# Putin wins record landslide in Russian election, early results show

Putin's hold on power is not under threat in the election. Aged 71 and in office as president or prime minister since the last day of 1999, he

The early result means Putin, 71, will easily secure a new six-year term that would enable him to overtake Josef Stalin and become Russia's longest-serving leader for more than 200 years.

## BJP TO CONTEST 17 SEATS, JD(U) 16 IN BIHAR

As per the Election Commission's schedule, the polling dates in Bihar are April 19, 26, May 7, 13, 20, 25 and June 1. BJP leader Bihar's Deputy CM Samrat Choudhary, speaking to the press, asserted that the Narendra Modi government will return to power with a thumping mandate in the 2024 elections and Bihar will give all 40 seats to the NDA alliance.

A skin condition characterised by thickening, dark pigmentation, and velvety appearance of the skin at the nape of the neck among people with Type 2 diabetes may indicate a higher risk of liver cell damage (fibrosis), said researchers from Fortis C-DOC hospital for Diabetes and Allied Sciences and AIIMS on Monday. The study, published in the journal Primary Care Diabetes showed that 'Acanthosis Nigricans has the potential to be used as an easy-to-identify clinical marker for risk of hepatic fat and fibrosis in Asian Indians with type 2 diabetes, allowing

for early detection and management strategies". "In this case-control study involving patients with Type 2 diabetes, we made important observations indicating an independent association between the presence of Acanthosis Nigricans and hepatic steatosis and fibrosis (adverse markers of liver damage)," said Dr Anoop Misra, Padma Shri, co-author of the

study and Executive Chairman & Director, Diabetes and Endocrinology, Fortis C-Doc Hospital, in a statement. For the study, the team examined 300 people with Type 2 diabetes and with Acanthosis Nigricans, and those without the skin condition. They found that the skin issue is more common in women, overweight/obese individuals, and those with a family history of type 2 diabetes. The correlation with severity of neck Acanthosis Nigricans was found to be "strongest, with fasting insulin and glucose levels, and insulin resistance as compared to the disease at other sites, that is, axilla, and knuckles."









# KAMAL NATH'S CLOSE AIDE SYED JAFAR JOINS BJP IN MP

In a jolt to the Congress in Madhya Pradesh, its state spokesperson and a trusted aide of former Chief Minister Kamal Nath, Syed Jafar on Monday quit the party and joined the BJP.

Syed Jafar arrived at the BJP headquarters here, where he was welcomed by state president V.D. Sharma. Chief Minister Mohan Yadav, party's co-in-charge for Madhya Pradesh, Satish Upadhyay and senior leader Narottam Mishra, who is chairman of the party's joining committee, were also present on the occasion.

Jafar, who had often been vocal against the BJP's governance at the Centre and state, gave an indication for his possible shift around two weeks ago after supporting the implementation of CAA.

Notably, during the Assembly election held in November last year, Jafar used to be present in the meetings chaired by Kamal Nath either at his residence or at the Congress headquarters in Bhopal, and in Chhindwara. The Congress witnessed a stunning defeat, and was reduced to



66 against its tally of 114 in 2018. The BJP won 163 out of the 230 Assembly seats. Considered to be a member of the close circle of Kamal Nath, Jafar is the second leader to switch to the BJP in the past year. Before Jafar, Narendra Saluja, who was the media

cell head in MP Congress, joined the BJP ahead of the Assembly election last year. This comes at a time when Kamal Nath is trying to keep the party cadre united, especially in Chhindwara to ensure the repeated victory for his son Nakul Nath, who is

contesting his second Lok Sabha election from the family-bastion. In the 2019 Lok Sabha elections, the BJP had won 28 of the 29 seats in MP. Nakul Nath, who was elected from Chhindwara, was the lone winner from the Congress in the state.

