SC: CAN ACCESS TO FREE EDUCATION, DRINKING WATER, ELECTRICITY BE TERMED FREEBIES?

IN VALID QUESTION!

The Supreme Court on Wednesday orally observed that issues raised during the hearing of petition against freebies promised by political parties during polls is getting "increasingly complicated", and whether access to free education, drinking water, electricity can be termed freebies?

A bench headed by Chief Justice N.V. Ramana orally observed that the court cannot prevent political parties from making promises. However, it added that the question is what constitutes right promises? The bench, also comprising Justices J.K. Maheshwari and Hima Kohli, further queried, "can we describe the promise of free education as a freebie? Can free drinking water, units of power, etc., be described as freebies?"

The bench said whether free electronics can be described as welfare? The concern right now is what is the right way of spending public money. "Some say money is wasted; some say it is welfare. The issue is getting increasingly complicated," said the bench, asking the parties involved in the matter to give their opinions, and after debate and discussion on the matter, the court may take a decision. The bench also cited the example of schemes such as MNREGA.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, representing the Centre, submitted, "If our understanding of social welfare is to distribute everything for free, then I am sorry to say...it is an immature understanding".

In the previous hearing, the top court had suggested constituting an expert panel comprising representatives from the central and state governments, opposition political parties, Election Commission of India, Finance Commission, Reserve Bank of India, NITI Aayog, etc.,. The top court is hearing a plea by advocate Ashwini Upadhyay seeking directions to the Centre and the Election Commission to take steps to regulate poll manifestos of political parties and also against irrational freebies promised by political parties to induce voters during polls.



'Breaking of ice is taking place', engaging with FIFA to lift AIFF suspension: Centre to SC

New Delhi: The Centre on Wednesday told the Supreme Court that it is holding talks with FIFA officials, and breaking of ice could take place soon, as the government is making all efforts to lift the suspension of All India Football Federation (AIFF), imposed by FIFA. Solicitor General

Tushar Mehta assured the top court that only government officials and authorised persons are holding discussions with FIFA officials and trying to find a way forward to resolve the crisis. Justice Chandrachud said, "Country should hold the tournament...it is a great tournament for under

17..." The bench added that efforts should be focussed on resolving the issue (suspension of AIFF by FIFA). The top court said the Central government should play a proactive role to resolve the matter to hold the tournament and also lifting of suspension of AIFF is duly facilitated.

CBI, ED PROBE AGAINST HEMANT SOREN STAYED

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Wednesday stayed the proceedings in the Jharkhand High Court on PILs filed against Chief Minister Hemant Soren, accusing him of money laundering and irregularities while granting mining leases, and also reserved its verdict on pleas filed by the state government and Soren challenging the maintainability of the PILs before the high court.

The state government and Soren had moved the top court against the high court order, which accepted the maintainability of PILs seeking ED/CBI probe against Soren.

After hearing the arguments, the top court was prima-facie of the view that neither the petitioner nor the ED could establish their case, and asked the ED why it was firing from a PIL petitioner's shoulders, if it were to have strong evidence in the matter.

INTERNAL POLITICS OR PARTY STRATEGY:

MP's dominance in BJP Parliamentary Board reduces

Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has been dropped from BJP's biggest and most powerful body, the parliamentary board and election committee. Satyanarayan Jatiya has replaced him. The Parliamentary Board had two members a year ago from the state, but now there is only one member. In such a situation, the discussion is also intensified about the loss of dominance of Madhya Pradesh. Lot of political meaning are also being extracted from this.

Notably, the Election Committee of BJP takes decisions regarding the selection of Assembly and Parliamentary candidates, the BJP Parliamentary Board takes all the major decisions of the party. It is worth mentioning here that Chouhan was made the state president of BJP before 2005 by removing Jatiya. Now Jatiya has been given a place by taking him out of the parliamentary board.

Political pundits say that there are assembly elections in Madhya Pradesh in 2023. That's why Chouhan has been given a free hand by getting him out of the parliamentary board in order to conduct state elections. On the other hand, it is also being said that Chouhan was the only Chief Minister who was included in the Parliamentary Board. In this regard, there was a voice many times to include Yogi Adityanath on the board. In such a situation, the party has also taken this decision because the party does not want to include any Chief Minister. However, it is also discussed that along with Chouhan, former BJP President and Union Minister Nitin Gadkari was also removed from the Parliamentary Board and reduced in stature. At present Chouhan is the longest-serving Chief Minister of BJP in the country.

Apart from Chouhan Thawarchand Gehlot was also a member from the Scheduled Caste category in the Board from Madhya Pradesh. Who was removed after being made the Governor of Karnataka about a year ago. Since then, only Chouhan was attending the Parliamentary Board meetings from the state. Now Satyanarayan Jatiya of the Dalit class has been given a place.

No change in ticket booking rule for children in train fare: Railways

The Railways on Wednesday clarified that there has been no change in the rule concerning booking of tickets for children travelling by train after news reports claimed that those in the age group of one to four years are now being charged adult fares.

A circular dated March 6, 2020 of the Ministry of Railways states that children under five years of age shall travel for free. However, it said that in that case, a separate berth or seat (in chair car) shall not be provided.

Passengers can, however, purchase tickets if they require berths/seats for their children who are below the age of 5 years. In that case, the full adult fare will be



charged. "There have been some recent media reports that claim that Indian Railways has changed the rule with regards to booking of tickets for children travelling in the train. These reports claim that now children between the age of one to four years will have to get a ticket for travelling on the train. On the demand of the

passengers, an option has been given to them to buy a ticket and book a berth for their under-5-year-old child if they want. And if they don't want a separate berth, then it is free, same like it used to be earlier," the statement from Railways said. Earlier, the news reports had led to angry reactions from a section.

Female teacher burnt alive dies in Jaipur hospital

Jaipur: A female teacher, who was burnt alive on August 10 at a village near Jaipur, succumbed to her injuries at the SMS Hospital here late on Tuesday night. As per sources, the incident took place at Raisar village, about 80 km from Jaipur. The victim has been identified as Anita Regar (32), who was a teacher at Veena Memorial School. At around 8 am on August 10, some miscreants surrounded Anita when she was going to the school with her six-year-old son. To save herself, Anita entered the house and dialled 100 for help. However, the police did not reach the spot. After this, the accused set Anita on fire by pouring petrol on her. As the woman kept screaming in pain, the people around her kept filming the incident instead of coming to her rescue. After battling for life for seven days in hospital, she died on Tuesday night. According to sources, Anita had reportedly lent Rs 2.5 lakh to the accused persons. When she demanded the money back, they started abusing her and even beat her up. On May 7, Anita had reportedly lodged an FIR in this matter at the Raisar police station. It is alleged that the police did not take any action, which further encouraged the accused.



Banks hike deposit rates ahead of festive season

Most banks are increasing their deposit rates for boosting deposit to support rising credit off-take as liquidity in the banking system has narrowed.

The hike in deposit rates is in line with the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) 50 basis points hike in repo rate in the August monetary policy. The rise in deposit will help banks fund the demand for loans during the festive season.

Banks' credit growth has remained in double-digits, handily outpacing the deposit growth. Whereas, credit growth continues to be driven by a low base effect, small ticket size loans, higher working capital requirements due to elevated inflation, and a shift to bank borrowings on account of high yields in the capital market.

The largest state-owned bank, State Bank of India, increased its deposit

rate by 15 basis points on deposit maturing between 180 days and 210 days from 4.40 per cent to 4.55 per cent. For all other tenures, the SBI FD interest rates have also been hiked by 15 basis points.

