DESPITE OATH OF NOT LEAVING PARTY, GOA CONGRESS MLAS SWITCH TO BJP

CONGRESS: COLLAPSES AGAIN

AHEAD OF THE ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS IN GOA THE CONGRESS HAD ADMINISTERED AN OATH THAT THE ELECTED MLAS WILL NOT LEAVE THE PARTY BUT ON WEDNESDAY 8 MLAS SWITCHED TO THE BJP LEAVING THE CONGRESS IN SHOCK.

FORMER CHIEF MINISTER DIGAMBAR KAMAT, MICHAEL LOBO, DELILAH LOBO, KEDAR NAIK, SANKALP AMONKAR, RAJESH FALDESAI, ALEXIO SEQUEIRA AND RUDOLF FERNANDES ARE THE EIGHT LEGISLATORS WHO HAVE SWITCHED SIDES.

AAP COMPLAINT TO PUNJAB DGP ABOUT THREATS, MONEY OFFERS TO MLAS

Chandigarh: Amid allegations of BJP attempting to bring down the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government in Punjab, the AAP on Wednesday said it has filed a formal complaint along with all proofs to Director General of Punjab Gaurav Yadav for a fair probe into threats and money offers to its legislators.

It lashed out at the saffron party, calling it a "serial killer" of democracy and condemned "Operation Lotus" for the "dubious manner" in which elected governments in the country are being brought down. State Finance Minister Harpal Singh Cheema told media that the BJP has "murdered democracy" by toppling elected governments in various states after "using" central investigation agencies and through money lures. It tried the same in Punjab, but the staunch soldiers of AAP foiled the BJP's "nefarious agenda".

He alleged BJP agents and workers from Delhi and Punjab have "tried to break" 35 MLAs of AAP to topple the government in Punjab. Cheema said a complaint against BJP leaders and agents has been submitted before the DGP for "offering Rs 25 crore each to at least 10 MLAs in the state and also giving life threat to Jalandhar West MLA Sheetal Angural and others for exposing their wicked agendas before the public".

Now, Maha loses bulk drugs park project to Gujarat, Andhra, Himachal

In another shocker, the Shiv Sena said on Wednesday that Maharashtra has lost out the mega project of Bulk Drugs Park to adjoining Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh and Andhra Pradesh this month.

Sena ex-Ministers Aditya Thackeray and Subhash Desai told the media that earlier this month, a Central notification indicated that Maharashtra has forfeited the prestigious project.

Corroborating the claim, they said that the September 1 statement said: "Centre grants in-principle approval of three bulk drug parks in Himachal Pradesh, Gujarat, and Andhra Pradesh. The three states to submit their detailed project report in next 90 days", and added it was another move to make the country Atmanirbhar in bulk drugs.

The Sena duo said that Maharashtra is missing in the Centre's statement implying that this state has lost out on the project, though it was vigorously pursued by the erstwhile Maha Vikas Aghadi government of Sena-Nationalist Congress Party-Congress.

This is the second big political-economic jolt to the state this month, after the Vedanta Group-Foxconn decided to shift its proposed Rs 2.06 lakh-crore project to Gujarat, sparking a major row in Maharashtra.



Aditya Thackeray said that the MVA government had reserved 5,000 acres of land in Raigad district for the Rs 30,000 crore Bulk Drug Park project which had the potential to create at least 75,000 jobs for locals.

The duo said that both the projects were planned to be implemented in Maharashtra "on merits", but owing to the "current unconstitutional government in the state and its disinterest in the state's development" - implying Chief Minister Eknath Shinde-Deputy CM Devendra Fadnis - it has gone out. Then CM Uddhav Thackeray had written a letter to the Centre proposing to set up the Bulk Drugs Park in Raigad while Desai had brought it up before the state cabinet, but now the Centre has asked Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh and Himachal Pradesh to start working on it, they pointed out.

The Congress had P Chidambaram as senior election observer and Dinesh Gundu Rao as state in-charge. Both of them failed in the elections as the BJP swept to power.

The turncoats had been in the BJP earlier. Digambar Kamat, an old BJP hand, switched to the Congress and was made chief minister and has now defected again. Similarly Michael Lobo and his wife were also in the BJP. Chidambaram said, "the curse of Goa's politics is the 'buying' of MLAs. Since 2014, there is a wholesale buyer in the Indian market."

On January 22, three dozen Congress candidates for the assembly elections pledged their loyalty to the party at three religious institutions; a temple, a church and a mosque, ahead of the February assembly polls in the state. The precaution was taken because of doubts in the voters' minds that the Congress candidates may defect to the BJP, following the mass defection of 10 Congress legislators to the BJP in July, 2019.

KARNATAKA SPECIAL COURT ORDERS GRAFT PROBE AGAINST YEDIYURAPPA

In a setback to BJP leader B.S. Yediyurappa, a special court for cases against MPs/MLAs on Wednesday ordered the filing of case and investigation by the Lokayukta police, into allegations of misuse of power when he was Karnataka Chief Minister.

The special court's order came on a plea by social activist T.J. Abraham who has alleged that Yediyurappa had allegedly awarded a BDA housing project to Ramalingam Constructions in return for financial favours diverted through shell companies.

Abraham had previously approached the court seeking probe against Yediyurappa, his son B.Y. Vijayendra, Co-Operation Minister S.T. Somashekar and six others.

However, the special court had dismissed the petition filed by the High Court which had directed the special court to revisit the case. Yediyurappa said that there is no truth in the allegations and he will emerge innocent, while expressing full faith in the judiciary. "It's a conspiracy against me," he said.

MEGHALAYA GOVT ISSUES LICENCES FOR CASINOS

Shillong: Amid the strong opposition from various circles against the issuance of licences to operate casinos in Meghalaya, the state government has issued licences to set up three casinos in the hilly state, officials said on Wednesday. The Joint Action Committee Against Casino (JACAC) and other organisations have been strongly agitating against the setting up of casinos in the state including in Ri-Bhoi district, which borders Assam. Meghalaya Taxation Minister James P.K. Sangma told the state assembly on Monday that temporary licences were issued to provide additional attractions to the tourists, visiting the state from other states.

Drugs valued at Rs 200 crore seized, six arrested in Gujrat

Gujarat Anti Terrorist Squad and Indian Coast Guard (ICG) have seized 40 kg heroin valued at Rs 200 crore from a Pakistani fishing boat and arrested six persons in this connection near the International Maritime Border Line (IMBL).

During the intervening night of September 13 and 14, on a specific intelligence input, the ICG strategically deployed two fast interceptor class of ships, C-408 and C-454 for patrolling in areas close to the IMBL.

During midnight, the Pakistani boat was observed moving suspiciously in Indian



waters, 5 nm inside notional IMBL and 40 nm from Jakhau.

On being challenged, the Pakistani boat over boarded a consignment and started evasive maneuvering, the ICG said in a statement.

The consignment was skillfully recovered by one of the two

ICG ships and found to be a drug haul.

"On visual examination, the drug is believed to be heroin with quantity approx. 40 kg and market value of Rs 200 crore. The other ICG ship, braving very rough seas in pitch dark night and marginal weather conditions, maneuvered and stopped the boat," the ICG added.

The boat is being brought to Jakhau for further joint investigation by all agencies.

This is the fifth such joint operation by the ICG and ATS, Gujarat in the last one year in which huge quantity of narcotics is seized and those involved in the crime are arrested.

PRESIDENT MURMU TO ATTEND QUEEN ELIZABETH'S FUNERAL

New Delhi: President Droupadi Murmu will represent India at the state funeral of Queen Elizabeth II in London on September 19.

Murmu will be visiting London from September 17 to 19 to offer condolences on behalf of the Government of India. Queen Elizabeth, the former head of state of the UK and Head of the Commonwealth of Nations, passed away on September 8. President Droupadi Murmu, Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar and Prime Minister Narendra Modi expressed condolences at the demise of Queen Elizabeth II. External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar visited the British High Commission in New Delhi on September 12 to convey India's condolences. India also observed a day of national mourning on Sunday (September 11).

12 killed, 24 injured in J&K road accident

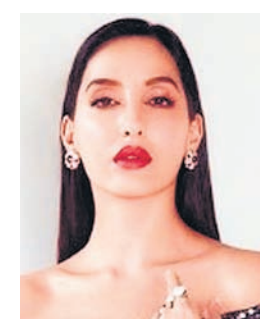
Twelve persons were killed and 24 others injured on Wednesday in a road accident in Jammu and Kashmir's Poonch district. Police sources said that a minibus went out of the driver's control near Brari Ballah in the Sawjian area of Poonch district. "The minibus rolled down into a gorge. Nine persons were killed in this accident while 27 others were injured. "Army rescue teams assisted by police and civilians shifted the injured to sub-district hospital in Mandi town.

