El Nino may impact India adversely: Ex

■ El Nino is the warm phase of the El Nino's Southern Oscillation and is associated with a band of warm ocean water that develops in the central and east-central equatorial Pacific, including the area off the Pacific coast of South America. La Nina refers to the periodic cooling of ocean surface temperatures in the central and east-central equatorial Pacific. It has the capacity to alter direction as well as velocity of the trade winds, which trigger the winter season in India.

l Nino and La Nina are climate patterns in the Pacific Ocean that can affect weather worldwide. According to meteorologists, El Nino weather patterns this year may lead to deficit monsoon rainfall.

For the third month running, the US government weather agencies on Thursday reiterated the possibility of El Nino conditions developing in late summer this year, which could be an adverse signal for monsoon in India

According to meteorologists, the anomaly in temperature and rainfall is the result of alterations in the weather patterns. The intensity as well as freon the lower side this winter season. Climate experts said that anomalies of cool temperature in the Pacific waters are likely to dissolve that will further impact the Indian monsoon adversely.

Western disturbance is known to drive weather activities and bring winter to Northwest India and the adjoining areas of Central India. Although January saw a good number of active western disturbances, they could not have any impact on the weather across the Indo-Gangetic plains.

An IMD official said that the ongoing trend of above normal maximum temperature can be attributed to the country's deficit rainfall that has been recorded for four consecutive months. Winter rains have been largely evading

Northwest, Central, East and Northeast India.

The South Peninsula has been recording some rains on account of few low-pressure areas and depressions forming in the South Bay of Bengal, but their impact was confined to the southern parts only.

"La Nina is a climate pattern marked by colder-than-normal sea surface temperatures in the equatorial Pacific Ocean that tend to suppress global temperatures. However, global warming and changing climatic conditions tend to play a major role, which can be temporarily governed by these ENSO conditions but cannot completely outplay the effects of climate change," said G.P. Sharma, President, Meteorology and Climate Change, Skymet Weather.

3,038 LAB CONFIRMED H3N2 INFLUENZA CASES IN INDIA, TWO DEATHS

Seasonal influenza is an acute respiratory infection caused by influenza viruses which circulate in all parts of the world, and the cases are seen to increase during certain months globally. India every year witnesses two peaks of seasonal influenza: one from January to March and the other in the post monsoon season.

fter the outbreak of the seasonal H3N2 influenza across the country, two deaths have been reported from Karnataka and Haryana. So far, 3,038 laboratory confirmed H3N2 influenza cases have been reported from across the country.

"Young children and old persons with co-morbidities are the most vulnerable groups for seasonal influenza. So far, Karnataka and Harvana have confirmed one death each from H3N2 influenza", the health ministry said on Friday.

Such cases are expected to decline from March end. State surveillance icers are fully geared to mee public health challenge, the ministry

Further, the IDSP-IHIP data from health facilities indicate that during the month of January 2023, a total of 397,814 cases of Acute Respiratory Illness/Influenza Like Illness (ARI/ILI) were reported from the country that increased slightly to 436,523 during February, 2023. In the first 9 days of March 2023, this number stands at 133,412 cases

The corresponding data for admitted cases of severe acute respiratory illness is 7041 cases in January 2023, 6919 during February 2023 and 1866 during the first 9 days of March 2023.

As per the health ministry, a total of 955 H1N1 cases have been reported in February this year. The majority of the H1N1 cases have been reported from Tamil Nadu (545), Maharashtra (170), Gujarat (74), Kerala (42) and Punjab (28).



BENGAL ACCOUNTS FOR 38% OF ADENOVIRUS CASES IN COUNTRY

Kolkata: West Bengal accounts for 38 per cent of the swab samples that have been tested adenovirus-positive throughout the country, according to a recent survey conducted by Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR)-National Institute of Cholera and Enteric Diseases (NICED).

NICED sources said that in the survey, which was conducted on the 1,708 samples in the different viral research diagnostic laboratories throughout the country from January 1 to March 9, 650 samples were test-

ed adenovirus-positive. As per the finding, West Bengal accounts for 38 per cent of the 650 samples that have been tested positive, the highest among all Indian states. Tamil Nadu comes in the distant second position with 19 per cent,

Kerala at 13 per cent, Delhi at 11 per cent and Maharashtra at five per cent are in the third, fourth and fifth positions respectively.

The common symptoms of adenovirus are flu-like, cold, fever, breathing problems, sore throat, pneumonia and acute bronchitis. The children of twoyears of age and below are most vulnerable to being affected by the virus.

