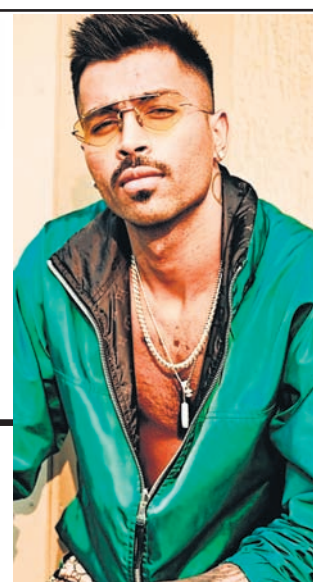

## COUNTRIES' CLIMATE PLEDGES PUT UNREALISTIC DEMANDS FOR LAND: REPORT

THIS STUDY REVEALS THAT COUNTRIES' CLIMATE PLEDGES ARE DANGEROUSLY OVER RELIANT ON INEQUITABLE AND UNSUSTAINABLE LAND-BASED MEASURES TO CAPTURE AND STORE CARBON. CLEARLY, COUNTRIES ARE LOADING UP ON LAND PLEDGES TO AVOID THE HARD WORK OF STEEPLY REDUCING EMISSIONS FROM FOSSIL FUELS, DECARBONIZING FOOD SYSTEMS AND STOPPING THE DESTRUCTION OF FORESTS AND OTHER ECOSYSTEMS.



### Climate financing, crypto assets to be main agenda points for India in G20: Sitharaman

New Delhi: Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Tuesday said that climate financing, funding energy transition, developing urban infrastructure and regulating crypto assets would be some of the major agenda items for India as G20 President.

India will be assuming presidency of G20 on December 1, which will continue till November 20, 2023.

Addressing the ICRIER's 14th annual G20 conference, Sitharaman said that global spillovers and global taxation are also areas of priority and it would be India's endeavour to build consensus on it among the member nations.

She said that debt distress will be an issue India would like to discuss during its presidency tenure.

A new study is the first to calculate that countries collectively need a total of 1.2 billion hectares of land to fulfill the promises laid out in their official climate plans, part of global efforts to meet Paris Agreement goals.

The study, involving more than 20 researchers from around the world and released on Tuesday by Melbourne Climate Futures, the University of Melbourne's interdisciplinary climate research initiative, determines that countries intend to use 633 million hectares of the total land area for carbon capture tactics like tree planting, which would gobble up land desperately needed for food production and nature protection. Only 551 million hectares

accounted for in pledges would restore degraded lands and primary forests, which store carbon, regulate rainfall and local temperatures, shelter plants and animals, purify water

and air and in some cases belong to Indigenous Peoples, whose land rights are found to be critical to reducing climate change due to their stewardship of forests. Researchers

Faced with a global land squeeze, we must think carefully about how we use each and every plot of land. Yet countries treat land like a limitless resource in their climate plans. Using a land area equivalent to half of current global croplands for tree planting simply won't work, particularly when the evidence in front of us shows the fragility of tree planting to worsening climate impacts like fires and droughts.

Kate Dooley, the lead author of The Land Gap Report, University of Melbourne

examined official climate plans and public statements, including Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs), which countries submitted to the United Nations as part of the Paris Agreement, to calculate the total land area set aside for carbon removals. The report says that these land changes would encroach on land safeguarded by Indigenous Peoples or used by local communities and smallholder farmers to feed themselves.

## Confusion prevails over announcement of Mangarh Dham as National Monument

Confusion prevailed on Tuesday over declaration of Mangarh Dham as National Monument, after the government withdrew its statement regarding the same from Twitter. Earlier in the morning, Press Information Bureau (PIB) wrote on Twitter, "PM @narendramodi declares Mangarh Dham as National Monument, #Rajasthan."

The PIB had tweeted when the programme of Prime Minister Narendra Modi was in progress. However, as the programme ended, there was no mention of the declaration of Mangarh Dham as National Monument and the tweet was deleted further.

It needs to be mentioned here that Modi on Tuesday reached Mangarh Dham, which is known as the martyrdom site of about 1500 tribals.

All eyes were set on whether he would announce Mangarh as National Monument or not as opposition in Rajasthan was pitching for the same ever since Modi's visit was planned here.

Speaking on the occasion, Modi said that before the freedom struggle of 1857, the tribal society had sounded the bugle of Independence. "We are indebted to the contributions of tribal society. It is the tribal society that saves the character of India."

However, he did not announce whether or not to make it a National Monument. Earlier, Prime Minister Modi paid tribute to the tribals by visiting the martyr memorial.



Modi said that it is everyone's desire to make Mangarh Dham grand. Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Gujarat and Maharashtra should discuss among themselves and prepare a detailed plan and prepare a roadmap for the development of Mangarh Dham. Together, the four states and the Government of India will take it to new heights.

Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot said that the history of Mangarh Dham has been written in golden letters. We have appealed to the PM to make it a national monument. The tribal society was second to none in fighting the war of Independence. Gehlot said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi gets respect in the world because of Mahatma Gandhi. Our appeal is to declare Mangarh as a National Monument.

However, there was no mention of Mangarh as a National Monument on Tuesday.

## 40 PISTOLS SEIZED IN MP AFTER CAR CHASE, SEARCH ON FOR ACCUSED



Indore: A cache of illegal weapons, including 40 pistols and 36 magazines, were seized from a car after a long chase by the police in Madhya Pradesh's Khargone district, an official said on Tuesday.

Acting on a tip-off, the police intercepted a Haryana-registered car on Agra-Mumbai National Highway in Indore's Rau area in the early hours of Monday, Police Commissioner Harinarayanchari Mishra told reporters.

In a bid to avoid the police, the driver increased the speed of the car and while fleeing, hit a police vehicle, he said.

Four people travelling in the car then reached Khalghat, about 90 km from Indore, where they again hit a police vehicle and the barrier, the official said.

After constant chase and police blockade, the accused of the inter-state gang left the car in Sanawad area of Khargone district and fled towards the dense forest, he said.

At least 40 pistols, 36 magazines and five cartridges were recovered from the vehicle, which had a Haryana registration number, the official said.

"These weapons are advanced imitations of foreign weapons. The magazines recovered from the car can be filled with 30 cartridges, whereas a normal magazine can only accommodate 10," he said.

A search has been launched for the accused and a probe has been initiated to trace the source of the weapons, the official said.

## WhatsApp bans 26 lakh bad accounts in India as amended IT rules take shape

Meta-owned WhatsApp on Tuesday said it banned over 26 lakh accounts in India in the month of September in compliance with the new IT Rules, 2021, which are now being amended to put more responsibilities on social media platforms.

