## WAR LEAPS WORLD FOOD COMMODITY PRICES: FAO

World food commodity prices made a significant leap in March to reach their highest levels ever, as war in the Black Sea region spread shocks through markets for staple grains and vegetable oils, the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) reported on Friday.

Russia and Ukraine, combined,

accounted for around 30 per cent and 20 per cent of global wheat and maize exports, respectively, over the past three years. World wheat prices soared by 19.7 per cent during the month, exacerbated by concerns over crop conditions in the US.

Meanwhile, maize prices posted a 19.1 per cent month-on-month increase, hitting a record high along with those of barley and sorghum. Contrasting trends across the various origins and qualities kept the March value of FAO's Rice



Price Index little changed from February, and thus still 10 per cent below its level of a year earlier.

The FAO Vegetable Oil Price Index rose 23.2 per cent, driven by higher quotations for sunflower seed oil, of which Ukraine is the world's leading exporter.

Palm, soy and rapeseed oil prices also rose markedly as a result of the higher sunflower seed oil prices and the rising crude oil prices, with soy oil prices further underpinned by concerns over reduced exports by South America.

The FAO Sugar Price Index rose

6.7 per cent from February, reversing recent declines to reach a level more than 20 per cent higher than in March 2021. Higher crude oil prices were a driving factor, along with currency appreciation of the Brazilian Real, while favorable production prospects in India prevented larger monthly price increases.

The FAO Meat Price Index increased by 4.8 per cent in March to reach an all-time high, led by surging pig meat prices related to a shortfall of slaughter pigs in Western Europe.

International poultry prices also firms in step with reduced supplies from leading exporting countries following avian flu outbreaks.

The FAO Dairy Price Index rose 2.6 per cent and was 23.6 per cent higher than in March 2021, as quotations for butter and milk powders rose steeply amid a surge in import demand for near and long-term deliveries, especially from Asian markets.

## Google to block outdated apps on Play Store from Nov 1

In a bid to protect users from installing outdated apps which can put their data at risk, Google has announced to block and hide apps on Play Store that have not kept up with latest Android operating system (OS) updates.

Starting November 1 this year, existing apps that don't target an API level within one year of the latest major Android OS version release. New apps and app updates that don't meet this requirement cannot be published on Google Play.

Users with the latest devices or those who are fully caught up on Android updates expect to realize the full potential of all the privacy and security protections Android has to offer.

"Expanding our target level API requirements will protect users from installing older apps that may not have these protections in place," said Google. According to the company, a vast majority of apps on Google Play already abide by these standards.

As part of Google Play's latest policy updates, the company is taking additional steps to protect users from installing apps that may not

have the latest privacy and security features by expanding its target level API requirements. Google currently requires new apps and app updates to target an Android API level within one year of the latest major Android OS version release. New apps and app updates that don't meet this requirement cannot be published on Google Play.

Users with the latest devices or those who are fully caught up on Android updates expect to realize the full potential of all the privacy and security protections Android has to offer.

"Expanding our target level API requirements will protect users from installing older apps that may not have these protections in place," said Google. According to the company, a vast majority of apps on Google Play already abide by these standards.

Google said it is notifying developers in advance and providing resources for those who need them.

## Three more tiger reserves get international accreditation for conservation

- The total number of tiger reserves to get CA/TS certification becomes 17 as on date, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change announced.
- The certificates of accreditation were handed over to the officials from the three tiger reserves at Pakke Tiger Reserve in Arunachal Pradesh during the 20th National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) meeting being held on Saturday and Sunday there.
- In July 2021, 14 of India's tiger reserves were awarded this global accreditation. India has over 50 tiger reserves. The government had initiated this CATS standardisation process 10 years ago

The Sathyamangalam Tiger Reserve in Tamil Nadu and Bandhavgarh and Pench Tiger Reserves in Madhya Pradesh were on Saturday awarded the Conservation Assured Tiger Standards (CA/TS) international accreditation certificates.

Environment Minister Bhupender Yadav had insisted on NTCA meeting to be held outside Delhi - for the first time - in order to get first hand information about the reserve, local issues etc.