Congress can field MLAs to contest the elections strongly against BJP's Ram Mandir card. Jaura MLA Pankaj Upadhyay can be fielded from Morena Lok Sabha, Bada Malhara MLA Ramsia Bharti from Damoh seat, Silvani MLA Devendra Patel from Vidisha, Lakhna Ghanghoria from Jabalpur, Pushp Rajgarh MLA



Phundelal Marco from Shahdol, MLA Vipin Jain can be fielded from Mandsaur. Sources reveal that the Congress high command is asking senior leaders of MP to contest the elections. But all the leaders including Kamal Nath, Digvijay Singh, Sajjan Singh Verma are not ready to contest the elections. In such a situation, Congress can now bet on the youth. BJP has given tickets to women on 6 out of 29 seats in MP. Four women

have been made candidates in the first list and two women in the second list. Now the challenge for Congress is to select winning women. Strong women candidates have been found only in Balaghat, Rewa and Damoh seats. In the face of BJP's Women's Reservation Bill and 6 women candidates, Congress is facing difficulty in fielding women equally. The names that have come up include Pankaj Upadhyay, Satyapal Singh (Neetu) Sikarwar from

Morena, Akshay Kanti Bam, Swapnil Kothari from Indore, Surendra Singh Shera from Khandwa, Priyavrat Singh, Ramchandra Dangi, Chander Singh Sondhia from Rajgarh, Mahesh Parmar from Ujjain, Devendra Patel from Vidisha, Arun Srivastava from Bhopal, GP Mali, Sanjay Sharma from Hoshangabad, Hina Kanwre from Balaghat, Virendra Raghuvanshi from Guna, Rao Yadendra Singh Yadav, Lakhna Singh Yadav from Gwalior, Praveen Pathak, Kantilal Bhuria from Jhabua, Dinesh Yadav and Lakhna Ghanghoria from Jabalpur, Ranjita Gaurav Patel, Ramsia Bharti, Tarwar Singh Lodhi from Damoh, The names of Neelam Abhay Mishra, Ajay Mishra Baba from Rewa, Phundelal Singh Marco from Shahdol, Prabh Singh Thakur from Sagar, Guddu Raja Bundela, Nandkishore Patel, Vipin Jain, DP Dhakad from Mandsaur are being considered.

## GOVERNMENT WILL IMPOSE NSA ON THOSE BUILDING ILLEGAL COLONIES

BJP, which had announced legalization of illegal colonies in the previous government, is now preparing to resolve this issue afresh. Instead of legalizing them, a new law will be brought and National Security Act (NSA) will be imposed on the concerned colonizer. The action will not be limited to this only, in the area where an illegal colony will be built, direct action will be taken against the Tehsildar and Zonal Officer of the Municipal Corporation up to the Patwari. The process of drafting the new law has started. The responsibility for this has been entrusted to the Principal Secretary of the Ministry of

Urban Administration.

The number of illegal colonies in the government records in the capital Bhopal was 576. The BJP government had announced to legalize illegal colonies built before 2016. Under this, 320 colonies were legalized. Last year, the Shivraj government had announced to legalize all the illegal colonies built by December 31, 2022, but this order could not be implemented.

In such a situation, FIR has been lodged in 256 colonies. There are many posh areas of the capital, next to which there are illegal settlements like settlements. Most of these do not even have basic facilities like electricity, water, roads and drainage. Most of

these colonies are such that people have been cheated in the name of cheap plots.

Recently, this issue was also raised in the meeting with builders. The builders said that all the rules and regulations of the government are for us, who take all the permissions and pay all the taxes. Illegal colonizers leave the colony anywhere and no action is taken against them. Later, if the government legalizes them, it puts additional burden on everyone including the Municipal Corporation.

Nilgiri Colony is also included among the 238 illegal colonies of Bhopal that were legalized in May 2023. At that time this was vacant land. Here the builder reduced the 12

feet wide drain to 4 feet for plotting. Presently the work of electric pole and transformer has been done here, on the basis of which the sale of land is going on. Similarly, work has intensified in many colonies which have been legalized without building houses.

Neeraj Mandloi, Principal Secretary, Urban Administration Department, says that in the current system, effective action is not taken against illegal colonizers. There are instructions to file an FIR against him, but in most of the cases the police leaves him with a letter. The new law has been discussed. The minister has given instructions for this, we will start the work soon.

