IPL 2024: League is back with new captains, big returns



New Delhi: Shortly after season two of the Women's Premier League (WPL) ended with a trophy for the Royal Challengers Bangalore, the cricket fans' focus immediately shifted to whether the franchise's men's team can do the same in Indian Premier League (IPL) 2024.

It's that time of the year again when ten teams will be competing over two long months to grab the glittering IPL trophy, with passionate fans debating over who will go all the way to the title by May-end.

The IPL 2024 will be commencing with a highly anticipated clash between Royal Challengers Bengaluru (RCB) and defending champions Chennai Super Kings (CSK) at the M.A. Chidambaram Stadium on Friday.

A day before the clash, CSK pulled off a surprise by announcing Ruturaj Gaikwad as its captain, thus replacing the talismanic M.S. Dhoni, who has been subject to adulation whenever the team played its matches in IPL 2023, on their way to winning their fifth title.

MS DHONI HANDS OVER CSK CAPTAINCY TO RUTURAJ GAIKWAD

New Delhi: Right-handed opening batter Ruturaj Gaikwad will be the new captain of Chennai Super Kings ahead of their IPL 2024 season opener against the Royal Challengers Bengaluru at the MA Chidambaram Stadium on Friday.

"MS Dhoni has handed over Chennai Super Kings' captaincy to Ruturaj Gaikwad ahead of the start of IPL 2024. Ruturaj has been an integral part of Chennai Super Kings since 2019 and has played 52 matches in IPL during this period. The team looks forward to the upcoming season," said the franchise in a statement on its official website.

This will only be just the second time MS Dhoni won't start an IPL season as skipper of CSK, after Ravindra Jadeja had been the captain in IPL 2022, only for him to be replaced mid-way by the legendary wicketkeeper-batter.

ED ARRESTS DELHI CM ARVIND KEJRIWAL IN LIQUOR POLICY CASE

KEJRIWAL KNOCKS SC'S DOORS

New Delhi: Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Thursday knocked Supreme Court's doors after the Delhi High Court denied him protection against "coercive action" by the Enforcement Directorate, which has issued multiple summonses to him in connection with the excise policy case.

Earlier on Thursday, a division bench of Justices Suresh Kumar Kait and Manoj Jain of the Delhi High Court declined to pass any order granting interim relief to CM Kejriwal at this juncture.

Last week, the ED issued the ninth summonses to Kejriwal in the excise policy case, asking him to appear before it on Thursday.

The Chief Minister had moved the high court seeking protection against 'coercive action' by the ED, claiming that there is a clear intent to arrest him and hence he won't appear before the agency.

ARVIND KEJRIWAL IS AND WILL REMAIN CHIEF MINISTER": ATISHI

New Delhi: Arvind Kejriwal will continue as the Delhi Chief Minister and discharge his duties from jail, the Aam Aadmi Party said today minutes after he was arrested in connection with the Delhi liquor policy case. "Arvind Kejriwal is and will remain the Chief Minister of Delhi... there are no two ways about it," said AAP's Atishi, who is currently his Number 2 in the government. "We made it clear from the beginning that he will work from jail if need be. There is no law that stops him from doing so. He has not been convicted," she added.

Calling the arrest a "political conspiracy", she said in two years, they have not been able to recover a single rupee, even though more than 500 officers were on the case.

Kejriwal will run govt from prison: Delhi Assembly Speaker

New Delhi: Delhi Assembly Speaker Ram Niwas Goel said on Thursday that as decided earlier, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal will run the government and the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) from prison in case of his arrest by the Enforcement Directorate (ED).

Incidentally, soon after the Speaker made the remarks, the ED arrested Kejriwal from his residence after a two-hour grilling in connection with the alleged excise policy scam.

"Everyone is aware that Manish Sisodia was arrested without any evidence against him. Additionally, hundreds of people have been detained by the ED so far. The aim is to silence Arvind Kejriwal before the elections," said Goel.

Kejriwal is the biggest name to be arrested in the alleged scam, after BRS lawmaker K. Kavitha, former Delhi Deputy CM Manish Sisodia, and AAP RS member Sanjay Singh, among others.

WHY ED ARRESTED ARVIND KEJRIWAL

- ▲ The ED in a press note had called Kejriwal a "conspirator" in the case.
- ▲ Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) leader K Kavitha allegedly conspired with Mr Kejriwal, and AAP leaders Manish Sisodia and Sanjay Singh while framing the now-scrapped liquor policy case, the ED has said.
- ▲ The alleged conspiracy involved making a policy that would benefit a liquor lobby from southern India, which the ED had called the "South Lobby".
- ▲ In return, the "South Lobby" would give Rs100 crore to the AAP, according to the ED.
- ▲ Kejriwal's name had appeared in the statements of some accused and witnesses. The ED has mentioned this in its remand note and chargesheets.
- ▲ Vijay Nair, one of the accused in the liquor policy case, frequently visited Kejriwal's office, and would spend most of his time there, the probe agency said.
- ▲ Nair allegedly told liquor traders that he discussed the policy with Kejriwal. It was Nair, who got Indospirit owner Sameer Mahendru to meet Kejriwal, the investigators have said.
- ▲ When the meeting was unsuccessful, he got Mahendru and Kejriwal talk in a video call, in which -Kejriwal said - Nair was his "child" who he trusts.
- ▲ Raghav Magunta, the first accused in the "South Lobby" and now a witness, had said his father, who is a YSR Congress Party MP, met Kejriwal to know more about the liquor policy.
- ▲ Sisodia's former secretary C Arvind in a statement in December 2022 had said that in March the previous year he got a draft group of ministers report from Sisodia.
- ▲ When he went to Kejriwal's house after Sisodia called him, Arvind said he also saw Satyendra Jain there and the document. He alleged he was surprised because no such proposal was discussed in any group of ministers' (GoM) meeting, but claimed he was asked to make a GoM report based on this document.

Disrespecting Indira, Rajiv Gandhi's legacy: Anand Sharma on Rahul's caste census stand

Congress veteran Anand Sharma, a member of the Congress Working Committee (CWC), has raised strong objections to the party's Lok Sabha election campaign centered around the caste-based census, calling it a "departure from the historic position and also amounting to disrespecting the legacy of former Congress PMs Indira Gandhi and Rajiv Gandhi".

Recalling the inclusive and all-encompassing approach of the Congress party, Anand Sharma cited popular slogans by Indira Gandhi and Rajiv Gandhi and said that the party's current stand will come as an indictment of previous Congress governments. Also, it will give political opponents of Congress a handle to throw muck at it.

"Na Jaat Par na paat par, Mohar lagegi haath par," Sharma quoted Indira Gandhi's clarion call of 1980.

He further quoted Rajiv Gandhi's historic call as the Opposition leader in the Lok Sabha in 1990, where the former PM said, "We have problems if caste is defined to enshrine casteism in our country. We have problems if casteism is going to be made a factor for Parliamentary

and Assembly constituencies. The Congress can not stand by and watch this nation being divided."

Meanwhile, The Congress party, led by its top brass including party President Mallikarjun Kharge, senior leaders Sonia Gandhi and Rahul Gandhi and Treasurer Ajay Maken held a press conference in the national Capital on Thursday and protested strongly against the party's funds being frozen by the Income Tax Department, allegedly with the blessings of the ruling dispensation at the Centre.

