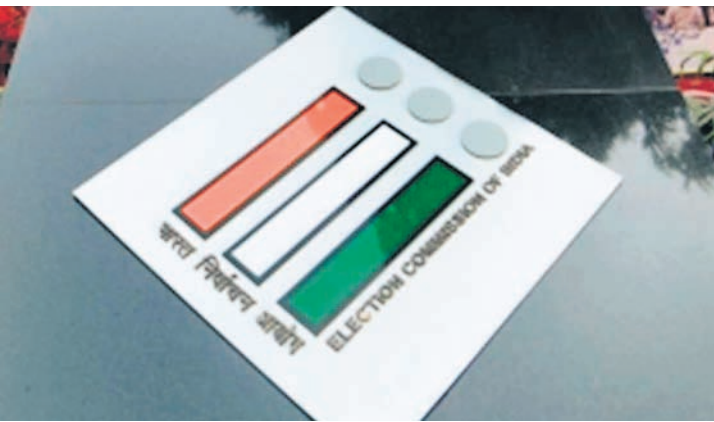
POLL PANEL WRITES TO PARTIES TO GIVE AUTHENTIC INFO ON POLL PROMISES, SEEKS VIEWS ABOUT

Mode of implementation

▶ THE COMMISSION NOTED THAT THE CONSEQUENCES OF INADEQUATE DISCLOSURES BY POLITICAL PARTIES GET ATTENUATED BY THE FACT THAT THE ELECTIONS ARE HELD FREQUENTLY, PROVIDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR POLITICAL PARTIES TO INDULGE IN COMPETITIVE ELECTORAL PROMISES, PARTICULARLY IN MULTI-PHASE ELECTIONS, WITHOUT HAVING TO SPELL OUT THEIR FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS MORE PARTICULARLY ON COMMITTED EXPENDITURE. IN ANY CASE, THESE DECLARATIONS ARE ALSO NOT SUBMITTED BY MOST OF THE POLITICAL PARTIES IN TIME.

▶ THE ELECTION COMMISSION HAS WRITTEN TO ALL RECOGNISED NATIONAL AND STATE POLITICAL PARTIES SOLICITING VIEWS FOR PROCEEDING WITH THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT FOR BRINGING ABOUT A STANDARDIZED DISCLOSURE PROFORMA WITH THE AIM OF NOT ONLY STRENGTHENING OF MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT GUIDANCE FOR POLITICAL PARTIES AND CANDIDATES BUT ALSO ENSURING AUTHENTIC INFORMATION TO THE VOTERS TO ASSESS FINANCIAL VIABILITY OF ELECTION PROMISES MADE BY POLITICAL PARTIES. ALL THE NATIONAL AND RECOGNISED POLITICAL PARTIES HAVE BEEN REQUESTED TO SEND THEIR VIEWS BY OCTOBER 18.

As per the proposal, the political parties will have to provide the details of the financial feasibility of their promises in a certain format which include information like extent and expanse of coverage; quantification of physical coverage and quantification of financial implications of the promises. Moreover, the information will also include availability of the financial resources and ways and means of raising resources for meeting the additional expenditure to be incurred in fulfilling the promises.

Noting the fact that declarations provided by the political parties about the financial ramifications of poll promises are quite routine and ambiguous, the Election Commission has proposed to mandate the political parties to provide authentic information to the voters to assess the financial viability of their election promises.

While the existing guidelines under the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) require the political parties and candidates to explain the rationale for

promises made therein as well as the possible ways and means to finance such promises, Election Commission has observed that the declarations are quite routine, ambiguous and do not provide adequate information to the voters to exercise informed choice in an election.

The Commission, under the guidance of Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) Rajiv Kumar proposed to supplement the existing MCC guidelines and mandate political parties to inform voters about financial ramifications of their promises in the manifesto against well-defined quantifiable parameters.

A senior official of the poll panel said the move was aimed at assessing the feasibility of implementation of such promises within the financial space available.

The EC in its meeting led by CEC Rajiv Kumar and attended by Election Commissioner Anup Chandra Pandey decided that it cannot remain a mute spectator and overlook the undesirable impact of some of the promises and offers, on the conduct of free and fair elections and maintaining level playing field for all political parties and candidates.

Drawing upon his experience in dealing with the Finance Commission, RBI and Budget process as Union Finance Secretary, CEC Rajiv Kumar has initiated yet another major electoral reform for not only bringing about a standardised disclosure proforma for guidance of political parties and candidates, but also ensuring authentic information to the voters to assess financial viability of election promises made by political parties. Proforma seeks details of revenue generation ways (through additional tax, if any), rationalising expenditure (cutting some schemes, if so required), impact on committed liabilities and/or raising of further debt and its impact on FRBM limits.

UTTARKASHI AVALANCHE: 10 MOUNTAINEERS KILLED SO FAR

Fatal Tuesday

Ten trainee mountaineers have been killed while eight others have been rescued so far after an avalanche hit Draupadi's Danda 2 mountain peak in the frontier district of Uttarkashi.

The avalanche reported near Draupadi's Danda 2 mountain peak had trapped 28 trainee mountaineers of Nehru Mountaineering Institute.

The DGP of the area has said that eight climbers have been safely rescued so far, while several others reported to be missing.

The Indian Air Force (IAF) has deployed two Cheetah helicopters for rescue and relief operations. Other helicopters in the fleet have been kept on standby for any further requirement.

The Nehru Institute of Mountaineering (NIM) had launched training for basic and advanced courses on September 22 at the Dokrani glacier.

A total of 122 people, including 97 trainees, 24 trainers and an officer of NIM, were involved in the basic training, while 53 people, including 44 trainees and nine trainers, were part of the advanced course.

