Proving yet again that age has got nothing to do with success, seven Indian-American women have made it to the Forbes' '50 over 50' list of 200 entrepreneurs, investors, creators and entertainers.

While Manjusha Kulkarni, co-founder of Stop AAPI Hate, is listed in the 'Impact' section, the remaining six women are included in the 'Entrepreneurs' category of the covered list.

Kulkarni's Stop AAPI Hate is America's leading aggregator of Covid-19-related hate incidents against Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders.

She is also the Executive Director of AAPI Equity Alliance, a coalition of community-based organisations that advocate for the rights and needs of the Asian American community in Southern California.

In 2014, Kulkarni received the White House Champions of Change award for her dedication to improving healthcare access for South Asian Americans.

Ravathi Advaiti took over as the CEO of the global manufacturing and supply-chain company, Flex in 2019.



At Flex, Advaiti oversees 200,000 employees and sets the strategic direction for a company earning \$26 billion in annual revenue.

Padmasree Warrior has served as CTO of Cisco and Motorola and is currently the founder-CEO of Fable, a platform for social reading and book clubs. It raised over \$28 million in 2021. A Cornell-trained engineer, she believes a STEM education informs creativity: "Increasingly it's not about knowing all the answers but asking

the right questions and figuring out how to get the right answer".

Retail jobs in India down 12% amid record festive sales

While employment growth is slowing in retail trade, employer demand for workers remains strong in other verticals and job postings were at 62 per cent above their pre-pandemic baseline (September end).

Bengaluru holds the largest share of jobs in retail nationally, with 12.26 per cent of all retail jobs in the city, followed by Mumbai at 8.2 per cent.

At 6.29 per cent, job seekers in Chennai accounted for the lion's share of clicks for delivery jobs in India, said the report.

Delivery jobs have seen the highest demand in Bengaluru as well, with 5.5 per cent of all delivery jobs in the country being generated in the city, the report mentioned.

As e-commerce players earn big this festive season, India saw a de-growth of 11.8 per cent in retail sector jobs from August 2021 to August this year, a report showed on Friday.

Indians searching for retail jobs see a fall during the pandemic and beyond, and jobs in retails have seen an overall 5.50 per cent degrowth in the past three years.

Although jobs in retail saw an uptick of 27.70 per cent in 2020-2021, it again de-grew last year.

This could largely be due to the lockdowns last year and the work from home set up where people

chose to purchase online during festivities, according to findings from leading job website Indeed.

"The festive months in India are usually a time where we see an increase in seasonal jobs to meet the increasing demand. Even though the percentage increase of jobs hasn't been on par with last year, that's not to say a substantial number of jobs have not been created," said Sashi Kumar, Head of Sales for Indeed India.

"Over 39.6 per cent of new jobs have been created. We see the discrepancy with last year given the global recessions happening, possible inflations, and the cautious nature of hiring currently," he mentioned.



Rupee plunges to all-time low of 82.33 against dollar

New Delhi: Indian rupee on Friday fell sharply to its all-time low of 82.33 against the dollar owing to a rise in US bond yields and firming up of crude oil prices.

Rupee had closed at 81.89 on Thursday. It was trading at 82.30 against the dollar in the morning after opening at 82.19 a dollar. Later, it touched an all-time low of 82.33 against the dollar.

The all-time low plunge in the rupee has come a day after the World Bank had on Thursday cut India's growth forecast for this financial year by a full percentage point amid rising inflation and adverse geo-political conditions.

US ASKS ITS CITIZENS TO EXERCISE 'INCREASED CAUTION' WHILE VISITING INDIA

In its latest India Travel Advisory, the United States has asked its citizens to "exercise increased caution in India due to crime and terrorism". The US State Department in the travel advisory issued on October 5 has put India at Level 2, which denotes "Exercise Increased Caution". The advisory asked its citizens not to travel to the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir (except the eastern Ladakh region and its capital, Leh) due to terrorism and civil unrest, and within 10 km of the India-Pakistan border due to potential armed conflicts.

"Indian authorities report that rape is one of the fastest growing crimes in India. Violent crime, such as sexual assault, has occurred at



tourist sites and in other locations," the advisory added. "Terrorists may attack with little or no warning, targeting tourist locations, transportation hubs, markets/shopping malls, and government facilities," the US State Department said.

The US government has limited ability to provide emergency services to its citizens in rural areas from eastern Maharashtra and northern Telangana through western West Bengal as the US government employees must obtain special authorisation to travel to these areas.

Clamour grows for probe into Eknath Shinde's Dussehra rally 'bills'

The Maha Vikas Aghadi allies have demanded a probe, while an activist-lawyer has moved the Bombay High Court for an FIR into the alleged 'cash payment' of Rs 10 crore purportedly made by the faction of Chief Minister Eknath Shinde for buses to ferry crowds for his Dussehra rally in Mumbai on October 5.

Senior Shiv Sena leader Ambadas Danve has written to the Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC) demanding details of the expenditure for hiring over 1,800 buses for the rally at the Bandra Kurla Complex.

Congress chief spokesperson Atul Londe contended that the MSRTC staff took two days to count the Rs 10 crore and asked from where



did the Shinde group get this large sum of cash.

Sena MP Arvind Sawant has called for a probe by the Enforcement Directorate, the Income Tax Department and

the Central Bureau of Investigation into the cash payment made for the state transport buses.

Nationalist Congress Party chief spokesperson Mahesh

Tapase has said that since this booking was akin to "a bulk client", why digital or online payment was not taken, as propounded by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

"If cash payment was indeed made for such a huge amount, then where's the bill and in whose name it was issued," Tapase asked.

A Mumbai lawyer, Nitin Satpute, filed a writ petition in the Bombay High Court on Friday seeking directions for an FIR against Shinde and others under the provisions of PMLA and Income Tax laws for the 'unknown source' of the Rs 10 crore funding for the Dussehra rally.

Londe also questioned the source of the funds and who gave the amount in cash for the rally.

FREE BUS RIDES IN TN TURN BUMPY: MANY WOMEN REJECT FREEBIE, INSIST ON TICKETS

Conscious and self-respectful citizen



R. Sundari, a domestic help in Tiruchi, told reporter that "Initially we thought it was good as we could juggle work and work at two places or three places as we did not have to bother about travelling as it was free. After some days, the bus conductors started abusing us, using the choicest expletives, and the men used to laugh at this. Anyone who has a little self-respect would stop taking free rides. Initially, I did not want to reject it as it was saving me good money but later I decided not to travel for free and forcibly asked the conductor to accept money."

The DMK government in Tamil Nadu announced free bus rides for all women in the state after assuming office. It gained traction across the country as a project which helps women to access free rides on public transport and makes them more independent.

The scheme was well received during the initial days and the percentage of women riding buses touched an all-time high with around 61% of the total passengers in the Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation (TNSC) buses

being women. The DMK government touted this as one of its major achievements and showcased that the party always stood for women.

However, the honeymoon was short-lived with several cases of bus drivers and conductors belittling the women travelling free in buses, even hinting that they were doing so at the benevolence of the staff.

The issue gained momentum after the Tamil Nadu minister for higher education, K. Ponmudi at a public function made some comments reminding the women in the audience about the free bus rides

introduced by the Stalin government.

He asked the women there, "How are you going in the bus today? If you want to go from here to Koyambedu (a place in Chennai) or anywhere you are going in 'OC'." OC is a term used in Tamil for free.

This infuriated several people and a video of an elderly woman arguing with a conductor that she won't travel unless he takes the money for a ticket went viral. The woman asked the conductor, "The minister is talking like that!!? We going in 'OC'? We don't want to go in 'OC'! We will travel by paying for the ticket. Prices of

everything have risen and five rupees is not a big deal. Take the money and give me a ticket. We don't want to travel free."

This led to an uproar in the state and those close to the DMK came out with the statement that the woman in the video, Thulasiammal, was an AIADMK supporter and that she had tried to belittle the government.

In another instance, four women rejected free travel and insisted on paying. After these incidents, the TNSC has reportedly issued oral instructions to the conductors to collect the fares if the women passengers insist on paying.

MAN PRACTICING WITCHCRAFT SACRIFICES MINOR SON IN BIHAR

Patna: A man allegedly involved in witchcraft has been arrested for killing his minor son in Bihar's Banka district, an official said on Friday.

