Calcutta HC cancels all OBC certificates issued in Bengal after 2010

The Calcutta High Court on Wednesday cancelled all the Other Backward Class (OBC) certificates issued in West Bengal after 2010.

The ruling by the division bench of Justice Tapabrata Chakraborty and Justice Rajasekhar Mantha effectively means that all OBC certificates issued by the current Trinamool Congress regime that came to power in 2011 now stand cancelled.

Following the order, over 5,00,000 OBC certificates issued since 2010 cannot be used for seeking reservations for jobs now.

However, there is an exemption for those who have already secured jobs using the certificates issued during that period, as the latest order will have no impact on them, the bench ruled.

While passing the order, the bench observed that since the certificates issued after 2010 were not issued in accordance with the prescribed legal procedures, they stand cancelled.

The bench ruled that the state Assembly will now decide who all are eligible to apply for OBC certificates. It also said that the West Bengal Backward Class Commission will now



decide the list of caste categories that can be included in the OBC list.

As per the rule, the Commission recommends the list and forwards the same to the state Assembly which takes the final decision on this count. In the past, there have been several complaints relating to irregularities in issuing OBC certificates in West Bengal, as a result of which several eligible persons were deprived of the certificates as several non-eligible candidates were included in the list.

I don't accept this order: Mamata Banerjee

"I do not accept this order of the Calcutta High Court. Recently the Calcutta High Court also cancelled around 26,000 jobs in state-run schools. I did not accept that order as well. I will not take any names. Whoever passed it, but I must say that this order favours the BJP. Hence we will not accept it. The reservation for OBCs will continue."

The Chief Minister linked the Calcutta High Court's order with the recent statement by Prime Minister Narendra Modi that the Congress and other allies of the Opposition INDIA bloc, if voted to power, have plans to reduce the quota for OBCs and give the same to Muslims.

STOP CAMPAIGN SPEECHES THAT MAY DIVIDE SOCIETY": POLL BODY

The Election Commission, criticised over what many called its kid-glove treatment of the BJP and its leaders, today read the Riot Act to the ruling party as well as the Opposition for campaigning along the lines of "caste, community, language, and religion". The party in power at the election time has extra responsibility. No unlimited extra space should go to the opposition either, the Commission said ahead of the last two phases of election.

"Political parties will have to take primary responsibility for the conduct of their candidates, star campaigners in particular. Campaign speeches by those holding high positions are of more seri-

ous consequences," the Commission said.

The BJP -- as the ruling party at the Centre -- has been asked to stop campaign speeches that may divide society.

The Commission said it expects the BJP to "fully align campaign methods to the practical aspects of the composite and sensitive fabric of India".

The star campaigners of the party have to adhere to the Model Code direction that "No Party or candidate shall include in any activity which may aggravate existing difference or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic," the Commission said.

"India's socio-cultural milieu is an enduring preserve cannot be made a

casualty to elections," the Commission said. The two big parties are not allowed to weaken the heritage of quality electoral experience of Indian voter, the poll body said. The poll body's statement came amid massive criticism of its handling of Model Code violation allegations against Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Congress's Rahul Gandhi. After each party filed petitions against the other's leader, the Commission sent notices to the respective party chiefs.

The critics have also questioned the Commission's silence about Model Code Violation complaints and its findings. The poll body has also been criticised for discontinuing the traditional practice of holding press briefings after every phase of election.

SHAH RUKH KHAN HOSPITALISED IN AHMEDABAD DUE TO DEHYDRATION

Ahmedabad: Bollywood superstar Shah Rukh Khan was admitted to the KD Hospital in Ahmedabad on Wednesday after reportedly suffering a heat stroke. The actor reached Ahmedabad on Tuesday to watch the Indian Premier League (IPL) match between his franchise Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) and Sunrisers Hyderabad (SRH), which KKR won at the Narendra Modi Stadium here to reach the final. "The actor was suffering from dehydration amid a high temperature of 45-degree Celsius in Ahmedabad. He is under medical observation although his health is stable. Security has been tightened around the hospital," sources said.



INDI Alliance has diseases worse than cancer: PM Modi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Wednesday that the INDIA bloc is afflicted with diseases like communalism, casteism and nepotism that are "worse than cancer" and can destroy the nation.

"The INDIA Alliance has diseases worse than cancer. They can destroy the whole of India if they spread. These three diseases -- of being extremely communal, extremely racist and extremely nepotistic -- can be more destructive for the country than cancer," said PM Modi while addressing an election rally in Uttar Pradesh's Shravasti. Seeing the massive gathering, the Prime Minister said that the love and enthusiasm of people "clearly shows" that the INDIA Alliance of SP-Congress has "completely collapsed" and the entire country is chanting 'phir ek baar, Modi sarkar'. "The BJP does not want the old Uttar Pradesh to be back and this is my guarantee that I will not allow it," he said. Continuing further, he said that the Congress party wanted to give reservation rights to Muslims by taking away the benefits from SC/ST and OBCs but he would never allow it.

"My guarantee is that I will remain a 'chowkidar' for the weaker sections and their rights. I will not allow any tampering with the reservation issue," he added.



The Prime Minister said that a top Congress leader who "worked like a commando for the Shehzada" used to call him an 'incumbent Prime Minister' but after the fifth phase, he too has stopped ridiculing him.

"I just saw some videos in which people can be seen climbing onto the dais. When I asked, I was told that these people had been brought for the INDIA rally on payment but the money had not been given to them. How can you trust such people and can they do any good for you?" he asked.

The Prime Minister further said that the 2024 elections would decide the future of the country.

Pune Porsche case: Accused minor's bail cancelled, detained to juvenile home till June 5

In a significant development, the Juvenile Justice Board (JJB) on Wednesday cancelled the bail granted to a minor -- charged with killing two persons with his speeding Porsche early on May 19 -- and has detained him in a juvenile rehabilitation home for 14 days.

The JJB's order came three days after it had granted bail to the minor boy -- son of a prominent Pune realtor -- barely 15 hours after the accident, and asked him to write an essay, serve with traffic police and take medical help to de-addict himself, sparking a huge public and political row.

The state police went in appeal against the JJB order before a Sessions Court, which directed it to go back to the JJB and seek a review of the previous



order, which was granted on Wednesday.

The Pune Police also informed the JJB that the investigators have enhanced the charges by adding a new IPC Section

185 to the chargesheet, besides Section 304 pertaining to culpable homicide not amounting to murder.

In a related development, the boy's father, Vishal S. Agarwal was remanded

to two days police custody, along with three others arrested, including the owner and managers of two eateries where the youngsters' brigade had partied on Saturday-Sunday night.

20 People In Intensive Care After "Extreme Turbulence" In Singapore Airlines Flight

Bangkok: Twenty people were in intensive care in Bangkok hospitals on Wednesday after a terrifying high-altitude plunge on a flight from London during which an elderly passenger died and more than 100 were injured.

Singapore Airlines flight SQ321 hit "sudden extreme turbulence" over Myanmar 10 hours into its journey to Singapore on Tuesday, abruptly rising and plunging several times. One passenger said people were thrown around the cabin so violently they put dents in the ceiling during the drama at 11,300 metres (37,000 feet), leaving dozens with head injuries. Photos from inside the plane show the cabin in chaos, strewn with food, drinks bottles and luggage, and with oxygen masks dangling from the ceiling. The plane, carrying 211 passengers and 18 crew, made an emergency landing at Bangkok's Suvarnabhumi Airport, where medical staff used gurneys to ferry the injured to ambulances waiting on the tarmac.

