INDIAN RAILWAYS TO RUN RECORD 2,742 MORE TRAINS TO CLEAR SUMMER TRAVEL RUSH CONVENIENCE AHEAD

Indian Railways will operate a record-breaking 9,111 trips across the country to cater to the anticipated surge in travel during the summer season, the Ministry of Railways said on Friday.

This translates to an increase of 2,742 trips over the 6,369 trips offered during the summer of 2023. The additional trains have been planned to connect key destinations across the country, ensuring seamless travel on major railway routes, the ministry said.

All zonal railways spread across India have geared up to operate these additional trips, catering to the summer travel rush from states like Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Odisha, West Bengal, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Delhi.

Planning and running of additional trains is a continuous process for which inputs are taken from all the communication channels like media reports, social media platforms, and the Railway Integrated helpline number 139, apart from details of waitlist passengers in the PRS system, to assess the demand of trains



on a particular route. Based on this requirement, the number of trains and number of trips are augmented, according to the official statement.

During the summer season, Zonal Railways have also been instructed to ensure the availability of drinking water at railway stations. Elaborate crowd control arrangements are

made at all major and important railway stations. Senior officers are stationed at these stations to monitor all the activities to regulate the crowd in a systematic manner, the statement added.

RPF personnel have been deputed at originating stations to ensure a queue system for entry in General

Class coaches. RPF staff are also deployed in the CCTV Control Room to keep a close watch on the crowded areas and render real-time assistance to passengers.

Passengers can book their tickets in these additional trains through Railway Ticket counters or the IRCTC website/app.

In a significant initiative, the Jawaharlal Nehru Port Authority (JNPA) plans to replace more than 6,500 trucks operating in and around the port with battery-powered vehicles as part of its 'Zero Emission Trucking' strategy, officials said.

The shift to ZET will take place in phases over the next five years, starting with over 15 trucks serving the Inter Terminal Rail Operations to be converted to electric in six months, said JNPA Chairman, Umesh S Wagh.

This will be followed by converting over 400 diesel-fueled trucks plying within terminals for the vessel and yard operations, to electric in the next couple of years.

The final phase would be converting 6,500-plus trucks plying from containers to Container Freight Stations and vice-versa, including the Centralised Parking Plaza Trucks at terminals, to elec-

tric operated in the coming 3-5 years, assured Wagh.

At present, a majority of the trucks operating within the sprawling JNPA run on diesel, contributing to massive emissions and pollution.

"Recognising the critical role of decarbonising truck movements, especially within port premises, JNPA has embarked on the ambitious plan to transition its truck fleet from diesel to electric power." By transitioning to ZET, we aim to achieve the

vision of a fully electrified port, aligning with national sustainability goals such as the Harit Sagar guidelines and MIV 2030," explained Wagh. The 35-year-old JNPA is the country's premier container handling port, accounting for around 50 per cent of the total container cargo volumes, said officials. At present, the JNPA ranks at 26th globally among the top 100 container ports in the world, and is connected to more than 200 ports worldwide.

Reunited with family, 95-year-old great grandma from Bihar seeks to cast vote

A 95-year-old woman from Bihar's Banka district, who was found lying unconscious on a pavement in Howrah, near Kolkata, was reunited with her family on Saturday, thanks to efforts made by the police and members of the West Bengal Radio Club (WBRC) -- an organisation of amateur radio operators. Sajmu Nisha Sajman had made two pleas to her rescuers. She was eager to return to her great-grandchildren as they would only have their meals if she told them stories and she wanted to cast her vote for the last time at a booth close to her house in Salmanpur village.

"Some passersby had first spotted her as she lay unconscious. The authorities at Golabari police station were informed and they swung into action. Sajmu was shifted to a hospital where she was diagnosed with

severe dehydration due to the immense heat. She was administered intravenous fluids till she recovered. Thereafter, the police got in touch with us as the WBRC has reunited hundreds of lost people with their families through its wide network. The woman spoke of her great-grandchildren and said that she was from Salmanpur. She also said that she was eager to cast her vote," said Ambarish Nag Biswas, secretary of the WBRC.

While the police started looking for Salmanpur in Uttar Pradesh, the WBRC searched in Bihar. Finally, it came to be known that a woman matching her description had been reported missing from Salmanpur village in Banka, Bihar. The HAMS got in touch with her family and Saimu's grandchildren broke down on being shown her photograph. One of them immediately boarded a train for Howrah.

IPL 2024: 'WOULD HE LIKE TO BAT HIGHER...', SAYS BRIAN LARA AFTER DHONI'S 9-BALL 28

West Indies legend Brian Lara has noted that former skipper Mahendra Singh Dhoni is coming to bat at No 7-8 position for Chennai Super Kings but does not like to bat higher to give younger players opportunities to excel at the top. Speaking exclusively to Star Sports Cricket Live, Lara shared his thoughts on MS Dhoni's batting against Lucknow Super Giants after the former CSK captain hammered a 9-ball unbeaten 28 to help his team reach 176/6 in 20 overs at the Ekana Stadium on Friday night. However, CSK ended on the losing side despite Dhoni's cameo as K.L. Rahul (82) and Quinton de Kock (54) shared a 134-run opening partnership to guide LSG to an eight-wicket victory.

Lara said Dhoni's knock was just brilliant. "It's just brilliant. The question has to be asked would you like to bat higher? Because I can see he's making valuable contributions. But there are a cou-

ple of losing causes as well. So, I think that should be a consideration," he said.

"At 42, he's most likely thinking from the team's point of view, that the young guys got to do the job. But I think the middle of the innings told a little bit too much about CSK's batting. And it created the fact that even though he exploded at the end and he did that Dhoni thing at the end and it still was not enough," said Lara. The West Indies legend said that CSK will have to go to the drawing board to little bit more aggressive throughout the innings.

New Delhi: Sam Altman-run OpenAI has hired Pragya Misra as its first employee in India. Sources confirmed to IANS on Friday that Misra has been appointed to lead public policy affairs and partnerships in the country.

She also graduated in commerce from Delhi University and holds a Diploma in Bargaining and Negotiations from the London School of Economics and Political Science. 37 Indian startups secure \$310 million in funding this week

New Delhi: At least 37 startups in India secured about \$310 million in funding this week, including 10 growth-stage deals, as deals continued at a normal pace in the country.

Last week, as many as 21 startups secured nearly \$105 million in the country. This week, 10 startups raised \$225.86 million in funding, including GPS Renewables which secured \$50 million in debt funding, according to a report in Entracker.