The accused, Dipak Sharma, allegedly practises witchcraft and to "gain black magic spells", he strangled his seven-year-old son Raghav Kumar on the night of Vijaya Dashmi. The incident occurred in Mahota village under Amarpur police station in the district.

The mother of deceased, Khusboo Devi, in her statement, accused her husband of killing her son Raghav on the night of Vijaya Dashmi. "We have registered an FIR against Dipak Kumar and arrested him from a nearby deserted place on Friday. After committing the crime, he was hiding behind the bushes which are located some distance away from his house. The accused confessed the crime," said Sunil Kumar, SHO Amarpur police station. "During the search of his room, we have recovered some books related to black magic, a sensor camera and a pen drive. The accused was involved in black magic for the past few months and he was waiting for Vijaya Dashmi to execute the sacrifice of his son and achieve witchcraft black magic spells," Kumar said.

Now, Vande Bharat Express hits Cow

The Vande Bharat Express on the Gandhinagar-Mumbai route hit a cow near Anand station in Gujarat on Friday, a day after the train hit a herd of buffaloes. There was only a dent in the train's front bumper and it had to be halted for 10 minutes, officials said.

In Thursday's incident, the newly launched semi-high-speed train had hit four buffaloes, and its 'nose' cone had come off. It proceeded after an eight-minute halt as damage to the nose - a bumper made of fibre-reinforced plastic - is not essential to the functioning. The animals died.

Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw has said such collisions with cattle are unavoidable and "this has been kept in mind while designing the train". "Its nose on the front is totally replaceable,"

the minister said earlier today. Prime Minister Narendra Modi had flagged off the train last month and travelled in it from Gandhinagar till Kalupur railway station in Ahmedabad.

The latest collision place a little before 4 pm near the town of Anand, about 100 kilometres from Gandhinagar and over 400 km from Mumbai.

"The train's front portion has suffered a small dent," Sumit Thakur, chief public relations officer of Western Railway, said, adding that all the passengers were safe.

The train reaches 160 km per hour in just over two minutes, and has better riding comfort than other trains, according to the railways.

Yesterday's collision with buffaloes occurred when the train was on its way back from Mumbai to Gandhinagar, around 11 am, between Batwa and Maninagar, ahead of Ahmedabad.



CBI CHARGESHEETS LALU PRASAD, RABRI DEVI IN 'LAND-FOR-JOB' SCAM

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Friday chargesheeted 16 persons, including Lalu Prasad and his wife Rabri Devi, in connection with a job scam that took place during Lalu Prasad's tenure as Railway Minister in the UPA government.

The CBI said that during investigation, it has been found that the accused persons in conspiracy with then General Manager and Chief Personnel Officer of Central Railway engaged persons in lieu of land either in their name, or in the name of their close relatives.

It has been alleged that more than 1 lakh square feet of land belonging to job aspirants' families in Patna was reportedly transferred to Lalu Prasad's family in return for jobs.

This land was acquired at prices lower than the prevailing circle rate and much lower than the market rate.

"The candidates used false TC and submitted false attested documents to the Ministry of Railways," the CBI alleged in the chargesheet.

The CBI has learnt that Lalu Prasad's wife Rabri Devi and daughter Hema Yadav were gifted land by job seekers who were later appointed in Railways. Haridayanand Chaudhary, a Railway employee,



and Bhola Yadav, then OSD to Lalu Prasad, were earlier arrested by the CBI. Bhola was Lalu's OSD between 2004 and 2009. The CBI had registered the

case against Lalu Prasad, Rabri Devi, their two daughters -- Misa Bharti and Hema Yadav -- and 15 others, including unknown public servants and private persons.

"During 2004-2009, Lalu Prasad had obtained pecuniary advantages in the form of transfer of landed property in the name of his family members in lieu of appointment of substitutes in Group D Post in different zones of Railways," a CBI official said. A number of residents of Patna, either themselves or through their family members, sold or gifted land to the family members of Lalu Prasad and a private company controlled by him and his family. They were also involved in transfer of such immovable properties.

"No advertisement or any public notice was issued for the appointment of substitutes in Railways, yet the candidates, who were residents of Patna, were appointed as substitutes in different Railway zones in Mumbai, Jabalpur, Kolkata, Jaipur and Hazipur.

Through this modus operandi, about 1,05,292 sq feet land in Patna was allegedly acquired by Lalu Prasad and his family members through five sales deeds and two gift deeds, showing the payment made to seller in cash in most of the land transfer, the CBI official said.

Massive fire breaks out in Noida plastic factory

A massive fire broke out in a multi-storey plastic factory located in Sector 3 in Noida. A total of 14 fire tenders have been pressed into service to douse the fire. A large plume of smoke could be seen from a

long distance as the fire spread quickly due to the excess of plastic items in the building. The cause of the fire isn't known yet, but investigation into the same will be conducted once the fire is extinguished. Reports have stated that the fire department got the information about the fire

at 3:24 pm, after which 14 fire tenders reached the spot and initiated the process of extinguishing the fire. The neighbouring companies have been evacuated as per the requirement of the fire department. No casualties have been reported till the time of going for print.

India objects to US envoy Blome's visit to PoK

India on Friday raised objection to US ambassador to Pakistan Donald Blome's recent visit to Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK).

MEA spokesperson Arindam Bagchi on Friday said that India has raised the issue with the US and the same has been conveyed to them. "We have objections regarding the visit and the meetings in PoK by the US ambassador and we have conveyed the same."

This was the second visit by a US official to PoK.

Blome referred PoK as "Azad Jammu and Kashmir", which is against the Indian stand as the region was forcibly occupied by Pakistan in 1947. The ambassador visited PoK on Monday to participate in a sapling planting event at a university and to lay a wreath in memory of the 2005 earthquake victims.

He also visited other landmarks in Muzaffarabad and referred PoK as "Azad Jammu and Kashmir".

The US embassy in Islamabad, following the Blome's visit, has shared a series of tweets during the last three days, detailing minutely the US envoy's itinerary in the disputed



region. The embassy, in a tweet quoting Blome, said: "The Quaid-e-Azam Memorial Dak Bungalow symbolizes the cultural and historical richness of Pakistan and was famously visited by Jinnah in 1944. I'm honored to visit during my first trip to AJK."

The US made it a point to highlight how it has been helping Pakistan in a holistic manner, restoring Pakistan's heritages and cultural sites, to providing significant humanitarian relief supplies during the 2005 earthquake to lately providing "over \$66 million in cash, food, and health assistance" as devastating floods ravage Pakistan.

Gujarat tribals accuse Christians of taking over temple, demand it back

Janjati (Tribal) Suraksha Gujarat, a sister organisation of Hindu front, has sought the district administration's intervention for getting back the possession of Gidhmadi Aya temple.

The temple is situated on Nana Bandharpada hills in Amba group village panchayat in the district.

It has alleged that Christians have illegally taken over the possession of the temple and are disallowing prayers as per tribal rituals.

Songadh Police Inspector N.S. Chauhan told the media that, "On October 1, Hindu priests had gone to the Gidhmadi Aya temple to conduct prayers, but the locals opposed it. Moment it was noticed, a police team was deployed to ensure that there was no breach of law and order. Then we had to convince both parties to disperse."

After this development, Janjati Suraksha Gujarat Prant's president Dinesh Gamit on Thursday led a



delegation of tribal leaders and priests and submitted a memorandum to the district collector and demanded his intervention in getting the Christians' possession vacated. They have alleged that Christians have renamed the temple and are now calling it "Mariam Temple". They have even put a Christian Cross in the temple. Gamit has even threatened that on Sunday (October 9), along with

tribal and priests there will one more time attempt to conduct prayer at the tribal temple. It will be the responsibility of the police and local administration to ensure that law and order is maintained, and tribes are allowed to conduct prayers as per their rituals in the Gidhmadi aya temple. He has threatened that if any untoward incident occurs it will be the responsibility of local administration.

Varanasi court defers Gyanvapi case hearing to Oct 11

The district court in Varanasi on Friday deferred the hearing in the Gyanvapi case and scheduled it for October 11.

The court was supposed to pronounce its verdict on the plea filed by the Hindu side demanding carbon dating of the structure they claimed to be a Shivling found inside the Gyanvapi Mosque's wuzu khana.

A heavy police force was deployed outside the premises of the court ahead of the crucial hearing.