PREPARATIONS FOR RESTRUCTURING OF CAPITAL PROJECT ADMINISTRATION (CPA) STOPPED IN SHIVRAJ GOVERNMENT

Bhopal: Preparations are underway to reconstitute the Capital Projects Administration (CPA), which was closed by the Shivraj government on March 3, 2022. Chief Secretary Veera Rana has called a meeting of officials of Public Works and Urban Development and Housing Department on May 28, in which the works related to parks, government buildings and roads of Bhopal will be reviewed after the closure of CPA.

In the year 2021, when the condition of the roads of Bhopal city deteriorated due to excessive rainfall, the then Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chauhan expressed his displeasure in the review meeting and gave instructions to close the CPA. The Urban Development and Housing Department presented the proposal in the Cabinet on March 3, 2022, which was approved.

After this, the work of CPA road and building maintenance was handed over to the Public Works Department and the responsibility of maintaining the parks was handed over to the Forest Department, but this did not bring any improvement in the situation. The condition of the gardens worsened. Minister Krishna Gaur wrote a letter to Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav requesting him to consider the restructuring of CPA on the basis of development of parks and forest area.

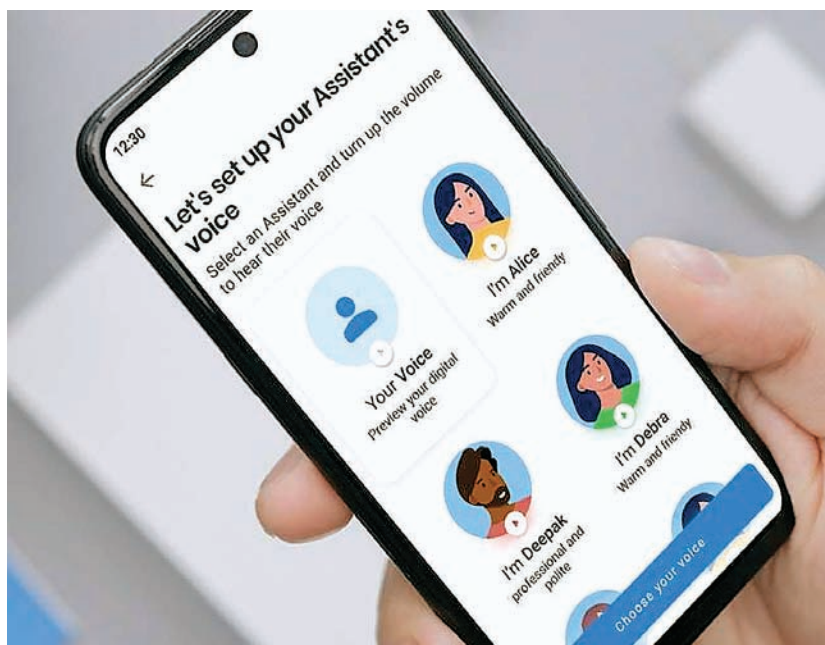

Easy process for new driving license from June 1

No need for driving test in RTO, it can be done in private driving school

Now, one does not need to give a test in RTO to get a driving license and you will be able to get your driving license from a private training center or driving school. The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has announced new rules for getting a driving license in India. These new rules will come into effect from June 1, 2024.

These institutions will be authorized to conduct tests for license eligibility and issue

certificates. The government's new rules aim to reduce pollution. For this, by making car emission rules stricter, about 9 lakh old government vehicles will be removed from the roads in different phases.

According to the new rules, the fine for speeding is between Rs 1,000 and Rs 2,000. However, if a minor is caught driving, a heavy fine of Rs 25,000 will be imposed. Apart from this, the vehicle owner's registration card will be canceled and the minor will be ineligible for a license till the age of 25 years.



ARVIND KEJRIWAL'S FIRST COMMENTS ON SWATI MALIWAL ASSAULT ROW

In his first direct reaction to the alleged assault on his party's Rajya Sabha MP Swati Maliwal, which has kicked up a political firestorm, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal has said he expects that a fair investigation will be conducted and justice will be done. The Aam Aadmi Party chief stressed, however, that there are two versions of the event. Maliwal has alleged that she was assaulted by Kejriwal's personal assistant, Bibhav Kumar, at the chief minister's residence on May 13. The AAP leader claimed Kumar had kicked her in the chest, stomach and pelvic area and had brutally "dragged her and pulled her shirt up". Kumar has been arrested and was sent to the custody of the Delhi Police till Thursday. In an interview with news agency the AAP chief said the alleged assault is "sub-judice" and him commenting on it could affect the proceedings. "But I expect there will be a fair investigation. Justice should be served. There are two versions of the event."



Police should investigate both versions fairly and justice should be done," he said. Hitting back strongly at the chief minister, Maliwal said it was ironic that the person who had "assassinated her character" and called her a "BJP agent" was now calling for a free and fair investigation. "After unleashing the entire army of



leaders and volunteers at me, calling me a BJP agent, assassinating my character, leaking edited videos, victim shaming me, roaming around with the accused, letting him re enter the crime scene and tamper evidences and protesting in favour of the accused, the Chief Minister, in whose drawing room I was beaten up, has finally said that he wants free and fair

investigation in the matter," the MP said in a post on X. The alleged assault on Maliwal has prompted attacks on the AAP and Kejriwal from the BJP. The party's president, JP Nadda, had questioned Mr Kejriwal's silence on the issue and said that it shows his "double character and dual standards". Delhi Lieutenant Governor VK Saxena had also waded into the row on Tuesday and said, "I would have expected that, at least for the sake of propriety, my chief minister would have come clean, rather than being evasive and dodgy. His deafening silence speaks volumes of his stance on safety of women." This had prompted a strong response from the Aam Aadmi Party, which said Mr Saxena's statement proves that Maliwal "is working for the BJP". "With the elections on, the BJP is bringing a new conspiracy daily, from liquor scam to Swati Maliwal to foreign funding. The BJP is losing badly, so they are trying to revive their prospects by using the Swati Maliwal issue," the party said.

Priyanka Gandhi to hold roadshow for Ajay Rai in Varanasi on May 25

Congress General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra will campaign and hold a roadshow in favour of Ajay Rai, the party's state president and candidate in Varanasi, on May 25. Prime Minister Narendra Modi is seeking a third consecutive term from Varanasi. Ajay Rai said on Wednesday, "Yes, Priyanka Gandhi will campaign and hold a roadshow in Varanasi on May 25." Rai has been camping here for the past few weeks. Priyanka Gandhi Vadra is one of the Congress's star campaigners. She along with her brother Rahul Gandhi and other senior party leaders, has been campaigning in different states. Priyanka camped in Rae Bareilly to campaign for party candidates -- Rahul Gandhi in Rae Bareilly and her family



loyalist K.L. Sharma in Amethi -- from May 6 till the end of campaigning there on May 18.

Polling in Varanasi will take place in the seventh and final phase of elections on June 1.