Indian Overseas Bank increased deposit rates by 10 basis points for 444 days and three years and above periods for the retail term deposits.

Indian Bank and Punjab National Bank have also hiked their deposit rates by 5-15 basis points.

On the other, in the private sector, HDFC Bank has increased interest rates by around 15 basis points on fixed deposits greater than Rs 5 crore in August.

ICICI Bank increased interest rates on fixed deposits of Rs 2 crore to Rs 5 crore in August.

Kotak Mahindra Bank has also increased rates by 15 basis points for select tenures for deposits up to Rs 2 crore, CareEdge data showed.

AIRLINES WILL HAVE TO TAKE ACTION AGAINST FLYERS WITHOUT MASK: DGCA

New Delhi: In light of the rising Covid cases in several parts of the country, the aviation regulator Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) on Wednesday made it mandatory for passengers to follow Covid protocols and wear masks inside the aircraft.

The regulator said that in view of the rise in the number of Covid cases, the airlines have been advised again on August 16, to strictly comply with Covid protocols inside the aircraft.

Airlines have to ensure that all passengers are wearing face masks properly and arrange for their proper sanitisation throughout the journey.

"In case a passenger does not comply with the directions, strict action will be taken by airlines against the passenger," said the regulator.

Why Covid infection tally goes up and down, experts project true picture

India reported a significant rise at 20,551 new Covid infections on August 5. However, the next day the tally declined to 19,406 cases and again to 18,738 on another day. India had 14,917 Covid cases on August 15. The next day on August 16, there was a marginal rise at 15,040 cases. The cases sharply declined to 9,062 cases August 17.

Amid the new scare of monkeypox, Covid cases are seeing a rise and fall on a daily basis at the national level. However, experts believe that this may not be the real picture to ascertain the present Covid condition in India.

"The virus is mutating and when the virus mutates, it may not be the same strain which caused the havoc like

situation. There may be another strain too in circulation. We need genome sequencing at regular intervals so we could find out what strain is currently in circulation. We have to keep a watch on the data from sequencing", Dr Sunila Garg, Member Lancet Commission and Covid-19 Task Force, told correspondent.

She told correspondent that accordingly, the vaccine could be made as per the new circu-

lating strain, because if we are vaccinated and the virus has mutated differently, the vaccine could not provide enough protection from the new strain. When we do not have the vaccine against circulating vaccines, we are not fully protected.

"As per the recent data of genome sequencing on August 1, out of total sequenced data, around 40 per cent were BA.2, 19 per cent BA.2.1.2, 30 per cent

BA.2.75. And all three strains are transmissible. However, to know the true picture of the actual current condition of Covid infection, one day data of rise and decline is not enough. At least, a data of seven days will make the true picture of Covid. However, because of the low number of tests due to August 15 and other festive occasions, the tally seems to be declining," Dr Garg told correspondent on the question of recent ups

TN GOVT SCHOOL HEAD MISTRESS REFUSES TO HOIST TRICOLOUR ON I-DAY

Chennai: A controversy has erupted in Tamil Nadu after reports of a government school headmistress allegedly refusing to hoist the national flag and salute it on Independence Day.

The woman named Tamil Selvi, a government school Headmistress in Dharmapuri district, did not hoist the national flag stating that she was a Christian and that her religious beliefs do not allow her to hoist and salute the national flag.

In a video recording justifying her act, she said that being a Yehova Christian, her religious belief allows her to salute only God. She, however, added that she does not disrespect the flag and said that she had arranged for the Assistant Headmistress to hoist the flag.

The headmistress did not attend the flag hoisting ceremony last year also and had taken sick leave.



DELHI HC EXPRESSES CONCERN OVER RAMDEV'S STATEMENT ON BIDEN, BOOSTER DOSE

The Delhi High Court on Wednesday expressed concern over a recent statement of yoga expert Ramdev on the Covid-19 vaccine efficacy pointing out that US President Joe Biden tested positive for the virus despite taking a booster dose.

"People are being named here. It can have international consequences for our relations, country's relations with foreign countries. World leaders are being named which will affect our good relations with them," Justice Anup Jairam Bhambhani orally remarked.

The court was dealing with a suit filed by several doctors' associations alleging Ramdev's public statement affects them as Coronil does not cure coronavirus and it is misleading. The bench also observed that the



public at large must not be misled by making statements against allopathy. "You are welcome to have your fol-

lowers, you're welcome to have your disciples, who will believe whatever you say. But please do not mislead

the public at large by saying what is more than what..." Justice Bhambhani said.

Senior advocate Akhil Sibal, who represented the doctors' associations, argued that Patanjali's Coronil product was claimed as a cure for Covid without any license. The matter will be further heard on August 23.

In the last hearing also, Sibal had said that the Patanjali website content claims that Coronil is a treatment for Covid-19.

According to an earlier complaint of the Indian Medical Association (IMA), Ramdev has allegedly been propagating false information on social media platforms against medicines being used by the medical fraternity, the Indian government, the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), and other frontline organisations involved in the treatment of Covid patients.

Nitish Kumar says not aware of legal status of law minister, BJP seeks his sacking

While Bihar's law minister Kartikeya Singh alias Kartik Master is facing charges of kidnapping and a warrant has been issued against him by the district court, Bihar chief minister Nitish Kumar said that he was not aware of the legal status of Singh.

Singh took the oath of a cabinet minister on Tuesday and Nitish Kumar allotted him the law ministry portfolio.

Kumar said: "The matter did not come into my cognizance. I was not aware of the warrant issued by the court."

Singh was booked in a case of kidnapping in 2014 in Bihta police station. His anticipatory bail plea was rejected by the Danapur district court and the Patna High Court. The Danapur district court issued an arrest warrant against Singh in the first week of August and he was asked to surrender before a court or in a police station by August 16. Instead of doing this, he took the oath of cabinet minister in the Bihar government on August 16.

This development has given a burning issue to the BJP leaders who are attacking the Nitish Kumar government.

Sushil Kumar Modi, Rajya Sabha MP of the



BJP said: "Nitish Kumar government should sack the law minister who is a fugitive person and the court has issued an arrest warrant against him. It is shocking that he, instead of surrendering in court, went to Raj Bhavan and took the oath of cabinet minister."

"Kartikeya Singh was given the law ministry portfolio to work on the wiping out of criminal cases in which RJD leaders were involved. The Jungle Raj of Lalu Yadav has returned to Bihar," Modi added.

Kashmiri Pandit employees protest, demand relocation

Kashmiri Pandit government employees carried out a protest on Wednesday in J&K's Jammu city demanding relocation from the Valley in the aftermath of the killing of another member of the community. Protesters gathered in the

busy Bikram Chowk disrupting the traffic. The Kashmiri Pandit employees recruited under the Prime Minister's special rehabilitation package and posted in different parts of the Valley said they have become soft targets for the militants and the government has failed to protect them. "We were employed in

the Valley under a special package, but everyone is aware about the situation there. We want our relocation to Jammu so that we can at least remain alive," protesters said.

Senior police officers later pacified the protesters after which traffic was restored in the area.

KEJRIWAL LAUNCHES 'MAKE INDIA NO. 1' MISSION

Delhi Chief Minister and Aam Aadmi Party National Convener Arvind Kejriwal on Wednesday launched 'Make India No. 1' mission to make the country lead on all parameters.

Kejriwal said: "We have to make India the number 1 nation in the world once again. We have to make India great again. We are beginning a national mission called 'Make India No. 1' today. Every citizen of this country, 130 crore people have to be connected to this mission."

