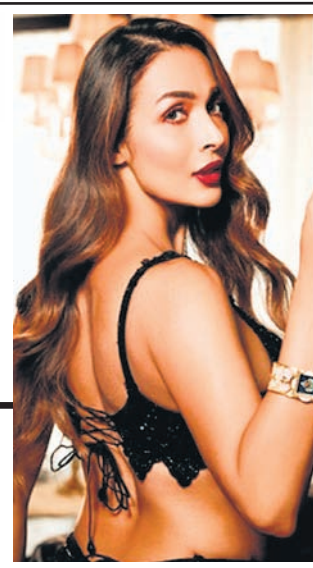

SC ISSUES NORMS ON DEMOLITIONS, SAYS VIOLATION WILL RESULT IN PROSECUTION

BULLDOZER PARKED

Laying down pan-India directives governing demolitions of unauthorised structures, the Supreme Court on Wednesday cautioned that flouting its directions by state officials will result in criminal contempt and prosecution. After several petitions were filed before the apex court alleging that demolitions were carried out by several state authorities without sufficient notice, a Bench of Justices B.R. Gavai and K.V. Viswanathan issued a slew of directions under Article 142 of the Constitution. In an interim order passed on September 17, the Justice Gavai-led Bench paused all demolition actions across the country, except with its permission.

Frowning upon "glorification" and "grandstanding" over bulldozer action, the top court said that unauthorised structures may be demolished following the due procedure but under no circumstances, property is to be demolished for "extraneous reasons". The SC stressed that even unauthorised construction has to be demolished in "accordance with law" and state authorities cannot resort to demolition of the property of the accused as an extra punitive measure.

Opposition hail verdict

New Delhi/Lucknow: The Supreme Court's decision to lay down pan-India directives governing demolitions of unauthorised structures on Wednesday gave fresh ammunition to BJP-baiters, with the Samajwadi Party even calling the verdict a slap on the face of Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath. Slamming the practice of "bulldozer justice", allegedly followed in some BJP-ruled states, the Congress and the SP hailed the apex court's ban on demolition of properties of suspects in criminal cases.

Samajwadi Party President Akhilesh Yadav thanked the top court for delivering the verdict and said, "Now, the bulldozer should stop. Unconstitutional activities should stop."

Congress leader Sandeep Dikshit hailed the apex court decision but voiced concern that the disturbing aspects which forced the top court to pass the stinging verdict went unnoticed in lower courts.

AIMIM President Asaduddin Owaisi welcomed the Supreme Court order on 'bulldozer justice'. He posted on the social media platform X that, "We should remember that no less than Prime Minister Narendra Modi has celebrated bulldozer raj, which SC today called a lawless state of affairs."

Directives laid down by the Apex court:

- No demolition will be carried out without a prior show cause notice returnable either in accordance with the time provided by the local municipal laws or within 15 days' time from the date of service of such notice, whichever is later.
- The time of 15 days will start from the date of receipt of the notice.
- The notice will be served upon the owner/occupier by a registered post, apart from affixing on the outer portion of the structure in question.
- As soon as the show cause notice is served, intimation will be sent to the office of Collector/District Magistrate by email and an auto-generated reply acknowledging receipt of the mail should also be issued from the office of the Collector/District Magistrate.
- The notice should contain the details regarding the nature of the unauthorised construction, the details of the specific violation and the grounds of demolition and a list of documents that the noticee is required to furnish along with his reply.
- The notice should also specify the date on which the personal hearing is fixed and the designated authority before whom the hearing will take place. The minutes of such a hearing will also be recorded.
- Within three months, every municipal and local authority will assign a designated digital portal, where details regarding service/pasting of the notice, the reply, the show cause notice and the order passed would be available.
- Upon hearing, the designated authority shall pass a final order. The final order should contain as to why the extreme step of demolition is the only option available and other options like compounding and demolishing only part of the property are not available.
- The demolition order will not be implemented for a period of 15 days and will be displayed on the digital portal.
- An opportunity should be given to the owner/occupier to remove the unauthorised construction or demolish the same within a period of 15 days.
- Only after the period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the notice has expired and the owner/occupier has not removed/demolished the unauthorised construction, and if the same is not stayed by any appellate authority or a court, the concerned authority will take steps to demolish the same.
- Before demolition, a detailed inspection report shall be prepared by the concerned authority signed by two witnesses. The demolition will be video-graphed, and the concerned authority will also prepare a demolition report. The video recording to be duly preserved.
- The demolition report should be forwarded to the Municipal Commissioner by email and will also be displayed on the digital portal.
- The SC said that violation of any of the directions would lead to initiation of contempt proceedings in addition to the prosecution.
- The officials should also be informed that if the demolition is found to be in violation of the SC orders, the officer concerned will be held responsible for restitution of the demolished property at his personal cost in addition to payment of damages.
- The SC clarified that these directions will not be applicable if there is an unauthorised structure in any public place such as road, street, footpath, abutting railway line or any river body or water bodies and also to cases where there is an order for demolition made by a court of law.
- The apex court ordered that registry to circulate a copy of its judgment to the chief secretaries of all the states and Union Territories and the Registrar Generals of all the High Courts.