Four women petitioners in the Gyanvapi mosque-Shringar Gauri case had sought scientific investigation and carbon dating to ascertain the nature and age of the Shivling.



The Hindu side had claimed that they had found a shivling in the abluition pond of the mosque when the survey was conducted.

The court had reserved the order in the Gyanvapi Mosque-Shringar Gauri case on September 29 after

hearing both sides' arguments.

The Muslim side in the Gyanvapi mosque-Shringar Gauri complex case had filed an objection in the court against the Hindu plaintiffs' plea for the carbon dating of the 'Shivling'.

Carbon dating is a scientific process that ascertains the age of an archaeological object or archaeological finds. On September 22, the Hindu side demanded carbon dating and other scientific tests of the Shivling-like structure.

Body of UP woman, killed 6 months ago, found

Sambhal (UP): The body of a woman, who was allegedly killed six months ago, has been recovered by the Sambhal police, police said on Friday.

It was recovered from the courtyard behind the accused's house on Thursday.

Sambhal Superintendent of Police, Chakresh Mishra, said, "We were informed by a man that his elder brother, along with a few other family members, had killed his wife six months ago on suspicion of an illicit relationship.

Police reached the spot and recovered the woman's body from the courtyard behind the house of the accused."

The highly decomposed body has been sent for a DNA test and further probe. The husband of the deceased and another family member have been arrested. Further investigations are on.

TRS predicts exit of a couple of Congress MPs in Telangana

A couple of MPs of Congress in Telangana are likely to leave the party around the time its leader Rahul Gandhi is in Telangana for his 'Bharat Jodo Yatra', TRS working president K.T. Rama Rao said on Thursday.

"As we speak, a couple of Congress MPs are likely to leave around the time Rahul Gandhi is here," he told reporters.

The Telangana Rashtra Samithi (TRS) leader said he had information that 1-2 MPs of Congress in Telangana would leave the party. He, however, declined to answer if they will be joining the TRS.

KTR, as Rao is popularly known, slammed the Congress party saying it has become the biggest liability



for the country.

Claiming that there is huge political vacuum in the country as the principal opposition party Congress has failed miserably.

The TRS leader said that the Congress party is facing an existential crisis and added that it will be very difficult for the party to survive this.

BJP Leader asks Rajputs to prepare to take up arms

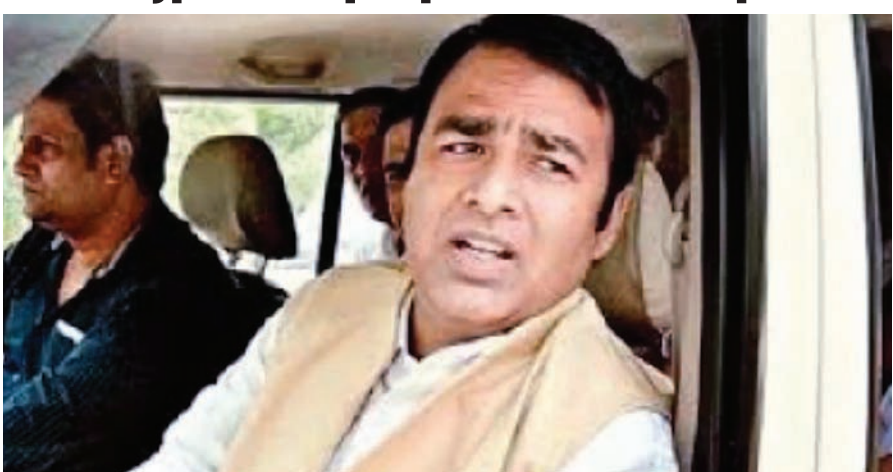

After a 'jagran' singer Dharmendra Pandey called upon Hindus to prepare to take up arms, it is now former BJP MLA Sangeet Som who has given a similar call.

Som, while speaking at a Dusshera function organised by the 'Rajput Utthan Sabha', said that the population of only a particular community was increasing and the Rajput community would need to take up arms in future to stop this.

"We have to be concerned about whose population is increasing. Our population is decreasing, but population of one community is increasing. It is possible that in future we would need to take up arms, when there is terrorism all around."

"We will need to pick up arms to stop 'Sar Tan Se Juda' (beheading) and terrorism threats," he added.



The former MLA further said that when the Rajput community picks up arms no one would dare to raise the threat of 'Sar Tan Se Juda' and create terrorism.

He also targeted the Bharat Jodo Yatra in Kerala, alleging that only green flags were hoisted in the rally, and hardly any national flag was used.

Som, a two-term former MLA from Sardhana Assembly segment in Meerut, is considered a Hindu hardliner and named in many cases related to the 2013 Muzaffarnagar riots.

The Justice Vishnu Sahai Commission which was formed after the riots named him in the list of those responsible for the flare-up.

He kicked up a controversy in 2015 when he called for the arrest of the family of Mohammed Akhlaq, who died in the Dadri lynching incident and promised bail for the accused in the case.

He lost in the 2022 Assembly election by a margin of more than 18,000 votes to Samajwadi Party candidate Atul Pradhan.

Centre asks Chief Justice UU Lalit to name his successor

The Central government has asked the Chief Justice of India U.U. Lalit to name his successor.

In a tweet, the Ministry of Law and Justice said: "As per the MoP on appointment of Chief Justice of India and Supreme Court judges, today the Minister of Law and Justice sent a letter to the Chief Justice of India for sending his recommendations for appointment of his successor." Justice Lalit will retire on November 8 and as per convention Justice D.Y. Chandrachud is to be recommended to the post in order of seniority. He is likely to be named as the next CJI by Justice Lalit. As per the convention, the government writes to the outgoing CJI and the CJI, in turn, recommends the name of the most senior judge as the successor, a month before retirement.

After the name of the senior most judge is recommended,



the incumbent CJI usually does not take decision on the recommendation for the appointment of new judges. The incumbent CJI usually leaves it for the new CJI.

The Chief Justice of India, who heads the collegium, had written to its four members -- Justices D.Y. Chandrachud, S.K. Kaul, S. Abdul Nazeer, and K.M. "The Minister was unhappy with the preparations of the Ujjain Municipal Corporation and smart city for the inauguration programme of 'Shri Mahakal Lok'," said a source in the Madhya Pradesh government. On Wednesday, after some stray cattle entered into the Chief Minister's convoy, Ujjain Municipal Corporation sprung into action and as many as six cattle enclosures were demolished and action has been taken against those who set their cattle free. The

BJP-led Madhya Pradesh government is preparing to organise a mega celebration on the auspicious occasion of the unveiling of 'Sri Mahakal Lok', a newly developed corridor at Ujjain's Mahakaleswar temple. Sources claimed that Wednesday's incident made state Urban Development Minister angry, which promoted him to transfer the Municipal Commissioner. Meanwhile, Ujjain Collector Asheesh Singh has declared a local holiday in the district on October 11 so that maximum number of people can participate in the inauguration programme of Shri Mahakal Lok.

Two MP Cong MLAs booked for harassing woman on train

The alleged incident was reported on the intervening night of Thursday-Friday when they were travelling in an AC coach of Rewanchal Express (Rewa to Bhopal).