The virus can spread through skin contacts, by air through coughing and sneezing and through an infected person's stool. So far, there have not been any approved medicines or any specific treatment-line to treat the virus. MEASLES OUTBREAK IN J'KHAND: GOVT TO RUN CAMPAIGN TO VACCINATE 46 LAKH CHILDREN

Ranchi: Concerned over the increasing cases of measles in nine districts of the state, the Jharkhand government has decided to run a special measles-rubella campaign in these districts for five weeks from April 15.

According to a WHO report, the maximum measles patients have been reported in Maharashtra, Jharkhand, Gujarat and Haryana.

Under the campaign, 45,62,492 children in the age group of 9 months to 15 years will be administered the vaccine. The state's Additional Chief Secretary Arun Kumar Singh has directed the Deputy Commissioners, Civil Surgeons and officers of the nine districts to make the

campaign a success. The districts where the campaign will be carried out are Dumka, Pakur, Sahibganj, Godda, Jamtara, Deoghar, Dhanbad, Koderma and Giridih.

Children who have been vaccinated before will be re-vaccinated.

Dr Jitendra Kumar of CCL Hospital, Gandhinagar, explained that measles is an infectious disease spread through a virus and has the most effect on children. He added that symptoms include body rash, fever, runny nose, red eyes and cough. Apart from coming in direct contact with an infected person, it spreads through the air.

MAHARASHTRA SHOCKER

WOMAN RAPED, STARVED, MENSTRUAL BLOOD SOLD AT RS 50K FOR BLACK MAGIC RITUALS

n another diabolical incident, a 27-year-old married woman from Maharashtra, was brutally raped, starved and her menstrual blood was sold for Rs 50,000 for some witchcraft rituals, officials said here on Friday.

Shiv Sena (UBT) MLC Manisha Kayande raised the issue in the Maharashtra Legislative Council and demanded strict punishment for the perpetrators of the crime, which ironically came to light on the eve of International Women's Day on Tuesday.

She said that following the intervention of the woman's maternal family, the Vishrantwadi police station in Pune has lodged an FIR against even accused persons, including the victim's husband and his parents.The woman added that since her love marriage around 2019, her husband and in-laws had been torgrounds though the exact reasons - whether dowry demands or others - were not available. She said that recently her

in-laws had tied her up during her monthly periods, collected her menstrual blood using cotton swabs and sold it for Rs 50,000 to some person who indulges in practicing witchcraft.

The Pune police have booked all the accused under the stringent Maharashtra Black Magic Act and other laws and further probe is on.

BJP's Pune Guardian Minister Chandrakant Patil expressed shock over the incident and directed the police to invoke the strictest laws against all the accused persons. This is the second such shocker emanating from Pune in the past two months. In January, a 28vear-old woman forcibly made to undergo bizarre rituals in a crematorium.The victim had informed the Sinhgad Police that she was made to take bath in the crematorium and then compelled to drink a liquid laced with powdered human bones and ashes as part of certain rites allegedly intended to enable her conception.

The Sinhgad police had swooped in to nab the woman's husband, his parents, his brother and three others for the heinous crime, while the President of Maharashtra State Commission for Women, Rupali Chakankar, had sought a probe report from the police.

K'TAKA HIGH COURT CANCELS BOARD EXAMS FOR 5TH, 8TH STANDARDS

Bengaluru: The Karnataka High Court on Friday cancelled the board examinations for the fifth and eighth standards from this academic year. The ministry of education was all set to hold the board exams from this academic year.

The bench headed by Justice Pradeep Singh Yerur opined that as per rules, the board exams for fifth and eighth classes could be held from the next year.

The petition was submitted before a single bench seeking a stay on the order. The appeal was filed before the division bench later.

The division bench headed by Chief Justice P.B. Varale and Justice Ashok S. Kinagi has also opined against conducting public exams. The single bench order has been given following the direction of the division

The board exams for the fifth and eighth standards had faced stiff resistance. Parents had questioned the necessity of board exams for these classes, when the CBSE does not hold exams for them. It was alleged that the education department is encouraging the tuition mafia.

Sisodia was part of money laundering nexus: ED

Delhi court on Friday sent Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader and former deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia to Enforcement Directorate (ED)'s custody till March 17 in connection with the now-scrapped excise policy After the Central Bureau of

Investigation (CBI) on February 26 arrested him, the ED, on Thursday also arrested Sisodia in the same case.

Earlier in the day, the court deferred hearing in Sisodia's bail application for March 21, in the same case being probed by the CBI.

Special CBI Judge M.K. Nagpal of the Rouse Avenue Courts has ordered Sisodia to be produced before court on March 17 at 2 p.m.

During the hearing, the ED sought his 10-day custody saying that they need to unearth the modus operandi, the entire scam and confront Sisodia with some other people.