## Guna LS seat: Battle of prestige for Scindia to get back his family pocket borough

The electoral battle for the Guna Lok Sabha seat, where Union Civil Aviation Minister, Jyotiraditya Scindia, is contesting for the sixth time, is going to be a high-profile and high-octane contest like always.

Spanning eight Assembly seats of the three districts of Guna, Shivpuri and Ashok Nagar, most of the time, this particular seat was represented by the

members of the Scindia family of the erstwhile Gwalior dynasty.

Jyotiraditya Scindia's loss in 2019 was a major jolt to his political career. Now, as he is contesting for the first time on a BJP ticket, local people said the seasoned politician is taking this election as a matter of prestige and is determined to get his family bastion back.

"Scindia was offered the choice to contest the election from Gwalior, but he chose Guna, because he wants to get

back his family pocket borough. In fact, preparations for the election had begun months before the poll schedule was announced.

"In the last six months, Scindia has been visiting Gwalior, Guna, Shivpuri and Ashok Nagar districts frequently," said a Shivpuri-based BJP worker.

During his visit to Guna last week, Scindia had assigned some specific tasks to his supporters and has asked them to meet him after 10 days for a review.

The Opposition Congress, however, is yet to announce its candidate against Scindia as it is eyeing over three lakh Yadav votes in Guna constituency.

It will be no surprise if the grand old party fields former PCC President, Arun Yadav, against Scindia.

Responding to his possible candidature from Guna, senior Congress leader Arun Yadav said he would be ready for it if the party gives him the opportunity.

"If the Congress leadership asks me to contest the election from Guna, I will come forward to take this opportunity. But, it depends on the party to decide the candidates," Yadav said during a conversation with reporter.

Notably, sitting BJP MP, KP Yadav, who defeated Scindia in 2019 with a margin of over one lakh votes, wasn't retained for the second term, and Scindia, who joined the BJP in 2020 is now the BJP's candidate from the Guna Lok Sabha seat.

# DRPPL launches survey of Dharavi to collect data from informal tenement residents

by laser mapping of the respective lane, known as 'Lidar Survey'. DRPPL has deployed a trained team to visit every tenement with an indigenously developed application to scan documents. A toll free number 1800-268-

8888 has been activated to respond to the queries and concerns of Dharavikars.

The beginning of the Dharavi survey is the first step to make Mumbai slum free and also transform Dharavi

into a world class township, a state of the art city within Mumbai. DRPPL has urged all Dharavikars to support the survey which will enable it to execute the rehabilitation process and ultimately provide them with their dream home.

As per the redevelopment plan, each and every informal tenement holder will get a home. Homes will be provided to qualified ineligible tenement holders too. DRPPL has recently announced that all eligible and ineligible resident tenement holders will get a flat with an independent kitchen and toilet.

Further, eligible industrial and commercial redeveloped Dharavi will enjoy a five-year holiday in state GST payment to boost and help formalise their businesses.

# Marathi-origin US health official to visit India for boosting health partnership

Dr. Atul Gawande, Assistant Administrator for Global Health, US Agency for International Development (USAID) will start a 4-day visit to India from March 19 to move forward the US-India health partnership, officials said here on Monday. Dr. Atul Gawande, 59, born to Marathi doctor parents who settled in the US, will have engagements with high-ranking government officials, healthcare professionals, academic, civil society and business leaders in New Delhi, plus Indore and Dewas in Madhya Pradesh. As a prominent member of the current US President Joe Biden's administration, he will underscore the US' commitment to partnering with India to forge global solutions to health challenges. The Indo-US development collaboration of more than 70 years has been transformational, strengthening both the US and India, besides making the world safer and more prosperous. Today, the two top democracies - both going to polls this year - are partnering to advance and achieve shared global health and development priorities.