"While promoting tiger reserves across the country, we need to ensure the livelihoods of the people dependent on forests," the Minister said and pressed on active involvement of locals for conservation and better development of forest area and tiger reserve.

Yadav also released Standard Operating Procedure for Tiger Reintroduction and Supplementation in Wild, 'Forest Fire Audit Protocol for Tiger Reserves' and a technical manual 'Management Effectiveness Evaluation' (MEE) of Tiger Reserves in India prepared by the NTCA. India harbours about 70 per cent of the world's tiger population in the wild.

## WhatsApp likely turns off 'media visibility' option for disappearing chats

**San Francisco:** Meta-owned WhatsApp is likely now automatically turning off the option of "media visibility" for disappearing chats on WhatsApp for Android, which let people view media in their phone's gallery. According to WA BetaInfo, the new move is to ensure a better privacy experience when using disappearing messages and to help keep media more private in disappearing chat threads. In addition, the messaging platform is also rolling out the same change on WhatsApp for iOS, where the option "Save to Camera Roll" is automatically turned off for disappearing chats. In this case, images, videos and GIFs are never automatically saved in a user's camera roll if the general setting is enabled. Users can still save media manually in disappearing chats. Some users on certain versions of Android already have an option to manually save media, the report said. On WhatsApp for iOS, users can save media as normally users do. The changes are rolled out to all users on beta and public builds and full activation to everyone may happen within the next 24 hours.



## THAILAND OPEN

India's Govind Sahani, Ananta Chopde and Sumit concluded their impressive run at the 2022 Thailand Open International Boxing Tournament with gold medals in Phuket on Saturday.

The trio registered commanding victories against their respective opponents from Thailand while four other Indian boxers - Monika (48kg), Amit Panghal (52kg), Varinder Singh (60kg) and Ashish Kumar (81kg), claimed silver medals after enduring defeats in the finals. Manisha (57kg), Pooja (69kg) and Bhagyabati Kachari (75kg) secured bronze medals with their semi-finals finish, as the 15-member Indian contingent ended their campaign with 10 medals. The Indian boxers also bettered the last edition's medal tally of eight medals - one gold, four silver and

# I WAS BORN IN CENTRE OF POWER BUT IT DOES NOT INTEREST ME: RAHUL GANDHI

Former Congress president Rahul Gandhi on Saturday said that despite being born in the centre of power, he has no greed or temptation for it.

The Congress MP was speaking while launching a collection of essays edited by former IAS officer K. Raju at Jawahar Bhawan.

"There are politicians who are constantly in search of power.... I was born in the centre of power but honestly, it does not interest me at all. On the contrary, I try to understand the people and the country. In the process, I came to know that India is the only country in the world where untouchability still exists. We need to break free from this regressive mindset," he said.

Expressing his gratitude for the constant love that he received from the people, Gandhi said: "My country has loved me unconditionally for which I shall be indebted eternally. Definitely, there have been times when I have received brick bats as well which caused immense pain but deep within I know that my country wants to teach me so I try to understand it." On people being targeted only because they belong to a particular caste or creed he said: "I have also seen times when mobs assaulted innocent people like animals with sticks and batons simply because they



belonged to a different caste or religion. This is happening only with Dalits in the country."

K. Raju in his new book "The Dalit Truth: The Battle for Realizing Ambedkar's Vision" has attempted to depict the Dalit voice. It depicts their fight against the mob of Dalit truth and the lies perpetrated by the caste system.

This is the eighth volume of Penguin

Random House India's 'Rethinking India' series.

K. Raju, who is also the National Coordinator of Congress's SC, ST, OBC and All India Minority Departments, said: "This book is a companion for the truth seeker who seeks to demolish the caste architecture that engenders inequality and discrimination in society, maintains it."

## Delhi BJP leader booked for sharing 'doctored' Kejriwal clip

Punjab Police have registered an FIR against a Delhi BJP leader for allegedly sharing on his Twitter handle a "doctored video clip" of Aam Aadmi Party national convener Arvind Kejriwal.

