Lensman-anthropologist Rajesh Satankar rates Kumbh Mela as 'LOGISTICAL MARVEL'

Photographer Rajesh Satankar, who is gearing up for his photobook exhibition of 'Celebration of Heritage' in Mumbai, has captured the essence of the Kumbh Mela in his lens. Portraying varied shades of spirituality in his pictures, Rajesh feels that the extravaganza makes for a textbook in logistics management given the sheer number of people attending the mela.

Rajesh spoke with correspondent and opened up on his journey of experiencing the beauty of the Kumbh Mela from close quarters, his analysis as an anthropologist about the growing influence of globalisation on human civilisation and the connecting thread between those attending the mela.

Talking about the themes that intrigue him as a photographer, he told correspondent: "People, in all their fascinating complexities, are what truly intrigues me as a photographer. Perhaps it stems from my background in anthropology, but I find myself drawn to capturing the stories etched on people's faces, the way they interact, and the unspoken narratives of their everyday lives. There's magic in connecting with someone, hearing their stories, and then translating that essence into a single image. My passion for people photography manifests in a variety of ways."

He said that the grandiosity of weddings, the meticulous artistry of fashion shoots, and quiet moments of spirituality at the Kumbh Mela all hold a certain allure. Even the bustling energy of street life, with its random encounters and fleeting moments, sparks my creative fire.

When asked about the germ of the photobook, he told IANS that the idea for the book sprouted from two things that weighed heavily on his mind. Firstly, the Kumbh Mela effort-



lessly manages millions of people every single day.

"It's a logistical marvel, and I felt this incredible story wasn't being shared widely enough. The second reason stemmed from a concern about the younger generation's awareness of the Kumbh Mela. It's a global phenomenon, yet there seems to be a gap in understanding, particularly among youth. The media often focuses heavily on the religious aspects, which are undeniably important, but there's so much more to the experience."

He said that he wanted to create a book that went beyond just rituals and customs.

"I envisioned capturing the vibrant spirit of the Kumbh Mela - the coming together of diverse cultures, the temporary city that springs up to accommodate millions, the joyous festivities, and most importantly, the human connections that form there. This wasn't just about showcasing the spiritual signifi-

cance of the Mela, though that's a powerful aspect too."

He said that it was about portraying the Kumbh Mela as a place where people from all walks of life, with different beliefs and backgrounds, come together in a spirit of unity and shared experience.

"That, to me, was the heart of the story waiting to be told," he said.

When asked how will globalisation manifest itself with ideas, values, and cultures travelling across the globe?

He said: "As an anthropologist, I'm fascinated by globalisation's impact on cultural exchange. Historically, migration has shaped civilisations and the Kumbh Mela embodies this beautifully. People from all walks of life converge, sharing traditions and fostering a global community. Technology like AI is accelerating this exchange, creating a 'glocal' world where global connections exist alongside local identities."

He said that this interconnectedness can break down cultural barriers and foster understanding.

"Imagine someone of a different faith attending the Kumbh Mela, discovering new perspectives or even a path to enlightenment through witnessing the pilgrims' devotion. The Mela becomes a platform for global faith exploration, not conversion," he said.

He said that the Kumbh Mela offers hope as millions come together united by a purpose yet celebrating their unique traditions. "This is a microcosm of the future I see - a world where globalisation fosters cultural exchange and understanding, while still allowing local traditions to thrive," he added.

'Celebration of Heritage' will be held at the Nehru Centre in the Worli area of Mumbai, with an inaugural function on May 11 and an exhibition on May 12.

Horse polo returns after 100 years to venue that hosted first Test on Indian soil

After a huge gap of 100 years, the royal sport of horse polo will return to the iconic Bombay Gymkhana, the prestigious venue in Mumbai which hosted the first cricket Test match played on Indian soil. The Bombay Gymkhana is set to once again host the Bombay Gymkhana Arena Polo Championship at its hallowed turf on Sunday, as the premier polo event is being revived at this iconic venue after almost a century.

"The Bombay Gymkhana Polo Challenge Cup" was founded in 1882 and the inaugural edition was won by the Central India Horse team, but it was brought back home to the Bombay Gymkhana in 1885 by the Gymkhana's polo team.

Sanjiv Saran Mehra, President of Bombay Gymkhana, informed on Saturday, "As a precursor to the Bombay Gymkhana 150th year celebrations in 2025 we have plans to organise various sporting events, some new additions (like the Bombay Gymkhana 10K run which was held in March 2024 or reviving some sports events linked to our rich



sporting heritage. In this connection, we are reviving 'The Bombay Polo Challenge Cup' founded in 1882." Two teams, comprising a mix of players from the Amateur Riders Club, Mumbai and the Artillery Corps, Nasik, will battle it out for supremacy under floodlights in an arena format on Sunday. The Bombay Gymkhana, one of India's most prestigious and premier clubs founded in 1875, boasts a rich heritage of sporting history and culture. The Gymkhana, which takes pride in having hosted the first cricket Test match in India in 1933, was also the home of Polo with the sport being hosted by Bombay Gymkhana and competitions being conducted until 1920 at this iconic venue. The Bombay Gymkhana was also one of the venues when India hosted its first Hockey World Cup in 1982. It plays host to a couple of top squash, billiards and snooker and rugby events annually.

UPI payments see surge in India, leading people to overspending too: Experts

As India's digital and less-cash journey gains steam, more and more people are not only purchasing their daily essentials via unified payments interface (UPI) mode of digital transactions but also costly home appliances, high-end gadgets and designer apparels, among other things.

The seamless digital journey via the UPI mode has also resulted in people overspending on stuff they actually may not need at times, experts said on Saturday.

The purchasing trend via UPI/QR code is due to the fact that digital transactions now take a jiffy to complete the purchase journey via smartphones.

According to a recent survey by IIT Delhi, nearly 74 per cent of people in the country are 'overspending' as a result of using UPI and other digital payment methods.

"The convenience and ease of digital transactions through UPI, in comparison to cash, may indeed lead to lower



awareness of spending, as transactions are seamless and reduce the tangible feel of money leaving one's possession," Prabhu Ram, Head, Industry Intelligence Group at market intelligence firm CMR, told IANS.

Latest data from the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) revealed that the number of Unified Payments Interface (UPI) transactions reached 1,330 crore in April. On a year-on-year basis, the UPI transaction count has increased by 50 per cent.

Last year, the UPI transactions

increased by almost 60 per cent to reach a record 11,768 crore.

Ramesh Narasimhan, Chief Executive Officer-India, Worldline, said that UPI maintains its position as the uncontested frontrunner, buoyed by substantial expansion in mobile transactions.

"This trend underscores users' growing confidence and familiarity with smartphone-based payment methods," Narasimhan added.

The average ticket size (ATS) of UPI transactions has also declined by 8 per cent from Rs 1,648 to Rs 1,515.

According to experts, consumer spending in India is soaring, with people splurging on cars, smartphones, TVs and other items, boosting the country's economic growth. However, the trend has also seen people overspending on certain high-priced items, thanks to UPI.

A recent report by Nielsen Media India, on behalf of Amazon India, showed that digital payment methods are on the rise in the country, with 42 per cent of consumers saying they will choose UPI for online festive shopping.

Mahindra & Mahindra joins MSDE to skill women to become drone pilots

Mahindra & Mahindra on Friday signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) for the flagship Drone Didi Yojana, launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, to skill women to become drone pilots. Under this partnership, Mahindra and MSDE will conduct two pilots at National Skill Training Institutes (NSTI) in Hyderabad and Noida to skill 500 women in batches of 20 each.

The 15-day curriculum, which has been approved by the Directorate General of Civil Aviation, will be conducted at these centres by RPTO (Remote Pilot Training



Organisation) instructors, the company mentioned.

"The pilot under the Drone Didi Yojana represents a first-of-its-kind convergence of women, farming, and technology. We are delighted to provide technology training to grassroots women and ensure that agriculture is equipped for the future," Dr Anish Shah, Group CEO & MD, Mahindra Group, said in a statement.

The programme aims to train 15,000 women to oper-

ate drones for agricultural purposes such as fertiliser sowing, crop monitoring and seed sowing.