The world's two top largest economies and hubs for technology and innovation, the US and India partner to test and pilot healthcare models and high-impact innovations to



address complex health challenges that can be scaled and replicated, not just in India, but worldwide. Dr. Gawande will reinforce the US' commitment to collaborating with India to address some of the world's toughest development challenges.

These would include harnessing emerging technologies to advance global health goals, bolstering primary health systems to strengthen global health security, and working directly with communities to formulate the most equitable and effective responses.

A renowned surgeon, author, journalist and public health researcher, Dr. Gawande was named by the President-elect Joe Biden as a member of the COVID-19 Advisory Board on Nov. 9, 2020, and in July 2021 was appointed to his current position.x

# Battle for Baramati becomes brutal for Pawar clan

Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister and Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) President Ajit A. Pawar faces an onslaught from an unexpected quarter -- his elder brother, guide and mentor, industrialist Shrinivas A. Pawar -- sending ripples in political circles. Shrinivas A. Pawar, who had supported Ajit A. Pawar during his 2019 rebellion, has now turned his back on the younger sibling, leaving the latter virtually a loner in Pune politics as the battle for Baramati turns brutal.

Catching many unawares, Shrinivas A. Pawar suddenly stepped out to oppose not only Ajit Pawar, but also his wife Sunetra, who is the likely NCP candidate for Baramati, locking horns with her 'nanand' Supriya Sule, the daughter the Nationalist Congress Party (SP) patriarch Sharad Pawar.

Without mincing words, Shrinivas A. Pawar described Ajit Pawar as "ungrateful, incompetent and thankless without regards for the family elders". "It was hurting when he (Ajit) said that our uncle (Sharad Pawar, 83) has no political future now, he should just retire, sit at home, chant bhajan-kirtan and adopt a mentoring role. Just because someone has aged, you are being disrespectful to him in the hope of getting benefits for next ten years by allying with someone," said Shrinivas A. Pawar sharply. "You may be surprised why I am talking against 'Dada' (brother) when I have always backed him in the past. I clearly told him that he is



an MLA and he should voluntarily give the (Baramati LS) seat to our uncle Pawar Saheb, who has done a lot for us... Clearly there is no one more incompetent than Ajit," said Shrinivas A. Pawar.

He further reminded Ajit Pawar that it was Sharad Pawar who had made him a Deputy CM four times, plus given him many ministerial assignments and other political positions, and he was fortunate to have such a 'great uncle'.

Shrinivas A. Pawar's wife, Sharmila also took the stand and criticized her brother-in-law Ajit A. Pawar, questioning "were you ever defeated in any elections due to Sharad Pawar's support," while interacting with villagers on their campaign trail for Supriya Sule. This is the same Shrinivas A. Pawar who had once sheltered the wayward Ajit A. Pawar when he deserted the (undivided) NCP to abruptly take oath with Bharatiya Janata Party's Devendra Fadnavis as CM and himself as Deputy CM in a dawn ceremony in November 2019, but the two-

man regime crashed in barely 80 hours.

When swords were out for Ajit A. Pawar at that time, he was found ensconced in the home of Shrinivas A. Pawar, and emerged out after the huge fracas subsided, though he was shunted to the political doghouse for weeks before being rehabilitated by Sharad Pawar as a Deputy CM.

This is the second jolt for Ajit A. Pawar in barely a fortnight after his nephew -- Yugendra Shrinivas Pawar -- also stood opposite him and has supported the NCP(SP)'s nominee Supriya Sule.

Sharmila Shrinivas Pawar chided her brother-in-law (Ajit A. Pawar) saying: "This is a delicate and agonizing time for the entire Pawar clan, something like this is unprecedented, nobody wants to oppose you, but we have many elders in the family and shall overcome this moment. Our identity is owed to Sharad Pawar and even his opponents take his name with respect. We have to make him victorious." Shrinivas A. Pawar said that he did not wish to share many other things about Ajit A. Pawar, but desired that he should live with respect and dignity.

