FACT-CHECK SITE ALTNEWS FOUNDERS AMONG CONTENDERS FOR NOBEL PEACE PRIZE

PRAISED FOR THE JOB

Fact-checkers Mohammed Zubair and Pratik Sinha have been listed as contenders to win the 2022 Nobel Peace Prize by Time magazine. According to Time, the co-founders of fact-check site AltNews, Sinha and Zubair are among the contenders to win the prize based on nominations that were made public via Norwegian lawmakers, predictions from bookmakers, and picks from the Peace Research Institute Oslo (PRIO).

ubair was arrested in June this year for a 2018 tweet that was "highly provocative and more than sufficient to incite feelings of hatred" as per a Delhi Police First Information Report (FIR). The Delhi Police charged him for promoting enmity between different groups on grounds of religion and deliberate acts to out-



rage religious sentiments. The fact-checker's arrest sparked global outrage, prompting the American non-profit Committee To Protect Journalists to issue a statement saying, "another low for press freedom in India, where the government has created a hostile and unsafe press reporting on sectarian issues." Zubair walked out of Tihar Jail a month later after being granted bail by the Supreme Court.

There are about 343 candidates -251 are individuals and 92 are organizations - in the running for the Nobel Peace Prize for 2022.

Although the Nobel Committee

does not announce the names of nominees, neither to the media nor to the candidates, a Reuters survey has found Belarusian opposition politician Sviatlana Tsikhanouskaya, broadcaster David Attenborough, cli mate activist Greta Thunberg, Pope Francis, Tuvalu's foreign minister Simon Kofe, and Myanmar's National Unity government are among those nominated by Norwegian lawmakers.

"Neither the names of nominators nor of nominees for the Nobel Peace Prize may be divulged until the start of the year marking the 50th anniversary of the awarding of a particular prize," reads the Nobel Committee's rules on nominations for the peace

Besides Sinha and Zubair, Ukraine President Volodomyr Zelensky, The UN Refugee Agency, the World Health Organisation (WHO) and Russian dissenter and Vladimir Putin critic Alexey Navalny are also contenders for the peace prize.

The winners of the 2022 Nobel Peace Prize will be announced at 11 am local time on 7 October in Oslo.

Fresh threats to Mukesh Ambani and family, Reliance Foundation hospital

resh death threats were made on Wednesday to billionaire industrialist Mukesh Ambani and his family members, and to blow up the Sir H. N. Reliance Foundation Hospital in south Mumbai.

Calls were received at the at 12.57 p.m. and at 5.04 p.m. warning to blow up the hospital building, said an official spokesperson.

The caller also threatened to take the lives of Ambani, his wife Nita Ambani, and their children Akash and Anand.

The hospital has lodged a formal police complaint and investigations have been

launched. The latest development came barely five days after the Central government upgraded Ambani's security from Z to Z+ from the CRPE. while his wife already is



accorded a Y+ cover This is the second time in 50 days that the Ambani family and the hospital have been similarly targeted with

Deadlock continues over CJI's move to elevate 4 judges to Supreme Court


he Chief Justice of India U.U. Lalit-led collegium may not be able to recommend any name to the Centre for filling up four vacant Supreme Court judges' posts, as the deadlock over the proposal to recommend new judges continues.

It is learnt that two of the five-member apex court collegium have opposed the proposal to recommend four new judges, which includes an an court lawyer, to the top court through a written note instead of a formal meeting.

Chief Justice Lalit is slated to retire on November 8, and the apex court is scheduled to reopen on October 10, by which the less than one-month-rule - in which an outgoing CJI cannot make any recommendation if the length of his remaining tenure is less than a month - would kick in.

According to sources, the two judges who have opposed to the written proposal to recommend judges for the appointment to the apex court are of firm view that holding a collegium meeting by circulation of proposal, instead of a face-to-face discussion, is not heard of.

The Chief Justice of India, who heads the collegium, had written to its four members Justices D.Y. Chandrachud, S.K. Kaul, S. Abdul Nazeer, and K.M. Joseph -- earlier this month seeking their consent for the elevation of Punjab and Haryana High



Court Chief Justice Ravi Shankar Jha, Patna High Court Chief Justice Sanjay Karol, Manipur High Court Chief Justice P.V. Sanjay Kumar, and senior advocate K.V. Viswanathan.

One of the collegium members had said that he has no objection to the CJI's proposal. However, two judges maintained that decision over names of judges for the appointment to the apex court cannot be done by circulating a proposal.

The one-month rule will not allow Chief Justice Lalit to hold a collegium meeting after October 8 while the apex court will reopen two days later. The CJI circulated a written proposal after a collegium meeting scheduled on September 30, the last working day before the Dussehra holiday, could not take place as Justice Chandrachud heard cases past 9 p.m.As per the convention, the government writes o the outgoing CJI to nominate his successor and the CJI recommends the name of the most senior judge, a month before retirement. After the name is recommended, the incumbent CJI usually does not take decision on the recommendation for the appointment of new judges, and leaves it for the new CJI.So far, the collegium, headed by CJI Lalit, has recommended elevation of Bombay High Court Chief Justice Dipankar Dutta as judge of the apex

A statement, uploaded on the apex court website, said: "The Supreme Court Collegium in its meeting held on 26th September, 2022 has recommended elevation of Justice Dipankar Datta, Chief Justice of Bombay High Court (PHC: Calcutta), as Judge of the Supreme Court". Justice Dutta's parent high court is the Calcutta High Court.