Two Congress MLAs from Madhya Pradesh were booked for allegedly harassing a woman while they were travelling on an overnight train. The legislators, accused of harassing the woman co-passenger, were identified as Sidharth Kushwaha and Sunil Saraf. Kushwaha is MLA from Satna city while Saraf represents Kotma assembly seat in the same district. 37-year-old Kushwaha is also president of OBC wing of the Madhya Pradesh Congress. He was also one of the mayoral candidates from Satna, but he lost the elections against the ruling BJP. The woman alleged that the MLAs were drunk, used abusive language and harassed her during the journey. Railway police swung into action after woman's husband in a series of tweets, alerted railway police that his wife was travelling on a train from Rewa to Bhopal and two heavily drunk persons in the same compartment are misbehaving with his wife. By the time train reached Sagar station, railway police reached that particular compartment for checking. Later, the woman left her seat and shifted to another compartment, according to the police. In her complaint, the victim stated that MLAs Siddharth Kushwaha and Sunil Saraf boarded the train at Katni railway station. They were having their meal when she was sleeping on her berth in the same compartment. In between



Ghatera and Sagar railway stations, the duo allegedly woke her up and forced her to have a meal with them. But as she refused, one of the MLAs held her hand and continued insistence on having food. The complainant deboarded the train at Habibganj and filed a complaint at Habibganj police station. The FIR has been registered in Sagar government railway police station under section 354 of IPC, said a senior police official in Bhopal. Additional Superintendent of Police Pratima Patel

told press that the complainant was travelling with her infant in the AC compartment of Rewanchal Express. Talking to media, MLA Siddharth Kushwaha said, "I along with Sunil Saraf was coming to Bhopal. I boarded the train from Satna and after few minutes the same woman requested me to exchange her seat as she was carrying her little baby, so I did the same. We had our dinner and asked her as courtesy for dinner. I fail to understand why the woman has levelled such serious allegations against me and my colleague MLA." Kushwaha further said that he didn't even switch on the light in the compartment so that no one get disturb. "There was no further conversation with the woman took place after the exchange of berths. It was in Sagar when a police team arrived in our compartment, and we came to know about the complaint she made against us," Kushwaha added. "How is it possible for anyone to indulge in such a criminal act when there are co-travellers, ticket-checking staff, coach attendants, government railway police personnel, etc," the MLA asserted. Madhya Pradesh BJP president V.D. Sharma said that "the act of two Congress MLAs has exposed their real face". "Their leader Priyanka Gandhi says Ladki Hun Lad Sakti Hun, now I want to ask Priyanka Gandhi as to what action she would take against her party's MLAs. I condemn this act and believe that the Congress leadership would take action against the two MLAs," Sharma said.

Rajbhar to join BJP again

Suheldev Bhartiya Samaj Party (SBSP) president Om Prakash Rajbhar is inching closer to the ruling BJP in Uttar Pradesh. The BJP is also reciprocating the affection in ample measure. Deputy Chief Minister Brajesh Pathak, on Wednesday, shared the stage with Rajbhar at a function in Ballia. The deputy chief minister addressed Rajbhar as a "permanent friend". When questioned, he reiterated, "Yes Rajbhar ji is my permanent friend." Rajbhar, who snapped ties with the Samajwadi Party after the Assembly poll results, has been sending out feelers for a rapprochement to the BJP. He supported the BJP's presidential candidate Draupadi Murmu and has backed the government on multiple issues. He is heard appreciating Yogi Adityanath's style of governance on occasions more than one. "The joining of SBSP helped the SP to create a narrative of backward consolidation in a limited scale and increase its seat and vote share in 2022 Assembly polls. The SBSP might not have a large support base, but it has some support in at least 30-35 Assembly segments. The BJP will definitely try to get the party on its side before 2024 poll and Rajbhar also has no option but to return to the NDA fold," said a political analyst. The SBSP was formed by Rajbhar in 2002 and has sizable support among the Rajbhar community in eastern Uttar Pradesh. Rajbhars constitute roughly 4 per cent of the state's electorate. The SBSP formed an alliance with the SP in 2022 Assembly polls and fought on 19 seats winning six. In 2017, the SBSP contested the election in alliance with the BJP and won four seats.

BANNING OF EXTREMIST ORGANISATIONS IS A RIGHT STEP

In a decisive move, a communal and radical outfit, Popular Front of India (PFI), has been banned for five years by the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) for its alleged links to terror funding. In addition to this, PFI's associate organisations -- Rehab India Foundation (RIF), Campus Front of India (CFI), All India Imams Council (AIIC), National Confederation of Human Rights Organization (NCHRO), National Women's Front, Junior Front, Empower India Foundation and Rehab Foundation, Kerala -- are also banned leading to debate in the media about this.

A leading organisation of Pasmanda muslim named All India Pasmanda Muslim Mahaz has welcomed this move stating that the Pasmanda Mahaz is against Muslim communalism and believes that such organisations are also against the basic spirit of Islam.

So the extremist and radical organisations must be proscribed in order to maintain peace and harmony in the country, especially those organisations which have been instituted in the name of Islam but fail to follow Islamic principles and teachings. Islam propagates love and compassion for building an idealistic society devoid of fundamentalist organisations and proprietors who incite evil and violent activities.

There is a famous 'hadees', which states: "Whosoever of you sees an evil action, let him change it with his hand; and if he is not able to do so, then with his tongue; and if he is not able to do so, then with his heart and that is the weakest of faith."

This hadees motivates all Muslims to prevent the wrong doer whether it includes big sins like killing, lynching, mass violence or small sins as abusing, backbiting.

A true Muslim must stop wicked person and organisation.

Such organisations must be banned which encourages a sense of enmity rather than love and compassion; provoking innocent Muslims into violent protests rather than focusing on a peaceful, prosperous community. The Prophet Muhammad never allowed his companions to create instability and dissonance.

"Whoever wrongs one with whom a covenant has been made, burdens him with

The reliable and applicable Hadees shows the importance of good will for our neighbours and near ones.

Contrasting this Hadees, proprietors and partners of radical organisations like Popular Front of India (PFI) have been trying to snare innocent unemployed Muslims in the organisation and grooming them to develop radical violent approaches and to harass innocent people not conforming to their ideology.

These organisations are

working against humanity.

The nationwide ban is expected to force them to quit their unethical work and repent to their flaws; adopt a simple and straightforward path that will lead them to build a prosperous culture and tradition as the following Quranic verse pleads unambiguously.

NOBEL PEACE PRIZE AWARDED TO UKRAINIAN, RUSSIAN & BELARUSIAN CAMPAIGNERS

The Nobel Peace Prize 2022 have been jointly awarded to Ukrainian, Russian and Belarusian civil rights campaigners for "their consistent efforts in favour of human rights, anti-militarism and principles of law", the Norwegian Nobel Committee said in a statement on Friday. The recipients of the award are human rights advocate Ales Bialiatski from Belarus, the Russian human rights organisation Memorial and the Ukrainian human rights organisation Center for Civil Liberties. According to the Committee, Bialiatski was one of the initiators of the democracy movement that emerged in Belarus in the mid-1980s.

He founded the organisation Viasna (Spring) in 1996 in "response to the controversial constitutional amendments that gave the president dictatorial powers and that triggered widespread demonstrations", says the statement. Viasna provided support for the jailed demonstrators and their families. In the years that followed, Viasna evolved into a broad-based human rights organisation that documented and protested against the authorities' use of torture against political prisoners. The Committee claims that Belarusian government



authorities have repeatedly sought to silence Bialiatski, leading to his imprisonment from 2011 to 2014.

Following large-scale demonstrations against the regime in 2020, he was again arrested.

He remains in detention without trial. Meanwhile, Russian human rights organisation Memorial was established in 1987 by human rights activists in the former Soviet Union who wanted to ensure that the victims of the communist regime's oppression would never be forgotten.

Nobel Peace Prize laureate Andrei Sakharov and human rights advocate Svetlana Gannushkina were among

the founders. After the collapse of the Soviet Union, Memorial grew to become the largest human rights organisation in Russia. In addition to establishing a centre of documentation on victims of the Stalinist era, Memorial compiled and systematised information on political oppression and human rights violations in Russia. Memorial became the most authoritative source of information on political prisoners in Russian detention facilities. The organisation has also been standing at the forefront of efforts to combat militarism and promote human rights and government based on rule of law.

During the Chechen wars, Memorial gathered and verified information on abuses and war crimes perpetrated on the civilian population by Russian and pro-Russian forces. In 2009, the head of Memorial's branch in Chechnya, Natalia Estemirova, was killed because of this work. The Center for Civil Liberties was founded in Kiev in 2007 for the purpose of advancing human rights and democracy in Ukraine. It has taken a stand to strengthen Ukrainian civil society and pressure the authorities to make Ukraine a full-fledged democracy.

After Russia's invasion of Ukraine on February 24, the Center for Civil Liberties engaged in efforts to identify and document Russian war crimes against the Ukrainian civilian population. In collaboration with international partners, the center is playing a pioneering role with a view to holding the guilty parties accountable for their crimes. Honouring the "three outstanding champions of human rights, democracy and peaceful co-existence in the neighbour countries Belarus, Russia and Ukraine", the Committee said that this year's laureates have "revitalised and honoured Alfred Nobel's vision of peace and fraternity between nations, a vision most needed in the world today".