Meanwhile, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has spoken to Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami over the incident and has directed the India Air Force to carry out rescue and relief operations.

Simultaneously, relief and rescue operations are being carried out by the district administration, NDRF, SDRF, Army and ITBP personnel along with a team of NIM.

10 MISSING IN GOMTI, GANGA RIVERS IN UP

Kanpur/Lucknow (UP): Ten persons were missing and feared drowned in two separate incidents in Lucknow and Kanpur on Tuesday, police said.

While four youths went missing in the Gomti river in Lucknow during idol immersion, six persons, including four girls, are feared drowned in Bilhaur in Kanpur. The youths in Lucknow reportedly drowned during idol immersion when they lost their balance in the boat. In Kanpur, four girls waded into waters and then slipped into the river. Two youths who had accompanied them, jumped into the river to rescue the girls. All are missing. Rescue operations have started in both places and senior police officials are supervising the divers.

11 KILLED IN VADODARA AS TRUCK COLLIDES WITH AUTORICKSHAW

Vadodara: At least 11 people were killed and four others injured when the autorickshaw they were travelling in collided with a heavy commercial vehicle (HMV) carrying cars on the National highway 48 near the Darjiipura area of Gujarat's Vadodara on Tuesday. Critically injured have been admitted to a government hospital. Deputy Commissioner of Police Panna Momaya told the mediapersons: "According to local eyewitnesses, the driver of the Heavy Commercial Vehicle driving from Surat towards Ahmedabad lost control over steering while attempting to avoid a car. The container crossed the divider and collided with the passenger rickshaw. 11 passengers have died so far, another three to four passengers are being treated, who are in critical condition in hospital." The container after hitting the autorickshaw also hit the wall of the Air Force station before finally coming to a halt. A team from the station also helped in the rescue operation.

CBI raids at 105 locations in 18 states against cyber crime

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) is conducting raids at more than 105 premises across the nation.

According to sources, the raids are being conducted at places belonging to the accused involved in cyber enabled crime. The CBI has given the entire operation the name, "Operation Chakra".

The agency had got inputs from the FBI and Interpol on the cyber enabled crime accused. The CBI formed teams and also informed the state police so that they could assist them in the search operation.

The CBI itself is conducting the probe at 87 locations while



the state police are involved in the other places.

The source said that they have recovered around Rs 1.5 crore in cash and 1.5 kg gold from a location in Rajasthan where the accused were running a fake call centre.

Two more call centres were busted in Pune and Ahmedabad. The accused used to call US and UK citizens and dupe them.

ON EVE OF DASSEHRA RALLY, MAHA GOVT'S DIWALI GIFT TO 17MN FAMILIES

Mumbai: The Maharashtra government on Tuesday announced an advance Diwali gift of subsidised food provisions to nearly 1.70 crore (around 7 crore persons) families covered under the public distribution system. Accordingly, each ration card-holder will be entitled to one kg sugar, one kg palm oil, chana dal and rava at Rs 100 only, giving a major relief to the masses reeling under inflation, in the festival season. The bonanza comes a day ahead of the 'two Shiv Sena Dassehra rallies' -- one to be addressed by Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and another by Sena President and ex-CM Uddhav Thackeray, with both going all-out to woo the crowds at their venues in Bandra Kurla Complex and Shivaji Park, respectively, scheduled on Wednesday. Announcing the cabinet's decisions, Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis said that these food commodities shall be available for a month vide an e-pass system and will entail a burden of around Rs 489 crore on the state exchequer.

'SERVE BURGERS TO ORPHANS'

DELHI HIGH COURT TO RESTAURATEUR AFTER QUASHING RAPE FIR AGAINST HIM

Quashing an FIR of rape charges registered against a restaurateur, the Delhi High Court directed him to serve hygienic and good-quality burgers to the children at two orphanages in Noida and Mayur Vihar as a social service. "I am of the view that in the present case, respondent No.2 (man) was married to the petitioner and, thereafter, had temperamental differences due to which they decided to part ways. Moreover, the respondent No.2 has herself made the statement that she wants to put quietus to the matter without any pressure, coercion and out of her own free will. In view of this, the allegations under Section 376 IPC can be quashed," Justice Jasmeet Singh said in the recent order.

His counsel submitted that as per the terms of the settlement, he has to pay the



woman a sum of Rs 4,50,000, which shall be transferred the same day.

Justice Singh further noted that

"However, I am of the view that the FIR in the present case is of the year 2020 and considerable time of the police has been wasted in investigation, which could have been utilised for important matters. Similarly, judicial time has also been wasted. Therefore, the petitioner must do some social good for the society."

'Bollywood's Hanuman looks like a Musalman': 'Boycott Adipurush' trends on social media

After "Laal Singh Chaddha" and "Brahmastra", another Bollywood movie has run into rough weather, with "Boycott Adipurush" trending on social media, days after its teaser got released.

The excitement for Om Raut's film "Adipurush" -- starring Saif Ali Khan, Prabhas and Kriti Sanon -- was quite high ever since it was announced. However, just a few hours after the release of the teaser, the netizens began criticising the film for Saif's "Islamic" look, unconvincing VFX, and also the costumes of the other cast were targeted.

The netizens have claimed that Hanuman's look in the film also has similarities with the Islamic attire.

A user tweeted, "Bollywood's Hanuman Looks Like A Musalman #BoycottAdipurush." Another one wrote, "After 35 years, gutter Bollywood converted the 'gracefulness' of arrogant Ravana and Hanuman ji into Mughals."