LS polls over, now focus on drought, farmers: Maha Congress tells govt

The Congress on Wednesday urged the ruling MahaYuti government in Maharashtra to pay attention to the problems of severe water shortages, agricultural woes, and farmers' plight now that the Lok Sabha elections are over in the state. Speaking to mediapersons here, Maharashtra Congress President Nana Patole said that large parts of the state are grappling with severe water shortage for drinking, livestock, and agriculture purposes. "Most dams and reservoirs are virtually running empty with little or no water, people in thousands of villages and hamlets have no drinking water. There is no water for



fodder animals and agriculture," Patole claimed. Under the grim scenario and with monsoon at least another fortnight away, he called upon the state government to make drinking water arrangements in every water scarcity region, fodder for the animals and farming purposes. Elaborating further, Patole said that people in the state, especially the rural women, are facing great hardships to get bare minimum drinking water, their animals have no

fodder and water, which in turn is hitting milk production. "Many cities and towns are getting water once in 10-12 days, at least 23 districts are experiencing severe water crises and the situation is serious in Marathwada. We had warned in January that the state would be facing water problems, but the MahaYuti allies were busy with infighting and preparing for the elections," claimed Patole. Now that the elections are over, the government must pay attention to the people's woes and take immediate steps to resolve the water-fodder crisis, start fodder camps, and deploy tankers to rush water to the critical regions, he urged.

MP govt floats tenders for 5 PPP model medical colleges

Giving a push to its ambitious proposal to establish new medical colleges under the public-private-partnership (PPP) model, the Madhya Pradesh government has floated tenders for it. Deputy Chief Minister Rajendra Shukla on Wednesday informed that a complete roadmap has been prepared for inviting tenders and a meeting will be called soon after the results of the ongoing Lok Sabha elections are announced on June 4. It would be the first time that medical colleges will be established on the PPP model in Madhya Pradesh. A proposal for this has already been approved by the Chief Minister Mohan Yadav led Madhya Pradesh cabinet in March this year. "In the first phase, five medical colleges will be opened under the PPP model. Tenders for some of these projects have been floated. We will proceed



further on the basis of the private parties," Shukla, who is also MP's health minister, said. This model will reduce the investment cost and

the investor will only need to build the medical college and not a hospital along with it. For the establishment of medical colleges under the PPP model, the government will provide land at the collector's guideline rates to investors, he said. He added that six new government-run medical colleges will become operational from the next academic year. "With these six, the number of government-run medical colleges in MP will increase to 20. Five medical colleges (PPP model) will be added in the next two years, and then we will have 25 medical colleges," he said. The minister informed that the state government is preparing to establish one medical college in every district. There are 53 districts in Madhya Pradesh, including two - Mauganj (separated from Rewa district) and Pandhurna (separated from Chhindwara district), which were made districts during the assembly elections in November last year.

NORTH BLOCK RECEIVES BOMB THREAT MAIL, BOMB DISPOSAL SQUAD RUSHED TO SPOT

New Delhi: The North Block in the national capital, which houses multiple ministries including the Ministry of Home Affairs, received a bomb threat on Wednesday afternoon, sources said, adding that a search operation is underway at the premises. Police sources said a team of bomb disposal squad along with fire tenders and sniffer dogs have been rushed to the spot. According to fire department officials, a call from the police was received at 3:37 p.m. after which two fire tenders were dispatched to the North Block. Further details are awaited. The latest threat comes days after several hospitals in Delhi, the Indira Gandhi International Airport and the Tihar Jail were targeted with bomb threat emails, alleging the presence of explosives on their premises.

Rajasthan sizzles: Met dept warns of mercury shooting up to 48 degree celsius in next 72 hours

Reeling under a severe heat wave, Pilani in Rajasthan was the hottest place registering a temperature of 47.2 degree celsius while almost all the other cities recorded a temperature ranging between 43 to 47 degrees in the last 24 hours, Met officials said on Wednesday. They warned that the temperature will touch 45 to 48 degrees in some parts of the state in the next 72 hours. According to RS Sharma, Director, Met centre, Jaipur, "The minimum temperature in some parts of the state is likely to be 2-5 degrees Celsius above the average." A severe heat wave in Rajasthan will increase the maximum and minimum temperatures by another 2-3 degrees in the next 72 hours. This will lead to nights becoming warm too due to an increase in minimum temperatures in the next five days, he said.



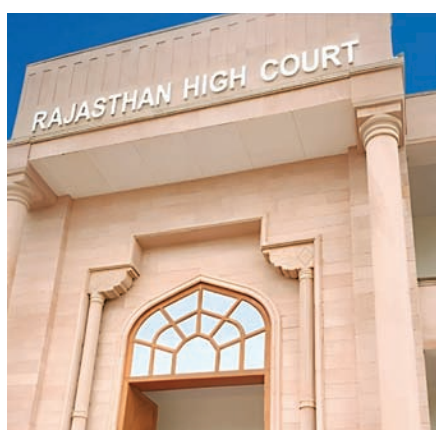
"There is a possibility of a heat wave at most places in the state and a severe heat wave at some places in the next two days. On May 23-24, there is a strong possibility of the maximum temperature touching the range of 45-48 degrees and a severe heat wave hitting some parts of Jodhpur, Bikaner, Jaipur, Kota and Bharatpur divisions."

Meanwhile, Barmer in Rajasthan was the second hottest place and recorded 46.2 degrees celsius temperature, Ganganagar registered 46.3, Phalodi registered 46 degrees, Bikaner was 44.8 degree celsius, Bikaner was 44.8 degree celsius, Kota was 44.8 degree celsius and Jaipur was 44.4 degree celsius.

RAJASTHAN HIGH COURT MIGHT SOON GET 10 NEW JUDGES

The High Court Collegium has sent the names of 10 advocates from Jaipur and Jodhpur to the Supreme Court Collegium for their appointment as High Court judges. These include advocates Sandeep Taneja, Sheetal Mirdha, Anand Sharma, Anurup Singhi, and Bipin Gupta from Jaipur. From Jodhpur, advocates Vinay Jain, Baljinder Singh Sandhu, Sandeep Shah, Mukesh Rajpurohit, and Sunil Beniwal are included. Taneja has been made Additional Advocate General by the current BJP government, while Sheetal Mirdha was Additional Advocate General during the previous Congress government. Similarly, Sandeep Shah and Sunil Beniwal also served as Additional Advocate Generals during the previous Congress government. Meanwhile, Anand Sharma from Jaipur and Mukesh Rajpurohit from Jodhpur are advocates for the central government. According to sources, the central government has requested an IB report on these names, and soon these names will be sent to the Supreme Court Collegium for consideration along with the IB report.

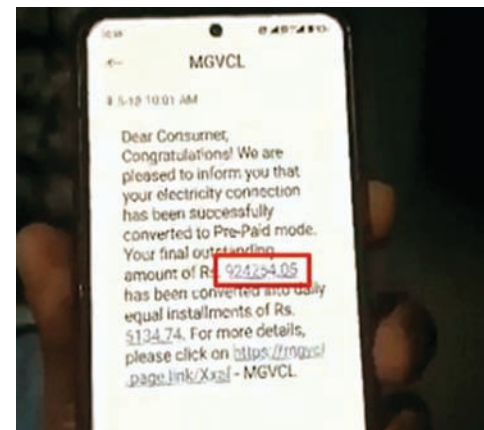

Vadodara resident gets Rs 9.24 lakh electricity bill, MGVCCL admits mistake

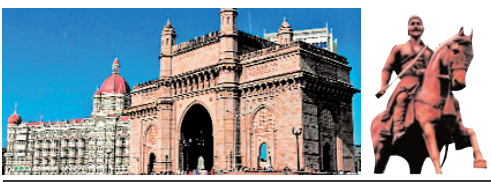

Amid the growing complaints against the newly installed smart electricity meters in Gujarat's Vadodara, a consumer received a bill of Rs 9.24 lakh for a month's consumption. Rahish, a Subhanpura resident living in a rented house, received an SMS from Madhya Gujarat Vij Corporation Limited (MGVCL) stating that his bill balance was Rs 9.24 lakh. Upon investigation, MGVCL discovered an error in their billing system, leading to an exorbitant bill. The customer's actual balance was corrected to Rs 1,037, which will be credited to his smart meter account. Another resident from Riddhi Siddhi Flats in the Subhanpura area faced a similar issue. His usual electricity bill was around Rs 2,000, but he received an SMS indicating his bill had skyrocketed to over Rs nine lakh, with an option to pay Rs 5,000 in instalments. He has been renting out the flat for seven years, and was unaware of any smart meter installation at his residence, highlighting the lack of



communication from the power company. The controversy surrounding Madhya Gujarat Vij Corporation Limited (MGVCL)'s installation of smart electricity meters in Vadodara continues to grow with consumers reporting a series of issues that have caused frustration.