ED's counsel Zoheb Hossain, while claiming that Sisodia was part of the "money laundering nexus" said that the movement of tainted money through



hawala channels was also being probed. Hossain submitted that the policy was formulated to ensure that certain private entities get huge benefits and that one of the biggest cartels was made to operate 30 per cent of liquor business in Delhi.

Referring to the meetings between restaurants association and Sisodia, the ED alleged that relaxations were afforded to the restaurants in excise policy like reducing the legal age of drinking and other things.

The central agency argued that Sisodia had destroyed the evidence.

VIDEO SURFACES SHOWING JAPANESE WOMAN GROPED, HARASSED ON HOLI

video has gone viral on social media showing a Japanese woman being groped and harassed by a group of youth, presumably in Delhi's

Paharganj area, on Holi.

In the video, the youth could be seen grabbing the woman and smearing colours on her amid chants of 'Holi Hai'. A boy could also be seen smashing an egg on her head, even as the woman shouted 'bye bye' just to escape from the spot.

A senior police officer said that a tweet has come to their notice which contains a video of Holi wherein few people are seen applying colour on a foreign national.

"The woman seems to be uncomfortable with the actions of the youth. The video attached with the said



tweet has been posted on several digital platforms. We have taken cognisance of the video. The video is being analysed to ascertain the requisite details," the officer "Prima-facie, on the basis

of the landmarks seen in the video, it seems that it pertains to Paharganj. However,

it is being verified whether any such incident took place in that area or the video is an old one," the officer added.

However, no complaint or call relating to any kind of misbehaviour with any foreigner has been received at the Paharganj police station, he said.

CENTRE **ANNOUNCES 10% RESERVATION FOR EX-AGNIVEERS IN BSF RECRUITMENT**

New Delhi: The Centre has announced 10 per cent reservation for ex-Agniveers in vacancies within the Border Security Force (BSF). For this, the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has amended the Border Security Force, General Duty Cadre (Non-Gazetted) Recruitment Rules, 2015, which has come into effect from Thursday. The notification issued by the MHA on March 6, added that the upper age limit will be relaxed by five years for the candidates of the first batch of ex-Agniveers in the recruitment of constables. It added that the subsequent batch will get age relaxation up to three years. As per the notification, ex-Agniveers will also be exempted from the Physical Efficiency Test.

ONLY BJP CAN PROVIDE GOOD GOVERNANCE IN TN: NA

IP National President J.P. Nadda on Friday said that only the BJP can give good governance in Tamil Nadu and added that the party will strengthen its position in the state.

He was speaking at a public function in Krishnagiri after inaugurating the new party office. Following this, he inaugurated nine other party district committee offices virtually.

The BJP National President added that Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin has appointed his son Udayanidhi Stalin as a minister and said that Udaynidhi may become the next Tamil Nadu Chief

Comparing Tamil Nadu with states like Punjab, Jammu and Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal, Odisha, Telangana, Maharashtra, Nadda said that succession politics was becoming the norm in Tamil Nadu as well.

The BJP and AIADMK, which are allies in the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) in Tamil Nadu, are not on good terms after several BJP leaders in the state quit the party and joined the AIADMK. There were war of words between the



Tamil Nadu BJP president, K. Annamalai and the AIADMK leadership, including former Minister and party's organising secretary, D. Jayakumar. Tamil Nadu BJP IT Cell President, C.T.R. Nirmal Kumar and State BJP IT Cell Secretary, Dilip Kannan, and several other district-wise leaders had resigned from the saffron party and joined the AIADMK.

They have openly blamed Annamalai's style of functioning for their exit from the saffron party.

The State BJP President had hit out at the AIADMK and the AIADMK interim general secretary and former Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami(EPS).

The BJP national leadership is expecting a few seats from Tamil Nadu in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections and it can get these seats only through piggyriding on the AIADMK.BJP has a potent ally in Tamil Nadu with AIADMK aligning with it during the last Assembly elections, and the national leadership does not want to break the alliance it has with the powerful Dravidian party.

The BJP national leadership is also unhappy with Annamalai acting against the AIADMK as in 2024 Lok sabha elections, BJP wants to improve its position in the state. However, after Annamalai lashing out against the state AIADMK leadership, the BJP national leadership is afraid of the political alliance going awry which the saffron party cannot afford to.

Sources in the BJP said that Nadda will likely conduct a meeting with EPS to iron out the differences between the two parties and to gain political-

Land for job scam: ED conducts raids at Tejashwi Yadav's Delhi residence

he Enforcement Directorate (ED) on Friday conducted raids at more than 15 places including RJD leader and Bihar Deputy Chief Minister Tejashwi Yadav's residence in the national capital, in connection with the land for job scam issue.

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has recently grilled former Bihar Chief Minister Rabri Devi and Lalu Prasad, the former Railway Minister on the same matter.