At present, the apex court is functioning with 29 judges as against the sanctioned strength of 34

ABSCONDING RAPE ACCUSED ENDS LIFE BY SUICIDE IN UP

Sambhal (Uttar Pardesh): A 21year-old man, accused of raping a minor deaf and mute girl, ended his

life by consuming poison. He had allegedly raped the girl on Saturday and was absconding after the police filed a case following a complaint by her father.

Additional SP Shrish Chandra said, "The rape accused was hiding in Aligarh and returned with his brother on Sunday. He then went to his sister's house in a village in Rajpura area. He started vomiting and was admitted to a nearby hospital, where he died on Tuesday. We have sent the body for autopsy. It

seems to be a case of poisoning." The police official said that the accused worked as a daily wager, and was a resident of a village in the Bahjoi area of the district.

The accused's brother said, "My brother was scared as he was in a relationship with the girl but her parents lodged a rape complaint against him. We tried to convince the girl's family to get the two married but they refused and sought police action. Fearing police action and jail term, he consumed some poisonous substance and killed

U'khand bus accident: 25 bodies recovered, many feared missing; U'khand CM reviews rescue ops

s many as 25 bodies have been recovered while many others are still feared missing after a bus travelling at a high speed fell into the Nayar river near the CMD band of Bironkhal in Uttarakhand's Pauri district, disaster control room officials said.

There were more than 50 processions in the bus while the rescue operation team has so far retrieved 25 bodies. Rescue operations are facing problems due to darkness. The death toll is expected to rise since there are many people reportedly missing.

On receiving information about the bus accident in Pauri district, Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami reached the disaster control room located at the Secretariat.

He took detailed information about the accident from the officials and also spoke to Pauri District Magistrate over the phone and instructed him to carry out relief and rescue work with utmost

Dhami directed the State Disaster Control Room officials to continuously monitor the situation



and be in constant touch with the district officials.

The Chief Minister added that all possible help will be provided at the government level and also spoke to the Lansdowne MLA over the phone.

Terming the bus accident as unfortunate, Dhami has directed to make arrangements for all possible treatment of the injured persons and speed up the relief and rescue operations with coordina-

The Chief Minister directed the Uttarakhand Secretary (Disaster Management), Ranjit Sinha, that the disaster management system should be operated continuously and the situation should be kept under constant watch.

Dhami himself is supervising all the preparations. Sub-Divisional Magistrate and ambulance, lights, rescue equipment, two ambulances from Ramnagar, one ambu-

lance from Haldwani and relief materials are being sent to the affected site. Proper arrangements have been made in the hospitals of Ramnagar and Haldwani.

The District Magistrates of Nainital and Almora are themselves monitoring all the arrangements. The Chief Minister also inquired about the situation in Uttarkashi and has postponed all the government programmes proposed on Wednesday

Fake job racket: MEA rescued 45 trapped in Myanmar so far

lerting people about dubious employment offers from overseas, the Ministry of External Affairs said on Wednesday that it has so far rescued 45 Indians from Myanmar who were trapped in fake job rackets. "We have been actively

pursuing the case of Indians being trapped in fake job rackets in Myanmar. Thanks to the efforts of @IndiainMyanmar & @IndiainThailand, around 32 Indians had already been rescued. Another 13 Indian citizens have now been rescued. & reached Tamil Nadu today," MEA spokesperson

Arindam Bagchi tweeted. Giving more information, the official said. "Some more Indian citizens have been rescued from their fake employers and are in custody of Myanmar authorities for illegal entry into that country. Legal formalities have been initiated to get them repatriated at the earliest.



Instances of similar job rackets have also come to light from Laos and Cambodia. Indian Embassies in Vientiane, Phnom Penh and Bangkok have been helping in repatriating people from there as the details of agents allegedly involved in this racket have been shared with the relevant authorities in various Indian states, Bagchi said.

These dubious IT firms, engaged in call-centre scams and cryptocurrency frauds, offer jobs to lure Indian youth for the posts of digital sales and marketing executives in Thailand. The firms have captured the attention of Indian Embassies in Bangkok and Myanmar, stated the Ministry in the advisory against fake job rackets issued on September 24.

Congress in search of tribal face to head Jharkhand unit

New Delhi: Congress is in search of new state chief in Jharkhand after the recent turmoil where three of its MLAs were caught in West Bengal with a large amount of cash allegedly as first part of a deal to switch sides - and suspended.

However, the new state President, to succeed incumbent Rajesh Thakur, is likely to be appointed after election for the Congress President's post later this month.

With the party focussing on a tribal face, Lok Sabha member and wife of former Chief Minister Madhu Koda, Geeta Koda is said to be the front runner, while Bandhu Tirkey and Kalicharan Munda are other contenders, party sources said.

Meanwhile, the state of affairs in the party unit is far from being peaceful.

Congress has four ministers -Alamgir Alam, Ramshwar Oraon, Banna Gupta, and Badal Patralekh in the JMM-led government, and sources say MLAs and leaders have expressed dissatisfaction over their working style, and several voices have been raised for a change.