This is the third FIR against a BJP leader since the AAP formed government on March 16. The FIR was registered against Delhi BJP's media cell head Naveen Kumar Jindal in Mohali, near here. He has been booked on the complaint of advocate Gurbhej Singh, who alleged that Jindal



shared a cropped video from the original footage of an interview given by Kejriwal to a TV channel and doctored the original content. The complainant said some words of the Delhi Chief Minister from the original interview were dropped, a police official said. An FIR was registered under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and the Information Technology Act.

## 6 FIREFIGHTERS AMONG 9 INJURED IN DELHI FACTORY FIRE



**New Delhi:** Nine people, including six firemen, were injured after a LPG cylinder exploded during a firefighting operation in a Chemical and Electrical equipment manufacturing factory in the national capital on early Saturday. A Fire department official told reporter that they received a call about a fire incident at 4.43 a.m. in a factory located at street no 4, Anand Parvat Industrial Area of Delhi after which as many as 10 fire tenders were immediately pressed into the service. As the firemen were dousing the flames, an LPG cylinder exploded resulting in injuries to six firemen and three civilians, the official said, adding the condition of the injured is now stable. The official confirmed that there have been no casualties in the incident, however, there was certainly a massive loss of property.

# Delhi: Students, activists demanding Hindu seer's arrest detained

Several students and social activists were on Saturday detained while staging a protest outside the Uttar Pradesh Bhawan in the national capital demanding arrest of a Hindu seer, Bajrang Muni.

The protest was called by All India Students Association (AISA), Campus Front of India, and Fraternity Movement, after which students in large numbers along with activists assembled outside the Uttar Pradesh Bhawan at Sardar Patel Marg in Chanakyapuri.

The protesters raised slogans demanding arrest of Bajrang Muni, for allegedly making some objectionable remarks.

"As the students continued to raise slogans outside the Uttar Pradesh Bhawan, they were stopped by the Delhi Police and later detained," AISA general secretary Prasenjit Kumar told reporter. The protesters were then taken to Mandir Marg Police station around 3.30 p.m. and later released at 7.15 p.m. in the evening,



Kumar said,

On April 2, an alleged hate speech by Bajrang Muni outside a mosque in Uttar Pradesh's Sitapur district went viral on social media, and later sparked an outrage.

Six days later -- on April 8, the Sitapur police in Uttar Pradesh, in a statement on Twitter, said that a case under relevant sections has been registered and further steps are being taken on the basis of witnesses' statements.

The 2-minute video containing the hate speech is said to have been recorded on April 2 when Bajrang Muni, who is the mahant of Maharsi Shri Lakshman Das

Udasin Ashram in Khairabad town, was taking out a procession on the occasion of Navratri and Hindu New Year. Muni can be allegedly heard saying in the video that if any Hindu girl is teased by a man belonging to a particular community, he would himself rape a woman of that community.

He also allegedly made some more objectionable remarks. Sitapur district Additional Superintendent of Police, North, Rajiv Dikshit, had said that legal action will be taken as per rules on the basis of the facts and evidence that surface during the probe.

# Iron bridge thieves inspired by Nitish, BJP, alleges Tejashwi Yadav

After a 60-feet long iron bridge was stolen from Bihar's Rohtas district, RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav on Saturday alleged that the thieves were inspired by Nitish Kumar and BJP leaders as the latter had "stolen" government in the state in 2020.

Since its defeat in the 2020 Assembly polls, the RJD had been alleging that the party had lost the seats due to counting malpractices and poll rigging.

"When Nitish Ji and BJP can steal the government in Bihar, stealing a bridge is not a big deal. The thieves were inspired by Nitish Kumar and BJP who had stolen the mandate," Tejashwi said in a tweet.

"Nitish Kumar and BJP, who have been ruling the state for the last 17 years, are responsible for allowing the loot of a 45 years old 500 tonne iron



bridge in Rohtas. Thieves arrived with gas cutters, JCB machines and uprooted the bridge in broad daylight. They were inspired from Nitish ji and BJP," Tejashwi alleged.

The thieves, posing as officers of the state Irrigation Department, used gas cutters and earth mover machines to demolish the bridge and take away the scrap metal in three days.

Interestingly, they took the help of local Irrigation Department officials and villagers during the removal of the iron bridge. By the time, officials could understand about theft, the thieves had fled with their "heavy" loot.