Amid Thackeray's criticism, poll panel officials check choppers of Maha CM and DCM

Amid Shiv Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray's criticism over his helicopter checking twice by the Election Commission, the poll panel staff on Wednesday checked choppers of Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar.

Both took to the X to upload videos, saying that they cooperated with the poll panel staff in discharge their duties. When the EC staff found some eatables including chakki (a spiral shaped savoury snack), Ajit Pawar asked him to eat while the Chief Minister was seen telling the staff that the suitcase contains shirts and trousers along with eatables and cold drinks. He also said that there was no urine pot, an apparent reference to Uddhav Thackeray's furious reaction, in which the latter had asked the staff to even check urine from his helicopter.

Shiv Sena spokesperson, who shared the video of CM Shinde's helicopter being checked by the EC staff at Palghar said, "The Chief Minister did not make any issue out of it and also extended cooperation."

Ajit Pawar in his post on X said, "Today while on my way to campaign, the Election Commission conducted a rou-

tine check of my bags and helicopter. I fully cooperated and believe that such measures are essential to ensure free and fair elections. Let us all respect the law and support efforts to uphold the integrity of our democracy."

Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari's helicopter was also checked by election officials in Latur on Tuesday when he arrived for a campaign there.

Meanwhile, BJP has slammed Shiv Sena Uddhav Thackeray over making noise about the checking of his helicopter.

The party in its official handle on X uploaded a video showing the frisking of bags of Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis after he landed at Kolhapur on November 5.

"Let it go, some leaders have a habit of showing off. On 7th November in Yavatmal district, our leader Devendraji Fadnis' bags were checked. But, he did not make any video, nor did he make any noise. Earlier, on November 5 at Kolhapur airport, Devendraji Fadnis' bags were checked," said the BJP.

Notably, the choppers and helicopters of top leaders of all parties are checked during election season, as part of the EC's standing operating procedure.

Himachal HC sets aside appointment of MLAs as parliamentary secretaries

Shimla: In a major setback to the Congress government in the state, the Himachal Pradesh High Court on Wednesday said that the appointment of MLAs as parliamentary secretaries is unconstitutional and ordered their immediate removal. The bench said that after the passing of the (Ninety-First Amendment) Bill, 2003, an embargo was placed on the size of the Cabinet in a Legislative Assembly, as under Article 164(1-A) of the Constitution, the size of the Council of Ministers in a state could not exceed 15 per cent of the total strength of the Assembly. In its detailed judgment, the Himachal Pradesh High Court noted that though parliamentary secretaries, under the Himachal Pradesh Parliamentary Secretaries (Appointment, Salaries, Allowances, Powers, Privileges and Amenities) Act, 2006, did not have the powers to approve the action proposed by a Secretary or any other subordinate functionary of the Government but had access to the office of the political executive.

It further noted that parliamentary secretaries had access to official files to participate in the decision-making process and the Chief Minister had also allotted the portfolios to them and they have been attached to the Cabinet ministers.

CCPA slaps Rs 54.6 lakh fine on 48 coaching centres, issues new norms to curb misleading ads

The guidelines explicitly prohibit coaching institutes from making false claims related to the following:

- THE COURSES OFFERED, THEIR DURATION, FACULTY QUALIFICATIONS, FEES, AND REFUND POLICIES.
- SELECTION RATES, SUCCESS STORIES, EXAM RANKINGS, AND JOB SECURITY PROMISES.
- ASSURED ADMISSIONS, HIGH EXAM SCORES, GUARANTEED SELECTIONS OR PROMOTIONS.

The Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) has slapped a fine of Rs 54.6 lakh on 48 coaching institutes for misleading advertisements and issued comprehensive guidelines to address malpractices in the coaching sector. The 'Guidelines for Prevention of Misleading Advertisement in the Coaching Sector, 2024,' aims to safeguard students and the public from deceptive marketing practices commonly employed by coaching centres. Nidhi Khare, Chief Commissioner CCPA and Secretary, the Department of Consumer Affairs told journalists on Wednesday.

The guidelines stipulate that coaching institutes must accurately represent their infrastructure, resources, and facilities. Misleading representations about the quality or standard of their services are strictly prohibited.

In a notable move, the guidelines bar coaching centres from using students' names, photos, or testimonials in advertisements without their written consent -- and importantly, this consent must be obtained only after the student's success. This provision is intended to reduce the pressure students face when enrolling, as they are often pushed into signing such agreements upfront. Coaching centres will need to dis-

close important information, such as the name, rank, and course details alongside the student's photo in an advertisement. Whether the course was paid for by the student that, too, must be clearly stated. Additionally, any disclaimers will need to be prominently displayed, with the same font size as other important details, ensuring that consumers are not misled by the fine print.

Every coaching centre will also be required to partner with the National Consumer Helpline, making it easier for students to raise concerns or complaints regarding misleading advertisements and unfair trade practices.

Any violation of these guidelines will be treated as a contravention of

the Consumer Protection Act, 2019. The Central Authority has the power to take stringent actions against offenders, including imposing penalties, ensuring accountability, and preventing further occurrences of such deceptive practices.

These guidelines are a crucial step in preventing the exploitation of students and ensuring that they are not misled by false promises or compelled into unfair contracts benefiting both consumers and the broader educational ecosystem, she said.

These guidelines will be in addition to any existing regulations, enhancing the overall regulatory framework governing advertisements in the coaching sector, she added.

SALTY TRAP: WHY DIABETICS MUST WATCH THEIR SODIUM LEVELS

For people with diabetes, staying healthy requires more than just blood sugar control. Careful diet choices, especially reducing salt intake, are crucial because excess salt can worsen complications and increase health risks, say healthcare experts. Ahead of World Diabetes Day on November 14, top healthcare experts here highlighted the dangers of excessive salt consumption for individuals with diabetes.

According to Dr. Praveen Kumar Kulkarni, Senior Consultant Internal Medicine Specialist, KIMS Hospitals, one of the primary concerns with excessive salt consumption for people with diabetes is its impact on blood pressure. "Diabetes already places individuals at an increased risk of developing high blood pressure (hypertension), a condition that exacerbates the long-term complications of the disease. Salt causes the body to



retain water, which can raise blood pressure by increasing the volume of blood circulating through the blood vessels. Over time, this added strain on the cardiovascular system can lead to more severe health problems," said Dr Praveen Kumar Kulkarni.

Dr G. Sandeep Reddy, Consultant endocrinologist, Kamineni Hospitals pointed out that the American Heart Association (AHA) recommends that

individuals with diabetes or high blood pressure aim to limit their sodium intake to not more than 1,500 milligrams per day. "Excessive salt intake can further harm the kidneys, as it places additional strain on these vital organs by requiring them to filter out more sodium and water. When the kidneys are already compromised by diabetes, the added burden of processing high levels of salt can acceler-

ate kidney damage, leading to chronic kidney disease (CKD) or even kidney failure. Kidney disease is one of the leading causes of death for people with diabetes. By cutting back on salt, individuals can help protect kidney function and reduce the risk of more severe kidney-related complications," said Dr Sandeep. Dr. Usha Rani, General medicine senior consultant and Diabetes management, at Aster Prime Hospital believes that the risk of heart disease and stroke is significantly higher in people with diabetes due to factors like high blood pressure, poor circulation, and nerve damage. "Diabetics have thickened blood vessels and increased the likelihood of arterial blockages that can result in heart attacks or strokes. This risk is even greater for those with both diabetes and high blood pressure. Reducing salt is essential for cardiovascular health and lowering the risk of heart disease and stroke," she said.