"Attending doctors said the condition of 11 injured passengers is critical," police sources said. J&K Lt. Governor, Manoj Sinha has announced Rs 5 lakh ex gratia



compensation to the next of kin of those who lost their lives in the accident. Sinha said on his official Twitter page, "Saddened by loss of lives due to a road accident in Sawjian, Poonch. Condolences to bereaved families. "May the injured recover soon. Rs. 5 lakh would be given to the next of kin of deceased. Directed Police and Civil authorities to provide best possible treatment to the injured".

EOW SUMMONS NORA FATEHI IN RS 200 CR EXTORTION CASE



New Delhi: After grilling actress Jacqueline Fernandez for over eight hours on Wednesday, the Economic Offences Wing (EOW) of Delhi Police has again summoned Bollywood personality Nora Fatehi for questioning at 11 am on Thursday in connection with the ongoing probe into the Rs 200 crore extortion-cum-cheating case involving multimillionaire conman

Sukesh Chandrashekar, who is presently lodged in jail. Nora was earlier grilling by the EOW in connection with the same case in the first week of September.

On Wednesday, Jacqueline reached the EOW office here at around 11 am and her grilling went on till about 8 pm.

According to sources, after grilling Nora on Thursday, the police will decide when to summon Jacqueline again.

On Wednesday, Jacqueline was confronted with another accused in the case, Pinky Irani.

Video shows how Kolkata Police van was torched, BJP says "Wasn't Us"

Torching of a police vehicle has become a central point of BJP's protest in Kolkata that turned violent yesterday, with videos showing how it was ransacked, its windshields and windowpanes smashed, and a man lighting the fire up close. Youth Congress national chief BS Srinivas tweeted a close-up video, which shows a man in a saffron T-shirt using a cigarette lighter to set fire to a towel kept in the police van. "Just identify,



which party's 'nationalist rioters' are burning police jeeps in West Bengal?" he wrote, in Hindi. He tweeted another video that showed men waving BJP flags and ransacking the police vehicle. In the caption, he took jibes at PM

Narendra Modi's past statements: "I am sure the Prime Minister will identify these rioters by their clothes and flags, and, in his heart, will never be able to forgive them." The BJP denied its workers lit the fire. "Police may do it themselves," said Leader of Opposition Suwendu Adhikari, "Our workers were not carrying any weapons. Maybe Trinamool Congress's jihadis came and carried out the violence." The party has claimed the violence started upon provocation by police.

Nadda's accolades for BJP's successful march

Kolkata: There might be differences in opinion in the political circles in West Bengal on the greater future impact of the BJP's march to state secretariat against corruption issues, but leaders of the saffron brigade have received accolades from the party leadership for the same.

Sources said that the party's state president, Sukanta Majumdar received a telephone call from the party's national president, J.P. Nadda on Tuesday night. "Besides congratulating Majumdar for leading the successful march to the state secretariat agitation programme on Tuesday, Nadda also advised him to conduct similar agitational programmes in the coming days. Our state president was also advised by Nadda to specially focus on the different corruption issues against the state government and the ruling Trinamool congress like teachers' recruitment irregularities scam, coal smuggling and cattle smuggling, among others," confirmed a state committee member of BJP in West Bengal.



AD-HOC APPOINTMENT/PROMOTIONS TO BE MADE IN RARE CASES ONLY: CENTRE

Amid the Centre announcing that 10 lakh people will be given jobs in the Central government in the next 18 months, the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT) has made it clear that ad hoc appointment or promotions are to be made in rare cases, in order to meet the functional requirement of the organisation while keeping the policy imperative that all posts have to be filled on regular basis.

While making an ad hoc appointment or promotion, it may be noted that persons appointed on ad hoc basis to a grade are to be replaced by persons approved for regular appointment by direct recruitment, promotion or deputation, as the case may be, at the earliest opportunity, it said.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi had, in June,

announced that 10 lakh people will be given jobs in the Central government in the next 18 months. Subsequently, a Task Force was constituted to coordinate the progress of filling up of the vacant posts as per the Recruitment Plan.

As per DoPT, ad hoc promotion may be resorted to in such rare circumstances, where the cases have been pending for long before the tribunal/court and the Cadre Controlling Authority or administrative Ministry is unable to make regular appointment or promotion and where the post cannot be kept vacant on functional grounds.

It may be in the cases where short-time vacancies have arisen due to the regular incumbent having proceeded on leave for more than 45 days, or on short-term deputation, etc. (of less than one year) and the post cannot be kept vacant on functional

grounds, the vacant post may be filled on ad hoc basis, it said.

DoPT said that Ministries and Departments can make regular appointments in Group 'A' or Group 'B' posts under 'One Time Method' by making a reference to the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) for deciding the method of recruitment to that post.

Further action to fill the post may be taken according to the advice tendered by the UPSC. All such appointments will be treated as regular appointments. Further powers have been delegated to Ministries and Departments to frame Recruitment Rules for Group 'C' posts without consultation with DoPT. Such posts are in any case outside the purview of the UPSC.

Therefore, no ad-hoc appointment may be made on the grounds that recruitment rules (RRs) for the post do not exist, said the DoPT.

TWO TERRORISTS KILLED IN SRINAGAR ENCOUNTER



Srinagar: Two terrorists have been killed in an ongoing encounter between terrorists and security forces in Jammu and Kashmir's Srinagar district on Wednesday, police said.

"One more terrorist killed (Total 02). Identification being ascertained. Search going on," police said. The firefight at Nowgam area started after a joint team of police and security forces got an input about the presence of terrorists in that area. As security forces cordoned off the area, terrorists hiding there started firing, drawing retaliation by the security forces.

There have been a series of encounters between terrorists and security forces across Kashmir over the last few months in which many terrorists and their commanders have been eliminated. A terrorist was killed in an encounter between terrorists and security forces at Heff Shirmal area in Shopian district on Monday.

Prashant Kishor meets Nitish Kumar amid speculation over 2024 bid

Pol strategist-turned-politician Prashant Kishor, who was giving statements against Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar till last week, met him on the dinner table in the latter's official residence, sources said on Wednesday.

Sources said that Nitish Kumar called him through former Rajya Sabha MP Pawan Kumar Verma, and Kishor stayed at CM's residence for two hours on Tuesday night and discussed various issues.

The development came in wake of Nitish Kumar, after the Delhi visit to cement opposition unity, claimed that Kishor does not know ABC of Bihar, and is a businessman, who worked with several parties in the country despite having been given an offer to stay in the JD-U.

Retaliating, Kishor said that Nitish Kumar will activate his 'Paltimar' plan again before 2024



or 2025.

Sources have said that Verma met Nitish Kumar on Monday and the latter reportedly assigned him to convince Kishor to work with him.

Sources said that Nitish Kumar gave the offer to Kishor to work with him as the Prime Ministerial candidate of the opposition parties for the 2024

Lok Sabha election.

Verma on Tuesday hinted that some people left Nitish Kumar after he supported the BJP and CAA in 2020, and now, he has separated his party from the BJP, many people are joining him again. Kishor is currently busy in Jan Suraj campaign in Bihar and he has scheduled his Padyatra from October 2.

Cattle smuggling scam: Businessmen admits giving money, costly vehicles to Mondal

Two businessmen, based in Bolpur in West Bengal's Birbhum district, on Wednesday told the CBI that they have provided cash and costly vehicles to Trinamool Congress strongman and party's district President, Anubrata Mondal, who was arrested over his alleged involvement in the multi-crore cattle smuggling scam.

Rajib Bhattacharya, owner of a number of rice mills in Birbhum district, reached the Central Bureau of Investigation's (CBI) temporary camp office for questioning and said that he made a payment of Rs 66 lakh to Mondal, which he also mentioned in his income tax returns details.

Later while coming out of the CBI camp office after three hours of questioning, he told waiting media persons the same. "Anubrata Mondal



asked for Rs 66 lakh for the treatment of his wife, which I provided. I am yet to get back that money. I have informed the CBI officials about this,"

Bhattacharya said.

The other businessman, questioned by the CBI sleuths on Wednesday, was Maloy Peet, owner

of a private polytechnic college and a private medical college at Bolpur.

Recently, when the CBI sleuths raided Bolpur-based Bhole Byom Rice Mill, reportedly owned by Mondal's daughter, Sukanya Mondal, they traced two high-end SUVs registered with two governing trusts under which the private polytechnic college and the private medical college operate. In the integration, Peet admitted to the CBI sleuths that he gave the two SUVs to Mondal for his use. Later he told media persons that since Mondal is an influential person and without his assistance, it was impossible to run the medical and polytechnic colleges at Bolpur, he had, hence, agreed to provide the two vehicles.