The bridge was constructed over the Arrah canal in 1972 at Amiyawar village which comes under Nasriganj police station. As by now, it became quite old and was declared dangerous, the local villagers were not using it, and using a concrete bridge adjoining it.

# Fake job racket busted, 5 held

Delhi Police has busted a fake job racket that used to dupe people on the pretext of providing them jobs in private airlines, and subsequently arrested five persons in this connection, an official said on Saturday.

**T**he accused were identified as Deepak a.k.a. Mama, Aniket, Sandeep, Avnendra and Pushpendra.

DCP (Crime branch) Rohit Meena said a complaint was received at Cyber North police station through National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCCRP) in which the complainant had alleged that he received a call from a person who informed that his resume had been selected for Computer Operator Job in Indigo Airlines.

Thereafter, the victim was made to talk with another person -- impersonating as an HR manager and his interview was conducted over mobile phone. After the interview, he was directed to deposit Rs 14,225 in a bank account for uniform fee, salary account activation fee, passport fee etc. Following the directions, the complainant deposited the said amount in a bank account provided

by the accused. After some time, when the complainant made a follow-up call regarding the job offer, he was told that due to some internal emergency, the company has stopped hiring. The complainant then asked to return his money but the accused switched off his mobile

phone.

Accordingly, on the basis of a complaint, the police registered an FIR under Section 420 (Cheating and dishonesty inducing delivery of property) at the Cyber North District, and an investigation was carried out.

The police team in an operation spanning two weeks finally zeroed in on the location of accused persons in a flat in Noida and with their arrests recovered 57 SIM cards, 25 mobile phones, 33 debit cards, 4 Wi-Fi routers and fake job offer letters.

Also, 13 bank accounts used to transfer money were also identified and are being scrutinised, the official said.

During interrogation, it was revealed that one of the accused persons namely Pushpendra was cheated through similar modus operandi a few years ago. Therefore, along with other accused persons hatched a plan to dupe job aspirants in the same manner to earn quick money.


The BJP on Friday said that it seems like "there is Taliban rule in the state".

## IMRAN SURVIVES!

Pakistan National Assembly's Speaker Asad Qaiser on Sunday refused to allow the members to cast their votes in the no-confidence motion despite the passage of several hours, reports said.

The Speaker, according to sources, said that since he shares a 30-year relationship with the Prime Minister, he cannot allow the voting to take place, Geo News reported.

Despite the PTI government's hectic efforts to avoid voting on the no-confidence motion against Prime Minister Imran Khan, the historic session of the National Assembly to decide his fate began on Saturday.



### Imran praises India's foreign policy

**Islamabad:** Pakistan Prime Minister Imran said he knew India better than other politicians and expressed sadness that Pakistan did not have good relations with it because of its "RSS ideology and what happened in Kashmir". He praised India's "independent" foreign policy, saying no superpower had the courage to tell the neighbouring country to change its foreign policy, Dawn news reported. "They (India) are saying they will import Russian oil because it is better for their people despite the sanctions (on Russia)." He said he had the "same problem".

### Pak govt files review plea against SC's decision

The PTI-led Pakistani government on Saturday filed a review petition against the Supreme Court's decision to restore the National Assembly and block Deputy Speaker Qasim Suri's decision to dismiss the voting on the no-confidence motion against Prime Minister Imran Khan, media reports said. The apex court's five-member bench - headed by Chief Justice Umar Atta Bandial and comprising Justice Muneeb Akhtar, Justice Ajiazul Ahsan, Justice Mazhar Alam, and Justice Jamal Khan Mandokhel - had issued the ruling. The top court had ordered National Assembly Speaker Asad Qaiser to summon the session on Saturday to allow the vote on the no-confidence motion against the Premier.

## Can't ban promise of freebies by political parties: EC to SC

The Election Commission (EC) told the Supreme Court that offering freebies either before or after elections is a policy decision of a political party, and it cannot regulate state policies and decisions taken by the parties.

In an affidavit, the EC said: "Offering/distribution of any freebies either before or after the election is a policy decision of the party concerned and whether such policies are financially viable or its adverse affect on the economic health of the state is a question that has to be considered and decided by the voters of the state."