US READYING FOR SEVERE FLU SEASON, NEW COVID WAVE

Washington | The US is readying for a severe flu season as well as a new wave of the Covid-19 pandemic in the upcoming fall season, with health experts urging the public to get flu shots and Covid boosters. The US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is calling on everyone above six months to get their flu shots, reports Xinhua news agency. "I don't want to be alarmed, but I am concerned. We know that it's going to be a strain of flu that tends to be more severe," said Michael Phillips, an infectious disease expert at New York University Langone Health.

"For those ages greater than 65, there's a specific formulations of vaccines that you should get and it dramatically reduces the likelihood of hospitalization and death," Phillips said.

Less than half of US adults plan to get a flu shot this year and just a third feel safe getting a flu shot and Covid-19 vaccine at the same time, according to a survey of the US National Foundation for Infectious Diseases. Flu season typically starts in October, peaks in December through February and can last into the spring.



13 inmates killed in Ecuador prison riot

The number of prisoners killed during a riot at a prison in Ecuador's city of Guayaquil has increased to 13, authorities confirmed.

The riot took place in the Litoral Penitentiary amid clashes between inmates, Xinhua news agency reported.

"We regret to inform that as a result of clashes 13 prisoners are recorded dead," the National Service of Integral Attention to Adults Deprived of Liberty and Adolescent Offenders said on Thursday.

The clashes took place between inmates from rival gangs related to drug trafficking, who were fighting for control of the prison, according to prison authorities. Tactical units of the police and the armed forces re-established order amid a day of violence, which caused damage to the prison infrastructure.

The disturbances began Wednesday afternoon with the use of firearms, which activated the corresponding protocols and a unified command post.

Since February 2021, when a wave of riots broke out at various prisons in Ecuador, around 400 inmates have been killed in detention, official statistics showed.

World would face Armageddon if Putin uses tactical nuke weapon: Biden

In his most outspoken remarks about the threat of nuclear war, US President Joe Biden warned that the world could face an "Armageddon" if his Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin used a tactical nuclear weapon to try to win the ongoing war in Ukraine.

Addressing a Democratic fundraiser in New York on Thursday, Biden said it was the closest the world had come to nuclear catastrophe for 60 years, The Guardian reported.

"We have not faced the prospect of Armageddon since Kennedy and the Cuban missile crisis," he said.

"We've got a guy I know fairly well," Biden said in a reference to the Russian President. "He's not joking when he talks about potential use of tactical nuclear weapons or biological or chemical weapons because his military is, you might say, significantly underperforming."

Putin and his officials have repeatedly threatened to use Russia's nuclear arsenal in an effort to deter the US and its allies from supporting Ukraine and helping it resist the all-out Russian invasion launched in February, said The Guardian report.

One fear is that he could use a short range "tactical" nuclear weapon to try to stop Ukraine's counter-offensive in its tracks and force Kiev to negotiate and cede territory, the report added.

If Russia did use a nuclear weapon, it would leave the US and its allies with the dilemma of how to respond, with most experts and former officials predicting that if Washington struck back militarily, it would most likely be with conventional weapons, to try to avert rapid escalation to an all-out nuclear war.

But Biden said on Thursday night: "I don't think there's any such thing as the ability to easily (use) a tactical nuclear weapon and not end up with Armageddon."

Sweden has evidence to back Nord Stream sabotage suspicions: Security Service

Stockholm | Agencies

Swedish authorities now have evidence to back the suspicions that the Nord Stream gas pipelines have been sabotaged, the country's Security Service said. "Certain seizures were made during the on-site investigation. The continued investigation will show whether anyone can be suspected of, and later prosecuted for, this crime," Xinhua news agency quoted the Security Service as saying in a statement on Thursday.

Earlier this week, the Swedish Coast Guard cordoned off an area around two of the four leaks, before deploying a Navy vessel equipped with the appro-



appropriate technology to conduct underwater surveys. Another vessel with similar capabilities was also sent to the area, according to local media reports.

However, investigation leader Mats Ljungqvist from the Swedish Prosecution Authority said he could not give any further information.

"We can state that there have been detonations at Nord Stream 1 and 2 in

the Swedish economic zone, which have caused extensive damage to the gas pipelines. The crime scene investigation has strengthened suspicions of gross sabotage. "Seizures have been made at the crime scene and these will now be investigated. There is pre-trial confidentiality and the case is very sensitive," he said. The pipelines were built to transport gas from Russia to Germany, and Russia has reportedly expressed interest in participating in the investigations concerning the leaks in the Swedish and Danish exclusive economic zones (EEZ). However, at a press conference on Wednesday, the Swedish Defence Minister said this was out of the question.



POLICE ARRESTS JUVENILE TASKED TO KILL SALMAN KHAN

New Delhi/Mumbai | Agencies

The Special Cell of the Delhi Police has apprehended two key members of an international terror module, including a juvenile, who were wanted in a number of terror cases -- the RPG attack incident at the Intelligence Headquarters in Punjab's Mohali, plotting to kill Bollywood actor Salman Khan & others.



August 4. "The apprehended JCL has also disclosed the task given to him along with absconding Deepak Surakhpur and Monu Dagar (in jail) by Lawrence Bishnoi regarding the elimination of film actor Salman Khan. While the JCL was being handled by Rinda, Arshdeep was being handled by Landa Harike," the official said. Dhaliwal said that they had been working to nab the culprits for a long time. They identified people who were providing logistics support to the accused. Finally, both the

accused, Arshdeep and the juvenile, were arrested from Jamnagar in Gujarat. On May 9, a rocket-propelled grenade was fired at Punjab Police's Intelligence Headquarters in Mohali. During the course of the investigation, it was established that the attack was a conspiracy of Babbar Khalsa International (BKI), backed by Pakistan's Inter-Services Intelligence (ISI) and local gangsters. The juvenile held by the Special Cell was also involved in the conspiracy. The police has learnt that the attack was conspired by gangster

turned ISI stooge Harvinder Singh alias Rinda. Another fugitive gangster, Lakhbir Singh Landa had joined hands with Harvinder Singh alias Rinda. They were sharing manpower, logistics and resources. Rinda's name had already cropped up in the grenade attack at the Crime Investigation Agency (CIA) office in Nawanshahr and in the arrest of four suspected Pakistan-linked terrorists in Haryana's Karnal earlier this year.

Salman Khan murder plot

The official said that the juvenile was involved in the conspiracy along with other accused to carry out an attack on Salman Khan. They couldn't conduct a recce due to some reasons. Later, the juvenile was asked to kill Rana Kandowalia, a businessman. Dhaliwal said that they will move a plea before the court with a request to try the juvenile as an adult. The official said that when the juvenile is over 16, the court can decide whether to try him as an adult or not.

Ex-pilot nabbed as NCB busts Guj-Maha drug cartel, 60 kg mephedrone seized

The Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) has busted a major inter-state drug syndicate active in Maharashtra-Gujarat to seize 60 kg of high-grade mephedrone in the operations, and arrested six persons, including a former pilot, a top official said here on Friday.



NCB Mumbai Zonal Director Amit Ghawate said that among the accused is the kingpin of the drug syndicate and a former Air India pilot. Ghawate said that the tip-off was passed by the Naval Intelligence Bureau at Jamnagar in Gujarat on the suspicious activities of some persons.

The NCB followed up the intel input in coordination with other agencies of the targeted persons to gather additional information on their shady activities. It came to light a bulk consignment of the drug was in the process of being smuggled from Gujarat to Maharashtra and the sleuths

planned out the operation. Keeping a low profile to trap and nab all the persons involved in the narcotics racket, the NCB seized 10 kg mephedrone and caught four persons on October 3, including Bhaskar V. from Jamnagar, and S.G. Mahida, the former pilot, S.M. Chowdhury and P.D. Muthu, all from Mumbai.

Their interrogation revealed major drug linkages and other traffickers and NCB sleuths tracked them at various places over three days in Mumbai and arrested the kingpin M.I. Ali, and his associate M.F. Chisty on Thursday, with an additional seizure of 50 kg of mephedrone, said Ghawate.

The NCB Mumbai head said that Mahida had taken his flying training from Texas and Lithuania and worked with Air India between 2016-2018, while Muthu has a former record of arrest by DRI in 2001 in a 350 kg mandrax smuggling case in which he is currently on bail.

According to Ghawate, the mephedrone seized from Gujarat and Maharashtra are of same quality and is connected with previous seizure operations carried out by Mumbai Police. Mephedrone is a stimulant, commonly known as 'meow meow' or M-cat in the streets drug market and classified as a New Psychoactive Substance.

