

# **4 JAWANS KILLED IN BATHINDA MILITARY STATION FIRING**

Stating that no individual has been detained yet, the Indian Army said on Wednesday evening that a search team has located the INSAS rifle along with the magazine used in the killing of four armymen inside the Bathinda military station in Punjab. "Joint teams of the Army and police will now undertake forensic analysis of the weapon for ascertaining further details," the Army said in an evening bulletin.

Considering sensitivities involved, the Indian Army on Wednesday asked the media to avoid rumours and refrain from speculation over a firing incident inside the Military Station in Punjab's Bathinda, which led to the deaths of four soldiers, and "the area continues to be sealed off to establish the facts of the case".

wo unidentified persons in civil dress opened fire at army personnel sleeping in the barracks of the military station early on Wednesday morning, killing four armymen, said Superintendent of Police (Investigation), Ajay Gandhi, adding that 19 empty shells of an INSAS rifle were recovered from the spot.

The firing took place at about 4.35 a.m. on Wednesday at the military base -- the largest in Asia -- located some 100 km from the Pakistan border.Gandhi, who is heading the police team probing the incident, refused to comment on the use of weapon/weapons in the crime. "The matter is still under investigation," he



### told the media.

The officer said that 19 empty shells of an INSAS rifle were recovered from the spot, adding that the deceased --Sagar, Kamlesh, Santosh and Yogesh -- were asleep when the assailants opened fire inside the military barrack.The South Western Command headquarters said the balance number of rounds in the INSAS rifle would only be available after forensic analysis."The joint investigation with Punjab Police is in progress. All possible assistance is being provided. No individual has been detained or apprehended yet," it added.Earlier in the day, the command headquarters had said in a statement that it has been "ascertained that in the unfortunate incident, four army jawans of an artillery unit succumbed to gunshot

injuries sustained during the incident". "No other injuries to personnel or loss/damage to property have been reported. The area continues to be sealed and a joint investigation with Punjab Police is being coordinated to establish the facts of the case," the statement said. It added that all aspects, including the possible use of an INSAS rifle and 28 rounds of ammunition that went missing two days back, are being probed.Senior Superintendent of Police (Bathinda), Gulneet Singh Khurana, told the media that "it was not a terror attack and seemed to be some internal development in the military station". The Bathinda cantonment, which houses one of the biggest ammunition depots in the country, is located along National Highway-7 on

### Not a terror attack: **Punjab Police**

Chandigarh: Four Army personnel were killed in a firing incident inside the Military Station in Punjab's Bathinda, one of the country's largest defence establishments, the Indian Army said on Wednesday. However, the local police clarified that it was not a terror attack.

Bathinda Senior Superintendent of Police Gulneet Singh Khurana told the media "it was not a terror attack and seemed to be some internal development in the military station".

He said the police teams have been on spot for an in-depth investigation and assisting the local military authorities.

Preliminary reports said the incident seems to be an incident of fratricide. Sources said an INSAS rifle from the unit and some rounds of ammunition had gone missing from the unit premises a few days ago.

The military installation in Bathinda is crucial as it is the headquarters of 10 Corps, which falls under the jurisdiction of the South Western Command based in Jaipur in Rajasthan.

'Social stigma may continue..': SC on pleas for extending reservation benefits to Dalit converts

he Supreme Court on Wednesday orally observed that social stigma and religious stigma are two different things, and social stigma may continue after conversion while hearing a batch of petitions seeking extending of benefits of reservation to Dalits who converted to

Christianity and Islam. Additional Solicitor General K.M. Nataraj, representing the Centre, submitted before a bench that Justice Ranganath Misra Commission report of 2007, which recommended for recognising Dalits in Christianity and Islam, had not gone into all aspects: it did not conduct field study, did not do comparative analysis etc., while defending Centre's decision to not accept the report.

The Centre had maintained that it had appointed

former Chief Justice of India K.G. Balakrishnan to head a commission to examine the claims and the court should wait for its report.

During the hearing, the bench orally observed how many commissions of inquiry may sit on the matter, and if tomorrow there is a different political dispensation, they will say that "we do not accept that inquiry commissions" report, "therefore there is some kind of a colour to this dispute".On the Centre's criticism of Justice Ranganath Misra Commission report, the bench queried Nataraj "Are you sure, you should probably recheck the report, it is not that perfunctory and it is a too generalised statement... It is a generalised comment on the report."The bench said it is flagging the issue, whether it will be in the domain of the court to look into the material of the report, and also

ers interacted on the opposition unity and future strategy to challenge the BJP in the country. Bihar CM Nitish Kumar, on several occasions has been saying that he is waiting for the Congress to take the initiative of getting the opposition together.

escribing the launch of the Vande Bharat Express between Ajmer and Delhi Cantonment as a "big gift" for Rajasthan, Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot on Wednesday said the state will become an economic leader in the country if rail facilities are increased.