DeepTech startup Ecozen raised \$30 million in a mix of debt and equity from existing investors, including asset management firm Nuveen.

Online B2B marketplace ProcMart raised \$30 million in its Series B funding led by Nandan Nilekani and Sanjeev Aggarwal's VC fund,



Fundamentum Partnership, and the Edelweiss Discovery Fund.

Gaming startup LightFury Games secured \$8.5 million in its maiden round, led by Blume Ventures and other key investors.

ClickPost, the logistics intelligence platform for online retailers, raised \$6 million in a Series A funding led by Infloxor Ventures partners and Athera Venture Partners. Emergency healthcare provider Medulance also secured \$3 million (about Rs 25 crore) in Series A funding.

ANUPAM KHER DRIVES LANSDOWNE KIDS TO SCHOOL: 'INNOCENCE RARELY SEEN IN BIG CITY CHILDREN'

FOUNDATIONS OF INDIA STAND AT THRESHOLD OF 'DESTRUCTION': PRIYANKA GANDHI

Congress General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi on Saturday said that the foundations of the country stand at the threshold of "destruction" under the BJP government.

"Our country made us proud for its foundation of incomparable spirituality, unbreakable resilience, unflinching enterprise and its immense ability to embrace diversity and thrive in it. However, these very foundations of our nationhood stand at the threshold of destruction today," Priyanka said while addressing a public rally in Chalakudy, Kerala.

She said that the ongoing Lok Sabha election is a fight for the soul of this great nation.

"It is a fight for a democratic India that stood valiantly against tyranny and inequality. It is a fight for the freedom we once took for granted. It is a fight for hope and it is a fight for all that is right," she said.



She said that some people who owe allegiance to the Prime Minister speak haughtily about changing the

constitution which was written with the blood of freedom fighters and martyrs. She said that the voices of

dissent are being silenced, students are arrested for expressing their opinions, activists are raided and jailed, journalists are sacked, beaten, and imprisoned for reporting the truth and much of the media is controlled.

"Government agencies that are meant to protect the law are turned into unlawful extortionists and used to silence dissent," she said.

Priyanka alleged that the government "protects" rapists and "defends" the oppressors and abusers of women as the "government vilified" victims using administrations.

"Public assets that belong to the people are handed to the Prime Minister's billionaire friends. Airports, ports, highways, vast tracts of public land and whole sectors of industry like cement, power and coal are virtually now being controlled by businessmen close to the Prime Minister," Priyanka said. She said that people in Kerala should recognise the ongoing general election as a fight for the soul of India.

BJP sponsors opinion polls, don't believe these surveys: Mamata Banerjee

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Saturday said that the opinion polls are sponsored by the BJP and asked people not to believe these poll surveys done by different agencies.

"Do not believe in any poll survey. All these opinion polls are sponsored by the BJP. They had claimed that they would cross 200 seats during the 2021 West Bengal assembly elections. They could not do it. BJP will not be successful this time as well in West Bengal," the Chief Minister said while addressing an election rally at Malda on Saturday.

She said that the Trinamool Congress has no alliance with the INDIA bloc in West Bengal. "I played the main role in the creation of the INDIA bloc. But in West



Bengal, I saw BJP, Congress and CPI-M joining hands. You should not vote for any of them here," the Chief Minister said.

She termed the long seven-phase election a "conspiracy" to benefit a particular political party.

"We had a norm to complete the election process in May. However, this time it has been extended till June. BJP does not understand the sufferings of the common

people," the Chief Minister said. On not allowing the Ayushman Bharat scheme in West Bengal, the Chief Minister said that if the West Bengal government had allowed the scheme, the state government would have to provide 50 per cent of the cost and only 50 lakhs of people would have benefited from it. "Our Swasthya Sathi scheme has benefited ten crore people," the Chief Minister said.

What's wrong if Rahul Gandhi contests from two places, Modi did it too: KC Venugopal

Reacting sharply to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's remark that the Congress party's 'Yuvaraj' (Rahul Gandhi) ran away from North India to South India, AICC general secretary (Organisation) K.C. Venugopal on Saturday said they never knew that it was Modi who was selecting candidates for the Congress.

Venugopal, who is fighting it out from the Alappuzha Lok Sabha constituency, was reacting to the interview of PM Modi given to a TV channel wherein he belittled Rahul Gandhi.

"Isn't Wayanad in India and didn't Modi contest from two seats in the past? It's surprising that Modi is saying such things and we never knew that it was Modi who was selecting the Congress candidates. Moreover what's wrong if Rahul contests from two seats," asked Venugopal.

Venugopal further pointed out that Modi has become jittery and that's why he is often saying that the BJP-led NDA will win 400 seats. "Modi finally appears to have realised that he is on the back foot and is trying to instil confidence by repeatedly saying about crossing 400 seats. Everyone knows what the reality is going to be," added Venugopal.



Meanwhile, veteran Indian Union Muslim League (IUM) legislator P.K. Kunhalikutty said there was nothing wrong with Rahul Gandhi contesting from two seats and their party general secretary PMA Salam said Vijayan was spreading canards that Rahul did not speak about CAA, in fact at Kozhikode addressing a mammoth rally he emphasised about CAA.

"He spoke in English and it was translated into Malayalam too," said Salam.

Vijayan since he began his election campaign has attacked Gandhi for not speaking a word on CAA.

FORCES WITHIN & OUTSIDE THE COUNTRY JOINED HANDS TO DEFEAT ME: PM MODI

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Saturday said that "big and powerful people" from within India and outside the country have united to defeat him in the Lok Sabha elections.

Addressing a massive gathering in Karnataka's Chikkaballapur city, PM Modi said that the first phase of voting has uplifted the spirit of the people in the country.

"With the blessings of 'Nari Shakti' and 'Matru Shakti', Modi is successfully facing the challenges and marching ahead. The INDIA bloc does not have a leader for the future, and also does not have a vision for the future as well," PM Modi said.

"The highest number of beneficiaries of Modi government's schemes are SC, ST and OBC families. During the tenure of the earlier governments, they lived in filth, did not get electricity and water, and they had lost hope from the government. Modi has rekindled their hopes on the government. The fact that 25 crore people are being lifted out of poverty in the country substantiates the fact," PM Modi said. PM Modi, speaking at the



rally, also said that those who were earlier called at last are being placed on the frontline today.

"A daughter from a tribal family went on to become the first citizen of the country," PM Modi said, adding: "Under the development for all objec-

tives, the NDA government has prioritised the education of Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC) and youth. "These sections are beneficiaries of Mudra Scheme which provides loans. It is being planned to increase

the loan amount from Rs 10 lakh to Rs 20 lakh," PM Modi said.