"This collaboration advances our mission of upskilling women for nation-building, particularly through the successful implementation of the Drone Didi programme in empowering women in emerging trades," said Atul Kumar Tiwari, Secretary, MSDE. The learnings and outcomes from the Pilot project will help MSDE in scaling up the Drone Didi Yojana at identified NSTIs or ITIs across the country.

As a further support to the intent of the Drone Didi Yojana, Mahindra said that it will soon roll out this training for women at the company's skilling centres at Zaheerabad, Telangana and Nagpur, Maharashtra.

Solar storm hits SpaceX's Starlink satellites

Starlink, the satellite arm of Elon Musk's SpaceX, on Saturday, warned users of a "degraded service" as the biggest geomagnetic storm struck the Earth due to solar activity in a very long time.

"Starlink is currently experiencing degraded service. Our team is investigating," the company wrote on its website.

Earlier, in a post on X, the tech billionaire highlighted the severity of the storm, saying that it has put Starlink satellite fleet under intense pressure and described it as "the biggest in a long time".

"Major geomagnetic solar storm happening right now. Biggest in a long time. Starlink satellites are under a lot of pressure, but holding up so far," Musk wrote.

According to the US National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, a major storm is currently occurring, which is the largest one since October 2003.

This storm is expected to continue over the weekend and poses potential risks to various systems such as navigation, power grids, and satellite navigation.

Meanwhile, Musk has said that Tesla will be investing over \$500 million in its Supercharger network to create thousands of new chargers in 2024.

"Tesla will spend well over \$500 million expanding our Supercharger network to create thousands of new chargers this year," Musk wrote on X.

He also said that this money only accounts for new sites and expansions, and not for operations costs, which are much higher.

Trans actor Trinetra Haldar shares facial transformation transition completed

Actress Trinetra Haldar, who was last seen in the streaming show 'Made In Heaven', has shared that she underwent facial transformation, recently. On Saturday, the actress took to her Instagram to share the news with her followers. She shared a picture of her face wrapped up in bandages in a graphic design. She penned a long note in the caption as she called the process the ultimate step in her transformation journey.

She wrote: "Facial Feminisation Surgery (FFS) in Spain isn't just a vacation, chaotic sketches and diary entries on opioids FFS is one of many interventions a trans person may undergo to feel more alignment between body and gender identity. Other gender-affirming interventions may include gender-affirming hormone therapy (GAHT/HRT), gender-affirming genital surgery, etc. My transition is complete."

She further said that she didn't think this final step would happen anytime soon, but it has. "I did this by myself, for myself, and still can't believe it. Transition to me is deeply spiritual, and not the stuff of tabloids and speculative nonsense. I haven't talked about wanting FFS at all mostly out of fear of public scrutiny and judgement, but why shy away from something so important in this journey of accessing myself? Who cares what anybody thinks or believes? Truth be told, I've wanted this for a decade, and there were lots of reasons to wait. I ticked them all off one by one." "I have no interest in promoting bodily intervention, but I do believe in transparency, as has always been the case, especially as a doctor. My reasons were gender affirmation and confidence therefrom, as extensively deliberated on over years of therapy. Others may have their own. Doing this alone hasn't been easy, but my god, I'm convinced I'm f***** invincible," she concluded.

Visually impaired lottery seller pardons man who stole her tickets

For Rosamma life is all about honesty, hard work and forgiveness. She sits quietly on the roadside selling lottery tickets to those who desire to check their luck. She trusts people to pay her every time they pick a ticket. She cannot see the faces but can recognise the voices.

Visually impaired Rosamma ekes out a living by selling Kerala State Lottery tickets here.

Recently she realized that the balance tickets and the cash were not tallying. She suspected some customer

who was taking the ticket but not paying money.

Upset by this, she got in touch with a fellow visually impaired lottery seller, her friend in Malappuram.

It was he who suggested she get a pen camera and she bought one through online mode.

Determined to catch the thief, she pinned the camera on her dress. And in the evening when she gave the pen camera to a friend who checked the visuals, the thief was identified.

"I get to know my customers through their voice and when the person, who was caught on the pen camera, came again. I told him that he had done a wrong. Initially, he tried to wriggle out, but when he was told that he had been caught on her pen camera, he admitted his crime and said he would compensate me, but I refused," said 45-year-old Rosamma.

"Then I told him that he needed to assure me that he would never again do this cheating, especially to those who are in deep distress due to various reasons. He agreed he would not do it again and in return, I promised him that I would not reveal his name or show the visuals to any person," said Rosamma.



PM MODI SPREADING HATRED IN SOCIETY, ALLEGES PRIYANKA GANDHI

Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi has accused Prime Minister Narendra Modi of spreading hatred in the society.

She claimed that PM Modi's truth has come out before the people as he can't seek votes on the basis of his performance.

"He seeks votes only in the name of religion. He only spreads hatred in the society for his political gains," she said.

On the last day of the election campaign in Telangana, she addressed the public at Tandru in Chevella constituency and a roadshow in Kamareddy in Zaheerabad constituency.

She said if PM Modi had worked, laid roads, built schools, hospitals and industries, he would have sought votes on the basis of these issues.

She alleged that, in 10 years of his rule, PM Modi did nothing for the poor, farmers, workers, women and small traders. "What has he given you? Demonetisation, GST, price-rise, unemployment and the gift of hatred," she remarked.



Asserting that the country was formed on the basis of love, non-violence and truth, the Congress General Secretary said that all countrymen are brothers and sisters.

She also accused PM Modi of giving away the country's resources to a few friends. "He waived off loans of 16 lakh crore of a few billionaires," she said.

Priyanka Gandhi said the people of

the country have awakened. "They don't want hatred. They want employment and development. Farmers need support, women need to stand on their feet and workers need fair wages," she said.

The Congress leader appealed to people to bring a change. "Tell Modi ji and his every candidate that enough is enough. We don't need your government. We don't need your anti-

constitutional ideology," she said.

"Bring a government which can re-establish politics of honesty and democracy. Send a message from here that we will save democracy and Constitution and fight to protect reservation," she added.

The Congress leader urged people to bring a government which does not misguide them but serves them.

"You have to decide whether you want a leader who never went to a poor's house or a leader who walked 4,000 km and met the poor. Do you need a leader who utters lies or a leader who never retreats from the path of truth," she said.

With Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy by her side, she asked people if they were happy with his government.

She said the Congress has given more guarantees in Lok Sabha elections. Eldest woman member of every poor family will get Rs 1 lakh every year. There will be the legal guarantee for MSP for farmers. For the educated unemployed, the government will come out with a scheme Pehli Naukri Pakki, she added.

Vijayamma appeals to Kadapa voters to support Sharmila

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y. S. Jagan Mohan Reddy's mother Y. S. Vijayamma on Saturday appealed to people of Kadapa Lok Sabha constituency to vote for her daughter and state Congress President Y. S. Sharmila Reddy, who is contesting from Kadapa Lok Sabha constituency. Breaking her silence on the last day of the campaign, Vijayamma released a video appealing to voters of Kadapa to elect her daughter with a huge majority. She said she was making an appeal to all those who respect and love the Late Y. S. Rajasekhara Reddy to cast their vote in favour of his daughter and gave her an opportunity to serve the Kadapa constituency.

Vijayamma, who has been staying away from active politics for the last couple of years, is reported to be in the United States. Sharmila has entered the fray from Kadapa against her cousin and sitting MP Y. S. Avinash Reddy of the YSR Congress Party (YSRCP).

Sharmila has been bitterly criticising her brother for fielding Avinash Reddy despite the CBI naming him as an accused in the murder of their uncle and former minister Y. S. Vivekananda Reddy. Supported by Vivekananda Reddy's daughter Y. S. Sunitha Reddy, Sharmila has called upon people to defeat Jagan Mohan Reddy for shielding the murder accused. Vivekananda Reddy was



murdered a few days before the 2019 elections.