Reacting, NCP (SP) National General Secretary Dr Jitendra Awhad said that it was the 'pain and indebtedness of Shrinivas A. Pawar that has come to fore as Ajit A. Pawar committed a 'paap' (sin) against Sharad Pawar". Responding to the sibling onslaught, NCP Thane chief and two-time MP Anand P. Paranjpe said that entire Baramati supporters Ajit A. Pawar, and "everything will be clear after the elections".

# BJP misusing probe agencies: Sanjay Raut

Shiv Sena (UBT) MP Sanjay Raut hit at Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) accusing it of being a party built on corruption, and said they should try to save themselves after the Opposition government takes power plus control over the Central investigation agencies, here on Monday. "The BJP is steeped in corruption. But it is misusing the Central investigation agencies to target the Opposition parties. Wait till the Opposition government comes to office at the Centre, the control of ED-IT changes hands, then you should try to save yourself... Iron cuts iron," Raut dared. Elaborating, Raut said that he had written a letter to the BJP's Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis a couple of weeks ago seeking strong action



against the online gaming companies which are ruining the people of the especially youth and dooming society. "There was a similar sentiment against the dance bars in Mumbai and other parts of Maharashtra which the then Deputy Chief Minister, the Late R. R. Patil had shown courage and banned them in 2005. The present government should act against the online gamers which promote gambling," the SS-UBT Chief Spokesperson said. However, the MP rued that the police are under pressure as "lot of money is being passed right to the top, I even

know through whom the cash is going or for what purposes." Taking a swipe at the BJP, he compared the development with the drug menace with drugs being smuggled from Gujarat which into Maharashtra and suspected its possible links with the Electoral Bonds financing row. "Why is the government not taking action? Is the drug mafia money being transferred to the BJP through the Electoral Bonds... Is this why they are so reluctant to reveal the identity of the donors," Raut said. The SS-UBT MP's no-holds-barred comments came a day after the national Opposition INDIA bloc launched its Lok Sabha 2024 poll campaign at a grand rally, after Congress leader Rahul Gandhi ended his 6,700-kms, 66 days long Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra and a brief foot-march, Nyay Sankalp Yatra on Sunday.

# Ashok Chavan on Rahul Gandhi's "Weeping senior leader who quit" comment

BJP Rajya Sabha MP Ashok Chavan said Monday he was not the "senior leader... who left the Congress... weeping" that Rahul Gandhi referred to at a 'Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra' event in Mumbai.

On Sunday Rahul Gandhi - set to contest the 2024 Lok Sabha election from Wayanad in Kerala and, most probably, the party stronghold of Amethi in Uttar Pradesh - concluded the Congress' pan-India yatra with sharp barbs at his rivals and an unnamed friend-turned-foe, who many saw as Chavan.

Gandhi suggested that a "senior leader" had moved to the BJP to evade scrutiny by probe agencies, repeating charges by the opposition - that the ruling party uses the Enforcement Directorate, the Income Tax Department, and others to intimidate rival politicians, particularly before elections.

"...A senior leader from this state left the Congress. Weeping, he told my mother (ex-Congress boss Sonia Gandhi)... 'I'm ashamed. Don't have the power to fight this force. I do not want to go to jail'."

Responding to the statement, ex-Maharashtra Chief Minister - who joined the BJP last month - pointed out Mr Gandhi had not actually named any



individual in his attack on the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party.

"But if he is saying that about me, then it is illogical and baseless. The truth is that till I resigned from the Congress, I was working at the party headquarters. I resigned from the post of MLA and, a few moments later, from the party also. Till then, no one knew I had resigned," he said in a video message.

"I never met Sonia Gandhi. It is baseless (to say) I met Sonia Gandhi and expressed my emotions. It is a political statement from the election point of view," he continued.

Two high-profile political leaders from Maharashtra quit the Congress this year: former Union Minister Milind Deora went to the Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena and Chavan went to the BJP.