He said that the Congress government has betrayed the farmers by stopping the Rs 4 crore subsidy given by the state government during the previous BJP government in Karnataka. "I am sure you will punish the anti-farmer Congress government," PM Modi said.

The Prime Minister further said: "The poor people of this country did not think that they would get free ration. This has been turned into reality. Lakhs of families are availing of free treatment. In Chikkaballapur, 4 lakh families have benefited from this. Free treatment would be given to senior citizens who are above the age of 70 years, up to Rs 5 lakh.

"In the last 10 years, in Chikkaballapur and Kolar, 25,000 houses have been built. Three crore more houses will be built."

PM Modi also said that the Nandi Hills, located close to Bengaluru, will be developed as a weekend getaway.

"The NDA gets inspiration from Nadaprabhu Kempe Gowda (founder of Bengaluru) to develop modern infrastructure," PM Modi added.

REVANTH REDDY WARNS KCR TO STAY AWAY FROM CONGRESS MLAS

A day after Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) president and former Telangana CM K. Chandrasekhar Rao claimed that 20 Congress MLAs are in touch with him, Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy on Friday warned that if he dares to touch Congress MLAs, he would be "burnt".

The Congress leader gave the warning to the former chief minister while addressing a meeting after participating in the nomination filing of Mahabubnagar Lok Sabha candidate Vamshichand Reddy.

Revanth Reddy cautioned KCR against treating Congress MLAs like a herd of sheep that he can take away like he did in the past.

"The guard here is Revanth Reddy. Try it if you can. We will erect the fencing to protect our MLAs. Here is Revanth Reddy... high tension Revanth Reddy. Come and touch. You will turn a crow," he said.

"By evening you would know how



many MLAs will be with you," Revanth Reddy told KCR, hours after BRS MLA T. Prakash Goud met him amid indications that he will soon join Congress. Three BRS MLAs have already defected to Congress during the last one month.

On BRS working president K.T. Rama Rao's remark that the "car" (BRS election symbol) has gone to the garage for servicing, Revanth Reddy

said the car's engine has stopped working and remarked that it should be sold as scrap.

The Chief Minister said KCR as Mahabubnagar MP between 2009 and 2014 did nothing for the constituency. He alleged that the BRS chief also let down the people of Mahabubnagar during his 10-year rule. He said KCR did not complete Palamuru Rangareddy, Jurala and

other pending projects.

He assured the people that the state government will fight to get national status for Palamuru Rangareddy project and bring Rs 30,000 crore for it from the Centre.

Revanth Reddy said sitting MP M. Srinivas Reddy, who has been fielded by BRS again, never opened his mouth in the Parliament for Telangana or Mahabubnagar.

The Chief Minister told the people that voting for BJP candidate D.K. Aruna will also amount to wasting the vote as the BJP has done nothing for Telangana. He asked if she ever spoke about the problems faced by people of Mahabubnagar.

Revanth Reddy stated that the Congress government implemented the promise of free bus travel for women, enhanced the limit under Arogyasri scheme from Rs 5 lakh to Rs 10 lakh and also gave cooking gas cylinders for Rs 500.

He claimed that the Congress government provided 30,000 jobs in just three months.

Jobs data in past 6.5 years shows consistent rise, unemployment rate on decline

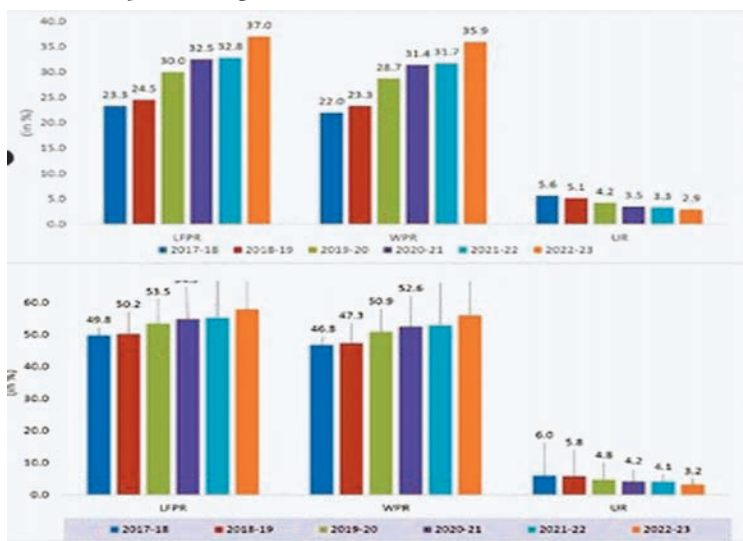
Amid the Opposition's claims of joblessness and unemployment hitting a new high, the latest findings on labour force data have come as a shot in the arm for the Centre.

As per the report of the Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS), jobs and employment opportunities have seen a consistent uptrend in the past 6.5 years of the Modi government.

The growth parameters in terms of jobs, postings and employment opportunities have recorded a rise while the Unemployment Rate (UR) has consistently gone down. This has been found under three key jobs data pools including - PLFS, EPFO and National Career Service (NCS).

Various tools of PLFS including the Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR) and Worker Population Ratio (WPR) have logged consistent rise over the past 6 years while the Unemployment Rate (UR) chart shows a constant decline.

The positive trend over the years, promises much hope in 'gloomy times', a charge reiterated by the opposition parties.



The LFPR, defined as the percentage of persons in the labour force, was recorded at 49.8 per cent in the financial year 2017-18 and this rose to 57.9 per cent in FY 2022-23.

Similarly, WPR, defined as the percentage of employed persons in the population, was recorded at 46.8 per cent in FY 2017-18, which in turn rose to 56 per cent in FY 2022-23.

During the same period, the unemployment rate dropped from 6 per cent to 3.2 per cent.

The labour market trend for female workers also shows a positive trend.

LFPR, for women workers, was recorded at 23.3 per cent in FY 2017-18, which rose to 37 per cent in FY 2022-23 while WPR saw a rise from

22 per cent to 35.9 per cent for the same period. The unemployment rate for women workers also saw a decline from 5.6 per cent to 2.9 per cent in the period from 2017-2023.

The comprehensive set of data has been shared by the Bluekraft Digital Foundation CEO on his X handle.

As per the Employment Provident Fund Organization (EPFO) data, a total of 6.1 crore individuals joined formal jobs during the past 6.5 years.

National Career Service (NCS) records say that over 1 crore job postings were offered in FY 2023-24 alone. Earlier, the Employee Provident Fund (EPF) was the only tool to measure jobs data, however, with many tools launched under the Modi dispensation, one gets a fair account of the rise and fall in jobs data, over the years.