The messaging platform, which has nearly 500 million users (according to third-party data) in the country, received 666 complaint reports in September in India, and the records "actioned" were 23.

"In accordance with the IT Rules 2021, we've published our report for the month of September 2022. This user-safety report contains details of the user complaints received and the corresponding action taken by WhatsApp, as well as WhatsApp's own preventive actions to combat abuse on our platform," a company spokesperson said in a statement.

The platform banned over 23 lakh bad accounts in India in August.

Under the upgraded IT Rules 2021, major digital and social media platforms, with in excess of five million users, have to publish monthly compliance reports.

Meanwhile, in a major push towards an



open, safe, trusted and accountable Internet, the Ministry of Electronics and IT has notified some amendments aimed at protecting the rights of "Digital Nagriks".

Currently, social media intermediaries are only required to inform users about not uploading certain categories of harmful/unlawful content.

The amendments impose a legal obligation on intermediaries to take reasonable efforts to prevent users from uploading such content.

Union Minister Rajeev Chandrasekhar said that protection of constitutional rights of the Indian citizens is a must.

## AIR QUALITY IN DELHI DIPS TO 'SEVERE' CATEGORY

The air quality of the national capital on Tuesday entered the "severe" category as the overall Air Quality Index (AQI) of the city crossed 400, according to data from the System of Air Quality and Weather Forecasting And Research (SAFAR), and will remain the same on Wednesday also.

The Narela area recorded PM 2.5 level at 448 on Tuesday evening. With air quality dipping in the city, there is a rise in carbon monoxide (CO) levels in some areas across the city, posing a threat to children and senior citizens.

The severe category of air quality calls for health warnings of emergency conditions and even serious risk of respiratory effects in the general public.

The AQI between zero

and 50 is considered "good", 51 and 100 "satisfactory", 101 and 200 "moderate", 201 and 300 "poor", 301 and 400 "very poor", and 401 and 500 "severe". In Pusa, the AQI

was recorded at 426 "severe" category while PM 10 was reported at 341 under "very poor" category. According to the forecast from SAFAR, the air quality of the city will

deteriorate further under "severe" category with PM 2.5 reaching 412 and PM 10 concentration at 426 also under "severe" category on Wednesday.

## Heavy rains in Chennai leave 2 dead, SDRF on standby

With two persons losing their lives in rain-related incidents in Chennai, which recorded

heavy to very heavy showers on Tuesday while various Tamil Nadu districts saw heavy rains in wake of the northeast monsoon hitting the state on October 29, the State Disaster Response Force has been kept on standby. In a tragic incident on Tuesday morning, 47-year-old

Shanthi died after a portion of the wall from the balcony of her house fell on her. The incident occurred at Prakash Rao Colony in Pulianthope area of the city. Police have commenced an investigation and according to initial reports, it was an old house that had collapsed due to the heavy rains since Monday. In another incident, autorickshaw driver, Devendran was electrocuted to death after he came into contact with a live wire in Vyasarpadi. The auto driver, according to onlookers, was in an inebriated state and was walking in knee-deep

water, when he got in contact with a pole in direct contact with a live wire.

Heavy rain leading to the closure of schools and massive traffic jams in several parts of the state, including Chennai. The districts where schools were ordered to close are Chennai, Kancheepuram, Chengalpattu,

Tiruvalur, Thanjavur, Tiruvarur, and Nagapattinam.

The weatherman has predicted heavy rain in Tamil Nadu and Puducherry till Friday.

Chief Minister M.K. Stalin has called an urgent meeting of top officials of the state at the secretariat.

## Truss texted US secretary of state after Nord Stream attack saying 'it's done': Russia

Russia has accused Britain of coordinating attacks on the Nord Stream gas pipes, media reported.

Dmitry Peskov, Putin's spokesman, said on Monday that Kremlin intelligence agents "have data indicating British military specialists were directing and coordinating the attack" which destroyed two gas lines running from Russia to Germany in September, Daily Mail reported.

It comes after Kim Dotcom, who ran site Megaupload before he was convicted of fraud, began circulating a conspiracy theory that Liz Truss had texted US Secretary of State Antony Blinken immediately after the attack saying "it's done."

Kim claimed to have learned of the message from Truss's iCloud, after it was revealed that Russia hacked her phone while she was



foreign secretary. Neither Kim nor Peskov have released the evidence they claim to have seen.

Western leaders have stopped short of publicly blaming Russia for the attack - which blew two holes in each pipeline and may have permanently disabled them - but have been privately briefing their suspicions that Putin was behind it.





# DELHI SHOCKER: FIRED FROM JOB, EX-EMPLOYEE HACKS COUPLE TO DEATH

A 38-year-old man, his wife and their domestic help were killed by their former employee and his five to six associates at the couple's residence in West Delhi's Hari Nagar area. The incident occurred on Tuesday morning.

The accused even ransacked the house and took the couple's belongings, including the CCTV camera's DVR to divert police and show it as a robbery bid. The entire conspiracy was unearthed after police nabbed two accused within six hours of the incident.

Meanwhile, a manhunt has been initiated to nab the remaining accused and the main culprit, who wanted to take revenge after being fired from the saloon owned by the couple.

The deceased have been identified as Sameer Ahuja, his wife Shalu and their domestic help Sapna.

According to Ghanshyam Bansal, Deputy Commissioner of Police (west), a call was received at Hari Nagar police station at about 9.15 a.m. regarding an incident of burglary in a house at Ashok Nagar area following which Emergency Response Vehicle (ERV) was dispatched for the spot.

"When police team reached the spot, the bodies of Sameer, Shalu and their maid Sapna were found.



Both Shalu and Sapna were found lying dead on the ground floor in a saloon owned by the couple, while Sameer was found lying in a pool of blood on the first floor of the building," said the DCP.

"Throat of both Shalu and Sapna had been slit with sharp-edged weapon and Sameer had multiple injuries on face and head. However, the couple's minor daughter was found alive on the first floor in the hall," said the DCP. "During investigation, it was revealed that the couple's driver came at around 9 a.m. who found the house ransacked, so he made the PCR call. The inspection of the spot revealed that it was a

friendly entry," said the official. "Keeping in view the sensational crime, multiple teams were formed and CCTV footage of the area scanned. The strategic efforts showed the result when the alleged people were found captured in a CCTV installed nearby. They came on two bikes around 8 a.m.," said the official. "The accused were also seen rushing in a hurry after committing the crime around 9 a.m. Though they had taken the DVR of the CCTV, the technical analysis of the event established that the main conspirator of the incident visited the house around 10 minutes prior to the visit of the maid Sapna," said the DCP.