Manipur: Demand to rescue six missing persons intensify

Demands and agitations for the rescue of the six missing persons -- three women and three children -- intensified in Manipur on Wednesday even as the security forces continued their search operation to locate the untraced persons for the past three days. Police said that after Monday's incident in which 11 suspected Kuki militants were killed during an encounter with the CRPF in Jiribam district, ten people were either kidnapped or missing. The Inspector General of Police (Operations), Manipur, I.K. Muivah said that during the search operations after the incident in Jakuradhor village, where several houses were also burnt down by the armed militants, two bodies of elderly civilians -- Maibam Kesho Singh (75) and Laishram Barel (61) - were found. The victims and the missing persons are inmates of a relief camp set up in the village for the violence-hit people. The IGP said another person was found

alive and rescued and another civilian came back on his own to Police Station

Currently, three women and three children are missing and search operations are going on to find them. Muivah said that on Monday (November 11), 10 militants were killed in the encounter with the CRPF. However, police officials earlier had put the toll at 11. All tribal organisations in Manipur including the Indigenous Tribal Leaders' Forum (ITLF), Kuki-Zo Council and Hmar Students' Association have been claiming that all the 11 are Hmar Village Volunteers. Normal life has been badly affected in five to six Imphal Valley districts on Tuesday and Wednesday after 13 civil society organisations called for a 24-hour total shutdown since Tuesday evening to protest the reported "abduction" of six people, belonging to the Meitei community. The 13 civil society organisations, including Peace and Social Advancement (IPSA) and Peoples' Action for National Democratic Movement (PAMDM) in a joint statement, claimed that there is no rule of law in the state.



ANGRY TRIBALS IN VIJAYPUR GHRAO POLICE STATION, POLLING RESUMES AFTER HALT

Voting for bypolls in Madhya Pradesh's Budhni and Vijaypur was underway under heavy security by police personnel and allegations of booth capturing at several places. Around 500 villagers from the tribal community in Veerpur block in Vijaypur surrounded the local police station and staged a protest, alleging that they were prohibited from exercising their right to vote.

Tribals alleged that BJP candidate Ramniwas Rawat's supporters forced them to return home without casting their votes.

Polling was disrupted for half-an-hour at Kheda polling booth.

Sheopur District Collector Kishor Kumar Kanyal said voting at the Kheda polling booth resumed after a brief halt and the situation was under control.

He said the poll was disrupted due to a conflict between two groups at the polling premises.

"People from two groups created a ruckus at a polling booth, following which a large number of villagers surrounded the local police station. However, the situation was brought under control and polling resumed after a brief halt," Kanyal said.

In another instance, villagers staged a protest on Sheopur-Morena highway, alleging that they were not allowed to enter a polling station. MP Congress chief Jitu Patwari accused the district administration and police of favouring the BJP in the bypolls and said that they have decided to lodge a complaint with the Election Commission.

"People are being barred from exercising their right to vote and booths are being captured at several places in Vijaypur. Vijaypur bye-election has become an election that has

Madhya Pradesh Leads the Nation in Ayushman Card Creation for Senior Citizens

Deputy Chief Minister Rajendra Shukla praised the remarkable progress made in Ayushman card creation for senior citizens across Madhya Pradesh, commending all involved officials, ASHA workers, ANMs, and community health officials. He stated that the state government is committed to reaching all eligible senior citizens with health security under this ambitious scheme. Madhya Pradesh currently leads the country in issuing Ayushman cards for senior citizens. Dr. Yogesh Bharsat, CEO of the Ayushman Bharat scheme, shared that over 2,00,667 Ayushman cards have been created for senior citizens aged 70 and above in Madhya Pradesh, compared to 1,76,167 cards in Kerala.

Dr. Bharsat added that approximately 30,000 to 35,000 Ayushman cards are being generated daily for senior citizens in Madhya Pradesh. He mentioned that the target of 34,73,325 Ayushman cards is expected to be met by January 15. An action plan has been formulated, with ASHA workers, ANMs, and CHOs con-



ducting door-to-door outreach and organizing special camps.

Dr. Bharsat explained that under the Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY), a new initiative has been introduced to provide accessible and high-quality healthcare services to senior citizens aged 70 and above. Launched on October 29, 2024, this scheme allows eligible senior citizens to register themselves on the National Health Authority's portal <https://beneficiary.nha.gov.in> or the Ayushman app <https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.beneficiaryapp>, enabling them to create their card from home by choosing the self-registration option.

Both the women injured in the wolf attack have been admitted to the district hospital Chhindwara. bravely faced the wolf. The Chief Minister appreciated Bhujlo Bai's courage and sanctioned one lakh rupees as an incentive. Cases are registered against both the above mentioned criminals in Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu states in connection with hunting of wild animal tiger and illegal trade of its parts.