The ED has also conducted raids in Bihar in the IRCTC scam. The ED's case is on the basis of CBI's FIR.

The CBI in its case has alleged that during the investigation, it was found that the accused, in conspiracy with the then GM Central Railways and CPO, Central Railways engaged some persons as substitutes in lieu of land either in



their name or in the name of close relatives of Lalu's family.

Prasad, the then Union railway minister, his wife Rabri Devi, two daughters and 15 others, including unknown public servants and private persons.

"During the period 2004-2009 Yadav obtained pecuniary advantages in the form of transfer of landed property in the name of his family members in lieu of appointment of substitutes in Group 'D' Post in different zones of Railways, the official said.

Gurugram: Ramesh Prasad Agarwal, the father of Ritesh Agarwal, Founder and Group CEO of OYO, died on Friday after falling from a 20th floor balcony of a highrise in Gurugram.

According to the police, at around 1 p.m. they received information from the DLF security that a person has fallen from the 20th floor of Tower of The Crest Society in Sector 54, who has been taken to the Paras Hospital, Virender Vii. DCP (East), said in a statement that Agarwal was declared brought dead at the hospital, adding that the body has been handed over to the family after conducting a post-mortem. "The body had multiple fractures. It appears that the victim died after falling from the high-rise," said Sudhir Chaudhary, who conducted the autopsy. Preliminary investigation suggests that it appears to be a case of accidental death, but the actual cause will be known after a detailed investigation, Vij

Arms supplier lands in police net in Delhi

arrested a 35-year-old man involved in supplying illegal weapons to gangsters in Delhi, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh, an official said, adding that eight high-quality semi-automatic pistols, seven single shot pistols and eight bullets have been recovered from his possession. The accused has been identified as Daud, a resident of Dewas, Madhya Pradesh.

The official said that the weapon supplying nexus was being run by notorious arms supplier Malkhan Singh, who is running a pan-India network and is linked to gangsters operating across India. Daud was one of the key members of this nexus.

"It came to our notice that Daud was supplying illegal firearms and ammunition to local gangs in Delhi-NCR. On the inputs were received that Daud would deliver a large cache of firearms and ammunition to Rakesh, a member of the Nandu-Jyoti gang," said Ingit Pratap Singh, the Deputy Commissioner of Police (Special Cell).

A trap was laid by the police which led to Daud's arrest. On questioning, Daud revealed that three-four years back, when he was in jail in a case of scuffle, he came in contact with Malkhan, who gave him the offer to join his gang of arms trafficking. "Daud had procured illegal firearms on five to six occasions from Malkhan and supplied them to his associates in Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Delhi-NCR. He used to procure one semi-automatic pistol from Malkhan for Rs 10,000 to Rs 12,000 and one single shot pistol for Rs 3,500," the DCP said.

Coimbatore car blast: Five accused sent to NIA custody till March 16

he National Investigation Agency (NIA), which is probing the Coimbatore car blast, has got the custody of five accused for further question-An NIA court in Chennai

sent the accused --Mohammed Azharudhhin(23), Feroze Khan (29), Firoz Ismail (27), Umar Faruq (39) and Mohammed Nawaz Ismail (25) -- to NIA custody till March 16.

The five accused, according to sources in the NIA, will be taken to various places for getting further information on whether there are other people behind the crime.

On October 23, 2022, Islamic State suspect Jameesha Mubin was charred to death in a car blast in Coimbatore. The Islamic State of Khorasan Province had in a recent issue of its propaganda magazine, Voice of Khurasan stated that it had a role in the Coimbatore car blasts of October 23, 2022,



and the pressure cooker blast in an autorickshaw on November 19, 2022. A paragraph in the Voice of

Khurasan in an article titled, 'A message to the inhabitants in the land occupied by cow and mice worshipping filths' said, "Know that the spark of war has already been lit. Do you not consider our attacks in Coimbatore (Tamil Nadu) and Karnataka (Bangalore), where our brothers who took revenge for the honour of our religion and terrorized kufar and its followers? Thus we promise that this is just the beginning.

Even as the write-up has mentioned the second place as Bangalore in Karnataka, the central agencies infer that Mangaluru was misquoted as Bangalore.

The article has also mentioned that Kashmir and the Gujarat riots and Babri Masjid demolition have not been forgotten.

The NIA will be conducting a thorough interrogation of those in custody and will try to ascertain whether those in custody have any connection with the article that has come out in Voice of

In Mandsaur and Neemuch in western Madhya Pradesh, the extent of damage was around 20-30 per cent. In Bhopal, Ujjain, Ratlam and Raisen, the damage could range between 15 and 20 per cent while it could be around 10-15 per cent in Shajapur, Sehore, Narmadapuram, Agar-Malwa, Barwani and Guna.