"Based on CCTV footage, the police team managed to nab Sachin (19), a resident of Najafgarh and Sujet (21), a resident of Uttam Nagar in connection with the incident," said the official adding that the main conspirator is still on the run and a manhunt has been initiated to nab him.

Police said that so far, the investigation has revealed that the main accused and his girlfriend were working with Shalu in the saloon and around 10 days ago, due to their unprofessional attitude, they both were sacked.

"Sameer also verbally thrashed them. The main conspirator felt humiliated and planned to take revenge and discussed it with Sujit and Sachin. The accused then roped in other three persons and they all on Tuesday morning came prepared and executed the plan," said the DCP.

"As maid reached the couple's house around 8 a.m., the accused also slit her throat. They took away the laptop, cash and other articles lying in the house," said a police official. "The Iphone-13 (Pro-Max) of Shalu, weapon of offence and blood-stained towel had been recovered at the instance of the accused persons. Efforts are being made to recover remaining case properties," said the DCP, adding that further investigation is underway.

# No violation of programme code, Malayalam news channel tells SC

Malayalam news channel 'MediaOne' on Tuesday told the Supreme Court that there is not a single instance when the channel violated the programme code and security clearance from the Centre is not needed for renewal of broadcast licence.

Senior advocate Dushyant Dave, representing the news channel, contended before a bench of Justices D.Y. Chandrachud and Hima Kohli that government does not have omnibus discretion to impose any new condition and emphasised on the aspect of freedom of press.

Dave said the Cable Television Networks (Regulation) Act, 1995 does not contemplate any requirement of security clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs for the renewal of broadcast licence. He said the Act itself provides certain conditions which need to be fulfilled like interest of sovereignty, and security of the state, friendly relations with foreign states, public order, incitement of offence, decency and morality, and contempt of court. "There is not a single instance when we



violated the programme code," he said.

He vehemently argued that the government cannot put any new conditions, and the channel is not eligible for registration and renewal of licence if the conditions in Act are not fulfilled.

The top court was informed that the Act provides that renewal will be considered after a period of 10 years, subject to the condition that the channel should not have been found violating programme code on five occasions.

The bench noted that renewal is like grant of licence at the initial level, which gives it uplinking rights for a fresh period of 10 years.

Dave said the renewal position has general terms and conditions which does

not say anything about the need for security clearances and added the government does not have omnibus discretion in imposing any new condition. The top court will continue to hear the matter on Wednesday.

The top court is hearing a plea by the news channel challenging the Kerala High Court's order upholding the Centre's decision to ban its telecast on security grounds.

On March 15 this year, the Supreme Court stayed the Centre's ban on the Malayalam TV news channel.

The Central government had acted national security grounds to justify the ban. Media One had moved the top court after the Kerala High Court upheld the ban imposed on it by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting.

# Two dead in Narela factory fire

Two people died while 18 were rescued after a fire broke out at a footwear factory in Delhi's Narela industrial area on Tuesday, fire officials said.

The deceased have been identified as Sonu Thakur (24), a resident of Bihar, and Akhil Kumar (20), a resident of Narela.

Delhi Fire Service chief Atul Garg said that a call regarding the fire at a building in the area was received at around 9.35 a.m. following which 12 fire tenders were pressed into service.

"The fire was doused by 3 p.m.," said a fire official, adding that around 50 fire personnel were pressed into action as the fire was on the



second floor of the building.

According to police, a total of 20 people were rescued from the slipper manufacturing unit. "Two were declared brought dead while eight people were treated at Ram Manohar Lohia hospital and

10 were referred to Safdarjung hospital for the treatment," said the official. A case has been registered under sections 287 (negligent conduct with respect to machinery), 337 (causing hurt by act endangering life or personal safety of others), 304 (punishment for culpable homicide not amounting to murder) and 34 (common intention) of the Indian Penal Code and further investigation has been launched, said a senior police official.

Police said that the owner of the factory, Sahil Garg (30), a resident of Pitampura, is absconding and a manhunt has been launched to nab him. Meanwhile, police have detained Sahil's father, Krishan Garg, the owner of the property.

## CHHATTISGARH CELEBRATES 23RD FOUNDATION DAY

Raipur: Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel inaugurated the third National Tribal Dance Festival to mark State Foundation Day on Tuesday by playing the tribal musical instrument, Nagada in Raipur. Artists from 28 states of India and 10 countries of the world participated in this festival.

Raipur is hosting the festival to celebrate Chhattisgarh's 23rd Foundation Day (Chhattisgarh Rajyotsava) from November 1-3 at Science College Ground.

In the programme, artists from 28 states, seven Union Territories of India and 10 foreign countries - Mozambique, Togo, Egypt, Mongolia, Indonesia, Russia, New Zealand, Serbia, Rwanda and Maldives - mesmerised the audience by their performances.

# Vigilance Bureau arrests its own inspector for accepting bribe

The Vigilance Bureau (VB) arrested an inspector of its own department, Amolak Singh, posted at Bureau range office Amritsar for allegedly accepting a bribe of Rs 5,000.

Disclosing this here on Tuesday, a spokesperson of the Bureau, in a statement said that the accused inspector had been arrested on the complaint of Prabhmesh Mohan, a resident of New Mohindra Colony, Amritsar.

He further informed that the complainant had uploaded a video while filing online complaint. The complainant said that he and his wife, who was an employee in MC Amritsar, were arrested by the Bureau in a corruption case in 2021 and court had granted bail to them.

The complainant further alleged that Amolak Singh, being investigating officer of this case, was demanding Rs 5,000 as a bribe from him to record his voice as a sample in their case. To keep it as evi-



dence, the complainant had recorded this conversation on his phone and handed it over to the Vigilance Bureau, the statement said. After verification of the facts in the complaint and the material evidence, the Bureau had arrested the inspector for accepting bribe of Rs

5,000 from the complainant, read the statement. A case under Prevention of Corruption Act had been registered against the accused official at Vigilance Bureau flying squad-1 Punjab, police station SAS Nagar and further investigation was under progress, said the statement.

# MANY FAINT IN LUDHIANA DUE TO GAS LEAK

Chandigarh: Many people fainted in Punjab's industrial town Ludhiana on Tuesday due to a gas leak in an oxygen manufacturing factory in Giaspura area, police said.

Most of the people who fainted were employees of the factory. Five people have been admitted to civil hospital for treatment. The leak occurred when gas was being transferred from the tanker truck to the factory tanker.

