I am part of INDIA bloc, but not with Bengal unit of Cong and CPI-M: Mamata Banerjee

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, on Thursday, claimed that although she and her party Trinamool Congress are an integral part of the opposition INDIA bloc, the West Bengal unit of Congress and CPI-M are not included in it.

"Some are misunderstanding and misinterpreting me. The opposition INDIA bloc was formed at the national level. We will remain a part of that alliance at the national level. I took the main initiative in the formation of that opposition bloc. Hence I am part of that national unit. But neither the West Bengal unit of Congress nor the state unit of CPI-M is included in that national bloc. They are with

BJP in West Bengal," the Chief Minister said while addressing an election meeting at Tamluk Lok Sabha constituency in East Midnapore district in the afternoon.

Observers feel that probably the Chief Minister on Monday tried to give a clarification following confusion over two contradictory statements made by her on the opposition INDIA bloc during the last couple of days.

On one hand, she said that the INDIA bloc's tally in the current Lok Sabha will end up at 315 with BJP finishing at 195 and on the other hand she said that if the INDIA bloc is in a position to form the government at the Centre, Trinamool Congress would provide outside support to that government.

Speaking on the occasion, she referred to the results of the Nandigram assembly constituency, one of the seven seats under Tamluk Lok Sabha, in the 2021 West Bengal assembly elections where she lost to the current leader of the opposition Suvendu Adhikari.

"That day, they got elected from Nandigram by disconnecting the power at the counting venue. Everything was changed taking that advantage. I have not forgotten that. I will take revenge someday. BJP will not be in power always. ED and CBI will not be there to protect you forever. The NIA and Income Tax department will also not be with you always. I will take revenge," the Chief Minister said.

COVISHIELD VAX LINKED TO ANOTHER RARE FATAL BLOOD CLOTTING DISORDER

New Delhi: British-Swedish pharma giant AstraZeneca's Covid-19 vaccine, made in collaboration with Oxford University has been found to raise the risk of vaccine-induced immune thrombocytopenia and thrombosis (VITT) -- a rare but fatal blood clotting disorder, claimed researchers on Thursday.

While not new, VITT emerged as a new disease following adenovirus vector-based Oxford-AstraZeneca vaccine -- sold as Covishield in India and Vaxzevria in Europe -- at the height of the Covid pandemic in 2021. "An unusually dangerous blood autoantibody directed against a protein

termed platelet factor 4 (or PF4)" was found as the reason for VITT.

In separate research in 2023, scientists from Canada, North America, Germany and Italy described a virtually identical disorder with the same PF4 antibody that was fatal in some cases after natural adenovirus (common cold) infection.

Now in a new research, Flinders University in Australia and other international experts found that the PF4 antibodies in both adenovirus infection-associated VITT and classic adenoviral vector VITT share identical molecular fingerprints or signatures.

CM Arvind Kejriwal, AAP to be named in supplementary charge sheet: ED to SC

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) will soon file a supplementary charge sheet in a money laundering case linked to the alleged excise policy scam arraying Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) as an accused, Additional Solicitor General (ASG) SV Raju informed the Supreme Court on Thursday.

Opposing the plea filed by Kejriwal against arrest, ASG Raju apprised a bench of Justices Sanjiv Khanna and Dipankar Datta that a prosecution complaint against AAP and its national convenor is in the pipeline and will be soon lodged before the special court.



Earlier, the probe agency, opposing the bail plea of former Deputy Chief Minister of Delhi Manish Sisodia filed before the Delhi High Court, said that it will soon file a supplementary charge sheet against the ruling party in the national capital.

In an order passed last week, the apex court ordered CM Kejriwal to be released on interim bail in the excise policy case till June 1 and directed him to surrender on June 2.

It prohibited CM Kejriwal from signing official files unless it is required and necessary for obtaining clearance/approval of the Lt Governor of Delhi. Also, while out on interim bail, he will not visit the CM office or the Delhi Secretariat.

ED can't arrest accused after special court has taken cognizance of money laundering complaint, rules SC

The Supreme Court on Thursday held that the Enforcement Directorate (ED) cannot arrest an accused on money laundering charges after cognizance has been taken by the special court on the probe agency's complaint.

A bench headed by Justice Abhay S. Oka ruled that in case, the custody of such an accused is needed for further investigation, the ED would have to approach the special court.

"After hearing the accused, the Special Court must pass an order on the application after recording brief reasons. While hearing the application, the court may permit custody only if it is satisfied that custodial interrogation is required," said the Bench, also comprising Justice Ujjal Bhuyan.

However, a person not arrayed as an accused in the complaint may be arrested by the ED fulfilling the mandate of Section 19 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), 2002, the apex court said.

Further, it added that a person not arrested during the money laundering probe but appearing before the special court pursuant to the summons issued under PMLA need not satisfy stringent twin conditions for grant of bail.

Under Section 45 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), twin tests



must be met to obtain bail.

First, the court should be convinced that there are reasonable grounds for believing that the accused is not guilty of such an offence. Second, the court should be convinced that the accused seeking bail is not likely to commit any offence while on bail.

In November 2017, a division bench of Justices Rohinton Nariman and S.K. Kaul struck down Section 45(1) of the PMLA for imposing two additional conditions to grant bail to the money laundering accused calling them arbitrary.

However, this decision was overruled by the July 2022 judgement by a bench comprising Justice A.M. Khanwilkar, Dinesh Maheshwari, and C.T. Ravikumar in the Vijay Madanlal Choudhary case. The three-judge bench upheld the 2019 amendments made to the PMLA, 2002 making it nearly impossible for the accused to secure bail and shifting the burden of proof of innocence onto the accused rather than the ED. Subsequently, a bench headed by then CJI N.V. Ramana agreed to review the PMLA judgment for two main concerns -- non-providing of ECIR to the accused at the time of arrest and negation of presumption of innocence.

In November last year, days before Justice S.K. Kaul was due to retire, a special bench headed by him ordered the pleas challenging the powers of ED to be placed before the Chief Justice of India (CJI) for the constitution of a new bench.



'IF YOU VOTE FOR AAP, I MAY NOT GO BACK TO JAIL': KEJRIWAL

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) on Thursday brought to the notice of the Supreme Court statements made by Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal appealing to people to vote for Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) if they wished he (Kejriwal) did not return to jail.

Solicitor General (SG) Tushar Mehta, the second highest law officer of the Centre, representing the ED, told a bench presided over by Justice Sanjiv Khanna, that such statements are a direct "slap on the system" and he would like to place CM Kejriwal's videos for the perusal of the apex court.

SG Mehta referred to CM Kejriwal's speech, where the AAP supremo had said that he would not have to go to jail if people voted for the "broom" symbol.