However, sources said that the CBI sleuths suspect that much of the proceeds of cattle smuggling had been routed to finance these two private colleges. However, Peet, so far, has denied this allegation.

Guwahati | Agencies

The Assam government plans to convert all its secondary schools to higher secondary level, the Assembly was told on Wednesday.

Replying to a question, Education Minister Ranaj Pegu said that as per the New Education Policy, the state government has already upgraded 215 high schools to the higher secondary level.

The preparation to convert another 785 high schools to the higher secondary level is underway, he added.

The initial upgradation list was prepared by the Education Department, based on the availability of logistics, manpower, etc. and



gradually, the other schools will also be upgraded, Pegu said. The minister also said that operationalisation of classes in the newly-upgraded schools will be looked into at the district level. The required administrative machinery will be provided by the state government.

Earlier, a majority of the state government schools in Assam had classes up to 10 only while a few could take students at 10+2 level also.

The state government colleges in the state have the facility to teach higher secondary standard students.

Six labourers killed as lift collapses in under-construction building in Ahmedabad

At least six labourers were killed and one seriously injured after the lift of an under-construction building collapsed here on Wednesday.

The lift crashed from the seventh floor. The under-construction high-rise building, named Aspire-II was located near the Gujarat University campus. "At the time of the accident seven labourers were inside the lift, which was used to carry various materials. The lift crashed from the seventh floor on Wednesday morning. The labourers were working in the lift chamber," said Mahendra, an eyewitness and labourer at the site. He told the media that all the labourers hailed from the Panchmahal district. The Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation said the



incident will be probed and action against responsible builders will be taken. Hitesh Barot, Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation Standing Committee Chairman told the media that all aspects of safety measures will be investigated, and if the builder was found responsible, suitable action will be taken against him or the company.

KASHMIR TO GET ITS FIRST ELECTRIC TRAIN ON GANDHI JAYANTI

Srinagar: On October 2, electric train will start moving on the 137 kms long Banihal-Baramulla corridor of Jammu and Kashmir rail link.

Indian Railway officials said that work on the project was going on since August 2019. The mandatory principal chief electrical engineer (PCEE) inspection of the electric rail link will take place on September 26 and on Gandhi Jayanti, the project will be inaugurated, the railway officials said. "Trials on Baramulla-Budgam part of the 137-Kms long electric train link have already been completed while the trial on the remaining Budgam-Banihal portion will be carried out on September 20", sources said, adding that the project cost of the electric train link from Banihal to Baramulla is Rs 324 crore.

ED raids private firm, seizes gold and silver worth Rs 47.76 cr

The searches were conducted in connection with the money laundering probe in case of Parekh Aluminex limited.

The ED had registered money laundering case against Parekh Aluminex Limited on March 8, 2018. An official said that the company duped banks and took loans to the tune of Rs 2296.58 crore. The money was thereafter siphoned off by layering through various companies. The money was routed to various accounts in context of providing unse-



cured loans and investments. The same was not the purpose of taking the loans and there were no agreements in place for such transactions.

During the search action, keys to private lockers were found in the premises of Raksha Bullion. On searching the private lockers, it was found that the locker

operation was being done without following the proper norms. "No KYC was followed and there was no CCTV camera installed at the premise. There was no in and out register. Searching the locker premise revealed that there were 761 lockers of which three belonged to Raksha Bullion. On operating the lockers, 91.5 kgs of gold and 152 kg of silver was found in two lockers and the same was seized. An additional 188 kgs of silver was also seized from the premises of Raksha Bullion," said the official.

SIX LABOURERS KILLED AS LIFT COLLAPSES IN UNDER-CONSTRUCTION BUILDING IN AHMEDABAD

Ahmedabad: At least six labourers were killed and one seriously injured after the lift of an under-construction building collapsed here on Wednesday.

The lift crashed from the seventh floor. The under-construction high-rise building, named Aspire-II was located near the Gujarat University campus. "At the time of the accident seven labourers were inside the lift, which was used to carry various materials. The lift crashed from the seventh floor on Wednesday morning. The labourers were working in the lift chamber," said Mahendra, an eyewitness and labourer at the site. He told the media that all the labourers hailed from the Panchmahal district.

The Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation said the incident will be probed and action against responsible builders will be taken. Hitesh Barot, Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation Standing Committee Chairman told the media that all aspects of safety measures will be investigated, and if the builder was found responsible, suitable action will be taken against him or the company. The police were also carrying out the investigation parallelly.

400-year-old Naick-era stone inscription found in Theni

A team of students and professors of Mannar Thirumalai College in Madurai recently discovered a 400 year old Naick-era stone inscription at a temple in Andipatti taluk in Theni.

The archaeologically precious material was discovered by Assistant professors of the Department of History of the college, R. Praiya and S. Rajagopal

along with a few students. Social activist S. Aswath was also in the team.

The stone inscription was originally installed at Pandya Meenakshi Sundareswar temple. However, this temple is now in a dilapidated condition. Unaware of its archeological and historical significance, local people installed the stone inscription at Vinayagar temple. The stone has a Vaishnava symbol, the sun, the moon and a lotus flower with

blurred letters. Retired Archeologist Dr C. Santhalingam, while told media persons: "The inscriptions on the stone talk about Veerakandama Naicker having received a donation from Muthu Veerappa Naick who was the 6th ruler of the Madurai Naick Kingdom". According to the local people, further exploration could provide more information on the Kandamanaykanur local administration.

Minor gang-raped in Aligarh, 4 held

Three men were arrested for allegedly gang-raping a 13-year-old girl in this Uttar Pradesh district, police said on Wednesday.

A woman, who is the survivor's neighbour and also an accomplice in the crime, was also arrested. The matter came to light after the girl's mother filed a police complaint in the case at the Harduaganj police station.

In her complaint, the woman alleged that the accused, who had also filmed the act, threatened to circulate the video across social media platforms if she dared to tell anyone about the crime.

DSP Vishal Kumar said: "On basis of the complaint received from the victim's family, an FIR has been registered against three men and a woman under IPC sections 376D (gangrape), 506 (criminal intimidation), 342 (wrongful confinement), 120-B (criminal conspiracy) and sections of the POCSO Act. The entire matter is being investigated in



detail."

According to the FIR, the 13-year-old was taken and locked in a room by the accused woman at her home on Sunday afternoon, where three accused men allegedly gang-raped her. They also filmed the crime and let her go home in the evening, the officials said. The victim's mother said: "We had approached the nearby police outpost on Sunday to file a complaint but policemen there pressured us to reach a compromise with the accused. However, when the matter came to the notice of senior officials, they registered an FIR in the case." They were arrested late on Tuesday night, the officials said, adding that further investigation is underway.

SUSPECTING THEM TO BE KIDNAPPERS, SANGLI MOB BEATS UP 4 SADHUS

Sangli | Agencies

In a shocker, a group of at least four Sadhus was thrashed by a mob on suspicion that they could be child-lifters, officials said, even as police got into action and detained six persons. The incident occurred on Tuesday in Lavanga village in the Jat tehsil of the district in western Maharashtra and revived memories of the lynching of three Sadhus in Palghar district. Though no formal police complaint has been filed yet, the incident sparked a fresh political row between the government of Chief Minister Eknath Shinde-Deputy CM Devendra Fadnavis and the Opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA). According to locals, the four Sadhus, hailing from Uttar Pradesh, had entered Maharashtra by a car from Karnataka's Bijapur and were proceeding to the pilgrimage centre of Pandharpur. On Tuesday, they were reportedly asking a boy for directions when some locals intervened, and suspecting them to be kidnappers,



hammered them. Videos of the incident -- showing some persons assaulting them with blows, sticks and belts -- went viral on social media platforms triggering protests and allegations between the ruling and opposition combines.

Slamming the Shinde-Fadnavis government, state Congress President Nana Patole said this is part of the BJP's "dirty politics" that Hindu Sadhus are being thrashed in such a manner. "The BJP is virtually ruling the

state, the Deputy CM and Home Minister (Fadnavis) are from the BJP.. Now what face they have left to show," said Patole. Congress General Secretary Sachin Sawant said that a similar incident had occurred in Palghar in April 2020 in the Palghar village ruled by the BJP and several local BJP office-bearers were also involved. "The BJP used that incident to label the MVA government as 'anti-Hindu'... A similar situation has arisen in Sangli now. Whose government is in power? Will they hand over the probe to the CBI?" Sawant demanded. Ruling BJP Spokesperson Ram Kadam termed the incident as "appalling and barbaric" and would not be tolerated in the state, while assuring a full probe into the matter. Sangli Police Superintendent Dixit Gedam told the mediapersons that the police have launched suo moto investigations and detained at least six persons, and appealed to the people not to fall prey to such rumours.