"Citizens need to come together to make India great again. It has been 75 years since we got Independence and we have achieved many things, but there is an anger among citizens that many small nations that got freedom after us have moved ahead of us," said the AAP Convener.

"Why did India lag behind? Every citizen is asking this," he added, giving



example that Singapore got independence 15 years after India, and that Japan and Germany were destroyed in World War II.

Kejriwal went on to say that "If we leave this to these parties and leaders, India will go back 75 more years as some of them love the family and some love their friends." He further urged BJP, Congress, and other political parties to join AAP's national mis-

sion, saying that everyone needs to come together for it.

Delhi CM said that people of India are the best people, "yet we were left behind." "We are not short of anything, we 130 crore people will now have to come together and take over the reins of the country," he added.

While counting the parameters, he said that we have to make arrangements for good and free education for

27 crore children. "We cannot say that schools cannot be opened in hills or tribal areas. Whatever money will be spent, we have to do it," he added.

Secondly, he said: "We have to make arrangements of free and good treatment for all."

Third, "Our youth power is the biggest strength. Employment will have to be arranged for each and every youth." "Fourth thing, every woman should get respect. The Right to safety and equality should be given to them."

"And finally, today the farmer's son does not want to become a farmer. Such a system will have to be made that farmers get full price for their crop and the son of the farmer must have a sense of pride to become farmers," Kejriwal said.

"Today I appeal to 130 crore people to join this national mission. We have nothing to do with any party, this is not a mission of any party," said AAP national Convener.

Raj minor's death case: Sachin Pilot questions his own govt

Raising questions on the police, administration and his own government in the case of the death of a child due to thrashing by teacher, former deputy Chief Minister Sachin Pilot has demanded the removal of Jalore's Additional District Magistrate and Deputy Superintendent of Police on charges of lathicharging and snatching the phone of the victim's family members.

Pilot met the relatives of the deceased child in Surana on Tuesday. He said, "As far as this incident is concerned, it is insufficient to say that it happens in other states. If this happens to Dalits, Adivasis, then we need to bring zero-tolerance. We cannot say that if it is happening in other states, it is happening here too."

Pilot said, "We have to take some steps to defeat the mentality which oppresses the downtrodden. In the minds of the downtrodden, we have



to make them believe that one cannot escape after committing atrocities against Dalits."

He said, "Should such an incident happen to anyone, we should speak against injustice. Today the govern-

ment is ours, we cannot escape the responsibility. It's been 75 years since Independence.

"The government should work to replace the shortcomings in the system. The government's trust should remain. It should be in the mind of the underprivileged that if anyone wrongs them, they will have to face the consequences.

"Wherever there have been atrocities against any poor, downtrodden, helpless, we have gone there. No one should have such courage in future to repeat the act, we are all in responsible positions. Together we will win the trust of the people. Now that child is gone, he will not come back, but we can set an example by taking action."

After meeting the victim's family members, Pilot said that even today this family was living in an atmosphere of fear. "It is the responsibility of the government to protect their lives and property in future and we hope that the government will protect them."

Six bodies recovered from two houses in Jammu's posh area

Jammu and Kashmir Police recovered six dead bodies from two houses on Wednesday in J&K's Jammu district.

While the exact cause of their death was being investigated, the police said that the bodies recovered from the Sidhra locality of Jammu city were found in a semi-decomposed condition.

Police said the bodies were recovered from two houses in the posh Tawi Vihar residential area of Sidhra in Jammu.

"All the deceased belong to Kashmir and their families have been intimidated.

"An SIT is likely to be constituted to investigate the case," police said, adding that the bodies have been sent to the mortuary of the govern-



ment medical college hospital in Jammu.

A doctor at the medical college told some reporters that all these dead bodies had a drip line attached with them adding that what caused their death would be known after the post-mortem. Police said the post-

mortem would be conducted after the family members of the deceased reach Jammu.

The dead bodies have been identified as Sakina Begum and her daughter Naseema, Rubina Bano, Zafar Ali, Noor-ul-Habib and Sajad Ahmad. Further details are awaited.

AZAD QUILTS HOURS AFTER NAMED AS CONG'S J&K CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE HEAD

New Delhi: Senior Congress leader Ghulam Nabi Azad quit as J&K campaign committee head after being named by the party and has conveyed his decision to the party leadership, sources close to him said. However, there is no official word from both sides.

Azad's resignation has come to surprise for many in the party as it was considered that he was consulted in the key appointments and was active in party forums. He even took part in Congress Gaurav Yatra on Monday and had addressed a press conference when Sonia Gandhi was called to ED.

Azad has been upset since being ignored for Rajya Sabha after he retired as Leader of Opposition in the upper house. He is one of the prominent leaders of the party G-23 group which demanded sweeping reforms in the party. The issue has come on fore when the party is to begin process of electing new president.

The party has appointed the office bearers of J&K state unit, in which Vikar Rasul Wani was made the state president. The post had fallen vacant after Ghulam Ahmad Mir stepped down as the JKPC president. Wani is a loyalist of former Chief Minister Azad.

Odisha: 400 DLs suspended, 77 vehicles seized for violating traffic norms

The transport authorities in Odisha suspended 400 driving licenses, issued 2,073 challans and seized 77 vehicles for riding motorcycles without helmets during the last 24 hours, an official said on Wednesday.

The state transport authority (STA) has launched a statewide special drive against riding motorized two-wheelers without wearing helmets on national and state highways on August 16 and it will continue till August 30.

On the first day of the special drive, a total of 2,073 e-challans were issued, and Rs 4.30 lakh fine collected from the violators, the official said.

Sanjay Biswal, Joint Commissioner, transport (road safety) said the main aim of this drive is to create a sense of responsibility among the road users for prevention of road accidents and fatalities.

It has been observed that out of the accidents taking place on national and state highways, many are related to two-wheeler riders. Helmet-less driving is a major cause of road accidents and grievous injury across Odisha, he said.



"Due to continuous enforcement activities people are using helmets in the urban areas but are unfortunately avoiding wearing helmets on highways where protection is much more needed," said the joint commissioner.

Biswal appealed to the two-wheeler riders and pillion riders to follow the traffic rules and wear helmets for their safety.

As many as 1,308 persons, including riders (868) and pillion riders (440) of motorised two wheelers, were killed in road accidents in the year 2021.

Most of them were not wearing helmets.

Similarly, a total of 1,280 persons were grievously injured and 747 had minor injuries in accidents involving two wheelers, he added.

Mysterious posters of 'new-look' Trinamool flood parts of Kolkata

Kolkata: The people in certain pockets of south Kolkata, especially around Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee's residence in the Kalighat area, were greeted with 'mysterious' posters and hoardings on Wednesday morning.

The posters and hoardings carrying only the picture of Abhishek Banerjee, the CM's nephew and Trinamool Congress' national general secretary, claimed that the party will emerge with a new look just as people want within the next six months.

Surprisingly, the posters did not carry the picture of Mamata Banerjee, a phenomenon unheard of since the inception of Trinamool in 1998.

While the posters were removed soon, by then speculations started doing the rounds as to whether the Trinamool in its 'new look' will have Abhishek Banerjee at the helm of affairs, replacing Mamata Banerjee.

Trying to downplay the incident, Trinamool spokesman Kunal Ghosh said, "It is quite possible that



some party followers may have put up such posters and hoardings based on some recent comments by Abhishek Banerjee. There is nothing to speculate about it.