The law officer said, "This is a slap on the system. He (Kejriwal) says, 'If you vote for me, I will not have to go to jail on June 2'. How can that happen?"



"Our order is very clear. We have fixed the timeline, i.e., the dates of release and surrender. We are not making any exception to anybody,"

clarified the Bench, also comprising Justice Dipankar Datta.

"He ought not to have said this. This is slapping on the face of the institution and I take an exception to that. I leave it to that end," SG Mehta said.

In response, senior advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi, representing CM Kejriwal, said that the AAP leader was alleging mala fide against the government and many senior ministers of the Centre made various kinds of statements against his client.

The apex court called the parties to "confine" themselves to the legal questions and proceeded to hear the matter. In an order passed last week, the apex court ordered CM Kejriwal to be released on interim bail in the excise policy case till June 1 and directed him to surrender on June 2.

Mumbai hoarding crash: Billboard owner Bhavesh Bhide nabbed from Udaipur

In a big breakthrough, a Mumbai Police team has tracked and arrested Bhavesh Bhide -- the owner of the hoarding that crashed in Ghatkopar on May 13 -- from his hideout in Rajasthan's Udaipur, sources said here on Thursday.

Bhide, a director at EGO Media Co., was on the run ever since the gigantic billboard crashed on Monday, claiming 16 lives and injuring 88 others.

Soon after the tragedy, the Mumbai Police had lodged a case against Bhide invoking the stringent charge of culpable homicide not amounting to murder.

An official source said the Bhandup police had formed multiple teams to track down Bhide, who was constantly on the move and changing locations, making it difficult for the police to pin him down. Finally, a Crime Branch team pursuing him managed to zero in on Bhide in Udaipur. He is



being brought to Mumbai.

Besides the hoarding crash case, Bhide - who claims to be politically connected - is facing several other cases at different police stations in the city.

Bhide is likely to be produced before a Mumbai court on Friday.

Besides the human casualties, the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) said on Thursday that so far, the civic teams have recovered mangled remains of 71 vehicles, including two trucks, 31 four-wheelers, 8 autorickshaws, and 30 two-wheelers.

Swati Maliwal's statement recorded in alleged assault case: Police sources

The Special Cell of Delhi Police on Thursday recorded the statement of AAP Rajya Sabha MP Swati Maliwal, days after she was allegedly assaulted at Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's official residence, sources said.

Additional Commissioner of Police (Special Cell), Pramod Kumar Kushwaha, along with other officers reached Maliwal's house on Thursday afternoon and spent around four-and-a-half hours there, police sources said. "Yes, the MP's statement has been recorded," said a police source.

On Monday, DCP (North) Manoj Kumar Meena said that a PCR call was received at 9:34 a.m. at the Civil Lines police station, wherein the caller claimed that she was assaulted at CM Kejriwal's official residence.

The PCR call record said "the woman is saying that she is at the CM's house and has been assaulted by CM's PS Bibhav Kumar".

DCP Meena, however, said that no formal complaint was lodged by Maliwal in this



regard. Meanwhile, the National Commission for Women (NCW) has taken suo motu cognisance of the matter and issued summons to CM Kejriwal's Personal Secretary (PS) Bibhav Kumar, asking him to appear before the Commission on Friday.

CONGRESS, SP NEGLECTED REFUGEES OVER VOTE BANK POLITICS: PM MODI

Prime Minister Narendra Modi while addressing an election rally in Uttar Pradesh's Azamgarh on Thursday, launched a scathing attack on the Congress, SP and other INDIA bloc parties and accused them of portraying themselves as secular and neglecting refugees over vote bank politics.

PM Modi also took a jibe at the Congress on the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) and said that the grand old party persecuted refugees for decades and never paid heed to their needs.

Mounting the attack, PM Modi said the Congress wants to snatch the rights of tribals and give them to its vote bank. "They also want to allot the country's 15 per cent budget to the minorities," PM Modi said. He accused the Congress of neglecting refugees and said, "Taking Mahatma Gandhi's name, these people scaled the ladder of power but do not follow his ideology."

"For the unity of the country and to live by the principles of Babasaheb Ambedkar, we need to be cautious of those people who indulge in Hindu-Muslim politics. We have to be united to make India proud and successful," he said. PM Modi also accused the leaders of the INDIA bloc of being



neck-deep in corruption.

Taking a swipe at the SP and the Congress, he said that the "Congress" 'shehzada' (prince) is running a mission and attacking our 'aastha' (faith). The SP's 'shehzada' 'honoured terrorists. The SP and Congress are two parties but dukaan ek hi hai."

He said that the enthusiasm of the people of Uttar Pradesh's Lalgarh clearly indicates that their blessings were with the BJP and the NDA.

"Two days ago, I was in Banaras, the way residents of Kashi celebrated the festival of democracy! From Kashmir to Kanyakumari and Attock to Cuttack, there is one voice 'Phir ek baar Modi

sarkaar', newspapers across the world are full of the democratic exercise of the country," he claimed. "The world is seeing that people's blessings are with the BJP and NDA. Wherever we go only one slogan is being heard, 'Phir ek baar Modi sarkaar'," he said. "The people have reposed so much faith. The world is surprised by the people having faith on 'Modi's guarantee'. One example of 'Modi ki guarantee' is the CAA," he said.

"I am saying it clearly, it's 'Modi's guarantee'. I dare you...you can't end CAA. It is 'Modi ki guarantee' that you will not be able to remove CAA," he said referring to the Opposition who has promised to remove the legislation if it is voted to power at the Centre. On Wednesday, refugees living in India for long were given Indian citizenship certificates.

PM Modi emphasised that individuals who received citizenship certificates under CAA were victims of the country's Partition based on religion.

He said that now the refugees granted Indian citizenship would be called "children of Bharat Mata." He also said that after 40 years, Srinagar registered a record turnout in the Lok Sabha polls.

"Earlier, people were afraid of stone pelting and terror attacks, but Modi had promised peace and scrapping of Article 370, which was delivered," he said.

MONSOON LIKELY TO ARRIVE IN KERALA BY MAY 31: IMD

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has announced that this year, the southwest monsoon is likely to set in over Kerala on May 31, with a model error of ± 4 days.

Southwest monsoon normally sets in over Kerala on June 1, with a standard deviation of about seven days. IMD has been issuing operational forecasts for the date of monsoon onset over Kerala from 2005 onwards. An indigenously developed state-of-the-art statistical model with a model error of ± 4 days is used for the purpose, according to an IMD statement.

Last year, the monsoon arrived in Kerala on June 8. The IMD had forecast the arrival on June 4 with a margin of ± 4 days.