"The freezing of Congress funds is a criminal action and it has been done with the blessings of the country's top leadership. It is a clear attempt to cripple our election campaign," former Congress President, Rahul Gandhi said.

MP Rahul Gandhi told the Press that the party doesn't have money to fund its campaigns. "We don't have money to buy train tickets, we don't have money to send our leaders for campaigns," he said. The senior Congress leader also questioned the timing and quantum of punishment and stated, "For an old case of Rs 14 lakh, the government has imposed a penalty of Rs 200 crore."

80 pc Indian workers feel drained when they have a lot of meetings

About 80 per cent of Indian employees have said that they feel drained on days when they have a lot of meetings to attend, a new report revealed on Thursday.

According to the Australia-based software firm Atlassian Corporation, 90 per cent of Indian workers find it hard to get their work done on top of attending all their meetings.

"Teams that revert to old ways of working and schedule meetings without intentionality are going to see themselves fall behind effective teams who experiment and take advantage of dynamic async tools like Loom and Confluence," said Dom Price, Work Futurist, Atlassian.

The report surveyed 5,000 knowledge workers in India, the US, Australia, Germany and France (1,000 per market).

The report revealed that meetings are ineffective, with workers agreeing that meetings fail to accomplish their goals 60 per cent of the time.

Workers cited time spent in meetings as the number one barrier preventing them from completing their day-to-day tasks, which is ranked ahead of lack of motivation, unclear goals, unclear responsibilities, and unsure of who to work with.

About 70 per cent of Indian workers said they feel lonely at work, even when they attend lots of



meetings, compared to 55 per cent globally.

Around 82 per cent of workers believe most of their meetings could be done in half the time, the report noted. As per the report, 74 per cent of Indian workers have to work overtime at least a few days a week due to meeting overload, compared to 51 per cent globally.

SBI files fresh compliance affidavit in SC disclosing all details of Electoral Bonds

In a latest affidavit filed on Wednesday, the State Bank of India (SBI) told the Supreme Court that it has disclosed all the details of the Electoral Bonds which are in its possession and custody to the Election Commission of India (ECI).

The compliance affidavit sworn by SBI Chairman Dinesh Kumar Khara stated that the name of the purchaser, the denomination and specific number of the bond, the name of the political party, last four digits of the bank account number of political parties, and the denomination and number of the bond encashed, have now been revealed.

"The complete bank account numbers and KYC details of the political parties are not being made public as it may compromise the security of the account (cyber security). Similarly, KYC details of purchasers are also not being made public for security reasons...SBI has not disclosed all details and no details (other than complete account numbers & KYC details) have been withheld from disclosure," the affidavit said.

The SBI handed over two sealed



envelopes afresh to the poll body on Wednesday containing all details regarding purchasers of the Electoral Bonds and all details as regards the political parties who have encashed these Bonds.



WE'RE GOING TO TAKE SERIOUS VIEW: SC REBUKES TN GOV FOR REFUSING TO ADMINISTER OATH TO PONMUDI AS MINISTER

The Supreme Court on Thursday took strong exception to Tamil Nadu Governor's refusal to administer the oath to K Ponmudi as a minister in the state Cabinet.

"What is your Governor doing? The conviction of a minister has been stayed by the Supreme Court and the Governor says that 'I will not swear him in.' You tell the Governor that we will have to make some observations now. Please tell the Governor that we are going to take a very serious view of it," a Bench headed by Chief Justice of India (CJI), DY Chandrachud, told Attorney General (AG), R Venkataramani, the highest law officer of the Centre.

"How could the Governor say - after the Supreme Court has stayed the conviction - that his re-induction is against constitutional morality? We give time to the Governor till tomorrow. Mr. Attorney General, if we don't hear from you in a positive manner tomorrow, we will pass an order directing the Governor to act in accordance with the Constitution. We want to avoid that situation by giving the Governor an opportunity to set the constitutional position right," added the Bench, also comprising



Justices JB Pardiwala and Manoj Misra.

AG Venkataramani said that he was not justifying the Governor's action and would come back after looking

into the file and having a word with Governor RN Ravi.

He wondered if the relief sought could be granted in an interlocutory application filed by the state govern-

ment in a pending writ petition filed against the Governor.

Posting the matter for hearing on Friday, CJI Chandrachud said, "Mr. Attorney General, we are seriously concerned about the conduct of the Governor in the state. This is not the way because he is defying the Supreme Court of India. The two-judge Bench of the SC stayed the conviction. The Governor has no business to tell us that this does not wipe out the conviction and is non-existent."

"The Governor better be informed that when the Supreme Court of India has stayed the conviction, the law has to follow its course. We are deeply concerned with the manner in which this matter has proceeded at the level of Governor."

Former Higher Education Minister, K Ponmudi, had to relinquish his post after the Madras High Court convicted him in a Disproportionate Assets case in December last year.

The Supreme Court later stayed his conviction, following which Chief Minister, MK Stalin, sent a request to the Raj Bhavan for re-inducting Ponmudi as a minister in the state Cabinet. However, Governor RN Ravi refused to administer the oath of office to Ponmudi.

Govt warns social media influencers against endorsing offshore online betting, gambling

The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting on Thursday advised all endorsers and influencers on social media to refrain from promoting or advertising, including surrogate advertisements, of offshore online betting and gambling platforms.

According to the ministry, these advertisements have significant financial and socio-economic implications of online betting and gambling on consumers, particularly the youth.

The advisory cautioned that failure to comply with it may lead to proceedings under the provisions of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019, including removal or disabling of social media posts or accounts and penal action under the applicable statutes.



Further, the ministry has advised online advertisement intermediaries not to target such promotional content towards the Indian audience.

Social media intermediaries have also been advised to conduct sensitisation efforts among their users to refrain from publishing such content. Moreover, the ministry has reiterated the advisory by the Central Consumer Protection

Authority (CCPA) dated March 6, 2024, which had expressed concerns regarding endorsements of betting/gambling platforms by celebrities and influencers to endorse and promote their betting activities, and had cautioned that any such direct or indirect advertisement or endorsement shall be subject to rigorous scrutiny.

Budaun murders: Second accused arrested from Bareilly

Uttar Pradesh Police arrested Javed, the second accused in the Budaun double murder case, from Bareilly on Thursday.

Javed was on the run after the murder of two children on Tuesday evening. His brother and the main accused Sajid was gunned down in a police encounter within two hours of the incident.

Javed was arrested on Thursday, said IG Bareilly range R K Singh.

In a video after his arrest, he is heard saying, "I ran straight to Delhi after the incident and from there I have to come to Bareilly to surrender. I have received phone calls from people about what my brother did."

He claimed that he had no idea why his brother committed the crime. He said he fled



because he feared for his own life.

Javed is now being brought to Budaun for further interrogation.

RBI issues new rules for self-regulatory organisations of banks, NBFCs

The RBI on Thursday issued an omnibus framework for recognising self-regulatory organisations (SROs) for its regulated entities such as banks, NBFCs and housing finance companies.

The omnibus SRO framework prescribes the broad objectives, functions, eligibility criteria and governance standards, which will be common for all SROs, irrespective of the sector.

The framework also lays down the broad membership criteria and other terms and conditions to be followed by the SROs for grant of recognition by the Reserve Bank.