Speaking at the Jaipur railway station after the state's first Vande Bharat train was flagged off by Prime Minister Narendra Modi virtually; Gehlot said there is a great need for development of railways in Rajasthan due to its geographically distinct identity.He said rapid industrial development has

taken place in Rajasthan. "For this reason, if rail facilities are increased here, the state will become a leader in the country from the point of view of the economy," he said.

"Railways has an important contribution in the social, cultural and economic development of the country. The changes brought about in the railways after independence are the

result of the thinking of our great leaders and the hard work of the dedicated railway employees and officers. Along with passenger and goods transport, railways have also rendered its important services in times of natural calamity and war in the country," Gehlot said. The Chief Minister said the Vande Bharat train "is a big gift for Rajasthan".

It is Rajasthan's first

semi-high-speed train, which will reduce the travel time between Jaipur and Delhi.

The regular service of the new Vande Bharat train will start from April 13 and will operate between Ajmer and Delhi Cantonment with stops in Jaipur, Alwar and Gurgugram. Gehlot also urged Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw to connect the headquarters of Banswara, Tonk, Karauli with the railways.

The Chief Minister said a memorandum of understanding (MoU) was signed between the Rajasthan government and the Railway Board for the rail service between Dungarpur-Banswara-Ratlam sections.

Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai commenting on the developments, stated on Wednesday that he is hopeful of retaining both the leaders in the party. Reacting to Savadi's threat to resign, Bommai said that he has spoken to him. Shettar is visiting New Delhi after he was denied a ticket from Hubballi-Dharwad constituency.

### **Retail inflation** falls to 5.66% in March as food prices slide

New Delhi: India's retail inflation, which is measured by consumer price index (CPI), fell to 5.66 per cent in March from 6.44 per cent in February, according to official data released on Wednesday.

The retail inflation fell mainly due to sharp slide in food inflation, which stood at 4.79 per cent in March against 5.95 per cent in February. Retail inflation was 6.95 per cent in March 2022. With CPI-based inflation falling below 6 per cent, it is now within the RBI's tolerance level, which is between 2 per cent to 6 per cent.The RBI has the mandate of keeping inflation at 4 per cent, with a margin of 2 per cent on either side.

### **KOLKATA METRO CREATES HISTORY WITH** SUCCESSFUL UNDERWATER TEST RUN Kolkata Agencies

olkata witnessed history on Wednesday as a rake of Kolkata Metro conducted a successful trial run through an underwater tunnel under Hooghly River in the route connecting Esplanade in central Kolkata with the iconic Howrah station.

Only senior officials and select engineers of Kolkata Metro were on board during the trial run, the first in the history of the nation.

Describing the event as a historic moment for the city, Kolkata Metro General Manager P. Uday Kumar Reddy said that this is just the beginning and regular underwater trial runs in this route will commence soon. Reddy, who described the trip as "revolutionary", was



he travelled from the Mahakaran station to the Howrah Maidan station. According to Reddy, regu-

lar trial runs on this route will be conducted for the next seven months

"Soon after that, regular services for the general public will commence," he said. The route stretching from

Howrah to Esplanade is approximately 4.8 km long, of which 520 metres will be through the tunnel under Hooghly River. The tunnel is 32 metres under the water surface level.

## Serum Institute Restarts Manufacturing Of COVID-19 Vaccine Covishield

Intro: According to Union Health Ministry data updated on Wednesday, India registered a single-day rise of 7,830 new coronavirus infections, the highest in 223 days, and the count of active cases in the country reached 40,215.

erum Institute of India CEO Adar Poonawalla on Wednesday said the company has restarted manufacturing of COVID-19 vaccine Covishield amid rising numbers of cases of the virus infection.

He said the company already has six million booster doses of Covovax vaccine available and adults must take the booster shot.

"Just as a precaution, at risk we have done it so that people have Covishield as a choice if

they want it," Poonawalla told Press Trust of India on restarting manufacturing of the vaccine.He further said Serum Institute of India (SII) will make 6-7 million doses of Covishield available in 90 days and it could take up to nine months to further build up the stock based on demand.

The company had stopped manufacturing of Covishield in December 2021.