Of the 18 Congress MLAs in the state, five are women, but they complain despite winning in such a large number for the first time, not a single woman MLA was given a ministerial

A Congress woman MLA said: "On hand, the party gives the slogan of 'Ladki hoon, lad sakti hoon' (I am a girl, I can fight), but on the other hand, the women who have won in the Assembly polls are not considered worthy of becoming a minister. This contradiction should be

The organisational structure of the Congress in the state is also not good. Since 2017, the party has not been able to constitute the Committee, and the organisation in the state is being run by the state President, three-four executive

Asked why the state committee could not be formed in the state in the past five to six years, state chief Thakur said: "This time, all processes

Two headless bodies found, heads still missing

Uttarkashi Avalanche: Six climbers rescued, says ITBP New Delhi Agencies

ONE PILOT KILLED, **ANOTHER INJURED AS** ARMY CHOPPER CRASHES IN ARUNACHAL



Itanagar: A pilot was killed and another injured when a Cheetah helicopter of Army Aviation crashed near Arunachal Pradesh's Tawang on Wednesday, officials

Defence spokesman Lt. Col Mahendra Rawat said that the Cheetah helicopter. which was on a routine sortie, crashed at around 10 a.m. injuring both the pilots and they were immediately evacuated to nearest Military Hospital.

"With regret to inform that one of the pilots Lt Col Saurabh Yadav, who was critically injured, succumbed to the injuries during treatment."The second pilot is under medical treatment. The cause of the crash at this stage is not known. Details are being ascertained," he said.

Expressing his deep shock, Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister Pema Khandu offered all assistance.

"Pained by the news of crash of helicopter at Nyamjang Chu near BTK area of Jemeithang circle in Tawang district. I am in touch with the Army officials for every possible assistance, and pray for speedy recovery of the injured pilots," he tweeted.

Eastern Army Command chief, Lt General R.P. Kalita also expressed his deep sorrow over the accident.

"Lt General Kalita and all ranks offer tributes to the supreme sacrifice of Lt Col Saurabh Yadav in the line of duty on 05 Oct 2022 while flying a Cheetah Helicopter near Tawang, Arunachal Pradesh. Eastern Command offers deepest condolences to the family," a defence statement said.

Goa to introduce 'Multimodal Transport App' for last mile connectivity

oa's Transport Minister, Mauvin Godinho, on Wednesday said that the government will launch 'Multimodal transport App' to give choice to visitors at affordable rates for last mile connectivity."One who lands in Goa at Dabolim airport, whether he or she wants to travel by taxi, bus or rickshaw or motorcycle pilot (a two-wheeler taxi), they can choose mode of transport through this App. It will give last mile connectivity," Godinho said here.

He said that the government will bring more electrical buses in the fleet of state government-operated Kadamba Transport Corporation to give good service to the people of Goa.

"Mopa airport will be a game changer for Goa. It is going to change the entire system of functioning in many ways. Today, perhaps, we might be not aware of its impact," he said.

Godinho said that recently he visited Mopa airport to check how transportation



can be improved."As mining is suspended, we are dependent on tourism (for economy). We have to take steps and decision to increase footfall of tourists. As both airports, Dabolim and Mopa, will function, tourism will increase and we will need more Kadamba buses. Hence, we will try to get more electrical buses,' he said. "Today we order everything on phone. This is new era. Thus we need to give facilities of transport to book on phone," he said urging app-based trans-

port should not be opposed.

He said that Multimodal Transport App

will help make advance booking. "We need to think how people can get cheaper and affordable transport mode," he said."After Mopa Airport is commissioned, we will have to revive infrastructure of Goa. "Mopa airport, being run by private operator, will have all type of taxis. Whether it is Ola, Uber, Goa Miles, Rent a Car, prepaid taxi. If we fail to give such facilities at Dabolim Airport then people will prefer to land at Mopa airport. Hence, those who are opposing app-based transport system should think over this," he said.Godinho said that he has taken taxi operators from Dabolim airport in confidence and they have shown positivity for 'Multimodal Transport App'. "We will launch it in next 10 days," he said.



the police many times, but neither the police patrol nor the police come here in the evening.



Body of teen couple who eloped found hanging from tree

n a shocking incident, the bodies of a teenage couple (an 18-year-old youth and a 15-year-old girl) who eloped from their houses were found hanging from a tree in Himmatgarh village falls under Dhar district.

As per details, the two were in a relationship. Meanwhile, the family members of the girl fixed her marriage near Rajgarh. The duo went missing from their houses on Tuesday evening to avoid marriage. Their relatives began a manhunt but were taken aback to find their bodies

Forensic Science Laboratory Report (FSL) has also been apprised about the incident. TI suspected it to be a suicide but the police are currently investigating all the possible angles. No suicide note has been discovered at the crime scene. The post-mortem of bodies was conducted by a panel of three doctors. Further reports are awaited. According to the FSL team, a teen couple committed suicide by hanging from a tree in order to avoid marriage. Police have also recovered their phones. Their call detail records revealed that the boy had spoken to the girl for a long time now. A police force has been deployed in the village to avoid untoward incidents

Why Twittereties follow celebrities more than political 'elites'

ost Twitter users don't follow political elites and they are much more likely to follow celebrities than an elected official, suggest researchers. Despite the prominence and impact of presidents, congressmen, journalists, pundits and the news media, researchers found that only 40 per cent of Twitter users follow one or more political "elites" and the remaining 60 per cent follow no political actors at all, according to the study published in the journal Science Advances."Those users who do follow political accounts on Twitter, however, stick to insular online communities and mostly follow and share information from their political ingroup," said Magdalena Wojcieszak, lead author and professor of communication at the University of California, Davis, and the University of Amsterdam. In other words, speaking to ongoing debates about so-called "echo chambers" on social media platforms, the small group of users who do follow political elites display clear political biases and engage with these elites in a very one-sided way. The findings come after researchers analysed four years' worth of data from a sampling of 1.5 million Twitter users. Researchers concluded that even though the group of social media users who display political biases in their online behaviours is small, it is nevertheless consequential. The research also reveals important ideological asymmetries: conservative users are roughly twice as likely as liberals to share ingroup versus out-group content, as well as to add negative commentary to out-group shares. Given a growing radicalisation in America, decreasing support for democratic norms, and rising support for political violence, concerns about political biases on social media platforms are valid, no matter how small the groups displaying those biases may be.