Sharmila, who had campaigned actively for YSRCP in the 2014 and 2019 elections, fell out with his brother when he allegedly started ignoring her after becoming the Chief Minister in 2019. Vijayamma resigned as the honorary President of YSRCP in 2022 to back her daughter, who had floated YSR Telangana Party. She merged the party with Congress early this year and was appointed president of the Andhra Pradesh Congress committee.

YSR, as Rajasekhara Reddy was popularly known, was Chief Minister of the united Andhra Pradesh from 2004 to 2009. He died in a helicopter crash in September 2009, a few months after leading the Congress to power for a second consecutive term.

In the May 13 elections, Jagan Mohan Reddy is seeking re-election from Pulivendula, one of the seven Assembly segments in the Kadapa Lok Sabha constituency.

'Whenever his party becomes weak, Sharad Pawar joins Congress', taunts Fadnavis

The Deputy Chief Minister of Maharashtra, Devendra Fadnavis, said on Saturday that whenever Sharad Pawar's party becomes weak, he joins the Congress and later leaves it.

Clarifying that Prime Minister Narendra Modi has not made an 'offer' to NCP (SP) chief Sharad Pawar, but 'advised' him to join the NDA, the senior BJP leader said, "From 1977 till date, we have seen that whenever Sharad Pawar's party weakens, he merges with the Congress and then exits.

"Sharad Pawar had said that he contested the elections on five different symbols. If we look at his political career, whenever his party became weak, he joined Congress, corrected his position, and then left the party," Fadnavis said. He said that PM Modi has advised Pawar not to merge with the Congress, which is a sinking ship, but to join the NDA.

"Sharad Pawar has realised that the Ajit Pawar-led NCP nominee will win the Baramati seat. So he made a statement that the regional parties should merge with



Congress after June 4. So, he knows the outcome of the elections. Already you are drowning, and now you are going to a sinking ship," Fadnavis said.

On his part, Pawar has ruled out the possibility of joining the BJP-led NDA, saying that there is no question of joining "such people who have no faith in democracy".

MEHBOOBA MUFTI ACCUSES ADMINISTRATION OF 'TRYING TO FIX ELECTIONS'

Former J&K Chief Minister and PDP President Mehbooba Mufti on Saturday alleged that the J&K administration is 'trying to fix elections'.

Addressing a press conference here today, Mehbooba Mufti alleged that the authorities have imposed restrictions for 48 hours from 6:30 pm on Saturday under Section 144 in Pulwama, which is part of the Srinagar Lok Sabha seat going to polls on Monday.

"From 6:30 pm today, Section 144 has been imposed in Pulwama district which is unprecedented. It has not happened before that restrictions are imposed where the elections are to take place and that too till the time of the conclusion of the elections.

They (the administration) are trying to harass the people so that they do not come out to vote," she said.

She said that preparations are being made to commit fraud in the elections.

"The election is being fixed," she



said. The former Chief Minister added that her party workers, who were organising meetings, have also been detained ahead of the polling.

"This is not restricted to Pulwama only. Some days back, there was an attack in Surankote (in Poonch dis-

trict of Jammu). Following the attack, our 50 to 60 workers have been detained," the former Chief Minister said. She said that if the Election Commission of India (ECI) has to repeat the 1987 elections then why this "drama of elections" is being

enacted in Kashmir?

"If they have to create Ikhwan (government gunmen) or the party of Ikhwan, their proxies whom they are supporting then they should say it. The administration is not yet openly coming out in support of their proxies as they are waiting for the elections to conclude in two seats in Srinagar and Baramulla. After that, they will declare their support in Rajouri-Poonch (part of Anantnag-Rajouri seat). The election was delayed there only because of their party, the party of suited-booted Ikhwan. They have created political Ikhwan whom they support fully, the whole government machinery supports them," Mehbooba Mufti said.

She said that government officials are under pressure to selectively target and harass the PDP workers.

"L-G Manoj Sinha should stop this election drama. If you want to do fraud in the name of elections then tell us and we will leave and will not put the lives of our workers at risk," she said.

'Missing' posters put up at AAP MLA Amanatullah Khan's residence days after petrol pump assault

The Noida Police on Saturday put up 'missing' posters at the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) MLA Amanatullah Khan's residence, days after booking him and his son in a violent assault case at the city's petrol pump.

The police have formed three teams to find out the 'whereabouts' of AAP MLA and his son and also intensified their search operation to trace the duo.

Amanatullah Khan's son had thrashed the employees of a petrol pump in Noida Sector 95, the video of which went viral on social media. In the CCTV footage, the AAP leader's son and his aides could be seen jumping the queue at the petrol pump and then thrashing the staff after a heated exchange.



After the assault incident, the Noida Police had booked AAP MLA's son and himself for creating disorder. The report said Amanatullah Khan also reached the fuel station after the fracas and threatened the fuel station employees. Noida Police on Saturday reached AAP

MLA's Okhla residence and pasted missing posters. An official said that the duo have kept their phones on 'switch off' mode and are untraceable. The police also said that they have tried to reach both Amanatullah and his son but both are deliberately avoiding them. Meanwhile, the cops claim

that they have enough evidence and have also taken account of eyewitnesses regarding the violent altercation that took place at the Noida petrol pump on May 7. Notably, AAP MLA Amanatullah Khan is also accused in a case linked to irregularities in the Waqf Board case.

Idashisha Nongrang becomes first woman police chief of Meghalaya

Shillong: Idashisha Nongrang, a 1992 batch IPS officer coming from a tribal background, was on Saturday appointed the first woman Director General of Police (DGP) of Meghalaya.

Currently serving as the Director General of Civil Defence & Home Guard in Meghalaya, Nongrang will assume charge with effect from May 20, replacing L.R. Bishnoi who will retire on May 19, officials said. The move follows a recommendation by the Empanelment Committee of the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC).

Congratulating Nongrang, Meghalaya Chief Minister Conrad Sangma posted on X: "Heartiest congratulations to Smti Idashisha Nongrang, IPS, on her appointment as the new DGP. Breaking barriers and making history, she became the first tribal lady from our state to hold this position, a moment of immense pride for all of us. Wishing her all the best!"

Two days before polls, wife of Trinamool candidate joins BJP in Bengal

Two days before the May 13 Lok Sabha elections at Ranaghat in West Bengal's Nadia district, Swastika Maheshwari, the wife of Trinamool Congress candidate Mukut Mani Adhikari, joined the BJP on Saturday.

Maheshwari, who is already contesting a divorce suit against her husband, joined the BJP at a party rally at Ranaghat in the presence of megastar and BJP leader Mithun Chakraborty.

"Anyone voting for Mukut Mani Adhikari will be cheated exactly like me," she said.

The development comes as a major embarrassment concerning Adhikari, against whom Maheshwari filed a complaint just a few days after their marriage last year accusing him of cruelty against her. Adhikari's nomination as Trinamool Congress candidate has been marred with controversy. He was elected as a BJP legislator in the 2021 West Bengal assembly elections from the Ranaghat-Dakshin constituency, one of the seven under the Ranaghat Lok Sabha. Earlier this year, he joined Trinamool Congress. However, his name was announced as a Trinamool Congress candidate from Ranaghat before he



resigned as a BJP legislator. As the BJP started making an issue of it, he finally resigned from the state assembly as a member last month. Till the time this report was filed, there was no reaction from Adhikari.

Videos of three abducted car dealers tortured with electric shocks to private parts go viral in Karnataka; 7 arrested

The Karnataka police have arrested seven persons for the brutal torture of three kidnapped second-hand car dealers in Kalaburagi district of the state on Saturday.

Horrifying videos, which went viral on social media, show the kidnappers administering electric shocks to the victims' private parts. The victims, were in a nude state.

The arrested abductors have been identified as Imran Patel, Mohammad Matheen a.k.a Steel Matheen, Mohammad Zia Ul Hussain, Mohammad Afzal Sheik, Hussain Sheik, Ramesh, and Sagar. The gang reportedly includes others, and the police have launched a hunt for them. The victims lodged a complaint with the Vishwavidyalaya police station in Kalaburagi on May 5 at 9:30 p.m., complaining that they were kidnapped while showing a second-hand car to the accused on May 4.