"Hanuman in Ramayan. Musalman in #Adipurush. Note: No Hindu keeps a beard without a Moustache. This film should be banned... They are defaming our Ramayan. They are showing Ravana and Hanuman with beards as Mughals with no Tika on their foreheads," added one. "Adipurush" is a retelling of the Ramayana. Prabhas's character is termed as Raghav, which is another name for Lord Ram. Saif plays Ravana while Janaki (Sita) is played by Kriti Sanon.

On Dussehra, when all Hindus celebrate the victory of good over evil and burn effigies of Ravana, one quaint temple in Kanpur will open its doors for those who worship the demon king.

On Dussehra, devotees from far and wide through the Ravana temple. There are four temples of Ravana across the country, but the

temple in Kanpur is one of its kind in Uttar Pradesh. This year too, 'puja' and 'aarti' of Ravan will start from 9 a.m. on Dussehra and will continue till Ravan 'Dahan' in the evening. Dhananjay Tiwari, who is a priest at the temple, says, "People throng this temple for a day to have 'darshan' of Ravana. In the evening, once the effigy of Ravana is set on fire on Dussehra, the doors of this temple are closed for a year." Anirudh Prasad Bajpai,

Known as the Kailasha temple outside Chinmastika Devi temple in the Shivala area of Kanpur, it has a ten-headed idol of Ravan. In this temple, Ravana is held captive for 364 days and the temple is opened only for one day -- Vijay Dashami (Dussehra). It is believed that the sight of Ravana in this temple not only kills evil thoughts but also sharpens the mind.

trustee of the Ravana temple, said the demon king's temple was one among many others located on Kailasha temple complex in Shivala. Ramraj, a local shop owner, who sells flowers and garlands outside the Ravana temple, says, "It is the common belief that on Dussehra day, Ravana comes to this temple. The 'darshan' of Ravana gives the message that evil never prospers."

A fair is also organised to mark the occasion. The demon king's idol is decorated, earthen lamps are lit and an 'aarti' is performed. It is believed that offering mustard oil and 'turai' (ridged gourd) flowers wards off all bad planetary effects.



Minister's threat 'MCOCA for getting even 1 liquor bottle from Goa' sparks row

Maharashtra Minister's threat to invoke the dreaded MCOCA against persons who bring in 'even a single bottle of liquor' from Goa sparked off a fresh political ruckus with the Opposition parties alleging it as a potential new 'extortion style', here on Tuesday.

The 'diktat' by Excise Minister Shambhuraj Desai - intended to curb the growing menace of smuggling in cheap Indian Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) brands from Goa to Maharashtra - failed to cheer tourists or ordinary folks who procure a few bottles for self-consumption.

Desai has ordered the Sindhudurg and Kolhapur districts, bordering Goa to work out a strategy against smugglers and slap the Maharashtra Control of Organised Crime Act, usually invoked against gangsters or for serious crimes.

For starters, the state excise authorities will deploy mobile check-posts at the entry-exit points between the two coastal states, supplementing the ongoing campaign by the police and Excise Department, and intensify efforts to detect vehicles 'smuggling' in the liquor.

Playing the move, Congress General Secretary Sachin Sawant asked whether 'there are no other laws' that have prompted the state govern-



ment to invoke the stringent MCOCA, and wondered "if even tourists would be targeted" or a 'Uttar Pradesh model' being implemented in Maharashtra.

Taking a swipe at the government, Shiv Sena Spokesperson Manisha Kayande said for getting just one bottle of liquor the government will slap MCOCA, but bringing an MLA from Goa would earn a reward of '50 Khokha' (slang for Rs 50 crore).

In a sarcastic comment, Nationalist Congress Party's national spokesperson Clyde Crasto said "good to know the Maharashtra ministers are finally getting down to some serious work".

"However, while a crackdown on

illegal activities like smuggling is okay, it should not become a tool of extortion or harassment of the ordinary folks," Crasto cautioned.

Sena's Deputy Leader Raghunath Kuchik demanded to know "why only liquor from Goa is being targeted, and what about the Union Territories of Daman & Diu, Dadra & Nagar Haveli" - sandwiched between Maharashtra and Gujarat.

A Goan living in Mumbai, Albert Coutinho said he drives down to his home state every other month and would bring in a few bottles of liquor for home consumption, especially during festive occasions.

"With this new rule, ordinary people like us cannot take the liberty or

we may end up being branded as organised criminals... We shall have to get our supplies locally," Coutinho said glumly.

Both Kayande and Kuchik wonder whether this is 'a target' set by the ruling ally Bharatiya Janata Party - supporting Chief Minister Eknath Shinde - to 'recover' the 'khokhas' (money) they had allegedly spent to bring down the Maha Vikas Aghadi government in June.

While Kayande feels the move could hit tourism in this state, Kuchik accused Desai of lacking knowledge of the MCOCA laws and offered to 'gift a copy of the statute to the Minister'.

Liquor vendors in Mumbai said that the prices of various IMFL brands in Maharashtra are very high compared with Goa or the UTs, the difference being up to 250-300 per cent, owing to the steep excise duties and local taxes.

"For instance, if a small bottle of IMFL costs Rs 300 in Maharashtra, it can be bought for barely Rs 100 in Goa and the UTs, making it a big attraction for ordinary drinkers or even smugglers," said Kumar A. Shetty, who runs a bar in Mumbai.

Referring to arguments that Goa wine shops provide a liquor licence to the buyers, Shetty pointed out that it is not valid in Maharashtra, so anybody found with any type of alcoholic drinks from the adjoining state could be at a big risk henceforth.

Maha family reunited with patriarch during Durga Puja

There couldn't have been a better Durga Maha Ashtami for the Satpute family from remote Bhendala in Gadchiroli, Maharashtra. On Monday, they received information that their 73-year-old patriarch, missing for over 15 years now and presumed dead, had been found near Kolkata, nearly 1,200 km away. Dipankar Chatterjee, a retired Indian Air Force personnel, was out for a morning walk along with friends at Ashoknagar in the North 24 Parganas district of West Bengal (about 46 km from Kolkata), when they found an elderly man picking up scraps to eat from a rubbish heap. Chatterjee approached the man and wanted to know his name and where he lived.