The restarting of manufacturing of Covishield by SII comes at a time when the number of COVID-19 cases in the country is rising again.

# **20 VILLAGE YOUTH CREATE 132 FEET BANNER ON AMBEDKAR'S LIFE**

Team Absolute Ahmednagar group of 20 village youth has created a 132 feet long and 8 feet tall banner on the life of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar ahead of the 132nd birth anniversary of the chief architect of Indian Constitution on April 14. The youngsters are from Dharangaon village under Kopargaon Taluka in Ahmednagar district, and they self-financed the cost of Rs 10.000 for their creation.

"The multi-coloured banner has been erected on the main thoroughfare leading to the village, and it is prominently visible to all those coming or going from there. It was inaugurated on Tuesday night with fireworks and celebrations," said Jitendra Chandrakant Ranshur, a Kopargaon Republican Party of India leader. Created under the name 'Samrat Group', the banner depicts some of the greatest sayings and slogans of Ambedkar, has glimpses of his life from childhood, his educa-

tion in India and abroad, his family, the old dark car which he used to travel in, images of the Parliament symbolising India's democracy, plus several pictures of other major historical personalities and those with whom he interacted during his lifetime. "The youth have tried to con-

how Ambedkar not only worked for the downtrodden Dalits, but also for the society as a whole along with his contributions to laying the foundation for Indian democracy," said Ranshur.

The giant cloth banner, measuring a whopping 1,056 sq ft and weighing around 40 kg, was stitched together in Kopargaon,

and then transported free of cost by a government bus driver to the Dharangaon village where it will be on display till April 20. Additionally, the Samrat

Group has collected Rs 100,000 which will be used for various social-cultural-educational programmes on April 14, including a community meal in the village.

## **Excise policy scam** Delhi court adjourns hearing in Sisodia's bail plea

Delhi court on Wednesday adjourned the hearing in AAP Leader Manish Sisodia's bail plea in connection with the Delhi excise policy case being investigated by the Enforcement Directorate (ED).

The ED submitted before the bench of special judge M.K. Nagpal of the Rouse Avenue Court that Sisodia had planted fabricated emails to show that there was public approval for the policy.

'We have evidence that Sisodia had e-mails planted. These were received not only in the official email account of the excise department, but even in his personal email account. The content of the emails was given by Sisodia which suited his agenda," the ED counsel told the court while opposing Sisodia's bail plea.

The directions to send these predrafted e-mails were given to Zakir Khan, Chairman of Delhi Minorities' Commission, who then asked his interns to send the e-



mails, the ED told the court.

"Fabricated e-mails were sent to show that there was public approval for the excise policy. It was a sham approval. An illegal ecosystem was created to give benefits to the liquor cartels in lieu of kickbacks," the ED counsel said. The ED's special public prosecu-

tor Zoheb Hossain then told the judge that the agency wants to show him the case diary. To this, Sisodia's counsel said that it should not be done so in secrecy.

"Sealed cover business should go If something is used against me to deny me my liberty, if they are relying on something behind my back, it should be shown to me as well," the counsel said on behalf of Sisodia.

However, the probe agnecy said that the 60 days given to complete the investigation against Sisodia are not over yet.

The ED counsel said: "We will show it to you after 60 days.' The court then adjourned the

matter for next hearing on April 18. On April 5, the ED had informed

special judge Nagpal that it has found fresh evidence indicating Sisodia's involvement in the alleged excise policy scam, and the investigation is at a crucial stage.

The court had extended the AAP leader's custody till April 17 in this case.

Advocate Vivek Jain, representing Sisodia, had told the court that the ED lacked evidence to support the accusation that his client was involved in money laundering

### **DELHI: 8 HELD FOR SELLING FAKE IPL MATCH TICKETS**

New Delhi: The Delhi Police on Wednesday claimed to have apprehended eight persons including two juveniles, and busted a racket involved in printing and selling fake IPL tickets. Police said that a total of 80 fake IPL tickets for the Delhi Capitals vs Mumbai Indians match were recovered from their ession According to the police, on Tuesday during an IP match between "Mumbai Indians and Delhi Capitals", a police team took their position around Arun Jaitley Cricket Stadium in plain clothes, posing as spectators, and also put colours and stickers on their faces. "After a close vigil, the team noticed a few persons engaged in selling tickets in black. During this exercise, a total of three persons were apprehended along with 24 tickets. They were selling IPL tickets of Rs 1,250 at the cost of Rs 4,000 each," Deputy Commissioner of Police Sanjay Kumar Sain said. The accused individuals were identified as Piyush, a resident of Gurugram in Haryana, Tarun Kumar, a resident of Daryaganj, and Mohammad Nasim, a resident of Moradabad in Uttar Pradesh, police said. "During further exercise, one more person was also apprehended. He was identified as Rohit Chauhan, a resident of Mumbai, the DCP said. On questioning, Rohit disclosed that he, along with his friends, used to visit those cities where IPL matches are being played. On reaching such a destination, they used to prepare fake IPL tickets having features similar to the original tickets using software, colour printer and other materials. After printing such tickets, the accused took position at the venues of IPL matches and, taking advantage of the high demand for tickets for IPL matches, they used to sell such tickets to needy persons at a very high rate.