# EC orders transfer of BMC commissioner IS Chahal, other bureaucrats

The Election Commission of India, in a bid to ensure a level playing field in the Lok Sabha elections 2024, on Monday ordered the removal of certain bureaucrats across India including Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation chief Iqbal Singh Chahal and some additional and deputy civic commissioners. As per a report, the announcement came after Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar, flanked by Election Commissioners Gyanesh Kumar and Sukhbir Singh Sandhu, held a meeting in the national capital on March 18. According to the report, the ECI had directed all state governments to transfer officers connected with election-related work, who have completed three years or are in their home districts. However, Maharashtra had partially complied with the directions. They had not transferred select municipal commissions, additional and deputy civic chiefs.

According to the report, the commission directed the removal of BMC chief Chahal as well as deputy and additional commissioners, with a deadline of 6 pm on Monday.

The poll body also directed the chief secretary to transfer all similarly placed civic chiefs and additional or deputy municipal commissioners of other cor-



porations in Maharashtra, the report further stated. A PTI report, quoting its sources, stated that the ECI ordered the removal of home secretaries of Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand as well. The report further stated that the poll body has also ordered the removal of the West Bengal director general of police.

CEC Kumar, while announcing the Lok Sabha elections 2024 dates on March 17, had reiterated that the poll body will maintain a level playing field and ensure the integrity of the electorate

in India.

Voting for 48 seats in Maharashtra in the upcoming Lok Sabha elections 2024 will be held on April 19, April 26, May 7, May 13 and May 20. The votes cast across India will be counted on June 4.

Chief Electoral Officer of Maharashtra S Chockalingam, per the PTI report, previously said, that there are 4,78,50,789 male voters and 4,41,74,722 female voters in Maharashtra as of March 15. He added that the state has 5,559 transpersons who are eligible to vote. He added that the number of voters has risen by 34,69,534 since 2019.









# Indian Olympic Association dissolves ad hoc committee for wrestling

The Indian Olympic Association (IOA) on Monday announced the dissolution of the ad hoc committee for the Wrestling Federation of India (WFI).

This decision comes following the lifting of the ban imposed on WFI by the United World Wrestling and the successful completion of the selection trials overseen by the ad hoc committee appointed by the IOA.

"Refer to this office Order No. IOA WFI/I-28/2023/1560 dated 27 December 2023, wherein an Ad Hoc Committee for wrestling was appointed, it is hereby ordered that the said Ad Hoc committee is dissolved with immediate effect," the IOA said in a statement.

"The decision to dissolve the Ad Hoc committee comes in light of the lifting of the ban of the Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) by the United World Wrestling (UWW) and the successful com-



pletion of Selection Trials by the Ad Hoc Committee appointed by the IOA as per the directives of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. Consequent upon the aforementioned developments, there is no further need for running the activities of the WFI through an Ad Hoc Committee," it said.

"However, as instructed by the UWW, it is imperative that the WFI appoint a Safeguarding Committee/Officer at the earliest to address the concerns of abuse and harassment and to ensure adherence to all rules, regulations and guidelines set forth by the UWW and other relevant authorities. Furthermore, the WFI is also directed to conduct the elections of the Athletes Commission in a time-bound manner, in accordance with the established procedures and guidelines. This step is essential to promote athlete representation and participation in the decision-making process of the WFI.

"The WFI is also instructed to repay the loan provided by the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) to the Adhoc Committee for managing WFI's operation. All concerned are requested to take necessary actions to implement this office order effectively. This is issued with the approval of President IOA," the letter read.

## 'Get a new javelin': Arshad Nadeem is the pride of Pakistan and must be supported, says Neeraj Chopra

India's Neeraj Chopra and Pakistan's Arshad Nadeem are javelin superstars and a symbol of perfect friendship.

Both the athletes are getting ready for the upcoming outdoor season. While Chopra is currently training in Turkey, 27-year-old Nadeem's preparations have hit a 'snag'.

The Pakistani recently said he is struggling to acquire an international standard javelin for many years and has been "using one for the past seven to eight years." Chopra, the world and defending Olympic champion, is rather surprised to hear this.

As per SAI statement, Chopra, who competed with Nadeem in the world athletics championships in Budapest last year, said, "It is hard to believe that he has been struggling to get a new javelin. Given his credentials, this should not be a big issue at all."