"The man snarled back at Chatterjee. The friends then realised that he was suffering from some sort of mental ailment. After some cajoling, the man accompanied them to their clubhouse where he was given food, water and fresh clothes to wear. The group then got in touch with us. They were aware that the West Bengal Radio Club (WBRC) helps reunite such people with their families," said Ambarish Nag Biswas, secretary, WBRC. WBRC is an

organisation of amateur radio enthusiasts with a wide network across India and other countries. Over the last several years, they have used this network to locate families of people found on the streets with mental problems. After ascertaining from his language that the man was from Maharashtra, members activated their contacts in that state. It didn't take too long for them to trace his family in Bhendala.

"The police there confirmed that Baburao Bapuji Satpute was a state government employee. Several years ago, he began suffering from a mental disorder and left home. A police complaint was registered but all efforts to trace him were futile. Finally, Baburao was presumed dead. His wife started receiving pension and son got a job on compassionate grounds. They were overjoyed when they received the news on Monday. The family immediately sent his identity details. They will arrive soon to take him back after clearing all legal formalities," Nag Biswas added. He said that WBRC is ready to provide free assistance to people in need. The organisation just needs to be contacted whenever such people are found on the streets in or around Kolkata.

ANIL DESHMUKH GRANTED BAIL AFTER 11 MONTHS



Mumbai: The Bombay High Court on Tuesday granted bail to former Maharashtra Home Minister Anil Deshmukh, 11 months after he was arrested by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) in an alleged money-laundering case. A senior Nationalist Congress Party leader, Deshmukh, 73, was arrested early on November 2, 2021, after multiple raids by the ED and Central Bureau of Investigation. However, the court has kept its order in abeyance till October 13 to enable the ED appeal against it in the Supreme Court, said his lawyers. NCP MP Supriya Sule hailed the court verdict by saying 'Satyameva Jayate' (Truth Prevails), adding that the entire party has stood behind Deshmukh like a 'family' in his hour of need.

BJP responds to Nana Patole's Cheetah-Lumpy virus link claim

Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis on Monday took a potshot on Congress leader Nana Patole over his 'Cheetah' remark, saying he speaks ignorantly for media attention. "Nana Patole (Maharashtra Congress chief) does not even know where the Cheetahs were brought from. He has a hobby of speaking without knowledge as he knows it will run in the media. Otherwise, he won't be seen altogether," said Fadnis in Mumbai.

Patole, the Maharashtra unit president of Congress, said on Monday that the Centre "deliberately" brought "cheetahs from Nigeria" to spread Lumpy Skin Disease to take revenge from the farmers over the withdrawal of the farm laws.

"This lumpy virus has been prevailing in Nigeria for a long time and the Cheetahs have also been brought from there. The central government has deliberately done this for the losses of farmers," he had said.

Blaming the Centre for the spread of Lumpy Skin Disease, Patole had said, "Congress interim president) Sonia Gandhi must give Nobel Award to Patole for his statement."



But in fact, eight cheetahs were brought to Gwalior from Namibia in a special plane as part of the cheetah reintroduction programme.

Nana Patole, talking to a news agency on phone, said, "PM has never spoken to the farmers during the black laws (farm laws) which they rolled back, and by bringing cheetahs from Namibia they are taking the revenge. The lumpy virus came in India after cheetahs were brought from Namibia on PM Modi's birthday".

"I have not seen such a disease in my 55 years and neither my ancestors did. It is purposely brought so that these farmers face losses. One can make out the spot on cheetahs brought in India and the spot of



lumpy on the cows are same. This disease already existed in Namibia and now it's spreading in India," he added.

Countering Patole, BJP leader and State Cabinet Minister Mangal Prabhat Lodha told news agency, "This is a laughable statement from Doctor Patole, his statement portrays this disease as a non-serious issue."

"Under the leadership of PM Modi, arrangements have been made for the cows to get vaccinated," he added. "If Sonia ji wants, she can give him Nobel prize from Congress side," he said.

Lumpy Skin Disease has severely affected dairy farmers in India. The virus has been found only in cows and buffaloes.

FOUR ARRESTED IN MUMBAI FOR TRYING TO DUPE BUSINESSMAN POSING AS CBI

Mumbai: Mumbai Police arrested four persons for allegedly attempting to dupe a businessman of Rupees five lakh by posing as officers of the Central Bureau (CBI). On September 30, four people pretending to be officials of CBI and police entered the office of Aastik Trading Centre in Goregaon and demanded Rs 5 lakh.

After being informed police arrived at the spot and arrested four people. Fake CBI and Police ID cards were also recovered from them, the Goregaon Police said.

The businessman told police that he needed around Rs 1.6 crore as loan and contacted a person and after some time the fake officials arrived at his office.

According to police, there were cases registered against the four arrested at several police stations on charges of duping.

As per police, the gang used to target rich businessmen and their modus operandi was to trap people by offering them loans and then conduct fake raids and demand money by pretending to be CBI and police officers.

The four arrested have been identified as Jeevan Aheer alias Vipul (52), Girish Klecha (29), Rahul Shankar Gayakwad (43) and Kishor Chaibali (52).

The police have registered a case of extortion against the arrested and have started further investigation. Other than the four arrested, the fifth member of the team is still on the run, the police said.

Kolhapur gets direct flight service with Mumbai

Maharashtra's Kolhapur city got a direct flight service with Mumbai on Tuesday under the government's regional connectivity scheme with Minister of Civil Aviation Jyotiraditya Scindia inaugurating a direct flight from Kolhapur to Mumbai.

