battered and sexually assaulted. 'Grabbed' is grossly inadequate as a description of what happened. Bianca was physically assaulted."

Legendary filmmaker Quentin Tarantino, who is known for 'Pulp Fiction', 'Django Unchained', 'Reservoir Dogs', and others, is not interested in making 'The Movie Critic', which he previously said would be his final directorial venture.

The director has given the project a thumbs down, reports 'Variety'.

'The Movie Critic' would have been Tarantino's 10th feature film, but sources say he won't be looking to rewrite the script or revive the project, instead making plans to move on to something new.

As per 'Variety', Brad Pitt had been cast in a lead role in the film. At one point, Tarantino had said the 1977-set film was about a small-time movie critic who wrote smart reviews for a porn magazine. It was also rumoured that Pitt would play some form of his 'Once Upon a Time... in Hollywood' character Cliff Booth, who in Tarantino's novelisation of the feature was a big movie buff.

Tarantino talked briefly about 'The Movie Critic' before an audience at the Cannes Film Festival last year, saying, "I can't tell you guys (anything) until you see the movie. I'm tempted to do some of the character's monologues right now, but I'm not going to. Maybe if there were less video cameras. You just have to wait and see."

The news was first reported by 'Deadline'.

The plan to film 'The Movie Critic' was moving along before Tarantino had a change of heart. In addition to casting Pitt, the production had secured a \$20 million tax subsidy from the state of California.

It remains uncertain which project the auteur will pursue next, as he had also decided against an R-rated 'Star Trek' film in 2019, saying it was too big a project. "Look, I might come up with a really big idea. But right now, the idea of a smaller audience almost all the way around is appealing to me," he said at the time.

In the next over, Harpreet flicked to deep backward square leg off Hardik. Kagiso Rabada's six made the equation 12 runs off the final over, but his run-out by Mohammad Nabi ensured relief for MI and heartbreak for PBKS.

LONG JUMPER SREESHANKAR MURALI RULED OUT OF PARIS OLYMPICS WITH KNEE INJURY

With less than 100 days to go for Paris 2024, ace Indian long jumper Sreeshankar Murali has unfortunately been sidelined from the Olympics due to a knee injury, he sustained during training, which requires surgery.

The Asian Games and Commonwealth Games silver medalist shared the heartbreaking news with a social media post, "All my life, I've had the courage to look at a setback in the eye, accept situations I can't change, and work hard at dictating the outcomes of those I can. Unfortunately, in what feels like a nightmare, but is a reality, my Paris Olympic

Games dream is over," the post read. "To wake up healthy every single day, and watch yourself get into the best shape of your life, is every athlete's dream. I was living it, until this incident. Life writes strange scripts, and sometimes there is courage in accepting it and moving on. That's what I will do," the post further read.

The 25-year-old sealed the Olympics qualification at the Asian Athletics Championships in Bangkok in July last year, clinching silver with a best jump of 8.37m, breaching the automatic qualification mark of 8.27m. "My journey to a comeback began the minute I injured my knee. This road is going to be long, difficult and will take a lot out of me. The good thing is, I have a lot to give. I will overcome this, because that's what Mamba Mentality is all about.

"I will need your prayers, love and positive energy. I may jump alone, but it takes a collective push before every leap. This is my biggest one yet," Sreeshankar wrote.

In 2023, Sreeshankar delivered a remarkable season, clinching a silver at the Hangzhou Asian Games and securing the silver medal at the Asian Championships.

Last year, he also became the first Indian long jumper to qualify for the Diamond League final following his fifth-place in the Zurich leg after the third and fifth-place finish in the Paris and Lausanne legs, respectively. But he had skipped the prestigious event to focus on his preparation for the Asian Games.

'Hotels are full, sleeping on the floor': Two Indian wrestlers stranded at Dubai airport

Indian wrestlers Deepak Punia and Sujet Kalkal have been stranded at the Dubai airport since Tuesday, because of heavy rains, while enroute to Kyrgyzstan's Bishkek for the 2024 Paris Olympics qualifiers, sources said. Speaking to IANS, sources close to wrestlers said that the duo will take flight at 11 pm on Thursday and their chances of participation in the tournament is 50-50.