INDIA'S GROWING DEFENCE EXPORTS

ndia's defence exports to various countries have increased manifold in recent years, the latest deal is to export Indian rocket launchers to Armenia. According to reports, India would supply the 'Pinaka' multi-rocket launcher system, which can fire a salvo of 12 HE rockets in 44 seconds to Armenia besides anti-tank missiles and a variety of ammunition as part of a package agreement. The complete details of these armaments have not yet been disclosed. Pinaka saw service during the Kargil War, where it was successful in neutralising enemy positions on the mountaintops.

While the deal's value has not been disclosed, the report claims armament worth \$250 million or Rs 2,000 crore would be sold over the next few months. The deal was signed earlier this month and supplies are to be fast-tracked

It is not the first time that Armenia has received weapons equipment from India. In 2020, India triumphed over Russia and Poland in a \$40 million defence agreement

with Armenia providing it with four indigenous 'Swathi' counter-battery radars. This disclosure comes days after India called on the "aggressor side" in fresh fighting along the Armenia-Azerbaijan border to "immediately cease hostilities" without directly naming Azerbaijan. Latest fighting erupted

between the two sides on September 13.

Meanwhile, it seems the Armenian-Azerbaijan conflict has helped India to boost its arms exports. According to reports, India recently announced figures for the highestever defence export growth that swelled by a staggering 334 per cent over the last five years.

IN FACT, INDIA IS CHASING AN EVEN HIGHER TARGET.

In 2020, the Narendra Modi government had set a target of Rs 35,000 crore (\$5 billion) export in aerospace, and defence goods and services in the next five years. This is part of the turnover of Rs 1.75 lakh crore (\$25 billion) in defence manufacturing by 2025 that the government is aiming to achieve.

India's defence exports touched a record Rs 13,000 crore in 2021-22, "eight times" of what it was around five years ago.

Besides the strategic importance of the deal with Armenia, the export order is a boost for



the indigenous defence industry with the Indian government keen to increase the value of Indian arms exports. India had also signed a contract with the Philippines in January 2022 for the sale of BrahMos missiles.

Currently, India exports defence equipment to 75 countries and these include weapon simulators, tear gas launcher, torpedo loading mechanism, alarm monitoring & control, night vision monocular & binocular, light-weight torpedo & fire control systems, armoured protection vehicle, weapons locating radar, high-frequency radio, coastal surveillance radar among others.

ARMENIA-AZERBAIJAN CONFLICT

The issue of the conclave of Nagorno-Karabakh has always been the bone of contention between Armenia and Azerbaijan ever since the two countries became independent republics, after gaining independence from the erstwhile USSR. The disputed region of Nagorno-Karabakh lies in Azerbaijan and is

inhabited mostly by ethnic Armenians. The conflict escalated into a full-scale war in the early 1990s which later transformed into alow-intensity conflict until four-day escalation in April 2016 and then into another full-scale war in 2020.

A ceasefire signed in 1994 in Bishkek was followed by two decades of relative stability, which significantly deteriorated along with

status quo, at odds with Armenia's efforts to cement it. Azerbaijan, for one, has received backing from its traditional allies and supporters, Turkey and Israel. During the 2020 skirmish between the two combatants, Baku turned the tide in its favour by overwhelming ly deploying Turkish Bayraktar and Israeli kamikaze drones. While Armenia has often turned to Russia for support, Moscow's preoccupation with the on-going war against Ukraine has resulted in not a very supportive response, this time. In the face of rising hostilities and little military aid, the defence deal with India may prove to be a shot in the arm for a beleaguered Armenia.

AZERBAIJAN-TURKEY-PAKISTAN RELATIONSHIP

India's military assistance for Armenia comes against the backdrop of its regional rival's bonhomie with Azerbaijan. Pakistan has consistently backed Azerbaijan in the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict and has refused to establish diplomatic ties and legally recognise Armenia as an independent state.

Azerbaijan is seen by many as part of an emerging axis with Turkey and Pakistan. It has used Turkish drones to fight war against Armenia, and is also in talks with Pakistan to buy the JF-17 fighter aircraft.

In 2017, Turkey, Azerbaijan,

Agreement that established security cooperation, and built upon previous bilateral military aid arrangements. These three countries also conducted a joint exercise named 'Three Brothers' last year. The rise of Azerbaijan with increased Turkey-Pakistan military cooperation is a direct warning to India.

Azerbaijan has acquired many deadly weapons by increasing friendship with Turkey and Pakistan in the name of Islam. Indian fears that other countries may also go along this route in the name of Islamic countries are not unfounded. However, in spite of these developments, an interesting fact is that India has stronger economic ties with Azerbaijan than with Armenia. Indian company ONGC has also invested heavily in Azerbaijan's gas sector. The Indian bilateral trade with Azerbaijan in 2019 stood at \$1,093 million, while with Armenia it was only \$48 million in 2020. Broadly this latest defence deal will place India as one of the emerging global powers with rising defence exports capability. In addition it will also allow it to play a significant role in the central Asian republics and

SKOREA, US FIRE 4 MISSILES INTO EAST SEA IN RESPONSE TO NKOREA'S PROVOCATION

outh Korea and the United States fired four ground-to-ground missiles into the East Sea on Wednesday in joint drills, a day after North Korea's intermediate-range ballistic missile (IRBM) launch, according to the South's military.