"Investigation revealed that in a similar fashion, land was taken from several poor parents and candidates in lieu of Group D jobs in the Railways. It has been revealed during the investigation that in many Railways Zones, more than 50 per cent of recruited candidates were from Lalu Prasad's families' constituencies," the ED said.

Team Absolute Chandigarh Punjab Police have arrested four alleged smugglers after recovering 35 packets of heroin, weighing 36.9 kg, from their possession in Fazilka district, Director General of Police (DGP) Gaurav Yadav said on Wednesday.

The arrested persons have been identified as Manpreet Singh, Jaspal singh, Sukhdev Singh and Dyalvinder singh, all residents of Tarn Taran district. The police have also recovered two Sedan cars, which were used to smuggle in drug consignments from Rajasthan.

The DGP said that following inputs about the influx of large quantities of heroin from Rajasthan to Punjab, the police carried out an operation in the Lalo Wali village area, where four persons were waiting for someone. On seeing the police party, the

accused tried to flee but the police managed to apprehend them.

"During checking, the police recovered 23 packets of heroin, weighing 24.295 kg, concealed in the enclosure of their car windows," the DGP said, adding that another chunk of 12 packets of heroin, weighing 12.620 kg, were recovered from the location disclosed by the accused.

Deputy Inspector General of Police (Ferozepur Range), Ranjit Singh Dhillon, said as per preliminary investigation, the accused were coming from Rajasthan after collecting the heroin consignment which was dropped from across the border using a drone. Senior Superintendent of Police, Avneet Kaur Sidhu, said that further probe is on to find out more people involved in this module and also the Punjab-based receiver of the consignment.

Dwarka and 300 grams of heroin worth Rs 1.5 crore was recovered from his possession, a Delhi Police official said on Wednesday.

The accused has been identified as Nnamdi Peter Oguegbulem, a resident of Imo State, Nigeria.

According to police, the staff of Anti-Narcotics Cell, Dwarka was tasked to develop intelligence and information regarding the drug traffickers, who are indulging in drug- trafficking in Dwarka. "On April 8, the police team was in Uttam Nagar

area for verification of illegally staying foreigners. Meanwhile, one foreigner came to Peer Baba road and was stopped by the team," said M. Harsha Vardhan, the

"The SWAT team is also conducting searches inside the premises. The police have so far conducted two rounds of search and that the third round is underway.

"Police teams are looking for the source of the e-mail. In November last year, the school received a similar email which was sent via a German server," the police officer said.

"We thank Education Minister Pradhan ji for encouraging the creation of this MoU. We shall now endeavour to ensure that this MoU produces concrete results," stated the IIT Bhubaneswar director.

The institutes will also focus on dedicated laboratory development. An advanced research centre called Center for Biomedical Engineering and Technology which will largely include biomedical signal processing, advanced characterisation, detector fabrication for imaging, additive manufacturing for designed materials, bio tracker and biosensor development for mental health care, is also planned under this collaboration.

In addition, both the institutes have agreed to facilitate faculty and student exchange programmes and reorientation/training courses that will bring academic excellence in their respective fields.

The institutes also agreed to develop and offer joint academic programmes involving technology and healthcare as well as academic credit sharing mechanism, sources said.

Both the institutes will focus on dedicated facility development and explore the use of advanced medical equipment for artificial intelligence enabled patient care services. This will provide joint academic programmes that include short summer courses for MBBS and B. Tech students, and research dissertation and thesis work for doctoral (PHD/M. Tech) students.







## Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve

one-and-a-half-vearold elephant was reportedly killed by a tiger in Madhya Pradesh's Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve (BTR) located in Umaria dis trict. The incident occurred on Monday when the baby elephant got separated from the herd owing to bad weather conditions and was attacked by a male tiger, a forest official said.

The forest officials found the body of the elephant calf while patrolling an area in the Panpatha Corps range of BTR on Monday. They also saw a tiger near the body along with pug marks in the surrounding area. The elephant's body had marks of tiger attack on the neck, the

official said.