MGVCL has installed 25,000 smart meters across the city, and many users claim their prepaid amount of Rs 2,000 is consumed within a week of installation. "The smart meter app prompts consumers to recharge their accounts four times and disconnects power when the balance reaches minus Rs 300. The new meters charge Rs 4.29 per unit, a significant increase from the previous rate of Rs 2.79 per unit. This has further aggravated consumer concerns, with some experiencing disconnections at inconvenient times, such as midnight, and speedy depletion of their recharge amounts," sources said. The implementation of smart meters in Vadodara has been contentious since the election period, with reports indicating that meters were installed without adequately informing residents. While the power company views smart meters as a futuristic and beneficial step, many consumers see them as a daily headache. Complaints have been pouring in from various parts of the city, with frustrated residents frequently visiting the power company's offices to express their grievances.

At least six villagers were missing and feared drowned, while one swam ashore after a motorboat overturned in a sudden storm at Solapur's Ujani dam waters, officials said here on Wednesday.

The incident happened late Tuesday night. This morning, the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) rushed a specialised team to the site and launched a rescue effort to trace the missing persons, the officials said. According to locals, the tragedy occurred when the launch with seven people was sailing from Kugaon village in Solapur to the Kalashi village in Pune on the opposite bank. The Solapur Police said that as per preliminary information, the motorboat with seven passengers set sail from Kugaon to Kalashi but midway a sudden thunderstorm accompanied by strong winds lashed the vicinity, churning up strong waves in the lake waters in which the small vessel overturned. At least one person on board, a Solapur assistant police inspector Rahul



Dongre, managed to swim safely to the opposite (Pune) shore while the others went missing in the darkness and have not yet been found till noon. Their identities are given as Gokul D. Jadhav, 30; his wife Komal, 25; and their kids, including three-year-old daughter Mahi, and one-year-old son Shubham; a villager Gaurav Dongre

and the boatman Anurag Avghade, 35. The policeman Dongre, who swam safely to Kalashi, sounded an alarm and alerted the villagers, the Pune Police and district administration besides other rescue authorities which rushed to the tragedy spot, but could do little in the darkness with sporadic rain. This morning, the NDRF deployed

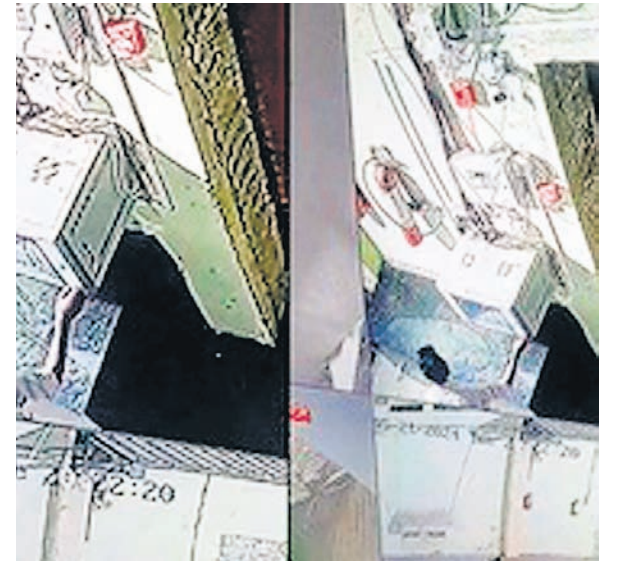
a team which started the search with expert divers, boats, ropes and other equipment, and further details are awaited. Baramati MP and Nationalist Congress Party (SP) Working President Supriya Sule rushed to the spot and took stock of the situation and the rescue operations.

MVA Ahmednagar LS candidate's 'wake-up call' to security as man lurks outside EVM strongroom

The opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi-Nationalist Congress Party (SP) legislator and Lok Sabha candidate Niles D. Lanke has alleged a potential security breach after an unidentified man was seen lurking outside the EVM strongroom, here on Wednesday.

Lanke, 45, an INDIA-MVA candidate pitted against Bharatiya Janata Party's Dr. Sujay Vikhe-Patil for the Ahmednagar LS constituency -- which went to the polls on May 13 -- has posted a purported video of the alleged security laxity on social media. "Security people, wake up a bit now... A trespasser has reached upto the (EVM's) warehouse," said Lanke's cryptic X tweet, highlighting the security breach, though there has been no official reaction so far. He pointed out how the person managed to gain



entry despite the 3-tier tight security deployed around the strongroom where the EVMs used in the recent LS elections in Ahmednagar constituency, are stored before the vote counting on June 4. He walked right up to the warehouse shutter and tried to smash the CCTV cameras installed there, but was

detected by Lanke's workers. "If my colleagues could detect this man then why can't the triple security layer notice him... The fence is now eating the grass and attempts are being made to 'steal democracy' while the administration is just watching with eyes wide open," said Lanke.

One more arrested by ED in Rs 263 cr tax refund scam case

The Enforcement Directorate (ED), Mumbai zonal office has arrested one more person in the Rs 263 crore Tax Deducted at Source (TDS) scam case, an official said on Wednesday, adding that the total number of arrested is now five.

The accused identified as Purshottam Chavan was arrested on Monday and was subsequently produced before the Special PMLA Court here. Chavan has been sent to ED custody till May 27.

Earlier, four persons were arrested in this case -- Tanaji Mandal Adhikari, Rajesh Brijlal Batreja, Bhushan Patil and Rajesh Shetty. The financial probe agency had initiated an investigation on the basis of an FIR registered by CBI under various sections of IPC, 1860 and the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1986



against Tanaji Mandal Adhikari and others for fraudulently generating and issuance of TDS refunds from Income Tax Department to the tune of Rs 263.95 crore. As per the probe agency, in this case, immovable/movable properties to the tune of Rs 168 crore have been identified and seized/attached so far. A Prosecution Complaint has also been filed on September 11 against Adhikari and 10 others, cognizance of which has also been taken by the Special PMLA Court.

PUNE PORSCHE CRASH CASE NCP(SP) MLA'S FAMILY RECALLS SON'S HARASSMENT IN SCHOOL

The Nationalist Congress Party (SP) MLA and former minister Prajak P. Tanpure's family remembers the days when their son was studying in school as a classmate of the same drunken 17-year-old boy who killed two persons while speeding his father's Porsche May 20.