MP High Court dismisses PIL seeking directions to authorities against farmers of Tikamgarh

he Madhya Pradesh High Court Litigation (PIL) that was seeking direction to the respondent authority for stopping the enquiry that was initiated against the petitioner as well as the farmers belonging to Tehsil-Palera, District -Tikamgarh. The PIL has been filed by

one Mahadev Singh. The entire case of the petitioner is that respondents may initiate proceedings and may dispossess the petitioner from the land in question and also initiate an enquiry against him for various offences. Therefore, the instant prayer to direct them to stop the enquiry.

On hearing learned counsels, the Division Bench of Chief Justice Ravi Malimath and Justice Vishal Mishra did not find any ground to interfere in this petition. The entire plea of the petitioner is based on apprehension. Even assuming an enquiry is in progress, the authorities will have to conduct the enquiry in



accordance with law. If the petitioner is required for any purpose, the respondents are always entitled to question him or to proceed in accordance with law. There cannot be a writ of mandamus to

direct them not to initiate or to stop an enquiry. The same is impermissible, the Bench observed. Hence, the High Court found no good ground to entertain this in a Public Interest Litigation.

Casual leaves increase for female govt employees

Firm cuts 257 more trees than needed for Rs 57 crore Indore flyover

Bai, a labourer, said. MP Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan had laid the foundation stone of the flyover in November last year and work is scheduled to be completed in 18 months, an IDA official informed.

NORTH-SOUTH IS ONE INDUSTRY; THE MEDIA IS NOT ONE!



th the super success of a few South Indian films throughout the Hindi-speaking areas, the South is extending its reach and trying to involve the media from the North, which limited its scope to covering only Hindi films.

They want to keep the people of Hindispeaking regions aware of South Indian films all the way while a film is in production and not later when it is a hit in the South and plans are afoot to dub it and take it to the audience in the rest of the country.

Hindi filmmakers who depend heavily on the South for content, buying the Hindi remake rights of many South hits, have not always been welcoming of the Southdubbed films, breaking records in the Hindi

Hindi filmmakers and stars did not take kindly to the fact that South Indian films had invaded the Hindi market and were also creating records at the box office. Some even had Twitter spats with their southern counterparts. It was more upsetting for Hindi filmmakers because, while the South films were excelling at the box office, Hindi films of even top stars were failing on a regular

The Hindi side did not have much ground to stand on because almost all makers were remaking South Indian films! It is also a fact that Hindi films alone can't feed the cinemas for all 52 weeks of the year.

Multiplexes with five or more screens have multiple shows each day that need more supply. Regional films, be it Bhojpuri, Gujarati, Punjabi or Marathi, are not doing all that well, either! All they have is Hindi and the Hollywood films and. if the South films were an added

So, to keep the audience informed about their films, the filmmakers in the South have taken to inviting the media from Mumbai, Delhi, and other North Indian centres to cover their events.

alternative, so much the better.

South Indian filmmakers inviting the media from the North used to be a routine practice when they made Hindi films. Now, it happens even for an event of a South Indian film because, at the back of their mind, the makers are envisioning the Hindi belt business.

However, just when the respective industries were coming to terms that what mattered was the Indian film industry, the North South divide was refreshed by the media in Bengaluru.

It was an event where the media from the North was invited to cover a promo launch of the Kannada film, 'Martin', starring Dhruv Sarja, in Bengaluru last week. The local media was reluctant to share their events with their counterparts from the North. In a surprising move, the local media blocked the media from the North from entering the

They probably don't believe in the philosophy of Atithi Devo Bhava (Guest is God), which is ingrained in our culture. When, finally, the organisers convinced the local media to let the event proceed, they grudgingly allowed the guest media to be accommodated in the front seats of the hall where the promo was to be screened!

What the Bengaluru media did to their brethren from the North was the result of the North-South divide set off by the then Kannada superstar, Dr Rajkumar. Kannada was not much of a film industry. There were no remakes in Hindi. The circuit, known as the Mysore circuit, was not worth more than Rs 50,000 to 60,000 for the rights of a Hindi film, which did business only in Bengaluru.

Dr Rajkumar was a demigod and, during what was termed as the Gokak Movement he ordained that Hindi films should not be

released in Karnataka! This was not all.

Dr Rajkumar went ahead and enforced a ban on the use of any languages except Kannada in the state! Cabbies and shopkeepers refused to converse in any language other than Kannada. The trade magazine I worked for at that time reported and criticised what Dr Rajkumar was up to and, as a result, the magazine was also banned in Karnataka!

That was around the early 1980s and I visited Bengaluru to promote an event. I made a call to the offices of 'The Indian Express'. Guess what? The telephone operator would respond only in Kannada to whatever I asked. I was left with no option but to ask, 'Why the heck do you publish an English daily if you don't answer a caller in English?' Thankfully, my hotel staff was not following the diktat.