"This is the first time that a tiger has hunted a wild elephant, not just in Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve, but in whole of Madhya Pradesh," the official said. "After the incident, queshave killed the elephant because it was alone after getting seperated from the herd," Pushpendra Dwivedi, the wildlife warden at Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve, said.

Dwivedi said the baby elephant got separated from the herd due to bad weather conditions. One more baby elephant had got separated from the herd, but it was rescued unhurt and was reunited with the rest of the elephants later, he said. Notably, out of the six tiger reserves in Madhya Pradesh, wild elephants are found in only two only two reserves -Bandhavgarh and Sanjay-Dubri Tiger Reserve. According to forest officials, Bandhavgarh is home to more than 48 wild elephants.

## WHO's new Covid update on vax threaten demand, revenues

The recent update on Covid-19 vaccine and booster dose by the World Health Organization (WHO) can lead to reduction in global demand and revenue for vaccines against the deadly infectious disease, according to a report on Monday. The WHO recently revised its vaccine guidance following a meeting of the agency's Strategic Advisory Group of Experts on Immunisation (SAGE). SAGE no longer recommends annual Covid vaccine boosters for healthy adults under 60 years of age after they have received both a primary vaccine series and booster. Further, they no longer recommend vaccinating healthy children aged six months to 17 years against Covid at all. With the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and other national health agencies following suit with similar updates, the future of Covid-19 vaccine rollouts is becoming highly uncertain, revealed the report by GlobalData, a data and analytics company. SAGE has also updated its guidance on bivalent Covid vaccines, now accepting the use of bivalent BA.5-specific vaccine doses for the primary series, due to the benefits observed in symptomatic disease. However, the agency highlighted that there is no evidence indicating the bivalent vaccine is more effective in preventing severe disease, further threatening the Covid booster landscape. Since the threat of severe disease has diminished, health agencies and governments are now focused on shifting resources to vaccinate against other diseases such as RSV and influenza. Most European countries, including the UK, have already restricted boosters to the highest-risk groups. Despite signs of decreasing funding and legislature to support booster rollouts, the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has approved a second booster dose in adults aged 65 years or older and is planning a meeting of its vaccine advisory committee in June to determine an action plan for the use of bivalent boosters during the upcoming fall season.

# **WHY DO WEAK PEOPLE ALWAYS HAVE TO PAY THE PRICE OF DEVELOPMENT?'**

ts mighty roar down to a warble, the Narmada flows tepidly through the quaint village of Odhari in Mohgaon block of Mandla district. On its banks, protests simmer over the looming threats - to land, livelihood and biodiversity

The Gonds and Baigas mostly occupy Odhari, the proposed site of Basania dam under the Narmada Valley Project (NVP). Once completed, the dam will flood 31 villages -- 18 in Mandla and the rest in Dindori -- and dislocate 2,735 fami-

Naval Singh Maravi is already troubled visualising that fateful day when he would have to leave. Hailing from Rampuri in Mohgaon, Maravi got five-and-a-half-acre ancestral property when his father partitioned 22 acres among his four sons. Income from his urad dal (black gram) crop is minimal, so the family depends on the village forest for a living. Armed with community and individual rights under the FRA, they collect tendu leaves, harra (Terminalia chebula), behda (Terminalia bellirica), chironji (Buchanania lanzan) and amla, besides firewood.

"I am more worried about losing the forest income than the land. We do not have to seek permission or pay up for accessing this resource. How will I feed my family if we are moved out?" says Maravi, who belongs to the Backward Class.

Titra Singh of Odhari is annoyed the moment you ask why villagers are protesting when they are eligible for compensation. "I have three acres of land abutting the forest. How much compensation will I get? Maybe, Rs 2 to 4 lakh per acre? If we calculate based on the maximum price of Rs 4 lakh, I will get Rs 12 lakh. Is this money enough to buy land elsewhere, run the household and conduct the marriages of my two children?" he rues. Titra says he will lose Rs 50,000 to



one lakh annually as there will be no forest, wherever he goes and settles. His calculations are based on the amount provided during previous instances of land acquisition. So far, the government has neither announced the project launch nor the compensation.