The two sides each launched two Army Tactical Missile System (ATACMS) missiles, which precisely hit mock targets and demonstrated the allies' capability to deter further provocations, the Joint Chiefs of Staff (JCS)

On Tuesday, the North fired an IRBM from Mupyong-ri in its northern province of Jagang in its first launch of an IRBM in eight months. It flew around 4.600 kilometers over Japan and landed in the Pacific, Yonhap news agency reported.

The allies are maintaining a full readiness amid the possibility of additional provoca-



tions by the North, the JCS said in a press release without specifying the exact location and time of the drills. Residents in and around the eastern coastal city of Gangneung said they saw a bright flash and heard a strong roar apparently from

the training at around 1:00 a.m. The South's military, meanwhile, fired one Hyunmoo-2 ballistic missile, but it fell within the base after

an abnormal flight. It said there have been no casualties reported as it is looking into the exact cause

of the incident.

South Korea and the US held a joint air training Tuesday, in which a South Korean F-15K fighter fired two Joint Direct Attack Munition (JDAM) precision bombs at a firing range on a Yellow Sea island.

POWER OUTAGE HITS BANGLADESH AS NATIONAL GRID COLLAPSES

Dhaka: Power outage has hit several areas of langladesh includi Dhaka, port city of Chattogram and Sylhet, due to a collapse of the South Asian country's national grid.

Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB) Director of Public Relation, Shameem Hasan informed that the national power grid failed and caused the power outage in many areas except some parts of the north, a state news media reported on Tuesday. "Due to the national grid failure, people of many areas of Dhaka, Chattogram, Sylhet and Cumilla area are not getting electricity since 2:05 p.m. today," Hasan said as quoted by Xinhua news agency report. Engineers of both BPDB and Power Grid Company of Bangladesh (PGCB) have been working to restore electricity transmission across the country, according to the state news media report.

The Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR), the media wing of the Pakistani military, said on Tuesday in a statement that in the first incident terrorists opened fire on a military convoy in the Hassan Khel area of the provincial capital of Peshawar. "Troops initiated a prompt response, effectively engaged and killed three terrorists," said the ISPR, adding that two soldiers also lost their lives during the exchange of fire. The ISPR said that weapons and ammunition were seized from the killed terrorists, Xinhua news agency reported. In the second encounter the security personnel shot dead four terrorists in an exchange of fire in the Tank district of the province, the ISPR added.





Mumbai Assembly bypoll: Cong, NCP support Shiv Sena candidate

n a boost for Shiv Sena (Uddhav group), the Congress and Nationalist Congress Party have declared support to its candidate in the upcoming Andheri East Assembly by-elections, party leaders said here on Wednesday.

The bypoll is necessitated owing to the demise of the sitting Sena legislator, Ramesh Latke, who died

The Sena has fielded his widow, Rutuja Ramesh Latke for the November 3 by elections, hoping to garner the sympathy votes.

She will take on the Bharatiya Janata Party's former BrihanMumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) corporator Murji Patel, who is considered a popular

This is the first crucial electoral test for the Sena President and former Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray after the collapse of the Maha Vikas Aghadi government in June.

The election has triggered a keen tussle between Thackeray and the rival faction led by the BJP-supported Chief Minister Eknath Shinde who toppled

Maharashtra Congress President Nana Patole said today that the party will not field its own candidate but will support the MVA nominee who is contesting on a Sena ticket.

NCP National Spokesperson also said that the party will support the Sena nominee for the

bypolls.
"The MVA was formed after the 2019 Assembly elections to keep the communal BJP out of power for the benefit of the state. During our tenure of two-and-half years, we took many welfare decisions and did good work during the unprecedented Covid-19 crisis," said Patole.

However, the BJP at the Centre misused the central agencies like the ED and CBI to bring down the MVA regime by taking away the Sena MLAs, he

Patole pointed out how, when all BJP efforts to break the MVA alliance failed, they created a rift in the Sena to oust the state government in June.

The three parties will now go all-out to ensure the victory of Rutuja R. Latke over the BJP nominee Murji Patel, they added.

5 men killed in 5 vehicles crash on Sea Link

n a shocking tragedy on Dassehra, five men were killed in a major road crash Linvolving an ambulance and four cars speeding on the Bandra Worli Sea Link, early on Wednesday morning, the BMC Disaster Cell said. According to the BMC officials, the accident took place around 2.15 hours on the southern (Worli side) arm of the sea link.

Besides the fatalities, another 8 persons, including some toll-post staffers were also

hurt in the pileup of the five vehicles. The deceased have been identified as: Stenar Jagdish Kadam, 36, Somnath Barnale,

32, Rajendra Singhal, 40, Gajraj Singh, 42, and Satendra Singh, 35.

Among the injured is a 28-year-old woman Aliya Khan and all the victims have been admitted to various city hospitals, said the BMC. Prime Minister Narendra Modi expressed "pain" over the loss of lives in the Mumbai accident.

"Condolences to the bereaved families. I hope that those who have been injured have a speedy recovery." According to a preliminary probe, a speeding car crashed into the ambulance and three other vehicles which had halted there to take some victims of an earlier

RELIANCE CAPITAL RESOLUTION PROCESS DEADLINE TO BE EXTENDED BY 90 DAYS TO FEB 1

he completion deadline for Reliance Capital resolution process is to be extended by 90 days to February 1, 2023. The current deadline ends on November

The administrator is all set to approach NCLT Mumbai to seek 90 days' extension. This will be the third extension, as the timeline has been extended twice in the past.