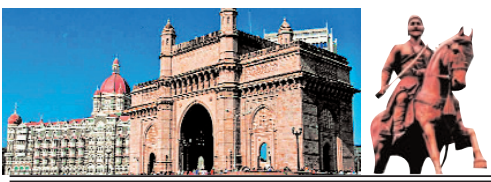
Accused Pujari Singh Bawaria has been sent to Tamil Nadu by the Nilgiri

SS strength, ensuring MahaYuti victory

Team Absolute | Mumbai

Amid MahaYuti's appeal to voters to re-elect the grand alliance to increase the pace of development in Maharashtra, Chief Minister Eknath Shinde faces a major challenge to increase the presence of Shiv Sena and also consolidate MahaYuti's position in his home district Thane and the adjoining tribal dominated Palghar district especially due to rebellion and differences among the MahaYuti partners.

Although the Chief Minister along with Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis partially succeeded in pacifying the rebels, those still in the fray have made the fight more tough for the MahaYuti.

Thane district has 18 assembly constituencies while Palghar has 6. During the Lok Sabha elections, of the four seats from these two districts, Shiv Sena won Thane and Kalyan while BJP bagged Palghar seat.

Thane has been traditionally been a bastion of Shiv Sena but after the split, Shiv Sena leader and CM Eknath Shinde outsmarted Uddhav Thackeray led faction to tighten its grip. Over the years, BJP has also made inroads in Thane district, which is a part of the Mumbai Metropolitan Region.

Of the 18 seats, Shiv Sena is contesting on six seats while nine is being contested by BJP, with the latter reasserting its big brother role.

Shinde's worries are far from over after his two trusted colleagues Vijay



Nahata and Vijay Chougule defied the party line and entered the fray from Belapur and Airoli constituencies respectively. Although Shinde disowned Nahata signalling party cadres to work for MahaYuti, the latter remains in the fray as independent against BJP's sitting legislator and nominee Manda Mhatre in Belapur constituency. Though, Shinde deputed party MP Naresh Mhaske for coordinating between BJP and NCP, Nahata is able to garner support from section of party cadres making the fight bitter. Incidentally, NCP SP has nominated former legislator Sandeep Naik against Mhatre and Nahata. Naik, who was the BJP's Navi Mumbai district unit, deserted the party and joined NCP-SP as the party did not consider his nomination. In the adjoining Airoli constituen-

cy, Shinde's another close confidant Vijay Chougule is contesting as an independent against BJP nominee and former minister Ganesh Naik and Shiv Sena UBT nominee MK Madhavi. Naik had openly criticised Shinde in the past.

Similarly, Shinde's close associate Mahesh Gaikwad crossed the party line and he is contesting as an independent from Kalyan East against the BJP nominee Sulabha Gaikwad who is the wife of party's sitting legislator Ganpat Gaikwad. Incidentally, Gaikwad is currently in jail in connection with firing on Mahesh Gaikwad due to personal rivalry. Although, Shinde and his son Shrikant Shinde, who is MP from Kalyan, have told party cadres to work hard for Sulabha Gaikwad's victory, Mahesh Gaikwad may turn out to be a spoilsport by

eating into the MahaYuti's votes. Shiv Sena UBT nominee Dhananjay Borade is leaving no stone unturned to encash the rift in the MahaYuti for his victory.

In Kalyan West, the widening rift between the MNS nominee Raju Patil and Shiv Sena MP Shrikant Shinde has made the fight more personal. Shiv Sena has fielded Rajesh More while Shiv Sena UBT has renominated Subhash Bhoir who had lost to Raju Patil in the 2019 elections. Raju Patil was expecting that Shiv Sena will not contest the election but support him considering his party chief Raj Thackeray had supported Shrikant Shinde during the Lok Sabha elections. However, it did not happen as Raju Patil is making all efforts for the defeat of Shiv Sena nominee. This has forced Shinde faction to pull out all its resources including the rank and file to gain victory there.

In Mira Bhayander too, an independent Geeta Jain, who made every effort to get Shiv Sena ticket, is contesting again as independent after the BJP bagged the seat during the seat sharing arrangement. BJP has fielded Narendra Mehta who had lost to Jain in the 2019 elections. Incidentally, Mehta is a close confidant of Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis. Congress has nominated former legislator Muzaffar Hussain who expects to win the seat cashing in on the division of votes between Mehta and Jain. For Shinde, it is a catch 22 situation as supporting Jain may hamper the poll prospects of BJP and in turn of MahaYuti benefitting the Congress.