PLFS was launched by National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) in April 2017 for collating labour force data at regular intervals while National Career Service (NCS) was launched in 2015 to replace the then Employment Exchanges and equipped with the IT enabled careers services, for easy and quick service.

HK, Singapore food regulators red flag 'cancer-causing' ingredient in certain MDH, Everest spices

TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF

In a statement posted on its website on April 5, the Centre for Food Safety (CFS), Hong Kong's food regulatory authority, said that three spice products of MDH -- Madras Curry Powder (spice blend for Madras Curry), Sambhar Masala (Mixed Masala Powder), and Curry Powder (Mixed Masala Powder) -- along with Everest's Fish Curry Masala contain "a pesticide, ethylene oxide". Both MDH and Everest Foods were yet to comment on the food regulators' claims.

Food regulators in Hong Kong and Singapore have warned people against using four products from two big spice brands --- three from MDH and one from Everest -- over the presence of ethylene oxide at "levels exceeding the permissible limit". The International Agency for Research on Cancer has classified ethylene oxide as a 'Group 1 carcinogen'. Under its routine food surveillance programme, the CFS took the products from three retail outlets in Hong Kong. "The test results showed that the samples contained a pesticide, ethylene oxide," said a CFS spokesperson. The regulator instructed the vendors "to stop the sale and remove from shelves the affected products". Recalls have been initiated on the products, it said. "According to the Pesticide Residues in Food Regulation (Cap. 132CM), food for



human consumption containing pesticide residue may only be sold if consumption of the food is not dangerous or prejudicial to health. An offender is liable to a maximum fine of \$50,000 and imprisonment for six months upon conviction," the CFS spokesperson said. The CFS noted that "investigations are ongoing" and "appropriate action" may be initiated in the matter. Meanwhile, the Singapore Food Agency (SFA) also ordered a recall of Everest's Fish Curry Masala due to the presence of ethylene oxide at levels "exceeding the permissible limit".

The SFA posted a release on its website on April 18 that said it "has directed the importer, Sp Muthiah & Sons Pte. Ltd., to recall the products. The recall is ongoing." The SFA noted that ethylene oxide is not fit for consumption, but is "used to fumigate agricultural products to prevent microbial contamination". However, under Singapore's food regulations, ethylene oxide can be "used in the sterilisation of spices". While there is no immediate risk to eating foods "with low levels of ethylene oxide, long-term exposure may lead to health issues", said the SFA, noting that exposure to the "substance should be minimised as much as possible". It also advised people who bought the product to not "consume it", and those who have concerns about their health after consumption must "seek medical advice". According to the US Environmental Protection Agency, "ethylene oxide is a human carcinogen. It causes cancer".

India among top countries in artificial intelligence adoption

From software development to customer service, GenAI is revolutionising industries, ushering in a new era of innovation in the region. The financial services sector is experiencing rapid growth in GenAI adoption in Asia -- projected to reach \$4.3 billion by 2027 with a CAGR of 96.7 per cent, the report said.

87 killed, over 80 injured as heavy rains wreak havoc in Pakistan

At least 87 people have been killed and 82 others injured in separate rain-triggered incidents in Pakistan over the past week as heavy downpours continued to wreak havoc in parts of the country, the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) said. The NDMA on Friday added that the rains have partially or fully damaged 2,715 houses across the country, adding that most of the people died in the incidents related to structural collapse, lightning strike and flash flood, Xinhua news agency reported. Most of the damages and casualties were reported from the country's north-western Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province,



where 36 people lost their lives and 53 others sustained injuries due to torrential rains, followed by the eastern Punjab province, which has reported 25 deaths and eight injuries, according to the NDMA. A total of 15 people

were killed and 10 others injured in the southwestern Balochistan province, whereas 11 people died with 11 others injured due to heavy rains in the Pakistan-occupied Kashmir during the period, said the NDMA.

K'taka Cong corporator flags daughter's murder probe, threatens to commit suicide

In a major development, Niranjan Hiremath, father of Neha Hiremath who was stabbed to death on her college campus, has claimed that the investigation of his daughter's murder is being "misled," and warned that his family would "commit suicide" if it continues. Talking to the press about photos of his daughter Neha with the accused Fayaz Kondikoppa being released on social media, the Congress corporator stated that "the photos are fake and 101 per cent done to botch up the investigation." "We will write a letter in the name of the Chief Minister and Home Minister and commit suicide. We will also send the letter to the Governor. Instead of getting us justice for the murdered child, they are resorting to bringing disrepute to her and our family," Niranjan warned. "How come the photos that bring



disrepute to my family and deceased daughter crop up all of a sudden? What is the police department doing about it? The killer is inside the prison, how come others are able to get these photos? Or has he been

allowed to do all this sitting inside the prison?" questioned Niranjan. "The cybercrime wing must act and put those who are posting these photos in prison. The accused and my daughter had studied together for

years and attended all the programmes. All of a sudden these photos at this juncture are coming up. This is the responsibility of the police department and the Home Minister. They should ensure these things are not done," said Niranjan. When asked about killer Fayaz and Neha having marriage plans, Niranjan stated that the boy might have had those feelings, but "my daughter did not have any such ideas on her mind." "My daughter Neha would never indulge in such dirty acts. Her photos have been edited. She had told me once that the accused was behind her, and I had advised her to strongly face it. She was a strong girl. The killer should not be alive, he should be hanged," Neha's mother, Geetha, said. Neha was stabbed to death on her college campus in Hubballi city on Thursday. The students had chased Fayaz, caught him and handed him over to police.

VEDDAS OF SRI LANKA HAVE CLOSE GENETIC AFFINITY WITH INDIANS, REVEALS STUDY

The Vedda, an indigenous group of Sri Lanka, has a close genetic affinity with the Indian population, revealed a landmark study by 10 researchers from five institutions. The significant findings of the study, which involved a comprehensive analysis of high-resolution autosomal and mitochondrial genomes and shed new light on the initial peopling of Sri Lanka and the ancient genetic ties between the Vedda and other populations in Asia, were published recently in the journal Mitochondrion, according to CSIR-CCMB. "The language isolate Vedda, who are among the least studied indigenous populations in Sri Lanka, have long intrigued scientists and historians alike due to their unique linguistic and cultural characteristics. This study, therefore, unravelling the mysteries of their genetic origins and affinities with the Indian population," said Dr. K. Thangaraj one of the senior authors of the study and JC Bose Fellow at the CSIR-Centre for Cellular and Molecular



Biology, Hyderabad.