The framework states that an SRO is expected to adhere to a set of overarching objectives for betterment of the sector they represent, foster advancement and address critical industry concerns within the broader financial system.

In particular, an SRO is expected to achieve the following objectives:

- Promote a culture of compliance among its members by encouraging progressive practices and conventions. Special attention must be given on extending guidance and support, particularly to smaller entities within the sector.
- Act as the collective voice of its members in engagements with the Reserve Bank, government authorities or other regulatory and statutory bodies, in India.
- Collect and share relevant sectoral information to the Reserve Bank to aid in policy-making.
- Encourage a culture of research and development within the sector to encourage innovation while ensuring the highest standards of compliance and self-governance. The RBI also said that existing SROs that have already been recognised shall continue to be governed by the terms and conditions under which they were recognised, unless this framework is specifically extended to such SROs.

In the notice, she said, "I am a loyal citizen of India and I am not affiliated to any person or organisation which is against the sovereignty of the Union of India." Shabir Shah is presently lodged in jail in connection with a money laundering case related to terror funding in Kashmir.



B'uru: Law student commits suicide by jumping in front of Metro train

A student of the National School of Law here on Thursday committed suicide by jumping in front of a Metro train at the Attiguppe Metro Station, the police said.

The deceased has been identified as Dhruv Thakkar, aged around 20 years, from Mumbai, the police said, adding that preliminary investigation has suggested the incident to be a case of suicide.

DCP S. Girish, West Division, Bengaluru city, after conducting an inspection on the site of the incident, told the media that Dhruv Thakkar was a first-year student at the National School of Law in Bengaluru.

"At this stage, it appears as a case of suicide and further investigation will have to be conducted to ascertain why he committed suicide. We are checking CCTV footage and statements will have to be recorded," the police officer said.

Earlier, the Bengaluru Metro Rail Corporation Limited (BMRC) had said: "This is to inform that one person has jumped in front of the train at Attiguppe station at 2.10 p.m." According to sources, the head and body of the youth were found severed. His body got stuck under the Metro train as



his body was dragged by the running train. The deceased had come to the station with a female and male friend.

Eyewitnesses told police that Dhruv Thakkar was talking on a mobile phone, and when the train came, he suddenly jumped onto the track in front of the train.

Even as the INDIA bloc's seat sharing formula has not been finalised in Bihar, the RJD has given tickets to three candidates for the Lok Sabha elections.

RJD national president Lalu Prasad gave tickets to three candidates on Wednesday evening while one will be given the same on Thursday, party spokesperson Chitranjan Gagan said.

Electorate in Bihar will vote for the first phase of Lok Sabha elections on April 19, and the filing of nomination papers is currently underway since Wednesday.

The party has given ticket to Kumar Sarwajeet to contest from Gaya reserved seat. Kumar Sarwajeet was the agriculture minister in the Mahagathbandhan government.

He was appointed agriculture minister after the resignation of Sudhakar Singh. He is expected to contest against Hindustani Awam Morcha-Secular candidate and former chief minister Jitan Ram Manjhi.

Besides him, RJD has also given the ticket to Abhay Kushwaha to contest from Aurangabad, Archana Ravidas from Jamui (Reserved) and Shrawan Kushwaha Nawada Lok Sabha constituency.

Congress state president Akhilesh Singh met with RJD chief Lalu Prasad Yadav on Thursday to discuss the seat sharing formula.

Rajasthan: Five family members charred to death as LPG cylinder explodes

Five members of a family, including three minors, were burnt to death after an LPG cylinder exploded in Jaipur on Thursday morning.

None of the family members could come out of the house after the cylinder exploded as it was kept at a

room near the entrance gate, a police official said.

The incident took place at Jaisalya village in the Vishwakarma police station area at 7.30 a.m.

ACP Ashok Chauhan said after getting information about the incident, a police team rushed to the spot.

The deceased were identified as Rajesh (26), his wife

Ruby (24), Ishu (7), Dilkhush (2) and Khushmani (4). The family hailed from Bihar's Motihari district and was living here on rent.

A neighbour said that Rajesh had changed the cylinder in the morning and the incident might have occurred due to its incorrect installation.

Two fire brigades brought the fire under control in half-an-hour.

"Rajesh was working in a factory here. He went to Bihar on leave for a few days and came back on Wednesday evening," said the ACP.

Rajasthan Chief Minister Bhajanlal Sharma said, "The news of the untimely demise of five civilians due to the massive fire in Jaipur is heart-wrenching."

"I pray to Almighty God to grant peace to the departed souls and to give strength to the family members to bear the loss," the chief minister said. Meanwhile, police officials said the bodies will be handed over to the family members after postmortem.

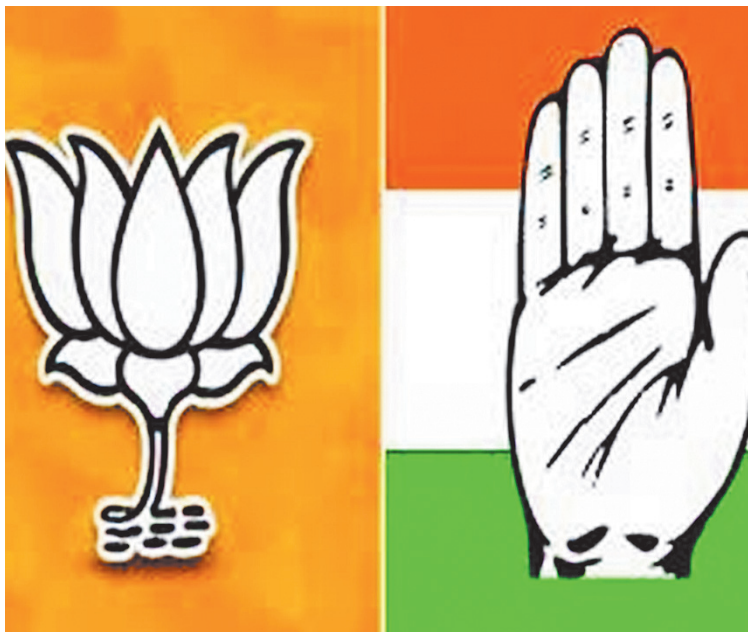
There is going to be an interesting contest on the Satna Lok Sabha seat of Madhya Pradesh. The rivals of the assembly elections held four months ago are once again face to face.

these 15 elections, seven times a person from a backward class won, while minorities also won twice. Congress last won here in 1991, when Arjun Singh was elected.

Ganesh Singh has been a four-time MP and is contesting for the fifth time. Siddharth Kushwaha's father Sukhlal Kushwaha has been a BSP MP from Satna. Satna parliamentary constituency has seven assembly constituencies out of which five are held by BJP and two by Congress.

In the assembly elections held about four months ago, there was a contest between BJP's Ganesh Singh and Congress's Siddharth Kushwaha on the Satna assembly seat. In this election, Kushwaha of Congress defeated Ganesh Singh by a margin of about five thousand votes. Here Bahujan Samaj Party had got more than 33 thousand votes.

From this it can be inferred that BSP also has a vote bank here.

Political analysts believe that backward class and upper caste voters are in almost equal position, in such a situation, since both the candidates belong to the backward class, the role of upper class voters can be decisive.