The legislator's wife Sonali P. Tanpure took to social media on Wednesday, saying she recalled "those days again" when the accused - the son of a prominent Pune realty developer - was studying in the same class as her son. "At that time, my son suffered a lot at the hands of some of his (the builder's son) friends. I had even complained about it to their parents, but did not get a proper response," rued Sonali. Finally, left with no options, the Tanpure family decided to change the school of their son to avoid his torture at the hands of the other brats. "The scars of those traumatic incidents are still there on his (son's) mind. If the parents had noticed the bad tendencies of their child in time, then such a terrible crime would not have hap-



pened," said Sonali, on the Porsche crash that left Maharashtra shaken. Her husband and Rahuri MLA Tanpure said the incident by a rich man's wayward kid has cut short the lives of the two young victims who hailed from a small town with big dreams to make success in life. In all this, Tanpure pointed out how, not only the boy and his rich family, but the entire system, including the liberal home department, government and police are equally responsible for the tragedy. "The authorities are committing the sin of destabilising the social order by supporting the influential big people. It's only because of the alert people present there and the pressure built by the citizens and the media that is leading to some effective action now," said Prajak Tanpure. Sonali sought justice for the families of the two well-educated victims, aged 24 -- Ashwini Koshta and Aneesh Awadhya -- who were killed instantly in the Porsche speeding at a dizzying 200 kmph speed which was barely captured as a fleeting shadow in the CCTVs installed at Kalyani Nagar junction.

Be reasonable, Bombay HC tells BMC; restrains it from sacking doctor-teacher on maternity leave

The Bombay High Court on Tuesday restrained the city civic body from terminating the services of a doctor, appointed as a teacher on contract at a corporation-run hospital, for taking maternity leave beyond what was permitted to her. A vacation bench of Justices Arif Doctor and Somasekar Sundaresan said the civic authorities should be reasonable in their approach towards the issue, reported news agency. The Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) assured the HC that no "precipitative action" would be taken against the woman as far as her termination was concerned until her plea is heard next month. The bench was hearing a petition filed by Seemantani Bose challenging a decision taken by the Bhabha Hospital authorities saying she was not eligible for the mandated six-month maternity leave as she was a contractual employee. As per the hospital, Bose could avail only seven days leave. The bench on Tuesday said it would



hear the plea on June 12 and added that until then the BMC authorities should be reasonable in their approach and not take any action against her. The HC recorded the statement of the civic body's

advocate, Prashant Kamble, that no "precipitative action" would be taken against Bose as far as her termination was concerned until the plea is heard in June. The court also asked the BMC to release her dues. "We make it clear that all entitlements of the petitioner, if due in accordance with law, shall be paid over to the petitioner, and pendency of this petition shall not come in the way," the bench said. Bose, an MBBS and MS in obstetrics and gynaecology, was appointed as a teacher-junior consultant at the Bhabha Hospital on December 1, 2023. Her plea, filed through advocate Swaraj Jadhav, contended that Bose was appointed on a contract basis for 6 months on a post which had a provision for automatic renewal of employment on expiry of that period unless communicated otherwise. In March this year, Bose wrote to the hospital's deputy superintendent seeking maternity leave from April for a period of six months as her delivery was due last month. The deputy superintendent, however, told her she could go on maternity leave without pay since she is working on a contractual basis.

PUNE PORSCHE CRASH: MAHA DYCM FADNAVIS SLAMS RAHUL GANDHI'S ATTEMPTS TO 'POLITICISE' TRAGEDY

Bharatiya Janata Party's Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Wednesday slammed Congress leader Rahul Gandhi over his statement on the Pune Porsche crash case. Speaking to media persons here, Fadnavis said that such a statement did not bring glory to a person like Rahul Gandhi and he should have refrained from it. "Rahul Gandhi was probably not aware of the strict action taken by the Pune Police in this case. So it is not proper for him to politicise such a sensitive issue in this manner just for getting votes every time," said Fadnavis. He was referring to the



Congress leader's late Tuesday video statement questioning the 'privileged treatment' meted out to the accused rich brat by making him write an essay, do social service and undergo medical counselling to give up alcohol. Drawing comparisons, Rahul Gandhi said that when any autorickshaw drivers, cabbies, bus or truck drivers kill anybody unintentionally, they are dumped in prison for 10 years and even the jail keys are thrown away.

SWATI MALIWAL ASSAULT CASE: CM KEJRIWAL'S EX-PS BIBHAV KUMAR TAKEN TO THREE LOCATIONS IN MUMBAI

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's former personal secretary (PS) Bibhav Kumar, who is accused of assaulting AAP Rajya Sabha member and former DCW chief Swati Maliwal, was taken to three locations in Mumbai, said police sources privy to the probe. "Kumar had formatted his phone in one of the locations, which was revealed after technical investigation," said the source. According to police, Kumar had formatted his phone on May 17, citing a malfunction. Sources suspect that Kumar before formatting his phone had transferred data to another person's device. Kumar was taken to Mumbai on Tuesday and was brought back on Wednesday. On May 18, CM Kejriwal's close aide Bibhav Kumar was arrested in connection with the assault on Maliwal and produced late at night before a local court which sent him



to a five-day police custody. Kumar was also taken to CM's residence on Monday where the crime scene was recreated. Delhi Police registered a case against Kumar after he allegedly assaulted Swati Maliwal at the Chief Minister's residence on May 13. The FIR includes charges under sections 308 (attempt to commit culpable homicide), 341 (wrongful restraint), 354(B) (assault or use of criminal force to woman with intent to disrobe), 506 (criminal intimidation), and 509 (word, gesture, or act intended to insult the modesty of a woman) of the Indian Penal Code at the Civil Lines police station.

Voter turnout improves marginally in Thane, Kalyan LS seats

Chief Minister Eknath Shinde's bastion, Thane, on Monday witnessed a low turnout but an upward trend was witnessed as Kalyan, which is being contested by the CM's son Shrikant Shinde, registered a 50 per cent turnout on Monday. The figures for 2009 and 2019 were a mere 34 per cent and 45 per cent respectively. Thane recorded a 52.09 per cent turnout, reflecting a similar trend. The average turnout in Thane, Kalyan and Bhiwandi was 53.92 per cent where 55.30 per cent of male voters, 52.32 per cent of female voters and 20 per cent of transgender individuals eligible to vote exercised their franchise on May 20. Despite being the battleground where the son of the CM is in the fray, half of the residents didn't turn up to vote at polling stations in Kalyan. As per information made available by the Election Commission of India, the constituency witnessed a little above



50 per cent voting with the Ambarnath and Mumbra constituencies experiencing the lowest turnout-47 per cent and 49 per cent respectively. But this is not the first time Kalyankars have shown little interest in the democratic process. In 2019, the voting turnout was hardly 45 per cent. Thane also witnessed a similar trend. The seat is seeing a close

fight between Shiv Sena's Naresh Mhaske and the Sena (UBT)'s Rajan Vichare. In Bhiwandi, the polling percentage was low like earlier elections. The only exception was Palghar, which is mostly a rural area. As was the case in 2019, more than 60 per cent of voters turned up at polling stations to select their candidate.