Sad, but Dr Rajkumar legacy still prevails. Don't they understand that it was one of their Kannada-language film producers who needed the North media and not the other way round?

Petty, isn't it?

A Tax Free Film? Pay More! Now, there is an excellent query raised by the Telangana High Court.

The entertainment tax (ET) levied on cinema tickets was a state subject before the GST regime was introduced and, because these tax slabs were very high, filmmakers sought tax exemption from various states. The idea was to make admission rates cheaper, more affordable to help draw more footfalls.

The idea behind exempting films from ET was to encourage good cinema.

This noble idea soon turned into a quid pro quo between filmmakers and politicians. The merit of a film was no more the criteria, greasing palms became the norm. The politicians loved to have film stars grace their events and birthdays.

The ex-UP Chief Minister Akhilesh Yadav, for instance, was on an exemption spree and exempt-

ed films on a regular basis. To

a great extent, this practice was at work in various states

As a rule, the benefits of the tax rebate were passed on to the viewers. But no more The new age management grads came up with a new ecosystem: gobble up that exemption. Without breaking the law, the cinemas increased the admission rates to an extent that would offset the exemption amount! Ek haath se de, ek haath se wapas

Take for example the film 'Mary Kom'. A friend went to watch it in an early show when the admission rate was Rs 120. The film was exempted from ET, so he expected the ticket to cost him Rs 90. But he ended up paying Rs 140 instead! What was the explanation? The cinema in question had changed the Rs 120 slot to Rs 140! Claimed they were legally allowed to do that.

The common people either don't know about the film's exemption status or do not care. But, in 2017, a cinema viewers' group, Cine Prekshakula Viniyoga Darula Sangham, filed a PIL in the Telangana High Court stating that the benefit of the films exempted from entertainment tax were never passed

on to the viewers by the cinemas. The HC in 2019 held that the government order had become pointless with the passage of time!

The matter went to the Supreme Court, which held the Telangana HC order was incorrect, and remitted the matter back to the HC, ordering it to dispose of the matter within three months.

Seeking ET exemption was a routine matter earlier, now, in the GST regime, not many filmmakers seek this favour. Because, unlike earlier, when the ET slabs varied from 50 per cent to 80 per cent or more of the admission rate, depending on the state, now the total tax on a ticket is 18 per cent -- 9 per cent for the state and 9 per cent for the Centre.

An 18 per cent rebate on a cinema ticket may not seem like much, but cinemas gobble up even that!



The vote on Friday was largely ceremonial as he had already locked in a historic third term as head of the Chinese Communist Party at a major party congress last

Changes to the country's leadership take place every five years and usually closely mirror the reshuffle announced at the party con-

Meanwhile, naming of a

new premier and various ministers in the coming days is considered more important, reports the BBC.

The new appointees are all expected to be Xi loyalists, including Li Qiang, who is tipped to serve as the President's number two.

Xi has solidified his rule as China reopens from his bruising zero-Covid policy that has fuelled anti-government protests



RUSSIA BANS 144 CITIZENS OF BALTIC STATES FROM ENTRY

Moscow: The Russian Foreign Ministry announced that 144 citizens of Latvia, Lithuania and Estonia have been barred from entering Moscow.

The newly blacklisted are Ministers, parliament members, public figures and journalists of the three countries, Xinhua news agency quoted the Ministry as saying in a state-

ment. The names of the targeted citizens were however not revealed.

Moscow imposed the travel ban in response to "the active lobbying by the Baltic states of sanctions and other measures against Russia, interference in its internal affairs, and inciting Russophobic sentiments", the Ministry statement added.

Trump may be charged in connection with hush money paid to adult film star

hrowing a huge question mark over the President Donald Trump may be criminally charged in connection with hush money he allegedly paid to silence Stormy Daniels, an adult film star, who said she had an affair with him. according to news reports.

A city prosecutor has "signalled" Trump's lawyers that he could face criminal charges in the 2016 incident. The New York Times reported on Thursday evening citing unnamed sources.

NBC news also reported quoting his lawyers that Trump had been asked to appear before a grand jury investigating the case, which is usually an indication that an indictment or framing of charges was likely.

But he is not obligated to appear before the grand

Being charged, standing trial or even convicted would not disqualify Trump from running for President under the US Constitution.

WhatsApp says will leave UK market if forced to stop end-to-end protection

eta-owned WhatsApp has said it will leave the UK market if forced to weaken its end-toend encryption for users under the upcoming Online Safety Bill.

In a briefing with reporters, WhatsApp Head Will Cathcart slammed the legislation as the most concerning set of online regulations in the western world, reports Wired.