As per the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC) rules, the administrator had to originally close the resolution of Reliance Capital within 180 days -- by June 3.

Earlier, the lenders of Reliance Capital had given an extension of 30 days to the bidders for submission of binding bids, along with an EMD of Rs 75 crore, by October 31.

The bidders were not happy with this 30 days' extension as most of them had sought extension by 2-4

Reliance Capital had for its multiple businesses.



Six companies had submitted bids for the entire company, while rest of the bidders had submitted bids for its multiple subsidiaries

Torrent, IndusInd, Oaktree, Cosmea Financial, Authum Investment, and B Right Real Estate have submitted bids in the range of Rs 4,000 crore to Rs 4,500 crore for Reliance Capital's entire assets.

For Reliance General Insurance business, Piramal Finance has bid Rs 3,600 crore, while Zurich Insurance's bid is Rs 3,700 crore. The third bidder, i.e., Advent, has bid Rs 7,000 crore for Reliance General Insurance.

Piramal and Zurich are now

considering a joint bid for Reliance's general insurance business.

As per the actuarial valuation. Reliance General Insurance is valued at Rs 9,450 crore.

Residents of a non-descript village in Maharashtra celebrate Dussehra in a different way as they perform the 'aarti' of demon king Ravana on the festival when his effigies are burnt in other parts of the

Many residents of Sangola village in Maharashtra's Akola district believe they are employed and able to sustain their livelihood because of Ravana's blessings and the peace and happiness in their village is because of the demon king.

Locals claim the tradition of worshipping Ravana for his "intelligence and ascetic qualities" has been going on in the village for last 300 years. At the centre of the village stands a tall black stone statue of the 10-headed demon king.

The villagers believe in Lord Ram, but they also have faith in Ravana and do not burn his effigies, local resident Bhivaji Dhakre told news agency on the occasion of Dussehra.

Visitors from across the country come to this small village on Dussehra every year to catch a glimpse of the Lanka king's statue and some even



Sangola resident Subodh Hatole said, "With the blessings of Mahatma Ravana, today many people in the village are employed. On the day of Dussehra, we worship the statue of Ravana with a maha-aarti." Some of the villagers hail Ravana as a "scholar" and believe he abducted Sita for "political reasons and preserved her sanctity". Dhakre said Local temple priest Haribhau

Lakhade said while the rest of the country burns effigies of Ravana on Dussehra, symbolising the victory of good over evil, residents of Sangola worship the demon king for his "intelligence and ascetic qualities".

Lakhade said his family has since long been worshipping Ravana and claimed the happiness, peace and contentment in the village is because

Mumbai: A contribution report of Mumbai-based AB General Electoral Trust disclosed that the trust donated Rs 10 crore to the BJP in the financial year 2021-22. "But the party organization is above any person. I am not disgruntled with anyone. I shall start preparations for 2024 polls if the party gave me a ticket," she said.

She changed herself as much as she could, and now it was the turn of those who wanted her to change, she said. Munde was a cabinet minister in the

Devendra Fadnavis-led government in the state between 2014 and 2019. But she did not make it to the cabinet when the BIP came to power again this June in alliance with the Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena faction

World' first Everest scalar woman was chief guest at RSS' Vijayadashami Event

arking a change in its tradition, the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh invited a woman for the first time in its history in the form of mountaineer Santosh Yadav as the chief guest at the annual RSS Vijayadashmi festival on Wednesday.

The festival was inaugurated by RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat who also performed the 'weapon worship' (shastra puja) on the occasion.

Santosh Yadav has been a mountaineer who created a world record by becoming the first woman in the world to scale Mount Everest twice.

Addressing the occasion, Bhagwat called for a "comprehensive policy on population" and said that it should be applied equally to all.

"It is true that the higher the population, the greater the burden. If the population is used properly, it becomes a resource. We also have to consider how many people our country can feed and support after 50 years. Population imbalance leads to changes in geographical boundaries.. Population control and religion-based population balance is an important subject that can no longer be ignored...So a comprehensive population policy should be brought and should be equally applicable to all. Only then rules pertaining to population control will yield results," he said. Bhagwat also advocated giving equal rights to women in all places. "Considering a woman as the mother is good, but restricting them to closed doors is not good. There is a need to give equal



rights to women to take decisions everywhere. All the work that the mother power can do that man cannot do, they have so much power. And therefore it is important to enlighten, and empower them and give them the freedom to work and give equal participation in the work in this way," he said. "Power is the foundation of peace. The presence of a woman chief guest has been discussed a long time," the RSS chief added.

Bhagwat said that the government's policies are leading the country towards self-reliance. "The government is pursuing policies which lead towards self-reliance. Bharat's importance and stature has increased in the community of nations. In the sphere of security, we are becoming more and more become self-sufficient. Our economy is getting back to the pre-pandemic levels, which is expected to rise further. The sportspersons are also bringing laurels to the country," he said.

The Vijayadashmi programme is considered to be of great significance for RSS, as the Sangh was founded by Keshav Baliram Hedgewar on this very day back in 1925. Last year, the Vijayadashmi programme of RSS was done in restricted numbers only, due to the COVID restrictions.




In 2020, Gunn tweeted that he "tried" to make Velma a lesbian in the live-action

INDIAN SUPER LEAGUE TO KICK OFF ON OCT 7 WITH MORE EXCITEMENT THAN EVER

he Hero Indian Super League (ISL) is set to return on October 7 and is poised to be bigger and more exciting than ever. The season will welcome back its 12th Man - the fans, who come back to cheer their teams at the stadiums.