This election is also giving Ganesh Singh a chance to settle the score of defeat at the hands of Siddharth in the assembly elections.

BSP's one-time foot soldiers are now leaders in other parties

They had toiled day and night to build the party. They were handpicked by late Kanshi Ram for the Bahujan Samaj movement that he converted into a political campaign in 1984 when he formed the Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP).

Today, 40 years later, the foot soldiers of the BSP are leaders in other parties while the BSP is gasping for breath.

As the election campaign gains momentum, these one-time BSP leaders are drawing up strategies to ensure the victory of their party over the BSP.

Talking to IANS on condition of anonymity, one of the former BSP leaders said, "It is Mayawati who is solely responsible for reducing the BSP to a political nonentity. She strayed from the ideology of late Kanshi Ram, ignored those who subscribed to the party ideology and gave preference to outsiders. The loyalists naturally moved away and the party was reduced to its present position."

Dinanath Bhaskar, one of the founding members of BSP and a close and trusted associate of late Kanshi Ram, was a minister in the first SP-BSP government in 1993.

As Mayawati moved to the centre stage of politics in the BSP in 1996, Bhaskar quit the party and joined the Samajwadi Party. In 2015, he walked out of the SP and joined the BJP. Today,



he is a BJP MLA from the Aurai Assembly segment. Raj Bahadur, once a state BSP president, was known for his proximity to late Kanshi Ram but in 1995 when Mayawati became chief minister for the first time, he moved away and later joined the Congress. Dr Masood, was the education minister in the Mayawati government in 1993. Later he was expelled from the party and his political journey later took him to the SP, RLD

and then Congress.

R.K. Chaudhary, one of the tallest BSP leaders during the time Kanshi Ram called the shots, was expelled from the BSP in 2001, called back later and shown the door again.

He then joined the Congress and is now with Samajwadi Party. He is the party's candidate from the Mohanlalganj seat and will be challenging Union Minister Kaushal Kishore.

Om Prakash Rajbhar was one of the BSP's foot soldiers in the early years. He left the party in 2001, joined the Apna Dal and now heads his own party -- Suheldev Bharatiya Samaj Party (SBSP). He prides himself as a kingmaker in contemporary state politics and knows the art of remaining in the news.

Babu Singh Kushwaha, once a trusted lieutenant of Mayawati, fell out of favour when his name emerged in the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) scam in 2011. Today he heads the Jan Adhikar party and continues to work for his community.

Two senior BSP leaders, who faced Mayawati's wrath for unexplained reasons in 2020, are Lalji Varma and Ram Achal Rajbhar. Today, both are senior members in Samajwadi Party and Lalji Varma is the party candidate from Ambedkar Nagar.

Former BSP Minister Inderjit Saroj is another leader who made his way from BSP to SP.

While SP has been the main beneficiary of exits from the BSP, the BJP has also gained leaders from Mayawati's party.

Deputy Chief Minister Brajesh Pathak started his political career in the BSP and now is among the top state leaders in the BJP.

BJP Minister Jaiveer Singh also has his roots in the BSP. Two former BSP ministers, Naseemuddin Siddiqui and Nakul Dubey, have found a haven for themselves in the Congress.

Controversies apart, supporters of Brij Bhushan confident about his LS ticket

BJP MP Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh's sprawling home 'Shakti Bhawan' in Gonda, is bustling with activity even in his absence. Singh's ticket has not yet been announced by the BJP for the upcoming Lok Sabha elections but there is no uncertainty in the air.

Supporters of the six-term MP are confident. "Chunav to ladna hi hai," says one of them rather confidently before another supporter asks him to keep quiet.

Singh himself has been overly active on the social media in recent weeks, posting photographs with his grandchildren and presently a 'family man' picture of himself.

A little away from Singh's residence, at a tea kiosk, people are more vocal. "He is sure to win whether he gets a ticket or not. Even if his son Prateek Bhushan contests, victory is sure. That is why no one is worried about the delay. Besides, the Samajwadi Party is waiting with open arms to welcome Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh," says the tea stall owner on phone as his 'boys' bustle around



attending to customers.

The Samajwadi Party has not named a candidate for the Kaiserganj seat yet and the buzz is that the state's main opposition

party is ready to back the 67-year-old wrestler-turned-politician if the BJP chooses to drop him.

His winnability factor makes him an acceptable choice for other parties.

That Singh does not welcome queries from the media about his political future and the status of his case related to sexual harassment, is evident from the several skirmishes he has had in the past few months with media persons.

However, it is also noteworthy that ever since Singh has been facing charges from wrestlers, not a single senior BJP leader has opposed him publicly which confirms the kind of clout he wields within the party. Political analysts feel that dropping Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, this time, may have an adverse impact on, at least, four to five seats in eastern UP because he enjoys immense influence in the region.

US says it recognises Arunachal Pradesh as Indian territory

Recognising Arunachal Pradesh as Indian territory, the US has said that it "strongly opposes" any unilateral attempts to advance territorial claims across the Line of Actual Control (LAC). The remarks came with Beijing repeatedly asserting that it "never acknowledges and firmly opposes" the "so-called Arunachal Pradesh illegally established by India", following Prime Minister Narendra Modi's recent visit to the state.

"US recognises Arunachal Pradesh as Indian territory and we strongly oppose any unilateral attempts to advance territorial claims by incursions or encroachments military or



civilian, across LAC," State Department Principal Deputy Spokesperson, Vedant Patel, said. Having routinely objected to Indian leaders' visits to the state in the past, Chinese

Foreign Ministry spokesperson Wang Wenbin said that it "strongly deplored" PM Modi's visit and India's move would "only complicate" the boundary issue.

In response, India rejected Wenbin's comments and said that the Chinese side has been made aware of India's "consistent position on Arunachal several occasions."

This week, New Delhi lashed out at Beijing for "advancing absurd claims" over the territory of Arunachal Pradesh and reiterated that the northeastern state will always remain its "integral and inalienable part" of India.

"We have noted the comments made by the Spokesperson of the Chinese Defence Ministry advancing absurd claims over the territory of the Indian State of Arunachal Pradesh," the Ministry of External Affairs said.

Blinken to visit Tel Aviv on Friday for talks on hostage deal, Rafah operation

US Secretary of State, Antony Blinken, will visit Israel on Friday and meet the Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and other senior leaders.

Blinken will also be meeting senior Egyptian and Saudi leaders on Thursday in Cairo and Riyadh respectively.

The visit of Blinken, the most powerful leader of the US, to the Middle eastern countries, including Israel, is to communicate to the concerned parties and mediators on the American viewpoint regarding the hostage deal as well as on the probable ground invasion of Israel Defense Forces (IDF) in Rafah area.

US President Joe Biden has recently spoken to Netanyahu not to push forward with the Rafah ground operations as it would lead to the death of a large number of Palestinian civilians, including women and children.

An estimated 1.3 million civilian population is living in Rafah area of the Gaza Strip and the idea of Israeli troops is to evacuate the civilian population to the north of Rafah.

However, Egypt has told the Israeli and American authorities of its strict opposition to the Rafah operation since it would lead to a huge refugee exodus to its territory in Sinai region bordering Rafah.

Meanwhile, the indirect mediatory talk between Israel and Hamas is continuing in Doha, Qatar.