Key findings from the research indicate that despite the lack of close linguistic similarities, the Vedda people share a significant genetic link with the ethnic populations in India. "Our autosomal analyses suggest a close genetic connection between the Vedda and Indian ethnic

populations speaking various tongues, pointing towards a deep-rooted history that predates linguistic diversifications," said Prof Gyaneshwer Chaubey, Molecular Anthropologist at the BHU, Varanasi. "Maternal DNA analysis supports the existence of an ancient link, reinforcing the notion of a shared genetic heritage. The study proposes that the Vedda population has undergone genetic drift and a recent bottleneck, resulting in a unique genetic makeup with limited gene flow from neighbouring Sinhalese and Sri Lankan Tamil populations," said the lead author, Dr Ruwandi Ranasingh, from Colombo University. Anjana Welikala, the first author of the study, stated that this unique discovery challenges the conventional isolation-by-distance model and underscores the distinct demographic history of the Vedda. The implications of this research are vast, offering novel perspectives on the demographic history of not only Sri Lanka but also the broader South Asian region.

Congress candidate's nomination invalidated provisionally in Surat

The nomination form of Nitesh Kumbhani, the Congress candidate for the Surat Lok Sabha seat, has come under scrutiny. The election officer has provisionally invalidated Kumbhani's nomination after three proposers - Ramesh Palara, Jagdish Savaliya, and Dhruvin Dhameiliya - claimed they had not signed his nomination form. They presented themselves before the election officer with an affidavit to substantiate their claim. Surat has favored BJP candidates since the 1990s by considerable margins.



Adding to the complexity of the situation, AAP leader Gopal Italia has suggested that the proposers alleging forgery might be under duress, possibly coerced or even kidnapped, given their affiliation with the party. He

raised concerns about the pressure they might be facing. This issue arises just as the deadline for filing nomination papers, April 19, has passed. The Congress party had also nominated Suresh Padsala as a backup candidate, but his nomination form faces the same allegations of unauthorized signatures. Amidst this electoral controversy, Congress spokesperson Naishad Desai stated that the party is prepared to challenge the election officer's impending decision in court if it is unfavorable.

Elon Musk confirms not coming to India amid crucial Tesla quarter results

Elon Musk, on Saturday, confirmed that he will not visit India this month amid crucial Tesla quarterly results and will possibly visit the country later this year to announce his investment plans. In a post on X, the billionaire said that unfortunately, "very heavy Tesla obligations require that the visit to India be delayed." "But I do very much look forward to visiting later this

year," Musk added. Last week, the billionaire had tweeted that he was looking forward to meeting Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The SpaceX CEO was also set to meet representatives of Indian space companies during his India visit. Musk has a key conference call with analysts about Tesla's latest quarter (Q1) results, after the company reduced 10 per cent of its workforce, or around 14,000 employees - globally.

The layoffs at Tesla "gutted some departments by 20 per cent and even hit high performers," and the decision was apparently made "due to poor financial performance." Two high-profile Tesla executives -- Rohan Patel, VP of Public Policy and Business Development and Drew Baglino, Tesla's SVP of Powertrain and Energy -- have also quit. Tesla has just shelved plans to develop a low-cost EV for around \$25,000.

'ONE IN EVERY FIVE INDIVIDUALS IS AFFECTED BY FATTY LIVER'

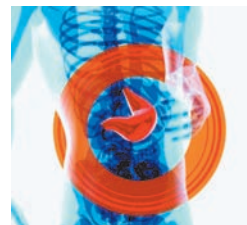

"Due to our government's policies, 12 lakh people in Parbhani are getting free ration. No one in these families has to sleep hungry. Such free ration will continue for the next five years as well," PM Modi said.

He said that 17 Janaushadhi centres in Parbhani will get an 80 per cent discount on medicines while more than 1.25 lakh women have been given Ujjwala gas connections.

"In Parbhani, more than 75 per cent of households are getting tap water. More than nine lakh animals in Parbhani have been vaccinated free of charge. Any government can do this only if it is sensitive to the poor," PM Modi said.

Attacking Congress, PM Modi said that after independence, they divided the country and also ignited the Kashmir issue and even Babasaheb Ambedkar's constitution was not allowed to apply to Jammu and Kashmir.

He said that the Congress also did not allow Dalits to get any rights.

"Having the same mentality as the Nizam, the Congress did not allow the development of Marathwada. I appeal to people that don't give any space to the people who have Razakar mentality," PM Modi said.

He said that Parbhani would help make India self-reliant and that the ongoing Lok Sabha election is the beginning of the economic development of the country.

"I know the pain of the poor. I am thinking about how to ease their pain. The opposition worked to block the schemes brought to Marathwada," PM Modi said.

MVA allies in fresh war of words over PM's post; BJP gleeful

A day after the first phase of Lok Sabha elections, Shiv Sena (UBT) MP, Sanjay Raut, set loose a rat - with broad hints suggesting ex-Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray as a possible claimant for the Prime Minister's post, here on Saturday. Speaking to the media in Sangli during an election tour, Sanjay Raut said that "if Maharashtra gets an opportunity to lead the nation after the current Lok Sabha elections, then it should be welcomed by all."

While avoiding a direct reference, the Sena MP said that the question was not whether Thackeray was in the reckoning for the post of PM, but "why can't he be a contender for the top job."

"He is a former CM of a major state like Maharashtra and performed exceedingly well during the Covid-19 pandemic... He enjoys mass goodwill and can take everybody along with him... So what's wrong if his name comes up. But all these things are first discussed with the INDIA bloc before anything is finalised," pointed out Raut, albeit with a cautious rider.

Expectedly, the statement evoked a sharp retort from the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) ally, Congress state President Nana F Patole,



who hit out at Raut for "changing his stance" daily, though the NCP(SP) has not yet reacted to the comment.

"Till yesterday, Raut was seeming okay with Rahul Gandhi's name as PM, but today he has suddenly changed his opinion... This does not augur well..." said a peeved Patole.

The tussle among the MVA allies was apparently music for BJP state President Ashish Shelar who attacked the Opposition alliance saying "they have no strong candidate for the PM's post, all the parties in INDIA bloc want to project their candidates and are trying to pull each other down."

"Only PM Narendra Modi is capable of leading the country and has a strong developmental goal for the nation's progress... The Opposition parties and their leaders are busy fighting among themselves, lacking

a clear agenda and spoiling each other's chances," slammed Shelar.