In its latest bulletin, the IMD has forecast heatwave conditions over Northwest India from May 16 and in the eastern region from May 18. Concurrently, heavy rainfall, accompanied by thunderstorms, lightning



and gusty winds, is anticipated over the southern states until May 20.

IMD has forecast above average monsoon rainfall in 2024, which augurs well for the country's agricultural sector which was hit by erratic weather last year.

The monsoon, which normally

arrives in Kerala around June 1 and retreats in mid-September, is expected to total 106 per cent of the long-term average this year.

The monsoon plays a key role in the Indian economy as over 50 per cent of the country's farmland does not have any other source of irriga-

tion. The monsoon rains are also crucial for recharging the country's reservoirs and aquifers from which the water can be used later in the year to irrigate crops.

India has emerged as a key exporter of foodgrains but had to resort to curbing overseas shipments of sugar, rice, wheat and onions in order to increase domestic supplies and keep prices in check due to the erratic monsoon last year which hit farm production. A robust growth in the farm sector helps to keep inflation in check. IMD defines average or normal rainfall as between 96 per cent and 104 per cent of a 50-year average of 87 cm (35 inches) for the June-Sept season. Apart from supplying food, the farm sector also plays a key role in providing a demand for industrial goods such as two-wheelers, fridges and fast moving consumer goods. An increase in agricultural production and incomes, therefore, apart from contributing directly to GDP growth also leads to an increase in industrial growth.

Delhi HC issues notice to CBI on K. Kavitha's bail plea

The Delhi High Court on Thursday issued a notice to the CBI on bail plea of Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) leader K. Kavitha, an accused in the alleged excise policy scam.

A bench of Justice Swarana Kanta Sharma also called for CBI's reply on writ petition filed by Kavitha, daughter of BRS President and former Telangana Chief Minister K. Chandrasekhara Rao (KCR), challenging her arrest by the CBI and the subsequent remand in the corruption case. The matter will be taken up for further hearing on May 24 along with her bail plea in the money laundering case.

Kavitha moved the high court after a special court here on May 6 turned down her regular bail pleas in cases being probed by both - the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and the Enforcement Directorate (ED). Last week, the ED filed its seventh chargesheet before a Delhi court in connection with the money laundering case related to the alleged excise policy scam, naming Kavitha and others as accused.



Kavitha was first arrested by the ED and later by the CBI on April 11 when she was in Tihar Jail.

Kharge, Thackeray, Pawar & Kejriwal to address INDIA bloc rally in Mumbai on May 17

As the Lok Sabha elections' fifth phase campaign enters the crescendo stage, top leaders of the national opposition alliance INDIA bloc and Maha Vikas Aghadi will address a mammoth rally here on Friday.

Among the top leaders who will attend and address the public meeting at Bandra Kurla Complex grounds include Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge, Nationalist Congress Party (SP) President Sharad Pawar, Shiv Sena (UBT) President and ex-CM Uddhav Thackeray.

Besides, there will be Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and representatives of other constituents of the INDIA-MVA alliance.

In addition, other senior MVA leaders like Nana Patole, Sanjay Raut and Jayant Patil are expected to speak at the rally, coming just three days ahead of the fifth



phase of Lok Sabha polls on May 20, covering 13 constituencies, including the crucial Mumbai Metropolitan Region. An MVA leader claimed that Friday's rally would be the biggest combined opposition show of strength in the state since the poll campaign started and people are expected to participate from all over the state. This is the second INDIA-MVA multi-party rally coming two months after a

similar show of strength held in Mumbai on March 17, marking the end of Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra.

In the last two months after the Lok Sabha elections were announced on March 16, INDIA-MVA top leaders have addressed several rallies, public meetings across Maharashtra in the 48 Parliamentary constituencies -- the second highest in the country.

Sex scandal: Party, Deve Gowda family has no idea about Prajwal Revanna's whereabouts: JD(S)

Reeling under the impact of the sex scandal involving Prajwal Revanna who is a JD(S) MP and grandson of former Prime Minister HD Deve Gowda, the party stated on Thursday that it does not have any idea about the whereabouts of the prime accused in the case.

Prajwal Revanna, who is the NDA's Lok Sabha candidate for the Hassan seat is absconding as the videos showing him sexually assaulting women have taken Karnataka by storm.

Speaking to reporters in Mysuru, JD(S) Core Committee President and MLA, GT Devegowda claimed that neither party leaders nor the HD Deve Gowda family have any idea about Prajwal Revanna's whereabouts.

The government has issued a Blue Corner notice to 196 countries regarding Prajwal Revanna, and he can only be tracked through this. "Prajwal Revanna has not been in touch with the leaders since the scandal came to light. No one knows where Prajwal Revanna is," Devegowda stated.

The Special Investigation Team (SIT) probing the scandal is carrying out the probe and Chief Minister Siddaramaiah asserted that he believes in the officers.

"The crimes related to the scandal were committed in Chennai city and Malaysia, and in this



backdrop, we are demanding an investigation by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI)," Devegowda stated.

Meanwhile, Prajwal Revanna, who had booked a ticket to Bengaluru from Munich in

Germany, did not board the flight on Wednesday.

Sources stated that this is the third time Prajwal Revanna did not board a flight after booking tickets from Germany. Prajwal Revanna's father, JD(S) MLA HD Revanna, who was jailed and released on conditional bail, has not gone back to his native Holenarasipur town in Hassan District to meet his wife Bhavani since his release.

In turn, Bhavani has also not come to meet him in Bengaluru where he is staying at his father HD Deve Gowda's residence in Padmanabhanagar. He has been visiting temples since his release.

Family sources explained that Deve Gowda and former CM HD Kumaraswamy are upset with her in the backdrop of the events related to her son Prajwal Revanna.

Meanwhile, the SIT has issued a second notice to Bhavani to appear for questioning in the kidnap case of a victim seen in one of the videos.

The SIT has registered cases under IPC Sections 376 (2) N (committing rape repeatedly on same woman), 506 (criminal intimidation), 354 (A) (1) (behaving in unwelcome way, explicit sexual behaviour, demanding sexual favours), 354 (B) (using criminal force on woman) and 354 (C) (voyeurism, capturing image of a woman in a private act without her consent) and Under Sections of the Information Technology Act.



BUZZ OF BY-ELECTIONS IN MADHYA PRADESH

Voting for the Lok Sabha has been held in four phases in Madhya Pradesh and the results are yet to come, but the murmur regarding the assembly by-elections has increased. There is a reason for this - three Congress MLAs have joined BJP, while five MLAs are contesting the Lok Sabha elections.