"The Election Commission cannot regulate state policies and decisions which may be taken by the winning party when they form the government. Such an action without enabling provisions in the law, would be an overreach of powers." The EC clarified that it does not have power to deregister a political party, except on three grounds, which were outlined by the top court in case of Indian National Congress Vs Institute of Social Welfare and others (2002).

The grounds are -- registration obtained on



fraud and forgery, party ceased to have faith and allegiance to the Constitution, and any other alike ground.

The EC added that it has also made recommendations to the law ministry to enable it to exercise the power to de-register a political party and to issue necessary orders regulating registration and de-registration of political parties.

The affidavit added: "Barring political parties from promising/distributing freebies from public fund before election...may result in a situation where the parties will lose their recognition even before they display their electoral performance in the elections." The EC's response filed the affidavit in response to a PIL filed by advocate Ashwini Kumar Upadhyay.

### UK PM Johnson meets Ukrainian President Zelenskyy in Kiev



**London:** United Kingdom Prime Minister Boris Johnson met with Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy in Kiev on Saturday. Johnson said that he has travelled to Ukraine to meet President Zelenskyy in person and show solidarity with the Ukrainian people. "Today I met my friend President @ZelenskyyJa in Kyiv as a show of our unwavering support for the people of Ukraine. We're setting out a new package of financial & military aid which is a testament of our commitment to his country's struggle against Russia's barbaric campaign," Johnson tweeted. The embassy of Ukraine to the United Kingdom tweeted a picture of Boris Johnson sitting alongside Zelenskyy in an office. This visit comes as the Johnson government has announced defence aid to Ukraine with a new 100 million Euros package. ## Mumbai man, 67, confirmed as first Omicron XE case

I t's official. The first case of coronavirus variant Omicron XE has been detected in Mumbai, and confirmed by the NCDC, Delhi, officials said on Saturday.

The infectee is a 67-year-old male who had travelled from Mumbai to Gujarat's Vadodara, where he suffered from mild fever on March 12.

His samples were sent for genome sequencing tests and the results, which came out on Saturday, showed it to be Omicron XE.

He was fully vaccinated with Covishield, is totally asymptomatic and stable, and now the process to trace his contacts is currently underway.

The development comes three days after a major fiasco when a South African woman film costume designer was declared as



Omicron XE infectee, but, later the Centre denied it.

The government has said there is no cause for worry as frequent changes in the genomic structure are part of the natural life course of viruses, but advised people to exercise all precautions.

## Siddaramaiah, 63 others in K'taka get death threats

"You have been on the path of destruction. Death is very close to you. You be ready. Death might strike you in any form. Inform your family members and make arrangements for your funeral affairs," read the message.

Former Chief Minister H.D. Kumarswamy has warned the government not



to take such threats lightly. He urged the ruling BJP to provide security to progressive thinker and writer K. Veerabhadrapur and also to other writers who have opposed the government's silence on "communal polarisation" in the state.

Incidents such as the shootout of activist and writer Prof M.M. Kalburgi should not be repeated in the state, he said. The development has caused concern in the state. 

In a letter to the Maharashtra government, Union Health Secretary Rajesh Bhushan on Friday advised the state to focus on five-fold strategy - test, track, treat, vaccination and adherence to Covid-19 appropriate behaviour. In a letter to state Additional Chief Secretary Dr Deepak Vyas, Union Health Secretary Rajesh Bhushan pointed out that Maharashtra had reported 794 new cases last week, accounting for 10.9 per cent of all cases recorded across India. "The state has also seen an increase in positivity rate in the last week - from 0.39 per cent to 0.43 per cent," the letter added.

The state was advised to monitor clusters of new Covid-19 cases and told that it required to take containment measures. Also, it was asked to monitor influenza-like illness and SARI cases in all health facilities. Meanwhile, after the Centre's announcement that booster shots against Covid-19 will be available for all adults from Sunday, private hospitals are gearing up for the vaccination drive. Around 10 lakh adults are eligible for booster shots in Mumbai. The booster shots will also help private hospitals use up their unused vials.