"Mamata Banerjee continues to be the supreme leader of Trinamool Congress, in which Abhishek Banerjee is the general. Trinamool in the new format means spearheading the party in a more disciplined and systematic manner." However, opposition

leaders in the state have started taking jibes at the development.

Deora was addressing a workshop focused on "Methodology and calculation for preparation of estimates of Gross Domestic Product of Madhya Pradesh" by the Planning, Economics and Statistics Department at the Academy of Administration on Wednesday.

Deora said that sectoral accounting statistics has an important role in the industry group-wise analysis of the state's economy. Estimates of State Domestic Product are an important indicator for evaluating the level of economy and development of the social and economic sector of the state. Data is the solid basis for the control of a strong economy and the implementation of developmental plans. He also appreciated the innovative efforts of the department.

Deora said that on the basis of state's Gross State Domestic Product (GDP) at constant rate (year 2011-12) is estimated at Rs. 5 lakh 64 thousand



514 crore in the year 2020-21 as compared to Rs. 5 lakh 75 thousand 554 crore in the year 2019-20, while on the basis of advance estimates, the Gross State Domestic Product is estimated to be 6 lakh 21 thousand 653 crore in the year 2021-22 with a growth of 10.12 percent.

Deora said that the Gross State Domestic Product showing an increase of 4.01 percent at the prevailing prices has been estimated to be Rs. 9 lakh 76 thousand 281 crore in the year 2020-21 as compared to Rs. 9 lakh 38 thousand 602 crore in

the year 2019-20. According to the advance estimates for the year 2021-22, with an increase of 19.74 percent, it is estimated to be Rs. 11 lakh 96 thousand 4 crore.

Deora said that for the year 2020-21, the per capita income in Madhya Pradesh is Rs. 58 thousand 334 at a constant rate (year 2011-12). The per capita income has been estimated to increase from Rs. 1 lakh 3 thousand 103 in the year 2019-20 to Rs 1 lakh 4 thousand 894 in the year 2020-21 at the prevailing prices, showing an increase of 1.74 percent. On the basis

of advance estimates, the per capita income for the year 2021-22 has been estimated at Rs.63 thousand 345 and Rs.1 lakh 24 thousand 685 respectively at constant/prevaling prices.

Principal Secretary Planning, Economics and Statistics Mukesh Chandra Gupta said that the statistics officers should pay attention to the quality of data, because the real progress of major departments like education and health is known only on the basis of data. He said that soon the activities of the Statistics Department would be done online.

MP Forest staff surrender weapons protesting unilateral action by senior staff

In an unprecedented incident, disgruntled with alleged 'unilateral action' against their colleagues, hundreds of forest officials, including guards and rangers, surrendered their weapons at their respective offices in different parts of Madhya Pradesh.

The step of surrendering weapons, which was first started by the forest employees deployed in Vidisha district, was soon extended support by forest officials from many other districts. One after another, forest officials started reaching out to their respective offices and surrendered their weapons before their seniors. The move was part of their protest against alleged 'unilateral action' against a forest team involved in an incident at Lateri in Vidisha district where a tribal man was killed in alleged firing. Many forest employees even reached the office of Madhya Pradesh Forest Minister Vijay Shah to surrender their weapons.

Following the incident, Vidisha district police had registered a case of murder against eight members of the forest team, though most remained unnamed. One of the named officers Deputy Ranger Nirmal Ahirwara had been arrested on August 12, though he claimed that he was not present on the spot. Associates of the deceased man claimed that the forest patrol team fired indiscriminately at them on August 9 evening near Katiyapura forest beat in Lateri, killing Chyan Singh and injuring three others of Raipura village. The forest employees had however claimed that the firing was in self-defence after stones were hurled at them by the men who were involved in timber smuggling, which is rampant in the area. Videos showing alleged timber theft and smuggling had been circulated on social media.

Later, a judicial probe was also ordered into the incident following directives of Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan and a compensation of Rs 25 lakh was announced for the family of Rhan Singh. A compensation of Rs five lakh each was announced for the injured

persons. Later, six more Raipura locals had claimed that they were also injured in the alleged firing.

Vidisha Divisional Forest Officer, Rajbir Singh had been transferred on August 11 as a fallout of the incident.

Resentment was brewing among the forest staff and many employees in Lateri had left their homes with families to avoid police action. The weapon surrender was reportedly called by State Forest Range Officers Gazetted Association of Madhya Pradesh, sources told IANS. Atul Kushwaha, President of the Vidisha unit of Forest and Wildlife Protection Employees Association, said that forest staff across the state had surrendered weapons in protest of unilateral action in the form of arrests of forest patrol team members in the Lateri incident. "What is use of these weapons, if we cannot fire a gunshot even for self-defence. Therefore, we have decided to surrender the weapons," Kushwaha added.

The employees' association has said that the Madhya Pradesh Forest Department has neither declared the armed forest staff as 'armed forces' nor is there any clear protocol for protection of the armed staff under the section 197 of CrPc. Later, the Forest Minister said that he will discuss the issue with Shivraj Singh Chouhan during their meeting on Wednesday. However, the forest employees continued to deposit their weapons in different parts of the state on Wednesday as well.

In a discussion with the forest workers, Shah said, "There is no need to be disappointed with the developments. I believe the protection of the forest is not based on the strength of guns." The Minister added that the rights of rangers and other forest employees will also be increased. "They say the security of an open forest can't be ensured by relying on 2,000 forest workers. Now, the members of forest committees will be entrusted with the responsibility of security. An outline will be made regarding this," Shah said.

Woman poisons husband with help of 'lover'

A mother of three murdered her husband by poisoning him with help of her lover in Morena district.

A tale of crime weaved within the branches of an illicit affair and jealousy was unwrapped in Morena district where a 28-year-old woman poisoned her husband with the help of her 'lover'. The prime accused, a mother of three children, allegedly admitted to the heinous crime committed in cold blood in front of the village panchayat as well.

The incident took place on July 20 and despite almost a month having passed since the 'confession' by the accused, she has not been arrested. This prompted the victim's family to approach the SP of the district seeking justice for the murder of their kin. According to a report in Bhashkar, the accused, identified as Seema,

had given in writing to the village panchayat that she had given poison to her husband on the suggestion of her lover. She also wrote that it was the man with whom she was in an extramarital affair with who supplied her with the poison.

However, police say that the accused cannot be arrested till the viscera report is received from the forensic laboratory. The victim's family had registered a complaint against Seema on July 21 and stated that the woman had confessed to murdering her husband by giving him water mixed with the poison. It was also alleged that the accused had met Dishant five years ago and they fell in love. Subsequently, Dishant bought her a phone which she used to be in touch with him and to keep her husband, Rajesh, in the dark.

All the patriots there were very furious with the death sentence given to revolutionaries like Khudiram Bose, Kanhai Lal Dutta, Satinder Pal and Kashi Ram. As a result, Madanlal Dhingra fired shots at Sir William Hutt Curzon Wylie at the annual festival of the Indian National Association. After hearing in the case of Madanlal Dhingra in July, 1909, he was hanged by the British Government on August 17, 1909.

NASSCOM WILL UPSKILL ENGINEERING AND POLYTECHNIC STUDENTS

Bhopal: In order to improve the placement scenario for engineering graduates of the state, the Department of Technical Education in collaboration with NASSCOM has decided to enhance the skills of engineering and polytechnic students from the academic session 2022-23. The valid data will be uploaded on the skill prime platform of the future by the DTEMP Group on September 3. NASSCOM will start the Sign Up Orientation-Session (Physical/Virtual) on 5th September.