By-elections are scheduled to be held in three to eight assembly constituencies in the state in the coming time. This is possible because three Congress MLAs, Kamlesh Shah from Amarwada in Chhindwara, Nirmala Sapre from Bina assembly constituency in Sagar district and Ramniwas Rawat from Vijaypur assembly seat in Sheopur district have joined BJP. In this way, by-elections are certain to be held on these three seats in the coming time.

Apart from this, BJP and Congress have made



five MLAs candidates for Lok Sabha.

There are 29 Lok Sabha seats in the state, where voting has been held in four phases and the election results will be declared on June 4. Present MLAs are contesting elections at five places. BJP has made Budhni MLA and former Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chauhan its candidate from Vidisha. Congress has fielded MLA from Satna Siddharth

Kushwaha from Satna parliamentary constituency, MLA from Dindori Omkar Singh Markam from Mandla parliamentary constituency, MLA from Pushprajgarh Phundelal Marco from Shahdol and MLA from Tarana Mahesh Parmar from Ujjain parliamentary constituency.

In this way, by-elections are certain in the state due to the change of party by three MLAs, while there is a possibility of by-elections at other places also depending on the victory and defeat of the five MLAs who are contesting the Lok Sabha elections. This possibility has already activated many contenders to become candidates in the by-elections.

A round of discussions have started within BJP and Congress regarding the assembly by-elections. There is a possibility that BJP will field only MLAs from Congress from those three places, while Congress can bet on new faces. Apart from this, after the results of Lok Sabha elections, both the parties will start searching for a fresh candidate.

22 out of 35 Congress MLAs who defected in Madhya Pradesh are in anonymity: Jitu Patwari

panion. I have full sympathy towards such supportive faces. I also wish that God helps them if they consider politics as a means of public service."

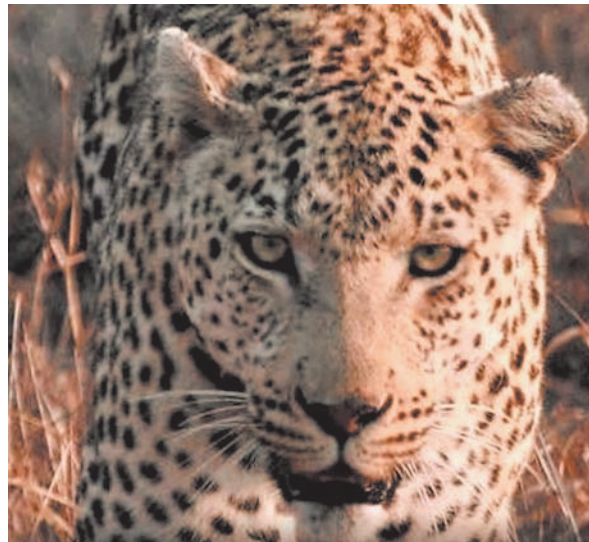
Leopard attacks villager who went to pluck tendu leaves in Dewas

The summer season has brought with itself a surge in travel, for which train is the most preferred mode of transport for the vast majority of people. While the scorching summer is pushing people out of their homes to cooler places for vacations, the Lok Sabha elections, being held across the country in seven phases, have further compounded the number of travellers across state borders as they exercise their right to vote. While the Indian railways have been an integral part of nation-building and the lives of its citizens, they also have had a major influence on Hindi cinema serving as an important plot point in many stories on the celluloid. Here are some Bollywood films where the trains played a pivotal role in the narrative. 'Saathiya', which was released in 2002, had the Mumbai local as an important catalyst to the love story between its lead pair. Vivek Oberoi, who made a sensational debut with 'Company' in the role of a gangster, underwent a 180-degree shift for his role of a lover in the film, which was a Hindi adaptation of 'Alai Payuthey' directed by Mani Ratnam. 'Jab We Met' is considered to be a defining film in Kareena Kapoor Khan's filmography, the one that established her as a leading female force in Hindi cinema. The story of 'Jab We Met' can't be separated from the train on which she finds Aditya Kashyap (Shahid Kapoor) without a purpose, only to later change his life for the good. Who could forget the fascination of Geet (Kareena) for the side berth? The two miss out



on the train twice and embark on a journey where they get to know more about each other. 'Baton Baton Mein', directed by Basu Chatterjee tells the story of an honest and hard-working middle class as they make their way around the Bombay of the 1970s. The director set a major part of the film in the 9:10 local that his protagonists commuted in. As legendary 'Dilwale Dulhania Le Jayenge' is

in itself, it has also given the famed scene to Hindi cinema where Raj is aboard the train, calling Simran for one last time as her father tightly holds her hand. It was at that moment when Chaudhary Baldev Singh (played by Amrish Puri) underwent a change of heart. As he understands Raj's eternal love for Simran, he lets her go with the dialogue, "Jaa Simran jaa, jee le apni zindagi."

The list would be incomplete without the mention of 'The Burning Train'. The multi-starrer film tells the story of passengers aboard a special train Super Express which suffers a sabotage. The film has quite a few elements similar to the James Cameron directorial 'Titanic' mainly in terms of the luxury and the novelty that both the modes of transport promised and a tragedy that leaves the passengers scrambling inside a limited physical space. The film was one of the most expensive films of its time given its production value. The song 'Chaiya Chaiya' deserves a special mention in this list. Although the plot of 'Dil Se.' has no relevance to the trains, it's the song that has over the years gained a cult status and why not? After all, it features some of the finest talents in our cinema including Shah Rukh Khan, Malaika Arora, Mani Ratnam, Sukhwinder, A. R. Rahman, Gulzar, Farah Khan and Santosh Sivan. The iconic song was shot on the Nilgiri Mountain Railway Line. The narrow gauge railway and the geography of Ooty posed a serious logistical challenge to the crew but, eventually they came out shining at the other end given how the song and its visuals have aged in 26 years since its release.