# 3 LeT terrorists killed in Pulwama encounter, one terrorist in Anantnag

Three LeT terrorists, including a commander, were killed in an encounter in Jammu and Kashmir's Pulwama district on Tuesday, as they were on their way to attack a security force camp, police said.

"Three terrorists killed in Awantipora encounter. Identification being ascertained. As per our source, one is Foreign Terrorist and one local terrorist of LeT namely Mukhtiyar Bhat, involved in several terror crimes including killing of one ASI of CRPF and two RPF personnel. A big success for us," tweeted Jammu and Kashmir



Police, quoting Additional Director General of Police, Kashmir Zone, Vijay Kumar. In another tweet, the police said that as per sources, Bhat, along with a foreign terrorist, was going for fideyeen attack on a security forces camp. An

AK-74 rifle, an AK-56 rifle, and one pistol was recovered from the spot.

"Awantipora police and Army averted a major terror incident," it quoted Vijay Kumar as saying.

The firefight started after a joint team of police and security forces got an input about the presence of terrorists in that area. After security forces cordoned off the area, terrorists hiding there started firing drawing retaliation by the security forces. This is the second encounter in Kashmir on a single day. Earlier on Tuesday, an encounter broke out between terrorists and security forces at Semthan Bijbehara area of Anantnag district in which one terrorist was killed.

# Petition filed at Delhi Lokayukta against Satyendar Jain

A Delhi-based lawyer has filed a petition at Delhi Lokayukta, seeking enquiry into the claims of multimillionaire conman Suresh Chandrashekhar against jailed AAP leader and Delhi Health Minister Satyendar Jain of allegedly taking protection money.

Vineet Jindal, an advocate said in the petition that Chandrashekhar, who was arrested by Delhi Police in the Rs 200 crore extortion case, had confessed in a letter to Delhi Lt. Governor that he was forced to pay Rs 10



crore to Jain as "protection money".

"The letter added that a total amount of Rs 50 crore was paid to the AAP as he was promised an important party position in south India," stated Jindal.

"He specifically says that 'After my arrest in 2017, I was lodged in Tihar Jail and was visited multiple times by Satyendar Jain, who held the portfolio of jail minister. In 2019 again, I was visited by Jain, whose secretary asked me to pay Rs 2 crore every month as protection money and to get basic facilities inside the jail," stated the petition. In his letter, Chandrashekhar also stated that he told a CBI investigative team last month about payments made to Satyendar Jain, the Aam Aadmi Party, and D-G Prisons.

# Bharat Jodo Yatra Rahul Gandhi hoists national flag at Charminar

As part of Bharat Jodo Yatra, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday hoisted the national flag at Charminar, the monument which symbolises Hyderabad.

Accompanied by party leaders and hundreds of party workers and supporters, he paid tributes to his late father and former Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi and unfurled the national flag.

The event was organised in commemoration of Rajiv Gandhi's visit to Charminar on October 19, 1990 to launch Sadbhavana Yatra for communal peace and harmony in twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad.

As soon as Rahul Gandhi reached the monument from Laad Bazar road, he stopped



for a few moments to take a look at the edifice and captured its beauty in his camera before moving forward.

Hundreds of Congress workers converged around Charminar to welcome the party leader and raised slogans of 'Jodo Jodo, Bharat Jodo' and 'Rajiv Gandhi Amar Rahe' when Rahul Gandhi was offering floral tributes at the portrait of his late father.

# Girl abducted in UP, video goes viral but no arrests

A 17-year-old girl was kidnapped from her home by a group of men in broad daylight.

The incident took place in the Tajganj area and a video clip of the incident has gone viral on social media. In the clip, some men can be seen climbing the wall of the girl's house even as others watch. Next, they attack her family with sticks and knives and walk away with her in front of neighbours and locals.

According to police, the crime took place on October 26 and the girl was rescued the next day, after which an FIR was registered against 10 people.

A complaint filed by the girl's father said that a local resident, Arun Lala, had been regularly misbehaving with his daughter.

The complainant, who is a daily wager, said, "Arun and his associates barged into my house. After beating us,



they forcefully took away my daughter."

A large crowd witnessed the crime. No one came forward to help us. My family is living in constant fear now. We went to the police station but an FIR was not lodged, despite there being video evidence," the father added.

The FIR was registered later on the

intervention of Senior Superintendent of Police Prabhakar Chaudhary.

The main accused Arun and nine others, identified by the complainant, along with 5-6 unidentified persons were booked under IPC sections 147 (rioting), 452 (house-trespass), 354 (assault or criminal force to woman with intent to outrage her modesty), 323 (voluntarily causing hurt), 363 (kidnapping), 504 (intentional insult) and 506 (criminal intimidation).

Archana Singh, DSP said, "The girl has been kept at Asha Jyoti Kendra, a shelter for women victims of crime, as a routine procedure. The accused men are absconding and will be nabbed soon."

Bhupendra Baliyan, SHO of Tajganj, said, "We need to record the girl's statement under CrP section 164 in the court. We are collecting all the evidence from the neighbourhood and investigating the case in detail. Action will be taken accordingly."

# ATM dispenses extra cash in Goa town

An ATM of a bank in South Goa's Baina in part town of Vasco reportedly dispensed two to three times extra currency notes on Monday night.

However, bank officials later switched off the machine. The locals said that the ATM delivered two to three times extra money without deducting it from their accounts. As news spread in the vicinity, many gathered at the ATM and withdrew their money. Later one person contacted the police, and after their intervention the ATM was closed.

"I got to know from my friend that many people had gathered at this ATM, which was delivering extra cash. Then I contacted the police and they arrived on the spot and the bank officials were summoned at the site, who later closed the ATM," a local person told reporters.

SORROW AND TEARS ENGULF IN MORBI

The collapse of a cable bridge on the Machhu river in Gujarat's Morbi on Sunday evening left at least 141 dead - including a few children left orphaned, while some have lost their entire next generation. When the bodies of the victims reached villages and towns, it left behind families and people in tears and pain. Four-year-old Shivam of Rajkot, had gone to Morbi with his father Bhupat Parmar, mother Sangitaben and brother Viraj. Only Shivam only has returned alive, and other three's dead bodies were brought back, said his grandfather Chagan Parmar. In Morbi town's graveyard, diggers have been busy since Sunday night as the town has lost 36 members of the community including children. It takes five hours to dig one grave. With the recovery of more bodies, the death toll increased to 141. The Morbi government hospital has released a list of 99 deceased, but has not mentioned the age of the victims. Congress on Monday demanded an inquiry headed by a retired High Court or Supreme Court judge into the Morbi bridge collapse incident. The Supreme Court on Tuesday agreed to hear a plea on November 14 seeking the constitution of a judicial commission to investigate the bridge collapse. The plea said the incident showed the negligence and utter failure of the government authorities. It further added that in the past decade various incidents have taken place in the country due to the mismanagement, lapse in duty, and negligent maintenance activities. BJP's senior leader and former Deputy Chief Minister Nitin Patel has raised questions over the renovation contract given to Oreva group's Ajanta Manufacturing Company Ltd. Patel has, however, given a clean chit to the state government and claimed that the government has no role to play in giving the renovation contract to the company.