Arshad Nadeem, who finished second behind Chopra in Budapest, was recently quoted in the media, saying: "It has now got to a stage where the javelin is damaged and I have asked the national federation and my coach to do something about it before the Paris Olympics."

"When I started off in 2015, competing in international events I got this javelin ... for an international athlete aiming to win a medal in the Olympic Games, you need proper equipment and training facilities."

Chopra, whose entire training and international tours are funded by the Indian sports ministry's Target Olympic Podium Scheme, feels that Nadeem is the pride of Pakistan and must be supported.

With a 90.18m throw, Arshad Nadeem had created a new javelin throw record at the 2022



Commonwealth Games in Birmingham to finish on top of the podium. It ended Pakistan's 60-year wait for a CWG gold medal.

"It can't be that he (Arshad) doesn't have the means to buy a javelin. He is a champion and must be doing some brand endorsements. I reckon he has earned a bit of money too. But having said that,

his government can look at Arshad's needs and support him just like how my government is doing so.

"Additionally, Arshad is top javelin thrower and I believe that the javelin makers will be more than happy to sponsor him and provide what he wants. This is a piece of advice from my side," said Chopra.

# Indian Wells: Alcaraz, Swiatek win titles

Carlos Alcaraz defended his trophy after beating Daniil Medvedev 7-6(5) 6-1, whereas Iga Swiatek bagged the 20th title of her career without dropping a single set across the tournament, defeating Maria Sakkari 6-4 6-0, at the Indian Wells Open final.

For Alcaraz, the journey to defend his title was riddled with challenges and doubts. Nursing an ankle issue, the young Spaniard faced an uphill battle against the formidable Daniil Medvedev in the final. Alcaraz rose to the occasion, staging a remarkable comeback after a tense opening set. After a tight opening set which Medvedev led 6-5, Alcaraz forced a tie-break which he edged 7-5 to take the advantage in the contest.

In the second set it was a different story as Alcaraz steamrolled the world No. 4 to clinch his first title of the year - and first since Wimbledon last summer.

Alcaraz is only the sixth player to successfully defend the Indian Wells crown.

Reflecting on his triumph, Alcaraz expressed gratitude for overcoming obstacles and seizing the moment on the grand stage of Indian Wells. His victory not only cements his status as a rising star in the tennis world but also serves as a testament to the power of perseverance and self-belief.

"I'm feeling great right now, this tournament means a lot to me," said Alcaraz, who is the first man to win back-to-back at Indian Wells since Novak Djokovic in 2016.

"Playing here is so special to me but I think this year is a bit more special because before the tournament I was thinking about whether I could play my best or not."

"I was not feeling well with my ankle. Weeks before the tournament I was hitting for 30 minutes with no movement, so there was a lot of doubt for me, but I was really happy to be able to overcome those problems and at the end feel better."

In the women's final, Iga Swiatek showcased her dominance on the women's circuit with a commanding victory over Maria Sakkari in two straight sets.

The younger player, Swiatek, unsurprisingly jumped out to an early 3-0



lead, but Sakkari held her serve to win one back and start to pose a threat to her opponent. The Greek then leveled the score at 3-3 with a spectacular break of Swiatek and bit back again to make it 4-4.

But in the end, the rising star from Poland picked up a level and won the opening set 6-4.

She has won every single one of her 69 WTA 1000 matches prior to that place. And it wouldn't stop here, either. Nearly every rally saw Swiatek display her exceptional talent, taking down the

world No. 9 and obliterating any hope for improvement. Sakkari, who had lost all hope, appeared powerless during the disastrous final match.

Swiatek showed her supreme quality in nearly every rally, wearing down the world No.9 and closing up every suggestion of light at the end of the tunnel. An utterly demoralised Sakkari looked helpless in the destructive final game.

It was a ruthless display to dismantle Sakkari 6-0 in the second set, the end of which came just over 20 minutes after the first.