In response to a question from Ashok Marskole, the MLA of Niwas Assembly constituency in Mandla district, Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan had said in a written reply on March 3, 2016, that the Basania dam project will be nixed. "It was announced in the Assembly that Basania dam and six similar projects were cancelled after considering the vast submergence area, the forestland involved and other reasons," Marskole told 101Reporters. When the MLA inquired about it in December 2022, he learnt that permission had been granted. Last November, when the govern-

ment entered into an agreement with Afcons Infrastructure Limited for dam construction, huge protests erupted in both Mandla and Dindori districts. In January, villagers submitted a memorandum addressed to Governor Mangubhai Patel and CM Chouhan to Mandla Collector Harshika Singh, with an appeal to convert the hydropower project that would possibly submerge 2,437 hectares of land, including 2,107 hectares of forest, into a micro-irrigation scheme. On January 29, the local struggle committees in all 31 villages jointly organised a massive public meeting at Dhangaon in Mandla. They claimed the area of submergence will increase once the authorities get down to field surveys and reiterated their demand.

### PESA over troubled waters

The NVP involves construction of 29 dams for the purpose of irrigation and hydropower generation. So far, work on 10 reservoirs are over. while six are under construction. Of the rest 13, nine have received administrative approval.

As per the Narmada Valley Development Authority's Annual Administrative Report 2009-2010. Basania dam will irrigate 8,780 hectares of land in 42 villages and generate 100 MW hydropower. The estimated cost of construction was Rs 2,884.88 crore at that time. However, preliminary information suggests that 6,343 hectares, including 2,443 hectares of private lands, 2,107 hectares of forestland and 1,793 hectares of government land, will be submerged.

Mandla is a designated Scheduled Area under the Fifth Schedule of the Constitution. The Panchayats (Extension to Scheduled Areas) Act, 1996, which gives village councils absolute powers on many fronts, including land acquisition and development plans, is applicable in the district starting November 15, 2022, the day Madhya Pradesh implemented the PESA Act.

Permission should be taken at the gram sabha meetings of the affected villages with regard to the dam project, but Titra claims the NVP officials have not even visited his village, which falls under Badjhar gram panchayat. It is rumoured that some NVD officials visited the villages surrounding

Odhari on December 30, 2022, but the villagers besieged them and made them write a letter saying no official would enter their premises to conduct any survey without prior permission.

"People have not been informed about the dam work. This is in complete violation of the constitutional rights bestowed on the tribals under the PESA Act. I learnt about the plan from a local daily's report on the pact that the NVP signed with a Mumbai-based company. Our gram sabha will never approve this construction," Titra says defiantly. According to Rajkumar Sinha, the

convener of Bargi Dam Displaced and Affected Association, the Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) has postponed the conditional permission for an environmental impact assessment of Basania dam project and has suggested submitting an Alternative Site Analysis. At the same time, it has not rejected the project as demanded by lakhs of affected families. "It is clear that the dam will be proposed again after the upcoming elections (likely in November)," he adds. But he is also optimistic about the

awareness among the people and the strength of their collective resistance, despite the sordid history of governments faking gram sabha resolutions to push projects through. "PESA will play a key role in Basania Project," he said. "In the rules formulated and implemented last year, it is clearly

stated that the gram sabha is empowered to oppose the handover of lands for the project and they will also have to be consulted regarding its social impact. The FRA too gives gram sabhas the right to protect their water sources and their resolutions are binding.'

In a joint letter dated January 25, social activist and Narmada Bachao Andolan founder member Medha

Patkar and other social activists/organisations including Sinha wrote to Dr K Gopakumar, Chairman, Expert Appraisal Committee for River Valley Projects, MoEFCC, saving a combined environmental assessment of all the projects was required if many dams were planned in a river valley like Narmada. However, the water planning of the Narmada is hardly visible and the information about its detailed plan is not publicly available. It claimed that imposing a project on the villagers and withholding information from them will go against the very spirit of the PESA Act and will prove that the Madhya Pradesh government's claim of implementing the PESA law is false.

The loss of forest cover and fertile land, decreased water in the Narmada due to serial dam construction and the dwindling fish stock apart, the villagers are worried about the project's social impact. To date, tribals have collectively worshipped bada dev, celebrated nava khai, hal sudum and janjativa gaurav divas, and participated in shaila dance.

"All of us will not be settling in one place after displacement. Our social and cultural identities will be broken. Moreover, we will have to remain silent spectators as the forests that house our deity, saaj (Indian Laurel) trees, drown. No amount of money can compensate for our losses," laments Titra.

As we take leave, Maravi signs off with a pertinent question: "Why do weak people always have to pay the price of development?"

nomic crisis, coupled with a steeply rising inflation, has increased the risk of a financial meltdown for the country, according to estimates and forecasts of global lenders including the International Monetary Fund (IMF)

In a latest forecast, the IMF has reduced the economic growth estimates of Pakistan to 0.5 per cent, while the inflation spike projection estimates are far above 20 per cent for at least two years.