# US PRIORITISES TIES WITH INDIA

US President Joe Biden's administration unveiled the US National Defence Strategy 2022 on October 27. It lists plans to boost its defence ties with India to deter Chinese aggression in the region. The latest Defence Strategy states that China presents the most consequential and systemic challenge, while Russia poses acute threats to vital US national interests abroad and to the homeland. "The world is changing. We're at a significant inflection point in world history. And our country and the world, the US has always been able to chart the future in times of great change. We've been able to constantly renew ourselves. And time and again, we've proven there's not a single thing we cannot do as a nation when we do it together, and I mean that - not a single solitary thing," President Biden stated in the introductory note to the strategy. Defence Secretary Lloyd Austin highlighted the different challenges posed by China and Russia as he unveiled the strategy. According to him the dangers are both conventional -- Moscow's aggression toward its neighbours and Beijing's efforts to gain control of Taiwan -- and nuclear, with Russia possessing an extensive arsenal and China's stocks of atomic weapons growing fast. The strategy likewise places the primary emphasis on China. It further asserts that Beijing is seeking to "refashion the Indo-Pacific region and the international system to suit its interests and authoritarian preferences", describing this dynamic as "the most comprehensive and serious challenge to US national security". The strategy says Chinese rhetoric about and "coercive activity" towards Taiwan, which Beijing has vowed to take control of, by force if necessary, is a destabilising factor that risks miscalculation and threatens peace in the area. As for Russia, it says the "acute threat" posed by Moscow has been most recently demonstrated by its invasion of Ukraine. Though the strategy tries to portray the US ties in the Indo-Pacific as the most important one, yet India as a whole is mentioned in the strategy only five times and that too in the context of the Indo-Pacific, and there too it refers to China's campaigns to establish control over the East China Sea, Taiwan Strait, South China Sea, and disputed land borders such as with India. It proclaims to promote a free and open



Indo-Pacific, which could only be achieved if the US builds collective capacity with other countries, like India. It further asserts that no region will be of more significance to the world and to everyday Americans than the Indo-Pacific, yet it fails to demonstrate India's importance to achieve this goal as a partner. The document lists out the US Vision, Washington's role in the global arena, and an overview of its strategic approach to different regional issues. Focussing on Middle East, the strategy talks about tweaking its policy in the Middle East and North Africa by eschewing grand designs in favour of more practical steps that can advance US interests and help regional partners lay the foundation for greater stability, prosperity, and opportunity for the people of the Middle East and for the American people. The strategy sets forth a new framework for US policy in the region based on America's unparalleled comparative advantage in building partnerships, coalitions, and alliances to strengthen deterrence, while using diplomacy to de-escalate tensions, reduce risks of new conflicts, and set a long-term foundation for

stability. However, it clearly states that the United States will not allow foreign or regional powers to jeopardise freedom of navigation through the Middle East's waterways, including the Strait of Hormuz and the Bab al Mandab, nor tolerate efforts by any country to dominate another, or the region, through military build-ups, incursions, or threats. But if we scrutinise the strategy in a little more detail then we realise the emerging contradictions present in the strategy. When the strategy declares the U.S. commitment to support countries "that subscribe to the rules-based international order", will it include those OPEC countries which recently snubbed the U.S. demands for increased oil production? When it talks about "military build-ups" then does it really mean that the US will halt its longstanding efforts to advance its partners' "military build-ups" in the face of the threat from Iran? Further how could the US achieve the Israeli "dominance" of the Hamas and Hezbollah?

Further the strategy lays stress on U.S. diplomacy to reduce tensions "wherever possible", will it translate into normalising ties with Syrian President Bashar al-Assad, or meeting with Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah? All this double talk on various regional and global issues and inherent contradictions of the strategy leads one to surmise that it is more of a document to placate the American public and not aimed at really achieving or changing substantially the US policies on these issues. Overall the National Security Strategy 2022 comes out as a bit of disappointment though perhaps packaged coherently for the first time. (Asad Mirza is a political commentator based in New Delhi. # NEW VARIANTS DRIVE UP COVID CASES IN US: CDC

Covid-19 cases caused by new variants are growing fast in the US, according to data released by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). According to the latest CDC data published on Monday, two new variants, BQ.1 and BQ.1.1, have been growing especially fast, reports Xinhua news agency. At the beginning of October, each one accounted for about 1 per cent of new infections in the US, but they have been roughly doubling in prevalence each week, the health body said. The data further revealed that BQ.1 led to about 14 per cent of new infections in the country in the week ending October 29, while BQ.1.1 caused 13.1 per cent of the fresh cases. Together, the two variants accounted for more than one in four new infections nationwide, CDC data showed. BA.5, which has dominated



Covid-19 infections in the US since July, now accounted for 49.6 per cent of new cases in the country. A host of new sublineages -- offshoots of BA.2, BA.4 and BA.5 -- are now responsible for the majority of new cases. These variants are slightly different from each other, but they all carry some of the same key mutations that help them skirt immunity from vaccines and past infections. This makes them more likely to lead to breakthrough infections and reinfections, according to experts. "BQ is actually a BA.5 variant," Dr.

Andrew Pekosz, a virologist at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, recently told Health. "Here in the US, all the variants that are circling -- BQ.1.1, I guess, is the biggest or the most talked about one now -- they're all derived from either the BA.5 or the BA.4 variants. They've picked up a few mutations that help them evade some of the infection or vaccine-induced immunity. Another variant, XBB, is also a variant of Omicron and has been dubbed the "nightmare variant" in Singapore. It is extremely immune evasive and has also shown that it might be immune to current vaccines. The World Health Organization (WHO) SARS-CoV-2 virus evolution advisory group said last week that XBB and BQ.1 do not currently diverge sufficiently from each other or from other Omicron lineages that have extra immune escape mutations to warrant a variant of concern designation or a new label.