Between 100-125 employees of the MSRTC - who are on the warpath since November 2021 - went on a rampage outside Pawar's home and later carried out a precision attack with stones and shoes, shaking the state and national polity.

The sudden attack has been blamed on "intelligence failure" by Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar, Raut and Leader of Opposition Devendra Fadnavis with demands for a probe into the role of the police and its allegedly delayed response though the media-teams had got advance tip-off and were present there in full strength.

The incident was taken note of at the highest levels including Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray while Home Minister Dilip Walse-Patil has ordered a police report into the assault. Taking no chances, the Mumbai Police have beefed up security at the homes of key dignitaries including the CM, DyCM, Transport Minister Anil Parab, the homes of the Pawar clan in Mumbai and Baramati (Pune) and other leaders.

## STRONG DOLLAR DENTS INDIA'S FOREIGN RESERVES, FOREX DOWN BY OVER \$11 BN

**Mumbai:** Global currency fluctuations, due to a rise in US dollar strength, depleted India's foreign reserve by over \$11.173 billion during the week that ended on April 1.

The foreign currency assets (FCAs), the largest component of the forex reserves, got negatively impacted due to the rising US dollar strength against other global currencies. The FCAs consist of global currencies and securities such as US treasury bonds.

As per the RBI data, the FCAs edged lower by \$10.727 billion to \$539.727 billion. India's overall forex reserves, thus, fell by \$11.173 billion to \$606.475 billion from \$617.648 billion reported for the previous week. The country's forex reserves consist of FCAs, gold reserves, SDRs, and the country's reserve position with the IMF. The value of the gold reserves also decreased by \$507 million to \$42,734 billion. While SDR value gained by \$58 million to \$18,879 billion, India's reserve position with the IMF also gained by \$4 million to \$5,136 billion.

## Maharashtra property registration probe: Clerks at helm in over 300 sub-registrar offices

**In total, more than 300 of 519 sub-registrar offices in Maharashtra don't have a sub-registrar, the IGR's office said.**

**F**ollowing the revelation that over 10,000 property documents were registered illegally in Pune district, it has now come to light that several sub-registrar offices across Maharashtra were being run by clerks. The office of the Inspector General of Registration (IGR) has confirmed that clerical staff and not high-ranking officials were running the show at more than 50 per cent of sub-registrar offices in the state.

In total, more than 300 of 519 sub-registrar offices in Maharashtra don't have a sub-registrar, the IGR's office said. Sources said that this has happened as promotions have not

been given in sub-registrar offices for years altogether. "We are taking steps to initiate the process of promotions that has been held up for years," IGR Shrawan Hardikar told media persons. Meanwhile, 11 sub-registrars in Pune district have been suspended by the state government after the IGR office found that they have reportedly registered 10,561 documents illegally. The 11 sub-registrars are among the 44 officials who have been suspended pending enquiry. "We have initiated a departmental probe against 44 officials. They are being charge-sheeted. If they accept their guilt, we will take action against them. If they refuse to accept that they are guilty, then the departmental probe against them will proceed," said Hardikar. The suspended officials allegedly registered properties in violation of the Real Estate Regulatory Act and the Maharashtra Prevention of Fragmentation of Holdings Act.

Hardikar said the state govern-

ment had launched a vigilance probe in this regard over a year ago. "This was done before I took charge as the IGR. The squad verified lakhs of documents and has found that over 10,000 were registered in violation of the two Acts," he said. Initially, four sub-registrars were suspended and now seven more have been suspended. This issue was also discussed in the state legislature. We have now come up with a resolution simplifying the rules so that people and officials can understand them before finalising any deal." "We will probe all stakeholders in this case, be it the sub-registrars, other officials, agents and advocates," he said.

The IGR said he has been regularly holding discussions with Revenue Minister Balasaheb Thorat on the issue. "Efforts are underway to make the functioning at sub-registrar offices simple, transparent and corruption-free," he said.

Lamenting that citizens often do not carry out a thorough verification

of the properties before buying them, Hardikar said, "People look for the easy way out. They do not want to carry out a proper check, nor do they want to study the rules. As a result, many of them end up with illegal properties."