BJP faces tough challenge to retain supremacy amid triangular contest in Bhiwandi

BJP nominee and Union Minister Kapil Patil, NCP(SP) candidate Suresh Mhatre and an Independent, Nilesh Sambre are locked in a triangular contest in Bhiwandi constituency which is famous for its powerloom industry and logistic activities in Thane District. Patil, who hopes to score a hat-trick, faces a tough challenge from Mhatre, who is a seasoned politician and Sambre who runs a well-known Jijau Sanghatana. While Patil and Mhatre come from the Aagri community, Sambre hails from the Kunbi community. Incidentally, Aagris and Kunbis along with the sizable Muslim community will be the deciding factor in this constituency. In addition, the three candidates cannot neglect the tribal community which is struggling to stay afloat due to the rising threat of encroachment on their lands. Patil hopes to weather anti-incumbency especially in the wake of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's rally at Kalyan on Wednesday and also because of praises showered upon him by his boss. Even though Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis intervened to bring together the warring Patil and party Legislator from Murbad, Kisan Kathore, the BJP is struggling to put up a show of unity which is crucial to send an "all is well" signal to the voters. However, Patil hopes to ride on PM Modi's guarantee and the support from cadres of the BJP, NCP, Shiv Sena, RPI and MNS. Patil is confident of getting overwhelming support from the Muslim community due to his outreach and a number of works carried out for their development during his two terms. On the other hand, Mhatre with his network of logistics and



storehouses is optimistic about encashing on the anti-incumbency factor against Patil due to the simmering discontent among the youth due to burgeoning unemployment, price rise and also among the Aagri and farming communities due to constraints on carrying out their traditional activities due to rapid urbanisation. Mhatre heaved a sigh of relief after the former Congress MP Suresh Mhatre opted out of the fray. Suresh Mhatre had staked his claim but Congress ultimately withdrew from the contest, adhering to the alliance dharna. Further, Mhatre expects that there won't be a division of Muslim votes despite the MIM's candidate in the fray. He hopes that Muslims will largely support him because of the Samajwadi Party's association and also due to their strong opposition to the BJP fearing change in the Constitution if it comes to power for the third time. On his part, Sambre expects victory due

to the division of votes and on the dint of his social work. Apart from that, the Prakash Ambedkar-led Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi's support is another positive for Sambre. There are 27 candidates in the fray with a total number of 20,87,244 voters. As many as 37 per cent belong to the Kunbi community, 21 per cent are Muslim, 15 per cent Aagri and 27 per cent Dalits and others. Of the six Assembly segments, the BJP represents Bhiwandi West and Murbad while Bhiwandi Rural and Kalyan West are held by Shiv Sena, Bhiwandi East by Samajwadi Party and Shahapur by NCP. The power distribution done by a franchise appointed by the state-run Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company and the issues with regard to supply has been a major issue raised by voters. They are making a strong pitch for cheaper power tariffs. The powerloom industry, once a flourishing sector, faces a survival threat after demonetisation and implementation of the GST regime amid volatile economic conditions. The industry expects time-bound solutions in the form of tax benefits.

The voters are insisting that connecting Bhiwandi with Thane and Kalyan through the Metro rail corridor will partially ease the traffic congestions in the area. Moreover, the increasing traffic jams in Bhiwandi and Kalyan, rising water scarcity and inefficient health system are some of the other important issues faced by the citizens from the constituency.

European Commission investigates Meta over child protection concerns

The European Commission announced on Thursday that it has opened investigations into Meta over child protection concerns regarding its Facebook and Instagram platforms.

The investigations concern fears the two platforms "may exploit the weaknesses and inexperience of minors and cause addictive behaviour," according to a commission press release. Another concern is "rabbit hole" effects that "draw you into more and more disturbing content," a commission official said. The EU executive is also concerned about minors' access to inappropriate content, as well as privacy.

The two probes into Facebook and Instagram, respectively, fall under the European Union's Digital Services Act (DSA), a broad online content law that requires large platforms to assess and mitigate various risks arising from the use of their services, especially for children.

"We are not convinced that Meta has done enough to comply with the DSA obligations -



to mitigate the risks of negative effects to the physical and mental health of young Europeans on its platforms Facebook and Instagram," said EU industry commissioner Thierry Breton on X. A commission official explained that a "rabbit hole effect" is created when a platform's algorithms "feed users with content of a certain type - for example leading to depression, or unrealistic body images - that can foster mental health issues in children."

Meta may also be failing to use age verification tools that are "reasonable, proportionate and effective" to prevent minors from accessing content that is inappropriate for children, the commission's press

release said.

The commission will also investigate whether the company is falling short of "DSA obligations to put in place appropriate and proportionate measures to ensure a high level of privacy, safety and security for minors."

The EU executive will pay particular attention to the responsibility of the EU's 27 member states, whereas the European Commission is the DSA enforcer for the large platforms.

Very Large Online Platforms (VLOPs) have to pay a yearly "supervisory fee" to cover the commission's costs, capped at 0.05 per cent of each VLOP's global annual revenue.

The company is already subject to DSA investigations over its handling of political advertising, ahead of the forthcoming European Parliament elections on June 6-9.

The commission is also investigating TikTok over similar child protection concerns.

Other DSA provisions - such as obligations to have mechanisms allowing users to flag illegal content - also apply to smaller platforms.

But heaviest fines are only applicable to very large platforms. Monitoring smaller platforms' DSA compliance is the responsibility of the EU's 27 member states, whereas the European Commission is the DSA enforcer for the large platforms.

Slovakian President convenes cross-party meeting after attack on PM Fico

Following the assassination attempt on Slovak Prime Minister Robert Fico, outgoing President Zuzana Caputova and her successor Peter Pellegrini have invited all political parties for consultations. "Let's get out of the vicious circle of hatred and mutual accusations," Caputova appealed to the public in a televised speech in Bratislava on Thursday. She said the attack on Fico had been an individual act. "But the tense atmosphere of hatred was our collective work." During the speech, Caputova and Pellegrini made a joint appearance. "We want to send a signal of understanding in this tense situation," said Caputova, from the liberal Progressive Slovakia party. Both politicians once again condemned the attack on Fico. Pellegrini, who joined Fico's coalition, called on the political parties to suspend or at least limit their election campaigns ahead of the European elec-



tions in June until the situation has calmed down. After their speech, both left to attend a special meeting of the Security Council at the government office. Pellegrini and Caputova met frequently for talks after Fico's third term as prime minister in the years after 2018 - both during Pellegrini's time in government from 2018 to 2020 as Fico's successor and during his years in opposition.

It was only when Pellegrini joined Fico's coalition that their personal relationship cooled.

Five Israeli soldiers killed in Gaza by errant Israeli tank shelling

Five Israeli soldiers were killed and seven others injured, three of them seriously, by errant Israeli tank fire in the Jabalia refugee camp in the northern Gaza Strip, the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) said in a statement on Thursday.

The casualties were with a force that entered Gaza City and seized buildings as part of a resumed attack on the refugee camp, Xinhua news agency reported.

Two IDF tanks, positioned several dozen meters away, apparently spotted a gun in a window of one of the buildings and fired two shells towards the target.

The army said it was investigating why the soldiers were misidentified as Palestinian militants.

A total of 626 soldiers have been killed in Hamas' Oct. 7 attack and Israel's ensuing attacks on Gaza, according to the IDF tally.