NCP National President and Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar on Wednesday distanced himself from BJP's slogans of 'Batenge Toh Katenge' and 'Ek Hain Toh Safe Hai', claiming that his party does not agree with these calls given ahead of Assembly elections.

"I don't agree with the slogans 'Batenge Toh Katenge' and 'Ek Hain Toh Safe Hai'. The NCP is committed to the progressive thoughts of Chhatrapati Shivaji, Mahatma Phule, Shahu Maharaj and B.R. Ambedkar," he said during his meetings with villagers from the Baramati constituency.

He clarified that his party wants the BJP should stop making appeals targeting a particular community as Maharashtra has been known for progressive thinking and communal harmony.

"We in the Mahayuti are united because of

the Prime Minister's 'Sabka Saath Sabka Vikas' slogan. They say that we are all together, we are safe. People of all castes come in the 'Sab Ek Hain' appeal," said Ajit Pawar

Justifying his decision to continue in the alliance, he said, "Even though the NCP's ideology is different from the ideologies of the BJP and the Shiv Sena, the alliance is formed on a common minimum programme. Adjustments and compromises will have to be made for the welfare of the state and people."

Ajit Pawar is locked in a fierce fight against his nephew and NCP-SP nominee Yugendra Pawar in Baramati constituency.

He also slammed Uddhav Thackeray for joining hands with the Congress after the 2019 Assembly elections.

Highlighting Mahayuti's commitment towards the welfare of all, including Muslims, he said, "The MahaYuti government has taken several decisions for the development of minorities."

Shah accuses MVA of playing BJP trying to break up country through inciting slogans: Mallikarjun Kharge

Ahead of the November 20 Assembly elections, Home Minister Amit Shah on Wednesday accused the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA), comprising Congress, Shiv Sena (UBT) and NCP-SP, of playing appeasement politics in Maharashtra and planning to give reservation to Muslims. Addressing an election rally for BJP and Mahayuti nominees, Shah targeted Shiv Sena (UBT) president Uddhav Thackeray, saying he has forgotten the



principles of the Shiv Sena founder Balasaheb Thackeray. "Mahayuti means development while Maha Vikas Aghadi means destruction. You have to decide whether to elect developers or destroyers," he said. "Uddhav Babu, you are sit-

ting with those people who opposed renaming of Aurangabad as Sambhaji Nagar, the construction of Ram temple, the abolition of triple talaq, the abolition of Article 370 and the surgical strike. You are sitting with those who call Hindus terrorists," said Shah.

"The Aghadi people are opposing all the communities. They gave a statement against Ramgiri Maharaj. They sparked riots in Sindhkeda and they are promoting people who are not good for Maharashtra and the country," he alleged.

The Congress accused the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) of attempting to break up the country's unity through inflammatory slogans in the ongoing Maharashtra Assembly elections campaign, here on Wednesday.

Speaking at poll rallies in Latur and Solapur districts, Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge called upon the gathering to raise chants of 'Hum Sab Ek Hain' and the crowds responded enthusiastically. "Look... We are all strongly united. It's the BJP which is trying to divide us with slogans of 'Ek hain to safe hain' or 'batenge to katenge', attempting to sow discord among the people... But the people of Maharashtra will foil such moves by voting out the (MahaYuti) government," thundered Kharge.

He said that for its divisive tendencies and insulting Dr B. R. Ambedkar by burning a copy of the Constitution which he had architected, "the people of the state must teach them a strong lesson". "The country is one and united, but the BJP lead-

ers are misleading the masses by raising slogans like 'batenge to katenge'. Nobody from the BJP-RSS has ever laid down their lives for the country, but three Congress leaders made the supreme sacrifice for the nation. Now, the masses will give the BJP a befitting reply next week," Kharge declared.

He reiterated that the BJP-RSS are actively working to destroy the Constitution through falsehoods and making fake claims of its achievements in Maharashtra, which the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) has exposed in the past few years.

"The soybean and cotton farmers are not getting the minimum support prices they deserve here... Prime Minister Narendra Modi is looting the agriculturists by levying GST on farming inputs instead of increasing the remuneration for the distressed soybean and cotton growers," Kharge pointed out.