Israel is taking a tough stand and not agreeing to many of the demands put forward by Hamas regarding the hostage deal and therefore, the mediatory talks are not progressing smoothly.

Sources in the Israel Defence Ministry told repote that the talks would progress only on the terms put forward by the Israeli side.

Israel has demanded a two-step release of all the hostages in the custody of Hamas and has told the mediators that Palestinian prisoners kept in Israeli jails charged with heinous crimes cannot be released.

According to sources in Israel Defence Ministry, the Israel intelligence agencies, including the Mossad, Shin Bet and the military



intelligence had informed the Israel government that Hamas was completely collapsed and the Rafah area is the key to defeat the remaining resistance of the militant outfit.

It has also reported that Hamas has only four army battalions remaining in the Rafah area and if they are also destroyed, then there was no other option for Hamas but only to surrender to Israel.

The Israel Defence Minister, Yoav Gallant, considered a hawk among the Israeli leadership, has again called on the IDF to look out for Hamas leader Yahya Sinwar and neutralise him.

It remains to be seen how Blinken will be able to prevent an impending ground offensive from a highly confident Israeli army in the Rafah region.

Eight injured as Russia's missiles hit Kiev

At least eight people were injured after Russian missiles hit the Ukrainian capital early Thursday "Eight people have been injured in the attack. Medics provided aid to them on the spot," Kiev Mayor Vitali Klitschko posted on Telegram, Ukrinform reported. Several explosions were heard in Kiev. The Kiev city military administration said that air defence is operating in the city and the region. The missile fragments fell on a kindergarten in the Sviatoshynskiy district and on the territory of an enterprise in the Podilskiy district.

Cars were set on fire in the Shevchenkivskiy district. As a result of falling missile debris, a fire was reported at a transformer substation and in a two-



storey non-residential building in the Podilskiy district. According to Kyiv City Military Administration, roof of a residential building caught fire in the Podilskiy

district. In the Sviatoshynskiy district, the explosions wave smashed windows in two nine-storey buildings, but there is no fire. Details are awaited.

S. Korea to suspend licence of defiant trainee doctors from next week

South Korea's health ministry on Thursday said it would begin suspending the medical licences of trainee doctors who have defied a return-to-work order from next week, as the government pushed ahead with its plan to hike the number of medical students.

A month-long walkout by trainee doctors in protest of the hike in medical school enrollment appeared to slide into a territory of little compromise as the government allocated on Wednesday an additional 2,000 medical school admission seats to universities across the nation, Yonhap news agency reported.

The ministry sent prior notices of licence suspension to some 5,000 trainee doctors, and they are required to submit opinions on the punitive step by next Monday. After that, the ministry will be allowed to send



formal notices of licence suspension.

"Starting next week, the government will take measures to suspend the licence under the principle regarding violation of the return-to-work order," Second Vice Health Minister Park Min-soo was quoted as saying to reporters.

"We urge junior doctors to return to their training hospitals, not only for the sake of patients, but for your col-

leagues who are filling in for your vacancies, and for yourselves who have chosen the career of medicine," Park said.

About 90 per cent of the 13,000 interns and resident doctors have remained off the job since February 20, forcing surgeries and other public health services to be cancelled or delayed at major hospitals. Park also cautioned that interns who fail to register in the training management system of hospitals by the end of this month will not be eligible to become residents next year, the report said.

As junior doctors are also required to undergo additional training in the event of a gap exceeding one month, Park noted that the suspension of their licences would affect their careers. The government has been pushing to sharply raise the number of medical students to brace for the country's fast-ageing population, and a shortage of physicians in rural areas and essential areas, such as paediatrics and emergency departments. Doctors, on the other hand, say the quota hikes will undermine the quality of medical education and result in higher medical costs for patients. They have called for measures to first address the underpaid specialists and improve legal protection against excessive medical malpractice lawsuits.

2 soldiers killed, 15 injured in suicide attack in Pakistan

Two soldiers were killed and 15 others injured in a suicide attack in Pakistan's northwestern province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on Thursday, official sources confirmed.

The incident happened in Dera Ismail Khan district of the province when some unknown militants opened fire at a convoy of security forces, Xinhua news agency reported, citing sources from the Counter Terrorism Department.

The firing was followed by the suicide attack in which the two soldiers including a military driver were killed, the sources added. The area had been cordoned off for investigations. No group has claimed responsibility for the attack yet.



Maha allows free shoots on govt premises; B-Town celebrates

In a major initiative, the Maharashtra government has bowed to a long-pending demand of the Indian film industry - permitting free shootings of films and tele-series on all its premises across the state, as per an official announcement.

Indian Motion Pictures Producers Association (IMPPA) President Abhay Sinha said that the state government issued the orders on March 16 to the effect, which has been widely welcomed by the film fraternity.

"Now, no fees shall be levied for carrying out shooting on any government or semi-government lands, locales and buildings anywhere in the state for films, documentaries, teleserials or even advertisements, by any film-makers from anywhere in India," Sinha told correspondent.

However, the concession will not apply to the famed Dadasaheb Phalke Chitranagari in Mumbai and the Chitranagari in Kolhapur, where the regular charges for all types of shootings shall be applicable.

Continuing its ease of doing business even for the film industry, the government has implemented a 'single window scheme' (SWC), for any shooting proposals for state properties submitted by any producers for any language film from anywhere in India.

"Through this SWC, we can freely shoot anywhere in the state... This will showcase Maharashtra in a big way, indirectly boost tourism and allied sector, plus help boost the image of the state, its people, culture and picturesque locations," smiled Sinha.



Earlier, the producers had to shell out minimum Rs 40,000-Rs 50,000 for a day's shoot at any government locations which would be a direct saving, but presently only state-owned places have been opened, with hopes that even Centre-owned premises here may also follow suit.

"All government, semi-government, local self-government bodies, aided institutions, corporations, etc. should provide free of charge for shooting movies, televisions, advertisements, and commercials in other languages, including Marathi and foreign languages," said an official order.

Certain government departments have enacted laws specifying charges for filming activities which shall be changed in the next session of the Maharashtra Legislature.

However, though there will be no fees for shoot-

ing, a nominal security deposit will have to be paid with each application - Rs 40,000 for commercials, Rs 100,000 for teleserials and Rs 250,000 for feature films.

This is to ensure that after the shooting, the premises are left clean and in case of any damage to the public properties, it will be recovered from the security deposit.

Sinha explained that on an average, 500 feature films are made in India each year in multiple languages, and more than 100 are produced in Mumbai alone.

Officials said that Mumbai has over 500 production houses, 250 theatres and multiplexes, and 150 cinema halls which provide huge employment through a well-established ecosystem for the expensive film production processes.

Through the SWC, the Maharashtra Film, Theatre and Cultural Development Corporation earns around Rs 8-10 crore per annum through filming process activities.

Bollywood circles say many places in the state, including beaches, forts, lakes, forests, historical monuments, memorials, sanctuaries, skyscrapers of Mumbai, Thane, Navi Mumbai, promenades, mega-infrastructure sites or bridges, etc. are popular among film-makers, depending on their requirements.

Presently, free filming on government properties is allowed in Andhra Pradesh and Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh gives certain concessions to local producers, while Maharashtra is contemplating subsidies to Marathi film production, as part of the larger strategy to make the state a "global film destination".