# N.KOREA WARNS OF 'MORE POWERFUL' ACTIONS AGAINST S.KOREA-US AIR DRILLS

North Korea on Tuesday warned that it could stage "more powerful follow-up measures" if the US continues "military provocations", citing its large-scale combined air exercise with South Korea. A spokesman at the North's Foreign Ministry denounced the ongoing combined air drills by the allies, called Vigilant Storm, as "ceaseless and reckless" military provocations, reports Yonhap News Agency. The exercise is "a war drill for aggression mainly aimed at striking the strategic targets of the DPRK in case of contingency in the Korean Peninsula", the spokesman said in a statement carried by the North's official Korean Central News Agency (KCNA). DPRK is the acronym of North Korea's official name, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. The allies on Monday kicked off their first massive joint air drills in nearly five years, with more than 240



aircraft, including stealth jets, mobilised, over the skies of the peninsula amid growing speculation that Pyongyang may conduct a nuclear test soon. The exercise is to run through Friday. The North's official warned that Pyongyang is "ready to take all necessary measures for defending its sovereignty, people's security and territorial integrity from outside military threats". "If the US continuously persists in the grave military provocations, the DPRK will take into account more powerful follow-up measures," the spokesman said. North Korea has long denounced joint military drills between Seoul and Washington as a rehearsal for invasion, calling on Washington to end its "hostile" policy.

# Iran sanctions 10 US officials, 4 institutions for 'inciting violence, interference'

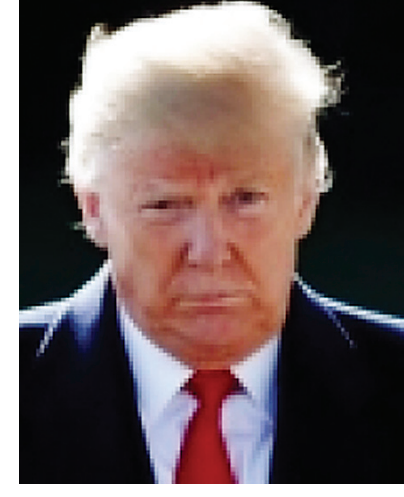

Iranian Foreign Ministry has announced that Tehran has imposed sanctions against 10 US individuals and four institutions for violating human rights, interfering in Iran's internal affairs, and inciting violence and riots in Iran. In a statement published on its website, the Foreign Ministry on Monday said the sanctions have been imposed based on a law adopted by the Iranian authorities to counter US human rights violations as well as its "adventurist and terrorist moves in the region". The US individuals on the list include Commander of the US Central Command



(CENTCOM) Michael Kurilla, CENTCOM's Deputy Commander Gregory Guillot, US Deputy Secretary of the Treasury Wally Adeyemo, and others. The list of the sanctioned institutions comprises an advocacy organisation United Against Nuclear Iran, the Central Intelligence Agency, the Ninth Air Force, and the National Guard of the US, Xinhua news agency reported.

# Criminal trial against Trump Organisation on tax fraud starts in New York

The jury in the criminal trial against the Trump Organisation started to hear opening statements on a 15-year tax fraud scheme from the plaintiff and the defendant in the Supreme Court of the northeastern US state of New York. The Trump Corporation and Trump Payroll Corp., two entities under the Trump Organisation, offered \$1.76 million of perks to Allen H. Weisselberg, former Chief Financial Officer of the Trump Organisation, without paying taxes, according to the Manhattan District Attorney's Office. While prosecutors tried to convict the Trump Organisation on its conspiracy role in the case, lawyers from the Trump Organisation said that Weisselberg was the man to be blamed but not his then



employer, the Trump Organisation. The trial is expected to last over a

month and the Trump Organisation could be penalised if it's found guilty, Xinhua news agency reported. The former Chief Financial Officer of Trump Organisation received a rent-free apartment, expensive cars, private school tuition for his grandchildren and new furniture from 2005 to 2018 while avoiding paying taxes, said an earlier statement from the Manhattan District Attorney's Office. In August, Weisselberg himself pleaded guilty to all 15 charges in the tax fraud and agreed to testify in the trial against the Trump Organisation. He would receive a sentence of five months in jail and five years' probation if he testifies truthfully in the trial against the Trump Organisation. Former US President Donald J. Trump was not indicted in the trial, and he is not expected to testify.

# Death toll in Seoul halloween stampede reaches 156

One more fatality was confirmed from the Halloween stampede in Seoul's Itaewon district, raising the death toll from the tragedy to 156, officials said on Tuesday. A 20-year-old Korean woman was pronounced dead on Tuesday morning while under treatment in serious condition, according to the Central Disaster and Safety Countermeasures Headquarters. A total of 29 people are still in serious condition, while 122 others had sustained minor injuries, Yonhap News Agency quoted the officials as saying. Of those killed, 101 were female, and victims in their 20s numbered 104, followed by 31 victims in



their 30s. There were also 26 foreign victims including five from Iran, four each from China and Russia, two from the US, two from Japan, and one each from France, Australia, Norway, Austria, Vietnam, Thailand, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, and Sri Lanka. The tragedy took place on Saturday night when a massive crowd of Halloween partygoers packed a narrow 3.2-metre-wide alley in Seoul's entertainment district of Itaewon.





# MADHYA PRADESH CELEBRATES 67TH FOUNDATION DAY

A week-long celebration has been organised by the state government to mark the occasion of 67th foundation day of Madhya Pradesh, which came into existence on November 1, 1956.

Although the history of the Madhya Pradesh legislature can be traced back to 1913 when the Central Provinces Legislative Council was formed, the present-day Madhya Pradesh came into existence on 1 November 1956 following the reorganisation of states. It was created by merging the erstwhile four states - Mahakaulash, Madhya Bharat, Vindhya Pradesh and Bhopal.

Initially, the strength of the Madhya Pradesh's Vidhan Sabha was 288, which was later enhanced to 321, including one nominated member, which later in 2000 (after separation of

Chhattisgarh) reduced to 230 seats. Besides 230 members directly elected by the people of the state, there used to be a nominated member, however, the system of nominated members was abolished in 2003.

"Till 2003, the strength of Madhya Pradesh Assembly was 231 as besides 230 elected members, there used to be a

nominated member also in the parliamentary system. However, the process of nominating a member, which used to be the representative of the government, was stopped," said state Assembly speaker Girish Gautam. Since the formation of Madhya Pradesh, the state has been ruled by 18 Chief Ministers, some of them twice,

Shivraj Singh Chouhan is the longest serving Chief Minister. Out of over 17 years, the BJP ruled after 2003, the current Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan held the post for over 15 years.