Hardikar said they have now decided to list FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions) to help citizens make the right decision regarding property purchase. "We have sensitised the officials of the collectorate in this regard. The civic bodies should also play a proactive role in encouraging people to own legal properties. For instance, the gunthewari scheme launched by the government is a better way to get properties regularised. Such schemes should be promoted," he added. The official said that the trend of illegally registering property documents was not limited to Pune alone but was prevalent in other parts of the state as well. "We are verifying documents registered across the state," he said.

This was an opportunity for us to set an example for our guests, viewers and our Academy family around the world, and we fell short -- unprepared for the unprecedented." The statement also hailed comedian Chris Rock, the recipient of Smith's infamous slap. It said: "We want to express our deep gratitude to Mr Rock for maintaining his composure under extraordinary circumstances. We also want to thank our hosts, nominees, presenters and winners for their poise and grace during our telecast." Reporting on the Academy's action, 'Variety' observed: "The organisation did not have too many other options to impose, especially with Smith's membership now no longer active following his resignation."

## 'Fantastic Beasts: The Secrets of Dumbledore': Visually immersive but shallow narrative

Rooted deep in the mythology of J.K. Rowling's Wizarding World, this film is the third instalment of the five-part Harry Potter prequel.

The film takes off from where it left in the previous edition, where at the near end of the film, we discovered that Albus Dumbledore (Jude Law) had been close to Grindelwald in his youth and had made a magical blood pact preventing them from ever fighting. Earlier, Johnny Depp essayed



Grindelwald. In this edition, Mads Mikkelsen replaces him.

Set in the 1930s, Europe, the plot delves into the electoral process and its politics to choose the Supreme Head of the International Confederation of Wizards. The powerful and dark wizard, Gellert Grindelwald (Mads Mikkelsen), who is recently released from prison, is determined to stand for the election. How he plans to make the way clear for him forms the crux of the story.

In a conversation with his one-time paramour, Professor Albus

Dumbledore (Jude Law), Grindelwald makes it clear, "With or without you, I'll burn down their world Albus".

Unable to stop him alone, Albus entrusts Magizoologist Newt Scamander (Eddie Redmayne) to lead an intrepid team of wizards and witches, which includes his brother Theseus (Callum Turner), Lally (Jessica Williams), Bunty (Victoria Yeates), and one brave Muggle baker Jacob (Dan Fogler), on the dangerous mission of stopping Grindelwald.

But, "How can you confuse a

man who can see the future?" is their predicament.

You get to see, how the team encounters old and new beasts, and clashes with Grindelwald's growing legion of followers.

The plotline of the narrative is paper-thin and superfluously stretched. While the entire electoral process appears like a sham, the epic showdown lacks lustre and takes its own sweet time to unravel as there are endless subplots and character introductions that distract us. Also, most characters somehow still feel underdeveloped

even after two hours and twenty-two minutes of watching them onscreen.

With frames- merging, dissolving, morphing, and disintegrating, the film transports you to its magical world with aplomb. There are shape-shifting characters and others who walk through walls or teleport across countries.

The film has all the tropes of its Universe - fantasy adventure with some superb production design and visual effects, seldom slowing down to explain the magic spells or strategies used by its characters, but unfortunately, the novelty and sheen seem to have worn out, and the intriguing factor missing.

The only scenes that seem fresh and are enjoyable are the ones in which Jacob Kowalski is present, and apart from that, the scene where Newt rescues his brother from a species of scorpions in a panopticon-style prison tower, where they engage in a silly crab walk, you chuckle when Redmayne instructs his brother, "swivel, swivel but delicately".

The rest of the film is chaotic, with swelling music and random objects flying across the screen.

Joshna doubled joy for the Indian contingent when they upset England's Sarah-Jane Perry and Alison Waters, the second seeds, 11-9, 4-11, 11-8 in a hard-fought final. Dipika and Joshna are Commonwealth Games winners in women's doubles and were seeded third in the

event. This is the first time that India has won the World titles. Their previous best were two silver medals in 2014 and 2016. Dipika and Saurav lost in 2016 while Saurav and Ritwik Bhattacharya finished as men's doubles runners-up in 2016.