Shiv Sena MP urges Oppn not to oppose Dharavi redevelopment for political mileage

Shiv Sena MP Rahul Shewale from Mumbai South Central Lok Sabha seat, who is likely to be renominated, has appealed to the opposition not to oppose the redevelopment of Dharavi slum only for scoring some political points.

Dharavi is one of the six Assembly constituencies in Mumbai South Central and the redevelopment is a leading electoral plank to be flagged off by the MahaYuti and Maha Vikas Aghadi during campaigning.

"Don't try to stop the Dharavi redevelopment process by spreading false information just for the sake of politics. Otherwise the people of Dharavi and future generations will never forgive you," warned Shewale. He further said, "People are being misled by the opposition by spreading false information against the survey that has started in Dharavi."

Shewale's statement came days after the Congress and Shiv Sena Uddhav Balasaheb Thackeray stepped up their attack against the Dharavi redevelop-



ment. Further, his appeal to the opposition coincided with the launch of survey by the Dharavi Redevelopment Project Pvt Ltd (DRPPL), a joint venture between the Maharashtra government and the Adani Group, to collect data from lakhs of informal tenement residents of Dharavi. The survey started from Kamla Raman Nagar in Dharavi on Monday.

"The opposition was shocked by the positive responses given by the Dharavikars during the survey. Therefore, they have started spreading confusion among the people by making baseless allegations. Kamala Raman Nagar is a part of the Dharavi Notified Area and the Slum Rehabilitation Authority had conducted a survey here before," said Shewale.

He said that since the Dharavi Redevelopment Project has been given the status of a special project, everyone here will get a home based on the state government's decision regarding eligible and ineligible residents. He urged the Dharavikars to cooperate during the ongoing survey without falling prey to false propaganda.

Maharashtra AAP women's wing president Seema Gutte switches to Congress

Rabale police station official said. "He also extorted Rs 5 lakh from her. A case under Indian Penal Code sections 376(2)(n) (rape repeatedly on the same woman), 384 (extortion) 328 (causing hurt by means of poison) 506 (2) (criminal intimidation) and 504 (intentional insult with intent to provoke breach of the peace) has been registered," the official said, the news agency reported on Thursday. The accused is yet to be arrested, the Rabale police station official added.

Uddhav Thackeray meets Chhatrapati Shrimant Shahu Maharaj in Kolhapur

In a warm gesture, barely two weeks ago, the Chhatrapati's son, Sambhajiraje Chhatrapati bowed out of the poll race after it became clear that his father would be the MVA candidate from Kolhapur and promised to work for his victory.

Body massager can't be categorised as adult sex toy, be prohibited for import: Court

A body massager cannot be categorised as an adult sex toy and hence cannot be included in the list of items prohibited for import, the Bombay High Court has said.

A division bench of Justices Girish Kulkarni and Kishor Sant on Wednesday quashed an order passed by the Customs department confiscating consignments containing body massagers.

The Commissioner of Customs had confiscated the goods claiming that the body massagers could be used as adult sex toys and such items are prohibited for import.

Opining that a body massager could be used as an adult sex toy was clearly the figment of imagination of the Commissioner of Customs, the high court said. It dismissed a petition filed by the Commissioner of Customs, challenging a May 2023 order passed by the Central Excise and Service Tax Appellate Tribunal whereby the Custom department's order confiscating consignments containing body massagers was set aside.

The Commissioner of Customs as adjudicating officer had in April 2022 refused to clear the consignment containing body massagers noting that they were adult sex toys and hence prohibited for import as per the Customs notification issued in



January 1964. The high court noted that the findings recorded by the commissioner are "peculiar and clearly appear to be quite astonishing and too far-fetched, when he reduces in writing his vivid imagination on what an equipment for a body massage would

be and more particularly on his perception on the perceived uses." "It was clearly the figment of the Commissioner's imagination and/or his personal perception that the goods are prohibited items," the high court said.

Mumbai hospital saves Nepal infant girl's gangrenous arm from amputation

A prominent Mumbai hospital saved the arm and hand of a two-month-old girl from Nepal who was born with medical complications after birth leading to gangrene, from amputation, officials said here on Thursday.

Soon after birth, the child developed severe cellulitis on the left arm which led to infection and resulted in gangrene (necrosis) on the entire arm, alarming the parents.

The skin of the entire forearm had turned black, leading to deterioration of the child's health, and doctors at a major hospital in Kathmandu advised amputation of the limb to save her life. Unwilling to amputate their tiny girl's arm, barely three weeks after her birth, they rushed her from Nepal to Mumbai's Bai Jerbai Wadia Hospital for Children (BJWHC) and immediately examined by Consultant Surgeon, Dr. Nilesh Satbhai. "We decided to salvage the limb and as soon as her medical condition permitted, we cleaned up the wounds, removed all the dead tissues and reduced the source of infection. Then we planned for wound cover and reconstruction in multiple surgical stages," said Dr. Satbhai. After the first stage of the wound debridement, it was washed multiple times and then covered

with a large abdominal flap which almost fully covered the arm, by the time the child turned one month old. The flap was kept for another three weeks and underwent a two-stage process that ensured the entire wound was covered on both sides of the child's arm. All these complex and multiple surgeries were performed in a span of five weeks, though the anaesthesia management for the major surgery on the infant was extremely challenging and critical, he added.

After all the procedures were completed, the child's arm was saved from a potential amputation, and she became stable and started achieving normal developmental milestones. "Her hand was salvaged due to timely surgical intervention and wound cover. Secondary reconstructive procedures will be needed for further functions as the child grows up. Not treating her at the right time could have led to amputation and lifelong disability," said Dr Satbhai. Later, the medicos learnt that the child's mother had a bad obstetric history and out of six previous pregnancies, she had lost four children, but the exact cause of her infant's skin necrosis is not known yet.

Cellulitis is a bacterial infection that occurs in the skin layers, often manifests as painful, hot, red swelling on the body.

The main culprits behind cellulitis are Staphylococcus and Streptococcus bacteria, but antibiotics are usually effective, though in some cases, cellulitis can deteriorate rapidly if left untreated or unresponsive to antibiotics. This escalation could result in a critical medical situation and potentially a life-threatening outcome when medical expertise and advanced technology were deployed for the Nepal baby, said BJWHC CEO, Dr. Minnie Bodhanwala. In this child's case, the cellulitis led to a flesh-eating disease, "necrotizing fasciitis" which is an infection in the deepest layer of skin spreading to the connective tissue that surrounds your muscles and organs, that could result in gangrene (tissue death), and in more extreme cases, require amputation. The distraught parents, including father Abdul Awwal, are now smiling and happy and full of gratitude to the BJWHC authorities for saving the arm of their child whom they have decided to name 'Tamannah'.

Raj Thackeray meets CM Shinde, DY CM Fadnavis amid speculation of tie-up

Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, and MNS leader Raj Thackeray met on Thursday amid rumours over a possible alliance ahead of the Lok Sabha elections. The meeting took place at the Taj Lands End in Mumbai's district of

Bandra. Earlier, MNS leader Raj Thackeray met with Union Home Minister Amit Shah in New Delhi, suggesting a possible coalition with the BJP in the Lok Sabha elections 2024 to strengthen the alliance in Maharashtra. Senior MNS leader Bala Nandgaonkar described Shah and Thackeray's meetings as "positive," indicating development.