The staggering estimates showcase Pakistan's deep rooted financial crisis, which are showing their damaging affects on the people, who are facing severe hardships, which for the moment, are

Nyathi attributed most of the accidents to human errors, including speeding, inattention, misjudgement and failure to observe road rules and regulations.

He urged the travelling public to be more careful on the roads during the forthcoming Independence holiday on April 18.The number of deaths from road accidents declined from the same period in 2022 when 73 people died in 264 road accidents.

ture was accompanied by unusual dry weather, with the average rainfall over mainland Spain merely reaching 21.2 mm, only 36 per cent of the normal amount the country usually experiences during March.

The Ministry for Ecological Transition and Demographic Challenge said that due to the alarming weather, Spain remains in a state of persistent drought that began at the end of December 2022.

The hot and dry weather also resulted in an early start of the wildfire season in Spain.

hree Sherpa climbers have gone missing in a crevasse on Mount Everest on Wednesday, according to Nepal's Tourism Department.

The three identified as Chiri Sherpa, Lakpa Tendi Sherpa and Lakpa Rita Sherpa, were heading to Camp II from Camp I carrying rope-fixing equipment, the Department's Director Yubraj Khatiwada.

Search and rescue efforts are underway

In 2021, the Department had issued a record 409 Everest permits.

The number dropped to 325 in 2022 as the Russia-Ukraine war prevented potential climbers from the two warring nations, Poland and some other European countries from com-

Hordes of adventurers are again plodding to the Khumbu region with fresh hopes, dreams and enthusiasm.

An Everest climbing permit costs \$11,000 for foreigners and 75,000 NPR for Nepalis

An experienced climbing guide makes as much as \$12,000 during the 45-day season, where the good weather window is normally available

for two weeks in a year. A normal or beginner guide earns \$7,000 per season, while high-altitude porters earn up to

\$4,000 per season. Even the income of a porter is

five times greater than the average income of Nepalis. The climbing time from the Everest Base Camp (altitude 5,364 metres) to Camp 1 (5,943 metres) is six hours.





The 75-minute meeting was held in bonhomie and a day later today (April 12), Pawar and Raut said that the MVA will continue to work with renewed vigour for future political challenges.

Raut said that they had detailed discussions on the political developments in the state and the



nation, the future implications, among others, and reiterated that there are "no differences in the MVA".State Congress President Nana Patole also expressed similar views and said that if the MVA alliance leaders meet other "then what is wrong" and said there was no need for making any wild speculations in the matter.

Meanwhile, AICC General Secretary K. C. Venugopal Rao is likely to visit Maharashtra and meet Thackeray and Pawar in the wake of the recent developments that signalled major cracks in the MVA, which seem to have been sorted out by the Pawar-Thackeray late-night meeting.

The MVA was perturbed by Pawar's comments last week questioning the need for a Joint Parliamentary Probe into the Adani Group scam, but on Tuesday, he apparently softened his stance and said he would not oppose the JPC if other Opposition parties wanted it.

Later, Pawar and his nephew Leader of Opposition Ajit Pawar remarks on Prime Minister Narendra Modi's academic qualifications, the reliability of EVMs, among others, also became the topic of discussion among the three allies.

## Case against man for abetting married woman's suicide

he Navi Mumbai Police have registered a case against a man from Pune for allegedly abetting the suicide of the married woman in Maharashtra, an official said on Wednesday. The accused and the woman were neighbours in Hingewadi area of Pune. The woman got married to another person in May 2019. She and her husband, who lived in Navi Mumbai, used to have quarrels over domestic issues, an official from Rabale police station said.

On February 22 this year, the woman allegedly committed suicide by handing herself from the ceiling of her house in Navi Mumbai, he said.On April 9, the woman's father



got to know from the Rabale police that her mobile phone found near the body contained some messages and calls made by the accused in January and February.In the messages, the accused man abused her. Due to the continuous harassment by him. she committed suicide, as per a complaint lodged by the woman's father. The

deceased's father also informed the police that when the victim lived in Pune, the accused used to harass her and her family had also reprimanded him for it, the official said.A case has been registered against the accused under Indian Penal Code Section 306 (abetment of suicide), he said, adding that no arrest has been made so far.