Arun Bali passes away at the age of 79

Senior actor Arun Bali, who has done many impressive roles in movies and shows such as '3 Idiots', 'Kedarnath' and 'Shaktimaan', left for his heavenly abode on Friday at 4:30 a.m., in Mumbai. He was 79 years old.

The actor was suffering from a rare neuromuscular disease known as Myasthenia Gravis.

He was recently seen in the Aamir Khan and Kareena Kapoor starrer - 'Laal Singh Chaddha', which was an official remake of the 1994 Tom Hanks classic 'Forrest Gump'. He played one of Aamir's titular character's co-passenger in the train. Arun impressed everyone with his acting in Hindi, Telugu, Punjabi films as well as several TV shows. He portrayed King Porus in the 1991 historical drama 'Chanakya'. He then played the character of Kunwar Singh in Doordarshan's very popular show 'Swabhimaan'.

Arun Bali rose to fame in the 2000s for his grandfatherly roles such as Harshvardhan Wadhwa in 'Kumkum'. He was seen in



'Doosra Kewal' which also starred Shah Rukh Khan. His last rites will be performed on Saturday in Mumbai once his two daughters, who reside in the US, land in Mumbai.

Shinde faction can't claim Sena symbol: Thackeray faction to EC

In the fight for who gets the Shiv Sena - party name, symbol and all - former Maharashtra chief minister Uddhav Thackeray told the Election Commission that the faction led by Eknath Shinde cannot claim the bow-an-arrow symbol as he and other MLAs in his camp had "voluntarily quit the party".

The Election Commission had asked Team Thackeray to respond to the claim by Eknath Shinde on the symbol for the upcoming assembly bypoll in Andheri East segment, the first such contest since Thackeray government was unseated in June.

Eknath Shinde, who became Chief Minister after the Sena mutiny backed by the BJP, has majority of the party's legislators on his side in the assembly and Parliament. His faction has even managed to get its members recognised as the Shiv Sena



leaders. But Uddhav Thackeray, who technically remains the party chief, is now gathering affidavits of support from party members -- the target is over 5 lakh -- to hold on to the party his father, Bal Thackeray, founded

over 50 years ago. Shinde claims the Bal Thackeray's "true legacy of Hindutva".

A court battle is on over whether the anti-defection law can unseat Mr Shinde and his MLAs. On the face of it, they have the two-third strength

among party legislators to avoid disqualification.

But the Election Commission looks at party units and members' support too - hence, the affidavits.

The Shinde faction's claim to the symbol was primarily seen as a bid to deny it to the Thackeray group, and thus keep it in abeyance until a final decision on the "real" Sena is taken.

Its immediate target is the November 3 bypoll, for which Team Thackeray has fielded Rutuja Latke, widow of Ramesh Latke whose death necessitated the election.

Team Shinde is backing the candidate of ally BJP, Murji Patel, a municipal corporator.

The Congress and the NCP have decided to support the candidate of the Thackeray faction, their partner in the Maha Vikas Aghadi that had come into being after Thackeray broke up with the BJP "over leadership issues" after the 2018 polls.

Mumbai Sea Link accident: Driver was plugging in phone charger

The driver of the sports utility vehicle (SUV), which rammed into multiple vehicles at the Bandra-Worli Sea Link in Mumbai killing five persons, was on Thursday sent to one-day police custody by a local court even as he told cops he was trying to plug in the mobile phone charger at the time of the pre-dawn crash.

The SUV driver, Irfan Abdul Rahim Bilakiya, was arrested from his residence at Mohammed Ali Road in South Mumbai on Wednesday, hours after the accident.

The 40-year-old was book under IPC sections 304A (death of any per-

son by doing any rash or negligent act not amounting to culpable homicide), 338 (causing grievous hurt by act endangering life or personal safety of others) and 337 (causing hurt by act endangering life or personal safety of others), among others after an FIR (first information report) was registered against him at the Worli Police Station. Bilakiya was produced before the court which sent him in police custody till Friday, a police official said. Bilakiya, who is into construc-



tion business, was returning home from suburban Jogeshwari when he allegedly rammed his SUV into three stationary cars and an ambulance on the bridge at around 3 am on Wednesday, police have said. Five persons were killed and eight others injured in the accident. After the accident, the SUV driver went to Saifee Hospital, where he received treatment for hand injury and afterwards proceeded to his residence from where he was arrested later in the

day, said the police official. The police took the help of CCTV footage of the Sea Link and obtained details of his vehicle before arresting Bilakiya, he said. During interrogation, Bilakiya told the police he was trying to plug in the charger of his mobile phone due to which he lost sight of the road ahead and rammed his SUV into the vehicles, he said. The police were ascertaining if the SUV driver was under the influence of alcohol and have sent his blood samples for forensic examination, the official said. They were also examining whether the SUV was speeding on the 5.6km-long cable-stayed bridge, which connects Bandra in the western suburbs to Worli in south Mumbai, he said.

Damaged Vande Bharat Express repaired within 24 hours

The front portion of the Mumbai-Gandhinagar Vande Bharat Express train, which was damaged after hitting some buffaloes in Gujarat, has been replaced by the railway authorities, an official said today. The Vande Bharat train was repaired within 24 hours of the incident.

The nose of the newly-launched Mumbai Central-Gandhinagar Vande Bharat Express train had suffered damage after it hit a herd of buffaloes around 11:15 am on Thursday near Ahmedabad, when the train was on its way to Gandhinagar. "The nose cone cover of the train's driver coach along with its mounting brackets was damaged in the cattle-hit incident. However, the vital parts of the train remained unaffected. The damaged nose cone was replaced at the Coach Care Centre in Mumbai Central," Sumit Thakur, chief public relations officer of the Western Railway said.



The nose cone was made up of FRP (fibre-reinforced plastic). The incident had occurred between Vatva and Maninagar areas of Ahmedabad, but the train had covered the distance to Gandhinagar Capital station and back to Mumbai Central without the panel on Thursday. "The nose cover is designed to absorb the impact without transmitting the same to the functional parts of the train. Therefore, it is sacrificial by design and hence replaceable," Thakur said. He said that a sufficient quantity of nose cones is kept as a spare.

Brawl between women on local train, female cop injured

The women's compartment of a Mumbai suburban train yesterday witnessed an ugly brawl between co-passengers, with some women coming to blows and even injuring a policewoman on duty.

In a video that went viral on social media, women can be seen clashing with each other inside the ladies' compartment of a Thane-Panvel local train.

According to Police Inspector Sambhaji Katare from Vashi Government Railway Police (GRP), the trigger for the clash was an altercation between three women passengers over a seat near Turbhe Station. The matter then escalated into a fight as more women got involved in the brawl.



In the video, some women passengers can be seen running over the seats to safety as a free-for-all broke out inside the carriage.

One policewoman who tried to intervene in Nerul to

resolve the dispute was also injured when some women passengers attacked her. At least three women, including the policewoman, suffered injuries. In the video, two women passengers can be seen bleeding profusely from their head injuries.

Katare said Vashi GRP was investigating the incident and a case had been registered.

According to the police, when a seat got vacant at Turbhe Station, one woman passenger tried to let a second woman take the seat. However, a third woman also tried to occupy the same seat. This resulted in a heated argument between the three women who started hitting each other. Soon, some of the other passengers also got involved in the brawl, resulting in an ugly scene inside the compartment.