The victims were held captive at an isolated location, assaulted with sticks, and extorted for money. The accused tortured the victims, demanding more money. The police have initiated a further investigation into the matter.



Amid fuel shortage, NFR operates 2 freight trains carrying petrol, diesel in NE states

Amid the disruption of train services in a few northeastern states for the past 17 days due to landslides in the hill section of Assam leading to a shortage of transport fuel and essential items, two freight trains, carrying petrol and diesel, reached Tripura and Silchar (Assam) from Guwahati to provide relief to the people.

Northeast Frontier Railway's (NFR) Chief PRO Sabyasachi De said the two freight trains, each consisting of 50 wagons carrying petrol and diesel, crossed the risky Jatinga Lumpur-New Harangajao section in Assam's Dima Hasao district safely at noon on Saturday.

Railways and state government officials said the arrival of the freight train in Tripura and southern Assam



would lessen the shortage of transport fuel in southern Assam, Tripura, Manipur, and Mizoram.

According to the NFR officials, passenger and goods train services have

been affected in the region since April 25 owing to heavy landslides causing damage to railway tracks in the Jatinga Lumpur-New Harangajao section under Lumding division after

heavy rains lashed the mountainous Dima Hasao district, a connecting route to southern Assam, Tripura, Manipur, and Mizoram.

Hundreds of workers and technicians, led by railway engineers, are working round-the-clock to restore the train services in the mountainous areas.

Considering the weak railway tracks and soil in the region, the NFR is now operating a limited number of trains in the daytime on the hilly route, besides regulating long-distance and express trains.

According to the officials, the stocks of fuel -- petrol and diesel -- and other essential goods in southern Assam, Tripura, Mizoram, and parts of Manipur are not adequate due to the restrictions on the movement of goods trains.

'YOGI ADITYANATH WILL BE SACKED'

ARVIND KEJRIWAL'S BIG CLAIM IF BJP WINS LOK SABHA ELECTION 2024

Arvind Kejriwal, addressing his first press conference since leaving jail, said that the Bharatiya Janata Party will not only imprison Opposition leaders but also leaders from their own party. Mr Kejriwal claimed that Prime Minister Narendra Modi has started a "one nation, one leader" mission and he will soon end the political career of Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath too.



"Our country is very old, whenever a dictator tried to take over, the people uprooted him. Today again a dictator wants to end democracy. I have come to beg from 140 crore people," he added.

In his speech, he singled out PM Modi and Home Minister Amit Shah as engineers behind a power takeover within the BJP, referring to how the BJP changes chief ministers in many states before assembly

elections to "clip their wings". He also warned that all the opposition leaders including Chief Ministers Mamata Banerjee, and MK Stalin would be sent to jail in case the BJP-led NDA comes to power after the 2024 Lok Sabha elections.

"They will send opposition leaders to jail and will finish them (Nipta denge) ... Our ministers, Hemant Soren (former Jharkhand CM), ministers of Mamata Banerjee's party (Trinamool Congress) are in jail... If they (BJP) win again, then Mamata Banerjee, MK Stalin, RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav, Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan, Uddhav Thackeray (UBT Chief) and other opposition leaders will all be in jail," Kejriwal said.

NARENDRA MODI WILL CONTINUE TO BE PM EVEN AFTER TURNING 75: AMIT SHAH

Hyderabad: Asserting that

Narendra Modi will continue to be the Prime Minister in the third term of NDA, Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Saturday sought to clarify that the BJP Constitution has no rule that a leader who reaches the age of 75 years should not hold the post.

"Modiji is not only going to complete this term but will continue to lead the country in future. There is no confusion in BJP. They want to create confusion," he said when asked to comment on Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's statement in which he said that PM Modi should be retiring after turning 75 on September 17.

"I want to say this to Arvind Kejriwal and company and the entire INDI alliance you need not rejoice over Modiji turning 75. It's not written anywhere in the BJP's constitution," he said at a Press conference here.



11 Maha LS seats campaigning ends

The high-octane campaigning for voting in 11 Parliamentary constituencies in Maharashtra in the fourth phase of Lok Sabha elections concluded on Saturday with both MahaYuti and Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) brimming with confidence of emerging victors.

The 11 constituencies which will go for polling on May 13 include Nandurbar, Jalgaon, Raver, Jalna, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar (Aurangabad), Beed, Pune, Shirur, Ahmednagar, Shirdi and Maval.

The recent controversy over Maratha and OBC reservations and caste politics dominated the major part of the campaigning narrative of both MahaYuti and MVA.

There are a total of 298 candidates in the fray in the

11 Lok Sabha seats while 2,28,01,151 voters will exercise their voting rights.

For the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), the polls are a crucial test to retain its supremacy in Nandurbar, Jalgaon, Raver, Jalna, Ahmednagar and Beed constituencies.

In the tribal dominated Nandurbar seat, sitting MP Heena Gavit hopes to score a hat-trick. She is locked in a direct fight with Congress nominee Gopal Padvi.

In Jalgaon, the BJP has fielded former legislator Smita Wagh, replacing sitting MP Unmesh PATIL, against Shiv Sena (UBT) nominee Karan Pawar.

In Raver, incumbent MP Raksha Khadse -- daughter-in-law of veteran leader Eknath Khadse who will soon rejoin BJP -- faces an acid test to win for the third time. She faces a challenge

from NCP (SP) nominee, Shriram Patil -- an industrialist.

In Jalna, Union Minister Raosaheb Danve, who is expecting a win for the sixth consecutive term, is pitted against Congress' Kalyanrao Kale. In Pune, former mayor Murlidhar Mohol is engaged in a direct fight against Congress legislator Ravindra Dhangekar while the heir of the pioneers of the cooperative movement, Sujay Vikhe Patil is locked in a fight against Covid warrior and NCP (SP) candidate Nilesh Lanke.

In Beed, the BJP dropped sitting MP Pritam Munde, who is the daughter of former union minister Gopinath Munde and fielded her sister -- Gopinath Munde's elder daughter -- Pankaja Munde against NCP (SP) candidate Bajrang Sonawane.

PM Modi recalls 1998 Pokhran tests that showcased India's strength to world

Remembering the historic feat achieved in India's nuclear capabilities during the 1998 Pokhran tests, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Saturday said that the day is not only a testament to India's emergence as a nuclear power but also highlights the country's ongoing growth and strengthening status as a global pioneer in technological innovations.

Saturday marks the anniversary of the 1998 Pokhran nuclear tests, the first time India made the world aware of its capabilities. "25 years ago today, Atal Ji's gov-

While India demonstrated its potential, the Congress continues to sow fear by suggesting Pakistan's possession of nuclear weapons," PM Modi said while addressing an election rally in Odisha's Kandhamal. Criticising Congress for its softened stance, he added: "They repeatedly try to frighten us, warning about Pakistan's atomic bomb. However, Pakistan is struggling to manage its own situation. They're even trying to sell their bombs, but no one wants to buy them because of their poor quality." Several top BJP

leaders and ministers also greeted the scientific fraternity of the country while recalling the Pokhran tests of 1998.



"If and when PM agrees...": Rahul Gandhi on invitation for public debate

After he said he was 100% ready to take on Prime Minister Narendra Modi in a public debate on the Lok Sabha elections, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi has formally replied to a letter by two former judges and a senior journalist inviting him and the PM to be part of such an event.

Stating that he or Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge would be pleased to participate in the debate, the Wayanad MP has asked the potential organisers to let him know if the PM agrees to do so as well. Former

Supreme Court judge Madan Lokur, former Delhi High Court Chief Justice Ajit Prakash Shah and N Ram, senior journalist and former editor of 'The Hindu', had written to PM Modi and Rahul Gandhi on Thursday, proposing a public debate between them. The letter said that the Lok Sabha election has reached its halfway mark and while both sides have raised important questions about each other's manifestos and key issues, there had been no "meaningful responses". "To this end, we believe that citizens would hugely benefit by hearing directly from our political leaders through a public debate on a non-partisan and non-

commercial platform. It would be ideal if the public heard not just the questions of each side, but also the responses. We are of the view that this would help to strengthen our democratic process immensely," the letter said. "As the principal parties fighting the election, the public deserve to hear from their leaders directly. Accordingly, either myself or the Congress President would be pleased to participate in such a debate. Please do let us know if and when the Prime Minister agrees to participate, following which we can discuss the details and format of the debate," Rahul said in a response posted on X.