This flight has been launched under the ambitious Regional Connectivity Scheme UDAN of the Ministry of Civil Aviation to provide air connectivity to tier-2 and tier-3 cities and affordable air travel for all.

The flight will operate between Kolhapur and Mumbai thrice a week -- Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

Scindia said that the UDAN scheme is realising Prime Minister's vision of making air travel affordable for the common citizen of the country.

So far, 433 new routes have been launched and more than one crore passengers have benefited under this scheme.

The Minister also assured that the expansion of the apron of the Kolhapur airport will be commissioned in November and domestic terminal building will be inaugurated in March 2023.

MoS V.K. Singh congratulated the people of Kolhapur and Mumbai, and expressed hope that this flight will not only create ease of travel but also significantly boost the trade and commerce activities in the region.

Pankaj Tripathi announced as National Icon by ECI

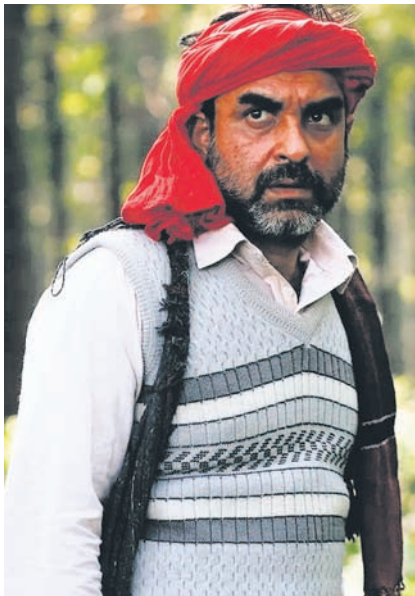

Actor Pankaj Tripathi, who is known for his work in 'Gangs of Wasseypur', 'Mirzapur', 'Bareilly Ki Barfi' and several others, has been roped in as the National Icon, as announced by the Election Commission of India (ECI).

The actor was already State Icon of Bihar to create awareness and encourage youth as voters and participate in the elections in Bihar. The ECI is launching a special programme in collaboration with All India Radio (AIR) which will include a series titled 'Matdata Junction' with 52 episodes of 15 minutes each to be broadcast every Friday on Vividh Bharti stations, and other primary radio channels of AIR.

The programme will be broadcast in 23 languages across 230 AIR channels. Pankaj Tripathi will join the launch of Matdata Junction as the National Icon. Show-of-strength Dussehra rallies by Shiv Sena factions; Police on toes

"Thousands of people are



expected from across the state for both rallies and, therefore, arrangements have been made to ensure law and order and deal with any untoward incident. Local police as well as additional cover by other units will be in place," an official said.

Mumbai Joint Commissioner of Police



Vishwas Nangre Patil said his team visited Shivaji Park and BKC to take stock of security arrangements at the venues.

Stringent security measures are in place as there is a possibility of supporters of the two rival factions coming face to face in the metropolis, which may lead to law and order issues,

police said. Incidentally, the security of Shinde was increased recently due to a threat input, police added.

The chief minister visited the MMRDA ground at BKC in suburban Mumbai and took stock of the preparations for the October 5 event. I have visited the venue (in BKC) and the

preparations are in full swing. Lakhs of people from across the state will come to the rally and all departments are working to ensure they don't face any problem. Our preparations will get over tomorrow (Tuesday) and this rally will be a success," Shinde said.

Sheetal Mhatre, a spokesperson for the Shinde camp, said the preparations at the ground are almost 80 per cent over and 4,000-5,000 buses have been booked by MLAs and MPs to ferry their supporters to the rally site.

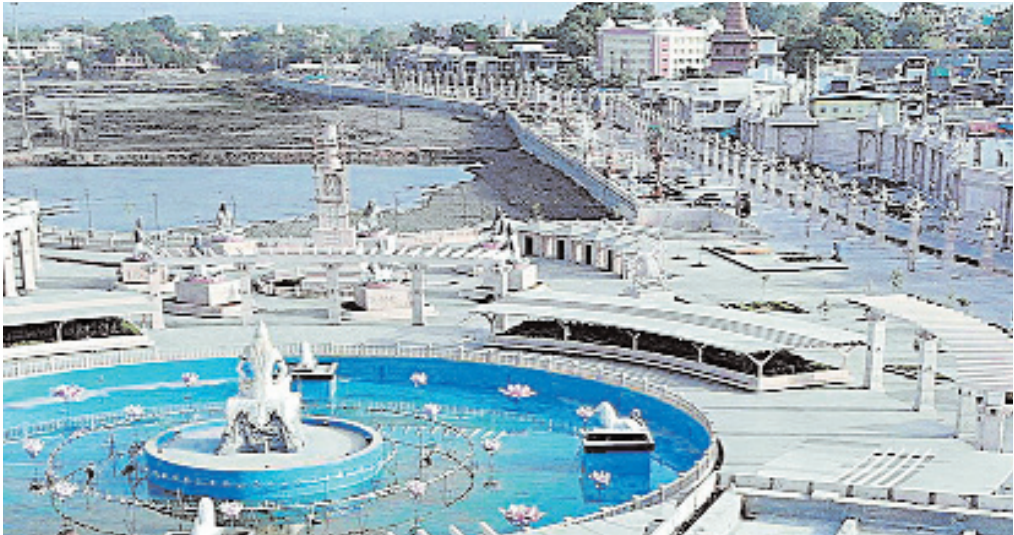

Ancient splendour of Ujjain will incarnate in a new form "Shri Mahakal Lok"

The ancient splendour of the place where Lord Shri Krishna received education, the ancient centre for computation of time, astrology, and culture, the glorious city of the great poet Kalidas and Emperor Vikramaditya, is now going to be incarnated in a new form "Shri Mahakal Lok". Keeping in mind the splendour, traditions, religious, cultural, historical significance of the mythological city of Ujjain, the state government made an effective development plan for the overall development of Shri Mahakal region, which is taking shape. The Prime Minister Narendra Modi is coming to Ujjain to dedicate the first phase of the project in a dignified ceremony on October 11.