For comment on Eknath Shinde's grandson, Uddhav Thackeray gets a retort

asked. On Wednesday, both the factions of the Shiv Sena - one led by

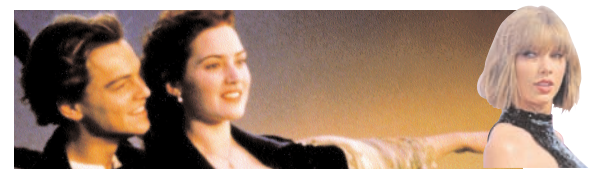
Thackeray and other by Eknath Shinde - held their rallies that saw attacks and counter attacks against

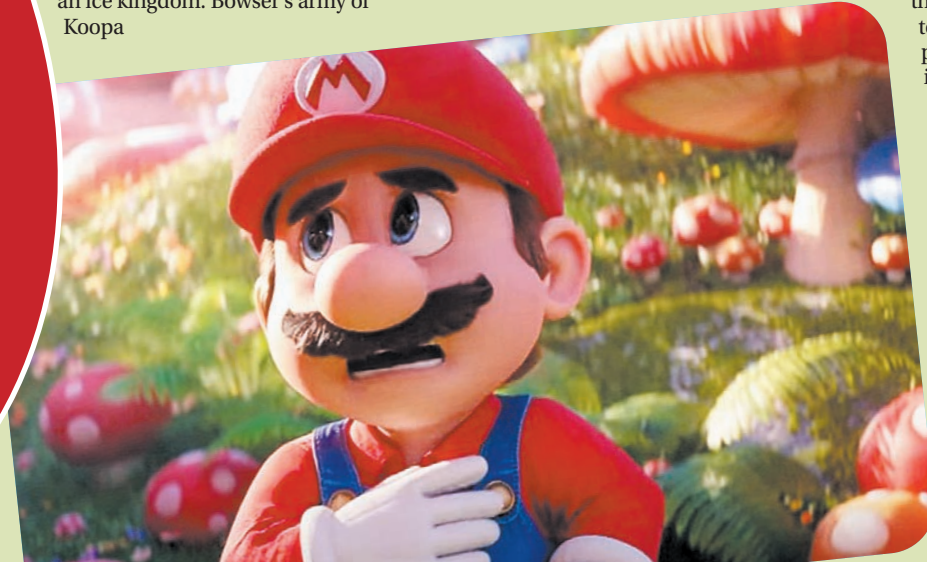

Anthony Rapp has made false sexual misconduct allegations: Kevin Spacey's lawyers

The 'House of Cards' star Kevin Spacey's legal representatives have now claimed that Anthony Rapp has manufactured sexual misconduct allegations against the actor. Furnishing the reason behind this claim, Spacey's attorneys said that Rapp was jealous of his success and angry about his own stalled career. "He blames Mr. Spacey for everything that hasn't gone well in his life," Jennifer L. Keller, an attorney for Spacey said during opening arguments in the actor's civil trial, quoted by 'Variety'.

Rapp "peaked around the year 2000 and he grew bitter about not getting parts as an openly gay man," Keller added. As per 'Variety', Spacey was on hand in Manhattan federal court as his lawyers attempted to fight back against Rapp's \$40 million civil lawsuit. Rapp is claiming that Spacey made unwanted sexual advances at him in 1986 when Spacey was 26 and Rapp was 14 years old. 'Variety' further states that Rapp's legal team made a point of reminding the jury that the actor was only a teenager at the time of the alleged assault, sharing a photograph of him in which he had a comb over haircut, wore glasses and appeared very boyish. They reminded the jurors not to think of Rapp as the 50-year-old actor who was watching the proceedings, but as the boy he once was. Rapp had claimed that during a gathering at the actor's New York City apartment, he went into Spacey's bedroom and at one point realised he was the last person at the party. He claims that Spacey blocked the doorway, preventing him from leaving the room, and eventually picked him up and put him on his bed. He then allegedly climbed on top of Rapp. However, Keller said that Spacey's apartment was a one-room studio and showed a floor plan on a screen that she said made Rapp's description of events improbable. "The story only works if you invent a wall and a door," she said. But Rapp's team painted a harrowing portrait of the evening, claiming that the teenager was "frozen" as he "felt the weight of Spacey" on top of him. At some point, they said, Rapp was able to escape to a bathroom, which they described as "a safe place, a place to retreat". Rapp eventually managed to leave the actor's apartment, deeply shaken by the incident.

GYMNAST-TURNED-DIVER MEDHALI REDKAR WINS DIVING GOLD

Maharashtra's Medhali Redkar on Friday won a gold medal in the women's 1M Springboard Diving competition at the 36th National Games Aquatics Competitions here.

The 24-year-old won the gold medal with a total of 171.50 points, finishing ahead of staminate Hrutika Shiram. The gold was a big success for Medhali, the gymnast-turned-diver, who switched sports in 2015, as she had finished fifth in the National Championships in Guwahati recently.

When Medhali Redkar hit the proverbial wall in her gymnastics career, her coaches suggested that she try her hand at diving as both sports require similar core strength and acrobatic abilities.

Unsure of whether it was the right choice or not, Medhali Redkar banked on her belief of not rejecting any new idea without trying it out first and took the plunge. Seven years later, the 24-year-old from Mumbai ended state-mate Hrutika Shiram's stranglehold on the gold medals

by clinching the yellow metal in the 1M Springboard contest here on Friday. "I had made the team in only one event, and since it was the last event, the fatigue of waiting was setting in. But I worked on that with my psychologist and came close to my best-ever (performance) to win the medal," said Medhali. Incidentally, Medhali had bagged a bronze medal in the 3M Springboard event at the just-concluded Senior Nationals in Guwahati and had finished fifth in the 1M Springboard event.

"I had complete confidence in my abilities. Yes, there was some anxiety in my mind going into the competition. But I worked on focusing only on my routine today," add Medhali Redkar, who is also a practising physiotherapist. The 24-year-old, who had won multiple national-level medals in gymnastics, has been successfully balancing her academics and sports over the years and said it

was easy for her as she was driven to excel in both. "I never wanted to restrict myself just to academics or sports. It means I need to work extra hard and my social life and friendships suffer. But I am happy with the way things are," said Medhali Redkar, who spends about three hours on diving practice and also works with a local sports clinic as her day job. Speaking about her transition from gymnastics to diving, Medhali said she initially used to practice both sports when she joined coach Tushar Gitaye in the Prabodhankar Thackeray Swimming Pool back in 2015.

Medhali is aware that diving isn't one of the more popular sports in the country but is hoping that things will change in the near future. "When I started gymnastics, it was still an obscure sport. It was only after Dipa Karmakar reached the Olympics that everyone started knowing about it.

Pakistan secure upset win over India

Just 24 hours after Pakistan endured a shock four-wicket loss to Thailand in the Women's Asia Cup, the side bounced back in style by pulling off an upset 13-run victory over India at the Sylhet International Cricket Stadium on Friday.

Friday's match also marks just the third time Pakistan have beaten India in T20Is and also the first time they defeated their arch-rivals in the history of Women's Asia Cup. Pakistan's famous victory was led by all-rounder Nida Dar, who slammed an attacking 56 not out off 37 balls for the side to get 137/6 in 20 overs.

With the ball, she then took figures of 2/23 in her four overs of off-spin. Left-arm spinner Nashra Sundhu was the pick of the bowlers for Pakistan with 3/30 while Sadia Iqbal had figures of 2/24 to bowl out India for 124 in 19.4 overs.

In the chase, none of the



Indian batters were settled at the crease, with Richa Ghosh giving Pakistan a late scare with 26 off just 13 balls, hitting three sixes and a four.

But once she was caught at long-on by Aliya Riaz for her third clutch catch of the match, the result became a foregone conclusion.

Indian National Car Racing Championship 2022 set to begin

MRF Formula 2000, among the quickest racing cars in the country, will return to the MRF MMSC-Fmsci Indian National Car Racing Championship after a two-season break as the first round of the 2022 season gets underway at the Madras International Circuit, here on October 8.

The two-litre single-seater will headline the compact, 10-race programme which also includes the MRF Saloons (Toyota Etios), Formula LGB 1300 and the three-tier saloon cars -- Indian Touring Cars, Indian Junior Touring Cars and the Super Stock -- categories. The MRF F2000 will have a grid of nine youngsters for whom it will be the first race outing in this category. Spearheading the pack is Agra's Shahan Ali Mohsin, winner of the MRF F1600 championship in 2021. All the nine drivers have graduated from karting and junior formula championships. As such, the competition is expected to be sharp.

Another notable development is the debut of Volkswagen Virtus GT car with two of them entered in the premier Indian Touring Cars



category. They will be driven by Chennai's Sandeep Kumar, last year's VW Polo Cup winner, and Jeet Jhabakh from Hyderabad, the 2019 VW Ameo Cup champion. The Virtus is powered by a 1.5 litre TSi engine tweaked to put out 215hp and mated to a six-speed sequential gearbox. The Virtus will go up against the modified Honda City Vtec from Race Concepts stable and driven by defending champion Arjun Balu from Coimbatore. The grid for the season-opener will comprise some 50 saloon cars and 30 single-seaters with a mix of young and experienced competitors besides a few female drivers. The grandstand for spectators is open for the weekend.