"We've recently been blocked in Iran, for example. But we've never seen a liberal democracy do that," Cathcart was quoted as saying in reports.

"Ninety-eight per cent of our users are outside the UK. It would be an odd choice for us to choose to lower the security of the product in a way that would affect those 98 per cent of users," he categorically said.



Cathcart says he is concerned that the bill could make it harder for WhatsApp and other messaging platforms to provide end-to-end encryp-

"It's hard to imagine we're having this

that might go around people's ability to communicate privately," he told

A provision in the Online Safety Bill requires tech companies to use "accredited technology" to scan users' messages for child sexual abuse material or

According to security researchers, it is impossible to introduce such a measure without breaking end-to-end encryp-

In 2021, Apple introduced plans to scan users' messages for CSAM but shelved those after facing criticism from the security researchers

The Online Safety Bill also puts the onus on Big Tech and firms that fail to comply with the new rules could face fines of up to 18 million pounds, or 10 per cent of their annual global turnover,

New measures in the law include tougher and quicker criminal sanctions for tech bosses and new criminal offences for falsifying and destroying

The Online Safety Bill will require social media platforms, search engines and other apps and websites allowing people to post their own content to pro tect children, tackle illegal activity and uphold their stated terms and condi-

"The Bill will strengthen people's rights to express themselves freely online and ensure social media companies are not removing legal free speech. For the first time, users will have the right to appeal if they feel their post has been taken down unfairly," former Digital Secretary Nadine Dorries had said last year.

7 dead in Germany church shooting

A t least seven people were killed and eight others injured during a shooting at a Jehovah's Witness church in the German city of Hamburg, local media reported on Friday.

Earlier media reports said the shooting, which occurred around 9 p.m. on Thursday night, killed six people. But one more body was found on the

upper part of the building later, Xinhua news agency reported citing the German newspaper Bild as saying.

Police have said that a gunman is believed to be dead, but it remains unclear if the attacker is among seven fatalities, the newspaper added. There was also no evidence of a flee-

ing perpetrator, according to the police. Hamburg's Mayor Peter Tschentscher expressed his condolences to the victims families.Police were working flat out to pursue the perpetrators and clarify the background, he said on Twitter.

Meanwhile, the city's Interior Minister Andy Grote said on Twitter that police



Shivneri Fort, where he was born, will get a museum on the life and times of the Chhatrapati and an amount of Rs 300 crore will be spent to revamp and conserve the major forts of his glorious era.The government will spend Rs 50 crore to set up a 'Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Theme Park' at Ambegaon, Pune, said Fadnavis.

Public parks with audio-visual media facilities shall be developed in Mumbai, Amravati, Nashik, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar and Nagpur to tell the story of the life of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj at a cost of Rs 250

crore.

As part of the initiative, a leopard safari will be started in Pune while a Rs 270 crore plan has been approved for Swarajya Rakshak Dharmaveer

Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj Balidaan Sthal in Tuljapur and at Shirur in Pune.

The Opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi leaders of Congress-Nationalist Congress Party-Shiv Sena (UBT) have slammed the government asking the budget has made no mention or allocation for the much-anticipated grand memorial of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj in the Arabian Sea off Mumbai coast.

They pointed out that way back on December 24, 2016, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had sailed in a boat to perform the ajal pujan' at the prospective spot where the memorial is planned in the sea off Raj Bhavan, but after that there's no movement on the project, expected to cost around Rs 3,600 crore.

Shocker: Maha admits 10-yr-old dead tribal girl was a 'bonded labour'

n a shocking admission, Maharashtra Tribal Development Minister Vijaykumar Gavit informed the state legislature on Friday that a minor tribal girl - who died in September 2022 - worked as a 'bonded labour', a practice abolished 47 years ago.

Gavit's statement came in the Legislative Council and attracted strong criticism of the Opposition MLCs during a question on the issue of the Ashram Shalas in the state.

As Gavit replied to a query on the Ashram Shalas (schools) run for tribal kids, he was also asked to respond on the death of a 10year-old tribal girl of Nashik six months ago.

The Minister said that the girl had been taken to work in the adjoining Parner tehsil of Ahmednagar district but since she was not in good health, the family which employed her had dumped the girl outside her parents'

She was found with injury marks on her body and passed away during her treatment later, he said.

The enraged Opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) demanded to know whether she had been 'sold', resulting in embarrassment for the ruling Shiv Sena-Bharatiya Janata Party alliance government. The MVA



members like Ambadas Danve, Eknath Khadse and Shashikant Shinde urged the minister to make a statement on her death, and Gavit said she was not 'sold' but was employed as a 'bonded labourer'.

Janata Dal's Kapil Patil pointed out that 'bonded labour' is banned vide a law enacted in Maharashtra, and "it is shameful that the Minister openly admits to the prevalence of such a practice in the state.'