MUMBAI CRIME BRANCH FORMS SIT TO PROBE GHATKOPAR HOARDING COLLAPSE INCIDENT

Mumbai: The Mumbai Crime Branch has formed a six-member Special Investigation Team (SIT) to probe the Ghatkopar hoarding collapse incident, officials said on Wednesday, reported news agency. 17 people died and 75 were left injured after a massive billboard collapsed due to strong winds earlier in the month. Bhavesh Bhide, the owner of the company that put up the giant billboard, was arrested by the Mumbai Crime Branch from Udaipur in Rajasthan last week and brought to Mumbai. Officials added that police are investigating how Bhide was awarded the hoarding contract and how much he earned. "Mumbai Crime Branch forms a SIT to probe into the incident. The SIT will now investigate the matter. The SIT comprises 6 officers. The SIT has checked the residence of prime accused Bhavesh Bhide and seized important documents from there. He has a total of 7 bank accounts in different banks," an official statement said on Wednesday. "The police are also investigating how Bhide got the hoarding contract and how much he earned. SIT has also recorded the statements of a few officials in the company of Bhavesh Bhide," the statement added. A day after the Ghatkopar hoarding collapse incident, BJP leader Kirit Somaiya took a jibe at the previous Maharashtra government. "I want to inform you that Uddhav Thackeray became the Chief Minister on November 28, 2019. This property comes under the jurisdiction of the then-Maharashtra Government. The land jurisdiction doesn't come under Central Government or Railway Ministry."

World sees India on cusp of economic take-off

Internationally there is a growing optimism that India is on the cusp of a long-awaited economic take-off, according to the RBI's monthly bulletin released on Tuesday. It states that recent indicators are pointing to a quickening of the momentum of aggregate demand and non-food spending is being pushed up by the green shoots of rural spending recovery. The RBI bulletin points out that while revising India's GDP growth upwards by close to 2 percentage points for 2023-24, the IMF's April 2024 World Economic Outlook (WEO) alludes to the robustness of growth expected in 2024 and 2025 as "reflecting continuing strength in domestic demand and a rising working-age population." It highlights that India is expected to continue to experience broadly stable and rapid growth according to the OECD, while inflation should moderate further provided food prices remain insulated from extreme weather events. The OECD's May 2024 Economic Outlook points to strong momentum in India in recent monthly indicators and expects "strong investment and improving business confidence in India...to sustain real GDP growth". There is also a worldwide focus on the transformation of the physical infrastructure, including highways, ports and airports. India's power sector has attained 100 per cent electrification and has been integrated into a single grid across the country. There has been a leap in renewable energy capacity creation, with India becoming the world's third-largest renewable energy producer. It has attained world leadership in leveraging the digital public infrastructure for payment efficiency, financial inclusion and direct benefit transfers. India's digital public infrastructure - the India Stack - is boosting productivity, and efficiency and generating employment, besides enabling better targeting of fiscal transfers. It further highlights that recent indicators are pointing to a quickening of the momentum of aggregate demand in the personal consumption space.

Lord Buddha: The architect of religious and individual evolution

Gautam Buddha is a beacon of spiritual awakening. His public welfare thinking, and deeds are timeless that have been guiding the society for ages. His birth anniversary is celebrated on Buddha Purnima, and his Nirvana Day also occurred on the day of Buddha Purnima. 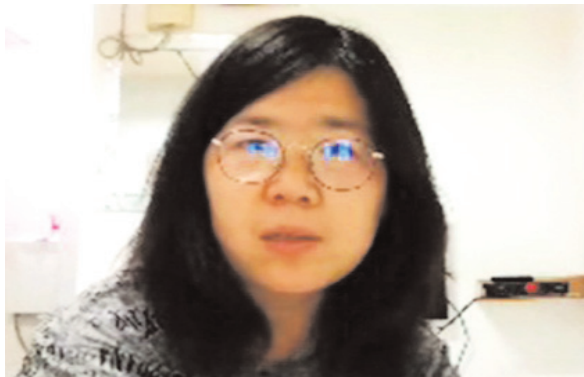

Activists confirm release of Chinese vlogger who reported on Covid-19

Chinese citizen journalist Zhang Zhan, who had been serving a four-year sentence for reporting on the early stages of the Covid-19 pandemic in locked-down Wuhan, has been released from prison, according to supporters. The former lawyer had been sentenced to four years in prison for critical reports on the coronavirus outbreak in Wuhan. She had posted videos, livestreams and essays about what she saw there. On Tuesday night, supporters published a video of the journalist and former lawyer on the social media platform X, in which she said the police took her to her brother's flat in Shanghai.



The organisation Reporters Without Borders (RSF) also posted the video, in which Zhang says she was released on May 13 and sent to her brother's home. "Although Chinese journalist Zhang Zhan was able to share a video today confirming her release from

prison after four years, we're worried about her situation under strict surveillance," RSF said in the post. "Our call for her full and unconditional release remains urgent." According to press reports, after her arrest in May 2020, Zhang went on a hunger

strike, causing her to be force-fed at times. Her weight reportedly dropped to 40 kilograms. RSF and human rights activists from Amnesty International repeatedly called for her release and international pressure on the Chinese government. After the then-unknown virus spread across Wuhan at the end of 2019, a lockdown was imposed on the metropolis of 11 million people at the end of January 2020. Officially, China has reported only about 1,20,000 deaths caused by the virus to the World Health Organization (WHO). However, various international estimates estimate the death toll in China at around 1 million.

US claims Russia likely launched space weapon into orbit last week

The US has claimed that Russia launched what is likely a space weapon capable of attacking other satellites in low Earth orbit, US Pentagon spokesman Patrick Ryder announced. Ryder added that the launch took place on May 16, and the Russian satellite is now in the same orbit as a US government satellite. When asked whether the Russian satellite threatened the US satellite, Ryder said: "Well, it's a space defence weapon in the same orbit as a US government satellite." American UN representative Robert Wood had previously expressed views similar to Ryder's. The Pentagon stated that it is not the first time Russia has launched such space weapons, referring to 2019 and 2022. On Monday, a UN resolution tabled by Russia against an arms race in space failed in the UN Security Council. The draft resolution received seven votes in favour, while seven countries, including the US, voted against it. US representative Robert Wood accused Moscow of using manipulative



tactics after Russia vetoed a US resolution against nuclear weapons in space last month. In February, reports in the US warned about Russia's nuclear ambitions in space, stating that the nuclear potential of weapons directed against satellites could pose a threat to national and international security. The US government responded to the reports, accusing Russia of developing military capabilities for use against satellites, with President Joe Biden assuring that there is no nuclear danger facing Americans or people anywhere in the world. Russian President Vladimir Putin responded to the reports and said that Russia is against the deployment of nuclear weapons in space.

Millions attend funeral procession for Iran's Raisi in Tehran

Millions of mourners flocked to a funeral procession in Tehran on Wednesday after the death of Iranian President Ebrahim Raisi in a helicopter accident, footage from Iran's state television showed. The broadcaster showed the country's supreme leader, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, leading a prayer ceremony in front of the victim's coffin. The procession then made its way from Tehran University towards Freedom Square along crowded streets filled with mourners. Raisi, Foreign Minister Hossein Amirabdollahian and seven other people were killed when their helicopter crashed in a mountainous area of north-western Iran on Sunday. In the wake of the crash, Khamenei ordered five days of national mourning, ending on Friday. Wednesday's funeral ceremony was attended by numerous high-ranking political and military representatives, as well as foreign dignitaries, the state news agency IRNA said. Raisi is to be buried in his home town of Mashhad on Thursday at the shrine of Imam Reza, the eighth imam of Shia Islam. High-ranking representatives of friendly states are expected to attend, including Russian parliamentary leader Vyacheslav Volodin. Iran's state railway company has organised special trains to take mourners from Tehran to the north-eastern city of Mashhad.