With a productive pre-season, where most Hero ISL teams sent their first teams to participate in the Durand Cup, the clubs are all set to give fans an enthralling experience across the season.

Last season's champions Hyderabad FC will aim to become the first Hero ISL team to defend their crown successfully, but will have healthy competition to contend

With some major transfers in preseason in the likes of Roy Krishna and Greg Stewart finding new home bases, and the influx of top international coaches, the title will be more closely contested than ever.

"This season, the teams are better I think," said Manolo Marquez, head coach of Hyderabad FC. "There are some teams that have improved the quality of the squad and I think that in some moments this will be good, because I think all the teams will



lose some important points. We could see last season that Odisha FC had chances to qualify even with only two games left. I think every team can beat the other teams, and it will be an equal competition for

Hyderabad FC will be looking for a repeat from their main marksman Bartholomew Ogbeche, who topped the scoring charts with 18 goals and led Hyderabad to being the highestscoring team in the league stage. Ogbeche is part of a solid core for Hyderabad FC, which includes captain Joao Victor.

"I said this last year, I'm the one who wears the armband, but we are full of leaders in the team," Victor said ahead of the season. "There are experienced players who can help the young guys we have.'

Hyderabad will have stiff competition from the likes of ATK Mohun Bagan, Mumbai City FC, and Bengaluru FC, who have all put together strong squads ahead of the new season. Former Bengaluru FC defensive midfielder Erik Paartalu suggested that Mumbai City FC will

season and predicted that they would go on to win the title.

"Their squad is not good, it's crazy good!," Paartalu said.

"When Des Buckingham took over last season they had lost quite a few big players from the season before that did the double. They were very up and down last year but Des managed to steer the ship impeccably in the Asian Champions league which was a big confidence boost for everyone involved. The arrival of Greg Stewart, who was the best player in the league last season, is already looking like a great move after he warmed up in the Durand Cup winning the Golden ball and looking untouchable as usual. With the squad they have, it needs to be a trophy this season."

Mumbai City FC had one of the strongest transfer windows ahead of the season, bringing in big names like Rostyn Griffiths, Alberto Noguera, and Jorge Pereyra Diaz in particular to slot in alongside their talented Indian contingent.

ATK Mohun Bagan are another team that have gone for a rehash in their squad, having fallen at the semi-final stage two seasons in a row, and more recently losing in the AFC Cup inter-zone semifinal.

Harmanpreet, Smriti Mandhana earn ICC Women's Player of the Month nominations

ndia captain Harmanpreet Kaur and vice-captain Smriti Mandhana on Wednesday earned nominations for ICC Women's Player of the Month award for September 2022. part from the duo, Bangladesh skipper Nigar Sultana has also been nominated for the honour to make it an all-Asian affair.

Despite not getting runs and desired results in T20I series in England at the start of the month,

Harmanpreet was in imperious form during the subsequent ODI series which followed to bag Player of the Series award as the highest run-getter with 221 runs at an average of 221 and a strike rate of 103.27.

Scoring 221 runs across the three matches, she guided her side over the finishing line in the first match with a controlled 74 not out, before she clinched the series for her team in style in the second match, striking an unbeaten 143, also her second-best knock in the format, to seal a historic first ODI series victory for her side in England since 1999 and subsequently, a 3-0 series whitewash at Lord's.

Just like Harmanpreet, Smriti, one of the leading lights of India's batting lineup, and last year's winner of the Rachael Heyhoe Flint Trophy for ICC Women's Cricketer of the Year, also excelled during her time in England in September.

She scored consistently across both white-ball series, highlighted by her unbeaten 79 off 53 balls during the second T20I in Derby. After becoming the highest run-scorer for

India in the T20I series with 111 runs at an average of 55.50 while striking at 137.03, she made a fine 91 in the first ODI at Hove - both match winning contributions.

In the final game where India only managed to get 169 at Lord's, she got a patient fifty to end the month averaging over 50 in both formats, underlining the scale of her successes in September.

On the other hand, Nigar led from the front during her side's successful ICC Women's T20 World Cup qualification campaign in the United Arab Emirates, scoring 180 runs at an average of 45 across five T20Is.

The Bangladesh captain opened her account with a crucial score of 67 in her side's first outing - a victory over eventual finalists Ireland, before registering an unbeaten 56 against the USA en route to clinching a spot in South Africa both as a leader and batter.

In being nominated for the award, Sultana becomes the first female Bangladesh international to be shortlisted since Nahida Akter

he Indian women's table tennis team crashed out of the ITTF World Team Championships Finals 2022 in the round of 16 after a 0-3 loss to Chinese Taipei, here on Wednesday.

India's top-ranked player Manika Batra lost the first match 0-3 (7-11, 9-11, 3-11) to World No 22 Chen Szu-Yu. With India trailing 0-1, national champion and Commonwealth Games 2022 gold-medallist Sreeja Akula went



down 1-3 (8-11, 11-5, 6-11, 9-11) to world number 35 Cheng I-Cheng. Thereafter, teenager Diya Chitale fought hard but could not prevent a 3-2 (6-11, 11-9, 11-9, 8-11, 7-11) defeat to Liu Hsing-Yin in the third match.

The Indian women's table tennis had qualified for the knockouts after finishing second behind Germany in Group 5. Chinese Taipei will now face Singapore in the quarter-finals.

Meanwhile, the Indian men's team will be up against top seeds China in the round of 16 on Thursday.

jax has conceded their biggest ever defeat in European football, losing 6-1 against an impressive Napoli on Tuesday night in the Champions League.