WILL NOT GO INSIDE RAJ BHAVAN EVEN IF I AM INVITED: MAMATA BANERJEE

In an oblique reference to the sexual harassment controversy surrounding West Bengal Governor CV Ananda Bose, the state's Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Saturday afternoon said that she would never go inside Raj Bhavan even if she was invited.

"I will not go inside Raj Bhavan even if I am invited. I would be better to meet on the streets. Whatever I heard about you it will be a sin to sit beside you," the Chief Minister said this without directly referring to CV Ananda Bose or the recent police



complaint against the Governor, accusing him of outrage of modesty.

However, Governor Bose has vehemently denied the accusations.

Without directly referring to the recent screening of CCTV footage at Raj Bhavan for the public earlier this week, Mamata Banerjee said that she had got a copy of the original footage and the edited version.

"I have kept it with myself. I have also got the edited copy. All are yet to be revealed. Today I received yet another pen-drive. What authority do you have to harass a woman?" Mamata Banerjee questioned.

Without directly naming Bose, the Chief Minister also made a reference to the recent statement by the Governor that he will not tolerate high-handedness over Raj Bhavan.

Char Dham Yatra hit by rain, snowfall day after it began

Uttarakhand was hit by heavy rainfall today, a day after the Char Dham Yatra began. The sudden weather change posed difficulties for the devotees on the adventurous pilgrimage. It's been raining heavily in the Ganga valley, including at the Gangotri temple, one of the pilgrimage sites of Char Dham Yatra along with Yamunotri, Kedarnath, and

Badrinath. The weather also took a turn in Badrinath today as the higher peaks witnessed snowfall and the low lying areas were hit by rain, a day before the doors of the revered temple are set to open for the devotees.

Earlier in the day, a huge crowd of devotees was stuck in long queues for hours on the hilly path to Yamunotri. The devotees blamed the authorities for the lack of proper management.

The Char Dham Yatra began yesterday, as the doors of Yamunotri, Kedarnath, and Gangotri temples were opened for devotees. The doors of Yamunotri and Kedarnath were opened at 7 am yesterday while the door of the Gangotri temple opened at 12.25 pm in the presence of thousands of devotees. Every year, lakhs of devotees turn up for the yatra from April-May to October-November.

DEATH TOLL FROM AFGHANISTAN'S FLOODS EXCEEDS 330

Kabul: More than 330 people have been killed as rainstorms and flash floods hit major parts of the provinces of Baghlan, Takhar, Badakhshan and Ghor of Afghanistan, according to the Afghanistan office of the World Food Programme and local Afghan officials, Xinhua news agency reported. The UN agency said Saturday on social media that more than 300 people have been killed in northern Baghlan province alone, with more than 1,000 houses destroyed.

"WFP is now distributing fortified biscuits to the survivors," it said. Local officials said on Saturday that at least 160 people have been killed and 117 others injured as rainstorms and flash floods hit major parts of the provinces of Baghlan, Takhar, Badakhshan and Ghor of war-ravaged Afghanistan.

What Causes A Solar Storm? Indian Scientist Explains

A celestial event is unfolding as solar flares and coronal mass ejections dazzle the skies, potentially extending the spectacle as far south as Alabama and Northern California in the US.

However, alongside the beautiful auroras, there are concerns over potential disruptions to Earth's communications networks this weekend. Explaining the phenomenon, a scientist said solar flares are common and so happen all the time. "It happens when the sun gets to the peak of its activity of the 11-year cycle.

After every 11 years, the activity of the sun goes from high to low and in 2025 the activity is going to be at its peak," scientific officer at the Institute for Plasma Research Centre Dr Ravi AV Kumar told news agency. The rarity of this solar storm harks back to October 2003, according to the US National Oceanic



and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA) space weather prediction centre, marking a significant celestial occurrence not seen in many years. The chance of solar flares coming out at this time are more, as these are highly charged particles of plasma

which can travel at very high velocities, the scientist said. The faster these particles move the more dangerous they are, he added. "Since these are charged particles from the Sun, they can get deflected from the Earth's magnetic field. Some of these deflected particles can come to polar regions of the Earth, which then interact with gas molecules in the upper atmosphere," Dr Kumar said. "... They produce a colour called Aurora. When there is a very strong solar flare like the one which happened yesterday, combined with the Earth's atmosphere and magnetic field, it produces Auroras. People are very fortunate to even see this right up to northern Italy," Dr Kumar said. "The Aurora could also be seen in Ladakh... Flares come and go; they don't affect us directly but can affect our day-to-day activities like communication as the satellites can be disrupted. Satellite TV signals and radio communication could also get disrupted," the scientist said.

Kushwaha's Gwalior South assembly constituency, voting was two percent less. There was 7 percent less voting in Energy Minister Pradyuman Singh Tomar's Gwalior assembly constituency. Similarly, 7 to 9 percent less voting has been recorded in the assembly constituencies of Krishna Gaur and Gaurav Tetwal.

In such a situation, the positions of these ministers are now in danger. Amit Shah is said to be very angry with the fact that despite giving targets, there has been less voting in the assembly constituencies of many ministers. BJP strategists believe that due to this the party may have to suffer loss in the elections.

Investment scam exposed in Bhopal

Fraud worth lakhs in the name of Gold Desert Coin

Cyber Cell has exposed a major cryptocurrency scam, in which the accused defrauded investors of crores of rupees through a fake crypto exchange. In this scam, with strings attached to Dubai, the accused lured people to invest in DGC/GDC coins and promised benefits like Bitcoin. He created IDs of around 10,000 people on his crypto exchange and conducted high-profile seminars across the country. Ultimately, he committed a fraud of around Rs 5 crore.

17 April 2024 Rajendra Viraj Singh Verma, a resident of Katara Hills, Bhopal, has filed an investment scam complaint, in which he has alleged that he was defrauded of Rs 1.15 lakh in the name of investing in Gold Desert Coin. According to Mr Verma, accused Sumit Jain, Atul Jain and Trilok Patidar lured him into this investment scheme through the website golddesertcoin.info.

The complainant said that he was assured that the value of his money would increase manifold if he invested in Gold Desert Coin (DGC). In an organized meeting, which was arranged by the accused Patidar, they were also told that the amount of their money



would triple after investment.

In this case, a crime has been registered under section 406, 420, 120 (B) of the Indian Penal Code and investigation has been started. This incident has reminded investors to exercise caution in online investment schemes. Bhopal Police has arrested one accused in this case, and the search for other accomplices is on. This scam is being investigated by a special team of Bhopal Cyber Cell, in which the accused have been caught through technical analysis and evidence collection. Mobile phones, laptops, and PCs have been seized from the possession of the accused.

MP HIGH COURT NOTICE TO KAREENA KAPOOR ON PREGNANCY BIBLE

Advocate Christopher Anthony had filed the petition in the High Court in 2022. The first hearing was held in August 2022, when the High Court had also asked the state government to form a party. Later the matter cooled down a bit. The hearing took place on May 10 after Anthony submitted his memorandum in the court.

It has been argued in the petition that adding Bible to the name hurt

the sentiments of people of Christian religion. Anthony says that the Bible is the religious text of Christianity. The description of the teachings of Lord Jesus is found in this holy book.

The use of Bible in Kareena's book is hurtful. Kareena Kapoor launched this book written on pregnancy on 9 August 2021. He called this book his third child. On the launch of the

book, she discussed with Karan Johar online and talked about the ups and downs in life during pregnancy. Kareena told that the second pregnancy was difficult for her as compared to the first pregnancy.

Kareena took to social media platform on 9 July 2021. Posted the video on Instagram. She asks, 'What? Is it baking?' After this She takes out the book from the microwave and says, 'It is baking.'

It was written, 'My pregnancy and my 'Pregnancy Bible' Writing, it has been a journey.