Justifying his contentions, Raut said in the past, senior leader and NCP(SP) President Sharad Pawar was also a strong contender for the PM's job, but owing to certain political circumstances he could not achieve it, "and we all regret it even now."

However, attempting to nip any speculation in the bud, Raut announced that both Gandhi and Thackeray shall be seen sharing the dais at MVA-INDIA bloc rallies scheduled during the forthcoming four phases of LS elections in the state.

"In the 2024 elections, the INDIA bloc will get between 300-310 LS seats, the BJP-NDA will be stuck between 180-200, at the highest at 230... Nothing can stop the INDIA bloc now," asserted a grim Raut.

Ex-actress Navneet Kaur-Rana radiates charming confidence in Amravati LS seat, now for BJP

The green but hot and dry Amravati (SC) constituency is among the few in Maharashtra that has elected women to the Lok Sabha four times since 1952, including a future President Pratibha Patil (1991), the first woman to hold the top post in the country. A seat that is being closely monitored, it was a traditional Congress stronghold which elected the party's candidates 10 times, plus in one by-election, while the (undivided) Shiv Sena nominees were elected 5 times, besides the RPI, CPI and an independent once each, with the Bharatiya Janata Party feeling left out so far. This time, the BJP is hoping Dame Luck may smile on the party -- through its comely candidate, NDA-MahaYuti-BJP's Navneet Kaur-Rana, an actress-turned-politician who is set to capture the attention of the voters once again. With her background in entertainment and now in politics, she might bring a unique appeal to the electorate. It's not uncommon for candidates with a background in the arts to leverage their charisma and public image to connect with voters. At the same time, it will be interesting to see how her campaign unfolds and whether her charm res-



onates with the electorate for the second time.

After all, in 2019, Rana overcame the BJP's 'second coming' to get elected as the sole independent MP in the state, of course, with the support of the (undivided) Nationalist Congress Party and other parties, to trounce the (undivided) Shiv Sena strongman Anandrao V. Adsul, a former Union minister, now with CM Eknath Shinde's party.

Campaigning aggressively, this time Rana has locked horns with her chief rival MVA-INDIA Bloc-Congress' MLA Balwant B. Wankhade, while the third contender is Republican Sena's Anandraj Y. Ambedkar supported by his brother and Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi (VBA) chief Prakash Y. Ambedkar, for the April 26 Lok Sabha polls.

Moreover, there seems to be internal challenges from

within Rana's own party or coalition that could pose a threat to her electoral prospects. Rana will need to navigate these internal challenges effectively to maintain her momentum and focus on her campaign goals.

A ruling MahaYuti ally, the Prahar Janshakti Party (PHP) founder Omprakash Babarao Kadu, alias Bachhu Kadu, has publicly vowed to "defeat" Rana at any cost and fielded its local heavyweight Dinesh G. Boob who has launched a blistering attack on his rival.

Rana's campaign got off to a 'crying start' with the actress recounting her political struggles and hardships for the past 12 years since she entered electoral politics, how she was targeted in different ways by opponents and appealed for support to strengthen the hands of PM Narendra Modi in the LS 2024 elections.

Man loses Rs 45.6 lakh in share trading fraud; six booked

A 44-year-old Navi Mumbai man was allegedly duped of Rs 45.6 lakh by cyber fraudsters who lured him to invest in share trading, police said on Saturday, reported news agency. The cyber police on Thursday registered a case against six persons under sections 419 (cheating), 406 (criminal breach of trust) and other relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code and the Information Technology (IT) Act, an official said.

The Navi Mumbai man, a resident of Panvel, came across a link called "Stock Loss Recovery" on Instagram and was routed to various groups involved in stock market trading, he said.

The official said the complainant started share trading and invested Rs 47 lakh in March and April.

The complainant's account reflected a balance of Rs 98 lakh, including the profits earned from trading. But when he attempted to withdraw the earnings, he was asked to pay 18 per cent of his profits, around Rs 7 lakh, he said.

Despite complying with the demand, the victim found that additional money was getting siphoned off from his account without authorisation, the official said.

The complainant managed to reclaim Rs 1.30 lakh but could not recover Rs 45.69 lakh, he said.

Election 2024 is between Narendra Modi and Rahul Gandhi: Ajit Pawar

Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar on Saturday said this Lok Sabha election is not about family relations but a battle between Congress leader Rahul Gandhi and Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Ajit Pawar's wife Sunetra, the NCP's candidate from the Baramati Lok Sabha constituency in Pune district, officially launched her campaign by offering prayers at the Hanuman temple at Kanheri on Saturday.

Ajit Pawar, his sons Parth and Jay, and several local party leaders were present for the campaign launch. On Thursday, Sunetra and her sister-in-law three-term Lok Sabha member Supriya Sule filed their nomination papers for the NCP and NCP (SP) respectively.

Ajit Pawar has also filed nomination papers for the seat, which an NCP functionary described as a backup plan in case his wife's nomination does not stand scrutiny or if any discrepancy is found.

Addressing the gathering, Ajit Pawar said, "We are launching the official campaign after praying to Lord Hanuman. The election is not about family relations. The election is all about Prime Minister Narendra Modi versus Rahul Gandhi." Incidentally, Sule launched



her poll campaign on Friday by offering prayers at the Hanuman temple in the presence of her father, NCP (SP) supremo Sharad Pawar, and other members of the Pawar family. "Yesterday, everyone (members of the Pawar family) was sitting next to Pawar saheb. They attempted to show that the family was united. One of them claimed that Sharad Pawar established all institutions in Baramati. In that case, what have I done in the last 30 years?" Ajit Pawar said. The NCP is a constituent in the Mahayuti alliance, comprising the Shiv Sena and Bharatiya Janata Party, and the NCP (SP) is a part of the Maha Vikas Aghadi with the Shiv Sena (UBT) and Congress.

TISS Suspends Student Over "Anti-National" Activities

The Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) has suspended a PhD student for two years for indulging in activities that are "not in the interest of the nation" and referred to instances like him participating in a protest in Delhi under the PSF-TISS banner. Ramadas Prinisivanandan (30), who is pursuing his doctorate in Development Studies, has also been debarred from entering the TISS campuses in Mumbai, Tuljapur, Hyderabad and Guwahati.

In a notice sent to Prinisivanandan dated March 7, TISS referred to instances like the screening of documentaries like 'Ram Ke Naam' ahead of January 26 as a "mark of dishonour and protest" against the Ram Mandir consecration in Ayodhya.

He has also been accused of screening a banned BBC documentary on the TISS campus last January and also organising the Bhagat Singh Memorial Lecture (BSML) by inviting

"controversial guest speakers".