Near-Catastrophe At Karam Dam Brings Tender Scam In Focus Again

Karam Dam, at the centre of a near-catastrophe after cracks earlier this week, has been in the headlines for leaks earlier too of public money, that is. Its part-collapse after heavy rain brings back into focus the e-tendering scam that is being investigated for four years and counting.

The scam took place allegedly during the previous BJP governments. The Congress that came to power in 2019, only to lose it in 15 months after a BJP-backed mutiny had listed it among the many "wrongdoings" of Shivraj Singh Chouhan's multiple tenures.

In 2018 media reported about the tampering of the online system, at which the then BJP government ordered a probe ahead of the assembly polls. But a police case was registered only a year later, under the Congress's Kamal Nath-led government. He pegged the losses at Rs 3,000 crore.

It could be higher. The system has been in place since 2014, which means the scam's shadow runs over scores of tenders for nearly Rs 3 lakh crore. The probe hasn't progressed much ever since Shivraj Singh Chouhan managed to topple the Congress government in March 2020. The police have booked officials of some companies which were awarded the tenders. Two IT companies carrying out the work have also been blamed.

The closest that cops have come to touching anyone political is when they arrested two private secretaries of senior minister Narottam Mishra, who held the Water Resources port-



folio in the past. But the secretaries, who got bail, remain posted with him. He has denied any connection with the scam and said in the past, "They started the game. We will finish it," in a cryptic reference to the Congress.

The Rs 304-crore, much-delayed Karam Dam project in Dhar district is among those being probed, the state government has acknowledged in the assembly.

This contract was first awarded to a Gujarat-based company, but was cancelled after the scam came to light. A Delhi firm then got the tender. Work began in August 2018. It was to be completed in three years, meaning August last year.

Delay aside, something odd happened at the outset, when the Delhi firm hired another firm from Gwalior for a part of the work. This Gwalior firm took this up for Rs 99.86 crore 14 per cent lower than what the Delhi firm had quoted to

the state, meaning that the government overpaid. And that was just about a third of the total work. That, too, was washed away earlier this week. Project insurance may save the contractor from utter loss, though. People from 18 villages had to be shifted out after the dam developed cracks on August 11. It could not handle the water in its reservoir. After channels were dug to release the water, danger to lives was averted, but a portion of the dam was washed away.

Other such, smaller incidents have happened with alarming frequency. Last year, bridges and culverts worth Rs 35 crore were washed away due to heavy rain. These had been built within the last three years. More recently, a part of the Begumganj-Haidargarh bridge caved in on Monday. The Rajghat dam on the state's border with Uttar Pradesh has deteriorated awaiting inauguration. Neither state paid the

Rs 50 crore needed for finishing. For the Karam cracks, the government has formed an investigation team. Yet, the larger question of corruption remains.

Water Resources Minister Tulsi Silavat said, "There's no truth in the allegation that BJP leaders are close to the Delhi company building the dam. It does not matter who was here before me. I just know will not spare the guilty, even if they belong to our party. I want the truth to be out in the e-tendering scam."

Congress leader Kamal Nath has visited the villages that were in danger due to the Karam Dam crack. "There is termite of corruption in the whole state - from panchayat to the ministries," he alleged. "This was the first heavy rain of the season, and they had to do this drama of making channels to release the pressure. Who knows how many dams, bridges and culverts will explode."

ACTIVIST WHO OPPOSED MP GOVT'S BULLDOZER ACTION HELD UNDER NSA

Bhopal: An activist, who was vocal against the bulldozer drive of the Madhya Pradesh government following communal violence in Khargone, has been arrested under the National Security Act (NSA).

Zaid Khan, a resident of Indore, was arrested in Khargone on Monday for allegedly spreading hatred among the communities, disrupting communal harmony, inciting religious sentiments and posting objectionable posts on social media. Indore district administration claimed that "Khan has been involved in several criminal activities before 2021. He (Khan) was deliberately disrupting communal harmony with his relentless posts on social media". Two FIRs have been lodged against Khan, accusing him of disrupting social harmony and inciting Muslims with his hate speeches. One FIR has been lodged in Indore and the other in Khargone district. Notably, Khan was one of those who had criticised the BJP-led Madhya Pradesh government's bulldozer drive in Khargone after a communal clashes broke out there in March this year. The communal violence had erupted after a group of Muslims had attacked a Ram Navami procession on March 10. After the clashes, the administration had imposed curfew in the area. Later, several houses were bulldozed during a drive against illegal encroachment.


Ram temple: Winning saga for BJP in 2024 Election

N.Korea fires 2 cruise missiles: Seoul official

North Korea test-fired two cruise missiles toward the Yellow Sea on Wednesday, a South Korean military official said, as President Yoon Suk-yeol held a press conference to mark the 100th day since taking office. "(The military) has detected two cruise missiles launched by North Korea from Onchon, South Pyongan Province, into the Yellow Sea early this morning," the official said without providing further details, including the exact type of missiles and time of the firing. South Korean and US intelligence authorities are conducting a related analysis, with the allies maintaining a firm readiness posture, Yonhap News Agency quoted the official as saying. In his Liberation Day speech two days ago, Yoon laid out the details of his "audacious initiative" meant to



help the North improve its economy in the event it takes denuclearization steps. The North's first known launch of a cruise missile since January also came a day after South Korean and American military troops kicked off preliminary drills just ahead of the start of their annual combined Ulchi Freedom Shield (UFS) exercise. While the North is banned from making launches using ballistic missile technologies under U. Security Council resolutions, such a firing of a cruise missile is not in violation of them.

After the improvement of the situation Wickremesinghe sees no necessity to extend the measure, the presidential office said in a statement. The state of emergency gives broad powers to security forces to make arrests, reports dpa news agency. It has been in effect for a month and is officially due to end this Thursday. Amid the ongoing economic crisis, Sri Lanka witnessed months of widespread protests against the government and storming of several key buildings last month which eventually led to the resignation of former president Gotabaya Rajapaksa. Wickremesinghe was picked as his successor in a parliamentary vote on July 20. He has in part addressed shortages of gas and fuel and restored some political stability, and the protests have recently largely fizzled out. Sri Lanka still faces an unprecedented economic crisis and is currently negotiating with the International Monetary Fund (IMF) to secure a bailout package.



Faisalabad men force girl to lick shoes, chop her hair over refusal to marry friend's father

Faisalabad | Agencies

In a ghastly incident in Pakistan's Faisalabad, a teenager was tortured, humiliated and sexually harassed for refusing to marry an older man, who is the father of her friend, media reports said. A video of the abuse that took place on August 9 surfaced on Wednesday morning and went viral on social media. In the video, the girl could be seen being tortured while a woman's voice can be heard in the background. The culprits made the victim lick shoes, her hair was chopped and eyebrows shaved. The victim said that her friend's father, a factory owner, was forcing her to marry him but when she refused, she was abused, harassed and filmed. She said that her friend also encouraged her to accept the proposal, Geo News reported. Taking note of the matter, the police



registered a case and arrested six people, including the prime suspect (her friend's father) and a female household staff member. The suspects will be presented before a magistrate in court. Earlier, the police had reportedly said that the arrested suspects included the prime suspect's wife as well, who is reportedly the woman behind the voice in the video. Later, a separate case was registered against the prime suspect at the Khurrianwala Police Station in Faisalabad, after liquor and weapons were found in his house.