Indonesia's Ile Lewotolok Volcano erupts, forcing flight to cancel landing

Ile Lewotolok Volcano in Indonesia's East Nusa Tenggara erupted on Thursday, causing a flight to cancel its landing at Wunopito Airport. A plane of Wings Air on the Kupang-Wunopito Lembata route with 40 passengers was supposed to land at Wunopito Airport at 11 a.m. local time, but the pilot decided to return to the departure airport, Xinhua news agency reported. "The pilot saw indications of volcanic ash near the landing strip, so he took the plane back to Kupang, for security reasons," said head of Wunopito Airport Muhammad Syaiful Zuhri.



Wunopito Airport due to volcanic ash, added Zuhri. Previously, the same incidents occurred on May 7 and May 14.

The mountain released one earthquake eruption and 102 earthquake gusts since 06.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m. local time, according to the Ile Lewotolok Volcano Monitoring Post.

Several wounded in Switzerland knife attack

Several passers-by were injured in an indiscriminate knife attack in the northern Swiss town of Zofingen, according to the local police.

Police said on social media on Wednesday evening that the perpetrator had been apprehended by special forces after hiding in a building for two hours.

The victims had been transported to the hospital with stab wounds, Xinhua news agency quoted police as saying.

A large-scale police operation continued in the evening. The authorities advised people to avoid areas near the local



train station. It was still unclear if there was more than one attacker, police said.

Hezbollah fires dozens of rockets at Israel

Dozens of rockets were fired by Lebanese armed group Hezbollah at northern Israel on Thursday in retaliation for overnight Israeli airstrikes in eastern Lebanon, Israeli and Lebanese sources said.

The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) said in a statement that about 45 launches were identified crossing from Lebanon toward the annexed Golan Heights and the community of Zarit in the Galilee, triggering sirens in the country's north, Xinhua news agency reported.

"Several of the launches were successfully intercepted by the IDF Aerial Defense Array," the military said, adding that no injuries have been reported.

Later, the IDF carried out strikes in southern Lebanon, saying it targeted the sources of fire.

Hezbollah said in a statement that its fighters launched "more than 60 Katyusha rockets," targeting several Israeli military posts in the Golan Heights. The group said



that the strikes were a response to Israeli attacks overnight between Wednesday and Thursday in the Baalbek area in eastern Lebanon. Tensions along the Lebanon-Israel border escalated on October 8, 2023,

following a barrage of rockets launched by Hezbollah toward Israel in solidarity with Hamas' attack on Israel the day before. Israel then retaliated by firing heavy artillery toward southeastern Lebanon.



Govt provides ration to population greater than US-EU together, says Ashwini Vaishnaw

Union Minister for Railways, Communications and IT Ashwini Vaishnaw, on Thursday, said that the Modi government's thrust on inclusive growth is yielding results and it will gain greater visibility in the next few years. He added that this has been possible because of a robust growth framework in place.

He underlined the Modi government's resolve to bring "generational change" in people's lives and also explained how the country is breaking barriers in public welfare schemes.

Citing example of the Centre's free ration scheme to the poor and marginalised, he said that the Modi government is feeding a population larger than the combined populace of United States and the European Union (EU).

"US population is about 35 crore while EU accounts for about 40 crore. India is providing free ration to a population of 80 crore, which is bigger than both, for past four years," informed the Union Minister, highlighting the scale and size of India's public welfare scheme.

Addressing the Viksit Bharat Ambassador event in Mumbai, the Union Minister said that the gov-



ernment's thrust on infrastructure investment, manufacturing, simplification of laws and inclusive growth have served as four pillars of growth.

Vaishnaw said that the Central government has earmarked adequate funds for building physical infrastructure and shoring up the digital economy.

"In previous regimes, Railways allotted Rs 1,140 crore for Maharashtra-specific growth. Under NDA, it has increased 10-fold to Rs 15,000 crore. In past ten years, 1,800 crore rail network has been built in Maharashtra alone" he said.

He further said that a 15 km railway network per day and 23 km road network per day are being built

under the NDA government.

"In terms of digital infrastructure, Maharashtra had 35,000 telecom towers 10 years ago, which has now grown to 2,75,000," he pointed out.

He further said that the government is committed to building social infrastructure as well and has built new universities and medical colleges, and developed new centres of higher education over the past decade.

"Earlier there were seven AIIMS, today they are 18. Out of the previous seven, six AIIMS were built during Atal Bihari Vajpayee's government. In the past ten years, 390 universities and 315 medical colleges have been built," the Union Minister told the Viksit Bharat Ambassadors.

Emphasising that inclusive growth is essential for the harmonious growth of a nation, he said that 'Antodaya' is one of greatest ideas towards bringing change in the lives of the poor and marginalised, and this has been one of the party's foremost pledge since the days of Jana Sangh.

He also listed some milestone achievements of the Modi government including 10 crore free LPG connections, four crore pucca houses for the poor, and explained how they have brought multi-dimensional change in people's lives.

Helped Narendra Modi a lot when he was CM, took him to Israel: Sharad Pawar

Day after Prime Minister Narendra Modi slammed Sharad Pawar over farmers' plight, the Nationalist Congress Party (SP) chief said on Thursday that when he was the Union Minister (2004-2014), he had helped the then Gujarat Chief Minister -- now the Prime Minister -- a lot for the agricultural crisis in his state.

Sharad Pawar was the Union Agriculture Minister from 2004 to 2014.

He said that on one occasion, the then Gujarat CM once called him and said he wanted to visit Israel to study the unique farming techniques there.

"He used to come to me with the problems of the agriculture sector and even took me to Gujarat. Once he



wanted to visit Israel so I took him there also. Whatever Modi says now I am not concerned," said Pawar.

Years later, Modi became the first Indian PM since Independence to visit Israel in July 2017.

The NCP (SP) supremo's retort came a day after PM Modi again attacked Sharad Pawar -- without taking his name -- accusing him of

doing nothing for the cause of farmers when he was the Union Agriculture Minister.

Even on earlier occasions during the ongoing Lok Sabha campaign, PM Modi has slammed Pawar for having abandoned the peasantry, and not doing anything for their welfare, while contending that the farmers benefited hugely during the last 10 years of the Bharatiya Janata Party government.

PoK is India and it will come back to India: EAM Jaishankar

External Affairs Minister (EAM) S. Jaishankar on Thursday said that Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) is an inseparable part of the country that will eventually come back to India.

Reacting to the growing unrest and continued violence that is taking place in PoK, he said that there is no doubt that people in PoK have been watching and getting affected with the massive development that has been taking place in Jammu and Kashmir over the last few years.

"People in PoK are seeing the positive changes across the Line of Control and they are asking themselves that if things are like that, then why are we suffering and why are we accepting this kind of mistreatment? So, they are undoubtedly getting affected by all this. We would



love to see where this goes," said EAM Jaishankar while speaking at 'Vishwabandhu Bharat' interaction in Nashik, Maharashtra.