Under the leadership of Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan, world class infrastructure was developed in Ujjain in Simhashta-2016. Now "Mahakal Lok" is being built on the lines of "Banaras Corridor". In the first phase of the scheme, small and big Rudra Sagar, Harsiddhi Temple, Char Dham Temple, Vikram Tila etc. have been developed in the courtyard of Lord Shri Mahakaleshwar. In the second phase, the Maharajwada complex will be developed, in which the historic Maharajwada building will be re-used as a heritage, the old remains will be included in the form of Kumbh museum and this complex will be integrated with the Mahakal temple complex.

The first phase of Shri Mahakal Lok, which is technically called "Mrida Project-1", has been completed. After the dedication of the works of the first phase on October 11, it will be opened for the common devotees.

The estimated cost of the "Shri Mahakal Lok" area development project is Rs. 800 crore, in which first

phase work of Rs. 350 crore including Mahakal Plaza, Mahakal Corridor, Mid-way Zone, Mahakal Theme Park, Ghat and Deck Area, Nutan School Complex and Ganesh School Complex has been completed. In the first component of the Mahakal corridor, a 200 meter long walkway has been made suitable for walking on foot. A 25 feet high and 500 meters long mural wall has been constructed. In addition, 108 Shiva pillars have been built with different postures of Shiva, which are spreading a distinct charm. Lotus pond, open air theater and lake front area and routes for e-rickshaws and emergency vehicles have also been made. The big Rudra Sagar lake has been filled with clean water. Also it has been ensured that the water remains clean.

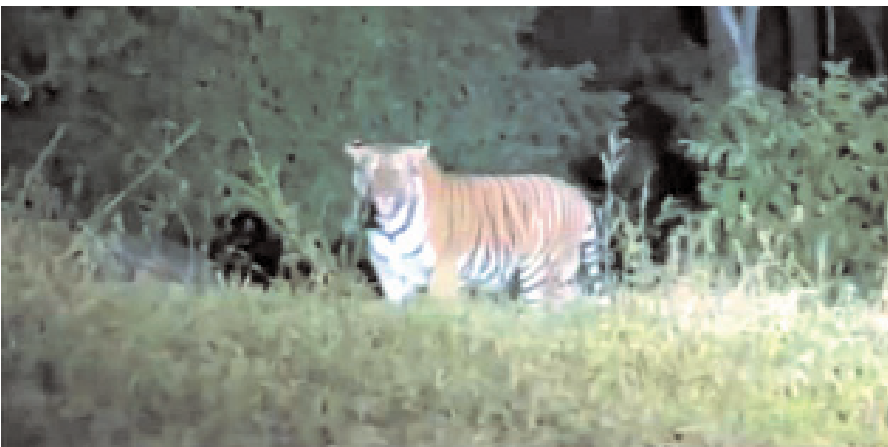
In Mahakal Theme Park, mural wall depicting stories of Lord Shri Mahakaleshwar, deck area for Sapt Sagar and shopping and meeting area facilities have been developed below it. Similarly, multilevel parking for cars, buses and two-wheelers has been made near Triveni Museum. Dharamshala and Anna Kshetra (food area) are also being built in this area. Paedestrian connectivity has been developed through road crossings. Surveillance and Control Centre has also been set up in the mid-way zone along with worship material shops, food courts, lake view restaurant, lake front development, public facilities and towers. Under Sugam Mandir Access Road, Triveni Museum to Harsiddhi Marg, Bhagat Singh Marg, Hari Phatak Bridge to Mahakal Square, Begumbag Road, road parallel to Saraswati Shishu Mandir, Mahakal Square to Mahakal Mandir, Mahakal police station to Bada Ganesh Naya Marg, Bada Ganesh Mandir Road, new road parallel to Narsingh Ghat up to Nutan School, Harsiddhi Mandir to Bhagat Singh Marg have been widened and new roads have been made.

MRIDA PROJECT PHASE II

Maharajwada complex will be developed in the second phase of Shri Mahakal Lok Kshetra Vikas Yojana, "Mrida Project-2". The works of this phase will be completed in the year 2023-24. In this, the historic Maharajwada building will be re-used as a heritage, by incorporating old relics and partially using the building as a Kumbh museum, this complex will be integrated with the Mahakal temple complex. Cultural Haat will be constructed reflecting the local art and culture. The components of Ramghat Façade Treatment include restoration of the paedestrian road leading to Ramghat, separate arrangements for vendors and cart hawkers, beautification of streets using architectural elements and Simhashta themed dynamic light show at Ramghat. Parking, Dharamshala, discourse hall and Anna Kshetra (food area) are also being constructed. In the second phase, renovation of Maharajwada, Rudra Sagar, Chhota Rudra Sagar lake front, beautification of Ramghat, parking and tourism information centre, widening of Hari Phatak bridge and railway underpass and foot bridge over Rudra Sagar, Mahakal gate, development of Begumbagh road, Rudra Sagar western road and Mahakal access road will be upgraded.