INDIA AIMS TO LEAPFROG IN QUANTUM TECHNOLOGY WITH INDUSTRY'S HELP : MINISTER

As India embarks on its Techade journey, the government aims to build capabilities in quantum and high performance computing with the help from industry leaders like IBM, Minister of State for Electronics and IT Rajeev Chandrasekhar said on Wednesday. Addressing the IBM's flagship 'Think' conference virtually, he said that quantum technology is a very important piece of India's tech journey. "Quantum is, notwithstanding the usual marketing hype that always accompanies new emerging technologies, clearly a technology that cannot be ignored. India intends to build capabilities in quantum and high performance computing to address challenges of the future," the minister told the gathering. Chandrasekhar, along with Sandip Patel, Managing Director, IBM India and Tom Rosamilia, Senior Vice President, IBM Software, also unveiled a white paper on quantum technology. The minister said that India, in the coming years, must move from being a consumer of technologies to being an architect and a producer of technologies and innovation. Chandrasekhar last year launched QSim - Quantum Computer Simulator Toolkit - to enable researchers and students to carry out



research in quantum computing. The project is being executed collaboratively by IISc Bangalore, IIT Roorkee and C-DAC with the support of MeitY. Earlier this week, IIT-Madras became the first Indian institution to join IBM's quantum network to advance quantum computing skills development and research in the country, the tech major announced on Monday. IIT Madras' Centre for Quantum Information, Communication and Computing (CQuICC) will focus on advancing core algorithms in research areas like quantum machine learning, quantum optimisation and applications research in finance.

SBI hits Rs 5 lakh crore market capitalisation

State-owned lender, State Bank of India (SBI) hit the Rs 5 lakh crore market capitalisation on Wednesday after its shares touched a record high of Rs 564.45. With this market capi-

talisation, SBI stood on the seventh position in the market capitalisation ranking. SBI has become the third lender in the country to cross the market cap of Rs 5 lakh crore. HDFC Bank held first rank in this list, which was

followed by ICICI Bank. At 1.10 p.m., SBI shares were up Rs 14.75 or 2.64 per cent at Rs 573.00. Meanwhile, Sensex was trading 126.21 points or 0.21 per cent down at 60,444.87, and Nifty was 32.90 points or 0.18 per cent down at 18,037.15.

PUNE FRIENDS COMMITTED SUICIDE WITHIN HOUR OF EACH OTHER

Pune: Two 19-year-old women, both childhood friends and living in the same building in Pune, allegedly died by suicide within a span of one hour, police said. The incidents took place on Tuesday evening in Maharashtra's Hadapsar town, they said. One of the women found dead in her bedroom at around 6:30 pm, police inspector Arvind Gokule told Press Trust of India. "While the body was being sent for an autopsy in an ambulance, the woman's childhood friend jumped to death from the terrace of the four-storey building at around 7:30 pm," he said. One of them was a commerce student and the other was pursuing an animation course, the police said. No note was found and the reasons behind their extreme step were not yet known, the police said.

Jacqueline Fernandez joins probe in Sukesh Chandrashekar extortion case

Bollywood actor Jacqueline Fernandez appeared before the Economic Offences Wing (EOW) of the Delhi Police to join the investigation in connection with the Rs 200 crore extortion cum cheating case involving multimillionaire conman Sukesh Chandrashekar. She went inside the EOW office from a back door and was accompanied by her counsels. The EOW had earlier postponed her questioning on her request and had fixed the matter for Wednesday. Pinky Irani, an associate of Fernandez has also been summoned to join the investigation and both are likely to be grilled together. Sources in the unit said that they have prepared a long list of questionnaire which will be asked to the actress. "We will ask her about her relationship with Chandrashekar and the gifts, money which she received from the conman. We might confront Irani and Fernandez," the source said.



There are possibilities that the questioning can go for two or three days. The questions that will be asked to Irani and Fernandez have been prepared by the top officials of the agency to nail the lies of Chandrashekar. In the first week of September, the EOW officials had recorded the testimony of another Bollywood actress Nora Fatehi in the matter. Chandrashekar was arrested for allegedly cheating and extorting money from some high-profile people, includ-

ing former Fortis Healthcare promoter Shivinder Mohan Singh's wife Aditi Singh. Many Bollywood actors and models have been questioned by the Enforcement Directorate for their alleged links to Chandrashekar. In April last year Chandrashekar was arrested in another money laundering case linked to the 2017 Election Commission bribery case, which allegedly involved a former AIADMK leader among others.

Based n suicide note, Thane Police charge victim's husband, family members

Based on a purported suicide note found with a 38-year-old housewife who hanged herself two days ago at Dombivili in Thane district, police have registered a case against her husband and seven members of his family, including in-laws, an official said on Tuesday. The accused, originally hailing from Jalgaon in north Maharashtra, have been charged with abetment to suicide and other offences, he said. An official from the Manpada police station of Dombivili in the Kalyan division said based on a complaint by the 71-year-old father of the woman, the police have registered the case against the eight under IPC sections 306 (abetment of suicide), 377 (unnatural offences), 498A (husband or relative of husband of a woman

subjecting her to cruelty) and 323 (punishment for voluntarily causing hurt), among others. No arrest has been made so far, he said. The police said the woman got married to one Dinesh Sriram Patil way back in 2004. According to the complaint, since 2008 the woman had been subjected to mental and physical harassment by her in-laws and other family members for some reason or the other. The victim's in-laws also doubted her character, it said. Fed up with the constant harassment, the woman hanged herself at her husband's home in Dombivili on September 11, the police said. The next day the police found a suicide note in her clothes and registered the case. However, the police have not revealed the content of the suicide note.

Builder held for raping actress under marriage pretext

Builder was arrested by Mumbai Police on Tuesday for allegedly raping a small-time actress under the pretext of marrying her, an official said. The accused, Aditya Ajay

Kapoor, had met the 24-year-old actress, who had worked in some Telugu movies, at the residence of a common friend in suburban Bandra. They exchanged phone numbers and stayed in touch. Over a period of time, they became close to each

other, the official said. "Kapoor maintained physical relations with the woman by promising to marry her," the official said quoting the FIR. The complainant stated that Kapoor raped her at his residence in the Cuffe Parade area and also in Goa.

Mysterious underground sounds in Latur village

In what may seem like a plot from popular Netflix series 'Stranger Things', residents of a village in Maharashtra's Latur district are puzzled after mysterious sounds can be heard underground, across the village. This has been happening now for over a week. The mysterious underground sounds have been reported at Hasori village in the district, an official said on Tuesday. In order to get a scientific explanation, district officials have requested experts from the Indian Institute of Geomagnetism to visit the village to study the strange phe-

nomenon, he said. Hasori village is located 28 km from Killari - a place where a deadly earthquake had claimed more than 9,700 lives in 1993. But no seismic activity has been recorded since in the area, officials said. As per local reports, loud mysterious sounds are being heard underground since September 6, leaving villagers scared and puzzled. Latur district collector Prithviraj BP visited the village on Tuesday and appealed to the people not to panic. A team of experts from Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University of Maharashtra's Nanded will visit the village today, officials said.

Bust of Annabhau Sathe - Father of Dalit Literature - adorns Moscow library campus

In a unique honour, a bust of the Maharashtra-born Tukaram B. Sathe, famed as 'Annabhau Sathe', the Father of Dalit Literature - was inaugurated at the famed Margarita Rudomino All-Russian State Library for Foreign Literature, Moscow, on Wednesday. Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis inaugurated the bust, terming it as "a historic development which will further strengthen relations between India and Russia". Fadnavis consecrated the bust - gifted by the University of Mumbai - in the presence of Legislative Assembly Speaker Rahul Narwekar, the varsity's Annabhau Sathe Study Centre Director Dr. Baliram Gaikwad and Dr. Sanjay Deshpande, Director, Central Eurasian Studies Department, ICCR President Dr. Vinay Sahasrabudhe, besides around 300 invitees at the famed library campus in the Russian capital this afternoon. The Dy CM also recalled the sterling contributions



of Annabhau Sathe to Dalit literature though he attended school "for only one day" owing to the prevalent social systems," but went on to create an impressive body of literary works and is a famous figure in the Russia academia. "After his epochal visit to Russia, he wrote the 'Ballad of Stalingrad' and 'My Journey To Russia - A Travelogue', many of his books were translated into Russian language and he was regarded as the 'Maxim Gorky of India', plus fostered ties between

the people of the two countries," Fadnavis said. Urbanisation increasing unprecedented flooding