He demanded an explanation from the Minister as to how the victim ended up working as a 'bonded labour', when this practice was abolished (in 1976).

Terming it as 'a reflection' of the government's inefficiency, Khadse said that the sale or bonded labour involving children is 'unpardonable' and demanded that the state government should take it very seriously.

Samajwadi Party MLA challenges Maha govt order tracking inter-community marriages

Samajwadi Party MLA has filed a writ petition in the Bombay High Court challenging the Maharashtra government's order setting up a Family Coordination Committee (FCC) to monitor inter-faith and inter-caste marriages in the state, here on Friday.

MLA Rais K. Shaikh has said that the Government Resolution (GR) to the effect is discriminatory against a particular religion and violates Article 14 (Right to Equality) and Article 15 (Right to Life which includes Right to Privacy) and Article 25 (Right to Freedom of Religion) and other articles as enshrined in the Constitution.

The GR of December 13, 2022 came in the wake of the grisly killing of a Palghar girl, Shraddha Walkar in Delhi, allegedly by her inter-faith boyfriend, Shaikh said in the plea filed through lawyer Jeet Gandhi.

"That the assumption that adult women who choose and consent to marry someone from another faith need to be 'saved' is misplaced and goes against the spirit of the Constitution," Shaikh said in his plea.

He claimed that it is the government's attempt to discourage and/ or prohibit interfaith marriages and is a precursor to the



laws related to purported 'love jihad' marriages that have been stayed in numerous states in the country.

The government's FCC is ostensibly intended to provide a platform to 'counsel, communicate and resolve' differences between such couples and their estranged families

Shaikh said that the FCC can intervene at the behest of any person which is a breach of the couple's privacy, especially when two consenting adults are married to each other. He pointed out that the discourse around marriage in India

fails to place adult individuals at the centre with the family, campaigning vigilante groups and societal forces playing the role to control the lives and determine the future of the young people who have chosen their own partner. The plea argued that the GR seeks to create a regressive and false narrative that "it is only in inter-faith or inter-caste marriages that a girl is at risk from her partner".

Besides, Shaikh said that the GR discriminates against a particular religion and encourages a divide among people instead of harmony, co-existence, assimilation and peace.

The FCC is authorised to seek information of both registered and unregistered marriages, which the petition warns could violate several rights of couples who have eloped to

He contended that the GR is ultra vires the Constitution as it was issued unilaterally, in extreme haste, under suspicious circumstances without following due procedures, particularly since distressed women have recourse to other laws like Indian Penal Code and Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act.Shaikh said that the GR doesn't cover those who plan to wed under personal laws and/or in their own religion, and sought that it should be scrapped, and the petition is likely to come up for hearing in due course.

WOMAN DEAD, 4 INJURED AFTER FIRE AT CHEMICAL UNIT

Palghar: An 85-year-old woman was killed and four others injured in a major fire and explosions at a small chemical unit in Vasai taluka of Maharashtra's Palghar district, officials said.

Thursday afternoon, they said.

The woman had given the ground floor space of her residence to the chemical plant to run its operations, while she herself lived on the mezzanine floor there, a fire brigade official said.

"A drum filled with thinner, an inflammable substance, was kept at the unit. While the liquid was being transferred, it resulted in a fire that triggered explosions around 4 pm," he said.

After the blaze, the elderly woman's daughter ran out to safety. However, the woman got trapped inside and died on the spot, the official said.

"Four persons working at the unit sustained burn injuries and were admitted to a hospital. They are currently undergoing treatment," he said, adding that the fire brigade personnel put out the fire by around 9 pm. An offence under Indian Penal Code (IPC) section 304 (culpable homicide not amounting to murder) was registered against the owner of the chemical plant, but no arrest has been made so far, police said.

"GAJAR HALWA": TEAM UDDHAV ON E SHINDE GOVERNMENT'S MAIDEN BUDGET

Referring to the announcement of paying Rs 6,000 to farmers under the 'Namo Shetkari Mahasanman Nidhi' to supplement the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Samman Nidhi

Yojana, the Shiv Sena (Uddhav Balasaheb Thackeray) said the budget did not speak about the compensation to farmers who lost their crop to hailstorm and unseasonal rains.

Large parts of the state witnessed unseasonal rains resulting in damage to standing

"The budget is a 'gajar halwa' (sweet dish made of carrots) of announcements that is aimed at misleading people," the party said.

Fadnavis had said in the Assembly that the budget was based on five major goals or 'Panchamrut' - sustainable farming-prosperous farmers; inclusive development of all sections of society, including women, tribals, backward classes and OBCs; development of infrastructure with substantial capital investment; employment generation for competent, skilled and employable youth as well as environment-friendly development.