Raj Thackeray previously separated away from the Shiv Sena, led by his cousin

Uddhav Thackeray, and created the MNS in 2006. If the alliance is formed, the MNS is likely to be given one seat to contest from Mumbai, the PTI report added. The report further stated that Lok Sabha elections 2024 in Maharashtra will be held in five phases beginning April 19, April 26, May 7, May 13, and May 20, with vote counting set for June 4.

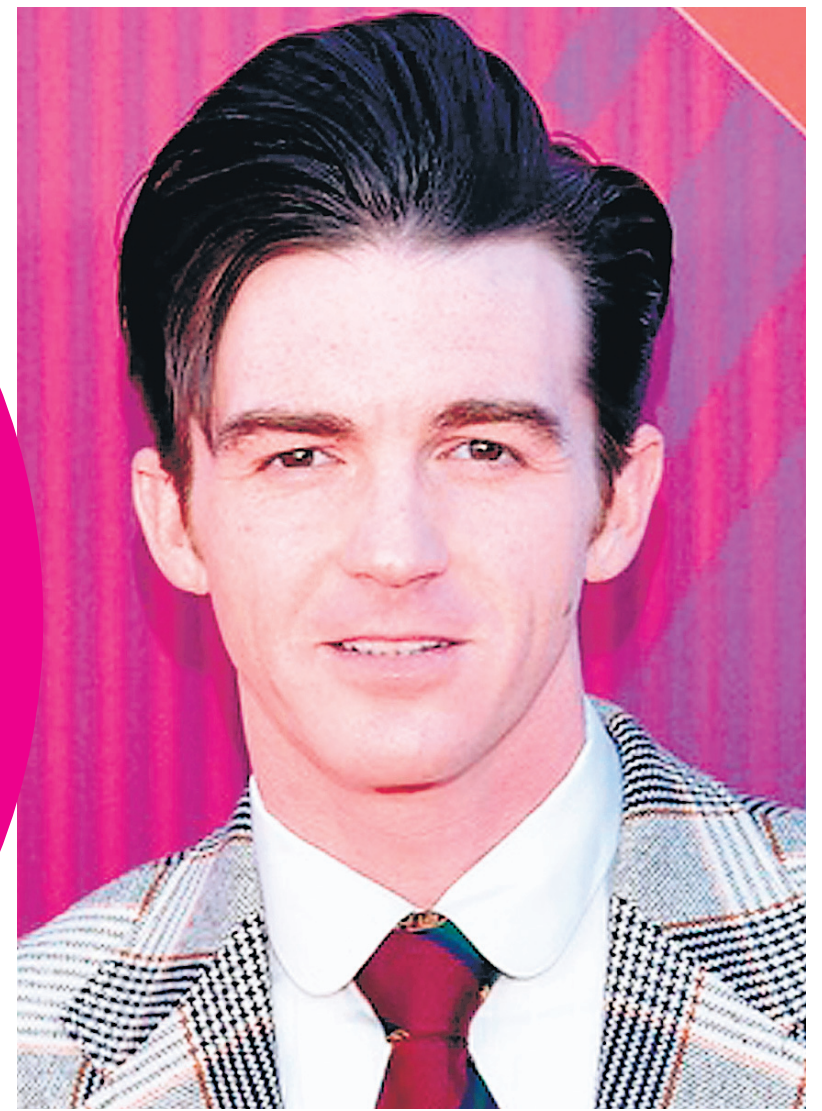

KEVIN BACON'S MEMORIES OF FILMING 'FRIDAY THE 13TH': A VERY SMALL BATHING SUIT

Actor Kevin Bacon went down memory lane as he recalled his beginnings in the industry with the iconic slasher film 'Friday the 13th'.

"There was no way I was surviving," the actor quipped, when asked about getting attacked by the character Jason on his podcast. Among the memorable deaths in the 1980 'Friday the 13th' instalment, Bacon's character Jack is stabbed in the throat with an arrow through a mattress while he lies atop it, reports people.com.

"I wasn't gonna stick around in that movie for very long," Bacon said, considering the vices his teenage camp counselor character indulged in "the combination of the speedo and the marijuana and the sex," he quipped.

"There was such a trope in horror movies that continued forever, and that was that if you had sex or did drugs, you were definitely gonna die." Over 40 years later, the swimming trunk holds a special place in some memories.

Answering a question about a scene where Jack dives headfirst into the camp's lake, "when everyone else jumped in... I'm not a diver by any stretch of the imagination." Anyone rewatching the film now "could see a very small bathing suit and a very bad

dive," said Bacon. "I remember a few years ago there was a meme of how bad my dive was... absolutely terrible." Bacon also talked about him and his co-stars Adrienne King, Harry Crosby, Jeannine Taylor, Laurie Bartram and Mark Nelson that they had only one chance to capture their group jump into the water.

"I could have done better," he said. "But I think the whole thing was that our hair was supposed to be dry, so we had to do it in one take." As for the famously iconic skimpy swimming trunk, which left little to the imagination, Bacon said: "We always had tiny little bathing suits. That was just what bathing suits were!"





The first feeling is I am happy that I am alive', says Pant on returning to lead Delhi Capitals

Rishabh Pant, who is returning to action after 14 months of being on a recovery route from multiple injuries suffered in a near-fatal car crash, has expressed his sentiments on his much-awaited return, saying he is happy that "he is alive" and want to enjoy the moment.

Pant, who is back as the captain of Delhi Capitals, underwent an extensive rehabilitation and recovery process at the National Cricket Academy (NCA) in Bengaluru following a road accident in December 2022.

Speaking on how it feels like to come back to the game after the car accident, Pant recalled the days when used to walk with crutches and added that he can't describe the feeling when he first held a bat after his accident.

"The bigger picture was that I had been walking using crutches, then I didn't need them. Then I began walking, then began jogging and then running. Then batting and then wicketkeeping. I don't remember those particular dates, but definitely remember the moments," Pant said on JioCinema.

"I can't describe the feeling when I first held a bat post the accident. It was amazing. You get mesmerised because of something. The feeling was like that. I didn't feel that I was playing for the first time, but it also didn't feel like I had played before. There



was a different sort of energy and feeling," he added.

Asked if he feels any pressure returning to DC, the wicketkeeper-batter said, "The first feeling is I am happy that I am alive. If you are not alive, how can you even think of anything else. So, it's important to go with the flow and enjoy these moments."

He further revealed how he coped with the injuries and admitted that there was frustration and anger but he started focussing more on the journey instead of thinking about the destination.

"When the journey is so long, you do get frustrated. With us, we are always looking for the destination. You should enjoy the journey. When you go out to practice, then how does the bat feel in your

hand, while keeping, how does it feel to have the ball in your gloves. If we start enjoying these things, then you are surrounded by positivity," said Pant.

Pant also recalled the moments when he came to know that DC had spent Rs 1.9 crore on him at the 2016 auction.

"There was nervousness about the auction as we were playing the U-19 World Cup. We used to keep bantering about the auction. Sarfaraz (Khan) went out of the field during the drinks break and when he returned, he informed me that I was picked for Rs 1.9 crore. I told him these kinds of jokes won't work. But when we came back and I got to know, it was a really nice feeling," he said.