With two wins in two matches in Group A, Italian Serie A leaders Napoli arrived in Amsterdam with high expectations and lived up to them. After an early Ajax goal by Mohammed Kudus, Napoli took con-

trol and outclassed the home team. Giacomo Raspadori headed in the equaliser, Giovanni Di Lorenzo headed Napoli in front, and on the stroke of half-time Piotr Zielinski was given a free run by Ajax to make it 3-1 for Napoli, reports Xinhua.

After a mistake by Ajax goalkeeper Remko Pasveer, Raspadori produced



his second goal just after half-time and Ajax was broken definitely. Khvicha Kvaratskhelia made it 5-1, Ajax captain Dusan Tadic received his second yellow card and substitute Giovanni Simeone extended the scoring to 6-1. The crossbar even prevented a seventh goal by Tanguy Ndombele.

The biggest home defeat ever in European football for four-time European Cup winners Ajax was a shock, although it was not the first time Luciano Spalletti's Napoli impressed this season.

Napoli now lead Champions League Group A with nine points, three ahead of Liverpool and six of Ajax. Next week Napoli hosts Ajax and bottom side Rangers plays against Liverpool.

Bayern crush Plzen to maintain perfect record in Champions League

ayern Munich cruised past Czech outfit Viktoria Plzen 5-0 for their third win in as many games in UEFA Champions League Group C, while Eintracht Frankfurt and Tottenham Hotspur played out a goalless draw in Group D on Tuesday night. The Bavarians made a fairy-tale start on home soil and broke the deadlock with seven minutes gone as Leroy Sane hammered the ball from a central position into the roof of the net.

Plzen tried to respond but was immediately caught flat-footed in the 13th minute when Serge Gnabry finished off a counterattack to double Bayern's advantage, reports Xinhua. Bayern gained momentum as Sadio Mane danced through Plzen's defence before beating hapless goalkeeper Marian Tvrdon with a low shot in the 21st minute.

The hosts' advantage could have been greater, but Jamal Musiala's goal in the 37th minute was ruled offside. Even though Bayern ceased their attacks after half-time, Julian Nagelsmann's men were able to extend the lead as Sane pinned down Mane's long



ball with a back heel before tapping past Tvrdon from inside the box.

Plzen couldn't put up a resistance while relentless Bayern established a 5-0 lead at the hour mark as Eric Maxim Choupo-Moting drilled Leon Goretzka's through-ball into the top-right corner from the edge of the box. The visitors from the Czech Republic showed signs of life in the closing stages as unmarked Fortune Bassey pulled wide from 17 meters. Bayern nearly made it six in injury time, but Marcel Sabizter narrowly missed the target. "We played well and put the result beyond doubt within 20 minutes. We reduced the pace after the restart and played it smart as we must spare our energy for the clash with Dortmund," said Bayern Munich's head coach Julian Nagelsmann, referring to Saturday's Bundesliga clash with their bitter rivals. In Group D, Tottenham clinched a point on the road as neither Harry Kane nor Son Heung-min was able to open the scoring in the first half. The Eagles lacked

Japan Open: Shapovalov serves past Johnson in Round of 32 clash

anadian tennis player Denis Shapovalov produced a near-perfect serving performance to register a win against America's Steve Johnson in a Round of 32 clash at the Japan Open Tennis Championships, here on Wednesday.

In a 6-3, 7-6(3) win, the seventh seed lost just one point on first serve,

firing 11 aces as he won 37 of 38 points behind his first delivery. He was further aided by making 76 per cent of his first serves and did not face a break point in the first-round

"(This was) definitely one of my best serving matches. I kind of felt like I needed to go against Steve. Obviously if I'm giving him a lot of looks on second serves, then he's going to capitalize and put a lot of pressure. I'm very happy with my serving performance today



and hopefully I can keep it up throughout the week," said Shapovalov.

"The courts are playing pretty quickly, so if you're putting a lot of first serves in, I think the percentage to win the point is really high here," he added.

Shapovalov avoided the Tokyo fate of his Seoul final opponent, Japan's Yoshihito Nishioka, who lost earlier in the day as he struggled with his energy levels and the new conditions after the short adjustment period.

Stokes to get No.4 batting position in T20 World Cup, says coach Mott

7ith England whiteball captain Jos Buttler keen to have Ben Stokes as a permanent member of the 'top four', the 31-year-old all-rounder will bat at No.4 in the ICC T20 World Cup in Australia, a position he has never batted at in the 34 T20Is so far.

England's white-ball coach Matthew Mott too said Stokes had been shuffling up and down the order during his career and that he wanted to give a clear role to the Test captain, who missed the seven-match T20I series against Pakistan recently

and joined the T20 World Cup squad in Australia directly."One of the things that's been said for a while is that he (Stokes) hasn't had a clear role," Mott was quoted as saying by The Cricketer. "And Jos (Buttler) in par-

ticular is clear that he's a top-four player. Those conditions in Australia will suit the way he plays. You always have a bit of flexibility with the batting but he will be expected to be higher in the innings."I got a couple of texts (from Stokes) on Sunday. He was jumping on that flight ready to go. We've deliberately left him alone.

He's had a busy summer,

added Mott."There's a lot of time before that first World Cup game and when we get to Australia, we'll be really clear with everybody on what the expectations are with their roles.'

Stokes, who recently retired from One-day International cricket to concentrate on Tests and T20Is, averages just over 20 but hasn't played a T20I since March 2021. Last year he played just one T20 for IPL franchise Rajasthan Royals, five matches for Durham in T20 Blast and a couple of matches for Northern Superchargers in The