PAK MAKES CURRENCY DECLARATION BY ALL INT'L PASSENGERS MANDATORY

Islamabad: The Pakistan government has made currency declaration by all international passengers mandatory, as part of the measures taken to curb money laundering to fulfil the condition of the Financial Action Task Force (FATF), according to a notification issued by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA). The notification came as an FATF team was expected to arrive in Pakistan next month for "on-site" visit to verify steps taken by Islamabad to curb money laundering and terror financing, The Express Tribune reported. A successful on-site visit would pave the way for Pakistan getting out of the FATF grey list. The CAA issued the notification on the instructions of the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR). The notification said that a declaration form would have to be filled and handed over to the airline staff, in which the passenger would show details of domestic and foreign currency. No international passenger would be able to board the flight or leave the airport without submitting the declaration, it said.

Palestinian President sparks outrage with Holocaust accusation against Israel

Visiting Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas sparked outrage when he accused Israel of committing a "Holocaust" against Palestinians during a joint press conference here with German Chancellor Olaf Scholz. During the joint press conference on Tuesday, Abbas said that "Israel has committed 50 massacres in 50 Palestinian locations since 1947" and added "50 massacres, 50 Holocausts", reports news agency. Abbas' remarks were in response to a journalist who asked whether he would apologise to Israel on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the attack by Palestinian terrorists on the Israeli team during the 1972 Olympics in Munich, which



resulted in the death of 10 Israeli athletes and coaches as well as one German police officer. Scholz listened to the statements with a look of alarm and annoyance, but did not offer an immediate reply. His spokesperson Steffen Hebestreit declared the news conference over immediately after Abbas' answer, which had been previously announced as the last question. Hebestreit said afterwards that Scholz was outraged by Abbas' statements.



MAHA LEGISLATURE SESSION: OPPN GREETES CM SHINDE WITH CHANTS OF '50 KHOKE, VERY OK' AND 'TRAITOR'

The ruling combine of Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) Deputy CM Devendra Fadnavis got a taste of the Opposition Nationalist Congress Party, Congress and Shiv Sena's dark mood on the opening day of the Monsoon Session of Maharashtra Legislature here on Wednesday.

A majority of the Opposition leaders and legislators staged a vociferous protest on the steps of the Vidhan Bhavan, carrying posters and placards, condemning and criticising the government at the start of its maiden legislature test.

As soon as the CM and other Shinde Group MLAs started trooping in, the Opposition legislators greeted them with full-throated rants of - "50 khoke (Rs 50-crore), Ekdam OK" and "Aala Re, Aala Re, Gaddaar Aala (Here comes the traitor)". The opponents were alluding to the alleged suspicions of horse-trading value of each legislator who walked out in June that culminated in the toppling of the Maha Vikas Aghadi government headed by former CM Uddhav Thackeray on June



29, with Shinde-Fadnavis taking the oath on June 30.

They also raised slogans condemning the regime, 'ED Sarkar,

Hai Hai' (Eknath-Devendra duo) and 'Gaddaar Sarkar, Hai Hai', as the Shinde Group and BJP legislators walked by. The aggressive agi-

tion follows the Opposition's boycott of the customary session-eve tea-party hosted by Shinde Tuesday evening.

Treachorous govt of Shinde-Fadnavis will crash soon: Aditya Thackeray

Setting the Opposition tone for the Monsoon Session of Maharashtra Legislature, Shiv Sena leader and former minister Aditya Thackeray predicted that "the treacherous government of (Chief Minister) Eknath Shinde and (Deputy CM) Devendra Fadnavis will collapse soon," here on Wednesday.

Interacting with the media, Thackeray Jr. said the Opposition is pitted against the "killers of democracy, and this illegal government of dishonesty will definitely come down".

"It's an unconstitutional regime, illegal from the start, consisting of dishonest traitors..." said Thackeray sharply, ahead of the session.

Referring to the inciteful statement by a Shinde Group MLA Prakash Surve of Mumbai and the slapping of a canteen manager by Hingoli MLA Santosh Bangar, he said that these are acts of 'cowards' and the people of the state will show them their place.

Thackeray rued that such threatening language is happening in our Maharashtra which is "not acceptable to the people" and wondered "who is really the Chief Minister". "Goons have no place in Maharashtra politics... If MLAs, who threaten people are walking around freely, then you can guess what will happen to the law and order situation in the state," he added.

Dwelling on the recent cabinet expansion by CM Shinde, which has caused much heart-burns among the Shinde Group MLAs,



Thackeray said it has "not included the independents or smaller parties supporting it, there is no representation to women and even a Mumbaikar is not taken on board".

"In such a situation, nobody is concerned about the voice of the farmers or the women... They are more worried about what they got (cabinet portfolios) or what they didn't get," Thackeray pointed out.

He claimed that even the first lot of Shiv Sena legislators who walked over to the Shinde Group in June were not taken in the cabinet, implying that loyalty does not count for them.

The son of former CM Uddhav Thackeray reiterated that "this government will topple" and many of the MLAs, who left Shiv Sena, will return to the party-fold soon.

Sukesh Chandrasekhar 200-crore money laundering case

ED to submit a charge sheet against Jacqueline Fernandez: Reports

The Enforcement Directorate will submit a charge sheet against Jacqueline Fernandez in the Sukesh Chandrasekhar 200-crore money laundering case. The actress may not be detained right now because the court has yet to take cognizance of the charge sheet, but she may be barred from leaving the country. It is also claimed that the actress communicated with Sukesh while he was imprisoned. For this topic, ETimes contacted Jacqueline's team.

The ED has already questioned Jacqueline multiple times. The actress told authorities that she had been in contact with Sukesh Chandrasekhar since 2017 and that the common claimed to be a member of late Jayalalithaa's family. "I

have been speaking to Sukesh since February 2017. In August 2021, he was arrested, after which I never met him. He told me that he is the owner of Sun TV and from the political family of Jayalalithaa." According to a leading news portal, Jacqueline alerted the ED about the charge sheet. The actress further stated that her sister got a \$150,000 loan from Chandrasekhar and acknowledged that he transferred roughly Rs 15 lakh to her brother's account in Australia. The ED had already attached Jacqueline's assets worth Rs 7 crore. Among the luxurious items Jacqueline got were diamond earrings, bracelets, Birkin bags, Louis Vuitton shoes, and a Mini Cooper automobile.

Several personal images of Jacqueline and Sukesh were posted online during this incident, fueling

speculation that the two were in a relationship. Chandrasekhar had issued a handwritten statement confirming their romance and claimed, "As I have mentioned before, Jacqueline and I were in a relationship. Seeing each other and the relationship was not based on any kind of monetary benefits like the way it is protected, commented and trolled in a bad light. The relationship had lots of love and respect for each other, without any expectations." The pricey presents allegedly included Gucci and Chanel luxury bags, two Gucci gym clothes, a pair of Louis Vuitton shoes, two pairs of diamond earrings, and two Hermes bracelets.

According to reports, Jacqueline's legal team will file a counter-charge claiming that the actress was unaware she was the recipient of extortion money.

Rupee's upside may limit on corporate outflows; local unit ends 22 paise up

The Indian rupee has appreciated 22 paise on Wednesday to close at 79.44 against the US dollar on easing Brent crude oil prices and uptick in domestic equities.

But, further appreciation of rupee can be capped by the corporate outflows lined up in this week.

At the interbank foreign exchange market, rupee ended at 79.44 as against 79.66 close on the previous trading session on Friday against the US dollar.

Indian financial markets were closed on August 15 and 16 on account of Independence day and Parsi New year.