Netanyahu says he has no plans for Israeli settlements in Gaza

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has told US media that Israel has no plans to build settlements in the Gaza Strip once the war there is over. "Resettling Gaza... was never in the cards," Netanyahu said in an interview with the US broadcaster CNN on Tuesday. "Some of my constituents are not happy about it, but that's my position." Several of the right-wing nationalist Ministers in Netanyahu's coalition had repeatedly spoken out in favour of resettling the Gaza Strip with Jewish settlers. National Security Minister Itamar Ben-Gvir even declared on Tuesday that he would like to live there himself. As soon as Palestinian militant organisation Hamas is defeated, sustainable demilitarisation of the Gaza Strip must be achieved,



Netanyahu told CNN, adding that "the only force that can prevent the resurgence of terrorism for the foreseeable future is Israel". "At the same time we want -- I want -- a civilian administration that is run by Gazans who are neither Hamas nor committed to our destruc-

tion." On Saturday, Benny Gantz, a member of Israel's war Cabinet, said that he and other members of his centre-right National Union Party would leave Netanyahu's government if the Prime Minister did not present a plan for the post-war order in the Gaza Strip by June 8. The 64-year-old retired Army General and former Defence Minister joined the war Cabinet as a Minister without portfolio. The parties involved sought to demonstrate national unity in the wake of the attacks led by Hamas and other extremist groups on October 7, in which more than 1,200 people were killed. The unprecedented attack triggered the Gaza war as Israel responded with massive airstrikes and a ground offensive. The National Union is an opposition party. In opinion polls, it is currently far ahead of Netanyahu's Likud party. Netanyahu has previously said he wanted the territory to remain under Israeli military control for the foreseeable future. So far, he has refused to present a plan for the administration and reconstruction of the Gaza Strip after the end of the war.

Biden accuses Trump of using 'Hitler's language' in newspaper mock-up

US President Joe Biden has accused his predecessor and likely election opponent Donald Trump of using Nazi rhetoric following the publication of a video referencing a "unified Reich." Trump is using "Hitler's language. That's not America's," Biden said in a campaign video released on Tuesday. In the short clip, the Democrat holds a phone in his hand and says, referencing the video: "Is this on his official account? Wow." On Monday, Trump shared a video, which was later deleted, on his social media site Truth Social, showing mocks of newspaper articles that would be written if Trump won the presidential election in November. Among the bits of text featured was a subheading referring to "the creation of a unified Reich." The term "empire" in German is often associated with the Third Reich under Adolf Hitler's Nazi regime from 1933-1945. The word Reich in the video presumably refers to the founding of the German Reich in 1871,



with the text being taken from a Wikipedia entry on World War I, according to US media. According to the reports, the video was created using a ready-made newspaper article mask. It has also been used in other clips circulating online. Other newspaper headlines in the video published on Trump's platform also make reference to World War I. Trump's team later confirmed that the clip had been removed from his account. A spokeswoman for his campaign team said that it "was not a campaign video, it was created by a random account online and reposted by a staffer who clearly did not see the word."

Biden also attacked the Republican, who is hoping to return to the White House, at a campaign event in Boston on Tuesday. The 81-year-old said that "the threat that Trump poses is greater in the second term than it was in the first," according to reporters travelling with him. He called Trump "a little unhinged" and accused him of seeking revenge after losing the 2020 presidential election. Biden and Trump are guaranteed to face off on November 5 in a rematch of the 2020 vote after both achieved the required number of delegates to be nominated as candidates of the Democratic and Republican parties, respectively. Trump has been using radical rhetoric in his election campaign, including hateful and dehumanizing language, as well as making racist statements and inciting hatred against minorities. The 77-year-old also compared Biden's government to the Gestapo, the official secret police of Nazi Germany.

Rape of a mentally handicapped in Sendhwa, angry people took to the streets

In Sendhwa of Barwani district of Madhya Pradesh, a young man made a nine-year-old mentally handicapped girl the victim of his lust. When this incident came to light, people came out on the streets and a situation of tension was created. Heavy police force has been deployed to prevent tension from escalating. The condition of the innocent child remains stable. Due to the accused belonging

Superintendent of Police Puneet Gehlot, who reached the spot, assured the protesters that strict action would be taken against the accused. The people who came out on the streets to protest demanded that the accused should be given such punishment so that no other person can even think of committing such a crime. Notably, the Mohan Yadav government of the state has even bulldozed the houses of the accused involved in the heinous crime. The people of Sendhwa have demanded similar action. In view of the possibility of increasing tension in Sendhwa, police force has been deployed and senior officers are present at the spot. The police have taken the accused into custody. But, his identity has not been revealed.

Citing media reports, the Congress State President said that the purpose of this exercise is to collect data of properties of various departments located outside Madhya Pradesh, so that funds can be raised by selling them or giving them on rent. Along with

the current condition of the property, information about its value has also been sought. The Congress State President raised questions on the Chief Minister's economic advisors and also directly attacked the Chief Minister for trying to save his property. CBI Inspector Rahul Raj dismissed in nursing scam, 10 new accused including DSP-Inspector made, FIR on 23 till now

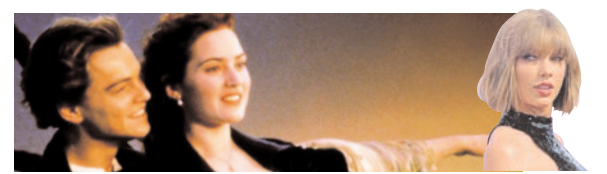
The CBI on Tuesday announced 10 new accused in the case of taking bribe to investigate the Madhya Pradesh Nursing College scam. These include DSP and an Inspector of CBI. Now the total number of accused in the case has increased to 23 including 4 CBI officers. At the same time, CBI Inspector Rahul Raj was dismissed. The new accused DSP Ashish Prasad and Inspector Rishikant Asathe live in Shivaji Nagar, Bhopal. Earlier, CBI Inspector Rahul Raj and Sushil Kumar Majoka have been arrested. Following the complaint of bribery of officers, 7 core teams of CBI and 3 to 4 auxiliary teams had raided 31 locations in Bhopal, Indore, Ratlam and Jaipur of Rajasthan. A total of Rs 2.33 crore in cash, four gold biscuits and 36 digital devices were seized. More than 150 unauthorized documents were also found from the accused. CBI sources say that now the entire investigation team has come under suspicion in this case. The investigation team formed on the orders of Madhya Pradesh High Court had given the investigation report of 308 nursing col-



leges out of 600. This team had declared the government college of Rewa unfit. At the same time, there are many colleges which were not fit and were declared fit. Now the CBI officers of Delhi are keeping the officers of Bhopal away from the entire case and gathering information about every suspect. For this, a team has gone to Delhi with the accused arrested till Monday. Investigation has revealed that CBI Inspector Rahul Raj was running a gang of extortion in lieu of inspection of nursing colleges. Rahul's team had to investigate 60 colleges. He had prepared a team of middlemen in different districts. He kept in constant touch with them and also held meetings with them. The time and day of the inspection was informed in advance to the college with which the deal was final-

ized. Rahul Raj used to send the amount received from the extortion to Dharampal, a resident of Jhalawar, Rajasthan. For this also the network of this gang was used. During the CBI raid, Inspector Rahul Raj was first arrested while taking Rs 10 lakh. Four other people who gave bribe were also detained. These included Suma, wife of nursing college owner Anil Bhaskaran. The CBI has also arrested three women, including Om Goswami, Ravi Bhardauria and Jugal Kishore, who were working as brokers. A CBI team raided the house of Inspector Rahul Raj in Professor Colony in Bhopal. During the search, Rs 7 lakh 88 thousand in cash and gold biscuits of 100 grams each were found. Rahul was awarded the Union Home Minister Medal for Excellent Investigation in August 2023. He was among the 15 CBI officers who received this honour. Meanwhile, Inspector Sushil Majoka was sent to CBI, Bhopal on deputation from Madhya Pradesh Police. After the arrest of the accused, many revelations have been made in this case. The accused were using special code words like buttermilk glass, pickle jar in bribe transactions.