It said that these issues are "very serious and it is discernible that you are intentionally and deliberately indulging in such unlawful activities in the name of freedom of speech and expression."

"Your activities are not in the interest of the nation. Being a public institution, TISS cannot permit or tolerate its students indulging in such activities which are anti-national and bring a bad name to the nation. Hence all such activities fall under the category of serious criminal offence.

"The committee recommended your suspension from the institute i.e. Tata Institute of Social Sciences for the period of two years and your entry shall be debarred across all campuses of Tata Institute of Social Sciences, which is accepted by the competent authority," the TISS notice dated April 18 reads.

Prinisivanandan, who hails from Kerala, said he will appeal against the suspension.

BMC announces 100 per cent water cut in parts of Goregaon and Kandivali on April 23

The Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) on Friday announced that there will be a 100 per cent water cut in parts of Goregaon east on April 23 due to planned repair works.

According to an official statement, the BMC said that the residents of Goregaon (East) in Mumbai's P South and P East wards are advised to brace themselves for a complete water cut from 10:00 am on Tuesday, 23rd April 2024, to 10:00 am on Wednesday, 24th April 2024.

The civic body said that the 24-hour water cut is necessitated by the replacement of a 600 mm diameter water pipe with a 900 mm diameter water line at the Virwani Industrial Estate, Western Expressway.

The BMC also shared the complete list of the areas that would be affected.

The BMC urged the residents of the affected areas to use water judiciously during the period and make necessary arrangements to mitigate the inconvenience caused by the water cut, the statement said on Friday.

Meanwhile, the BMC has so far removed 5,895 metric tons of water hyacinth, a free floating perennial herb found at the surface of water bodies, from the

Powai lake in Mumbai, the civic body said.

The removal of these plants will help in protecting the lake's biodiversity

along with enhancing its natural richness, the BMC said in a release on Wednesday.

The BMC said it has

cleared 23 per cent of the total 123 acres of water hyacinth-infected area of the lake, built during the British era.



111-Year-Old Maharashtra Woman Votes At Poll Booth

The people from tribal communities came out to vote in large numbers as all three tribal-dominated seats -- Chhindwara, Mandla and Balaghat recorded more than 70 per cent voter turnout.

Other three Lok Sabha constituencies polled in the first phase of the general elections -- Shahdol (Scheduled Tribe) voter



turnout at 63.23 per cent, Jabalpur at 60 per cent, while Sidhi recorded the lowest at 54.36 per cent.

The State's Electoral Office, however, was yet to release a final update on voter turnout in the state as polling went till late Friday evening and therefore, voting percentage may see a little surge later. The elections for the

state's 29 Lok Sabha seats are scheduled in four phases.

The first phase concluded in Friday while the second phase covering six more Lok Sabha constituencies, mostly in the Bundelkhand region, will be held on April 26.

The third and fourth phase elections will be conducted on May 7 and 13 and the results will be announced on June 4.

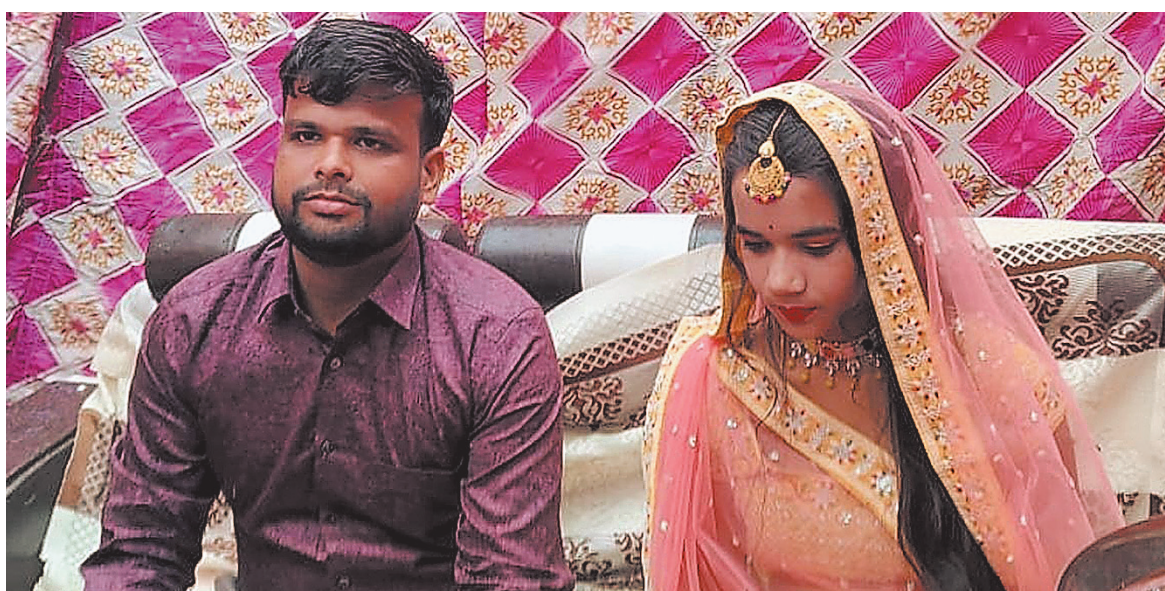
Wedding procession held hostage after accusing groom of drinking alcohol and extorted Rs 5 lakh

Fraser-McGurk brought out his clean bat swing by whacking Sundar for three sixes and as many fours in the third over to collect 30 runs. With Abhishek Porel hitting three boundaries from the other end, Fraser-McGurk backed away to drill Pat Cummins for four and then got down on one knee to hit a lofted drive over mid-on for six as 20 runs came off the fifth over. Rishabh Pant got a rousing reception from his home crowd and he



didn't disappoint them by producing two dazzling flicks fetching him boundaries off Bhuvneshwar.

Tristan Stubbs succumbed to it by pulling to mid-wicket off Nitish Reddy,

followed by Lalit Yadav's leg-stump being sent on a cartwheel ride by T Natarajan, who took out Axar Patel, Anrich Nortje and Kuldeep Yadav in the 19th over.

Indian para-canoeist Jaideep secured the gold medal in the VL3 Men's 200m event as the Indian contingent asserted their dominance at the Asian Canoeing/Para Canoeing Sprint Championships held here on Saturday. Sangeeta Rajput and Shabana Rajput added to India's medal total by winning bronze and silver in the KL3 Women's 200m division, respectively. Pooja Ojha and Prachi Yadav main-



tained their winning streak by earning gold medals in their respective categories, dominating the KL1 and KL2 Women's 200m events. Both Rajni Jha and Sonalben Ratilal Vasoya added silver medals to India's medal total in the KL2 and KL1 women's 200m competitions. Men's division winners Surender Kumar, Yash Kumar, and Gajendra Singh took home gold, silver, and bronze, respectively, in the VL1 and VL2 Men's 200m events, demonstrating equal talent.