She wrote, 'There were some good days and some bad days, some days I was eager to go to work, but some days I was struggling to even get out of bed. This book describes my physical and emotional experiences during both my pregnancies. These are very personal details. In many ways this book is like my third child, from its conception till its birth day.'

'PM cries like a child on his problems rather than wiping tears of people', Priyanka says at Maha rally

Launching a broadside, Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra accused Prime Minister Narendra Modi of "crying like a child on his problems rather than spelling out steps to wipe the tears of the suffering masses", here on Saturday. Addressing a large tribal gathering during a rally in the Nandurbar (ST) Lok Sabha constituency in Maharashtra, Priyanka said it has become a norm for PM Modi to rave and rant about his problems on the dais during election rallies instead of discussing how he will resolve the peoples' burning issues.

"Modiji remembers the tribals only during elections when he comes to seek their votes. He claims to fight corruption alone -- but how can he be a loner? He has the entire government, its machinery, and agencies behind him. Instead of talking about what the BJP government did in the past 10 years, he comes on the stage and weeps, saying people are abusing him," she said.

The Congress leader also reminded the PM that he is in public life and should take inspiration from her grandmother (former Prime Minister late Indira Gandhi), who displayed her "Goddess Durga" strength and "chopped Pakistan into two pieces".

"Show some courage, Modiji... Learn from my grandmother and her sacrifices. But you cannot because you label that great martyr as a 'traitor'. Your words as a PM lack weight. The post of PM



was always held in high esteem and occupied by great leaders like Jawaharalal Nehru, Indira Gandhi, Atal Bihari Vajpayee, Manmohan Singh... Look at the level you have reduced it to," Priyanka said.

The Congress leader also recounted the problems faced by the tribals, Dalits, and poor families all over India, the atrocities on women in Manipur, tribal areas, Uttar Pradesh, among others, claiming, "But at all times, Modiji chose to keep mum and even supported the perpetrators of such heinous crimes."

"Modiji is cut off from the people... He has no inkling of how the poor are trying to survive amid the massive inflation, the horrors the womenfolk face... women who work outside the whole day, then come home and do the household chores, and look after the entire family," she said.

"In these times of high prices, the women are

unable to feed their families properly, or get medical care if anyone at home falls sick, they have no money for their children's education, or to marry off their daughters... They take loans for these needs and get caught in the debt-trap, with many committing suicide," Priyanka said amid loud cheers from the crowd.

She also claimed that rather than providing solutions or help to the masses, the Modi government is working against the interests of the ordinary people, who have continued to suffer in the past 10 years of BJP rule.

Replying to the PM's assertions made at a BJP rally in Nandurbar on Friday (May 10), Priyanka countered that President Droupadi Murmu is a tribal, but the BJP and the PM don't accord her the respect due to the august position she holds.

"The President has come up through sheer hard work... The PM built a new Parliament building worth thousands of crores, but did not invite her for its inauguration... The same thing he did with the Ram Temple in Ayodhya... Modiji only speaks sweet words in his rallies, but does something else... He works against the interests of tribals. He indulges in a lot of empty talks, there's a huge gap between his words and deeds," Priyanka said amid cheers and claps. Contending that PM Modi has lost touch with the masses and avoids going into their midst, she pointed out how his ministers and senior leaders are also scared of approaching him or telling him the grim realities confronting the country today.

Congress' OBC-BJP's Maratha vie to conquer prestigious Pune LS seat

Thrilled after the knockout victory of the Congress candidate Ravindra H.

Dhangekar in the Kasba Peth Assembly by-elections 15 months ago, the party has attempted to cash in on the goodwill even for the 2024 parliament polls, The Congress has fielded the OBC leader Dhangekar for the prestigious Pune Lok Sabha seat to grapple with the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP)'s Murlidhar Mohol, its Maratha face and an ex-Mayor, in place of the late Brahmin heavyweight Girish Bapat, who died as the sitting MP in March 2023.

Besides Congress' Dhangekar and BJP's Mohol, the third corner is occupied by Prakash Ambedkar-led Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi (VBA)'s Vasant More, who quit Raj Thackeray-headed Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS) in March (2024) after being denied a party ticket.

Dhangekar's victory in the Kasba Peth Assembly by-polls, a BJP Brahmin bastion was impressive in many ways. The by-polls were necessitated by the death of sitting MLA Mukta Tilak - a great-granddaughter-in-law of the freedom fighter Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak.

The BJP did not field any member of the Tilak family or even a Brahmin but nominated a Maratha Hemant Rasane who lost to Dhangekar in the BJP's bastion. Later, local



leaders attributed the BJP's loss to factors like not fielding a Brahmin and not giving a ticket to a Tilak family member to garner sympathy votes.

Rattled by Dhangekar's surprise sweep, the worried BJP did not favour the Lok Sabha bypoll after Bapat's demise and the seat remained vacant for nearly 15 months.

Since 1952, a Congress fortress 10 times, the Pune Lok Sabha seat had deserted the party on at least 7 occasions, aligning with some prevalent political 'wave' or a prominent candidate.

Woman sustains firecracker burns at Shrikant Shinde rally

A woman from Dombivli who was paid to participate in a rally organised for Shrikant Shinde-two-time MP and son of CM Eknath Shinde-sustained burns after she came in contact with firecrackers during the procession. The injured woman, Annapurna Shirsat, alleges that she was abandoned after the incident and no party worker offered medical help. The incident took place on May 2, when Shrikant Shinde, Shiv Sena Shinde group's candidate for the Kalyan Lok Sabha constituency, filed his nomination papers. At this time, women's self-help groups as



well as youngsters were taken in buses to Dombivli with the promise of a daily allowance of Rs 200 to be a part of the crowd. According to Shirsat, around 50 women from Lalchakki and Subhash hill areas of Ulhasnagar were ferried to Dombivli. Shirsat, an elderly woman in need of money joined the crowd to cheer the leader. These women were given a bottle of water and a vada pav each and were part of the rally from 8 am to 2 pm. He was accompanied by Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, MLA Dr Balaji Kinikar, and MLA Kumar Ailani, along with other leaders. Welcoming their arrival, the party workers burst firecrackers.

6-month-old baby kidnapped; rescued by Kalyan police

The Khadakpada police in Kalyan, along with the Madhya Pradesh police, have apprehended six individuals, who were involved in the kidnapping of a six-month-old boy from Rewa district in Madhya Pradesh. Authorities reported that among the arrested suspects is a teacher and five accomplices responsible for hatching the abduction. During the investigation, police said that the teacher, a 53-year-old man, wanted a child and paid Rs 29 lakh to acquire the child through illicit means. According to the police, a case was filed at the Civil Line police station in Rewa district, Madhya Pradesh, on May 7. The case was registered against an unknown individual under Sections 370, 363, and 34 of the Indian Penal Code. The baby boy belonged to a couple residing on the streets, who claimed in their statement to the police that a motorcyclist had approached them. They alleged that the motorcyclist forcibly took away their six-month-old baby and fled the

scene.

"After gathering input from sources, it came to light that a couple from Kalyan were involved in the crime. Accordingly, a team of Madhya Pradesh police reached Kalyan for further investigation," said a police officer. "After receiving information from the superintendent of police, Rewa, the Khadakpada police apprehended two suspects, Nitin Rajesh Soni and Swati Nitin Soni, in Ambiwali, Kalyan West.

During interrogation, they confessed to kidnapping the child after monitoring him for five days and bringing him to Kalyan. They claimed to have handed the baby over to Pradeep Kolamba, a rickshaw driver. The police detained Kolamba, and upon questioning, he stated that the infant had been passed on to Anmol Yerunkar and his wife, Arvi Yerunkar. The Yerunkar couple were also detained. Further investigation revealed that the six-month-old baby had been entrusted to Krishna Patil, 53, a teacher residing in Poladpur, Raigad, Panvel. Patil was subsequently taken into custody, and the rescued baby was

recovered from his possession," said a police officer.