Unprecedented floods in Bangladesh followed by Assam floods, extremely heavy rain in Madhya Pradesh, parts of Rajasthan and Bengaluru in India, and the Pakistan deluge. Climate experts say all calamities have shown how the quantum of extreme events has increased exponentially in South Asia. The UN's Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) last year warned about the increase in extreme weather events across South Asia in the coming years if the emissions continue to be unchecked. Asian urban areas are considered high-risk locations from projected climate change, extreme events, unplanned urbanisation and rapid land-use change, as per the expert. With increasing urbanisation, the cities are at greater risk as the volume of damage in terms of loss of human lives, property damage and economic losses are higher than in the rural areas. Cities like Mumbai, Kolkata, Bengaluru, Delhi and Chennai are home to millions of people and so high is the climate risk. Studies say Asia is home to 54 per cent of the world's urban population, and by 2050, 64 per cent of Asia's 3.3 billion people will be living in cities. Asia is also home to the world's largest urban agglomerations: Tokyo (37 million inhabitants), New Delhi (29 million) and Shanghai (26 million) are the top three with Cairo, Mumbai, Beijing and Dhaka home to nearly 20 million people each. By 2028, New Delhi is projected to become the most populous city in the world. In the warming environment, urban flooding is a major threat to the cities and towns. Regional ecological challenges coupled with climatic variability have aggravated flood risks. Urban flooding that was primarily a concern of municipal and environmental governance has now attained the status of 'disaster'. Extreme rainfall has direct and increasing consequences on urban flooding risk, which is further exacerbated by urbanisation trends that reduce land permeability, divert water flow and disrupt watersheds.

WRACKED BY INFIGHTING & REVOLT AGAINST PCC CHIEF, CONG IN DISARRAY

The BJP's emergence as a strong opponent to ruling TRS in Telangana has pushed the Congress to the third place, and the grand old party faces an uphill task to arrest its decline ahead of next year's Assembly elections. Series of defections, a string of defeats in by-elections, disastrous performance in Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) polls and continued infighting have considerably weakened the party in its former stronghold. The Congress appears to be in complete disarray with resignation of some of its top leaders in recent weeks and the open revolt by some seniors against state Congress chief A. Revanth Reddy. The recent resignation of sitting MLA from Munugode constituency, Komatireddy Rajagopal Reddy, and his subsequent defection to BJP has added to the woes of the Congress, which does not look ready to confidently face a by-election. The outcome of the upcoming by-election is likely to indicate the direction of the wind before the 2023 polls. The bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh by granting statehood to Telangana in 2014 was a political gamble by the Congress, which was hoping to reap the political dividend by claiming credit for carving out the separate state. However, TRS chief K. Chandrasekhar Rao dashed its hopes by rejecting the proposal to merge his party with the Congress. He decided to maintain the identity of TRS as an independent political party. KCR, as Rao is popularly known, succeeded in claiming credit for achieving the goal of a separate state by winning the public mandate. In the 2014 elections, held just before the formal bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh, TRS won 63 seats in the 119-member Telangana Assembly. The Congress, which was completely wiped out in Andhra Pradesh due to the public anger over the bifurcation, could win 22 seats in Telangana. However, the party failed to keep its flock together as several of its leaders defected to TRS. In the 2018 Assembly elections, held a few months before the term of the Assembly was to end, Congress faced a disaster. It could win just 19 seats, though it had forged an electoral alliance with the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) and other TRS opponents.



However, the worst was yet to come. Even before it could gear up for the Lok Sabha elections in 2019, it had lost as many as 12 MLAs to the ruling party. Though the party salvaged some pride by winning three Lok Sabha seats, with the reduced strength in Assembly it lost the status of main opposition to Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (MIM), a friendly party of TRS. Congress suffered a huge embarrassment as it failed to retain the Huzurnagar Assembly seat, where by-election was necessitated following the resignation of Uttam Kumar Reddy after his election to the Lok Sabha. The TRS wrested the seat from Congress as its candidate S. Saidi Reddy was elected with a huge margin of over 43,000 votes. Uttam Reddy's wife N. Padmavathi Reddy finished a distant runner-up. The BJP, which became aggressive following its impressive performance in the Lok Sabha polls after winning four seats, added to the worries of Congress. Projecting itself as the only viable alternative, the saffron party started making inroads in Telangana. The BJP wrested Dubbak from the TRS in 2020 to further consolidate itself. The saffron party, which hardly had any presence in the constituency, pushed Congress to third position. The Congress suffered another humiliation the same year as it could win just two seats in the 150-member Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC). In its best-ever performance in the civic

body, the BJP bagged 48 seats to deny the TRS a clear majority. The emergence of BJP as the main opposition party sent the alarm bells ringing. Owing moral responsibility for the defeat, Uttam Reddy had resigned as the party chief. The Congress was pinning its hopes on the by-election to Nagarjuna Sagar to revive its fortunes in the state. But its senior leader and former minister K. Jana Reddy lost by over 18,000 votes to TRS debutant Nomula Bhagat, whose father late Nomula Narasimhaiah had defeated Jana Reddy in 2018. The only solace for the Congress was that it finished runner-up and BJP was a distant third with its candidate forfeiting his deposit. The appointment of Revanth Reddy as the new state president by the central leadership last year after ignoring several seniors and strong contenders triggered open revolt by a section of leaders, who saw Revanth as an outsider as he had defected to Congress from TDP just before the 2018 elections. The change of guard also could not bring any change in the party's fortunes. Several seniors started openly attacking Revanth Reddy for sidelining them. In the Huzurabad by-election held last year, Congress' performance was disastrous. Eatala Rajender's resignation from the constituency after he was dropped from the state Cabinet by Chief Minister

Chandrasekhar Rao had caused the by-election. He switched loyalties to BJP and contested the by-poll as the candidate of the saffron party. Rajender defeated his nearest rival Gellu Srinivas Yadav of TRS by 24,068 votes. Rajender polled 1,06,780 votes while Srinivas Yadav secured 82,712 votes. The Congress candidate secured only 3,012 votes and lost the deposit. It was a disaster for Congress which had secured 47,803 votes in 2018 to finish runner-up. BJP is confident that in Munugode, Rajagopal Reddy will repeat the performance of Eatala to give it another victory. Political observers say the by-election offers another opportunity to Congress to arrest the slide and improve its prospects in the big battle ahead. With speculations doing rounds in political circles that Rajagopal Reddy's brother and MP Venkat Reddy may also quit Congress and join BJP, Congress is likely to face more embarrassment. Under attack from his critics within the party over his style of functioning, Revanth Reddy will be under big pressure to deliver and give a befitting counter to Komatireddy brothers and his bitter critics on their home turf.

'UKRAINE HAS PULLED OFF ONE OF GREATEST COUNTER ATTACKS IN MODERN HISTORY'

Vladimir Putin has no good options for how to react after a lightning offensive by Ukraine inflicted Russia's most serious and rapid military defeat on the battlefield since the Second World War, a UK military expert said, Daily Mail reported. Justin Bronk, a research fellow at London's Royal United Services Institute, has analysed the latest situation in an article as Ukrainian troops continued to pile pressure on retreating Russian forces. Ukraine is now seeking to hold onto its sudden momentum that has pro-



duced major territorial gains, with Russian troops surrendering en masse amid hopes that a turning point in the war has finally been reached. The counter-offensive left the Kremlin struggling for a response to its largest mili-

tary defeat in Ukraine since Russia pulled back from areas near Kyiv after a botched attempt to capture the capital early in the invasion, Daily Mail reported. It comes as Russia's state media war correspondent

Alexander Sladkov accidentally revealed the scale of their losses in Ukraine, telling the Kremlin-run Rossiya 1 news channel that a 'huge number of people' have died, Bronk said. Bronk said Ukraine has 'baited Russia into accepting an attritional battle in a very militarily disadvantageous position', adding that Russia 'will be hard pressed simply to avoid any more disasters before winter'. The expert said it had been 'one of the most successful counter-offensives we've seen in modern history in terms of territory gained over a given speed of advance,' Daily Mail reported.

SHOOTING AT THAI ARMY COLLEGE KILLS 2

Bangkok: A shooting incident at a Thai army college in Bangkok on Wednesday claimed the lives of two people and injured another person, a military spokesperson said. The gunman, a 59-year-old staff worker at the Royal Thai Army War College, shot at his colleagues at around 8.55 a.m., Xinhua news agency quoted deputy army spokesperson Sirichan Ngathong as saying. The perpetrator was taken into custody after he surrendered to the police and the motive for the shooting is still unclear, he said.