ATP Tour: Tsitsipas saves two match points to win, advances to semifinals at Barcelona

Greece superstar Stefanos Tsitsipas survived a major scare against Facundo Diaz Acosta of Argentina at the Barcelona Open, saving two match points to earn a dramatic three-set victory to advance to the semifinals. Tsitsipas defeated Diaz Acosta 4-6, 6-3, 7-6(8) in a quarterfinal clash on Friday evening and said it was "extremely difficult to sustain the same level throughout the entire match". The Greek player said he came close to losing the match at certain moments and reminded himself that he wore a headband that had a mountain and that he had to climb it. "So, it kept me going," Tsitsipas said after the match.

In a thrilling two-hour, 31-minute clash, Tsitsipas had the chance to serve out the match at 5-4 in the third set but hit two double faults in the game as Diaz Acosta broke back. The Argentine then failed to convert a match point on the Greek's serve at 5-6, before both players saved match points in the third-set tie-break.

With little to separate them, it was Tsitsipas who stood tall on Pista Rafa Nadal, saving another match point at 6/7 in the tie-break before he converted on his third opportunity to triumph. After his ninth win in a row, the fifth seed collapsed to the court in delight before he rose to his feet to embrace Diaz Acosta, who served two costly double faults in the tie-break. Tsitsipas is chasing his second title of the season, having captured his third Monte-Carlo Masters crown last week. He is up one spot to No. 7 in the ATP Live Rankings.

The 25-year-old, who is a three-time finalist in Barcelona, holds a 28-2 record against players ranked outside the Top 20 in the ATP Rankings on clay since the start of 2022. He will look to maintain that record when he meets No. 59 Dusan Lajovic in the semifinals on Saturday. Lajovic overcame Frenchman Arthur Fils 6-4, 3-6, 6-2 to reach his eighth tour-level semifinal and just his second since 2020. The World No. 59, who is a two-time tour-level champion, is the lowest-ranked semifinalist in Barcelona since then-World No. 63 Tsitsipas in 2018.



Nitin-Salman pair wins open doubles gold in Asia Cup rowing in South Korea

Indian rowers Nitin Deol and Salman Khan won the gold medal in the Men's Open Doubles competition in the 2024 Asian Cup here on Saturday.

The final race of this category concluded on Saturday morning and in a keenly contested race, Nitin Deol and Salman Khan defeated a strong challenge from a local pair to win in a timing of 6:35.73.

Meanwhile, in the Asia Oceania Olympic Qualification Regatta being held alongside this event, India's Lightweight Men's Double Sculls pair Ujjwal

Kumar and Arvind Singh topped their race and qualified for the final (Final A) on Saturday.

Balraj Panwar, who finished second in the Men's Singles Scull race, also qualified for the Final A as he inched closer to qualification for the Paris Olympic Games to be held from July 26 to August 11.

The winner of the final in the Asia Oceania Olympic Qualification Regatta will qualify for the Olympic Games. Those who fail to get through the continental qualifiers will get a chance to make it through the final Olympic qualifying regatta to be held in a few weeks.

Wrestler Anshu Malik & Vinesh Phogat secures Olympic quota

Wrestler Anshu Malik clinched the Olympic quota in women's 57 kg category after beating Laylokhon Sobirova of Uzbekistan by 11-0 at the Asian Olympic Qualification tournament on Saturday. Mansi Ahlawat faltered at the last hurdle as she missed out on a quota after losing 0-6 to reigning Asian Games Champion in the 62 kg semis. India's Vinesh Phogat clinched the Paris 2024 Olympic quota after beating Kazakhstan's Laura Ganikzy 10-0 in the



women's 50kg semifinal at the Asian Olympic qualifier on Saturday. Asian Games and Commonwealth champion



Phogat won the bout via technical superiority against Laura in 4 minutes 18 seconds.

I am 100 per cent ready to represent India in T20 WC, says Dinesh Karthik

I respect any decision that they take. But all I can say is I'm 100% ready. And you know I'll do everything I can to be on that flight to the World Cup," he added

Karthik's most recent innings came against Sunrisers Hyderabad of 83-runs in 35 deliveries which gave his team a chance to chase down the



mammoth total of 288 runs.

DK's innings ultimately ended up in a losing cause, but it still meant that RCB were able to post a total of 262 runs in their 20 overs, with the margin of defeat being just 25 runs.

"It's been thoroughly enjoyable to do what I'm doing for RCB as a finisher," said Karthik.

"Look, I think these days as a play-

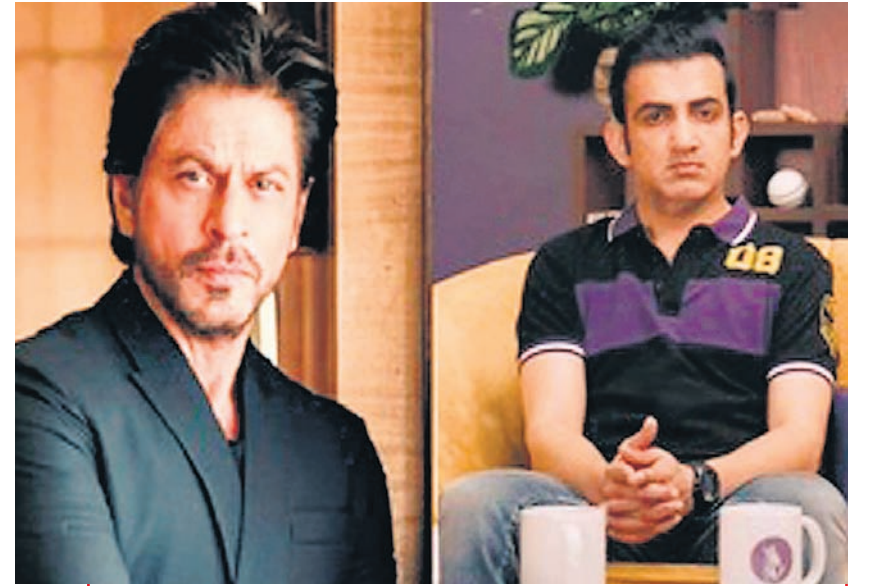


Sunny Leone slams physical violence, says even animals have code of conduct