He recalled how Deputy CM Devendra Fadnis had promised to accord MSP of Rs 6000/quintal for soybeans but never implemented it.

Kharge said that in 2021, the soybean prices had touched Rs 10,000/quintal, and the MSP is Rs

4892/quintal now but the farmers are forced to sell it at much lower rates of around Rs 42,00/quintal, thus adding to their woes despite getting a good yield, and spurring suicides.

"The farmers of Marathwada and Vidarbha are deeply worried about the falling prices of soybean and cotton, but the PM has imposed GST on at least 35 agricultural items, promised to farmers to double their income, but did not increase MSP or the tillers' incomes. The BJP regimes at the Centre and state are anti-farmers and have cheated them with hollow assurances," slammed Kharge.

Taking up the MVA Manifesto, he assured that after the alliance assumes power, it will immediately take up the cause of the suffering farmers, women, youth, senior citizens, unemployed, the ill and other sections of society earnestly to provide them relief.

Telangana Minister Uttak Kumar Reddy, ex-state Ministers Amit Deshmukh, Dilip Deshmukh and Dheeraj Deshmukh, MPs and other senior MVA leaders were present on the occasion.

STAND UP ON OWN LEGS: SC TELLS NCP'S AJIT PAWAR FACTION

The Supreme Court on Wednesday asked Ajit Pawar-led faction of Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) to not use the name and photograph of veteran leader and party founder Sharad Pawar in its political advertisements, in the run-up to Assembly elections in Maharashtra.

A bench presided over by Justice Surya Kant asked Ajit Pawar side "to stand up on his own legs" and not contest elections on Sharad Pawar's name.

Last week, the Bench, also comprising Justice Ujjal Bhuyan, had asked the Ajit Pawar faction to give wide publicity to its interim orders requiring the addition of disclaimers in party advertisements that allocation of party's clock symbol is sub-judice and subject to the outcome of proceedings pending before the top



court.

It had asked the Ajit Pawar side to publish fresh disclaimers regarding the clock symbol in newspapers, including in Marathi, within 36 hours.

The apex court was dealing with an application filed by the Sharad Pawar faction demanding that the Ajit Pawar camp be temporarily allotted a new symbol for the Maharashtra Assembly

elections instead of the clock.

The Supreme Court stressed that the parties should meticulously comply with its orders and asked both sides not to violate the March 19 interim direction.

In that order, the SC had asked the Ajit Pawar-led party to issue a public notice in English, Marathi, and Hindi editions, stating that the usage of the

clock symbol reserved for the NCP is subject to the final outcome of proceedings pending before the Supreme Court.

"Such a declaration shall be incorporated in every pamphlet, advertisement, audio, or video clip to be issued on behalf of the respondents (Ajit Pawar-led party)," it had said.

The SC had clarified that the Nationalist Congress Party-Sharadchandra Pawar (NCP-SP) - having the 'Man Blowing Turha' symbol - will also follow court orders and not use the clock symbol. Further, it had asked Ajit Pawar's side to sensitise NCP workers, office bearers and candidates to not defy the top court's direction.

Adjourning the hearing to November 19, the apex court remarked that people are very wise and know how to vote and can differentiate who is Sharad and who is Ajit Pawar.

NCP's Nawab Malik accuses rivals of defamation ahead of Maharashtra polls

Nawab Malik, the Mankhurd Shivaji Nagar candidate from Ajit Pawar-led Nationalist Congress Party (NCP), has alleged that some political parties are attempting to tarnish his reputation by linking him with notorious gangsters and money laundering cases, in an effort to turn voters against him.

Speaking to reporter on Wednesday, Malik stated, "I am up against both the MahaYuti and Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) in the upcoming Maharashtra Assembly elections. All parties are opposing me, yet the people of Mankhurd Shivaji Nagar support me, even those affiliated with rival parties."

Addressing the divide within the NCP, Malik expressed hope that supporters of both factions -- led by Ajit Pawar and Sharad Pawar -- would unite. However, he emphasised that



the decision ultimately rests with the party leadership. Malik condemned efforts to link him to underworld don Dawood Ibrahim, calling them "baseless" attempts to slander him.

"Some political leaders are calling me a terrorist, others a traitor. My legal team is reviewing these allegations, and we'll send legal notices to those

responsible. If they don't apologise, I'll pursue criminal and civil defamation cases," Malik said.