The Congress won the last elections in 2018. However, it collapsed within 18 months after Jyotiraditya Scindia along with 20 other MLAs joined the BJP and saffron party romped back in power in 2020.

Speaker Girish Gautam further said that the separation of the state had become the need of hour as being a huge state, the people in the remote areas were deprived of government schemes. "The demand for formation of Chhattisgarh was much before 2000, and it was a good decision of the Centre. Because of it, both the states have witnessed tremendous growth since then," he added.

## 4-yr-old girl raped in Khandwa; accused held

In a shocking incident, a four-year-old girl was allegedly raped and abandoned in sugarcane field in Madhya Pradesh's Khandwa district, the police said on Tuesday. It was the fourth incident of rape reported in the past one week in the state.

According to the police, the incident was reported on Monday and the victim is recuperating at a government hospital. A 25-year-old youth has been arrested in connection with the case.

The incident came to light after the girl was reported missing from her relative's house in Jaswadi village on Monday morning.

After receiving a missing complaint, the local police launched a search operation during which they found the child lying unconscious in a sugarcane field.

She was rushed to a nearby hospital from where she was referred to another hospital in Indore, said Superintendent of Police (SP), Vivek Singh.

The police had initially registered a case under Section 363 (kidnapping) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC). Later, they added Section 376 (rape) and relevant provisions of the Protection of

Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, Singh said. The police said that during interrogation, the accused youth admitted to have taken the girl to a sugarcane field where he raped her. The man had allegedly approached the victim's family on Sunday night to borrow a cot, the officer said.

**CM Chouhan has said that the mischievous elements who harm the honor of daughters should be punished severely. Criminals involved in such incidents do not deserve pardon. Such elements should not be spared at all. CM today directed the Commissioner Indore and IG Indore at Indore airport to take strict action against the culprits of the incident with a girl child in Khandwa. 3. On October 19, a 17-year-old girl was raped and strangled to death in Bhind district.
4. On Monday, a woman was found in an unconscious state on the roadside in a posh area in Bhopal. In her statement to the police, the woman alleged that while she was on her way to her home, two men tried to overpower her. She resisted and fought against them during which she lost consciousness.

## 4.3-magnitude earthquake hits Madhya Pradesh

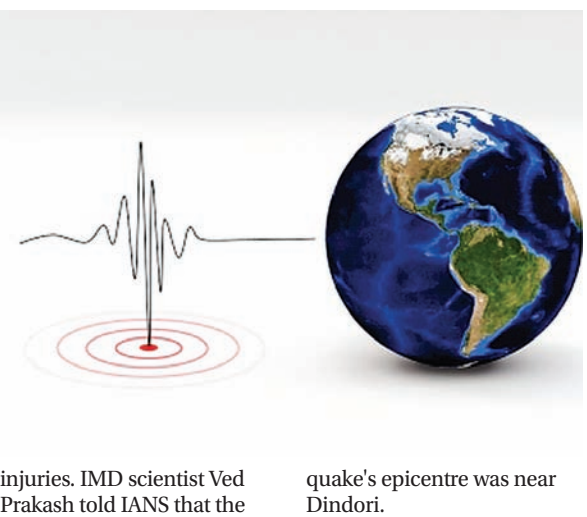

A special Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) court in Madhya Pradesh's Indore on Monday sentenced a man to seven years of imprisonment and imposed a fine of Rs 10,000 in a case related to Vyapam scam.

The court of additional sessions judge (CBI) Sanjay Kumar Gupta convicted solver Vinay Kumar Mehta, a resident of Bihar, under sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC for fraud and forgery of documents and sections

3(D)(1)(2)/4 of MPRE Act. Mehta appeared for Shishupal Yadav in the pre-medical test (PMT)-2004 examination organised by Vyapam, which is now known as MP Employees Selection Board (MPESB), the prosecution said.

Khandwa police arrested Mehta along with Yadav and middleman Ajit Singh in relation to the crime. The accused were tried in Khandwa court, wherein in 2015, court acquitted middleman Ajit Singh and sentenced Shishupal Yadav. Mehta was on bail and was

later absconding. Later in 2015, the case was transferred to the CBI and Mehta was arrested.

"The court found Vinay Kumar Mehta guilty and sentenced him to maximum imprisonment of seven years along with a fine of Rs 10,000. He is sentenced to imprisonment for different periods under different sections of the IPC," said special prosecutor Ranjan Sharma.

At least 17 witnesses were examined before the court along with other evidence in the special court during trial, Sharma added.

## People swarm dam site in Panna looking for diamonds

Hundreds of people, including those from neighbouring Uttar Pradesh, have been digging the soil near an under-construction dam at Vishramganj in Panna district after videos and messages went viral on social media claiming a contractor found diamond gravel there.

The construction of the dam over an eight-kilometre area over the Runjh river to irrigate 12,000-hectare farmland started this year. Officials said the land belongs to the water resources department and anybody can dig out a pit up to 2.5 feet.

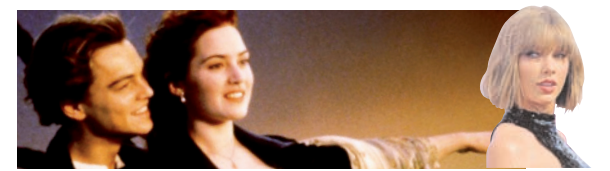
HT in August last year reported that 77.72-carat diamond was found in Panna since January 2021, the lowest over the last five years. The resumption of mining at the National Mineral Development Corporation (NMDC)'s mine at Majhganwa in Panna was expected to boost the diamond business. The



NMDC mine was closed after 60 years as its environmental clearance ended on December 31, 2020. There are shallow mines in the region that are leased out. The state mining department and NMDC organise auctions of diamonds in Panna. Police said that thousands of people have come with digging equipment and created law and order problems, prompting them to act. Sub-divisional police officer Kalyani

Verkade said they have seized over 100 motorcycles in a fortnight. "Everyday police visit the area to check the law and order situation but people are not ready to give up. Now, they are coming by foot." Rajkumar Banda, a resident of Uttar Pradesh's Banda, said he came to know a labourer found diamond worth crores. "The land is going to be submerged and we are just trying our luck before the construction of the dam." Residents demanded action against outsiders. "Vishramganj is my native village. We saved nature for years but now the outsiders are exploiting it. They are uprooting trees...The administration should take action against them and make arrangements to stop them," said Vishu Gond, a local resident. Panna diamond officer Ravi Patel said the land has been allotted to the water resources department for the construction of the dam and they cannot take any action until a complaint is received. "We are discussing the matter with the collector.