## Akhil, Anish, Niraj shine as India win six medals at the Polish Grand Prix

Paris Olympics quota winners Akhil Sheoran and Anish Bhanwala as well as Niraj Kumar shone the brightest as Indian rifle and pistol shooters ended their Polish Grand Prix campaign with six medals, including two gold.

Some members of India's 50m rifle and 25m rapid-fire pistol squad are currently on an exposure tour to Europe to compete in various established international Shooting events, in the build-up to Paris 2024.

Akhil Sheoran won gold for India in the men's 50m rifle 3 positions (3P) match two when he shot a scorching 468.4 to leave Patrik Jany of the Czech Republic a distant 2.2 behind in second at the Grand Prix Wroclawia & Dolnego Slaska.

Both those scores were however higher than the existing world record of 466.1, held by Jany's countryman Jiri Privratsky.

Anish Bhanwala also won gold in the men's 25m rapid-fire pistol, to extend a golden run of form at the Jozef Zapadski Grand Prix held simultaneously.

Navy shooter Niraj Kumar was also highly impressive finishing with two bronze medals in both the men's 3P matches, thereby becoming the only Indian to finish with two medals.

Niraj also shot impressive scores of 595 and 594 in the two qualification matches. In the first match he finished third behind Jany and Rio Olympic silver medalist Serhiy Kulish of Ukraine. Swapnil Kusale also shot a solid 595 in match two to top the qualification standings, being more accurate than Niraj, but finished fourth overall.

The two Grand Prixes also saw another Paris quota winner Shriyanka Sadangi win bronze in the women's 3P and Ashi Chouksey pick up a silver in the second women's 3P.

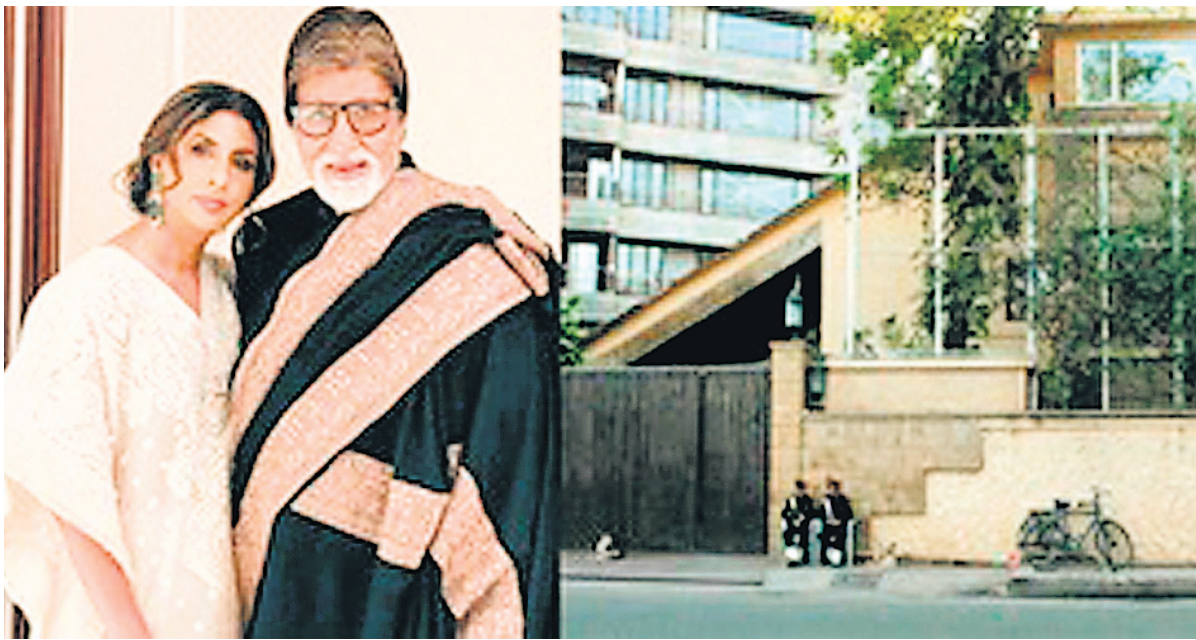