"USD INR spot closed 20 paise lower at 79.44. Fall in oil prices and higher global equity markets helped Rupee to gain against US Dollar. FPI flows have been persistently positive and that is positive for Rupee. However, there are corporate outflows lined up over this week and that can limit down-



side in USD INR. Over the near term we expect a range of 79 and 80 on spot," said Anindya Banerjee, VP, Currency Derivatives & Interest Rate Derivatives at Kotak Securities Ltd. Brent crude oil prices which were trading at \$98 a barrel on Friday has eased to \$92.04 per barrel. Crude oil prices in the international market has fallen due to disappointing China's economic data that forced China's central bank to hike lending rates. The prices on crude continue its fall on Tuesday too, but by afternoon trade it rose. Meanwhile, Sensex ended up 417.92

points or 0.70 per cent at 60,260.13, and Nifty ended 119.00 points or 0.67 per cent higher at 17,944.25. About 2,019 shares have advanced, 1,405 shares declined and 132 remained unchanged.

Vinayak Mete's death: Maharashtra CID to probe accident

Following a clamour from various quarters, the Maharashtra government on Wednesday ordered a CID inquiry into the death of prominent Maratha leader Vinayak Mete in a road accident on August 14.

Taking cognizance of the matter, Chief Minister Eknath Shinde has directed the Director-General of Police to initiate measures for the CID probe into the accident three days ago.

Mete, 52, president of the Shiv Sangram Party and a face of the Maratha agitation a few years ago, was killed instantaneously when his SUV coming from Beed via Pune to Mumbai crashed into a vehicle ahead of him on the Yeshwantrao Chavan Mumbai-Pune Expressway, early on Sunday.

Soon afterwards, Mete's aged mother, wife Jyoti and on Wednesday his nephew Balasaheb Chavan, besides several leaders of the Maratha Kranti Morcha and other groups raised doubts about the circumstances leading to the accident, the purport-



ed delay in rushing medical help to him and other aspects.

On Sunday, Chief Minister Eknath Shinde had

announced a probe into the mishap with the highway police, Raigad Police setting up around half a dozen teams to investigate Mete's death which shocked the state. Mete's last rites were performed in his native village in Beed on Monday with full state honours, though his family and other Maratha leaders kept raising questions about the highway crash at around 5 a.m. the previous morning.

Speaking to the media in Pune on Wednesday, Mete's nephew Chavan said that among other things, the vehicle driver Eknath Kadam -- one of the three drivers who worked for Mete -- was giving contradictory replies on the accident to the investigators and demanded an in-depth probe into the whole incident. Squarely blaming the driver, who also suffered minor injuries, for the crash, Chavan accused him of not giving the 'exact location of the accident' despite repeated attempts, why was the SUV not visible in the CCTVs and who was the person keeping in regular touch with the driver on the phone.

BJP leader warns NCP of fresh 'expose', Oppn denounces him

Virtually setting the cat among the pigeons, a Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) activist Mohit Kamboj-Bharatiya, hinted that he would soon 'expose' a senior Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) leader, attracting loud howls of protests from the Opposition, here on Wednesday.

Kamboj-Bharatiya's tweets came late on Tuesday -- strategically, on the eve of the monsoon session of Maharashtra Legislature -- "One NCP Big-Big leader will meet Nawab Malik and Anil Deshmukh soon!"

He followed up with another missive -- "The irrigation scam case should be investigated again which was closed

in 2019 by Param Bir Singh". Kamboj-Bharatiya said he would soon hold a press conference and reveal the NCP leader, his assets in India and abroad, benami properties, assets in his girlfriend's name, corruption done as a minister in various ministries, and his family income and assets details.

He also urged Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and BJP's Deputy CM Devendra Fadnavis to reopen the irrigation scam which had muddied the state politics a few years ago.

"Har Har Mahadev... Ab Tandaav Hoga," added Kamboj-Bharatiya.

With the reference to the irrigation scam, the needle of suspicion immediately pointed at current NCP Leader of

Opposition Ajit Pawar, the bete-noire of the ruling alliance, who has not yet reacted to the tweets.

However, other leaders of the Opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) from NCP, Congress and Shiv Sena, besides anti-corruption activist Anjali Damania, slammed Kamboj-Bharatiya for the tweets.

"It's a mystery... How does he (Kamboj-Bharatiya) come to know what the Enforcement Directorate (ED) is planning to do... Is he an agent of the probe agency," an NCP MLC Amol Mitkari said.

Congress state President Nana Patole said all that the BJP is doing is threaten and terrorise the political opponents to silence them.

We had picked up one Mahesh Vaishnav from Surat and Dinesh Dhruv in this connection and during questioning, they revealed that the drugs are stocked in the Savli factory."

Earlier, both were arrested under NDPS act, Mahesh was arrested by Customs sleuths in Bhavnagar and Dinesh Dhruv by DRI. Both were jailed. After completing their jail terms, the duo again started a drug




racket in 2022. Police have also rounded up four more persons for the alleged connections to the drugs racket.

Mahesh used to arrange liquid MDMA drug which was dried and



INDIA v ZIMBABWE ODI SERIES

KL RAHUL, DEEPAK CHAHAR IN FOCUS AS INDIA FACE CONFIDENT ZIMBABWE

The last time India came on a tour of Zimbabwe, it was in 2016 and KL Rahul, who had been in the Test fold, was starting to get into white-ball scheme of things after a breakthrough IPL season with Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB).

In the first ODI of that tour, making his debut in 50-over format under MS Dhoni, Rahul became the first India batter and eleventh overall to make a century on debut. He ended the ODI leg of the tour as the leading run-getter and took Player of the Series award as well.

Six years later, Rahul will be returning to Harare as the captain of the side, to the place where his white-ball mainstay story for India began. But he is coming back after a long time on the sidelines. A groin injury was followed by sports hernia surgery and testing positive for Covid-19.



Thursday's match, the first of the three ODI matches between India and Zimbabwe, will have the majority of focus on how Rahul as well as Deepak Chahar shape up, especially with Men's T20 World Cup coming in October-November and before that, the Asia Cup, starting from August 27.

Just like Rahul, who last played a competitive cricket match in May,

Chahar was last seen in action in February in the T20Is against the West Indies. A quadriceps tear he picked during the series got him on sidelines and with the back injury picked up, he had to spend more time away from playing action.

The ODIs against Zimbabwe give time and chance for both Rahul and Chahar to get back into playing

groove in international cricket, especially with back-to-back action coming up. Rahul has got success as a number five batter in ODIs and should be interesting to see if he comes to bat in same position or gets fit on top of the order, which he does in Tests and T20Is. Others like Shikhar Dhawan, Shubman Gill, Mohammed Siraj, Axar Patel, Kuldeep Yadav, Ishan Kishan and Avesh Khan would be itching to continue their impressive run in recent matches.

On the other hand, Zimbabwe are full of confidence and are coming into the series against India on the back of series victories against Bangladesh in T20Is and ODIs. The series against India gives them the chance to see where they stand against strong teams in ODI cricket and collect some crucial points for the 2023 ODI World Cup Super League.

Border-Gavaskar Trophy

Two sets of five-match in ICC Men's FTP cycle of 2023-27

Dubai | Agencies

Two sets of five-match series for the Border-Gavaskar Trophy in each of the upcoming cycles of the ICC World Test Championship has been one of the major highlights in the ICC Men's FTP cycle of 2023-27 released on Wednesday.

The 12 members in men's cricket will play a total of 777 international matches -- 173 Tests, 281 ODIs and 323 T20Is -- in the 2023-27 FTP cycle compared to the 694 in the current cycle.