"Patil, who was childless, urged Yerunkar to procure a newborn, specifically aged six to seven months, promising a hefty sum. Yerunkar, employed at a renowned Mumbai hospital, agreed to steal a baby for Patil, receiving Rs 29 lakh for the task. Yerunkar asked his wife, Arvi, who works in the stock market, to assist. Arvi, while commuting daily via autorickshaw, shared their need for a baby, promising the driver and later the Soni couple from Madhya Pradesh a significant reward. With the help of the rickshaw driver, they traveled to Madhya Pradesh and orchestrated the kidnapping. The Yerunkar family then invested the proceeds in a new home," said a police officer. The child is safe, and his health condition is good. These six accused have been handed over to the Madhya Pradesh Police along with the child, who will be later handed over to his parents," said Sachin Gunjal, deputy commissioner of police, Kalyan Division.

Brazilian national held at Mumbai airport for smuggling cocaine

Officers from the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) at Mumbai's Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport (CSMI) intercepted a Brazilian national on May 8, 2024, based on specific intelligence regarding drug smuggling. The suspect aroused suspicion and upon questioning, confessed to ingesting capsules containing drugs, intending to smuggle them into India.

BJP stoking communal tensions, instigating regional conflicts: Congress

In a recent address, Sachin Sawant, the spokesperson of the Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee (MPCC), vehemently criticised the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) government for stoking communal tensions and instigating regional conflicts. Speaking at the event on Friday, Sawant accused the BJP of resorting to divisive tactics ahead of the upcoming elections.

Sawant's remarks came in response to the BJP's attempts to "polarise voters along religious lines". He condemned the BJP for bringing up the Hindu-Muslim issue, calling it a dangerous ploy to divert attention from real issues affecting the country. Sawant urged the public to see through such tactics and focus on pressing concerns such as unemployment, inflation, and healthcare. "The BJP is using all possible means of bringing up the Hindu-Muslim conflict with instances of the prime minister using words like Muslim and Jihad, while also saying that if you vote the Congress, the votes will be counted as votes to Pakistan in an address during a rally," he said.

Turning his attention to Mumbai, Sawant criticized BJP candidates for exacerbating the Gujarati-Marathi conflict. He accused them of inflaming regional sentiments for political gain, warning that such actions could lead to social discord. "Instead of bringing up the Gujarati-Marathi conflict, the BJP candidates could have brought up the issues faced by the common man to ask for votes. If the candidates are resorting to such ways now, imagine how they will work after being elected. They will not pay



attention to the 'aam aadmi' needs and will use the power for their own benefit," he said.

Furthermore, Sawant spoke of the recent bail granted to Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal. "The Supreme Court too has realised that the BJP government is using central agencies like the Enforcement Directorate (ED) and the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to suppress the Opposition. BJP has been misusing these agencies

to intimidate and harass political opponents, undermining democracy. The blatant arrest of two CMs without any evidence is proof that BJP is using these agencies to deliberately disintegrate their parties." Sawant also cited the example of Ravindra Waikar and how he was forced to switch parties because of the ED case against him. "Waikar had only two options... either go to jail or change his party to avoid ED harassment," he said.

Fire breaks out in Bandra's Narang House; no injuries reported

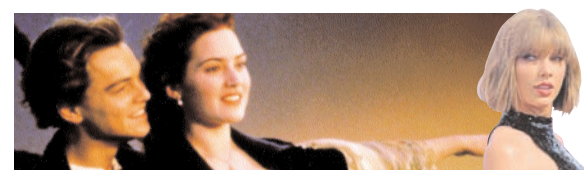

Sean 'Diddy' Combs files motion to dismiss Jane Doe sexual assault lawsuit

Rapper Sean 'Diddy' Combs' lawyers have filed a motion to dismiss a lawsuit accusing him of sexual assault. The motion comes five months after the music mogul, 54, former Bad Boy Entertainment president Harve Pierre, and another individual labelled "Third Assailant" were sued by a woman known as Jane Doe in the US District Court for the Southern District of New York, reports People magazine.

The December 2023 filing accused the individuals of sex trafficking and gang-raping Doe when she was 17 years old. Combs has previously denied all claims in his ongoing sexual assault lawsuits.

According to court documents filed on May 10 (Pacific Standard Time), accessed by 'People', Combs' attorneys claim that this is Doe's "second attempt to state an entirely false and heinous claim against the Combs Defendants".

Regarding the plaintiff's use of "trigger warning" in her pleading, as "legally irrelevant", the motion alleges that it was a "stunt" "intended to prominently showcase a baseless and time-barred claim, which was designed to cause the Combs Defendants unwanted publicity, embarrassment, and financial costs."

As per 'People', the motion states, "Combs and his companies categorically deny Plaintiff's decades-old tale against them, which has already caused incalculable damage to the reputations and business standing of the Combs Defendants, even before any evidence has been presented." The filing further argues that Doe "cannot allege what day or time of year the alleged incident occurred," calling for the case to be "dismissed now, with prejudice, to protect the Combs Defendants from further reputational injury and before more party and judicial resources are squandered."

As previously reported by 'People', the accuser's lawsuit claims that she was given drugs and alcohol before being "viciously gang-raped" "one after the other" after being convinced to take a private jet to Combs' recording studio in New York City.

Jane Doe's lawyer, Douglas H. Wigdor, previously said in a statement that "the depravity of these abhorrent acts has, not surprisingly, scarred our client for life."

The rapper has been hit with multiple sexual assault lawsuits in the past couple of months.

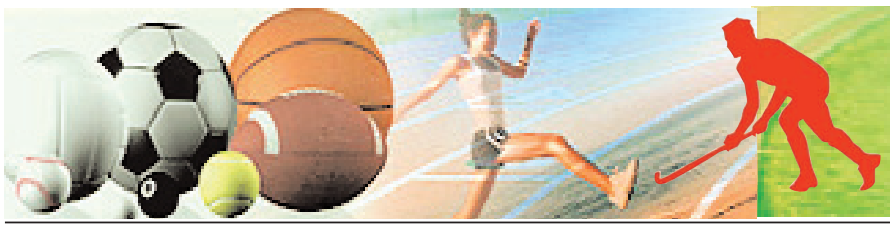

was held in March 2024 or reviving some sports events linked to our rich sporting heritage. In this connection, we are reviving 'The Bombay Polo Challenge Cup' founded in 1882." Two teams, comprising a mix of players from the Amateur Riders Club, Mumbai and the Artillery Corps, Nasik, will battle it out for supremacy under floodlights in an arena format on Sunday. The Bombay Gymkhana, one of India's most prestigious and premier clubs founded in 1875, boasts a rich heritage of sporting history and culture. The Gymkhana, which takes pride in having hosted the first cricket Test match in India in 1933, was also the home of Polo with the sport being hosted by Bombay Gymkhana and competitions being conducted until 1920 at this iconic venue. The Bombay Gymkhana was also one of the venues when India hosted its first Hockey World Cup in 1982. It plays host to a couple of top squash, billiards and snooker and rugby events annually.

IPL 2024: In Rishabh Pant's absence, Axar Patel to lead DC

In the absence of designated skipper Rishabh Pant who is suspended for a match for maintaining a slow-over rate, Delhi Capitals' head coach Ricky Ponting said left-arm spin all-rounder Axar Patel will be leading the side in their important Indian Premier League (IPL) 2024 clash with Royal Challengers Bengaluru at the M. Chinnaswamy Stadium here on Sunday. "Axar Patel will be our captain tomorrow. He's obviously been vice-captain of this franchise now for the last couple of seasons. Obviously, very experienced IPL player, an experienced international player, a very sensible guy, understands the game really well. He's really excited, to be honest," said Ponting in the pre-match press conference on Saturday. Pant will miss DC's



crucial clash against RCB after being handed a one-match suspension for his side's third slow over-rate offence in the tournament, recorded during their 21-run win over Rajasthan Royals at the Arun Jaitley Stadium on May 7. Ahead of the last over of RR's innings, DC were found

ten minutes short on the innings timer, which meant they could field only four fielders outside the 30-yard circle as per the in-game slow over-rate penalty. Apart from the suspension under the IPL Code of Conduct for over-rate offences, Pant was fined INR 30 lakh. "We started talking about it a couple of days ago when there was a possibility that Rishabh might be banned, so he's got his head around it, we've done our bowlers' meetings today. "What I know about him is, you've only got to watch the way he goes about his cricket to understand that he is a sensible guy that's always involved and in tune with the game, so I'm sure he'll lead the team really well tomorrow," added Ponting.