Complete chaos prevails in PoK's Muzaffarabad which has been rocked by violent protests as the locals, fed up with the rising inflation and high electricity bills, continue to clash with police over the past many days.

"PoK is a different category because eventually PoK is India and it will come back to India, I don't think we should

ever have any doubt about it. Pakistan has a lot of other problems, including in Balochistan and various other parts as well," commented the EAM.

Pakistan's economic woes too continue to dampen its credibility amid fears of a complete meltdown, he said.

"They also have severe economic problems right now. Whether they do the right reforms, and whether they take the right policies... Because, this policy of continuously going against India, today has brought Pakistan down to where it is. We have to see whether there is any change in thinking there," stated Jaishankar.

Earlier this week, while addressing a campaign rally in Palghar, Union Home Minister Amit Shah also made it clear that "PoK was, is, and will continue to be an integral part of India" and no power can challenge this position.

Chaos At Mumbai Metro Station Amid Restrictions For PM Modi's Roadshow

Prime Minister Narendra Modi's grand roadshow in Mumbai on Wednesday evening drew huge crowds. However, as thousands thronged the streets to catch a glimpse of the Prime Minister, chaos ensued at the Ghatkopar metro station, with stampede-like situations caught on cameras.

Ahead of PM Modi's roadshow, authorities took precautionary measures by suspending train services between Jagruti Nagar and Ghatkopar stations. This move, intended for security reasons, inadvertently disrupted the commute of countless office-goers, with services only resuming nearly two hours later, at 7:46 pm.

Social media platforms buzzed with videos shared by dismayed commuters showing the overwhelming crowd at the Ghatkopar metro station. Among the voices of concern was Shiv Sena (UBT)



leader Priyanka Chaturvedi as the Mumbai Metro, a lifeline for over three lakh daily commuters, bore the brunt of the security measures implemented for the Prime Minister's visit.

"PM Modi in Mumbai for campaigning, public services go for a toss for security reasons and has led to creating massive chaos," Chaturvedi wrote on social

media.

The chaos extended beyond the metro station, with blockades impeding the movement of locals returning from work. Partial suspension of services between key stations disrupted the routines of citizens.

PM Modi's roadshow was held ahead of the May 20 polling for six Lok Sabha constituencies in Mumbai and seven others across Maharashtra. The event, stretching from Ashok Silk Mills in Ghatkopar (West) to Parshawanath Chowk in Ghatkopar (East), saw thousands of people waving BJP flags and chanting slogans for the Prime Minister.

Earlier on the same day, PM Modi delivered speeches at two campaign rallies within Maharashtra - one in Kalyan, situated in Thane district, and another in Dindori, located in Nashik district - to endorse the Lok Sabha candidates from the BJP-Shiv Sena-NCP 'Mahayuti' coalition.

Posing As Crime Branch Cops, 6 Men Take Rs 25 Lakh From Cafe Owner's Home

Six men claiming to be from the crime branch entered a cafe owner's home in Mumbai's Sion area and allegedly took away Rs 25 lakh, an official said on Thursday. The police have arrested four of them.

The complainant, who runs a popular cafe in the city's Matunga area, told the police that six persons came to his house near the Sion hospital on Tuesday saying they were from the Mumbai crime branch.

The men claimed that they were on election duty and had information that he had



kept money for use in connection with the Lok Sabha

polls, the official said citing the complaint.

Mumbai will vote in the fifth phase of general elec-

tions on May 20. The hotelier told them that he had only Rs 25 lakh cash from his food business and it had nothing to do with the elections, the official said.

However, the six accused took the money and left his home threatening to implicate him in a crime. The cafe owner then approached the Sion police station, prompting an investigation.

During the probe, the police arrested four of the accused. Cops suspect the involvement of a retired police constable and personnel of the police motor transport department in the crime, the official added.

Jet Airways founder Naresh Goyal's wife passes away after battling cancer

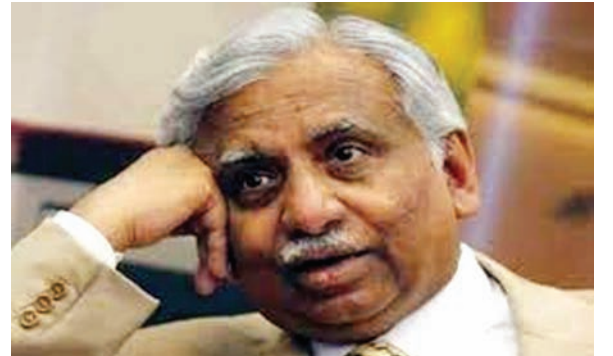

Mumbai hoarding crash: Death toll rises to 16 as two more bodies recovered

Two more bodies were recovered here from the debris at the site of the giant hoarding crash of May 13, taking the toll to 16, the BMC Disaster Control said here on Thursday.

The bodies of a male and a female were found in a highly decomposed state and have been identified as Manoj Chansoria, 60, and Anita Chansoria, 59.

The rescue work is still underway at the site of Chheda Nagar for the fourth day after the monstrous hoarding collapse. The rescue operation on Wednesday also led to the recovery of several vehicles buried under the debris, raising fears of more casualties.

The incident sent shockwaves in Mumbai which is dotted by 1025 big and small hoardings, besides many others on railways properties.

The BMC has started yanking off all illegal or oversized hoardings violating the permissible size of 40x40 feet (1600 sq feet).

The civic body has also slapped notices to the Central Railway and Western Railway to immediately identify and remove all illegal hoardings on its properties immediately.

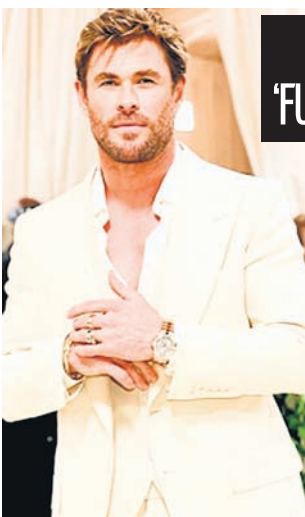
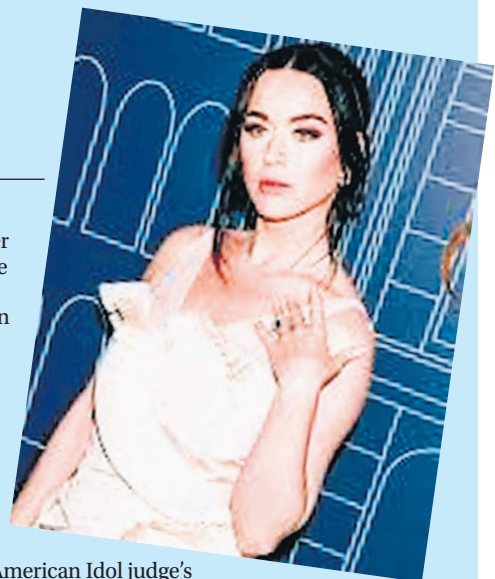

Following Sunil Chhetri's official announcement in which the striker announced that he will be playing his last game for India against Kuwait on June 6, many boards, teams and players have come out pay tribute to the Indian captain's stellar career.