"Everyone starts telling you 'Yes. But I was walking around with a really pained heart,'" he said, reports people.com.

"I was around 23 and I had an event in Miami, but I couldn't leave my hotel room. The world felt like it was closing in; I was having anxiety attacks."

Murray said things started to change

after his 25th birthday.

"I woke up and felt unsettled. I didn't like the direction that I was going in my life. I went to church, and I got a tattoo of a cross on my left wrist, and I was like, 'I'm going to move myself in faith.'"

The actor recommitted himself to Christianity at 25, and explained that a combination of religion and therapy helped him with his career and mental health.

"I remember in my younger 20s, I'd wake up and say, 'Oh, I've got to go to work.' And that's a very different place to even start your day."

"It's just a very different mindset where I have gratitude. I get to go to work and I love that opportunity to just spread love, try to elevate energy, and respect the craft. Instead of coming at it as a disgruntled, tired 21-year-old."

Others who have battled with agoraphobia include names such as Zac Efron and Linda Evangelista.

Rajasthan Royals (RR) finished third in the standings with 17 points and a net run rate of +0.273. They won eight out of their 14 group matches with the last one getting washed out. With a win in the Eliminator, the team can proceed to Qualifier 2, where they will meet the loser of Qualifier 1 for a place in the final.

Sumit Nagal to make Wimbledon men's singles main draw debut

Indian tennis star Sumit Nagal is all set for his Wimbledon main draw debut. His participation marks the first time in five years that an Indian will compete in the Wimbledon singles draw. The main draw of the grass court major is scheduled to begin on July 1. Nagal has competed at Wimbledon once before, in the qualifying rounds in 2018, where he lost in straight sets to Poland's Kamil Majchrzak. The last Indian to play in the Wimbledon singles draw was Prajnesh Gunneswaran in 2019. Nagal won the Junior Wimbledon Boys' Doubles title in 2015 with his Vietnamese partner Nam Hoang Ly. Notably, Ramanathan Krishnan was the first Indian to win the a junior's Wimbledon title in 1954. He will also make his Roland Garros main draw debut on clay this month. The main draw matches at the second Grand Slam of the year begin on May 26. Sumit Nagal secured his place in the main draw of the men's singles thanks to

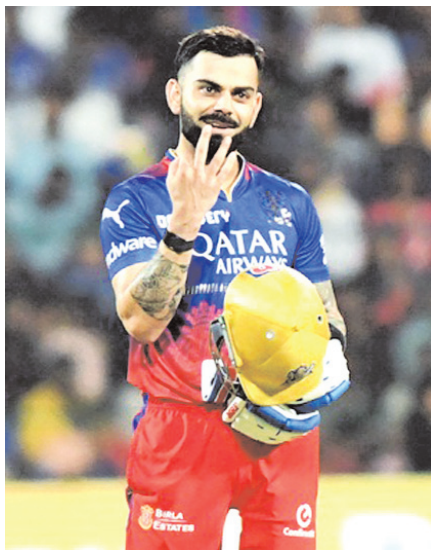


his career-high world ranking of 80. He is the first Indian male player to qualify for the French Open main draw since Prajnesh in 2019. Nagal recently stunned world No. 38

'I'm not a big stats guy, never watched analysis of any bowler', says Kohli

He currently sits at the top of the orange cap standings with 708 runs. "I like to keep things very simple. I am not a big stats guy. I have never really watched the analysis of any bowler, the wrist positions, where the ball is, because the guy might do something different on a particular day. "I have to adapt. I have to trust my own eyes, my own instinct and react to the ball and find the best solutions in any situation possible. And when you are thinking on your feet, you will find solutions to the situations that arise," said Kohli in the video posted by Star Sports. Kohli is also 266 runs short to break his record of 973 runs in a season (2016). Although it is unlikely that he touches the record, he could potentially play up to three games more this season, if the team is to reach the final which could propel him to the elusive record. "I don't think a computer sim-



ulation can tell you the situation you are going to be in. It can't prepare you for that. So, finding solutions is a very in the moment process. As I said, I have based my cricket on the basics of the game. I keep my game very similar in all three formats of the game and for me it's just playing the game at a very different tempo," added the former Indian skipper.

Julieta Jankunas (53') received a pass from Sofia Cairo, controlled the ball with her back to the goal, and fired it into the top corner, making it 4-0. 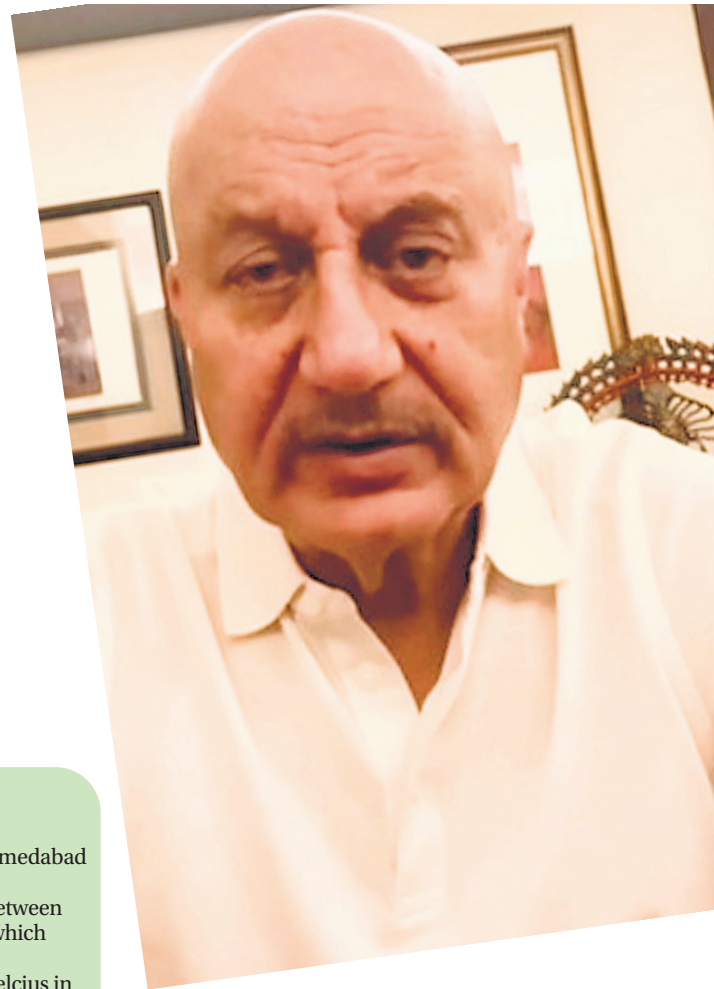
Actor Juhi Chawla visited the actor at the hospital.