Highlighting his record, Malik added, "I've served as a minister for six terms without any charges of corruption. Now, in the absence of any proof, they resort to severe accusations to malign my image. I am confident I will be vindicated in the court proceedings."

Additionally, Malik firmly dismissed any association with Dawood Ibrahim, calling him "an enemy of the country."

Two construction firm owners booked for cheating Thane family of Rs 1.2 cr

Police have registered a case against two owners of a construction company for allegedly cheating a Thane family of Rs 1.2 crore in Maharashtra's Thane district, officials said on Wednesday, reported news agency.

A 28-year-old woman, resident of Rabodi area, in her police complaint said the accused had convinced her as well as her mother and sister to invest in their construction firm based in Mumbai's Bandra area, promising significant returns.

On December 31, 2022, the two accused, who are brothers, allegedly persuaded her family to invest Rs 1.20 crore with the assurance of a payout of Rs 3 crore in five years or, alternatively, the option to receive

two or three flats in Bandra, a Rabodi police official said.

The woman's family then took loans from different sources to invest the money into the construction firm, he said.

However, when her family sought the invested amount back and the profits in May this year, the accused refused to pay the sum and threatened them, boasting of their high-level connections, the official said.

The woman filed a complaint, based on which a case was registered against the two accused on Monday under Indian Penal Code sections 420 (cheating), 406 (criminal breach of trust), 506 (criminal intimidation) and 34 (common intention), and provisions of the Maharashtra Protection of Interest of Depositors Act, the official said.

The Maharashtra Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) has said that its vigilance squads have made seizure of more than Rs 500 crores from across the poll-bound state in the past few days.

The CEO, under the Election Commission of India (ECI) directives and SOPs has deployed Static Surveillance Teams (SSTs) and Flying Squads (FS), besides organizing strategic Check Posts during the election season.

The SSTs and others are aimed at keeping a vigil on excessive poll expenses, voter inducement by way of cash-kind offers, movement of arms, liquor or even musclemen.



Against this backdrop, the SSTs have swooped in multiple districts and cities like Mumbai and Pune, intercepting vehicles and recovering in excess of Rs 500 crore so far, said an official here.

The CEO's revelation came amid the ongoing row that erupted after Shiv Sena (UBT) President and ex-CM Uddhav Thackeray expressed his displeasure at the frisking of his helicopters for two consecutive days - Monday and Tuesday.

He wanted to know why he always appeared to be the 'first customer' for the ECI's protocols and demanded whether the officials have checked the aircraft of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Home Minister Amit

Shah, Maharashtra CM Eknath Shinde, Deputy CMs Devendra Fadnis and Ajit Pawar, plus other bigwigs from the ruling side.

As the huge fracas continued, the ECI and state officials said that they carried out similar searches on the aircraft of PM, Shah, Shinde. "Even Union Minister Nitin Gadkari's chopper was frisked yesterday and Fadnis was subjected to the same treatment last week in Kolhapur," they said.

The state CEO said that there was no discrimination as alleged in these operations and the SOPs are strictly adhered to by the team comprising ECI officials, a policeman, a revenue official plus other designated officers.

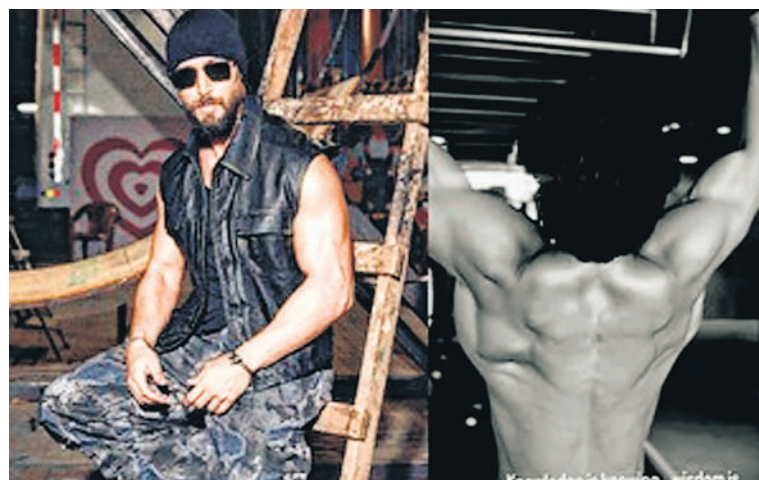