In the Chhota Rudra Sagar Lake Front Development Plan, recreation centre, Vedic Vatika and Yoga Center, Mantradhwani Sthal and parking will be developed along with landscaping. Parking information centre and sales centre will be developed. Desilting of Rudra Sagar Lake will be done by removing the sludge in the Rudra Sagar Rejuvenation Plan. Rudra Sagar will be connected with Kshipra river. The four arms of the Hari Phatak Over Bridge will be widened and a railway underpass will be built near Jaisinghpura.

The Mahakal gate located near Shri Mahakaleshwar police station will be protected and heritage corridor will be developed here. Similarly, Begumbagh area will also be developed and beautified. A 210 meter long foot bridge will be built over Rudra Sagar, which will connect the Mahakal theme park with the water tank of PHE. In this phase, the front part of Shri Mahakal temple complex will be expanded to about 70 meters. In this, the process of acquisition of 11 buildings has been completed. Seating, landscaping and walkways are also proposed in this area.

landed in trouble for allegedly shooting a video of her dance at a temple in Madhya Pradesh Chhatrapur district. The woman allegedly shot her dance on a Bollywood song - 'Munni Badnam Hui', which led to a controversy. The woman shot the video and uploaded it on her Instagram account which she deleted later. It made the right wing members angry and demanded action following which the state home Minister Narottam Mishra on Tuesday, directed Chhatrapur district SP to lodge an FIR against the woman.

"I have directed the Superintendent of Police of Chhatrapur to file an FIR against the woman. The way she dressed and shot the video was objectionable. I had earlier objected to such incidents and said FIRs will be registered in such cases. Despite the warning, she did this," Mishra said.

The five Muslim men arrested from a Garba pandal in Madhya Pradesh's Indore did not commit any crime, and the arrest was only preventive, a senior cop said today. The men argued with the organisers and the police, he said.

Speaking to NDTV, Indore Zone-4 Deputy Commissioner of Police RK Singh said there is also no report of any complaint against Bajrang Dal members, and no official order was passed to check identity cards of attendees at Garba pandals.

Singh said such events often happen during the annual event.

"Our duty is to take action, irrespective of religion. We didn't get a

complaint from the Bajrang Dal, only from the organisers," he added.

Since the start of the Navratri festivities, there have been several instances of Muslim men being held or beaten up in Madhya Pradesh's Indore. Bajrang Dal members are carrying out search drives at Garba pandals, checking people's ID cards. They were seen thrashing three young Muslim men in Ujjain yesterday, after which they handed them over to the police. They accused the youth of making videos of women at the pandals. The Muslim men have refuted the allegations, saying they had no intention to even enter the pandal. Speaking to NDTV, 19-year-old Kaif said they had simply stopped on the road as their motorcycle's fuel ran out.

"We just stopped on the main road and were beaten up," he said, adding that they didn't even try to enter the Garba event.

Kaif further narrated that eight to ten Bajrang Dal members, accusing them of making videos, surrounded and assaulted them. They also checked their phones but found nothing, he said. Kaif said they stood with folded hands.

"One of our friends is still in jail. We complained against the Bajrang Dal too, there was no action," he said. Another Indore resident, Abdul, said people's IDs are being checked around the pandal which is on the main road, and hence people can't stop going there. He said identity cards are being checked only this year and never happened before.

"We went for Garba for years, nobody had a problem before this," he said.

The organisers of the Garba event told NDTV that the Bajrang Dal members harass Muslims and hand them to cops. "This should not happen, the Garba pandals have always been open for all," they said.

"There have been no complaints of harassment by women, and the Bajrang Dal is simply creating nuisance," the organisers clarified. They say when they asked the police why there's no action against the Bajrang Dal, the police said because they're with the government. The Bajrang Dal, however, said they have got 14 Muslims arrested from Garba pandals as they came for "love jihad".

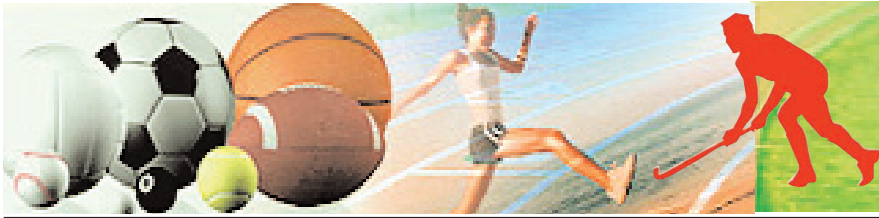

SOUTH AFRICA THRASH INDIA BY 49 RUNS

South Africa produced a dominating performance to thrash India by 49 runs in the third and final T20I of the three match series at the Holkar Cricket Stadium, here on Tuesday.

With the win in the first two T20Is, India won the two match series 2-1.

A scintillating maiden T20I hundred century from Rilee Rossouw (100 not out off 48) and a fine fifty by Quinton de Kock (68 off 43) powered South Africa to 227/3 in 20 overs, after being invited to bat first.

Apart from Rossouw and De Kock, Tristan Stubbs (23 off 18) and David Miller (19 not out off 5) also played valuable knocks for South Africa, who were also helped by India's sloppy fielding. Umesh Yadav (1/34) and Deepak Chahar (1/48) were the wicket-takers for India.

Chasing a big total, India scored at brisk rate for majority parts of their innings but kept losing wickets at regular intervals. The likes of Dinesh Karthik (46 off 21), Rishabh Pant (27 off 14) got starts but couldn't convert them into big innings.

SWAPNA BARMAN, PROUD DAUGHTER OF BENGAL, WINS DOUBLE GOLD FOR MP

She is as practical as they get. And that is the reason Swapna Barman says that while her two-gold effort in the National Games Athletics competition at the IIT Gandhinagar campus gives her happiness, she is not satisfied with her own performance in her favourite event, the Heptathlon.

She claimed the High Jump gold with a Games record clearance of 1.83m and added gold in the gruelling seven-event contest spread over two days.