Shanghai raises emergency response as typhoon Muifa approaches

Shanghai on Wednesday upgraded its typhoon emergency response to Level III, the third-highest, as Muifa, the 12th typhoon this year, moves closer. The municipal flood control and typhoon and drought relief headquarters raised the response level at 7 a.m. Wednesday, according to the flood control office of Shanghai. As of Wednesday morning, more than 1,900 ships had returned to port, and two tourist attractions and two parks had been temporarily closed, reports Xinhua news agency. The city had also assigned personnel to inspect dikes, construction sites and other areas as Shanghai braced for the typhoon. In China's Zhejiang province, the local flood control and typhoon and drought relief headquarters upgraded the emergency response to Level I, the highest level, on Tuesday afternoon. A total of 11,680 fishing boats had returned to port in the province by Tuesday noon. More than 719,800 people had been



evacuated to safe places by Wednesday morning. Muifa was observed over the ocean 185 km southeast of Xiangshan county in Zhejiang province at 10 a.m. Wednesday. It is expected to move northwestward at a speed of 20 to 25 km per hour, China's National Meteorological Centre said in a statement. The typhoon will make the first landfall in coastal areas between Sammen county and Zhoushan, Zhejiang province around nightfall. The second landfall is expected between the coastal areas of Jiaying city in Zhejiang and Shanghai's Pudong district on Wednesday evening, according to the forecast.

Pakistan's rivers to witness increased flows in coming days

Pakistan's National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) has forecasted that the upper catchments of the country's eastern rivers may get affected due to increased flows in the coming days. According to a report released by the NDMA, water flows may increase in the eastern rivers of Sutlej, Ravi, and Chenab, and their associated tributaries and canals from September 17-18, reports Xinhua news agency. The NDMA has directed all the concerned authorities to maintain an enhanced alert

level and monitor the developing situations to reduce reaction and response times, the report said. It has further notified the authorities to manage the timely evacuation of the at-risk population from low-lying and flood-prone areas as per evacuation plans and the availability of shelter, food and medicines in those shelter camps. The total death toll in Pakistan from this season's monsoon rains and floods since mid-June has risen to around 1,481 along with 12,748 injured.

Trump blasts 'weaponised' FBI as he fumes over seizure of My Pillows CEO's phone

Former President Donald Trump claimed the US had become a "weaponised police state" after fuming over a report that MyPillow CEO Mike Lindell's cellphone had been seized by the FBI. Lindell, one of the most prominent 2020 election conspiracy theorists, said federal agents took his phone while questioning him about Tina Peters, a Colorado clerk who is under incitement over allegations of tampering with election voting equipment, the Newsweek reported. Lindell posted a video online charging that he was targeted by a "weaponised" FBI, adding what happened to him was "disgusting." In a post on Truth Social, Trump also made a similar claim



while showing support for the man who frequently backs the "false claim" the former President lost the last election due to widespread voter fraud. "Our Country is a laughing stock all over the

World. The majesty of the United States is gone. Can't let this happen. TAKE BACK AMERICA!", he said. Speaking on his online show The Lindell Report, the MyPillow CEO

described how FBI agents approached him while he was at a Hardee's fast food restaurant in Mankato, Minnesota. Lindell said the agents asked him about Peters, Dominion Voting Systems, and Doug Frank, an Ohio math teacher who claims he has a mathematical algorithm to prove the last election was stolen from Trump, which has frequently been debunked. The agents then told Lindell they had a warrant to seize his phone and ordered him to turn it over. Lindell shared with the Washington Times a letter, he said, accompanied the search warrant which stated there is "an official criminal investigation of a suspected felony is being conducted by an agency of the United States and a Federal Grand Jury in the District

Wildfires burns over 3,200 hectares of land in France

Wildfires have burned over 3,200 hectares of land in France's southwestern department of Gironde, forcing 840 people to be evacuated, the local government announced in a statement. "More than 900 firefighters from Gironde and other departments will be mobilized, thanks to the arrival of reinforcements from other departments in the coming hours. Two Canadairs, one Dash (plane) and three water bomber helicopters have

been deployed since this morning," Xinhua news agency quoted the statement issued late Tuesday as saying. The local government said emergency accommodations are being offered to evacuees in Le Porge and other municipalities. No further evacuations are planned at this time, it added. More than 30,000 hectares of land had been burned in the department of Gironde this summer due to dry weather and heatwaves, according to media reports.



UPROAR OVER NUTRITIONAL DIET IN MADHYA PRADESH ASSEMBLY

Muslims are welcome at Garbas, if their sacred scripture permits them: Culture Minister

With the holy festival of 'Navratri' a few days away, the controversy on Garba dance in Madhya Pradesh has started again after Usha Thakur, the minister for tourism and culture, said that 'Garba' programmes have become places of 'Love Jihad', and "Muslims will be welcomed at Garbas if their sacred scripture Quran permits them to pursue idol worship."

The minister said that they (Muslims) aren't being invited to Garbas, but if "they are so high in faith for the Garbas, then they should have faith in idol worship also which should be allowed by their sacred scripture Quran as well". "Also, Muslim men, who have faith in pursuing idol worship will only be welcomed at Garba venues, if they come along with their female family members," Thakur told journalists in Bhopal on Tuesday.

The minister, however, reiterated that no one will be allowed at any Garba venues across the state without authentic identity proofs. "We are writing to all district collectors, requesting them to ensure that entry at Garbas during the coming Navratri celebrations is only allowed to those, who carry authentic ID proofs. This will stop those who



hide their actual identity from entering the Garba venues."

Last week, the minister stated that "Garbas in the past had turned into a big medium of 'Love Jihad' activities, but now all concerned stakeholders have become very alert about it. Just to ensure that no one enters the Garba venues by hiding their real identity, and no one should be allowed entry into the Garba pandals without proper ID proofs." While asking the Garba organisers to

ensure strict implementation of 'No Entry without ID proof at Garbas', the minister had said, "This is 'salaah' (advice) as well as 'naseehat' (instruction)."

Importantly, in 2013, while she was the BJP MLA from Indore, Thakur, ahead of Navratri celebrations had demanded ban on the entry of non-Hindus, particularly Muslims at the Garba venues, for preventing Muslim men from seducing Hindu girls and women. She had then demanded making Aadhaar and other ID proofs mandatory for entering the Garba venues to prevent Muslim men from entering the venues by posing themselves as Hindus.

In 2017, an umbrella group of Hindu festival organisers in Bhopal, the Hindu Utsav Samiti too had demanded from the district administration in the state capital to make possession of Aadhaar document necessary as the ID proof for entry into the Garba pandals to prevent the entry of non-Hindus (particularly Muslims) at those venues.

Garbas, which form a seminal part of Navratri celebrations, are organised across Madhya Pradesh during the Shardiya Navratri, but they are most popular in Malwa-Nimar/West Madhya Pradesh region, including Indore and adjoining districts.

TWO DEAD, 20 INJURED AFTER BUS FALLS INTO RIVER IN KHANDWA

At least two persons died while over 20 others were got injured after a private bus fell into a river in Madhya Pradesh's Khandwa district on Tuesday.

The bus (MP-09/FA6658) carrying around 40 passengers was heading toward Indore from Khandwa when it fell into Satsoi river. Officials said the injured persons have been rushed to nearby hospitals and the bus has been pulled out of the water. Preliminary inquiry by the local police revealed that the incident occurred due to overtaking at high-speed due to which the driver lost control of the bus.

The deceased have been identified as Kailash Chetram (45) and Radha Verma (50).

"At least 20 passengers got injured, out of which the condition of two is critical. All the injured passengers are being treated in Khandwa," the police said.



Meanwhile, Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan extended his condolence to the deceased and prayed for the speedy recovery of those injured in the incident.