'Mankading' well within rules but I won't do it: NZ cricketer Amelia Kerr

The controversy surrounding India spinner Deepti Sharma dismissing England batter Charlie Dean at the non-striker's end in a WODI recently doesn't seem to die down, with young New Zealand cricketer Amelia Kerr saying that while it was well within rules, she wouldn't do it herself.

With England requiring 17 runs to win the match, Dean, who fought hard with an 80-ball 47, backed up too far at the non-striker's end and Deepti removed the bails to leave the batter in tears and those watching in shock.

Deepti's 'mankading' of Dean has since become a hot talking point with the likes of England all-rounder Moeen Ali, England women's team skipper Heather Knight and several others having an opinion on the dismissal.

On Friday, Kerr was quoted as



saying by ICC that, "it's in the laws of the game... a genuine dismissal and then you've got to weigh up the options if that's something you want to do in terms of the spirit of the game. If it's going to happen more, batters probably need to be more aware around them backing up."

In response to Kerr's opinion, fellow New Zealand cricketer Frankie Mackay said she once executed a run out of a non-striker while she was bowling multiple times in a season before being pulled up. "Three scalps in one season was enough for Canterbury Cricket, my association, to say 'please cease and desist, we don't wanna see that anymore', so I have shelved it since but heck it might be the only way I can get 'Melie (Kerr) out, so it might have to come back on the table for this year now it seems to be back in vogue!"

Mackay defended the run out, adding, "We want a game where there's a balance between bat and ball -- that's what cricket's all about so if it's heading too far one way with batters getting such an advantage with their running between the wickets, being able to crib a few extra yards, then yeah I can see definitely why it comes back in."

ROGER BINNY SPARKS BUZZ OF GETTING A ROLE IN BCCI REPORT

New Delhi: Roger Binny, currently serving as president of the Karnataka State Cricket Association (KSCA), has been named in the BCCI draft electoral rolls ahead of the elections in India's cricket governing body.



A report in Sportstar says Binny, the former India all-rounder and member of 1983 World Cup-winning squad, may land a role in the BCCI after he was named to represent Karnataka in the upcoming Annual General Meeting (AGM) to be held on October 18 in Mumbai, the very same day when the elections result will also come out.

The report added that with questions over Ganguly's future as BCCI president, buzz has been there of Binny, also a former senior men's selector, getting an important role. "It is too early to predict anything. The nominations will be filed next week, only then things could be clear," a BCCI source was quoted as saying in the report. Current BCCI secretary Jay Shah is set to represent Gujarat Cricket Association and treasurer Arun Dhumal is nominated by the Himachal Pradesh Cricket Association to represent the state body in the AGM. Anirudh Chaudhary, a former BCCI treasurer, will represent Haryana while current BCCI vice-president Rajiv Shukla will represent the Uttar Pradesh Cricket Association. Ex-ICC Chairman Shashank Manohar's son Adwait Manohar will represent Vidarbha Cricket Association while Ashish Shelar has been nominated as the Mumbai Cricket Association representative. The BCCI elections will happen for the role of president, vice-president, secretary, joint secretary and treasurer. The nominations for contesting the posts have to be filed by October 11 and 12. The report also said that the BCCI office-bearers had a meeting in Delhi late on Thursday about the AGM and the elections.

Astana Open Tsitsipas downs Hurkacz, sets semis clash with Rublev

World No.6 Stefanos Tsitsipas registered a 6-3, 6-2 win over Hubert Hurkacz to reach the semifinal of the Astana Open, here on Friday.

The Greek rallied to win a gripping first set, then broke late in the second for the victory. With this, Tsitsipas powered into his ninth semifinal this season and improved his ATP head-to-head lead against Hurkacz to 7-2. This, however, marked the first straight-set result in their past seven duels. Tsitsipas has yet to be broken in three matches at the ATP 500 in Kazakhstan, although it looked like he would concede his first set of the week when his fellow Top 10 star in the Pepperstone ATP Rankings held five set



points in the first-set tie-break. On the third one of those, the Greek player looked in particular trouble. With Hurkacz serving, Tsitsipas threw up a defensive lob after the Pole's forehand approach. But Hurkacz, so assured on smashes previously in the set, erred wide. Two more set points came and went for the seventh seed before Tsitsipas capitalised on his lone opportunity when Hurkacz's backhand passing shot strayed wide.

Yuvraj Singh Sandhu crowned champion of PGTI Players Championship

Chandigarh golfer Yuvraj Singh Sandhu continued his hot streak by securing his fourth win of the season at the TATA Steel PGTI Players Championship 2022 here on Friday.

Sri Lankan N. Thangaraja (68) finished fourth with a score of 16-under 272 while overnight leader Badal Hossain (73) of Bangladesh finished fifth at 15-under 273.

Yuvraj Singh Sandhu who started the day in the second position, one shot off the lead, was steady with two birdies and all pars till the turn that helped him emerge as a leader. The 25-year-old Yuvraj picked up the pace with birdies on the 11th and 12th before dropping a shot on the 13th even as Ajeetesh Sandhu made a charge to move in within one shot of the lead after 14 holes.

Japan Open Fritz advances to semis after Kyrgios withdrawal, to face Shapovalov

Taylor Fritz moved into the semifinals of the Japan Open Tennis Championships on Friday following the withdrawal of Nick Kyrgios due to a left knee issue.

The 2016 Tokyo champion had been in fine form this week with singles wins against Chun-Hsin Tseng and Kamil Majchrzak in addition to a run to the doubles semi-finals alongside Thanasi Kokkinakis. The Australian pair has also withdrawn from the doubles draw as a result of Kyrgios' injury.

Kyrgios plans to return to the ATP Tour later this month in Basel and Paris.

Meanwhile, the third seed Fritz had not won a match in three previous appearances in Tokyo but has battled hard to advance through the draw this week in the Japanese capital.

India commence Men's T20 World Cup preparation with the first training session in Perth

Hindutva : A political drama, tells the story of India

Story: The film revolves around the theme of how religious propaganda can cause mayhem in the society and how unity can curb it.

Hindutva is about two childhood best friends Bharat and Sameer who are divided by their individual ideologies. While Bharat tries to educate the world that the true meaning of HINDUTVA is Vasudhaiv Kutumbakam, Sameer, a popular student leader believes that his community is discriminated against. He poses to be a leftist, one who is fighting to protect his community. He is in love with Sapna, and Sapna also loves his dynamism and leadership in the University. But what happens when Sapna gets to know about Sameer's evil intentions? What happens when the two ideologies clashes? Will there be peace or destruction? The rest of the film answers these questions.

Review: The film truly tests the depths of Hinduism. And debates the concepts of Patriotism and Nationalism. Apart from having an engaging screenplay, such a film rest on hard-hitting dialogue and powerful per-



formances by the cast.

The storyline of Hindutva is exhilarating

and exciting, but only in fragments, making for a passable experience on the big screen.

The first half is interesting, but the subsequent events like romantic portions between and unneeded flashbacks drag and add on to the runtime.

This story contains plenty of blood, sweat, and grit, but not a lot of true emotion. However, it's the smartly written hard-hitting dialogues that are the pioneer of the film and plays a major role in uplifting its tonality.

Speaking of performances, Aashiesh Sharma as Bharat has literally breathed the character and efforts are palpable. Be it being a humorous, delivering dialogues effortlessly, and maintaining the guy-next-door vibe, the actor aces his part. His conflict with Sameer Siddiqui, Ankit Raaj forms some of the interesting portions of the film. Ankit is fantastic in his parts, albeit the emotional portions. Sonarika Bhadoria as Sapna delivers a decent performance, and is pleasing to watch. While Deepika Chikhalia as Guru Maa lends adequate support in the progression of the story, the rest of the cast play their respective portions well.

Talking of other technical aspects, the camerawork efficiently captures the grim vibe and beauty of Uttarakhand and Dehradun. The runtime and music act as a major dampener of the whole flick with the background score working well.

Conclusion: The film's larger issue revolves around the topic of Love Jihad and religion propaganda and rightly makes a strong case that it's evil and an attempt should be made to curb this practice. With its fiery dialogues, it can make a strong case. However, with no novel treatment and fine performances, the audience should not expect out-of-the-box.