"After winning a surprise gold in the High Jump, which I had not trained for, I did not complete my recovery as well as I wanted to. That affected my Heptathlon performance," the 25-year-old said.

Swapna Barman topped three events - 100m Hurdles and High Jump on the first day and Javelin Throw yesterday - and was second best in Shot Put and Long Jump to insure against her weak efforts in the 200m at the end of the opening day and 800m, the final event of the

competition. The 2018 Asian Games champion and 2019 Asian Championships silver medallist hinted that not having support staff was a reason. This year, Swapna chose to compete for Madhya Pradesh in the National Games rather than her home State, West Bengal for whom she won the Heptathlon gold and High Jump silver back in the 2015 National Games in Thiruvananthapuram. She said one of the reasons for the shift was that her long-time coach Subhash Sarkar may relocate to Madhya Pradesh upon retirement in January. She is okay with being criticised for not aspiring to compete in the Olympic Games and World Championships.

Swapna Barman has topped the 6000-point mark once, when she secured 6026 at the Asian Games in Jakarta. She missed that milestone by 7 points in the Asian Championships in Doha. She is confident that she can prime herself up to get the National record, pegged at 6211 points by JJ Shobha 18 years ago.

World Team TT Finals

Indian men advance to round of 16 despite loss against France

The Indian men's table tennis team advanced to the round of 16 despite losing 0-3 to France in their final Group 2 tie at the ITTF World Team Championships

Finals 2022, here on Tuesday.

In the first match, youngster Manav Thakkar went down 0-3 to (6-11, 8-11, 8-11) to world No 30 Alexis Lebrun. In the second match, Commonwealth Games 2022 bronze-medallist Sathiyam Gnanasekaran suffered a shocking 0-3 (4-11, 2-11, 6-11) defeat to 16-year-old Felix Lebrun, the younger brother of Alexis.

Thereafter, National Games champion Harmeet Desai gave a tough fight to Jules Rolland but ultimately lost 2-3 (11-13, 13-11, 7-11, 11-8, 7-11) and conceded the tie.

However, the men's table tennis team had won their previous three matches, including a memorable win over second seeds Germany and ended up with seven points in four ties.

It placed India third in Group 2 and ensured that they advanced to the knockout stages as one of the best-placed third teams in the group stages. The Indian women's team has also made it through to the round of 16.

Jemimah Rodrigues jumps four places to reach eighth position

India batter Jemimah Rodrigues gained four places to reach eighth position in the batting chart in latest ICC Women's T20I Player Rankings, released on Tuesday.

Rodrigues, who smashed a match-winning 76 off 53 against Sri Lanka in an Asia Cup match in Sylhet, is the third-highest ranked India batter after Smriti Mandhana (third) and Shafali Verma (seventh). On the other hand, India captain Harmanpreet Kaur has reached 13th position after gaining two places. Meanwhile, West Indies captain Hayley Matthews, who last week grabbed the top spot for all-rounders in ODIs after the ICC Women's Championship series against New Zealand, carried her fine form into the ongoing five-match T20I series which is currently led 2-1 by New Zealand. Matthews has gained eight slots and is tied in third place in the bowling chart with South Africa fast bowler Shabnim Ismail after a haul of four for 12 in the third T20I. The 24-year old, who also scored 30 runs opening the innings in that match, is up one place to 33rd among batters and advanced three places to second in the list of all-rounders led by New Zealand's Sophie Devine. Bangladesh captain Nigar Sultana (25th), Pakistan captain Bismah Maroof (28th) and India all-rounder Deepti Sharma (36th) have gained a slot each while Pakistan's Nida Dar and Bangladesh's Fargana Hoque have also progressed and are tied in 44th place. Former Bangladesh captain Salma Khatun is in 49th position after moving up four slots.

Nitin Menon in list of 16 umpires for ICC T20 World Cup

Nitin Menon, the only Indian in the ICC Elite Panel of umpires, figures in the list of 16 umpires and four match referees who will officiate in the T20 World Cup First Round and Super 12s stage matches in Australia from October 16.

Chief Referee of the ICC Elite Panel of Match Referees, Ranjan Madugalle, is part of a quartet of former international cricketers who will make up the match referees for the eighth edition of the T20 World Cup. Sri Lankan Madugalle is joined by Andrew

Pycroft of Zimbabwe, England's Christopher Broad and Australian David Boon.

Pycroft will be in-charge of the tournament opener in Geelong on October 16 when Sri Lanka take on Namibia in the First Round with Joel Wilson and Rodney Tucker the umpires in the middle. Paul Reiffel will act as the TV umpire with Erasmus, occupying the role of the fourth umpire.

Erasmus, Tucker and Aleem Dar are set to appear in their seventh ICC Men's T20 World Cup, with Langton Rusere umpiring in his second World Cup of the year having stood in the ICC Women's Cricket World Cup 2022, including acting as reserve umpire for the final.

Rusere will be the TV umpire when Australia and New Zealand kick off the

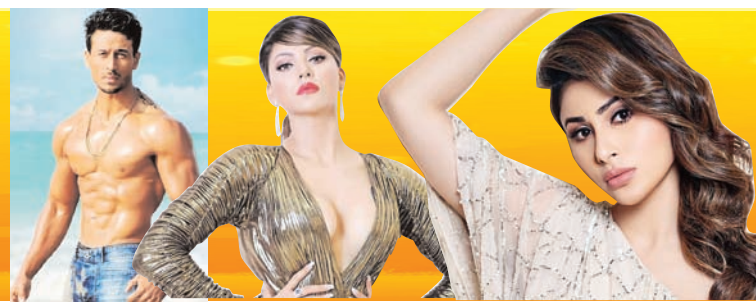