Rifle/Pistol Shooting: Manu, Anish, stay on course for top finish at Olympics Selection Trials

Olympian Manu Bhaker and India's top men's rapid-fire pistol (RFP) shooter Anish Bhanwala stayed on course for a top finish at the first ever Olympic Selection Trials (OST) Rifle/Pistol, shooting solid qualification rounds in their 25m pistol OST T3 matches respectively. Taking aim in Bhopal's MP State Shooting Academy range, Anish topped the men's 25m RFP with a score of 587, while Manu came third in the women's 25m pistol with 585, as both maintained the top rank among the five shooters in each event. The finals will be played on Sunday when there are crucial podium points to be won by the five qualified shooters. In the women's pistol sec-



tion, Rhythm Sangwan, after having two ordinary outings by her standards in Delhi, bounced back with a top score of 586, while Simranpreet Kaur Brar continued an inspired run to pip Manu Bhaker to second on inner 10s with a 585. Esha

Singh (579) was fourth while Abhidnya Ashok Patil (575) was fifth. This means that whatever happens in the finals on Sunday, Manu would go into the fourth trial with at least a four-point cushion over her nearest competitor. The fight for the second spot is currently very tight between Esha, Rhythm and Simranpreet. Anish Bhanwala too is assured of a two-point cushion over his nearest challenger in the men's RFP after his stand-out 587 on Saturday. Here Vijayveer Sidhu and Bhavesh Shekhawat are in a close fight for second with the former edging it currently, with Adarsh and Ankur seemingly looking out of it. The fourth trial, depending on how each of the five in each event perform, could change all those equations, however, given the fine margins involved.

'I have seen miracles happen' says Shubman Gill on GT playoff hopes

Following the Gujarat Titans' 35-run win over the Chennai Super Kings at Narendra Modi Stadium on Friday, captain Shubman Gill stated that "we all believe that we can still make it into the playoffs," with just two games remaining. We lost our last three games and it was important for us to win this one and that is what me and Sam were discussing. Every over we tried to maximise our opportunities against every challenge that was thrown at us," added the 24-year-old. Chennai on the other hand will be looking to make a major comeback in their penultimate game against the Rajasthan Royals who are in the running to finish at the top of the table.

Italian Open: Djokovic makes first round winning return against Moutet

Novak Djokovic made a winning return to Tour after beating French lucky loser Corentin Moutet to reach the third round of the Italian Open. The Serbian, playing in his first match since the Monte-Carlo semifinals last month, overcame a sluggish start to win 6-3, 6-1 in Rome. Following an hour and twenty-six minutes, Djokovic overcame a 1-3 hole in the opening set and effectively countered Moutet's court craft in the second set to win. In their second Lexus ATP head-to-head match, Djokovic hit consistently against Moutet, forcing the Frenchman to take chances with his retrieval abilities. According to ATP Stats, the 98-time tour-level champion broke Moutet's serve six times to advance to an 18-0 lead in the first round of play in Rome. "Match play is different to practise



sets," Djokovic said. "I played a lefty and I have not practised with a lefty in a while, so it took me a little time to adjust to the different rotations of the ball. The first four games were quite bad from me. A bad start. I lost both my services games. "But then I played well. I only lost

one game from 1-3 down. Corentin is a very talented player. He has great hands and is very unpredictable. You don't know what comes up next, so I had to stay focused, which I did and it is a good opening match." The top-ranked player in the PIF ATP Rankings, who last won the ATP Masters 1000 event in 2022, is a six-time Rome champion. With his victory over Moutet taking him to 1099, Djokovic is chasing his first trophy of the season and his 1100th match win in the Italian capital. "You always have doubts," Djokovic said when asked if he had any ahead of his return to Tour. "Every single match. It is just the manner of how you deal with them and how long they stay there. How long they overwhelm your whole being and mind. It is an internal battle always more than an external battle. If you win that battle the external battle becomes a little bit more likely for you to win."

Neeraj Chopra 'not happy' after finishing second in Diamond League

Olympic and World Champion Neeraj Chopra was 'not happy' after finishing second in the javelin throw discipline of his first Diamond League event of the year on Friday. With his back against the wall, the Indian star came up with his best throw in his sixth and final attempt in Doha but missed the top spot by just 0.2 metres. Chopra had a best throw of 88.36 metres, ending behind Jakub Vadlejch of the Czech Republic, who finished first with a best effort of 88.38. "Honestly, I felt I could throw beyond 88m, but that did not happen. I am happy with the fact that I was consistent with my throws, but not with my efforts. My first throw was very bad (foul)," Neeraj said to NNIS. "This is my first competi-



tion, the good thing is that despite my body was not at the peak (I don't know for what reason), I could throw 88m. There are more competitions coming up, I will work hard and prepare for the next competition. I will play three to four competitions before the Paris Olympics," added the athlete. Neeraj, however, remained confident of achieving the elusive 90m throw. "Today I felt I could do it, but somewhere I could not. Maybe God wants me to do it somewhere else. But I am happy with my consistent

performances, and I will throw over 90m," he said. Talking about his burgeoning rivalry with Jakub, who finished behind Neeraj at the Tokyo Olympics and fell to third place at the Eugene World Championships with the Indian snatching away the silver medal, Neeraj said, "It was a good competition with Jakub, I was just behind by 2 cm. It feels good when there is a good contest. We push each other to go for better throws. In the upcoming competitions I will do better." Neeraj Chopra will next participate in the Federation Cup, starting from May 12, which will be his first domestic tournament in three years. Neeraj last competed in the 2021 Federation Cup which was held before the Tokyo Olympics, the javelin thrower made his mark by becoming the first Indian to win an Olympic gold in athletics.

James Anderson to retire following England's first Test against West Indies at Lord's

England's veteran fast-bowler James Anderson has announced he will retire from international cricket after the first Test of their upcoming home summer against West Indies at Lord's, starting on July 10. Anderson, 41, became the third bowler after Shane Warne and Muttiah Muralitharan to reach the landmark of 700 Test wickets - the most by any fast bowler - earlier this year during England's fifth and final match of their India tour at Dharamshala. But reports emerged in various sections of the British media on Friday that Brendon McCullum, England's Test coach, has asked for Anderson, the country's leading wicket-taker in Tests, to retire to build a team for the future, especially with Ashes happening in 2025-26. "Hi everyone. Just a note to say that the first Test of the summer at Lord's will be my last Test. It's been an incredible 20 years representing my country, playing the game I've loved since I was a kid." "I'm going to miss walking out for England so much. But I know the time is right to step aside and let others realise their dreams just like I got to



because there is no greater feeling," said Anderson in his Instagram post on Saturday. Anderson made his Test debut against Zimbabwe in 2003 and has earned 187 caps so far in the format, which is also an England record. He sits in second position on the all-time list of Test appearances behind only the legendary batter Sachin Tendulkar, who played 200 Tests for India. "I couldn't have done it without the love and support of Daniella, Lola, Ruby and my par-

ents. A huge thank you to them. Also, thank you to the players and coaches who have made this the best job in the world." "I'm excited for the new challenges that lie ahead, as well as filling my days with even more golf. Thank you to everyone who has supported me over the years, it's always meant a lot, even if my face often doesn't show it. See you at the Test, Go well, Jimmy," he added. Anderson also played 194 ODIs and 19 T20Is for England but became a Test-match specialist fast-bowler in 2015. Anderson had been in patchy form during last year's Ashes, taking only five wickets from four games, following which he signed a new one-year central contract in October 2023. On this year's Test tour of India, which England lost 4-1, Anderson picked 10 wickets from four matches. It is not clear whether Anderson will continue to play for his county side Lancashire. "I don't think we'll ever see a bowler to match Jimmy again. It has been an honour as an England fan to watch him, and to marvel at his skill with the ball. To still be bowling at the top of his game at 41 is remarkable, and he is a true inspiration and role model for peers and younger generations alike," said Richard Thompson, ECB Chairman.