Thane: The Navi Mumbai police have registered a case against an automobile dealer from Maharashtra's Thane city for allegedly cheating a travel car operator of more than Rs 8 lakh, an official said on Wednesday. The accused and the victim got acquainted at a food outlet. The victim expressed the desire to purchase a car following which the accused offered him a vehicle at Rs 8.99 lakh, inclusive of the registration, delivery and other charges, an official from Nhava Sheva police station said.

The victim paid more than Rs 8 lakh in February this year, but the car was not delivered to him. When the victim reminded the accused about it, the latter gave evasive replies, he said.

The victim then filed a complaint, based on which the police registered a case on Sunday against the automobile dealer under Indian Penal Code Sections 420 (cheating) and 406 (criminal breach of trust), the official said.

No arrest has been made so far, he said, adding that a probe was on into the case.

On April 6, the angry employee called Mhamane to Dahagaon area for a business deal. The employee and two of his friends, all in the age group of 22 to 25 years, allegedly strangled the shop owner to death and dumped the body in a forest there, he said.

After the victim did not return home, his family lodged a missing person's complaint with local police.

During the search, the police found the victim's car abandoned on road in Dahagaon on April 8. They also found his decomposed body in the forest the



next day, the official said.

The post-mortem confirmed the death due to strangulation following which the police registered a case of murder and destruction of evidence, he said.The police team worked on various leads and nabbed the three accused on Tuesday, the official said.

The accused were booked under Indian Penal Code Sections 302 (murder) and 201 (causing disappearance of evidence of offence), he added.

Meanwhile, a search has been launched for Ghazi who is currently absconding.

It boiled down to five runs off the final delivery faced by Dhoni when Sandeep Sharma, who had started the final over with two wides, bowled a good yorker to deny Dhoni the glory on his milestone day.

After deciding to bowl first and restricting Rajasthan Royals to what initially looked like a below-par 175/8 in 20 overs, Chennai could manage 172/6 in 20 overs and lost by a narrow



margin.Earlier, brilliant bowling by Rajasthan Royals spinner Ravichandran Ashwin (2-25) and Yuzvendra Chahal (2-27) off their respective four overs had hampered Chennai Super Kings' chase as they had recovered from losing an early wicket to reach 78/1 in the 10th over.

Tovak Djokovic made a winning return to action as he fought his way into the third round of the Monte Carlo Masters with a 7-6(5), 6-2 win over Russian qualifier Ivan Gakhov.

It was Djokovic's first tournament in over a month as he was forced to miss the Sunshine swing -- Indian Wells and Miami Open -- both ATP 1000 masters' events, after he was denied entry to the United States over his vaccination status.

After receiving a bye in the opening round, the World No. 1 faced a spirited challenge from World No. 198 Gakhov and was in danger of losing the opening set. But Djokovic navigated the big moments well to seal the win. "It was probably, if you can call it this way, an ugly tennis win



for me today," Djokovic said in his oncourt interview. "I haven't played my best, particularly in the first set. And I kind of expected that that was going to happen in a way with swirly conditions, a lot of wind today, changing directions. "It's different practising and then playing an official match on clay, (where) I guess no two

bounces are the same. It's always quite unpredictable what's going to happen. But all in all, I'm just pleased with the way I held my nerves in the important moments and I managed to clinch the two-set win." Gakhov was the fourth alternate into the qualifying field and took full advantage of the opportunity to reach the main draw and earn his first ATP Tour win to advance to the second round. But Djokovic was playing his 1,254th tour-level match compared to Gakhov's third, and that experience paid dividends in the critical moments. "I never saw Ivan play before today to be honest. I've seen a little bit of his video from yesterday's match and that's all. That was not the best preparation, but he's a young player coming up from the Challenger Tour and he just was on a roll," Djokovic said.

## FIFA: Women's World Cup: Spain defeat China by 3-0 in warm-up

he Spain women's football team defeated China 3-0 in Ibiza, Spain in a friendly match to help prepare for the forthcoming World Cup in Australia and New Zealand.

Goals from Tere Abelleira, Athenea del Castillo, and Alba Redondo gave the Spanish a win against a well-organised rival that had chances to score, but seemed tired in the closing minutes, reports Xinhua. Spain took the lead on the stroke of halftime with Abelleira hitting a low shot into the bottom corner of the net after excellent work from Jenni Hermoso, who beat two defenders and then found the midfielder in space to score her first international goal.

However, Spain doubled their lead in the 61st minute when Del Castillo beat two defenders in the area before scoring with a left-foot shot that left Xu Huan rooted to the spot. Redondo added Spain's third goal following a corner in the 81st minute, with the Chinese defense looking tired and allowing her a free header that gave an extra sheen to the result.