As per the FTP, Australia are set to welcome India for a five-match series in the 2023-25 cycle of the WTC while a reciprocal tour is set to be played in the 2025-27 cycle. It will be the first time in over 30 years that the two sides will clash in a five-match Test series, the last time being in 1992. Australia, England and India all play five-match Test series as part of the third and fourth editions of the WTC, which also comprises 19 two-match series and five three-match series each in the two editions of the Championship that run from 2023-25 and 2025-27.

Also, England, Australia and India will feature in the greatest number of Test matches



during the cycle, as they are set to play 22, 21 and 20 matches in the longest format of the game respectively. India will also be playing one home Test against Afghanistan in June 2026. In that particular series, three ODIs will also be played between the two teams. Later in the year, India are also slated to play three away T20Is against Afghanistan.

The FTP also confirms that India will play 38 Tests in the 2023-27 WTC cycles to start post IPL 2023, 20 of which are against Australia and England combined. In the 2023-25 WTC cycle, India will be hosting New Zealand, England, Bangladesh while they play Australia, West Indies and South Africa away.

Raducanu beats Serena Williams in Western & Southern Open first round

In what could end up being the second-last tournament of Williams' career, after confirming she will retire after the U.S. Open beginning later this month, the 40-year-old showed fight early on against the 19-year-old world number 11 on Tuesday, reports DPA.

After getting broken to love in the very first game of the match, Williams found her footing, and even secured a break of her own in the opening set, but a second for Raducanu saw her comfortably serve out the opening frame. Venus Williams, 42, was also eliminated in her opening match, going down 7-5,

6-1 against Karolina Pliskova, with Pliskova now scheduled to take on Elise Mertens in the second round after a 6-1, 6-1 thrashing of Ukraine's Anhelina Kalinina.

MINISTRY TO FUND RAVI DAHIYA'S WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP PREPARATION IN RUSSIA

New Delhi: The Sports Ministry will finance Olympic 57kg category silver medallist Ravi Dahiya's travel and training in Vladikavkaz, Russia, ahead of the World Wrestling Championships in Belgrade, Serbia next month.

Cleared under the Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS), Dahiya will travel to Vladikavkaz on Wednesday night. The 24-year-old will be accompanied by his coach Arun Kumar, sparring partner Sahil and physiotherapist Munish Kumar. The travel, visa, boarding and lodging cost of all four will be covered under TOPS. The camp is scheduled to last for 29 days with Ravi set to travel to Belgrade, Serbia for the World Championships. Ahead of the Commonwealth Games earlier this year, Dahiya, a 2019 World Championship bronze medallist, was sanctioned a special training camp in Bulgaria besides competitive exposure in Bulgaria, Turkey and Mongolia.

Tim Gajser becomes five-time World Motocross Champion

Team HRC's Tim Gajser became the most successful current MXGP rider after winning his fifth world title and the fourth in the premier MXGP class at the MXGP of Finland.

The Honda CRF450R rider wrapped up this year's championship two rounds early, after dominating periods of what has been a very challenging campaign.

Starting off the season with six wins in the first seven rounds gave him a



platform that none of his rivals could get near, and further wins in Germany and a perfect performance in Indonesia meant that he was able to cement his crown and cruise home to yet another world

title. This weekend at the sandy Hyvinkaa track, No. 243 wasn't at his best, but he was still able to post six-seven results, which was more than enough to give him a 104-point advantage

and wrap-up the championship with two rounds still to race. With the pressure of winning his fifth world championship over, expect Gajser to be battling for wins once again, and adding to what is already a remarkable 2022 season.

Unfortunately, teammate Mitch Evans wasn't able to put his practice and qualification speed into either of the two motos, as first lap crashes in each race ruined his chances of challenging for a podium.

Brazil-Argentina replay called off

England's Emma Raducanu collected a memorable win in the opening round of the Western & Southern Open, defeating Serena Williams 6-4, 6-0 in the pair's first ever meeting.

Brazil and Argentina will no longer be required to replay a World Cup qualifier that was controversially abandoned last year, both countries' football associations have said.

The South American rivals had been slated to play the qualifier last September but the fixture was suspended less than 10 minutes after kickoff because of alleged Covid-19 rule breaches by Argentina.

FIFA had ordered the match be rescheduled for September 22 but



changed its mind following appeals from the Brazilian Football Confederation (CBF) and the Argentine Football Association (AFA), Xinhua reports. "Finally, the match between Brazil-Argentina will not be replayed and the open date will allow for our national team to play a friendly as a result, in preparation for Qatar World Cup 2022," the CBF said.

"(We are) grateful to FIFA for the willingness and availability to resolve this problem under these very specific circumstances in this short span of time." In a separate statement, the AFA said it would also seek to play a friendly on the now vacant FIFA date.

Brazil and Argentina finished first and second, respectively, in the South American zone qualifying standings for the World Cup, to be played in Qatar from November 21 to December 18. Brazil are in Group G with Serbia, Switzerland and Cameroon while Argentina will face Mexico, Poland and Saudi Arabia in Group C.

New Delhi: After winning the pairs event, 13-year-old Anshul Bhatt captained Team Blitz to win the teams event in the U-16 World Youth Transnational Bridge Championships teams event in Salsomaggiore, Italy.

He was awarded the Gold in Overall Performance in the U-16 category. Anshul, who has been playing bridge since the age of six, is the youngest winner of three Gold medals at the World Bridge championships where participants from over 30 countries took part. Anshul Bhatt (captain), Canada's Darwin Li, and Estonia's Jasper Vahk and Albert Pedmanson won the Gold medal on August 13. The four players came together in July 2022 to form Team Blitz.

Eleven teams had participated in the qualifying rounds, and Team Blitz was the fourth and last team to enter the semifinals, which were played on August 12 against Poland's CKIS Skawina U15.

In the finals against the USS Unsinkable, the Blitz team, which was trailing by 10 points after the second round, recovered lost ground in the third round with a two-point lead and ended the fourth round with a 23-point lead to bag the championship.

Anshul won the gold medal with Canada's 15-year-old Darwin Li in the pairs event at the under-16 World Youth Transnational Bridge Championships.



Russell keen to play in T20 World Cup but wants West Indies to agree to his terms

As West Indies all-rounder Andre Russell has declared he wants to be a part of his country's campaign in the ICC T20 World Cup in Australia in two months' time, but has added that Cricket West Indies (CWI) should also agree to his terms.

"We have families and we have to make sure that we give our best opportunity while we have one career. It's not like I can start over again. I'm 34 and I want to win another World Cup -- or two more -- for West Indies because at the end of the day, I'm here now, and I'm just taking it day by day," he added.

Russell has played 67 T20Is and has been a part of West Indies' successful T20 World Cup-winning teams as a two-time



winner of the trophy in 2012 and 2016.

Russell's comments come days after West Indies coach Phil Simmons vented his frustration at the non-availability of key players at international level, with the likes

of Chris Gayle, Sunil Narine and Russell reportedly not showing their keenness for the T20 World Cup.

However, Russell insists he wants to get involved in the preparations.

PRAGGNANANDHAA, CARLSEN SHARE FTX CRYPTO CUP LEAD

Miami: India's chess star Rameshbabu Pragganandhaa and world champion Magnus Carlsen made it two wins out of two as the FTX Crypto Cup favourites powered into an early lead.

On Tuesday night, Pragganandhaa narrowly beat Anish Giri in the four-game match to avenge a costly defeat the Dutch number 1 inflicted on him earlier this year in the Oslo Esports Cup. Pragg and Giri played out three draws before the India struck in the final game.