There has been a serious crime in the hostel premises, so the junior doctors have been taken out of the hostel and taken to the police station. 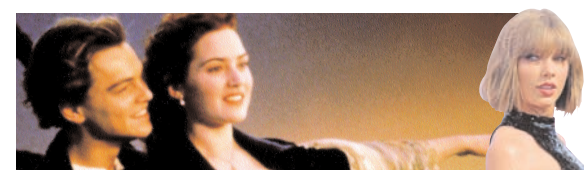

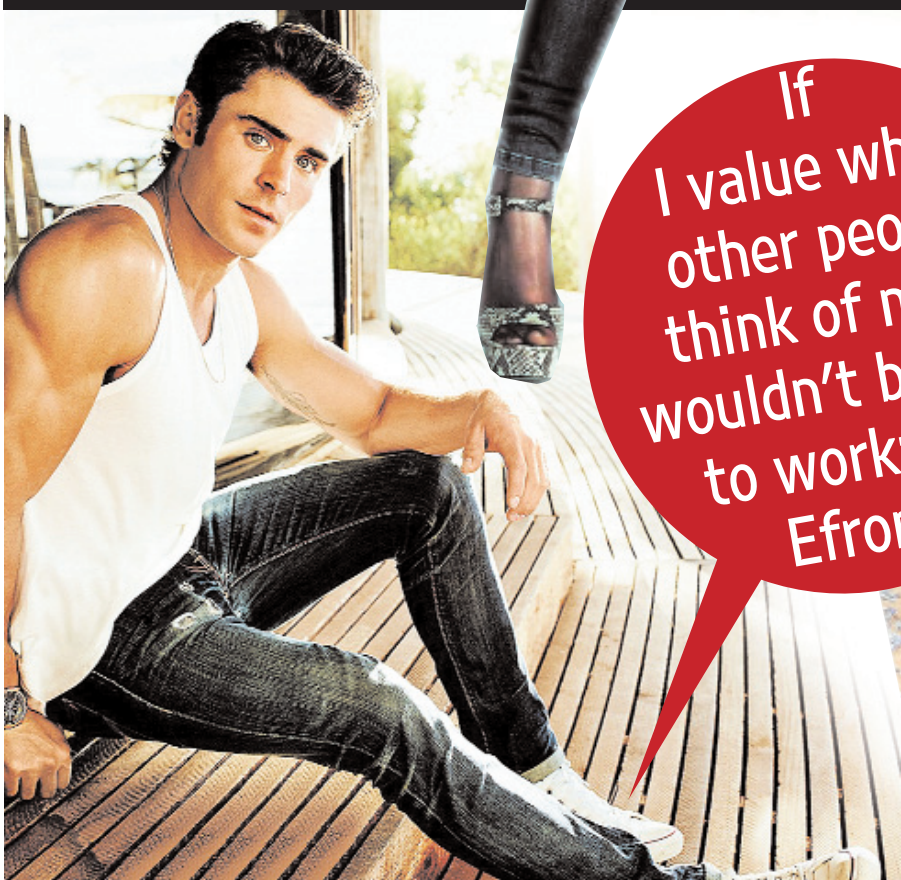

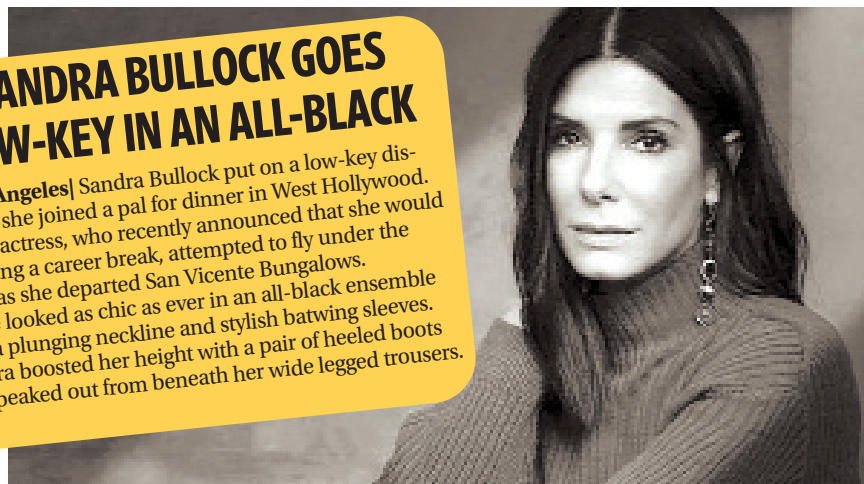

first 15 minutes of the film are the only sane part. After that, everything started happening at once. Which makes the viewer overwhelmed by the chaos.

To be more specific, the film is a visual treat. After a long time, we finally get to see a film that will blow your mind in a variety of ways. In terms of acting, each character in the film plays an important role and contributes to the film's

brilliance. Evelyn, played by Michelle Yeoh, is a Chinese-American immigrant who runs a facility with her husband Waymond (The Goonies and Temple Of Doom star Ke Huy Quan, who is finally back on our screens). Her story has a particularity. But her feelings are universal: she is overwhelmed by the relentlessness of her life, consumed by everything, everywhere, all at once.

She has a business to run, taxes to file, customers to please, a father to live up to, a husband to argue with, and a daughter to whom she is increasingly unable to relate. As a result, she's closed off, trapped under the weight of her failed hopes and dreams, struggling to maintain a life she despises.

Stephanie Hsu, who plays Joy (Evelyn's daughter), is a real delight. She is the antagonist, but not quite the antagonist.

Ke Huy Quan's brilliant performance backs up all of this. The actor has two roles and does so well that you can tell the difference even when nothing about his appearance changes.

It's so fascinating that you almost don't want science fiction to come in. But when it does, it does so spectacularly, with Waymond's 'Alphaverse' self-introducing Evelyn to alternate universes where she can be anything she wants: a singer, a chef, or an action-movie

star. With the multiversal evil Jobu Tupaki ("an agent of pure chaos") threatening to end everything, Evelyn must 'Verse-Jump' into her other life paths and use those skills to fight back. The events that follow are heart-pounding.

INDIA WOMEN THRASH ENGLAND TO LEVEL T20I SERIES 1-1

Following their nine-wicket defeat against England women in the opening T20 International, India hit back with an equally impressive comeback win as vice-captain Smriti Mandhana smashed an unbeaten half century to help the visitors level the series with an eight-wicket victory at the Country Ground in Derby late on Tuesday. The 53-ball 79 from Mandhana was enough for India to chase down a competitive 142/6 from England for the loss of just two wickets and with 20 balls to spare.

The deciding third T20I will be played at Bristol on Thursday, following which the focus will shift to the One-day International series beginning at Hove on September 18. On a day when Freya Kemp becomes the youngest woman to make a T20I half-century for England, the total proved too less for India who



batted with far more authority in the chase, with Shafali Verma (20) and Mandhana giving India a solid start of 55 runs. By the time the young opener departed in the sixth over, Verma had laid a solid foundation from where Mandhana just took off, hitting 13

boundaries and scoring at a strike rate of nearly 150. With none of the damp and soggy English conditions to trouble India after their travails in their opening game, which they lost by nine wickets, India went about their task in a cool manner at Derby's

Incora County Ground. England women lurched from 16/3 to 54/5 before 17-year-old left-hander Freya Kemp guided them to a face-saving score with an unbeaten 51. Mandhana then put on an opening partnership of 55 with Verma, who departed following a sharp return catch to Sophie Ecclestone. However, an unbroken stand of 69 with skipper Harmanpreet Kaur (29 not out) ensured victory for the tourists. In between, Dayalan Hemalatha lost her wicket to Freya Davies. Mandhana brought up the winning runs with a boundary off off Davies.

Uthappa shared a heartfelt post announcing his retirement from all forms of cricket on social media.

The right-handed batter said it has been "greatest honour" to represent India and Karnataka during this illustrious career.

"It has been my greatest honour to represent my country and my state, Karnataka. However, all good things must come to an end, and with a grateful heart, I have decided to retire from all forms of Indian cricket. Thank you all," Uthappa said on the Koo app.

Uthappa played the 2004 Under-19 World Cup. He made his international debut



two years later and featured in 46 ODIs and 13 T20Is for India.

"It's been 20 years since I started playing professional cricket, and it has been the greatest honour to represent my country and state, Karnataka - wonderful journey of ups and downs; one that has been fulfilling, rewarding, enjoyable and has

allowed me to grow as a human being," Uthappa further said in the post.

The stylish batter was a part of the Indian side which lifted the inaugural T20 World Cup in 2007 in South Africa. The batter from Karnataka has won two IPL trophies - one for KKR and one for CSK in 2014 and 2021 respectively.

Virat rises 14 spots to 15th on latest ICC T20I batter rankings

Star India batter Virat Kohli has risen 14 spots to 15th overall on the ICC T20I batter rankings due to his efforts in the recently-concluded Asia Cup in the UAE. Kohli scored his first international century in almost three years - against Afghanistan - and scored 276 runs in the continental showpiece event.



has also been rewarded for his dominant performances at the Asia Cup, while a new No.1 all-rounder has been crowned in the shortest format of the game.

Sri Lanka match-winner Hasaranga improved three places to sixth on the bowler rankings and seven spots to fourth on the all-rounder list after he was adjudged 'Player of the Tournament' at the Asia Cup.

On the list for T20I bowlers, India pacer Bhuvneshwar Kumar (up four spots to seventh) and Pakistan duo Haris Rauf (up nine places to equal 25th) and Mohammad Nawaz (up seven spots to 34th) were among the biggest movers after strong performances at the Asia Cup.

There was no movement inside the top 10 on the latest Test player rankings, but there were some big jumps made by England and South Africa players following the completion of their recent three-match series.