**TAYLOR SWIFT IS FIRST ARTIST WITH ENTIRE TOP 10 ON BILLBOARD HOT 100**

Singer Taylor Swift has made history as she scored 10 out of 10 to become the first artist in history to claim the Top 10 slots on the Billboard Hot 100 chart in the US.

Billboard reported on Monday that Swift has surpassed Drake, who had held the previous record with nine of the Top 10 songs for a week in September 2021.

"10 out of 10 of the Hot 100??? On my 10th album??? I AM IN SHAMBLES," the 32-year-old pop star tweeted. The new album came out on 21 October with both a 13-track standard release and a deluxe version with seven bonus tracks. It has had one of the biggest album launches in nearly seven years.

According to Billboard Swift, now ties with Barbra Streisand for the female artist with the most No 1 albums.

The No 1 spot on the Billboard chart is given to 'Anti-Hero'. The other Top 10 songs include 'Lavender Haze', 'Maroon', 'Snow on the Beach', 'Midnight Rain', 'Bejeweled' and 'Question ...?'

Swift has set a number of new records with Midnights: it had the biggest first week of sales of any album this year, almost doubling the numbers of the previous title-holder, Harry's House, the third solo album by Harry Styles. Midnights also had the highest first-week streams of the year: 72.5m, again beating Styles' figures of 53.9m.

Swift has also overtaken Madonna to set a new all-time UK chart record for the fastest succession of nine UK No 1 albums of any female artist - although Madonna still has the record for the most UK No 1 albums of any solo female artist, with 12 overall. Swift is now second in that list, pushing Kylie Minogue into third place.

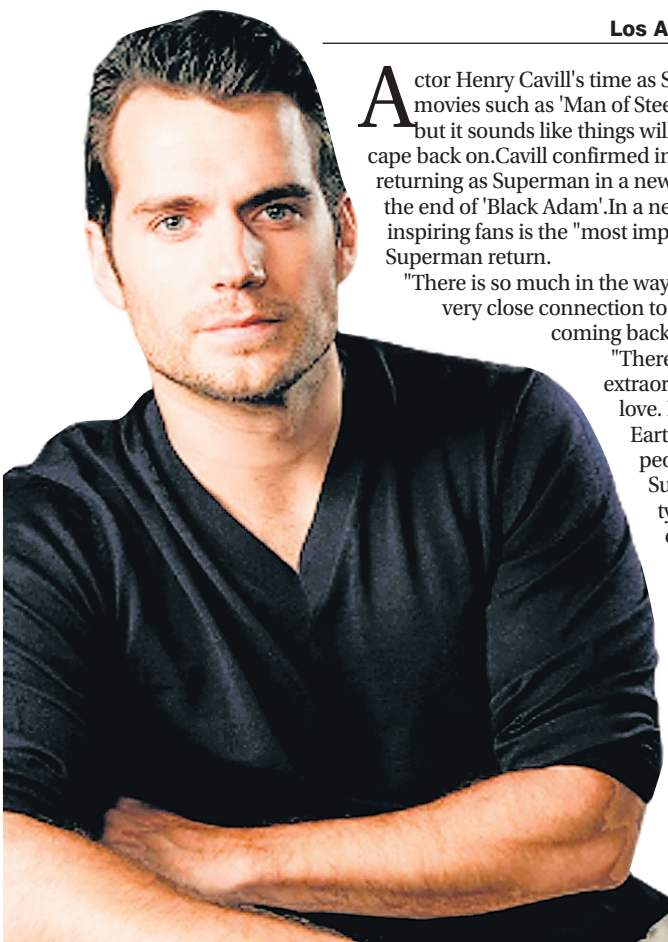
Lloyd married Wilde in 1884 and the pair had two sons. However, she moved to Switzerland with the children after the writer received a two-year prison sentence for homosexuality.

That would be my goal." During a live recording of the "Happy Sad Confused" podcast last week, Cavill said there is "a bright future ahead for the character" and added, "I'm so excited to tell a story with an enormously joyful Superman." Fans interpreted Cavill's "enormously joyful" tease as a hint that whenever Superman does return to the big screen, he will have a different look and feel compared to Cavill's last Zack Snyder-directed Superman outings.

# KIT CONNOR SAYS HE'S BEEN 'FORCED' TO COME OUT' AS BISEXUAL

Connor's tweet comes five months after he confronted the allegations online. "Twitter is so funny man," he tweeted on May 2. "Apparently some people on here know my sexuality better than I do." Later that month, 'His Dark Materials' alum called the queer baiting accusations "mean" and defended his choice to keep his sexuality private. "I'm perfectly confident and comfortable in my sexuality, but... I'm not too big on labels and things like that," he shared on the Reign with Josh Smith podcast. "I don't feel like I need to label myself, especially not publicly."

Connor also said that it was "strange" for people to make speculations about him and his Heartstopper co-star Joe Locke, who also plays a queer character. "To start speculating about our sexualities and pressuring us to come out when maybe we're not ready," he continued, "I feel like that's very interesting, slightly problematic assumption to make."

(28) had given Afghanistan a strong start by putting on 42 for the opening wicket, until Hasaranga's timely intervention following the batting Powerplay, according to ICC. Hasaranga finished with match-winning figures of 3/13 and even chipped in with an excellent catch in the outfield to help dismiss the dangerous Najibullah Zadran (18). The Afghanistan veteran tried in vain to recover safely but was caught short. Afghanistan, meanwhile, are out of contention for a semifinal spot and meet Australia on Friday.

That net run rate is almost as good as a point for the Black Caps, meaning it is very much an advantage for them in the qualification race. The Kiwis would need to lose to Ireland in their final match at Adelaide Oval and by a significant margin to give Australia and England the opportunity to deny them a top-two finish.

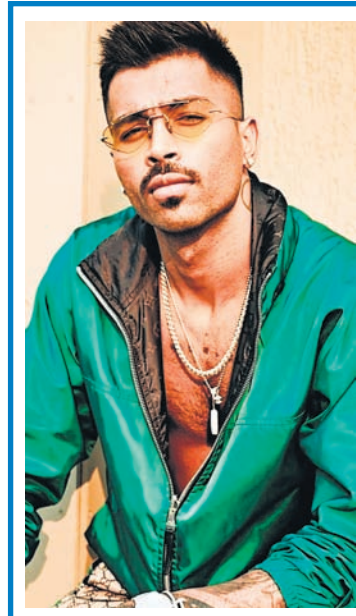