Further speaking on his relationship with MS Dhoni, Pant said he learnt that transfer of energy is important and one can't build that connection over phone.

"I am learning from him that one-on-one interactions are different from those on the phone. The transfer of energy is more important. You can't build that connection on the phone."

Delhi will open its IPL 2024 campaign on March 23 against Punjab Kings, which will be Pant's first assignment in 14 months. "I am nervous, I am excited. It's a mixed feeling. So, I don't want my mind to start straying in too many directions. I want to keep it simple," he added.

CSK secured the services of Gaikwad at the IPL 2019 player auction and since then he hasn't disappointed with the bat and will now lead the squad.

Gaikwad in a video posted by CSK, X (formerly Twitter) handle looked confident and felt privileged to get the charge of leading the team in the season-opener against Royal Challengers Bengaluru (RCB) on Friday.

"It feels good, obviously it's a privilege to lead the team. It's a huge responsibility and I am really excited because of the kind of group we have. Everyone's experienced enough, so not much to worry about," said Gaikwad in a video posted by CSK on X.

"I have Mahi bhai in the team, Jaddu bhai (Ravindra Jadeja), Ajju bhai (Ajinkya Rahane), so nothing much to worry about. I am just



looking forward to enjoying it," said Gaikwad.

Gaikwad has played 52 matches in his IPL career so far and scored 1797 runs, with an average of 39.07, with his highest IPL score being 101 not out. In the IPL Auction 2024, Chennai acquired him for Rs 6.00 crore.

Sr Women's Hockey Nationals: Haryana to play Jharkhand; MP face Maharashtra in semis

Haryana is set to face Jharkhand while Madhya Pradesh will take on Maharashtra in the semis of the 14th Hockey India Senior Women National Championship scheduled to take place on Friday.

Haryana, the most dominant side in the tournament so far and consisting of 11 international players, reached the quarter-final by defeating Odisha 4-1. Haryana progressed to the knockout round after defeating Assam 15-0 and Le Puducherry 22-0 to top Pool D.

"We won quite comfortably in the group stage but we faltered a little bit in the quarters against Odisha. I think if we can do better defensively and not give away too many penalty corners the way we did in the quarters, we should have a good semi-final. Jharkhand is a wonderful team but if we execute our plans and convert the scoring opportunities we get, I am sure we will do well," Haryana Coach Azad Singh Malik said ahead of their semis clash against Jharkhand.

It must be mentioned that Haryana lost 1-2 to Jharkhand in the 3rd/4th place playoff in the previous edition of the tournament.



Jharkhand posted a commanding win over Andhra Pradesh 13-0 before drawing with Uttar Pradesh 2-2 to top Pool C based on a higher goal difference than Uttar Pradesh. They then went on to defeat Mizoram 2-1 in a closely contested quarter-final to set up a semi-final clash with Haryana. Jharkhand coach Sumrai Tete spoke about the team's performance and how they were going to approach the semis. She said, "The Quarter-Final was a great game. We have

played a couple of tight games in this tournament and it has helped us learn to deal with pressure. Haryana is a top-quality team filled with international players, but we have a few of them too and are certainly second to none on ability. We beat them last year and will look to repeat the performance this year."

The reigning Champions, Madhya Pradesh, secured a spot in the semis following a gripping 1-1 (4-3 SO) victory against Bengal in the quarters.

Prior to this, they emerged as leaders of Pool A by defeating Chhattisgarh with a score of 8-0 and triumphing over Bihar with a 7-1 victory.

Speaking ahead of the semis against Maharashtra, a side they defeated 5-1 in last year's Hockey India Senior Women National Championship to win the trophy, coach Paramjit Singh said, "We played the quarter-final after a break of six days and were a bit rusty. We didn't convert the multiple chances we got and that's why the game was such a close one.

I think if we do better in that aspect we can be in more control of the game. It is wonderful to be in the semis again and the players will be very happy with the opportunity. We will go all out and look to cement a place in the final."

Hosts Maharashtra beat Delhi 3-0 and Kerala 10-0 to top Pool B and set up a clash with Manipur in the quarter-finals. They beat Manipur 2-1 to qualify for the semis. They will next take on Madhya Pradesh, a team they lost against in the final in last year's edition of the tournament, in the semis.

Ex-Real Madrid and Man City star Robinho to serve 9-year prison sentence for rape: Reports

Ex-Real Madrid and Manchester City forward Robinho will have to serve a nine-year prison sentence for rape in Brazil, the court ruled.

In 2017, Robinho was sentenced in Italy to nine years in prison for his part in a group sexual assault of a 22-year-old Albanian woman in 2013, when he played for AC Milan.

But at the time he had already travelled to his homeland Brazil, which does not extradite its nationals. As a result, Italy sought his imprisonment in his home nation.

A Brazilian court, following a request from Italy, has now ruled that he must serve out the prison sentence in Brazil, judges on Brazil's Superior Court of Justice voted 9-2 to validate Robinho's conviction, Sky news reported.

Eight of the 10 votes cast in the Superior Tribunal of Justice (STJ) case were in favour of Robinho's arrest and serving of the sentence



on home soil. Robinho's lawyer, Jose Eduardo Alckmin, stated in court that his client seeks a retrial in Brazil on the basis of national sovereignty, indicating potential appeal to the country's Supreme Court. The ex-Brazilian international, who has 100 national

caps, won two La Liga championships during his four-year tenure with Real Madrid. He later transferred to Manchester City in September 2008 for a then-British record fee of £32.5 million on transfer deadline day.

Osaka sweeps past Cocciaretto; Rogers beats Fruhirtova in Miami

Four-time Grand Slam champion Naomi Osaka swept past Italian Elisabetta Cocciaretto 6-4, 6-3 on her return to the Magic City after maternity leave to reach the second round at Miami Open.

She took just 1 hour and 18 minutes to defeat World No.51 Cocciaretto on Wednesday. In seven appearances at the Miami Open Osaka has never lost an opening match. The Japanese last played the Miami Open in 2022, where she beat Angelique Kerber, Danielle Collins and Belinda Bencic before finishing runner-up to Iga Swiatek. At the end of that year, Osaka began her maternity leave, and she gave birth to daughter Shai in July 2023.

Osaka returned to the tour this season, so far, her best result was reaching the quarterfinals at Doha.

The 26-year-old will now have a second-round showdown against another returning

mom, No.15 seed Elina Svitolina. The Ukrainian came back from her own maternity leave less than a year ago and is already back inside the Top 20.

Later, American Shelby Rogers outlasted Czech teenager Linda Fruhirtova 4-6, 6-4, 6-2 in first-round action.

Rogers was sidelined for the second half of 2023 after Wimbledon as she underwent a second career knee surgery in the summer. She lost to Emma Raducanu in the first round of the Australian Open in her return to the tour this year, WTA reports.

The American will next face 2021 Roland Garros finalist and Anastasia Pavlyuchenkova in the second-round.

Earlier in the day, the opening Stadium match had Florida native Sloane Stephens celebrating her 31st birthday by defeating 6-2, 6-3 German Angelique Kerber, another former WTA No.1, who is coming back after giving birth to her daughter just over one year ago.

Indoor Championships with the best jump of 6.23m. She won the silver medal last year at the 37th National Games in Goa with a best jump of 6.52m.