Kohli has some way to go before he is back into contention for the top ranking for T20I batters, but he is at least moving in the right direction now after returning to form during the Asia Cup.

The champion right-hander was the big mover near the top of the T20I batter rankings, with India team-mate KL Rahul (up seven places to 23rd) and Sri Lanka star Bhanuka Rajapaksa (up 34 spots to 34th) also making good ground on those players near the top.

Bayern down Barcelona in UEFA Champions League

Bayern Munich made it two wins from two in this season's UEFA Champions League after goals from Lucas Hernandez and Leroy Sane, edging a wasteful Barcelona 2-0 in Group C.

Barcelona started powerfully on the road and created the first opportunity as Pedri tested Bayern goalkeeper Manuel Neuer with a low shot from eight metres in the ninth minute.

Former Bayern striker Robert Lewandowski then had a great chance to break the deadlock, but the unmarked Pole pulled over the target with 18 minutes gone.

Lewandowski remained in the thick of things and kept Neuer busy as the Bayern keeper had to save a dangerous header on target three minutes later.

The visitors were the more energetic team as Raphinha unleashed a promising long-range effort at the half-hour mark, Cinhua reports.



Bayern needed some time to gain a foothold into the clash, with the next chance not coming until the 31st minute, when Marcel Sabitzer lacked accuracy in front of the goal.

Barcelona came out with all guns blazing after the restart and should

have opened the scoring, but Raphinha's hammer went just wide.

However, the opener was scored at the other end and against the run of the play, as Joshua Kimmich's long ball found Hernandez, who headed home to mark the opener in the 50th

minute. Bayern's goal shocked the visitors, and the home side made it 2-0 four minutes later, after Sane benefited from Jamal Musiala's good build-up work and through-ball to beat Barcelona custodian Marc-Andre ter Stegen.

Starc, Marsh, Stoinis to miss upcoming T20Is against India due to injuries

Australia trio of left-arm pacer Mitchell Starc, all-rounders Mitchell Marsh and Marcus Stoinis are set to miss the upcoming T20I series against India due to injuries.

Opener David Warner had already been rested from the trip and now, Starc (knee), Marsh (ankle) and Stoinis (side strain) have been ruled out of the short tour of India.

"Selectors felt with three games in six days across three cities - including travel to India and internally - Marsh, Stoinis and Starc are best served remaining in Australia to prepare for the ICC Men's T20 World Cup," said a statement from Cricket Australia (CA).

Earlier, a report in cricket.com.au said pacer Nathan Ellis, all-rounders Daniel Sams, and Sean Abbott will be the replacements for the injured trio



on their trip to India, with matches to take place on September 20, 23 and 25 in Mohali, Nagpur and Hyderabad respectively.

The last time Australia played a T20I series against India, it was in 2019, where Australia won two-match series 2-0. Marsh and Stoinis were injured during Australia's ODI series against

Zimbabwe at Townsville and against New Zealand at Cairns. But Starc, their pace spearhead, is a late exclusion from the tour to India after a scan on his knee in Sydney on Wednesday.

The trio's absence means that Australia will have some changes to their desired playing eleven on tour of India.

EQUESTRIAN STAR MIRZA EYES GLORY AS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP BEGINS ON THURSDAY

New Delhi: Ace Indian equestrian rider Fouaad Mirza is all set to compete in the FEI World Championship Eventing 2022, scheduled to commence in Pratoni del Vivaro, Italy on Thursday. The Asian Games double silver medalist, Mirza is the lone Indian to have qualified for the 15th edition of the World Championship Eventing, which will be conducted at the historic equestrian venue Pratoni del Vivaro.

The venue had hosted the Eventing discipline of the 1960 Rome Olympics.

"I'm very excited to participate in the World Championship at the historic venue where top riders from across the world will compete. I have trained hard in Germany while preparing for the event and I look forward to giving my best and bringing glory to the country. I would also like to thank the Sports Ministry and Equestrian Federation of India for their support and encouragement," the 30-year-old Indian rider said. The Bengaluru-born Mirza will enter the competition along with his horses, Seigneur Medicott and Dajara 4. Seigneur Medicott was part of Mirza's historic Tokyo Olympics campaign last year, where he became the first Indian to reach the Olympics final.

It was also the same horse, which helped Mirza win two silver medals at the 2018 Jakarta Asian Games.

CPL 2022: Mayers, Mujeeb star as Barbados score sixth win in a row

put together a fine rebuilding partnership to leave the home team well set at 100 for 4 with five overs to go. That did not last long.

TT FEDERATION MARRED BY CHAOS, NEEDS REVAMP: HC-APPOINTED COA

Observing the "sorry state of affairs" in the running of the Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI) and the need to revamp it, the Delhi High Court-appointed Committee of Administrators (CoA) on Wednesday observed that there is total mismanagement in TTFI's functioning with no record of any decision or meeting to take major decisions. In its 91-page report

submitted before the high court, the CoA said there "is a critical need to re-examine the entire byelaws and its constitution in view of not only the sports code, but also for fair and transparent execution of functions as they are being managed in an unprofessional manner".

The CoA, which was categorically clear in observing that the sport's governance in the country since long has been plagued by nepotism, fieldism, lack of accountability and financial irregularities, recommended that "there is also requirement of various effective steps, which are required to be taken by the TTFI in the procedure of election, the auditors, the appointment of ombudsman and for grievance redressal".

The high court, hearing a petition filed by ace women's paddler Manika Batra, had in February directed the appointment of an administrator to run the TTFI, saying its faith was shaken in view of the sports body's "sorry state of affairs".

Ganguly, Shah set for second innings as SC allows amendment to BCCI constitution

The Supreme Court on Wednesday allowed the Board of Control for Cricket in India's (BCCI) plea in connection with the amendments proposed to its constitution to relax the cooling-off period requirement.

The cooling-off period for office bearers will kick in after two consecutive terms at either the BCCI or at the state association level. The office bearers can now have a maximum of 12 years at one go: two three-year terms at the state association level and two three-year terms at the BCCI, and after this, the cooling-off will be applicable.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, representing the BCCI, submitted before a bench of Justices D.Y. Chandrachud and Hima Kohli that clause 6 as approved by the top court indicates that a person who has competed one term at the state cricket association level followed by one term at the BCCI



would have to undergo a three-year cooling off period.

Therefore, the cooling off-period would come into effect after only one

term at the BCCI.

Mehta had submitted before the bench that three years is a very short time period to prove leadership quali-

ties to take the sport forward, and urged this provision, in the existing constitution, be modified to reflect that it comes into effect after an office-bearer has completed two consecutive terms. On this existing cooling-off period rule, the top court said it is unduly stringent and needs to be modified with regard to the purpose with which cooling-off periods were introduced.

The proposed amendment enables the current President Saurav Ganguly and Secretary Jay Shah to seek a second term at BCCI. According to the unamended clauses, they would have attracted disqualification - they have completed one term each at the state association and the BCCI.

The top court noted submissions from senior advocate Maninder Singh, amicus curiae in the matter, that there was no justification in confining the cooling-off period to the President and Secretary, and it should extend to all office-bearers at the BCCI.

Synopsis: Siya is the tale of a 17-year-old rape victim who, in the end, is victimised by an ineffective justice system that has been used as a puppet by the wealthy.

Review: Siya, starring a perceptive Vineet Kumar Singh and Pooja Pandey, the movie's heart and soul, is directed by Manish Mundra, who previously served as producer on masterpieces such as Newton and Masaan.

Siya takes inspiration from at least six recent, closely related real-life occurrences. However, the Unnao and Hathras Rape Cases' shadows will stand out more clearly. Knowing what awaits our protagonist Siya Singh, as she goes about her day collecting genhu and lakdi on her bicycle, makes your heart turn to ice. She is kidnapped, subjected to continuous brutality, and chained to a bed without access to food or water as men alternate



turns assaulting her.

The movie is rife with outright use of power-political, financial, and social-in all three of these areas. Siya is constantly being reminded that she is small and weak. And subject to the desires of the powerful. She will be put down by force if she dared to reject one of their offers of "love."

Mundra presents us with literature that is brutal at its core in his directorial debut. This year, at least, nothing else like the film has come out of the Hindi film industry. It is simultaneously so upsetting and uncomfortable that it takes

you several hours or even days to process.

Vineet Kumar Singh, who portrays the backbone in Siya, never misses a beat. But Pooja Pandey is Siya's heart and soul. Within a matter of seconds, she sheds tears of pain, anger, and hopelessness. She is exceptional.

Without a doubt, the movie has incredible music. It has been kept very neatly by the decision-makers to intensify the movement.

Conclusion: This movie may be upsetting to you, but that's just how the world is. It's worth watching.