"They have been there for the past two days. Hotels are all full so they are sleeping on the floor

at the airport. Their chances of competing in the qualifiers is 50-50. Maybe they will reach Bishkek just before the start of the weigh-in, only if they manage to leave Dubai late tonight." The Asian Wrestling Olympic Qualifiers in Bishkek is scheduled to kick-start from April 19. There will be a total of 36 Paris 2024 quotas on offer in 18 weight divisions in Bishkek. India has fielded seventeen wrestlers. This qualifier will be the penultimate opportunity for Indian grapplers to secure a quota for the Summer Games. The World Qualification Tournament in Turkey, scheduled in May, will be the final wrestling qualifiers.

Two-time world champion Kento Momota announces retirement from international badminton

Two-time world champion Kento Momota of Japan announced his retirement from international badminton on Thursday, marking the Thomas & Uber Cup Finals in Chengdu, China as his final tournament on the international circuit.

Momota became the first Japanese man to win the world championship in 2018 in China and the following year he successfully defended his crown in Switzerland.

"I've realized I can no longer get back to the point where I'm aiming to be No. 1 in the world again," Momota said in a press conference in Tokyo as quoted by Japanese news agency Kyodo News.

"I had a very fulfilling career playing for the national team. Now I want to be involved in helping all kinds of people find enjoyment in sports."

In 2019, Momota won a record 11 titles on the BWF Tour and was named the top men's player. However, in January of the follow-



ing year, after winning the Malaysia Masters title he met with a tragic highway accident in Kuala Lumpur from which he miraculously survived.

The former world no.1 made his competitive return in December the same year but his form has not

been the same since then. He also made a disappointing group-stage exit at the Tokyo Olympics and has had just two tour wins since the crash.

"I'm not going to lie, after the accident I've asked myself, Why me? "Honestly, it was one difficult

time after another. But I didn't want to blame it on the accident. I wanted to try and beat it.

"Since the accident in January 2020, there was a lot of hardship. I tried so many things but I just couldn't close the emotional, physical gap between who I used to be and who I am. I felt I couldn't become world No. 1 again.

"I had eye surgery and I was seeing double. I couldn't move on the court the way I wanted to, I'd get tired like I never used to. I tried. But I just felt it was no longer possible to keep up with the world's best players. I couldn't play badminton the way I wanted to," he said.

Momota's journey, marred by a gambling scandal that cost him his chance to vie for a medal at the 2016 Rio Olympics, had set his sights on competing in the Paris Olympics, but fell short of qualification due to his ranking.

However, the 29-year-old plans to continue to play domestically in the national championships and the professional League.

BAYERN EDGE ARSENAL TO REACH CHAMPIONS LEAGUE SEMIFINAL

Joshua Kimmich's sole goal helped Bayern Munich progress into the UEFA Champions League last four after beating Arsenal 1-0 (3-2 on aggregate) in the second leg. The German giants caught a bright start in front of the home crowd as Harry Kane's volley went just wide in the opening stages before Noussair Mazraoui's deflected shot missed the target with 23 minutes gone. Arsenal's goalkeeper David Raya was also busy as he had to palm away Jamal Musiala's dangerous effort moments later.

The Gunners came also close and tested goalkeeper Manuel Neuer but neither Martin Odegaard nor Kai Havertz was able to score the opener from a promising position. Bayern started powerful into the second half and rattled the woodwork in quick succession. Leon Goretzka's header dropped off the crossbar allowing Raphael Guerreiro to hit the outside of the left post with the subsequent rebound. The



Gunners, meanwhile, lacked penetration and couldn't pose a threat to the host's well-organised defence, reports Xinhua.

The Bavarians eventually broke the deadlock and shocked the visitors at the

hour mark when Guerreiro's whipped cross into the box found Germany international Kimmich, whose diving header caught Raya flatfooted.

Tuchel's men gained momentum but

Leroy Sane and Kimmich got their chances denied later.

Arsenal remained uninspired as Bayern's defense was able to keep the Gunners at bay. The visitor's best chance in the second half came from Odegaard, who rattled the side netting.

Bayern protected its narrow lead to the final whistle and snatched the first semifinal ticket since 2020, the same year when it lifted the Champions League trophy. The German record champion joined Bundesliga rival Borussia Dortmund in the last four and clash with Real Madrid.

"It is great to advance into the next round. Both sides took no risks in the first half, but we gained the upper hand after the half-time. We showed will and took the win," said Bayern coach Thomas Tuchel. "The first half was nervous, but we played very well in the second half and should have added more goals to our lead. The bottom line is that we deservedly progressed into the next round," commented Kimmich.