The official handle for the FIFA World Cup has posted a tribute for Chhetri as well which included the iconic photo of him standing with Lionel Messi and Cristiano Ronaldo on a podium, which signifies the top three active international goal scorers.

The picture was coupled with a caption, "Retiring as a legend".

"Sunil Chhetri, the world's third-highest active international goalscorer, will play his final game for Indian Football in next month's FIFA World Cup qualifiers," added the official account for the FIFA World Cup on X (formerly known as Twitter).

The 39-year old played his 150th game for his country against Afghanistan last month. He has scored 94



goals so far in his international career with fans hoping he finds the back of the net at least one more time in the blue tigers jersey during the game vs Kuwait at Salt Lake Stadium.

FIFA World Cup's official account also posted a video of Chhetri's previous interview in which he talked about the comparisons made between him, Messi and Ronaldo.

"Some of the fans go overboard and think about comparing (with Messi & Ronaldo) but there are footballing fans who understand there is no comparison between the kind of players that we are but I will definitely compete with them with all my might in terms of giving the best for my country. There I probably would not lose," Chhetri had said to FIFA +

Playing against Pakistan tricky as they and India do not play much against each other : Harbhajan Singh

Harbhajan Singh, former off-spinner and member of the 2007 Men's T20 World Cup winning team, believes it will be a tricky time for India when they face Pakistan in the upcoming edition of the mega event as both countries don't play much against each other internationally.

It's little less than a month now for the highly-anticipated 2024 Men's T20 World Cup Group A match between India and Pakistan to be held at the newly-built Nassau County International Cricket Stadium in New York on June 9.

In the seven meetings between these two teams in the Men's T20 World Cup, India have emerged victorious six times. The last time the two teams faced off internationally was in the Men's T20 World Cup in October 2022 inside a packed Melbourne Cricket Ground, where Virat Kohli's sensational 82 not out helped India get a thrilling four-wicket win over Pakistan.

"At the end of the day, playing against Pakistan is always (tricky) as both countries do not play much against each other. We do not know much about their strong and weak zones but the Indian management keeps track of every player and



their strong and weak zones."

"In the bowling department too, Pakistan bowlers keep themselves mentally and physically strong. These aspects will be taken care of by the Indian team. These things will come into play when both sides will battle it out on the field," said Harbhajan while responding to an IANS query during an episode of the 'Star Sports Press Room' show.

Pakistan's unpredictability factor along with how the New York pitch would behave also adds as a challenge for India. But Harbhajan thinks the Indian team being more aware about their own game and taking decisions based on the on-ground conditions will be key.

"It also depends on what decision you take on that particular day. You know Virat Kohli plays

cover drive beautifully but bowlers still check him in the same area to get an outside edge in the slip. These chances you have to take according to the conditions. It is not important how much you know about your opponent but how much you are aware of your game. That is what matters the most and everything else is basic," he added.

Manika, Sharath to lead India's six-member TT squad at Paris Olympics

As women's table tennis star Manika Batra and Commonwealth Games medalist Sharath Kamal will spearhead the team events of Indian women and men's challenges, respectively, at the Paris Olympics in what will be the first-ever participation of our squads at the Games.

"The senior selection committee of the Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI), which met here on Thursday, picked a six-member squad (three in each section) as per the Olympics norms, besides naming the individuals who would compete in the singles events," the TTFI said in a statement.

Achanta Sharath Kamal, Harmeet Desai, and Manav Thakkar will form the three-member men's team, while Manika Batra, Sreeja Akula and Archana Kamath will be squad members in the women's category.



The "Alternate Player" in each section would be G. Sathiyam and Ayhika Mukherjee, it said.

In the men's singles, Sharath and Harmeet will compete and it will be Manika and Sreeja in the women's event.

Since the selection of the squads and the individuals were as per the

already pronounced TTFI criteria, three players "got selected themselves" because of their consistent performances over time and world rankings.

"However, there was a debate over the third player for the women's squad. After Manika and Sreeja Akula walked in on the back of their higher

world rankings (top 50). Archana Kamath made it to the team as the third player. The Bengaluru paddler edged Ayhika Mukherjee out as the former scored over the latter on several counts, including her world ranking (No.103), 33 places ahead of Ayhika.

"As for the men, Sharath picked himself as the top-ranked Indian at No. 40, while Hareem (No. 63) and Manav (No. 62) were separated by one slot in WR. Though both made it to the team composition, National champion Harmeet got the selectors' nod based on his international (better win-loss proportion to his participation) and national performances," the statement further read.

Incidentally, Massimo Costantini's presence as a special invitee at the meeting also added teeth as the foreign expert's inputs proved handy in the selection of the squads, it added.

But the first-half action wasn't finished there, as another dangerous cross from Lamptey on the right picked out the head of Joao Pedro and he rattled the crossbar.

The game's next goal came in the 64th minute when Gusto drove inside the penalty area and pulled the ball across the box for Nkunku to direct the ball past Verbruggen. Brighton piled on the pressure from there and Simon Adingra struck a post on the volley before a low cross from the left by Joao Pedro was poked home at the near post by Danny Welbeck.

As anticipation builds for the race weekend, Formula 1 fans can expect the unexpected when it comes to the Emilia Romagna region. Known for its

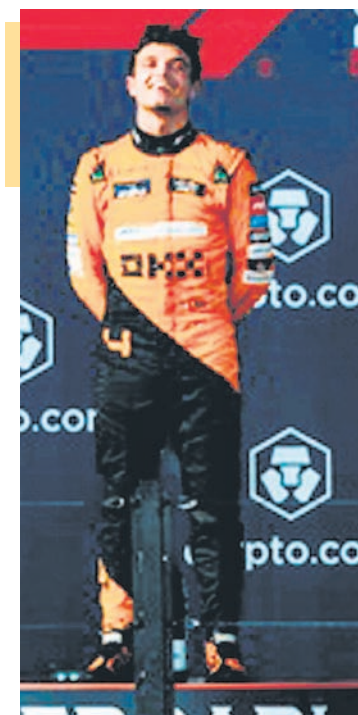
unpredictable weather, racing enthusiasts will be mindful of the possibility of rain looming large over the weekend, which could promise an extra layer of excitement to the racing action
